Kiwi Cassidy narrowly avoids coronavirus lockdown in Wuhan

Prominent Asian buyers expected at Inglis Classic Sale despite worsening outbreak

strong contingent of buyers from Hong Kong and mainland China are expected to attend the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale despite the outbreak of contravirus and the implementation of travel restrictions into Australia as a result of the potentially fatal condition.

In the wake of the viral emergency, predominantly in China, the federal government imposed a ban on people who have left or transited through mainland China from entering Australia.

Only Australian citizens, permanent residents and their families are exempt from the protocols that have been recommended by the country's chief medical officers in a bid to stop the spread of the virus.

More than 360 people were yesterday reported to have so far died after falling ill to coronavirus, surpassing the 349 killed during the SARS outbreak in the region in 2002 and 2003.

Cellsabeel draws barrier five


The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) was firmed into the TAB's \$1.45 favourite for Saturday's Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) at Warwick Farm having been handed barrier five at yesterday's draw. The promising juvenile, who was catapulted to the head of the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) market following her six-length romp on a heavy track at Rosehill last month, is set to be suited by the prevailing conditions with rain forecast towards the end of the week in Sydney. Cellsabeel will once again be partnered by Tommy Berry and she was one of 14 two-year-olds (plus four emergencies) to accept for the \$2 million Inglis Millennium, which was won last year by subsequent Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) runner-up Castelvecchio (Dundeel). Morning Briefing page 5 >> << Continued from page 1 Expatriate New Zealander Quinton Cassidy, who is employed by owner Tao Gu as his trainer in mainland China, was yesterday at Inglis' Riverside Stables in Sydney, inspecting yearlings ahead of Sunday's opening session of the three-day sale.</p>

Cassidy, who started his jockeys' apprenticeship with Graeme Rogerson and later Keith Hawtin, is overseeing a stable of horses in training based at Wuhan Jockey Club, about 35 kilometres from Wuhan city centre.

Yesterday the trainer revealed that he was "very lucky to get out in time", flying out of Wuhan just days before the city went into lockdown because of the outbreak.

Fellow Chinese owner, Yulong founder Yuesheng Zhang, whose global racing and breeding interests include both Australia and mainland China, has also escaped exposure to coronavirus after he remained in Australia after last month's Magic Millions sale on the Gold Coast.

He is expected to be at Caulfield on Saturday to witness promising juvenile Fresh (Fastnet Rock) in Saturday's Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 2, 1100m).

Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch believes the company can offset any potential loss of buyers who might be forced to skip the sale due to the virus. *Continued on page 4>>*

Chinese investors in the past and I expect him to continue to do so," Hutch said.

"To be perfectly honest, there is a mandate to grow the (ownership) participation base, not just domestically but internationally as well, and China is a country that has shown a good appetite for (Australian thoroughbreds)."

Meanwhile, Cassidy expects to be active at the Classic sale as Gu expands his thoroughbred interests in China as well as both Australia and New Zealand.

"We are building a nice quality team and we are gradually growing," Cassidy said.


"Not only are we acquiring horses for China, we are looking outside as well. Mr Gu will have horses in Australia and New Zealand and he will probably look at pinhooking a few.

"Mr Gu is going to be really involved in the industry and things are looking very promising for him."

With the assistance of Cassidy, Gu bought two horses at last October's Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs In Training Sale, including a \$200,000 son of Headwater (Exceed And Excel), as well as the three lots at the Inglis Ready 2 Race Sale soon after.

A colt by Pins (Snippets), purchased from the New Zealand Bloodstock Ready to Run Sale of 2YOs in November, has also been sent to the stable of David Vandyke in Queensland, while Gu also has two horses in training with Matt Cumani at Ballarat.

Blinkers for Encountabull

Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) runner-up Encountabull (Bull Point), who aside from Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) is the only other starter priced in single figures for the Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m), will be equipped with first-time blinkers when he lines up on Saturday. Trained by John Sargent, Encountabull is the TAB's \$7 second-favourite to build on his last-start second to Wild Ruler (Snitzel) and James

McDonald, who has been aboard the twoyear-old in both of his outings, recommended the fitting of the headgear following a recent barrier trial win at Randwick. "James said he just wanted to look around when he got to the front in his trial," Sargent said. "He had a jumpout in the blinkers last Friday and was fine so he will wear them."

Inglis Sprint return for Xilong

Also at Warwick Farm, co-trainer Tony McEvoy has sounded a note of caution ahead of Xilong's (Deep Field) return in the Inglis Sprint (1200m), suggesting the three-year-old could be unsuited if conditions become attritional. A four-time winner who landed the Twilight Glow Stakes (Listed, 1400m) on her last outing at Sandown-Hillside in November, Xilong has drawn barrier five under Kerrin McEvoy. "I'm not totally comfortable with the forecast," McEvoy, who trains in partnership with his son Calvin, said. "It looks like it's going to be heavy. Her mum was OK on heavy and she has trialled OK on a heavy track but really I don't know. But she's going very well.

She won a trial last week at Gawler and she seems in really good order." Looking ahead, McEvoy added: "I think she has got stronger and bigger and better, which she will need to be because she's going to be going up to higher heights again. After this run she'll go towards the Surround Stakes and then probably the Coolmore Classic."

Two for Waller in Orr

Chris Waller's two C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1. 1400m) contenders Kings WIll Dream (Casamento) and Night's Watch (Redwood) are on track for Saturday's Caulfield race after preparing for their summer-autumn campaigns in Sydney. "They've both arrived into the Flemington stable safely," Waller said. "They've had a couple of trials each and seem to be quite forward in condition. Night's Watch is an exciting horse and I don't think we've quite seen the best of him. He's got a great finish. And Kings Will Dream got back to Group 1-winning form last preparation. He's probably not quite as sharp as he used to be over the 1400-metre trip but it's certainly a good starting point."



Hey Doc out to break Caulfield drought

In other Orr Stakes news, Hey Doc (Duporth) will return to 1400 metres for the first time since running second over track and distance in the 2017 renewal of the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). The three-time Group 1 winner, who was runner-up behind Scales Of Justice (Not A Single Doubt) on his return in the Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Moonee Valley last month, has yet to win in five outings at Caulfield. "Caulfield can do that to horses, for sure, but there's not one of those races we walked away from and blamed the track," co-trainer Tony McEvoy said. "We just thought there were other circumstances. He was huge in the Guineas (third in 2016) from his wide barrier. So I think he goes at the track, but yes, he hasn't been able to win there." Reflecting on the return to 1400 metres, McEvoy added: "He's not a miler but he was very good at 1400 metres. His win in the (2017) C S Hayes Stakes was pretty impressive and very dominant. I think he'll be fine at 1400 and I am looking forward to seeing him out to that distance again."

Oliver to ride Frondeur

Champion jockey Damien Oliver will replace Zac Spain on Frondeur (Roc de Cambes) in Saturday's Kevin Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield and co-trainer Mick Price is hopeful the unbeaten three-year-old can make the transition to Pattern company. Spain rode Frondeur to a comfortable victory at Pakenham in a Benchmark 64 last start, while Dean Holland partnered her to a three and a half-length success on debut at Moe. "Zac makes way for D. Oliver, but anyway, Zac is one of our jockeys and we put him on some nice horses...I feel guilty there, don't I?" Price told Racing.

com yesterday. "She's got a little black-type factor about her, I reckon, just working her. She worked on the course proper (at Caulfield) this morning, Ollie rode her. She's a good Kiwi filly that I think is black type. We gave her one run on a heavy track, tipped her out, she had enough and then one run the other day and she was very good."

Futurity next for Kolding

Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and Golden Eagle (1500m) winner Kolding (Ocean Park) is sitting pretty among the top ten in voting for the \$5 million All-Star Mile (1600m) and trainer Chris Waller hopes he can pick up another Group 1 win on the way to the rich race. Kolding, who resumed from a spell with a closing fourth in the Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in Sydney on Saturday, is currently fourth in the poll for the All-Star Mile on March 14 and Waller intends to give the horse his next start in the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on February 22. "I was very happy with the (Expressway) run," Waller told RSN927. "Obviously 1200 metres is just a bit short for him and we went back from his wide barrier. I actually haven't seen the sectional times but to my eye they looked pretty good. He's come through the race well and his next run will be at Caulfield just to give him the experience of running around there, which will be in the Futurity in two-anda-half weeks' time. And then three weeks to the All-Star Mile."

Newmarket an option for Nature Strip

Chris Waller has locked in both the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington on February 15 and the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Randwick on April 4 for Nature Strip (Nicconi) this preparation, but the champion trainer remains open minded about where he will run the five-year-old between those assignments. The two options appear to be the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) at Randwick on March 7 or the same day's Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington, and while the former would be a first run beyond 1200 metres for the star sprinter, he is set to be burdened with at least 58 kilograms in the Newmarket - the same weight Black Caviar

(Bel Esprit) carried to victory in 2011 and half a kilogram less than Hay List (Statue Of Liberty) lumped in 2012. Speaking to RSN, Waller said he would 'see how things pan out' after the Lightning regarding a possible Newmarket bid. "I'll speak to the owners. I don't want to overtax him but he will have three runs this preparation, ending with the T J Smith," Waller said. "I wouldn't discount a race like the Canterbury Stakes over 1300 metres if he didn't go to the Newmarket."

Shared Ambition doubtful for Australian Cup

Irish import Shared Ambition (Born To Sea), who is prominent in the market for next month's Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m), is unlikely to line-up in the Flemington Group 1. "I just think timing won't be on his side and (he's) not really a weight-for-age horse just yet," trainer Chirs Waller said on RSN927. "Australian Cup horses have got to be up and running probably a week earlier at least and I think it just comes up too quick." Shared Ambition, who maintained his unbeaten record in Australia when winning over 2800 metres at Flemington in November, is set to resume in the Gardenia Handicap (1600m) at Warwick Farm on Saturday. "He has had two trials and an exhibition gallop. He looks very exciting," Waller added. "Realistically I'd say he's going to have a good autumn and we will know a lot more after the autumn."

Autumn Classic return for Miami Bound

Danny O'Brien has mapped out a four-start campaign for impressive VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Miami Bound (Reliable Man). "We are hoping to have her at Caulfield on Blue Diamond Day in the Autumn Classic," O'Brien said. "We'll kick-off there and maybe run one more time in Melbourne before she heads up to Sydney for the Vinery and then the Oaks." The Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) is run on February 22, while the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) is held at Rosehill on March 28 and the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on April 11. Miami Bound has won four of her seven starts having also landed the Wakeful Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) prior to her VRC Oaks success.

Smith offers Bart All-Star incentive

Lindsey Smith will give ten per cent of Black Heart Bart's (Blackfriars) All-Star Mile (1600m) prize-money to a randomly selected voter provided the nine-year-old makes next month's \$5 million contest at Caulfield, "Black Heart Bart is struggling for votes, which surprised me, so I thought we'd give him a bit of a kick along to get in," Smith told Racing.com. "In my wisdom, I thought as most people know I own 50 per cent of him, so if I threw five per cent out there for somebody who votes for him and we can sort of draw the winner out of a hat and they can race him with me for the day." Racing.com host Matthew Stewart was able to twist the arm of Smith harder with the promised percentage increasing to ten per cent. Black Heart Bart, who won last year's Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) prior to finishing second in the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), was sat in 18th spot on the All-Star Mile voting leaderboard as of yesterday afternoon.

Vow And Declare second at Cranbourne

Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War) continued his preparation for an autumn campaign when running a five-length second to Shepard (Sea The Moon) in an 1190-metre barrier trial at Cranbourne yesterday morning. The four-year-old, who is reported to weigh 50 kilograms more than he did when winning at Flemington in November, pleased jockey Craig Williams on his first official outing since those spring heroics. "It was only a field of four so he either ran second or third last," Williams told Racing. com. "He's not a flash worker but his action was good and his recovery was amazing as always.

He had a tendency of leaning a little bit left, which is just normal to how he's going, and I just loved the way he's building up. He looks a lot fuller and mentally he's more mature, which is great."

Jameka's brother third in trial

Co-trainer Ciaron Maher has high hopes for the younger brother of Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jameka (Myboycharlie) who has made his first public appearance in a Cranbourne trial. Two-year-old Grandslam, ridden by Mark Zahra, finished third in yesterday's 800-metre trial giving Maher confidence for the future. "I've always thought he was the colt version of her, same attitude, same action," Maher said. "She was quite unique in her action and the way she moved. She covered the ground with relative ease and I was pleased that Mark said he gave him a similar feel." Maher indicated he would be in no rush with Grandslam saying the colt may turn out to be a Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) contender in the spring. "He's had a jump-out at home and we brought him here today. It's a bit like race-day conditions and I said to Mark to ride him like that, get him out of the barriers, get him to travel and give him a good squeeze late," he added.

Stevie passes trial test

The Michelle Payne-trained Stevie (Pride Of Dubai), a two-year-old named in honour of the Melbourne Cup-winning jockey's brother, who shot to stardom as strapper of 2015 Cup hero Prince Of Penzance (Pentire), pleased his trainer when running fourth over 800 metres in his first official trial at Cranbourne yesterday morning. The unraced juvenile had previously undergone two quiet jumpouts at Ballarat and Payne said: "He's one of the favourites around the stable, hence the name. I brought him here for experience, but he jumped and put himself on the speed and trialled really nicely. Hopefully we can have a bit of fun with him."

Two SA trainers granted stay of proceedings

South Australian trainers Craig Curtis and

Len Jarvis can continue to train under a stay of proceedings as they appeal lengthy bans handed to them. Curtis was given two nine-month disqualifications, to be served concurrently, after being found guilty of two charges that relate to failing to give proper care to an unnamed filly. Jarvis was also handed a 12-month disqualification after traces of cobalt were found in Beautiful Flyer (Solo Flyer) following her win at Morphettville on June 22. Beautiful Flyer returned a level of 173 micrograms per litre, above the threshold of 100 micrograms per litre. Stewards noted this was a fourth offence for Jarvis under the presentation rule AR240(2) when determining a 12-month suspension. Stewards considered outing Curtis for the full 18 months due to the seriousness of his charges. However, they accounted for a variety of factors, including his genuine remorse, cooperation during the inquiry, long-standing involvement in the industry and clean record when imposing the suspension.

NEW ZEALAND

Luvaluva travels well

Koby Jennings will attempt to maintain his perfect strike-rate on the John Sargenttrained Luvaluva (Mastercraftsman) in the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. Jennings has ridden the five-year-old mare in her last two starts, winning both the Summer Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick on Boxing Day and then the January Cup (Listed, 2000m) over the same course and distance. "She is going really well," he said. "Her first start she was in control of the race from a very long way out and she was never going to be beaten. It was a pretty similar scenario the start after. There were a bit of tactics going on in that race and she had to carry a bit of weight, but she was still too good." Luvaluva arrived in New Zealand last weekend ahead of her Te Rapa assignment and Jennings said reports from the stable have been positive. "I have been talking with John's foreman (Campbell Ashby) who is over with her now," he said. "He is very confident with her and said she has come over great, is doing well and feeling fresh."

Five in Derby mix for Campbell

Cambridge trainer Andrew Campbell will be looking for some clarity on his running plans in next month's New Zealand Deby (Gr 1, 2400m) when he sends a trio of runners to contest the Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. Vladivostok (Tavistock), Pimlico (Proisir) and Peloton (Charm Spirit) are all set to line up at the weekend with the three among five Derby possibles in Campbell's care. The trainer said he is particularly looking forward to Peloton competing against his own age group. "He has been in great form. We have been mixing his races up, 2000 metres and back to a mile, just to keep his brain on the job," Campbell said. It is, however, stablemate Tibetan (Shocking), who is set to contest the Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2100m) at Ellerslie on Saturday-week, that Campbell rates as his best Derby hope at present. "We are more than happy with him and his main aim has always been the Derby," he continued. "I think he is a seriously good horse. At this stage, for the Derby, he is the one I really like. On his pedigree he should see the distance out."

Stakes goal for The Precious One

Connections of regally-bred mare The Precious One (Darci Brahma) are on the hunt for an elusive Group victory before they retire her to the broodmare paddock. The daughter of Darci Brahma (Danehill) and dual Group 1 winner The Jewel (O'Reilly) won the Hazlett Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Wingatui on Boxing Day, and trainer Claire Anderton now has her sights set on the South Island Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Riccarton next month. "Looking at her from the owners point of view and going forward to being a broodmare, we are really looking at some more black-type," she said. "There is a Group 3 fillies and mares mile

on March 21, so we are just trying to plot a plan to get her to that. She is improving all the time at the moment. Her racing manners seem to be improving, she is relaxing and she seems to be finding the line a bit better."

ASIA

Syndicator links with Singapore's Gray

Singapore-based New Zealander Stephen Gray has become the latest trainer to have horses in his care owned by Perth syndicator Peter Morley of Belhus Racing Stables.

Having recently visited Gray's training operation in Singapore, Morley decided to extend his racing operation to the Asian racing jurisdiction. "We visited Singapore recently and bumped into Stephen. After having a look around we decided that Stephen was exactly the sort of trainer we wanted to be associated with," Morley said. "With Perth being on the same time-zone as Singapore and only four hours away it made perfect sense to expand our reach and provide our clients with further opportunities to race for good prizemoney." The pair subsequently purchased Lot 972 at last week's Book 2 session of the NZB National Yearling Sale at Karaka. They went to NZ\$70,000 to secure the Tavistock (Montjeu) colt, who is out of Group 1 performer Abidewithme (Redoute's Choice), from Kiltannon Stables. Morley said the latest acquisition will remain in New Zealand and trial before heading to Singapore.

Milestones beckon in Hong Kong

Milestones are in sight at Happy Valley tonight with trainer John Moore one away from his 1700th Hong Kong win and jockey Vincent Ho one short of his 300th Hong Kong win.

The seven-time champion trainer has three entries on the eight-race card, G Unit (Danerich), Earth Trilogy (Animal Kingdom) and Magic Supreme (Zoustar). The other milestone man, Ho, has a full book of eight rides in his bid to land his 300th Hong Kong win.

INTERNATIONAL

Firebreak dies at 21

Group 1-winning miler Firebreak (Charnwood Forest) died on Monday aged 21 following a deterioration in his health. He had been living out his retirement at Bearstone Stud, where he had served since he finished racing. Firebreak, who won the Mill Reef Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) and Prix de Cabourg (Gr 3, 6f) as a two-year-old, was sold to Godolphin and under the care of Saeed bin Suroor won the Godolphin Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) in 2003 and 2004 before finishing his career by winning the Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) as a five-year-old. Although he never covered large books of mares during his time at stud, he sired four stakes winners, the best of which was Hearts Of Fire, who took the Gran Criterium (Gr 1, 1600m) in Italy as a juvenile.

New starting gates at Churchill Downs

A new custom-made, 20-stall starting gate - which is manufactured in Australia - will be in place for this year's Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) at Churchill Downs to ensure a uniform start for the largest field in American horse racing. The gate, which is being designed and constructed by Australianbased Steriline Racing, will eliminate the wide gap between barrier 14 in the standard gate and barrier 15 in the auxiliary gate of six stalls. "We believe that a new custom-made, 20-stall starting gate will deliver a clean start for all horses and enhance safety for horses and riders in the Kentucky Derby," Mike Ziegler, executive director of racing for Churchill Downs, said. The new gate, which is due to arrive in early April, will be utilised exclusively for the Kentucky Derby in May, while the standard starting gate will continue to be used for all other races.

recent study has linked the increase in road rage incidents with the surge in inane, cringeworthy radio advertisements promoting the TAB.

Live ad reads from otherwise sensible and generally conservative broadcasters have also been identified as part of the problem.

So pernicious is the trend that the study has concluded they present a bigger threat than the fatuous, and sometimes offensive, offerings from our corporate bookmaking friends (well, acquaintances at best).

This, of course, is not the case but I'd hardly be surprised if it were true. At the very least, these auditory assaults have driven me to distraction and despair...and very nearly off the road as I was bombarded three times in the space of three minutes the other day.

First, one of those grating ramblings from the TAB bobbed up. I can't remember if it was the one about sharing a bowl of chips - you know the one which effectively says you're never going to buy a racehorse - which comes across as odd to say the least in a racing-betting ad.

Or it could have been something about ordering from a Chinese restaurant menu

or not liking surprises or overcoming "Mondayitis" and "hump day" via the unbridled anticipation of Saturday's nominations and final fields being released. Each is as nonsensical, galling, poorly written and downright off-putting as the other.

I don't want to be one of those kinds of people.

Now, don't get me wrong, I love Tabcorp. Everyone should bet with the TAB if, for no other reason than to protect the financial future of the industry (and I'm, casually, indirectly employed by them - well at least I was up until now).

But those silly ads have got to go.

Then it was either Gerard Whateley or Anthony Hudson warbling on about a woman watering her pot plants with her Nylex hose, shortly before they crossed to their "friends" at Bet365 for a cricket preview. No, boys - they are your sponsors and they provide nothing more than odds.

Broadcasters have, of course, done this since Marconi launched the first transatlantic radio signal in 1901.

I can still hear Bill Collins, he of race broadcasting not movie review fame (although there was one notorious case of mistaken identity) advertising Wee Willem cigars... Cos he smoked. I just can't picture Whateley or Hudson installing their automated sprinkler systems.

Worse still, we've had Whateley's ads for McDonald's coffee. In fairness, they were well scripted and exceptionally delivered by the Bruce McAvaney heir but I'll bet Gerard would

be a decaf, soy latte kind of guy - which just ain't coffee, is it? And I'd rather he be my authority on all matters sport than selling his soul to Ronald.

Then we endure the cross to Bet365, apparently 'the world's favourite on-line sports betting company' - not mine, but certainly that of co-founder Denise Coates, who reportedly paid herself a lazy \$617 million last year (2000 times more than Briain's PM Boris Johnson). She's Britain's best paid (joint) chief executive and apparently the highest-paid woman in the world.

The English-owned Bet365 is apparently Australia's second-most popular bookmaker, behind the Irish-owned Sportsbet. Ahead of the TAB. That's a worry, my friends, given their relative contributions to the industry are all the more reason why the TAB needs to work a little harder on their advertising copy and promotions. Perhaps a cut in take-out rates from exotic pools would be a good starting point.

Then we hear from David Davutovic representing Bet365 on the radio. I could have sworn he was the football writer from the Herald Sun. I like my (round) football.

Now that's disconcerting, and damns more the media than corporate bookmakers, that he joins a long list of ex-journos who have seen careers with betting organisations as more rewarding (presumably financial) than their high-profile media roles.

Yes, first world problems and perhaps I'm taking this (and myself) a little too seriously.

So, let's go back to the story of William Henry Collins (1928 - 1997) who remains

Australia's greatest race-caller and arguably the most talented person to appear on the electronic media in this country - from singing, dancing and hosting to sports broadcasting.

Did you know, in the first year of the Logies (1959), he won the outstanding performance award for his appearances on Sunnyside Up, HSV-7?

But back to that case of mistaken identity. It was 1993, and 3AW's Ross and Dean were on holiday and were replaced on breakfast by Greg Evans and Sam Newman.

With the Academy Award having been announced, they asked their producer to call Bill Collins.

"Now we have on the line the one and only Bill Collins," Evans announced. Not quite the one and only as it turned out.

"Well a very good morning to you too," was racing Bill's deadpan reply as he happily let them hang themselves for about 90 seconds before Newman twigged.

"I've got a question about the Oscars, Bill. Did you agree with the best picture award for the Unforgiven," Newman said.

"I don't know, I've never seen the Unforgiven," Collins replied.

"That surprises me," said Newman before he and Evans began laughing heartily as Newman then announced: "We are talking to Bill Collins, the greatest race-caller of all time, in the history of the world and all other places."

Collins didn't then add much to the 'television tonight' segment as he declared he'd only be watching the News and Dad's Army and that "the rest of it is pretty much rubbish as far as I'm concerned".


