McGrath promises strong sales presence as staff cut as a result of operational shake-up

One of the biggest investors in world thoroughbred racing and breeding in recent years, the Hong Kong-owned Aquis Farm, will undertake a major restructure of its huge Australian operation, leaving a cloud hanging over its three-state stallion roster heading into the new year.

Members of the Aquis nominations team Jimmy Unwala, Bernie Kane and Nick

Taylor were told on Monday that they were no longer required, while some marketing staff were also made redundant as part of the staged restructure which has been occurring behind the scenes in recent months.

Owned by Hong Kong billionaire Tony Fung and his family, Aquis has been a major player in Australian racing since it acquired the former Nathan Tinkler-owned parcel of properties at Canungra in the Gold Coast hinterland in early 2015.

<< *Continued from page 1* The property tycoon, whose investment vehicle Aquis Group also owns the Canberra Casino, arguably enjoyed his finest moment in racing earlier this year when Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) won the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) and sent his stallion value soaring alongside a horde of Aquis-owned colts made their mark on the racetrack in a remarkable run of success.

While Farnan was the headline, Aquis also unearthed Prague (Redoute's Choice), Holyfield (I Am Invincible) and Global Quest (More Than Ready) and, more recently, Anders (Not A Single Doubt) and Mo'unga (Savabeel).

The emergence of the valuable group, the envy of many colts syndicates, also coincided with Aquis' continued expansion into stallions, with its Canungra farm growing to include a Hunter Valley base in 2017, and at Seymour in Victoria last year.

Aquis had 18 stallions under management across three states this year.

Shane McGrath, Aquis' managing director, yesterday said the onset of Covid-19 this year

gave the operation's decision makers time to consider the future for the business.

"With Covid, it has given us the opportunity to put steps in place to introduce a new strategic plan for Aquis. We have elected to change the way that we are doing business and there will be a lot more in the future," McGrath said.

"Across most industries, people have had time to reflect and review and we're going to try to be a little bit more innovative in how we do business and we'll implement new things.

"There will be more changes in store over the next six to 12 months as we implement our new strategy."

Since entering the market, Aquis has invested enormous amounts of money on bloodstock, amassing a broodmare band of more than 200 as well as yearlings and stallions in both hemispheres.

Aquis has either outright, or in partnership, spent more than \$110 million on horse flesh at public auction alone, and this year some of that investment has paid off, with Farnan's win in the Slipper skyrocketing his value to around the \$40 million mark.

While McGrath would not be drawn on the future of the stallion business, he indicated that Aquis would again be active at next year's yearling sales, particularly in support of stock by its stallions.

He said: "I am looking around at Magic Millions yearlings at the moment now that the breeding season is slowing down. *Continued on page 4>>*

"We have had a great season across the board with support from the breeders and shareholders and we look forward to supporting those same people in the sales ring where possible.

"We have had a phenomenal year on the racetrack and the push is to try and find the next Golden Slipper winner."

The first public sign Aquis Farm was embarking on a dramatic change in direction emerged in early July when it was revealed that its NSW stallion roster and broodmare band would relocate from Emirates Park in the Hunter Valley to Gooree Park Stud in the central west of the state.

Before the start of the breeding season, Aquis instead used Lincoln Farm at Blandford to stand its NSW stallion roster in order to remain closer to the majority of the mare pool, which is located in the Hunter Valley.

In early August, Aquis and partner Phoenix Thoroughbreds also sold a majority share and standing rights in prized new-season three-year-old Farnan to Kia Ora Stud, arguably the most valuable colt of his generation.

Subsequently, Aquis continued the selling off of its colts portfolio, with Prague sold outright to Kia Ora Stud, and sold down its interest in Anders to Widden Stud, while Tony "Tubba" Williams, who oversaw the breeding arm of the business, suddenly left his role as chief executive after less than nine months in the position.

Fung's contribution to the Australian thoroughbred industry since 2015 has been immense after quickly building his racing and broodmare numbers, which were fast-tracked with the assistance of agent Julian Blaxland, particularly in 2016 and 2017, which coincided with the stallion operation at Canungra with four foundation sires.

Aquis then entered into an agreement with Emirates Park in 2017 to establish a Hunter Valley presence before the deal was ended mutually last July,

It remains unclear whether Aquis will retain its leased stallion property near Seymour in Victoria, a farm which is owned by prominent owner and breeder Darren Thomas, and was taken on to stand stallions last year.

This year, Lean Mean Machine (Zoustar), the relocated Needs Further (Encosta De Lago) and Royal Meeting (Invincible Spirit) headed up Aquis' Victorian roster.

In NSW, high-class Group 1-winning sprinter Pierata (Pierro) - almost certainly Aquis' best-credentialed stallion to stand under its banner - entered his first year at stud this year while Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Divine Prophet (Choisir) has started to have his first two-year-olds hit the track this season.

The Japanese-bred, Australian-raced Group 1-winning sprinter Brave Smash (Tosen Phantom), has also created interest on Aquis' Hunter Valley roster with his first foals born this year.

Newcomer Dubious (Not A Single Doubt), another colt raced by Aquis after being purchased as a yearling, heads up its Queensland stallion roster this year after winning the ATC Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) and BRC Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at two.



Aquis Farm timeline

2015

JANUARY

Tony Fung buys the four Canungra properties, once known as Wadham Park, Elysian Fields, Sarahvale and Benobble, from Patinack Farm's Nathan Tinkler and rebranded as Aquis Farm.

2016

MAY 27

With significant investment in the Aquis Farm base at Canungra, it stands four stallions at stud for the first time: Spill The Beans, Holy Roman Emperor, Domesday and Benfica.

2017

APRIL 21

Aquis forms a joint venture with Emirates Park at Murrurundi to create a Hunter Valley stud presence where Caulfield Guineas winner Divine Prophet becomes its flagship stallion. Invader, a colt part-owned by Aquis in conjunction with the China Horse Club-Newgate Farm partnership, wins the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes and later joins Aquis stallion roster, starting in 2018.

MAY 10

Aquis secures the Hawkes Racing-trained Caulfield Guineas winner Divine Prophet to spearhead its Hunter Valley roster.

MAY 21

Shane McGrath leaves Coolmore to become deputy chief executive to Justin Fung at Aquis Farm. He is later appointed as managing director and plays a key role in the section of yearlings including Farnan.

JUNE 20

Jimmy Unwala joins Aquis as head of nominations for NSW after a long stint at Darley

2018

JULY 2

Aquis launches a \$1 million prize pool for breeders who back its Group 1-winning Queensland-based first season stallion The Mission if his progeny go on to make an impact as juveniles on the racetrack.

AUGUST 27

Aquis acquires young sprinter Jukebox for stallion duties on the eve of the breeding season.

2019

MAY 3

Aquis leases Seymour property to allow the expansion of the stud business into Victoria, with Siege Of Quebec and Lean Mean Machine as its first stallions on the roster.

OCTOBER 4

Aquis acquires a controlling interest in the Greg Hickman-trained Group 1-winning sprinter Pierata.

OCTOBER 13

It is announced that Tony "Tubba" Williams will return from the UK to become Aquis CEO overseeing the stud side of the business.

2020

MARCH 21

Farnan wins the Golden Slipper in a season in which Aquis-owned colts such as Prague, Holyfield and Global Quest all win stakes races.

JULY 6

Aquis announces it will move its NSW stallion operation from Emirates Park at Murrurundi to Gooree Park Stud at Mudgee.

JULY 9

Backed by Aquis, Annabel Neasham, previously Ciaron Maher and David Eustace's Sydney stable foreperson, takes out her own trainer's licence at Warwick Farm and has immediate success.

Woodside Park Stud lauds Morningside property

A new era for Woodside Park Stud is dawning with their 2021 yearlings the first to be raised at the Morningside property in Nagambie. Woodside Park principal Mark Rowsthorn acquired the historic Morningside, which had been developed by Dr Bill Burns, in 2019, with the farm having most recently produced wagyu stock before it changed hands. "Woodside Park's newly acquired property in Nagambie has proven pivotal to the outstanding success of many of Australasia's racetrack elite; Australia's most iconic races - the Melbourne and Caulfield Cups, Cox Plate, Caulfield Guineas and more - all won in recent times by horses grazed on this property," Woodside Park chief executive James Price said. "This includes 31 Group 1 winners including Zipping, Maldivian, Shocking, Efficient, Silent Witness, Divine Madonna and Vengeance Of Rain. Add in 173 stakes wins and over \$86 million in prize-money and it is a record second to none. It boasts a soil composition unrivalled in Victoria, and it is now playing host to our young stock, developing them into the next Group 1 stars." The first yearlings to come off the property are four lots consigned at next month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, including three by their prolific stallion Written Tycoon (Iglesia).

Williams hoping for Gailo turnaround

Matthew Williams is confident veteran Gailo Chop (Deportivo) can bounce back from a disappointing Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) run last time out, as the combination of a

better draw and a slower tempo can play to his advantage in the Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) at Ascot tomorrow. The ten-year-old finished last of 16 in the Railway but Williams believes jockey Brad Rawiller can use the barrier four draw to his advantage this weekend. "It's a much better gate for him on Saturday, barrier four," Williams told Racing.com. "We wanted to be forward on him (in the Railway) and so did about ten other runners inside him. It was carnage. It was the quickest mile race he has been in, compared to the couple of runs in the Makybe Diva he had. They were going along four, five lengths quicker a furlong in the Railway than they were in the Makybe last year. Drawn four, he should be able to bounce and be there. He might take up the lead and if he can get things run along to suit him better, he can turn that poor run around from last start."

Rodd ready for Barbie

Michael Rodd will resume riding in Queensland a week earlier than anticipated after the Covid-19 border restrictions were lifted between Victoria and Queensland. Rodd made the decision to leave Victoria and rejoin his family in Queensland, after a frustrating nine months in the state followed a five-year spell in Singapore, which ended at the beginning of the pandemic. "I flew up (from Newcastle) Tuesday, the first day they were open, had Wednesday to get things sorted and then had trackwork this morning," Rodd told Racing.com. "I just can't wait to get back in the routine of it all again. Everything has sort of been on hold for a few weeks, so it's great just to be back and I'm raring to go." Rodd is excited to partner the Tony Gollan-trained Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) in the George Moore Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben tomorrow. "I was

speaking to Tony (Gollan) this morning and he's really happy with where she's at, although he's not over the moon about her barrier (11)," Rodd said. "She goes really well fresh and she has had a little freshen up since Sydney and the blinkers go on. I know the stablemate, Jonker, is going to be hard to run down because he's a flying machine and he looks like he's back to his best, but if they do carve each other up in front, it's going to give me a great chance to run over the top of them."

Jenni over niggles for Pakenham Cup

David Brideoake believes Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Princess Jenni (High Chaparral) can make it consecutive feature country cup wins in tomorrow's Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m). Princess Jenni has not appeared since her success on October 28 due to an eye injury and then a foot abscess, but Brideoake is confident those issues are behind her. "I'm very pleased with the horse. I'm very confident about her at the track and distance," Brideoake said. "Her weight (61 kilograms) worries me but I'm happy to roll the dice. I'm optimistic about her prospects. Her work over the last couple of weeks and all of her gallops suggest she's ready to run a big race."

Pakenham target for Passage

Connections have primed Northwest Passage (So You Think) for a shot at the Pakenham Cup, having had the race in mind for the seven-year-old gelding all preparation. He will step up from 2000 metres to 2500 metres after a fourth-placed finish in the Kyneton Cup a month ago. "This has been the target for a while. I thought he was quite a big price, I thought he'd run

above his odds," David Eustace, who trains Northwest Passage in partnership with Ciaron Maher, told Racing.com. "He has been racing well. He has been a victim of not being able to run over 2400 metres because of a lack of options. It's probably not a vintage race and there's a lot of horses in it that have been racing for a while or can throw in bad runs."

The Astrologist on trial for Gold Coast

The consistent The Astrologist (Zoustar), who has not finished outside the first three in his last eight runs, will step up to 1400 metres for just the second time in his career when he lines up in tomorrow's Gold Bullion (1400m) at Pakenham. The four-year-old gelding finished runner-up in the MSS Security Sprint (Listed, 1200m) two starts ago and is the pre-race favourite for the contest. "Saturday is a really good test for us," co-trainer Troy Corstens told Racing.com. "We're trying to get him to the Magic Millions in January and obviously the 1400 metres is going to be a test, so it's going to tell us which races we want to target up north. He needs to go there on Saturday, run super well and then we'll make our mind up and then plot a course to Queensland." In The Astrologist's only previous attempt at 1400 metres, he placed second behind talented mare Rubisaki (Rubick) at Flemington in June last year, when trained by Tony McEvoy. "It's pretty good form (behind Rubisaki)... he's always around the mark and we know he's got the ability, it's just a matter of putting it all together," Corstens continued. "He's starting favourite again on Saturday and we need him to put a race like this away."

Hi Stranger heading for Millions

Hi Stranger (Zoffany) will aim to secure himself a trip to the Magic Millions Carnival next month when lining up in a 1200-metre handicap at Pakenham tomorrow. The four-year-old gelding landed a Benchmark 78 event at Bendigo two starts ago, before finishing runner up over 1200 metres at Ballarat last month. Nash Rawiller has been booked to ride Hi Stranger and trainer Shane Flidner is expecting another good run. "When we found out Nash was available, he was an obvious choice because I'm not sure

how many of the Vic jockeys will be heading up to Queensland and of course it's always great to have a rider of his capability," Flidner told Racing.com. "There looks to be more depth and speed in Saturday's race, so he'll probably have to get a bit further back and then run on well. He's a horse that needs a good speed in the race for him to be at his best. I'm expecting him to run well again hopefully, he's definitely taken improvement from his last start. The topweights look the ones to beat but he'll meet them better in the weights. We've put a tongue-tie on him just to try and get a little bit extra out of him, he's worn the tongue-control bit previously but was just playing around with it a little."

Price, Thomas for a pair of Williams

Apprentice Will Price has always wanted to ride William Thomas (Nicconi) and he will be granted his wish at Pakenham tomorrow. The high-class sprinter has racked up over \$500,000 in prize-money during his career but the reason Price is keen to ride William Thomas is because of his name. "My name is William Thomas Price and to make it even better, William Thomas is trained by John Price," the apprentice said. "With that in mind, I've always wanted to ride him and now I've got the chance." Last weekend at Moonee Valley, the 20 year-old rode his first city double when he was successful on both frontrunner Ocean's Thirteen (Ocean Park) and Bandersnatch (Casino Prince). "That was the best day of my riding career. The timing was great as we had aimed to use my three-kilo claim in the city over summer," he added.

Smart Image a black-type horse: Snowden

Peter Snowden is excited about the prospects of Smart Image (Smart Missile) as the three-year-old colt returns in tomorrow's Schweppes Handicap (1300m) at Rosehill. Smart Image, who won his first two starts before finishing seventh in the Up And Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) on heavy ground in August, won his last trial at Randwick on November 24 and Snowden is pleased with his condition, but is slightly concerned about the trip. "He's come back well, he's developed a fair bit more. He's in good order and his two trials have been

good," Snowden, who trains in partnership with his son Paul, told Racing NSW. "The only little question mark is 1300 metres first-up. It's the right race for him if it is 1200 metres but I'm a touch worried about 1300 metres with 59.5 kilograms on his back. He's better than a Saturday horse, that's for sure, I think he's definitely a black-type horse."

Ryan's Express Pass to Sydney

Victorian trainer Nick Ryan will make a rare trip to Sydney with talented sprinter Express Pass (Wandjina) after bypassing last week's Carlyon Stakes (Listed, 1000m) in favour of the Members Christmas Handicap (1100m) at Rosehill tomorrow. Express Pass is unbeaten in three starts at 1100 metres and Ryan believes the experience of an interstate trip will help the four-year-old's development. "It looks a suitable race for him and the trip away will do the horse good," Ryan said. "He has really trained on super." Group 2 placed behind Dalasan (Dalakhani) as a spring three-year-old, Express Pass was gelded after missing a place in the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in February. He returned to win his first two starts at Bendigo and Caulfield and has been kept fresh since his midfield finish behind Shamino (Shamus Award) in the Doveton Stakes (Listed, 1000m) last month.

Bateup's bid for city success

Theresa Bateup is hoping improving geldings The Guru (Rubick) and Golly I'm Lucky (Lucky Owners) can establish themselves as city-grade horses when lining up at Rosehill tomorrow. The Guru progressed from a maiden winner at the Sapphire Coast to metropolitan placegetter last preparation and showed he had returned in good order with a first-up second at Hawkesbury. The Guru keeps Bateup on her toes but also has his share of ability. "There's not a nasty bone in his body but he's like Dennis the Menace, he likes to push the boundaries," she said. "At the races he will lean on the tie ups until they break, not that he's interested in going anywhere but it's a game. He's going to be better as he steps up in trip but his first up run was super." Golly I'm Lucky strung together three provincial wins last campaign and was

a late-closing fifth to Mo's Crown (Uncle Mo) when he resumed at Kembla Grange last month. "His stable name is Spider because he has legs like a spider and very early on he didn't know where they all went," Bateup said. "He's always shown a great deal of ability and a lot of work has gone into him to teach him how to settle in his races. He deserves his chance in a Saturday city race and he's up to winning one of them, he just needs a few things to fall into place for him."

Final 'Clap' for Webster

When multiple Group 1 winner Happy Clapper (Teofilo) was retired earlier this year, his trainer was never going to be far behind and Pat Webster announced he was calling time on his training career earlier this week. Best known as the trainer of Happy Clapper, one of the few horses brave enough to regularly take on Winx (Street Cry), Webster will saddle his final runner, Kosciusko (All Too Hard), at Newcastle tomorrow. "To come down from Clapper's level to Kosciusko running at Newcastle on Saturday has been pretty difficult," Webster said. "When Clapper was in work it was like going to the track on a magic carpet ride from the farm and after he retired it was like driving a B-Double." Webster will continue his work with Racing NSW, including his role mentoring apprentice jockeys, and has 58 acres of land and 25 black angus bulls to look after at his central coast property. "There are a lot of lawns to be mowed and a lot of paddocks to be slashed," he added.

Laming penalty in December

Richard Laming will likely receive a decision on the cobalt case relating to Iam Ekstraordinary (Ekraar) by Christmas, with the case nearing its end yesterday. The Victorian Racing Tribunal decided in October to dismiss the most serious charge of Laming administering cobalt to Iam Ekstraordinary, but the trainer is still awaiting a penalty for presenting the six-year-old gelding to the races with cobalt in his system and not having an updated treatment book. VRT chairman judge John Bowman announced yesterday that they will aim to make a decision on Laming's penalty before the Christmas break.

Alexander to contest charges

Archie Alexander intends to contest cobalt charges after Tom's Knight (Duporth) exceeded the permitted cobalt threshold after winning a maiden at Kilmore on November 2, 2018. Alexander's legal representative, Jack O'Connor, indicated at the VRT directions hearing yesterday that Alexander will contest the charge of Tom's Knight being administered with cobalt, arguing it was an honest mistake relating to the contents of the gelding's feed. A preliminary hearing will be held early in the new year, with the date yet to be decided.

Tycoon Bec wins for Judd

Tycoon Bec (Written Tycoon) made an impressive debut in a fillies and mares maiden over 1450 metres at Kyneton yesterday, defeating runner-up Shezadandi (Dandino) by four and a half lengths. Part-owned by former AFL star Chris Judd, Tycoon Bec is named after his wife and was bought for \$140,000 at the 2018 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. Trainer Matt Cumani is excited about her prospects and believes she will improve when upped in trip over time. "I'm not going to make the mistake of jumping up to that too quickly, because she is competitive at this distance (1450 metres), so I think we might have a look again at this distance or gently ease her up to a mile," Cumani told Racing.com. "I think if she can do that at this trip, at 2000 metres I think she is going to improve."

Seemar backs Aussie racing

Satish Seemar, multiple champion trainer in the United Arab Emirates, has vocalised support for the Australian racing industry. In a question and answer interview with Thoroughbred Racing Commentary, Seemar was asked what was the one thing he would change in racing and he responded he would like to see the global racing industry follow Australia's example in attracting the next generation to the sport. "I would love to see the next generation become more involved in racing. The country that is doing the best job of that from my personal observation is Australia," said Seemar. "They have understood that we need to move with the times to protect the future of our sport. We understand that we need new equine blood for

our industry to continue to thrive and improve, but we tend to forget that we need new human blood to survive too. I have noticed what a good job Australia are doing to counteract that when I have visited there, but it needs to happen around the world."

Post-spring review for Valley

The Moonee Valley Racing Club will conduct a review of its fixture program this summer, after the forced move of their August meeting to the end of November saw promising commercial results. The meeting, which was abandoned halfway through due to heavy rain in August, was reported by MVRC CEO Michael Browell to have attracted a 56 per cent year-on-year increase in turnover when it was moved to November. "It's an option we are considering at the moment and we will make a call on that in due course," Browell told Racing.com when discussing a potential move of the McKenzie Stakes (Listed, 1200m) and Carlyon Stakes. "It's given us an option. We will definitely look at it. I think there was some benefit to having those black-type races towards the tail end of the spring carnival. Turnover was super strong, but we need to see if we leave the races there, can we backfill the gap in that August race meeting? We are just moving the magnets on the board and we should be able to make a call shortly."

NEW ZEALAND

Moana primed for Bonecrusher

Chad Ormsby has no doubt that promising filly Moana (Ocean Park) has returned from a spring spell a far superior version of her previous self. The Waikato trainer will produce the filly in tomorrow's Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Ellerslie in her first start since a luckless third in the Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Hastings at the beginning of October. She was denied clear running that day but still only went down a nose and a head at the hands of Aegon (Sacred Falls) and Bourbonaire (Darci Brahma), three-year-olds that subsequently ran the quinella in the New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton last month. "Every man in

Australasia saw that she should have probably beaten them both," Ormsby said. "She had two weeks out after that race and even in that time, she put on 50 kilograms and has strengthened a lot. She's improved and she's turning into a real racehorse. She feels amazing and her demeanour has improved. She means business now." Moana is likely to tackle the Eight Carat Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie on Boxing Day and will have no problems getting up over 2000 metres and even further, Ormsby said, adding that he expected her long-term future to lie in Australia.

Lad unleashed at Riccarton

Michael and Matthew Pitman will have numbers in their favour as per usual at their home track meeting at Riccarton today. The father-and-son training duo like to take full advantage of not having to travel their horses given Riccarton's standing as the premier southern track and they will saddle as many as 17 runners today before they venture north to tomorrow's Trentham meeting where they have a trio of acceptors. Among the 17 is quality sprinter Enzo's Lad (Testa Rossa), who will follow a well-worn path when he contests the Perfect Packaging Open Handicap (1200m). The eight-year-old is being set for the Telegraph (Gr 1, 1200m), a race that will be run under weight-for-age conditions for the second year, after previously being a handicap. It is a race that Enzo's Lad won under handicap conditions in 2018 and 2019 and then went within a short neck of making it a hat-trick in the race when playing second fiddle to Avantage (Fastnet Rock) earlier this year. "He has to have firm ground but he needs racing as well," Michael Pitman said. "I thought he went a cheeky race on an unsuitable track in the Stewards' and he wasn't that far away. I was happy with him. We have been pleased with him since. He has plenty of weight to carry but he deserves to carry it, he has won two Telegraphs. He has run in this race before and won this race before. Winning this race obviously won't affect his weight for the Telegraph now. He is going here and then Dunedin. He will follow the path we have always followed."

Pike braving the Trentham Storm

Cambridge trainer Tony Pike will head south to Trentham tomorrow to a wet welcome, with rain forecast for the weekend's premier meeting. Despite the gloomy outlook he is set to bring his own storm in the form of unbeaten two-year-old Stormy (Telperion), who will contest the Wakefield Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m). The promising juvenile beat home Wakari (Vespa) on debut, and the Roydon Bergerson-trained gelding subsequently went on to win impressively by four lengths in his next start. However, Wakari won't be seen on raceday for the rest of the season after he chipped a sesamoid in the race. Pike was pleased with Stormy's debut win and he is hoping for a repeat performance this weekend. "It was good. He was pretty green around the corner that day but it was a pretty tough effort," he said. "Roydon's horse has since gone out and won again since that race. He was strong to the line and past the post. He will take a lot of improvement out of that first-up run and he is a very genuine two-year-old. You would think off that first-up win, taking a line through Roydon's horse, he should be hard to beat again. He has definitely gone the right way and based off that first-up win you would expect him to be right in the finish again."

Drama's Endless career on the line

Tony Pike will also be hoping for an improved performance from evergreen galloper Endless Drama (Lope De Vega) at Ellerslie tomorrow. The nine-year-old, Group 1-placed in Ireland, the UK and Australia and twice a Group 2 winner in New Zealand, was unplaced in his first-up run in the Legacy Lodge Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Te Rapa and Pike said his performance tomorrow will dictate his future. "He had a long time off," Pike said. "He came back and trialled really well, but he just raced too fresh (last start). He tried to do the whole thing on one breath. We will ride him a lot colder on Saturday and if he can get smothered up and get some cover he has got the class to be competitive." While

the globetrotter's better days are behind him, Group 1 targets are still in the offing if he performs well this weekend. "He is an older horse now and it is all going to depend on his form," Pike said. "We have got him in the Railway and the Telegraph and if he finds some form they are two nice races for him. He is a nine-year-old stallion now so what is left in the tank we will find out in the next few weeks."

ASIA

JAP: Lord Kanaloa leads strong Shadai roster

Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha) will be the highest publicly-priced member of the 30-strong roster at Shadai Stallion Station for 2021. The sire of the all-conquering Almond Eye as well as Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Tagaloa has had his price trimmed for next year and will be available at ¥15m (approx. AUD\$194,000), from this year's ¥20m. Next in line are three sires available at ¥10m (approx. AUD\$129,350) including Epiphaneia (Symboli Kris S), whose fee has doubled after the Triple Crown heroics of his daughter Daring Tact. Kizuna (Deep Impact) and Duramente (King Kamehameha), who also have both been making an impression as bright stallion prospects, have also risen to the same mark.

INTERNATIONAL

206 for More Than Ready

Important Mission (6 g ex Laura's Pleasure by Cactus Ridge) put the benefit of a recent run to good use when he swooped late to post an unlikely win in the Garhoud Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Meydan last night. The six-year-old gelding looked woefully outpaced for much of the race before hitting top gear in the final stages to notch his fifth career win and in the process provide More Than Ready (Southern Halo) with his 206th individual stakes winner. Behavioral Bias (Shackleford) finished second, with Bochart (Dubawi) in third. Former shuttler More Than Ready will stand at WinStar's Kentucky farm for a fee of US\$65,000 (approx. AUD\$87,350) in 2021.

193 for Dubawi

Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) edged closer to a double century of stakes winners when his son Firnas (7 g ex Crystal Music by Nureyev) kept his good run on form going with a victory in The Entisar (Listed, 2000m) at Meydan last night. Lining up off the back of his recent success over the course and distance, the seven-year-old gelding fought hard in the closing stages to see off the challenge of the more-fancied Saltarin Dubai (E Dubai) and register a fourth win in 12 career starts to date, in the process providing his sire with his 193rd individual stakes winner. Much of the pre-race attention had been focused on Pakistan Star (Shamardal), the dual Group 1 winner in Hong Kong, who was making his debut for new connections here. Rider Pat Dobbs made sure the seven-year-old was given a clear passage free from any kickback on this first start on dirt, and the duo looked like being involved in the finish when they

loomed up on the turn for home. However the gelding, who pulled himself up on his final start in Hong Kong, again showed signs of reluctance and eventually missed out on the places after being caught on the line in a bunch finish for third.

Four for Lilbourne Lad

Johnny Drama (5 g ex Quelle Histoire by Whipper) kept his winning run

going as he registered his fourth successive victory when making a successful debut in stakes company at Kempton on Wednesday evening. The five-year-old gelding was winning for the sixth time in 17 starts to date as he beat favourite Sinjaari (Camelot) by a short head in the Wild Flower Stakes (Listed 1m4f). Sextant (Sea The Stars) was a length away in third. The victory provided the former Rathbarry stud resident Lilbourne Lad (Acclamation) with his fourth individual stakes winner. A half-brother to a dual winner in Italy, Johnny Drama is out of the Whipper (Miesque's Son) mare Quelle Histoire, a half-sister to Endless Drama (Lope De Vega), who was placed in both the Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and Lockinge Stakes (Gr 1, 1m), before heading south where her most recent success came in last year's Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m).

Sottsass date beckons as Demi O'Byrne lands 360,000gns session-topper

Few offerings draw prospective purchasers to the Park Paddocks ring quite like the draft of Juddmonte fillies and those lots again took centre stage during another solid session of the Tattersalls December Mares Sale on Wednesday.

Khalid Abdullah's operation offered 19 three-year-olds and a single juvenile and the draft duly brought an aggregate of 1,526,000gns (approx. AUD\$2.9 million) and an average of 76,300gns (approx. AUD\$145,000). The most in-demand member of the bunch was Cressida (Dansili), who was knocked down to Demi O'Byrne, seated to the right of the rostrum with Tammy O'Brien, at 360,000gns (approx. AUD\$630,000).

The filly, who was signed for on behalf of Peter Brant's White Birch Farm, will now form part of Sottsass's (Siyouni) debut book as the owner's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) hero begins his second career at Coolmore.

"She's a very nice physical and a great walker," O'Byrne said of the daughter of Dansili (Daneshill), whose looks are backed up by a deep Juddmonte pedigree. She is the fifth foal out of Modern Look (Zamindar), the dam of four winners from as many runners and the winner of the Prix de Sandringham (Gr 2, 1600m) herself.

Modern Look's best performer is Grand Jete, a Dansili sister to Cressida who won the Eatontown Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) and finished runner-up to Dacita (Scat Daddy) in the Beverly D. Stakes (Gr 1, 9.5f) for Chad Brown.

In turn, Modern Look is out of Cheveley Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) heroine Prophecy (Warning), whose brood includes the likes of multiple Group 1 winner Foreteller (Dansili) and Arabesque (Zafonic), dam of stallion siblings Showcasing (Oasis Dream) and Camacho (Daneshill).

Cressida won one of her three outings for Abdullah and John Gosden, with her Kempton

novice stakes success coming on debut last July.

Brant is set to throw his considerable support behind Sottsass's stallion career, with the son of Siyouni (Pivotal) and Starlet's Sister (Galileo) also due to be visited by the likes of Unaided (Dansili), dam of the champion Uni (More Than Ready) who sold for US\$4.1 million in November; Rosa Bonheur (Mr. Greeley), dam of Brant's dual Grade 1 winner Raging Bull (Dark Angel); Albany Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) victress Different League (Dabirsim); and Azafata (Motivator), whose offspring include May Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) scorer and Group 1 runner-up Fleeting (Zoffany).

Twomey gets his Girl

Paddy Twomey enjoyed a big result on day two of the sale when Sonaiyla (Dark Angel) was sold by his Athassel House Stud to Moyglare Stud for 900,000gns (approx. AUD\$1.7 million). Nearly 24 hours later the trainer turned buyer when going to 310,000gns (approx. AUD\$589,300) to add Stormy Girl (Night Of Thunder) to his string.

The daughter of Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) has developed into a high-class performer for Sedgfield-based trainer Rebecca Menzies

and owners Stonegrave Thoroughbreds, as highlighted by her success in the Flying Fillies' Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Pontefract in August.

"She's a nice filly and she looks to have progressive form," said Twomey. "She's been unlucky the odd time in her races but hopefully, if the cards fall her way, another winter might help her improve again. Her dam's half-sister bred a Group 1 winner this year so it's a deep family and she has residual value as a broodmare. She's been bought for an existing owner."

The three-year-old's value had appreciated markedly since her previous visit to the sales, as she fetched just €22,000 when bought by Compas Equine as a yearling. Her pedigree had also undergone a notable upgrade in that timeframe, as she is out of a half-sister to the dam of Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr 1, 1600m) hero Tiger Tanaka (Clodovil).

Menzies was on hand to offer new connections her congratulations, and after the docket had been signed she said: "She's been absolutely amazing for us and she's progressed as the year's gone on. There's loads more to come from her as a racemare and I'm sure she'll be a brilliant broodmare in time."

"She was owned by Mike And Eileen Newbould, they've had more jumpers than Flat horses but they bought some yearlings a couple of years back and she's been their flagship horse so it's a brilliant result for them.

"Hopefully we can go back to the sales in future and find another like her. We've only got a small yard and she'll leave a massive hole but I'm really looking forward to watching her. There probably aren't many trainers who'd say that but I'll get a lot of pleasure out of seeing her race on."

Juddmonte action continues

Famed Juddmonte producer Clepsydra (Sadler's Wells) has exerted a notable influence on proceedings at this year's December Mares Sale, with no less than four of her daughters changing hands.

The priciest of those was Time Saver (Frankel), who went the way of Blandford Bloodstock at 850,000gns (approx. AUD\$1.615million), while Gerrardstown House Stud gave 200,000gns (approx. AUD\$380,000) for Mechanism (Zamindar) and Ted Durcan and the Heider family went to 160,000gns (approx. AUD\$304,150) for Amser (Frankel).

On Wednesday the fourth daughter of Clepsydra sold when Marc-Antoine Berghgracht of MAB Agency went to 190,000gns (approx. AUD\$361,200) for the three-year-old filly Brinjal (Kingman). The half-sister to Timepiece (Zamindar), Passage Of Time (Dansili), Father Time (Dansili) and Continuum (Dansili) is set to commence her breeding career in France.

"It's just a lovely family and she's been bought for French breeder Haras d'Haspel,

which is based in Normandy," explained Berghgracht. "The farm started in the last three years, mainly as a commercial breeder.

"The pedigree is very active with plenty of fillies breeding – you can expect the page to look different next year. We will think about what stallion we send her to. We might ask Juddmonte what would be their suggestion!"

Tom Goff also dipped into the Juddmonte draft when the Blandford Bloodstock man went to 170,000gns (approx. AUD\$323,175) for Arabian Dream (Oasis Dream), an unplaced sister to Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) scorer and Whitsbury Manor Stud stallion Showcasing.

Being by Oasis Dream (Green Desert) and out of Arabesque (Twirling Candy) means the three-year-old filly is also a half-sister to Yeomanstown Stud sire Camacho, the Group 3-placed Tendu (Oasis Dream) and the stakes-placed Westerland (Frankel) and Bouvardia (Oasis Dream).

"I thought we had her at 65,000gns!" said Goff. "Oasis Dream is a fantastic broodmare sire and she's going to go to Ireland and be a mummy straight away. The page speaks for itself."

Godolphin queens in demand

The Godolphin draft also proved a major draw as 22 lots brought receipts totalling 686,800gns (approx. AUD\$1.3 million). The priciest of those was Queen Kahlua (Kingman),

who was knocked down to Stuart Thom of Galloway Stud in Woburn for 160,000gns (approx. AUD\$304,150).

The three-year-old won two races for Sheikh Mohammed Obaid and Henri-Francois Devin, including a Bordeaux Le Bouscat conditions event by four lengths on her penultimate outing. She also compiled some classy form in defeat, most notably when fourth behind Earthlight (Shamardal) in the Prix Kistena (Listed, 1200m).

She will get the opportunity to further enhance her race record as Thom reported that her new owner would be sending her into training in Newmarket.

"She's been bought to keep in training but she'll probably come home for some rest first. Then she'll go into training with this man," said Thom, gesturing towards Stuart Williams. "She's a lovely filly physically, we thought she moved very well, and the fact she was only beaten five lengths by Earthlight really caught our attention.

"Eventually she'll come back to Galloway Stud and hopefully she'll make a nice broodmare."

Bred by Horizon Bloodstock, Queen Kahlua is a half-sister to six winners, most notably the Listed scorer Windhoek (Cape Cross). She was making her second appearance at public auction having been signed for by Devin and Stephen Hillen at 57,000gns at Book 1 in 2018.

Keogh added: "He came down as our second bunch of two-year-olds from Crown Lodge. He was probably the quiet achiever of the stable and the last couple of weeks he's really put it together.

"Lucky enough we had James down during the week and he enjoyed his work here at The Valley during the week and thought he could run a nice race.

"We needed James' call to run the horse because he's probably not furnished enough and where we need him at the moment - there's a lot more to come from this horse."

Paulele is likely to chase some of the big juvenile races in the autumn, but it appears that next spring as a three-year-old will prove his time to shine.

Dawn Approach (New Approach) served five seasons in Australia, producing five stakes winners on both sides of the Tasman led by top performer Dawn Passage and New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up Dawn Patrol. However, he has not made the trip the last two years, instead remaining at Darley's Kildangan Stud in 2019 and 2020.

Paulele is the ninth named foal, the eighth to race, out of former Ingham-owned filly Chatoyant (Flying Spur), a three-time Randwick

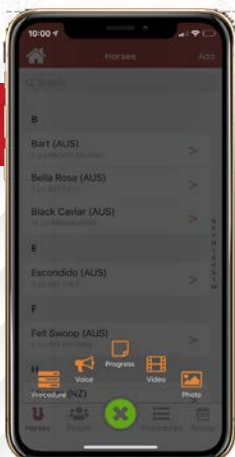

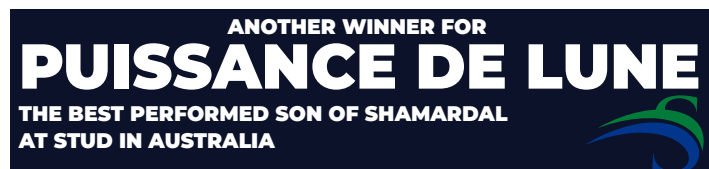

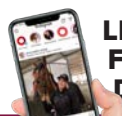
