Spitting image Lonhro colt sells for \$180,000 in Book 2 of **Magic Millions National Sale**

Gold Coast auction comes to a close as Bowditch expresses satisfaction with results

f there was ever a need for further proof that well-credentialled horses will be found by buyers no matter what marketplace they are offered through, there was another example yesterday when a striking colt by champion sire Lonhro (Octagonal) made \$180,000.

The top-priced lot in Book 2 of the Magic

Millions National Yearling Sale, purchased online by the Hong Kong-based Upper Bloodstock, also capped off a successful 2020 pinhooking exercise for NSW's Jazcom Thoroughbreds.

The fact that there were numerous bidders on the colt past the reserve of \$80,000 also highlighted the continued demand for new season two-year-olds from an array of participants in an array of racing jurisdictions. Continued on page 2>>

GLOBAL GROUP 1 CALENDAR - PAGE 30 << Continued from page 1 The strong result for the Lonhro colt - and the \$260,000, \$160,000 and \$160,000 price tags for racehorses Noble Privilege (Lonhro), Sole Heir (Exceed And Excel) and Haunted (Lonhro) respectively - brought a satisfying end to the seven-day national Gold Coast sale which for some time was in doubt due to the coronavirus pandemic.

This year's National sale may not have seen the exorbitant turnover of past years, but for Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch it was one of the most satisfying, given the problems faced in the lead-up to the delayed auction which managed to set a new milestone with the selling of \$4.2 million mare Sunlight (Zoustar) last Monday week.

"It has been a long haul for both us and the vendors," Bowditch said.
"There are plenty of people that have gone to extraordinary efforts to be here, whether it be vendors, buyers, staff, some of which have had to isolate in hotels, leaving states early to work within the restrictions that were put in place."

"We thank them for what they have done and helping us in making the best of it. To have well over \$80 million for the stock we had, and to be clearing well over three quarters of what we offered, is a phenomenal effort in the current climate.

"This sale was for the participants of the industry and they got in behind it and met the market and the buyers were here and they were very motivated to play and I think that is evident. It has been an extraordinary sale from start to finish. "To the team at Magic Millions, to put a plan in place to hold this sale and I have never been more proud of them."

Inglis Australian Weanling Sale purchase from Twin Hills Stud by Jazcom Thoroughbreds, He is the second foal out of the twice-winning mare Respected (Street Cry) who is a half-sister to the Listed-winning sprinter Federal (Medaglia d'Oro). Further back is MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Flit (Medaglia d'Oro). Consigned by Goodwood Farm for Jazcom, the colt was catalogued as Lot 1625.

Jazcom Thoroughbreds' Colin Branthwaite had intended to offer the colt for sale earlier this year but was forced to wait until the delayed National sale to put him to market.

"It was a bit of a mistake (that he was in Book 2), but in all honesty, we had the same thing happen two years ago when we topped Book 2 at Magics in January when our Brazen Beau filly was in Book 2," Branthwaite said.

<< Continued from page 2 "We were all down and out about it, but I just find when Book 2 horses are able to be viewed at the same time as Book 1 horses, if you've got the right product they find their way.

"That Brazen Beau filly two years ago made her way to be one of the best (by the sire) in the sale even though she was in Book 2 and she brought \$230,000.

"This horse he made himself and the buyers don't miss the nice horses."

Magic Millions bloodstock staff helped facilitate the sale on the Lonhro colt with Upper Bloodstock.

"We have been an information service for those guys who are in Hong Kong and they have been doing their work back there," Bowditch said.

"Upper Bloodstock bought a lovely Capitalist (on Monday) and a fantastic Lonhro today and I know when they actually get to lay eyes on these horses, they will be delighted with what they have purchased.

"The way the sale has gone gives us confidence that we can provide a competitive market even in tough circumstances. The virtual or online platform is the way the world is going to be for quite some time.

"This has been an outstanding effort just to pull it off, but for it to be as successful as it has been is truly humbling for me and the whole team."

The sale of the Lonhro colt was not the only success for Branthwaite's Jazcom Thoroughbreds which also turned \$10,000 into \$180,000 after

topping last month's Inglis Scone Yearling Sale with a son of Toronado (High Chaparral).

Branthwaite placed an \$80,000 reserve on the Lonhro colt and would have been happy to retain him to race.

"Everyone who saw his x-rays would have seen that they were good and his video scope was good," he said.

"The horse has ended up as the closest looking horse to his sire as I've seen. He was a Lonhro colt who looked like Lonhro." WE WERE ALL DOWN

As for next year, Branthwaite has not let the economic uncertainty dent his confidence, having secured 29 weanlings for the 2021 yearling sales

"Put it this way, the worst we'll do with our 29 horses is break even. We're fortunate enough at the farm to be able to run our horses here through the farm and all our staff look after the weanlings the same as they do with all the spelling horses that we have," he added.



Darby Racing secure unraced Noble Privilege

After missing out on a Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) colt at Monday's Magic Millions National Yearling Sale, Darby Racing, in conjunction with Will Johnson Bloodstock, returned yesterday and secured three-year-old colt Noble Privilege (Lonhro) for a session-topping \$260,000.

Catalogued as **Lot 1808**, the colt was from the unreserved draft of The Estate of the Late Eduardo Cojuangco, and hails from a family that includes Northern Meteor (Encosta De Lago) and Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock).

Mark Holland, sales manager for Darby Racing, was delighted to secure Noble Privilege.

"We missed out on the Shalaa last night, we were wrapt with that Shalaa, but when this guy came up, he was just a must get for us," Holland told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"Lonhro, outstanding family, two stallions in the family and he's a horse that's won a city trial already. We've had success buying breeze-up horses last year with Malkovich, who was a horse that had won a city trial as well. We bought him for good money and sold him very quickly. This horse is still a colt, he's Lonhro who is a champion stallion and he was just a must have."

Holland lauded the fact the colt is a racehorse which means shareholders won't have to wait long for him to hit the racetrack.

"That's one of the massive bonuses," Holland said. "We're up here buying yearlings at the moment and now we can get our shareholders into

a racehorse and with legitimate reasons for Gooree to be moving him on."

Formerly trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, Noble Privilege is set to join the Team Hawkes stables.

"Obviously John (Hawkes) with Lonhro, it's a great match for them," Holland said. "They pride themselves on good types and this colt was a mirror image of his father and we think it's a perfect fit for Team Hawkes."

"There was good competition, but everyone was up against it because we got beat for the Shalaa colt, so we really wanted this bloke.

"We found this sale tough, it has been hard work and the competition has been strong for the good horses and a lot of work has gone into it.

Kia Ora buys into Slipper winner Farnan

MAGIC MILLION

Kia Ora has purchased a stake in reigning Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) with the deal also seeing the three-year-old colt standing at the Hunter Valley operation at the end of his racing career, as was revealed exclusively by ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. A winner of five of his six starts last season, including three feature juvenile Sydney races culminating in the Slipper, Farnan will target spring races such as the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) with an extended ownership group of Kia Ora joining the Aquis Farm and Phoenix Thoroughbreds partnership. Consigned by Vinery Stud at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Farnan was purchased for \$550,000 by Aquis in conjunction with his breeder Phoenix Thoroughbreds. Interestingly, even though Aquis has an extensive three-state stallion operation, a key element of the agreement is that Farnan will stand at Ananda Krishnan's Kia Ora once the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt's career is over. Aquis Farm managing director Shane McGrath and Kia Ora bloodstock and breeding manager Shane Wright declined to comment on the deal yesterday.

'Internationals looking less likely'

Speaking on RSN927 yesterday morning, Racing Victoria chairman Brian Kruger said it is looking less likely that internationally-trained horses will be able to compete at this year's spring carnival. "Racing Australia is working with the federal government on behalf of both Victoria and New South Wales to see whether we can get exemptions for international staff to travel to Australia," Kruger said. "The timeline around that decision I'd say that the international stables would need to know that is probably within the next four or five weeks. Clearly with what's happening in Victoria at the moment, you'd have to say the probability is becoming less and less likely that we'll be granted that exemption. We are likely to be bringing a shipment of up to 16 horses on oneway tickets but that would not be with any staff, they would be picked up and looked after by local trainers."

Godolphin rule out Melbourne campaigns for internationals

Godolphin's British-based trainers Charlie Appleby and Saeed bin Suroor will not be sending horses to Melbourne to compete in this year's spring carnival, Racing Victoria revealed yesterday. The pair have enjoyed notable success on their visits over recent years but will be absent this time around due to a change in the Covid-19 restrictions in Melbourne. "Both Saeed and Charlie have advised over the last few days that they won't be coming to Melbourne this year," RV general manager of international operations Paul Bloodworth told Racing.com. "Charlie Appleby advised last night that because of the change to Stage 4

restrictions, he wasn't comfortable sending his staff to Melbourne and Saeed has also advised he won't be coming."

O'Briens dominate Cox Plate international entry

Aidan O'Brien and his sons Joseph and Donnacha are responsible for a staggering 22 of the 28 international entries made for the 100th running of the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) which is set to take place at Moonee Valley on October 24. A total of 128 entries were made for the race and while international interest was on a par with recent seasons, it is expected Covid-19 restrictions could have an impact on the number of visitors who actually make the trip. Aidan O'Brien has nominated 13 horses including Galileo (Sadler's Wells) trio Magic Wand, Japan and Magical, while his sons Joseph and Donnacha, who is in his first year training, have entered eight and one respectively. A total of 51 individual Group 1 winners feature in the entries with the home contingent headlined by Vow And Declare (War Of Declaration) and also including the likes of Russian Camelot (Camelot), Alligator Blood (All Too Hard), Mystic Journey (Needs Further) and Regal Power (Pierro).

Aquis launch virtual stallion parade

Aquis Farm yesterday launched a virtual stallion parade of their NSW-based stallion roster, led by All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Pierata (Pierro). The parade includes detailed footage of all eight stallions, who are now based at Lincoln Farm following their relocation from Murrurundi. Multiple Group 1 winner Verry Elleegant (Zed) looks set for another fruitful campaign after finishing fourth without being asked to do anything in a hot 1000-metre heat at Rosehill yesterday. Bjorn Baker's Fun Fact (The Factor) led home the field, with the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Holyfield (I Am Invincible) finishing two and a quarter lengths away in second. Winx Stakes (registered as Warwick Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) favourite Funstar (Adelaide) also featured in the heat, coming home in sixth under a hard hold.

Master Of Wine gets going late

Cups contender Master Of Wine (Maxios) also had his first major hit-out ahead of the spring yesterday at Rosehill. The Team Hawkestrained gelding settled last in the ten-runner heat over 1030 metres before running on in the straight to finish fourth, four and a half lengths behind the winner Toryjoy (Street Cry).

Jack Bruce to lead Maher and Eustace's Sydney stable

Ciaron Maher Racing yesterday announced the appointment of Chris Waller's racing manager Jack Bruce as assistant trainer at their Sydney stable. A graduate of the Godolphin Flying Start program, Bruce, who has also spent time with Bjorn Baker and Mike de Kock, will replace Annabel Neashem, who is set to start training in her own right. "Jack has all the attributes required to continue our success in Sydney," Maher said. "He has already worked with some of the best and he knows his way around the Sydney racing scene. I think he is going to add another dimension to what is already a great team." Of his appointment, Bruce said: "I have observed the emergence of Ciaron's Sydney stable and I couldn't be more impressed with what has been achieved in such a short period of time. It's exciting to be joining on the cusp of what promises to be another great season."

Sentimental Miss joins Waller

Last year's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Sentimental Miss (Reliable Man) will fly to Sydney next week, joining the Chris Waller stable in her hunt for Australian success. Sentimental Miss will aim for both the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "It was always the long-term plan for her to go to Australia for her five-year-old season," Go Racing principal Albert Bosma said. "Given Covid-19, it now looks like it will be the least depth to spring racing in Australia for a long while, perhaps since the equine flu. There will be a limit on northern hemisphere horses coming down and restrictions on horses moving interstate. We purposely gave her a light four-year-old campaign and didn't step her up to the 2400 metres even though it's her best distance. We have worked really closely with trainer Lisa Latta to prepare for the spring. She had a jump-out last week at Levin, and Lisa is really happy with her, saying she's even stronger this year."

Jenni's Rainbow impresses on debut

The David Brideoake-trained Jenni's Rainbow (More Than Ready) looks set for bigger and better things after breaking her

maiden in impressive fashion over 1100 metres on debut at Pakenham yesterday. The three-year-old daughter of More Than Ready (Southern Halo) settled last on the rails under Ethan Brown before rocketing home in the straight so score by three lengths ahead of the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Kiani (Headwater). Purchased for \$75,000 at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, Jenni's Rainbow is out of the unraced mare Three Rainbows (King Mambo), who herself is a three-quarter sister to Mambo Light (Kingmambo), the dam of stakes scorers Le Juge (Dansili) and Frankel Light (Frankel), while she is also a half-sister to Group 3 winner Beauty Bright (Danehill) and Listed victor Aloft (Galileo).

Star Turn relation scores at Pakenham

Luiselli (Written Tycoon), the team Hawkestrained daughter of a half-sister to Vinery Stud resident Star Turn (Star Witness), broke her maiden at her first start since March at Pakenham yesterday. The three-year-old filly overran her rivals in the final stages of the race to score by half a length in the 1200-metre maiden. Purchased for \$380,000 at the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Luiselli is out of Pinova (Fastnet Rock), the half-sister to multiple Group winner and Group 1 placegetter Star Turn, who now resides at Vinery Stud in the Hunter Valley where he will cover his second season at fee of \$16,500 (inc GST).

Moss Trip to visit Trapeze Artist

Group 3 winner Moss Trip (Mossman) is set to visit Widden Stud stallion Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) in the upcoming breeding season, owners Triple Crown Syndication have announced. The winner of five of her 23 starts, Moss Trip was also placed twice in Group 2 company and followed up her win in the James H B Carr Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) with a victory in the Inglis 3YO Guineas (Listed, 1400m). Trapeze Artist, the highestrated son of four-time champion sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) will stand for a fee of \$77,000 in 2020.

"Racing Victoria stewards have opened an inquiry into the conduct of licensed apprentice jockeys Michael Poy and Teodore Nugent and a stablehand registered to Robert Hickmott upon receipt of information of possible breaches of Covid-19 protocols," a stewards' report read. "Acting on the advice from RV's chief medical officer, the three have been stood down until further medical assessments are undertaken and until such time as the stewards conclude their inquiry. The trio have been advised that they are not permitted to attend any racecourses or licensed premises until approved by the stewards to do so. The chief medical officer has advised that all three should self-isolate at home and adhere to all Stage 4 restrictions pending further direction."



The William Muirtrained four-year-old posted a career-best effort to notch his latest success and set him out on a path which, if all goes to plan, will eventually lead to Flemington. "We wouldn't get to Australia this year but it's definitely a possibility next year as that's why we bought him," Muir said. "Clive (Edginton, owner) bred Red Cadeaux before selling him on and he's always wanted a decent stayer that could head out there. He fancied this Dunaden foal as he beat Red Cadeaux by a pixel in the Melbourne Cup and it would be great if we could get over there and go one better." More immediate targets closer to home for the five-time winner include handicaps the Ebor (1m 6f) and Cesarewitch (2m 2f), as well as the Doncaster Cup (Gr 2, 2m 2f).

TBA: Lock in transport plans early for movement of mares

horoughbred Breeders Australia (TBA) yesterday encouraged breeders sending mares interstate to consider their transport plans carefully and well ahead of schedule with the Covid-19 pandemic creating havoc with interstate travel as the breeding season fast approaches.

While TBA chief executive Tom Reilly confirmed that breeding has been deemed an "essential agricultural activity" by the federal government and all of their state counterparts - something that was also conveyed by Thoroughbred Breeders Victoria (TBV) executive officer Charmein Bukovec in a statement yesterday - he said that the application processes for each state need to be closely examined.

Anyone transporting horses between states will need an appropriate border permit for whichever border they are crossing, while each person travelling with a horse will require their own documentation and identification.

"The message from state governments has been very clear; that breeding is an essential activity and moving a mare between states to be covered is also an essential operational activity," Reilly said.

"But I would urge breeders, especially

if they are moving horses themselves rather than using a transport company, to look at the application process for the permit they will need to travel and return from interstate."

Restrictions for interstate travellers vary significantly. Victorians travelling into New South Wales will have

to maintain a logbook detailing all of their movements in Victoria, while they will also have to self-isolate for the time they are in New South Wales. Queensland has similar restrictions for all visitors, from whichever they state they are arriving.

Reilly also encouraged farm workers that will be crossing state boundaries to have a letter from their employer, detailing their work in undertaking an essential agricultural activity. The letter should be dated, with the contact details of their employer clearly marked.

"While border permits are essential, I believe that if farm staff also carry a letter stating that they are an employee, and that they are carrying out an essential agricultural activity, it may avoid delays or confusion at borders," he said.

"The situation with borders has obviously changed a number of times in recent weeks,



so I think having a letter can only help when travelling between jurisdictions."

TBV yesterday said that they would also issue a letter for Victorian farms in order to assist workers involved in the movement of mares, with intrastate checkpoints also in operation due to different levels of restrictions across the state.

"TBV are more than happy to write a letter explaining that your farm requires movement to get your mare covered. This is not a legal requirement but designed to give clarity to those at the checkpoints," Bukovec said in the statement.

"In addition, I have spoken with stallion farms and they have confirmed they are more than happy to confirm your booking in writing via email. This will enable you to print the email off, which you can also present at a checkpoint."

Dialogue between the TBA and the federal and state governments continues.





'The Incomparables': The remarkable story of Frank Wootton

rancis Leonard Wootton (1893 - 1940), from Australia and known as Frank, was champion jockey of England in 1909-10-11-12 - all before his 19th birthday.

He should have been champion five years straight ... but we'll get to that.

He arguably paved the way for the group which might be happily and appropriately dubbed The Incomparables, the Australian jockeys who dominated in England, Ireland and France well before and long after Bradman's Invincibles and were every bit as successful as the antipodean tennis champions of the 1950s to the early 1970s.

Frank and his high profile and arguably better known brother Stanley (1895 - 1986) were sons of Dick Wootton, a renowned trainer and punter on the pony tracks and proprietary courses in Sydney according to J. A. Ryan's biography of Frank Wootton at the Australian Dictionary of Biography.

Their great grandparents came to Australia as convicts. The father, it was said, was so intent on the boys becoming jockeys they were purportedly underfed as children.

Frank rode trackwork at the age of nine and was apparently thought by his father to be ready to race ride, but the Australian Jockey Club's minimum age for a registered jockey was 14. So, Dick moved his family and a team of horses to South Africa - where no such restriction applied - and Frank rode his first winner two months before his 10th birthday!

He and brother Stanley rode with great success in South Africa, as did fellow Australian Bill "Midge" McLachlan, great grandfather of the Freedman brothers of training prowess, who travelled with them as he was apprenticed to Wootton senior. Frank rode his first winner at

Turffontein in South Africa at the age of nine.

The Woottons briefly returned to Sydney in 1906, but within six months had moved again to England where Wootton senior was champion trainer in 1913.

Frank rode his first winner in England at 13. In 1909, just before his 16th birthday, he rode his first Classic winner and became the first Australian and youngest ever rider to top the English jockeys' premiership,

with a tally of 165 - a title he would claim for the next three years.

American Danny Maher was the champion jockey immediately before and immediately after Wootton. Anti-gambling sentiment and restrictions on racing led Maher, who died of tuberculosis at just 35, and other jockeys to leave America for Europe where they had quite

an impact on European racing. Apparently there was no love lost between Wootton and Maher.

The Jockey Club in 1910 suspended Wootton, described in newspapers at the time as "the famous Australian jockey", for a period of two months on a foul riding charge prosecuted chiefly at the instigation of Maher.


"The most interesting feature of the incident," it was reported, "perhaps, is that it is somewhat in the nature of a coincidence. Two seasons ago, in England, Frank Wootton was suspended for a month - also upon Danny Maher's instigation. The Australian's enforced idleness in the midst of the season thus cost him the jockey premiership of the old country ... and Maher was the winner of the title."

Thus, it seems it should have been five straight premierships for Wootton.

Why did these visiting riders do so well? Perhaps Wootton and Maher filled a void in the

ranks of top, local jockeys; most significantly in the absence of Steve Donoghue, who rode in France and Ireland from 1905 to 1911. Donoghue was champion in England ten years straight from 1914 before the dominant era of Sir Gordon Richards (and later, of course, Lester Piggott).

Australian jockey Bernard "Brownie" Carslake said this of Donoghue: "Stephen can find out more about what is left in his horse with his little finger than most men with their legs and whip."

But it would be unjust to underestimate the ability of Wootton and Maher. In 1999, the Racing Post ranked Maher as third on their list of the Top 50 jockeys of the 20th century while Wootton was described, again by the Racing Post, as "the most precocious talent ever seen on a British racecourse".

Wootton's career, like Maher's, was cut short. Increasing weight forced him to stop riding on the flat in 1913 when he was still only 19. He later rode over the jumps and was runner-up in the National Hunt title in 1921.

Known as the "Wonderboy" and renowned for his rails riding style and knowledge of his rivals, Wootton won many major races riding on a retainer for wealthy owners such as Sir Edward Hulton, newspaper proprietor and one-time chairman of Manchester City FC, and Lord Derby.

Wootton rode seven winners at the St Leger meeting at Doncaster in 1908; seven at Ascot week in 1912; ten at the Goodwood carnival in 1911 and rode eight consecutive winners during one week in August 1913.

Frank and Stanley served in World War I. Frank served in Palestine and Mesopotamia while his brother reached the rank of Lieutenant and, with the 17th Battalion, Royal Fusiliers, he was awarded the Military Cross for rescuing a fellow officer during the Battle of the Somme, France.

When his sons returned from the war, Dick returned to Sydney and established R. Wootton Pty Ltd. (hotel and picture theatre proprietors and property owners) and his holdings

included the famous racing pub, the Doncaster Hotel.

Frank Wootton still managed to keep his "eye in" during the War. "Occasionally race meetings were planned and the various divisions would send representatives. Frank Wooton [sic], the well-known jockey, was a dispatch-rider, and usually succeeded in getting leave enough to allow him to ride some general's horses." (From War in the Garden of Eden, by Kermit Roosevelt, Captain, Motor Machine-Gun Corps, British Expeditionary Forces).

Frank, having first won a jumping event while serving in Baghdad, began a new career as a National Hunt jockey and trainer after his

war service. He was celebrated for his dashing style and risk-taking over the jumps and his wins in that sphere included, in 1921, taking the Imperial Hunt Club Cup on Noce d'Argent, trained by his brother Stanley.

Back in Sydney from 1933, he suffered ill health, perhaps partly due to serious falls and to the exacting regime and weight wasting of his youth. On 6 April 1940 at Central Police Court, Sydney, he was convicted of drunkenness. Later that day he died in Long Bay gaol of traumatic

> epilepsy and was buried with Catholic rites in Botany cemetery.

> Stanley remained successful trainer of horses and jockeys, from his UK base at Epsom, until 1962.

> He made frequent visits to Australia and is best known, of course, for exporting Star Kingdom to Australia.

From the mid-1950s he was notable as a breeder and owner in New South Wales; he invested in stud properties and sent out selected horses including Star Kingdom, who stood at Baramul Stud, and produced a notable thoroughbred bloodline in Australia; his progeny included the stallions Todman, Biscay and Bletchingly, the Derby winners Sky High and Skyline and the first five winners of the Sydney Turf Club's Golden Slipper Stakes. In Sydney, Wootton's wins as an owner included the Golden Slipper with Todman in 1957 and the Australian Jockey Club's Epsom Handicap with Noholme in 1959.

Stanley Wootton died on 21 March 1986 at Epsom, England, and was buried in the cemetery there. His wife and their daughter Catherine Remond, a successful thoroughbred breeder in Australia, survived him.

The Wootton family's influence on Australia's breeding and racing industry was remarkable and, unsurprisingly, the family was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2002. I fancy there's a strong case that the brothers could well have been inducted individually.


