\$340,000 Capitalist filly takes centre stage in robust session at Magic Millions

Book 2 yearlings and racehorse session to bring down curtain on Gold Coast National Sale

A strong second day of trade has helped Magic Millions recover from an at times lack of market activity in the auction ring to achieve a five-year high aggregate at the end of Book 1 of its National Yearling Sale, the penultimate session of the three-week Gold Coast bloodstock extravaganza.

The Book 1 sale came to a close last night with 17 yearlings making \$200,000 or

more, nine of them sold yesterday, to help turnover for the two sessions break \$14.5 million, the highest figure since the 2017 auction.

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch, who had vowed to boost the clearance rate from 57 per cent after day one, was pleased with how the second day unfolded as vendors appeared more willing to meet the market and a more consistent amount of trade took place.

"I thought today had a little bit more momentum to it than yesterday had and the vendors who were willing to meet the market were achieving results and getting their horses sold," Bowditch said.

"Obviously, this year we've sold a lot of yearlings all over Australia and probably more than ever before, so at some stage, given that our (international) borders are shut, the market was going to become a little bit more selective and that's been apparent over the past two days."

As of last night - the Book 2 sale is still to be held today - 247 yearlings had been sold for \$14,591,500 at an average of \$59,075 and a median of \$40,000. The clearance rate was at 65 per cent.

In 2017, 297 yearlings sold for \$16,135,500 at an average of \$54,328.

"This is not a sale where we never hit it out of the park from a clearance rate perspective but to have the highest gross for this sale since 2017, a very healthy average and clearly the horses that were well sought after, in most cases, exceeded the vendors' expectations," Bowditch said.

"This is part of the cycle of our game, so to have horses selling that are facilitating (buyers' needs), whether they are taking them back to trial them, race them or bring back to breeze-up sale, it's an incredibly vital part of the sale.

"For a lot of these vendors, this is where they make the call that this is their last possible chance to sell these yearlings and to provide a spot to do that is important to us.

"I think this year we achieved that, albeit the clearance rate on a whole was less than satisfactory."

Capitalist filly catches Fogden's eye

Canungra trainer Kacy Fogden only needed one inspection to make up her mind that a Capitalist (Written Tycoon) filly from the family of champion sprinter Starspangledbanner (Choirs) was the one for her.

As it turned out, she wasn't alone in her view of the filly, leading to strong competition just three lots from the conclusion of the Book 1 sale and she was forced to go to \$340,000 to buy her.

Fogden, located at the back of sales ring next to the pre-parade ring when bidding, has a big association with Hong Kong owner Tony Fung

but she revealed the filly will be syndicated amongst stable clients.

"She was just a queen, so athletic, and so strong," said Fogden, who did not inspect the filly again after having her paraded on Tuesday.

"We have got a couple of Capitalists at the farm who are really nice and she is a lot like them, really strong, forward and precocious and she's from a great family, too, so we hope that she will go early."

Offered by Scott Seamer as Lot 1828, she is the second foal out of Kimigayo (Show A Heart), an unraced half-sister to Gold Anthem (Made Of Gold), herself the dam of Starspangledbanner and the stakes-placed Barood (Choisir) and Gold Chant (El Moxie). The filly's older brother, Fenton, is in training with Greg Hickman and has been given just one start at Canterbury last month.

Milburn Creek's Muir to race imposing More Than Ready filly

Milburn Creek's John Muir will race a More Than Ready (Southern Halo) filly after his agent Suman Hedge was able to come to terms with Vinery Stud for the daughter of Group 1-winning mare Allez Wonder (Redoute's Choice) at \$300,000 after she initially failed to meet her value.

From the second-last southern hemisphere crop by More Than Ready, the filly was passed in at \$280,000 with a reserve of \$300,000 before Hedge, who was standing to the grandstand side of the sales ring when she went through, made his first official move. He did not bid on her in the ring.

"She's a filly that we think has all the hallmarks of a nice race filly and broodmare to go on with," Hedge said.

"She's by one of the leading broodmare sires in More Than Ready, out of a Group 1-winning mare, and that's always a great starting point.

"Allez Wonder's done a really good job at stud, throwing Kooweerup and Prompt Prodigy, so there's a little bit there as well with Kooweerup at stud moving forward."

The eighth foal out of Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Allez Wonder, she is also a half-sister to Group 3 winner Pretty Pins (Pins) and Breccia (Fastnet Rock), the dam of Group 1-winning Waikato Stud stallion Tivaci (High Chaparral).

The filly, a sister to the Group 3-winning juvenile Kooweerup and the Group 2-placed Prompt Prodigy and three other winners, was catalogued as Lot 1654.

Greg Bennett will break the filly in.

"It is hard to get these types of fillies of her quality with these pedigrees," Hedge said.

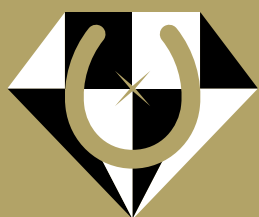

"We go to these sales to get these horses and there's generally a lot of competition for them, so when you're breeding them and you know the horse, you can see why they protected her strongly and I think that was a fair price for that type of article."

Allez Wonder has a Dundee (High Chaparral) weanling filly and is back in toal to the Arrowfield Stud stallion.

Hedge also bought an Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) filly from Bhima Thoroughbreds for \$200,000 late in the session. The filly, by Cambridge Stud's high-profile shuttle stallion, is the second foal out of New Zealand winner Hi Gorgeous (Savabeel). Her second dam is Group 1 winner Calveen (Canny Lady), New Zealand's champion sprinter, miler and older miler in 2004-05.

On day one, Hedge went to \$220,000 in combination with trainers Mick Price and Mick Kent Jr for an Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) filly and \$500,000 for a Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) colt, the latter offered by Milburn Creek.

Sydney trainer Gerald Ryan, meanwhile, reached a deal with Yulong to buy a Snitzel filly for \$300,000 after she was passed in by the Victorian farm on Tuesday. The filly, catalogued as Lot 1573, is the fourth foal out of champion New Zealand mare Soriano (Savabeel), a dual Group 1 winner who was victorious nine times.

Capitalist colt joins Fung Investments with \$260,000 price tag

Tony Fung Investments' racing team gained another member yesterday when a son of Newgate Farm's boom first season sire Capitalist was sold for \$260,000.

The colt, offered as agent by Lustre Lodge, is the fourth living foal out of the stakes-placed Anabaa's Legacy (Anabaa), herself the dam of the stakes-placed Wolf Moon (Wandjina).

"We thought he was a smashing colt and we loved the fact he was out of an Anabaa mare. He has got a lovely pedigree, he presented very well and he's a nice colt to bring home," Fung's representative Shane McGrath said.

"We're looking forward to getting him under saddle and he looked like, even though he's an October foal, he's the sort of horse that might get up and rolling nice and early. He's a nice one for the racing team.

"With respect to Wandjina, Anabaa's Legacy's thrown a good one by him, so I am looking forward to what she can do with Capitalist."

Either Fogden or Annabel Neasham will train the colt, with that decision to be made once he has been broken in.

McGrath was pragmatic about the market conditions over the past two days.

"It is a very tricky market, but at the end of the day, from a sales company's point of view, at least they are providing an avenue for people to move their stock and people are still able to turn over money," he said.

"Sure, the clearance rate is a little bit tricky, but it's the end of the road for a lot of people and from a vendor's point of view, if you love your horse, you're going to be getting some racing colours if you're not meeting this market."

Ho makes late call for son of Maurice

As bidding slowed on a Maurice (Screen Hero) colt and auctioneer Grant Burns was about to bring the hammer down for \$225,000, a new player emerged but Hong Kong owner Bon Ho's sale ring tactics were not by design.

Ho's Legend Racing bought the Arrowfield Stud-consigned colt, catalogued as Lot 1675, for \$235,000 after bidding through Magic Millions' Clint Donovan via the phone.

The colt is the second foal out of the two-time winner Arleigh (Smart Missile), whose third dam is champion filly Alinghi (Encosta De Lago), making him a brother to this season's juvenile placed Rocstar Boy.

"He looked more of a colonial style of horse, an earlier, speedier horse (than some of the Maurices)," Donovan said.

"He's all quality and it's great to secure him for Mr Ho."

As for leaving his "run" late, Donovan explained: "To be honest, I couldn't get onto him. It was at \$225,000 and Mr Ho finally called back and he said, 'I've missed him?' and I told him, 'no, but you've got to be quick, though,' so we bid and we got him."

The colt will be sent to Glenhaven Racing's Matt Vella at Hawkesbury to be broken in.

Arrowfield Stud also sold a Snitzel filly for \$230,000 soon after to Sunshine Coast-based trainer Nat McCall.

The filly, catalogued as Lot 1687, was passed in at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale but she was able to find her mark yesterday. She is the third foal of Japanese mare Bariloch (Deep Impact), a winning three-quarter sister to dual Grade 3-winning mare Dia De La Novia (Sunday Silence).

"At Easter, there is a plethora of top-class yearlings and here she was one of the stand-outs," Arrowfield Stud's Jon Freyer said.

"There was more focus and attention on her, We were very happy with the price and she's a nice, racy filly and we'd expect her to get away and run early."

Bariloch remains as part of the Arrowfield Stud broodmare band and has been used to support its roster of stallions.

"She has got a lot going for her and has got a nice pedigree. We think a fair bit of the mare and she has got a Snitzel filly at foot and is in foal to Pariah," Freyer said.

McCall also bought an Invader (Snitzel) colt for \$34,000 yesterday from the draft of KBL Thoroughbreds.

Player joins forces with O'Shea for Zoustar colt

John O'Shea found a receptive ear in International Thoroughbred Solutions' Mark Player when he floated the idea of purchasing Widden Stud's Zoustar (Northern Meteor) colt out of dual Group 2 winner French Emotion (Snitzel).

The colt, who was forced to be withdrawn from the Inglis Easter sale in April, was knocked down to O'Shea for \$230,000, half the price the Randwick trainer thought the colt would have made had he gone through the Sydney yearling sale as planned six weeks ago.

"He was in at Easter and I think he would have made double there than what he did here, it's just the nature of the market. He's a beautiful, neat running two-year-old type and we'll get him broken in straight away," O'Shea said on the Gold Coast.

"He's for a new client through Mark Player who is a top bloodstock agent in Victoria. I rang him up as I knew he had a stallion syndicate going, but we ended up finding an owner behind him to take the whole horse, so it's worked out well."

Catalogued as Lot 1777, the six-figure colt is the first foal out of French Emotion who Widden Stud paid \$850,000 for at the 2018 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. She has an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) weanling filly and is in foal to Pierro (Lonhro).

A noted straight-shooter, O'Shea said vendors who brought quality yearlings to the sale were rewarded.

He said: "The market's transparent now and if you bring bad horses here, they will get found out, and if you bring good horses they will make good money."

Book 2 of the National Yearling Sale and the National Yearling Sale will be held today from 10am.

First for Tarzino

Westbury Stud stallion Tarzino (Tavistock), the 2015 Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) and 2016 Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) winner, got off the mark with his first crop when Jungle Magnate (2 c ex The Love Of Money by Casino Prince) made the perfect start to his career with a victory at Sandown yesterday. Bred by Gerry Harvey, who retained a share in the colt, the Mick Price and Mick Kent Jr-trained Jungle Magnate (\$8) defeated favourite Mac 'N' Cheese (Sebring) by a long head in the Clanbrooke Racing Handicap (1400m). Back In The Day (More Than Ready) was three quarters of a length away in third. Jungle Magnate was a \$75,000 purchase from the 2020 New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale. "Jungle Magnate is typical of Tarzino in terms of his toughness," Price said. "They are going to be good, energetic, tough horses and Jungle Magnate is very sound. We didn't buy Jungle Magnate as a staying type as such. He does have a better turn of foot. We need to assess him as to whether he stays in work or not, but given that he may be a spring colt, he might be best placed for a break now, but it is still to be decided. Tarzino stands at Westbury Stud in New Zealand for a fee of \$12,000 (plus GST).

Warwick delighted by Tarzino's start

Russell Warwick, the studmaster of Gerry Harvey's New Zealand-based Westbury Stud, watched Jungle Magnate's victory from the Magic Millions sale yesterday and he was delighted by what he saw after receiving a call from co-trainer Mick Price to ensure

he tuned in to the race. "To get a horse (like Jungle Magnate) for a young stallion like Tarzino, who is predominantly a staying stallion, is a good start and the fact it's in Australia is all the better," Warwick said. "He's had two runners in Australia now and Mick's had both of them and they both have well above average ability." Warwick believes owners and trainers racing the progeny of Tarzino will be rewarded in their three-year-old season. "The expectation was that if we saw a little bit in the autumn and early winter we'd be happy with that," he said. "He's had three trial winners in New Zealand and two in Australia that have both shown ability, so you'd expect natural improvement and really see them start to step up in the spring. He won the Victoria Derby himself, so it wouldn't surprise if he ended up with a three-year-old of that ilk coming through in the early spring."

Five for Rommel

Bandalera Beau (2 g ex Bandalera by Scenic) got off the mark at Belmont yesterday to provide Rommel (Commands) with his fifth individual winner. The Fred Kersley-trained gelding finished fourth on debut at Pinjarra Park last month and improved on that performance to narrowly take out the Tabtouch Better Your Bet 2YO Plate (1400m). Sent off at \$16, Bandalera Beau saw off Guard The Safe (Safeguard) by a short head, with Disengo (Toronado) a length and a half further back in third. Bandalera Beau is the third winner out of winning mare Bandalera (Scenic). Rommel, who sits eighth on the leading first season sires by earnings, has so far sired one stakes performer in Pixie Chix, who was runner-up in March's Supremacy Stakes (Listed,

1000m). He will stand at Mogumber Park for an unchanged \$4,400 this year.

Cummings happy with Duais

Last-start Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) runner-up Duais (Shamus Award) will bid to go one better in the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. The Edward Cummings-trained Duais hasn't run since finishing behind Hungry Heart (Frankel) in April but has been kept fit with a trial between runs. "(I'm) calm, collected, happy that I've got a really nice filly," Cummings said. "Hopefully she's good enough to get the job done on Saturday. But, whatever happens, she'll be much better again in the spring and again next year."

Media Award enjoying Brisbane warmth

Chris Calthorpe is not going to let the prospects of a firm Eagle Farm track dent his hopes of a second Group 1 victory with Media Award (Shamus Award). A last-start winner of the Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) at Morphettville on May 1, Media Award was galloped on a softer surface on Tuesday, instead of the course proper at Eagle Farm, ahead of the Queensland Oaks. "It's a Group 1, it is what it is," Calthorpe told RSN. "If it's a Heavy 10 she'll be running, if it's a Good 3, she'll be running. We're not going to shirk the issue. She's settled in well. She's enjoying the warmer climate, a bit of sun on her back during the day. She did a nice piece of work yesterday with John Allen on. We've drawn a good gate (five) and hopefully it's all systems go and she can put her best foot forward on Saturday."

Newnham banks on Bargain

Bargain (Ocean Park) will bid to end Mark Newnham's run of Oaks placings when she contests the Queensland Oaks. "I've had four placings in Oaks around the country and I'm due to win one," Newnham told Racing Queensland. "She's drawn well in barrier four which is perfect and it'll give her plenty of options depending on how the race is run." Bargain was a last-start second in The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) and placed in the Australian Oaks the run prior. Newnham made a special trip to Brisbane to ride her in work this week, which he hopes will prove a lucky omen. "I don't often ride her work and the last time was in her final gallop before the Australian Oaks in Sydney," the trainer said. "I was really happy with her final gallop yesterday and she hit the line strongly and her recovery was very good."

Coventina Bay impresses in Qld trial

New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up Coventina Bay (Shamexpress) made the best possible start to her Queensland campaign on Tuesday. Under regular rider Sam Collett, she won her 1200-metre trial at the Sunshine Coast by three and a half lengths, pleasing trainer Robbie Patterson. "She trialled nicely," Patterson told SNTTrack. "I have got Sam Collett over here, she is riding her in track work and is going to ride raceday as well." While nominated for the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm next Saturday, Patterson is leaning towards two other Group targets with his mare. "My gut feeling is that running her in the Stradbroke could be detrimental to carrying on in Queensland," he said. "I would prefer to run in the Dane Ripper and then two weeks into the Tatts Tiara. I think they are two really good races that she will be highly competitive in."

Savatoxl to press on to Stradbroke

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Savatoxl (Kuroshio) will line up in Saturday week's Stradbroke Handicap having pulled up well from his sixth-placed effort in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) last weekend. "He's really good. He's a horse that does feel his runs

a touch and it was firm enough ground up there, but he's in really good order, hasn't left an oat and we will consider maybe changing something on his head leading into the Stradbroke," Calvin McEvoy told Racing.com. "He just got a little bit lost in the straight and laid out a little bit, a bit of it was to do with the lead horse Jonker coming out on top of him, but he didn't go a hundred per cent straight, so there is something we may be able to do to help that."

Moroney delighted with Tofane

Michael Moroney is looking forward to watching Tofane (Ocean Park) attempt to add a second Group 1 victory to her name in the Stradbroke Handicap. Tofane impressed when finishing second in the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1350m) last start, and Moroney received a positive report from jockey Opie Bosson. "He (Opie) thought she was back to her best," the trainer said. "Her effort was terrific with the weight (60 kilograms). If she had been able to take that run up the middle she wouldn't have been far off the winner, but she made up really good ground with what would have been a weight-carrying record for a mare in a Group handicap, had she won." Moroney believes the Eagle Farm track should also suit the five-year-old mare, but is cautious of the racing surface. "I think Eagle Farm should suit her, but I am a bit wary about the way it is playing, as in the surface itself. Some horses are handling it and some aren't, but she is pretty adaptable. If it does happen to rain, she does get through a bit of wet, and she has got some pretty good stats on top of the ground as well. We have got over a week to go, but at this stage all systems are going fine."

Four from four for Orbisyn

The David Vandyke-trained Orbisyn (Rich Enuff) maintained his unbeaten record with another comfortable win at Doomben yesterday. Making his fourth start, Orbisyn was sent off at \$1.12 in the Canadian Club Handicap (1350m), his first run above 1200 metres, and eased to a two and a quarter-length win over Warp Speed (Star Witness). Owner Jan McMillan has already refused seven-figure offers from Hong Kong for the three-year-

old gelding, who has won his four starts by a combined 15 and a half lengths. He will now be spelled, with Vandyke planning to start him off in lower company before potentially tackling some bigger contests.

Neasham impressed by Verne

Annabel Neasham could have another rising star in her stable as Verne (Snitzel) cruised to victory in the Too Darn Hot @ Darley Handicap (1100m) at Warwick Farm yesterday. The two-year-old ran away for a comfortable length and three-quarter win over Lucky Sun (Maurice), backing up a promising second-placed effort on debut last month, and Neasham was full of praise for the colt. "We've always really liked him. He just had a little setback last preparation and went for a short break," she said. "I still think he's going to furnish again, he's still quite raw, but he didn't do a lot wrong today. It looked like he was facing the breeze a bit and didn't have much cover, but he's put them away nicely." On his potential targets, Neasham added: "There's the Oxlade Stakes at Eagle Farm Saturday week, or we could leave him down here and run him here. He's certainly a horse that'll be spring quality, so at some stage we'll put him away and give him a break."

Change of plan for Dice Roll

Nick Ryan has opted to run promising import Dice Roll (Showcasing) in a Flemington jump-out tomorrow rather than a Winter Championship heat on Saturday. The six-year-old, who won at Group 3 level in France and also placed in the French 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), has won his first two outings Down Under, at Caulfield and Sandown, and will instead run in a Winter Championships heat on June 19. "He had nine days in the paddock after Sandown," Ryan told Racing.com. "He's had a little freshen-up, so he will need a little jump-out before he gets back to the races. You'll see him Friday at the jump-outs on the course proper here at Flemington. I was going to go to Traralgon (next week) but the jump-outs at Flemington were transferred from the steeple grass to the course proper on Friday, so I couldn't pass up the course proper at Flemington. He'll go to the next (Winter Championship) heat on the 19th (June)."

Kennewell after black type with Roca

Lloyd Kennewell will aim to secure some black type in the coming weeks with Esta La Roca (El Roca), who comfortably landed the 1000-metre Benchmark 64 at Sandown yesterday. It was the fourth win in eight starts for the three-year-old filly and Kennewell is keen to take advantage of her age before the end of the campaign. "She was just too quick," he told Racing.com. "She's a lot more physically stronger this prep, she's not very big but she's robust through the hip and got a good shoulder on her with speed to burn. She's got good improvement in her still (this campaign), she's got a long coat on her and I'm happy with her. We'd like to get black type with her and it's easier at three than it is after."

Written Matter impresses trainers

Chris and Michael Gangemi are delighted with unbeaten three-year-old Written Matter (Written Tycoon) ahead of his shot at Saturday's Raconteur Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Belmont. The gelding has comfortably won both his two starts so far, at Ascot and Belmont. "We have a big opinion of this horse," Michael Gangemi told The Races WA. "He's been pretty good and I don't think he could be any more impressive in what he has shown. He's had a few mental issues that he's overcome, but is improving race to race. He was strong to the line last time out and what I like about him is he'll run through a brick wall. He's a progressive horse and ready for the 1400 metres. This will give us a good guide on where he's at. If he runs well, we'll look at the Belmont Guineas."

Invincible Caviar accepted for Flemington

Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible), the two-year-old daughter of champion mare Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), is set to make her debut after Peter Moody accepted her for a 1100-metre two-year-old contest at Flemington on Saturday. "She's the same colour and she's got a similar physique," Moody told Racing.com when asked to compare the two Caviars. "She's a big, strong

girl with a big, long stride, that's probably where the similarities start and end at the moment. She's not as bullish as her mother was, her mother was a bull at a gate as a young horse, this filly's more relaxed at this stage. Her mother became a very relaxed mare, but she was very big and bullish as a young horse, where this filly had a great temperament all the way through." Invincible Caviar impressed in a recent all-the-way jump-out win in Pakenham, but Moody is keen to play that effort down. "If you take that into context, that morning when she put that big gap on them, they only went even time the first couple of furlongs, so I think that's a bit deceiving that jump-out," he said.

Weight swing against Declares War

The Matt Cumani-trained Declares War (Declaration Of War) will need to overcome a severe weight rise if he is to follow up his last-start win in the VRC Member Otto Kohn Trophy (2000m) at Flemington on Saturday. The five-year-old scored at headquarters with 54 kilograms but will rise 10.5 kilograms in the Benchmark 84 contest, with three of those kilograms offset by the claim of jockey Campbell Rawiller. "He's got a big weight and there's some sturdy competition in that race," Cumani said. "It's going to be a true test, but it's a good time of year for a horse like him and it's a track that he goes well at, so I think it's our best option. The alternative option is to give him a break and turn him out for the spring, but I don't think that's a good idea for him at this stage when he's going well, training well and racing well."

Aktau set for jump-out return

Staying import Aktau (Teofilo) will step-up his return to competitive action when competing in an 800-metre jump-out at Flemington tomorrow. The five-year-old gelding, who landed the Mornington Cup (Listed, 2400m) last year, hasn't competed since suffering a tendon injury after finishing down the field in the Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in the spring. "He's coming back from a tendon injury and we've given him plenty of time to

get over it," his trainer Michael Moroney told Racing.com. "He seems to be coming along nicely, so he'll have this jump-out and then at least a couple more before he gets back to the races. There is no timeframe on when he will return but we know he has a bit to do to qualify for those good races and we are well aware of that, so it would be nice to have him up and running before the spring."

Tsaritsa one of five mares killed in crash

Tsaritsa (Dane Shadow) has been named as one of the five mares killed in the Hunter Valley float crash last week. The former Chris Waller-trained mare, who was sold to Widden for \$950,000 at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale earlier last week, was in foal to I Am Invincible. Tsaritsa, winner of the 2016 Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m), produced three foals, the first of which is two-year-old Patton (American Pharoah) who was bought by Spendthrift for \$675,000 as a yearling and won at Pakenham in March.

Affair To Remember retired

Matriarch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Affair To Remember (Toronado) has been retired after a recent MRI scan revealed issues that could prove "catastrophic" if she came back to work. The four-year-old mare, who finished fifth in the Frances Tressady Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) on her last outing in February, recovered from hoof injury in March before the MRI revealed other issues. "We wouldn't have picked these things up unless we did an MRI," Dan O'Sullivan told Racing.com. "Her x-rays weren't showing much and her action was fine but her MRI did show there were some things there that possibly saved us from a catastrophic injury down the track. She's 100 per cent sound now but the vets felt that once you train her up to get her fit again, this is when these things might get brittle and this is the argument that Racing Victoria is putting up with doing these MRIs," the trainer added. "She only gets more valuable by winning a Group 1 and so it's too big a risk and you miss a year at stud. It's a real pity. She will be hard to replace."

Country king Ryan calls time on career

Champion country jockey Greg Ryan has retired from riding. The 55-year-old, who has won 11 NSW Premierships and was Australia's leading rider five times in a 30-year-career, last rode at Mudgee in December. "It's taken me a long time to make my mind up," Ryan told Racing NSW. "When I went to the races at Mudgee that day I had the intention that I was going to retire. I couldn't imagine myself having another ride. I don't need a party, I'd rather retire quietly and get back to a quiet life. I'm pretty comfortable with retirement and the temptation is probably over to return. I have missed it for sure," he added. "Change is always difficult, there's always uncertainty when you change something in your life. I miss the racing, I miss the competition. I feel very well in myself and I have a pretty hassle free life at the moment which is pretty good. I'm only 63 kilograms and that's probably about my optimum weight. I'm still physically active."

Hickman fined \$6,000

Greg Hickman has been charged \$6,000 after Tudor Music (Your Song) tested positive to the prohibited substance Flunixin at a Randwick race meeting on April 10. Racing NSW conducted an inquiry into the findings yesterday and Hickman pleaded guilty to the charge of presenting Tudor Music to the races with Flunixin in her system. Tudor Music ran in the PJ Bell Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and finished 15th.

Walter disqualified for six months

Rider agent John Walter has been disqualified for six months after pleading guilty to betting on five NSW races where a rider he was

representing was partaking in the race. Walter, who used to manage John Parr and Tim Clark, bet, or had an interest in, 25 individual bets on the races. His disqualification will run from June 7 until December 7.

McDonald wins appeal

James McDonald has successfully overturned his three-day careless riding ban, meaning he is free to ride in the Queensland Oaks on Saturday. He was handed the ban at Canterbury last week but the Racing NSW Appeal Panel yesterday scrapped the suspension. McDonald will now be free to ride leading Queensland Oaks fancy Grace And Harmony (Sebring), while he has also picked up the ride on Ayrton (Iffraaj) in the Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1600m).

McNeil remains in Queensland

Jye McNeil has opted to stay in Queensland rather than return to Victoria, with the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained Homesman (War Front) one of the reasons behind his decision. McNeil partnered the Lloyd Williams-owned seven-year-old to third place in the Lord Mayor's Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) last weekend and he is set to run again on Stradbroke day. "It was probably a number of factors," McNeil told Racing.com. "The racing is really good up here at the moment and I wanted to stick with Homesman that obviously Lloyd owns. He's running on Stradbroke day and I just thought that if we were to come home, we obviously wouldn't get back. In the gist of all that, we're escaping a bit of the lockdown too, which is quite pleasant."

Lucky escape for Stackhouse

Daniel Stackhouse will be able to continue riding after suffering minor injuries from a bike crash on Tuesday. The 30-year-old had to attend hospital having suffered some nasty skin grazes from the accident, and he explained what happened to Racing.com. "I was out riding with a friend and travelling about 55 kilometres per hour when a car pulled out of a driveway and we both swerved to miss it and I took a fall," he said. "My front tyre basically came off and my helmet was smashed to pieces, so I'm really lucky that it wasn't more serious, I definitely could have ended up with some

broken bones. I had to go into hospital and they just took out the gravel and bandaged up some of the grazing, but it won't stop me from riding at the races at all and I was able to do trials at Balnarring the next morning."

O'Keeffe signs up to Team Tye

Des O'Keeffe, the long-serving Victorian Jockeys Association Chairman, has joined Tye England's Team Tye Foundation. O'Keeffe will provide welfare, support and guidance on behalf of the Team Tye Foundation to injured and ill racing participants, including ex-jockeys and their families in NSW. "I feel privileged to be asked to help the Team Tye Foundation in assisting those in the racing industry who might be struggling and in need of some help, including families of riders that we have lost," O'Keeffe said.

Grassroots prize-money to increase in Vic

Brian Kruger, chairman of Racing Victoria, has revealed there will be significant investment in grassroots and country racing prize-money in the state with the full details set to be released next week. "When we do announce those increases, which will hopefully be at some point in the next week or so, you'll see some significant investment being made in grassroots and country racing minimum prize-money levels," he told Racing.com. "The other area which was pretty unanimous that needed to be addressed was just in terms of our black type minimums. You will see ... a significant increase for those black type minimum levels as well."

Racing NSW makes Covid rule changes

Following the confirmation that a positive Covid-19 case from Victoria travelled to the NSW south coast and Goulburn areas, Racing NSW are requiring any person who has been to a list of venues at a specific time to self isolate and not attend a NSW racecourse or licensed premises. The venues are: Green Patch campground, Cooked Goose Cafe (formerly Hyams Beach Cafe), Coles Vincentia Shopping Village, Shell Coles Express Big Merino, and Trapper's Bakery. NEW ZEALAND

NZ equine exports to return to normal

The export of horses to and via Australia is set to return to normal with New Zealand in the final stages of having Australia accept its freedom from Theileria equi status. Travel was halted last year after a single, isolated case of the tick-borne protozoal disease, piroplasmosis was found in New Zealand. Australian authorities have confirmed they have accepted the amendments to the new health certification from Ministry For Primary Industries and New Zealand authorities are now awaiting final sign off to recommence the effortless exporting process again between New Zealand and Australia. Once this is completed, the added expense of the extra blood tests and paperwork to travel will be removed, and the time between booking and export will be reduced. "It has been about getting all the information together and getting Australia to accept our country freedom status," NZB airfreight manager Greg Northcott said. "Without that we have to take the extra pre-export blood tests which has been very challenging as they have to get exported to Perth for testing. It was taking a good three weeks to get export booked, a vet out to take the bloods, those sent on the courier and to get the results back. It is not just a saving of cost, it means there is more flexibility and you don't have to make a decision three or four weeks out from the flight."

Supreme Heights after further stakes success

Mark Brosnan is hoping to add another stakes win to the burgeoning record of Supreme Heights

(Jimmy Choux) when she contests the AGC Training Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Wanganui on Saturday. The five-year-old boasts an imposing record in black-type company, having won twice at Group 3 level and placed at stakes level on another three occasions, from just the seven starts. That included a runner-up result behind Pop Star Princess (Makfi) when fresh-up in the Rotorua Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) last month, which duly pleased her trainer. "I was very pleased with the run, she was beaten by a fitter horse on the day and she took the short-cut, while we went wide, and it's the way it worked out," Brosnan said. Supreme Heights will jump from barrier four under Lynsey Satherley aboard, but Brosnan said the inside gate may not be so favourable at Wanganui, on what was rated a Heavy 10 track yesterday morning. "At Wanganui you are generally coming down the outside, so an inside draw might not be a good thing," he said. "But it (track conditions) doesn't seem to worry her, she seems to go on all sorts of tracks."

Refreshed Barnes enjoying being back in saddle

Racing's Covid-19 enforced break was tough on many racing professionals, but jockey Courtney Barnes said it was probably a godsend for her. The 26-year-old started her riding career strongly as an apprentice. She scored 23 wins in 2012-13, her second season of riding, and 33 victories in 2013-14. She made a good start to her professional career, riding 27 winners in 2016-17, but the following three seasons were a struggle for Barnes. She fell from 27 wins to ten in 2017-18 and then to seven and eight the next two seasons. "The lockdown break was really beneficial to me. I probably kick-started things off there," Barnes said. "I'd never had a break as

long as that since I left school, so I really think that benefitted me a lot and it kicked on from there." Barnes came back feeling much better and her results have proved it. She got her total rides to more than 380, the most she has ever had in a season, and her total of 28 victories is the best she's had as a professional. "I hadn't really enjoyed it for the past couple of seasons, so to enjoy it and go really well is a huge thing," she added.

ASIA

SGP: Second-up run crucial to Mr Malek's big-race goals

After an encouraging first-up run from his new star stable transfer Mr Malek (Swiss Ace), Steven Burridge is hoping to see that form hold up this Saturday. The trainer has pencilled in the Stewards' Cup (Listed, 1600m) on July 3 as the four-year-old's short-term target, with an even bigger catch three weeks later, the Singapore Derby (Listed, 1800m) on July 25. But before that, Burridge said that Mr Malek must at least reproduce that eye-catching first-up third over 1200 metres in this Saturday's easier Class 2 race over 1400 metres. "I would have liked to give him another week so he has three weeks between runs towards the Stewards' Cup, but there was no suitable race," he said. "So we've got to run him now. The 1400 metres will suit him a lot better. My only worry is the D Short Course. The track seems to suit leaders better. Long-term, the Derby is definitely a race we'd like to explore with Mr Malek. I'm not sure if he's bred to run 1800 metres, but he won over 1600 metres once, so you'd think 1800 metres should not be too hard. But seriously, I'm happy enough with him and I hope he goes well this Saturday."

First for Churchill

Dual Guineas winner Churchill (Galileo) got off the mark as a sire when Il Grande Gatsby (2 c ex Irene Watters by Miswaki Tern) took out the 1400-metre maiden at Rome yesterday. The Coolmore stallion, who will have his first southern hemisphere runners later this year, was provided with a comfortable first success as the Mario Giorgi-trained colt defeated Raimark (Markaz) by one and a half lengths, with Ilgeng (Footstepsinthesand) another one and a quarter lengths back in third. The fifth winner from as many to race out of Irene Watts (Miswaki Tern), Il Grande Gatsby successfully followed the promise he showed when runner-up on debut at Rome last month. Churchill, who scored at elite level four times during a 13-start career, has covered 360 southern hemisphere mares during his three years at stud. Currently based at Coolmore in Ireland, he will stand in Australia for a \$22,000 service fee later this year.

UK: O'Brien to saddle five in Oaks

Aidan O'Brien will send out a five-strong team in his bid to win tomorrow's Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) for a ninth time. Santa Barbera (Camelot), who finished fourth in the English 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m), will be joined by stablemates Snowfall (Deep Impact), Divinely (Galileo), La Joconde (Frankel) and Willow (American Pharoah). A field of 14 fillies will go to post.

UK: Al Aasy faces six in Coronation Cup

Al Aasy (Sea The Stars) heads a field of seven declared for tomorrow's Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m 4f) as he attempts to follow up his impressive win in a Group 3 at Newbury last time out when stepping up to elite level for the first time. The William Haggas-trained four-year-old is a warm favourite for the race in which Aidan O'Brien will be represented by brothers Japan (Galileo) and Mogul.

US: Medina Spirit positive confirmed by second lab

The second split sample taken from Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) winner Medina Spirit (Protonico) has also revealed a positive to the banned substance betamethasone. Craig Robertson, the attorney for Medina Spirit's trainer Bob Baffert, released a statement yesterday confirming the finding. "In response to the inquiries, this will acknowledge that the Medina Spirit split sample confirmed the finding of betamethasone at 25 picograms," Robertson said. "There is other testing that is being conducted, including DNA testing. We expect this additional testing to confirm that the presence of the betamethasone was from the topical ointment, Otomax, and not an injection. At the end of the day, we anticipate this case to be about the treatment of Medina Spirit's skin rash with Otomax. We will have nothing further to say until the additional testing is complete."

Hall, Whyte upstage big guns with Happy Valley doubles

Overshadowed by Caspar Fownes and John Size's titanic battle for the trainers' championship, David Hall and Douglas Whyte struck important blows of their own with pivotal doubles at Happy Valley yesterday.

Hall reached 30 winners for the season with his first brace since September when Red Brick Fighter (Artie Schiller) pounced late under Matthew Poon to snare the second section of the Class 4 Morrison Handicap (1200m) before Alexis Badel enjoyed a trouble-free passage on Sun Of Makfi (Makfi) in the Class 4 Rumsey Handicap (1650m).

The Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning trainer moved into the top ten as Whyte built on a fine debut season in 2019/20 by boosting his tally this term to 31 wins, leaving him in seventh place in a championship headed by Fownes (66) and Size (65).

With neither Fownes nor Size celebrating victories on the card, Hall and Whyte happily shared the mantle as the program's leading handlers as the talented Gallant Crown (Hallowed Crown) continued his impressive rise for Tony Millard.

Millard has guided the gelding to four victories from his most recent six starts with the latest in the Class 3 Hillier Handicap (1650m) for Poon who, along with Zac Purton and Alexis Badel, registered a double.

"He's done a great job this season," Millard said of the four-year-old. "He's showing a lot of promise and we'll just see now how he comes back after this run before we decide if he runs again."

"Matthew rode him perfectly and it's great to see this horse perform like that."

Poon continued his strong association with Hall, who was chuffed to post a two-timer.

"It's been a little tough at different times, but it's always nice to get a double," Hall said. "It makes things a little better."

"If any one horse deserved to win one, it's him," Hall said, referring to Sun Of Makfi. "He's a little horse, he'd shown he was going to get a couple of wins on the board but he had to settle down a little bit and learn to relax."

"He's still not the full article, there's not much of him and he's still continuing to improve but it's good to get the win and I'm certainly looking to next season with him."

Hall believes Red Brick Fighter retains the capacity to fire again at both Happy Valley and Sha Tin.

"He's still got the flexibility and he's not a one-trick pony," Hall said. "Fresh out of Conghua and 1200 metres was the right trip."

Whyte, who trained 44 winners last season, delivered with Valiant Elegance (Salade) in the Class 5 Wing Lok Handicap (1000m) under a clever, searching ride by Jerry Chau before completing the double with Simply Fluke (Keeper) in the first section of the Class 3 Cleverly Handicap (1200m) under Badel.

"Alexis made the difference tonight - he gave him a gem of a ride," Whyte beamed after Simply Fluke's triumph. "He was probably unlucky last week not to finish in the first three and Alexis jumped off and gave me the confidence that he could back up and run again."

"He ran too well without winning and tonight, once he got that decent draw (two), I thought he was going to run a big race and he let down beautifully."

Whyte derived just as much satisfaction from Valiant Elegance's victory.

"This horse has shown me a lot at home and unfortunately he's had to have a throat surgery, which has been pretty successful," Whyte said. "He's had to get his confidence back to realise that he could breathe again."

"The last three or four starts, he's run third and shown good consistency but he needed a race like today to show us that he had got over that throat surgery."

Paul O'Sullivan lavished praise on veteran Harrier Jet (Dane Shadow) after the nine-year-old again defied Father Time - and younger rivals - to land the second section of the Class 4 Morrison Handicap (1200m) for Purton.

Contesting his 72nd start in Hong Kong after competing in ten races for Chris Waller in Australia - and winning three in 2014/15 - the gelding showed he had lost none of his competitive zest by charging along the fence to down Fortune Carrier (Your Song) by a short head.

"He's done a great job in Hong Kong, he's been here seven years and a race hasn't gone by where he hasn't put in and he's remained sound and enjoys the environment," O'Sullivan said.

"He's damn near ten-years-old and he got all the favours and just got up. We're very pleased with him. It's very satisfying with an old horse like that.

"It will certainly be his last race of the season, he's owned in Beijing and I don't know what they want to do. It's fair to say there are more runs behind him than he's got in front of him.

"If he was to come back next year, he'd have a pretty quiet season.

"You can walk in the box with him and he's the kindest horse I've ever trained. He tries hard and remains sound, physically and mentally."

Benno Yung attributed Amazing Rocky's (Bel Esprit) effortless victory in the Class 4 Jervois Handicap (1000m) to a perfect barrier (one) and another measured Purton ride.

"The barrier was really good and it worked out well," Yung said. "He'll probably go up to Class 3 now and have a chance."

Joao Moreira solidified his grip on the jockeys' championship by guiding Francis Lui's Winning Volatility (Holy Roman

Emperor) to victory in the Class 4 Wellington Handicap (1800m) before Derek Leung and Chris So combined with Goodluck Goodluck (Magic Albert) to land the second section of the Class 3 Cleverly Handicap (1200m) Handicap.

IT'S IN THE BLOOD

TREVOR MARSHALLSEA'S IN-DEPTH PEDIGREE ANALYSIS

That song about the old grey mare doesn't speak too fondly of her, reminding the listener – again and again – that “she ain't what she used to be”.

But in the case of the unbeaten Riot And Rose, old grey mares have served the pedigree particularly well.

The gelding, himself a flashy grey, has bounced back from early adversity – he was hand-reared at Waikato Stud after losing his mum at four weeks – by winning all three races in his first campaign, capped by a 1600-metre three-year-old handicap at Caulfield last Saturday. Once back from a well-earned spell, he looks set to continue the bountiful partnership of trainer Peter Moody and syndicator Wylie Dalziel.

What stands out about Riot And Rose's pedigree is it seems to have been aged like a fine wine.

Only three columns in, third dam Tautina was foaled way back in 1968, only a year before the 51-year-old Moody himself. She bore Riot And Rose's second dam Just For Luck when 17 in 1985. In turn, Just For Luck had the dam, Lasting Luck, also as a 17-year-old in 2002, and Lasting Luck threw Riot And Rose, the last of her eight named foals, at 15.

Compare that to the pedigree of the contemporary Riot And Rose beat on Saturday, Rathlin: his third dam was born a full 16 years after the counterpart in Riot And Rose's pedigree, Tautina; his second dam eight years after Just For Luck. Even Rathlin's fourth dam came along eight years after Tautina.

For that matter, Riot And Rose's male line also has some decent longevity. Third sire

Lunchtime was a 1970 drop, before Snippets in 1984, and lastly Pins in 1996, who left Riot And Rose aged 21.

“They certainly endure pretty well,” Dalziel tells *It's In The Blood*. “It's an older style family. We've had a bit of luck with other horses like that, where you've got to go back a fair way in years for not many generations.”

Dalziel might not have acquired Riot And Rose simply because he liked the progeny of old grey mares, but his colour was a factor. The man behind Wylie Dalziel-Roy Higgins Racing has always been a fan of greys.

“I'd had a few that didn't kick on, so I was very keen to get a good one. It was on my bucket list,” he says. “A lot of people do like grey horses, because they're beautiful. OK, they can be easier to sell for that reason, but while we do try to buy nice types over those sorts of factors, I did still want a good grey.”

Whether Riot And Rose can achieve like the likes of Schillaci, Chautauqua, or everyone's favourite grey, Subzero, is dreamtime thinking,

but so far he's making a very good fist of things for the team that fortunately snared him from New Zealand.

Bred by Kerrie Cox and Angelique Bridson, who both worked at Waikato Stud, Riot And Rose had been bound for Hong Kong. He won a Te Rapa trial and the deal was almost done, before it fell through when x-rays picked up a slight knee ailment.

Cox and Bridson contacted old associate Moody, and the ball started rolling, the breeders ultimately staying in a syndicate Dalziel found predictably easy to build.

“I rang the vets over there and they were confident if we gave him a bit of time the knee problem would clear up,” Dalziel says. “That trial win over there was very impressive. I liked the fact he looked like he had more to offer, since he looked a bit immature.”

After some spelling and maturing following his arrival in Victoria, Riot And Rose's racing career was delayed again by a cut to a leg. This at least enforced still more time for maturation

in a paddock, which evidently has helped make him the exciting prospect he is, having won as a short favourite at Moe, Pakenham synthetic and Caulfield.

There's not just longevity in his pedigree, but class as well. Suiting Moody down to the ground, there's a good patch of his home country – Queensland – in the maternal half.

Tautina was the first of the grey mares, acquiring her colour from sire Lumley Road (GB). Though nothing special on the track, Tautina was a prodigious producer who threw 15 named foals. The ninth began a run of seven straight foals by Semipalatinsk (USA) – who Queensland breeding legend Colin McAlpine boldly imported after he'd won stakes races in Italy – and kicked off the sequence of foals in style. Named Just Now, she won the 1986 AJC Oaks and VRC Turnbull Stakes.

Two foals later, the Semipalatinsk-Tautina mating produced Just For Luck, who threw triple stakes-winners Scenic Warrior (Brave Warrior) and Stanzaic (Raise A Stanza). Tautina in fact had her last named foal aged 23, a Semipalatinsk filly called Just A Tick, winner of six races.

Just For Luck left eight named foals, the seventh being Lasting Luck, by Iglesia, who won five in Queensland, including two in Brisbane, before Waikato bought her in 2007.

After six foals, three of them by resident stallion Pins, Cox and Bridson acquired her, and knew where to send her.

"We'd always been big fans of Pins," says Cox, who was Waikato's bloodstock manager at the time, while Bridson handled marketing. "We thought he was one of the most underrated stallions around, and he was getting to the end of his career, so there wouldn't be many more opportunities to breed from him."

The knowledge base about Iglesia mares and Pins was shallow, making this a type mating. It seems to have worked with their

first cover by Pins, another grey mare named Vincere who fetched \$NZ115,000 as a yearling and has won two from six. It also clearly worked with Riot And Rose, who was to be sold to Hong Kong for a lot more.

"She was a big, roomy mare and Pins put a lot of strength into his stock, which might've been what she was lacking," Cox says. "We also hoped to get a nice grey Pins, because he'd had some quality grey ones, and that's what we got."

Pins, the Australian Guineas winner of 2000, departed only a few months after Riot And Rose was born, aged 22. But the colt had lost his dam to illness months earlier.

"He was four weeks, so too old to foster on to another mare. We had to feed him milk and hand-raise him, so he's very special to us. It was a team effort at Waikato," Cox recalls.

"He was the most stunning foal born. He was big, strong, just a real good-looking foal.

But when he lost his mum he went through that real pot-bellied stage. It took a long time for him to get back to what he looked like when he was a foal, but we knew at some stage he'd get back to it."

Cox, who also thanks breaker Paul Pertab for his early education work, says Riot And Rose was "never going to be a yearling article" due to immaturity.

"We thought we'd give him the time he needs and one day he'd repay us for all the time we spent with him," she says.

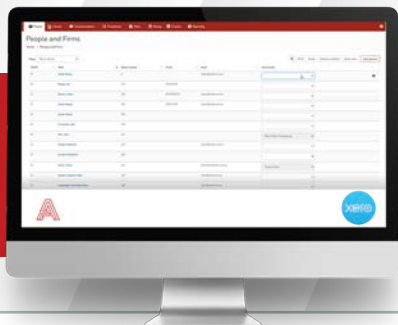
"We didn't foresee the challenges we'd have with him, but every horse has their time."

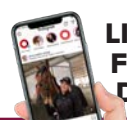
