### Westbury's big day with trans-Tasman

### celebrations

First top-flight winner for Redwood, Telperion remains flawless as half-brother Kementari breaks 1,001-day drought

reeding is notoriously a long-term game with a day of success, where everything goes right, potentially influenced by decisions made weeks, months, years, even decades before.

For Gerry Harvey's Westbury Stud, vesterday was one of those days where all the stars aligned as the New Zealand farm's stallions - both past and present - had a redletter afternoon on both sides of the Tasman.

First-season sire Telperion (Street Cry)

maintained his perfect record as a stallion when his sole starter to date, Stormy (2 c Telperion -Silent Night by Swiss Ace), took out the Wakefield Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Trentham. It was also a celebratory moment for another of their stallions, Swiss Ace (Secret Savings), who brought up his first stakes victory as a broodmare sire.

Less than two hours later, Westbury Stud was celebrating again as Rock On Wood (6 g Redwood - Rock On Rye by Catcher On The Rye) took out the Captain Cook Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), giving longterm resident Redwood (High Chaparral) his first top-flight winner. Continued on page 2>>

<< Continued from page 1 Later in the day, former Westbury shuttler Makfi (Dubawi) was represented by Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m) victor Attorney (6 g Makfi - Tia Kia by Montjeu), although the French import was conceived in Europe.

And while it could have been the perfect day if Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) favourite Inspirational Girl had gone one better in the Perth feature for Westbury Stud's leading light Reliable Man (Dalakhani), it was not to be as she rattled home into second behind her stablemate Truly Great (Dundeel).

While it was Westbury Stud that was leading the charge yesterday, general manager Russell Warwick acknowledges that it has been a strong few months for the New Zealand breeding industry across the board.

"Gerry rang from Australia early today and said, 'You've had a good day,' but there are so many well wishers on days like this," Warwick told ANZ Bloodstock News. "You get so many texts and calls to say well done, but it's a team effort. It's about the staff, the shareholders and broodmare owners that support these stallions. Without them we'd never get these stallions off the ground.

"So we're very fortunate that Gerry has got a big broodmare population in New Zealand which supports our stallions and gives them an enormous start to begin with, but then the shareholders and the breeding fraternity that support these stallions are what gets them to the next level.

"I think New Zealand is really starting to add that level of strength to their stallions over the last few seasons. There are a lot of New Zealand-based stallions among the top 20-odd sires in Australia and New Zealand, the likes of Ocean Park, Tavistock, who has unfortunately deceased now, Zed and Reliable Man. We've got a lot of stallions that are doing very well and when you look at what they stand for, they're enormous value in the market."

### Telperion in the spotlight after Stormy success

First season stallions are always one of the great unknowns each season as juveniles demonstrate their sire's potential as a future breedshaper. For Westbury Stud, they are in the rare position - at least with a roster of their size - of having two stallions with their first two-year-olds this term.

Telperion, a standout juvenile himself, has been first off the blocks, with Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Tarzino (Tavistock) as expected, yet to have a runner.

Bred and raced by Godolphin, Telperion was one of the two-yearolds of his generation. He defeated Group 1 winners Prized Icon (More Than Ready) and Spright (Hinchinbrook) to win the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1100m) before finishing fourth to Capitalist (Written Tycoon) in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and second to Yankee Rose (All American) in the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

At the time he was acquired by Westbury Stud, his year-younger half-brother Kementari (Lonhro) had just won the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) - more on him later - while his pedigree, by Winx's sire Street Cry (Machiavellian) from a family that descends from the mighty Denise's Joy (Seventh Hussar), also made him an attractive stallion prospect.

"He was an exceptionally well-bred horse and we felt he was a horse

that could definitely make a stallion, but obviously starting at the lower end of the service fee range," Warwick said. "It's a huge bonus with his first runner to be not a winner but a Group 2 winner. It really sets him up to go forward from here and you couldn't have wished for a better start than what he's had. We really look forward to where he's going in the future.

"I guess when you look at his form it wouldn't surprise you at all to see him producing two-year-olds. He ran a fast-finishing fourth in the Golden Slipper and ran second in a Sires' Produce, albeit as an autumn two-year-old. He was always a very sharp horse but physically he's a big, strong horse and whatever they do they're going to be better as they get older I think. He had enough mares to suggest he was going to get two-year-olds."

Trained by Tony Pike, Stormy produced a tough effort to win at Awapuni at his first start in October, giving Telperion his first winner with his first runner. With that run under his belt, the flashy chestnut was sent to yesterday's Wakefield Challenge Stakes at Trentham, a race that Pike won last year with Not An Option (Not A Single Doubt).

Ridden to lead by Lisa Allpress, the \$1.50 favourite kept on finding down the long Trentham straight, even as it appeared he was about to be swamped. Fonsalette (Belardo) was strongest of the challengers, getting within a half-length, but Stormy was simply too tough, once again showing a tenacity that had been on display at Awapuni.

Promisingly, the pair came almost five lengths clear of third-placed debutant Taoiseach (Highly Recommended).

"He got a bit lost out in front and got on the wrong leg going over the crossing but he has got the job done," Pike said. "He's probably a better chaser than a leader but he has done it nicely in the end.

"He is a homebred horse and not a Karaka Million contender so we will give him a little break now and then bring him back for one run before we go into the Sires' races."

Those races are the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ellerslie on March 13 and the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Awapuni on April 3

Bred and raced by Queenslanders Geoff and Heather Nicholls, Stormy - who, like his sire, features Denise's Joy as his sixth dam - is the first foal out of the unraced Silent Night (Swiss Ace), a mare who was offered by Westbury Stud and passed in. Stormy gave Swiss Ace a first black-type victory as a damsire.

"It's not so much regret because we're thrilled for the owners, but every year we look to sell a few mares and Silent Night, the mother of Stormy, we actually put up for auction and she was passed in there," Warwick said. "She was then bought for a very low amount, I think only \$700 for the mare in foal to Telperion. That foal was Stormy.

"Unfortunately for them the mare died the following year, so it's been a bit of a good luck bad luck story for the Nicholls who own and race Stormy, but they've got a Group 2 winner and he's still a colt so who knows where that might lead them."

Stormy's success comes at a critical time as sales season approaches, with two Telperion yearlings consigned by Westbury Stud in Book 1 of next month's Karaka Premier Yearling Sale and 11 by the sire, seven offered by Westbury Stud, in the auction's Book 2.

"I think we've got some really nice horses in the second group and, walking through them, probably the best group of foals on the ground at the moment," Warwick said. "We're really, really excited with the foals we've got. The two horses he has got in the Book 1 session at Karaka, one is out of Group 2-winning mare Chinchilla Rose and he's a very powerful sprinting-type colt and the other is a half-brother to stakes winner Red Striker, and a very promising three-year-old filly called Mega Bourbon.

"Both of those colts will measure up and be well-received, especially now he's got a Group 2 winner on the board."

As for Tarzino, "They're totally different," Warwick concurred. "It's probably a rare feat for us to stand two new stallions in the one season, something we wouldn't normally do. We already bought Tarzino when Godolphin approached us to see if we'd be interested in Telperion and we looked at his pedigree and his race performance and we thought, 'well, they'll probably be quite diverse'. One is a sprinter-miler type horse at the lower end of the market and the other is a staying Derby-type horse, so we felt we might get away with it and we duly did.

"In his first year, Tarzino had 124 mares and Telperion had 118 so both horses were extremely well-received in their first season."  $\label{eq:telperion}$ 

Telperion stood for NZ\$5,000 (plus GST) in 2020, with Tarzino at NZ\$12,000 (plus GST).

### Family affair for Elliots as Wood joins sire as Group 1 winner

Rock On Wood's win in the Captain Cook Stakes represented a number of firsts.

It was a first Group 1 win for the honest six-year-old, a first Group victory - let alone a first Group 1 - for trainer Leanne Elliot, a maiden top-level success for her son, rider Ryan, and a breakthrough triumph as a stallion for Westbury Stud's Redwood.

Narrowly sent out as the third favourite, just behind top two market fancies Concert Hall (Savabeel) and Hypnos (Reliable Man), Rock On Wood was given a patient, cool-headed ride by Ryan Elliot. The 21-year-old took the gelding back in the field in the three-wide line before taking off early.

While known for his dislike of soft tracks, Rock On Wood sprinted sharply and sustained his run to hit the front halfway down the Trentham straight. Concert Hall made one final bid but Rock On Wood had enough in hand to score by a length. Deerfield held down third.

For Leanne Elliot, who is also a part-owner with her mother Jill Ker and her sister Yvonne, it was an emotional moment for the family to share.

"It's just blimmin awesome," she said. "I was worried about the sticky track but he went so good. He did it tough as he was out three wide and I was thinking 'oh no,' but he was just awesome.

"It's Ryan's first Group 1 as well so that just makes it even better."

Added the younger Elliot: "He's put in a big effort and done it well. He jumped well and when they pushed up inside him, I thought I'd just stay where I was as there wasn't any point in going back with him.

"I got a bit of a windbreak from (Times Ticking) on the corner which helped me out and then he sprinted really well in that ground. He was floating around a little bit but that is what he does on a slow track as he needs better ground.

"It is so special to win this for mum as my first winner was on one of hers, so for mum to get such a good horse and for me to win a Group 1 on, it is just awesome."

For Warwick, it was simply a matter of time for Westbury stalwart Redwood, whose Group 1 placegetters have included Night's Watch, Platinum Invador and Rising Red, as well as Rock On Wood twice earlier this year.

"I think he's had four Group 1 placegetters before today," he said. "He's had two Derby placegetters, a placegetter in the Toorak and Rock On Wood last season was extremely unlucky not to win the Thorndon and the Herbie Dyke, which are both Group 1s. Many of the forecasters and presenters on television have put the tag on Rock On Wood as a Group 1 winner in waiting and I think today he got his due rewards.

"He's a lightly raced horse and has been well-handled, so hopefully there's many more in store for him. Some Group 1 races in the summer should very much be to his liking as he does prefer a firmer track rather than the ground he met today."

Redwood's biggest moment in his eight years as a stallion could come next weekend in a race he contested twice, the Hong Kong Vase (Gr 1, 2400m). It was a race in which he finished second a decade ago and his son Columbus County will aim to go one better, with the Caspar Fownes-trained five-year-old one of seven runners in the Sha Tin feature. *Continued on page 4>>* 

<< Continued from page 3 "That would be sensational," Warwick said. "It's great to get the Group 1 off our back today but it would be amazing to do it at the Hong Kong meeting that's got the focus of the world on it and Redwood coincidentally ran second in the Vase himself, so for his son to go one better would be an enormous feat and he's obviously got some chance.

"Joao Moreira won the race last year and has elected to ride the horse, and he's come of age this season. Caspar Fownes seems to have got him reacclimatised up there now. It's not going to be an easy task when you're meeting horses from all around the world, but it would be great for Redwood if he was able to achieve that success."

Redwood stood for NZ\$8,000 (plus GST) in 2020.

Also striking success was former Westbury shuttler Makfi, with the French-bred Attorney taking out the Pakenham Cup.

Ridden by Sydney-based Nash Rawiller for Warwick Farm trainer Matthew Smith, Attorney justified favouritism by producing a narrow but dominant success over Creedence (Helmet), with a further short halfhead to Knights Order (So You Think) in third.

Rawiller, who is originally from Victoria, is in the state to visit friends and family including his son, star apprentice Campbell, before returning to NSW in the new year.

"I've had good support all week and that's the first winner I rode," Rawiller told Racing.com. "But it's good to be back and catch up with old friends and acquaintances that I've ridden for over the years and they've been kind enough to give me a nice ride.

"I think he's a really good stayer, he just proved that. It was a bit of a slog but he really shone through when it counted. I think he'll be placed to his advantage in the autumn where he could almost win a Sydney Cup or something like that. He's a nice horse."

Reflecting on the success of Makfi in Australia and New Zealand, Warwick said: "We spend a lot of time studying our pedigrees and obviously you've got to have the horse with the performance and ability to throw his genes onto the broodmare pool, but we felt he was very much aligned with the broodmare pool in New Zealand. If you look back now, I think his southern hemisphere progeny sits at around seven, seven and a half per cent stakes winners to runners, which is a very impressive figure.

"He's had the dual New Zealand Horse of the Year in Bonneval, he's had two Oaks winners with Bonneval and Sofia Rosa, he's had a Group-winning two-year-old with Marky Mark, so he's just been a phenomenal success down here. Probably one of the things about Makfi is, because he's been such a good stallion, I'm excited to see what his broodmares are going to do down here too. We won't have heard the last of Makfi now his daughters are going to stud."

#### 'Truly Great' Peters dominates Kingston Town Classic

The only thing that would have made Westbury Stud's day even better would have been a victory for Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Inspirational Girl (Reliable Man) in the Kingston Town Classic at Ascot, but it was not to be.

Instead, the string of ones next to her name was broken as she flashed home from another postcode to finish second, two lengths astern of her

stablemate Truly Great (5 g Dundeel - Truly Special by Jeune), in the final Australian Group 1 of 2020.

It was a sixth win, and a second quinella, in the race for leviathan owner-breeder Bob Peters, whose famed cerise and white silks have been carried to victory by Old Nick (Old Spice), Old Comrade (Old Spice) twice, Perfect Reflection (More Than Ready) - who led home Peters' Delicacy (Al Maher) in 2015 - and Arcadia Queen (Pierro).

Three-year-old Dom To Shoot (Shooting To Win) finished third, a length behind the runner-up.

The middle of the race shaped the eventual finish; Truly Great, ridden by Chris Parnham, was three wide with cover behind Taxagano (Rogano) and was perfectly poised to strike as veteran Gailo Chop (Deportivo), guided with aplomb by Brad Rawiller, steadied the field approaching the 1000 metres.

Meanwhile, the Willie Pike-partnered Inspirational Girl, who jumped from the inside gate, was back second-last between horses and in a difficult position, with runners coming back into her face, as the field started the swing towards home.

Steering a similar line to the one he took on Kementari a mere 40 minutes prior, Parnham sent Truly Great after a valiant Gailo Chop and his initial challenger Too Close The Sun (Carlton House). While that pair battled on gamely, finishing fifth and fourth respectively, Truly Great was bounding away, while Inspirational Girl was out and charging home when it was all too late.

"He got a good run and she got way back - that's all it boiled down to," Peters told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "When he hit the front, I saw they weren't going to run him down. I've said all along, that year he was our best foal, and I've had to wait a long time for him. A lot of things went wrong, but I've always believed in him.

"He's just had problems, silly little things that seem to happen with every foal in this family. I've always said he's one of the best types of any horse I've ever bred, this fellow. Stand back and have a look at him, he's magnificent."

Truly Great is the fifth Group 1 winner for Arrowfield Stud's Dundeel (High Chaparral), while he is also a half-brother to Western Australian Oaks (Gr 3, 2400m) heroine Special Alert (Not A Single Doubt).

Dam Truly Special (Jeune) has visited Dundeel every year since, producing four-year-old gelding Truly Inspired, three-year-old gelding Special Deal and two-year-old filly Truly Blessed. She also produced another filly this year, having missed to the Arrowfield stallion last year.

<< Continued from page 4 Second dam Reigning Belle (Military Plume) won the Morphettville Guineas (Listed, 1600m), while she produced a game stayer in the stakes-placed Jeune's Reign (Jeune).</p>

With that pedigree, the Perth Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) always appeared his logical target, but Peters said that the Kingston Town Classic win is likely to see him routed away from the January 2 feature, instead going to the Ted Van Heemst Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at weight-for-age on December 19.

"I think the team were a bit surprised when we told them we were heading this way and the Railway. It's worked out for us," he said. "I don't think he will go to the Perth Cup though, he will get too much weight. Maybe he can go to the Van Heemst next."

Truly Great took his record to seven wins from 12 starts, with his earnings now at \$872,575, while Dundeel stood for \$66,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

### Thousand-day drought ends in style for Kementari

Literature fans would be well aware that Kementari is one of the forms taken by Yavanna, Queen of the Earth, who inhabits Tolkien's Middle Earth made so popular by The Lord Of The Rings.

Little did they know that, with her gelded equine namesake, they should instead have been looking to a different time period and a different fiction genre completely. The more accurate pointer: One Thousand and One Nights, also known as Arabian Nights.

Why? Because it was 1,001 nights between wins for Kementari, who - like Scheherazade before him - was trusted time and time again before his ultimate breakthrough in the A J Scahill Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Ascot yesterday, giving Parnham a remarkable race-to-race double and rewarding Godolphin with their first victory in Western Australia.

Those 1,001 days since the 2018 Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) have featured a story fitting of a literary classic: six times on the board in Group 1 races but unable to break through for another win; shipped to stud but proving practically infertile, leaving only two mares in foal; gelded and set for another equine discipline before making a return to the races earlier this year; racing consistently but looking as though a final hurrah may be beyond him; and then, given one final chance to record the ultimate comeback.

Like all good three-act plotlines, though, Kementari (6 g Lonhro - Yavanna by Redoute's Choice) recorded the perfect resolution to his complex and frustrating drought with a triumph that brought back memories of that top-class three-year-old three seasons ago. All that was missing was a soaring John Williams soundtrack as he skipped home down the outside.

In 19 starts since he'd last tasted success, he'd been favourite on seven occasions, including in races like the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), the C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m).

Remove champion mare Winx (Street Cry) and another two Group 1 races - the George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) and the first running of the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) - would pop into the column.

Yesterday was not one of those days, even as he dropped back from

top-weight in the Railway Stakes to a weight-for-age Group 3 affair. Instead, the James Cummings trainee was sent out the \$8 equal second favourite behind luckless Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Celebrity Queen (Redoute's Choice), who was as short as \$1.70 at post time.

Ridden quietly by Parnham from an awkward draw, a solid tempo in front set by Valour Road (Frost Giant) - who shared the second line of betting with him - proved the first ingredient to success, particularly once Laverrod (Toronado) crossed to apply pressure.

As the field approached the sweeping Ascot turn and Parnham pushed out into the three-wide line, the hulking brown, almost black, gelding was travelling powerfully, tracking up ominously. It was that similar visual sight to his sire Lonhro (Octagonal) that, among other things, had stamped him as a potential heir apparent.

Yet he'd looked a likely winner many times before, looming large only to lack that killer instinct when the drive was fierce.

Not yesterday. Instead, pulled to the outside by Parnham, he continued to accelerate at a frightening speed.

The manner in which he quickened down the centre of the track was breathtaking, a turn of foot not seen since that Randwick Guineas defeat of Pierata (Pierro) and Trapeze Artist (Snitzel), but it also left him a sitting shot for the favourite. Celebrity Queen, although back last, only had a length and a half to find on Kementari at the top of the straight and was hastening at a rate of knots.

Surely she would reel him in from there?

Not yesterday. In the end, she made up a half-length or so in the run to the line, but she was never catching Kementari, who looked like the 'Special K' of old

Godolphin's travelling foreman Nacim Dilmi, who has prepared Kementari and stablemate Trekking (Street Cry) during their campaign in Perth and declared yesterday "Kementari Day" before he returned to the winner's stall, said that the blue army always believed that the "gorgeous" gelding would one day prove triumphant once more.

<< Continued from page 5 "The team never gave up, they always had faith that he would one day win a race again," Dilmi said. "Obviously, the team retired him to be a stallion and things didn't go his way, so he made a comeback to the races as a gelding. It's easy to forget that it is very hard to do - it's rarely done by any horse.

"After he ran two weeks ago, I told James that I thought he still had it in him and that we should have one final throw at the stumps. He was perfectly suited in today's race and the way that he let down today was unreal."

While Kementari's comeback may be a leaf right out of the best tales of the past, the journey incorporated a uniquely Australian twist as he prepared for what was potentially his final start.

"This week, we have done so many different things with him," Dilmi continued. "We went to Jim Taylor's property on Monday just to work him away from a racetrack. He saw emus and kangaroos and that was a big eye-opener for him.

"On Tuesday, we took him to Belmont for his final gallop; on Wednesday, we took him to the beach. Even today, when we brought him to the races - we are stabled right across the road but I said to James, I think we need to put it in his mind that we're not coming here today. So we put him on the float, it drove around for half an hour, dropped him at the races and he got off the float like he was a new horse.

"We changed so many things though that we don't really know what has worked!"

Yesterday's win was his fifth from 29 starts, while he has earned more than \$2.1 million throughout his career.

While Kementari has no future as a stallion, he will have two future foals on the racetrack: a bay colt out of three-time country NSW winner With Care (Bernardini) and a bay or brown filly out of the unraced Mithila (Encosta De Lago), with the mare a three-quarter sister to Encosta De Lago's (Fairy King) stallion sons Manhattan Rain, Niagara and Echoes Of Heaven.

Whether Kementari, like Scheherazade, has earned another day at the office remains to be seen, with Dilmi indicating that retirement was a more likely option. But as enigmatic as the six-year-old may be, there is little doubt that yesterday's Kementari is the equal of almost every horse nationwide.

"If today was his swansong, it's a great way to go out," Dilmi said. "I'm sure the team will have a meeting about it, but to finish with a win like that, it's a great feeling. But I keep telling James to send him for a spell and then to bring him back into work because he doesn't give you a feeling at home that he wants to stop.

"Hopefully the win today gave him a lot of confidence and he can come back to racing again next preparation. He will go to Melbourne on Tuesday night, James will cast his eye on both horses - him and Trekking - and we look ahead to what's next."

While the horses will head to Melbourne, Dilmi heads to Brisbane, ready for another carnival. The travelling bandwagon moves on.

Glen Eden Stud's Rebel Dane (California Dane) produced his first winner from just two runners after Subterranean (2 c ex Caves by Bernardini) made a mess of his rivals at Doomben yesterday. Sent out as the \$3.90 favourite after finishing third on debut at the Sunshine Coast, when he became the first runner for his sire, the Matt Dunn-trained Subterranean was not for catching yesterday in the 1200-metre quality to kick off the Doomben card. Ridden by Michael Cahill, Subterranean stretched away to score by three and a quarter lengths over the fast-finishing Collay's Spirit (Charm Spirit), with You'll Be Mist (Headwater) hanging tough for third, a further nose away. Bred and raced by Steve Grant under his Grant Bloodstock banner, Subterranean is the first foal out of Caves (Bernardini), a four-time winner at Geelong, Seymour, Woolamai and Hanging Rock, who was purchased for just \$1,000 by Kenny Lowe's Carpe Diem operation at the 2017 Inglis Melbourne Spring Thoroughbred Sale. Offered on Inglis Digital in January, 2019, Caves was passed in for \$5,500. Remaining in the care of Grant Bloodstock, she produced another colt by Rebel Dane last year before producing a third colt, this time by Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock), in 2020.

Rebel Dane stood at Glen Eden Stud in Victoria for \$5,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

#### **First for Rommel**

Ultimate Command (2 f ex Weona Lady by Lonhro) provided Rommel (Commands) with his first winner when landing the two-year-old plate over 1000 metres at Ascot on debut. Trained by Neville Parnham, who also had Rommel under his care, Ultimate Command led all the way to defeat stablemate Flying Missile (Cable Bay) by half a length, with Astrape (Snitzel) a further one and a quarter lengths behind in third. Ultimate Command was a \$15,000 purchase from Mogumber Park at this year's Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale. Rommel has had three runners so far, with Pixie Chix and Rommel's Command failing to place. In his race career, Rommel took out the Western Australian Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) and the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) before retiring to stud and he now stands at Mogumber Park for a fee of \$4,400 (inc. GST).

#### **Five for Dundeel**

Truly Great (5 g ex Truly Special by Jeune) took out yesterday's Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) in truly great fashion, defeating Inspirational Girl (Reliable Man) by two lengths to provide Dundeel (High Chaparral) with his fifth individual elite-level winner. Dom To Shoot (Shooting To Win) finished a further length behind in third. Six-time Group 1 winner Dundeel, who has also sired Atyaab, Castelvecchio, Yourdeel and Super Seth to elite-level success, stands at Arrowfield Stud for \$66,000 (inc. GST).

#### 41 for Written Tycoon

Written Tycoon (Iglesia) sired his 41st individual stakes winner when Kissonallforcheeks (3 f ex

Rosie Rocket by Blackfriars) impressively took out the Sir Ernest Lee-Steere Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Ascot yesterday. The Daniel Mortontrained three-year-old stormed down the outside under a well-timed ride from Brad Parnham, who earlier partnered Ultimate Command to success, to defeat Solaia (Toronado) by one and a half lengths. Western Empire (Iffraaj) was close behind in third. Bought from Newhaven Park for \$120,000 at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Kissonallforcheeks has won four of her eight starts and went one better than her Listed runner-up finish in the Burgess Queen Stakes (1400m) at Ascot last month. Her sire Written Tycoon, who stands at Woodside Park Stud for \$77,000 (inc. GST) has had a magnificent 2020, with the likes of Pippie, Ole Kirk and Odeum all scoring at the highest level.

#### Seven for Deep Field

Isotope (3 f ex Great Dansaar by Choisir) provided Deep Field (Northern Meteor) with his seventh individual stakes winner when taking out the Mode Plate (Listed, 1200m) in emphatic style at Doomben yesterday. The Tony Gollantrained three-year-old was making his second start this preparation, after finishing runner-up at Doomben last month, and produced a stunning turn of foot under an effortless Ryan Maloney ride to defeat Gotta Kiss (Not A Single Doubt) by three lengths. Paredo (Better Than Ready) was a further head behind in third. Isotope, who finished runner-up in the Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) in May, was purchased by Gollan, John Foote and Black Soil Bloodstock for \$170,000 from the Daandine Stud draft at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Deep Field, the sire of Group 2 winners Cosmic Force, Dig Deep and Xilong, stands at Newgate Stud for \$55,000 (inc. GST).

#### 24 for Tavistock

She's Alight (5 m ex Keep Alight by Keeper) took out the Jungle Dawn Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Ascot yesterday to bring up Tavistock's (Montjeu) 24th individual stakes winner. Lining up in stakes company for the first time, She's Alight battled well to just hold off the field in a bunched finish, with nine rivals finishing within two lengths of the winner. The five-year-old mare, who grabbed the lead with 200 metres to run, defeated Special Choice (Redoute's Choice) by a short head, with Chantrea (Puissance de Lune) a further head behind in third. She's Alight provided two-time winning mare Keep Alight with her first stakes winner. All seven of Keep Alight's progeny that have graced the racecourse have won. Tavistock, who stood at Cambridge Stud, died aged 14 last year.

### Second stakes win for Hard Empire

Hard Empire (7 g Hard Spun - Last Quill by Last Tycoon) recorded his first stakes success since landing the R. N. Irwin Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) last year when taking out the George Moore Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben yesterday. The Tony Gollantrained Jonker (Spirit Of Boom), who attracted much of the pre-race attention and was sent off a \$2 chance, led all the way up the straight and looked the winner until the Toby and Trent Edmondstrained Hard Empire just managed to reel him in in the final few strides, with a head the final margin between the pair. Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) finished three lengths behind the winner in third. Hard Empire was bought by Charles White for just \$11,000 from the Maluka Thoroughbreds draft at the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale in 2019 and has now amassed over \$500,000 in prize-money for his owners. He is one of 81 stakes winners for Darley's Hard Spun (Danzig). Post race, Edmonds Racing said on Twitter: "What a deadset beauty this bloke is! Been with us for three starts and he has run enormous in each of them! Big thanks to Charles White and his friends who have entrusted Hard Empire with us."

#### **Grand Prix for The Elanora**

The Elanora (Redoute's Choice) will target the Grand Prix Stakes (Gr 3, 2200m) at Eagle Farm on Boxing Day following his impressive performance in yesterday's De Bortoli Wines Handicap (1800m) at Rosehill. Sent off the \$3.30

favourite, The Elanora backed up his win in the Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Newcastle to make it two consecutive victories, downing stablemate Kukeracha (Night Of Thunder) by two lengths, with Dhakuri (Contributer) a further length and a quarter back in third. "Australia is becoming one big carnival now and we're pretty lucky from that perspective," winning trainer Chris Waller said. "You need to train a bit differently and keep your horses up a bit longer and it suits my style." The Elanora is raced by businessman John Singleton, whose racing manager Duncan Grimley is keen to get The Elanora into the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). Waller added: "Duncan Grimley is a great form student and he said to me, 'you won a Derby with Shoot Out off a similar preparation, he ran on Boxing Day as well and still managed to stay up for the Derby'. I said, 'I didn't train Shoot Out then' and he said, 'oh well, at least you know it can be done'."

#### Oscar Zulu, Ellsberg bound for Guineas

Three-year-old Oscar Zulu (Epaulette) has booked his passage to Queensland for the Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) with a winning return in the opening Benchmark 72 contest at Rosehill yesterday. The Chris Waller-trained Oscar Zulu was tried in Group 3 company on his last two starts, finishing fourth in the Up And Coming Stakes (1300m) and then fifth in the Ming Dynasty Quality (1400m) and Waller holds the gelding in high regard. "We certainly had him in the right races to say we had an opinion of him and he's come back really well," the trainer said. "All you can do is win so we'll aim the bar a little bit higher. He's eligible for the three-year-old race at the Magic Millions and he's mainly owned by a womens' syndicate so there is an extra bonus there. That's the path but he will certainly have another run in Sydney first." Up-and-coming colt Ellsberg (Spill The Beans) could also be Magic Millions-bound after demolishing his rivals in yesterday's Precise Air Handicap (1500m) at Rosehill, in which he defeated Joliette (Charm Spirit) by four and a quarter lengths. Group 3 placed in the Spring Stakes at Newcastle at his previous start, Ellsberg dominated throughout under Tim Clark and looks a nice colt for Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou.

#### Written Miss continues Jennings' hot streak

An all-the-way win by Written Miss (Written Tycoon) in the opening race at Pakenham has continued Caroline Jennings' fine run of form, with the trainer recording five wins from her last six runners. Ridden by Jason Benbow, Written Miss was sent off the \$2 favourite to take the Benchmark 70 contest and rewarded favourite backers with a one and a half length defeat of Veranskova (Written Tycoon) to maintain her unbeaten record. "There was a lot of hype around Written Miss and rightly so but you just don't know what's going to happen until they've crossed the line," Jennings told Racing.com. "Massive congratulations to James (Kennedy, owner) and all the team. She's an absolute credit to everyone. It's been a great week, totally surreal and to be totally honest with you utterly nerve-racking."

### First Melbourne metro win for Benbow since 2016

Group 1-winning jockey Jason Benbow, the rider of Written Miss, recorded his first city win since partnering Astro Castro (Astronomer Royal) to victory at Flemington in July 2016. Benbow now believes he is back to flying form after a horror run with injuries and is very fond of the Caroline Jennings-trained filly. "She's just very exciting and very grateful personally to be given the opportunity," said Benbow. "My personal battles have been well documented so a big thanks to Kennedy Racing, the whole team there to have the confidence to give me the opportunity on a filly like this. I'm the fittest I've ever been. I'm really enjoying another opportunity to do what I love and it's fantastic when you get on a horse like Written Miss. It makes that 15 months staring at the wall on the couch with the family, not knowing if you're ever going to get back on a horse, it makes it all worthwhile."

#### The Astrologist lands Bullion

After two narrow defeats, The Astrologist (Zoustar) finally got his head in front to take out yesterday's \$150,000 VOBIS Gold Bullion (1400m) at Pakenham. The four-year-old gelding narrowly defeated Wild Vixen (Foxwedge) by a short head, with Galaxy Raider (Hard Spun) a length and three quarters back in third. Craig Williams was full of praise for the winner, who is prepared by Leon and Troy Corstens. "I thought he was really good," the winning jockey told Racing.com. "He had to make the running. You can feel the gusty wind. He was just confident. After riding him last time I thought we'd give him every chance and trust him a little bit. We found that he's not quite push-button, he's not quite bombproof. I thought we fought off a good warhorse (Iconoclasm) outside of me and then Ben Melham (Wild Vixen) seemed to time his run to perfection and we both lunged at the same time like in a running race. I asked Ben if he knew (who won) and he said 'no, it's pretty close."

#### Webster's fairytale finish spoiled

There was no fairytale finish for Pat Webster, who can now look forward to the next stage of his life after saddling up his final runner at Newcastle yesterday. The popular trainer announced his retirement from training earlier this week and his last runner, Kosciusko (All Too Hard), finished runner-up under stable apprentice Brandon Griffiths, having been run down by Mikayla Weir on Leave Me Some (Time Thief). In his usual laconic style, Webster said Weir didn't pay attention to instructions. "I said to the apprentices it was my day but Mikayla didn't listen," Webster told Sky. "He tried hard. The training side is finished, it's really sad. I'll have a cry tonight over a glass of red."

Opalescence, who was purchased as a yearling by Mahoney for just NZ\$1,000 on gavelhouse.com, was given little chance by the market despite winning at Tauranga at her most recent start. However, given a pearler of a ride by Jasmine Fawcett, she managed to hold off second favourite Jason Belltree (Ferlax) by three-quarters of a length, with a further two lengths back to the pace-setting Explosively (Sweynesse) in third. Opalescence is her family's first stakes winner in five generations, although fifth dam Homespun (Round Table) produced Group 1-winning stayer Mashaallah (Nijinsky) and is also the matriarch of a family that includes top-level victors Union Strike (Union Rags), Avenge (War Front), Local Talent (Northern Dancer), Mark Of Esteem (Darshaan), Hard Not To Love (Hard Spun) and Secret Spice (Discreet Cat). Showcasing, who last shuttled to New Zealand in 2017, will stand at Whitsbury Manor Stud in Hampshire for £45,000 (approx. NZ\$85,750) in 2021.

#### From rags to riches for Opals

Jenny Mahoney, a co-owner of Opalescence, was delighted with the performance of the NZ\$1,000 buy and is considering the Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) as a target for the filly. "When I saw she was paying close to \$13 I got quite a surprise," she said. "We all got quite a good collect in the end. When she drew well, we were quietly confident and she rewarded us, as we thought. She can run the times that you need to be competitive at this level and she did it well. She isn't very big, about 15.2 hands, but you don't have to be big to be fast, and she is very professional, which can take them a long way. I'm thinking about a race on either Boxing Day or New Year's Day back here for her next. I think she will get over further in the future as she is out of a Pentire mare, but we'll just keep her around the 1400 metres at this stage. She's proven to be a real little beauty after we only paid \$1000 for her originally. Her other owner is Carl Brown who works at the stable in the mornings. When we bought her, he took a real shine to her when she was being broken in and he took a ten per cent share in her. He is as happy as can be and enjoying the ride."


#### 165 for Deep Impact

#### **UK: Record-breaking Indianapolis** tops Goffs UK December HIT Sale

Indianapolis (Galileo) set a new record of £52,000 (approx. AUD\$94,135) when selling to Richard Ryan and trainer Ian Williams at Friday's Goffs UK's December HIT Sale. From 127 lots offered at the one-day auction, 104 sold for a clearance rate of 82 per cent and an aggregate of £694,500 (approx. AUD\$1.25 million), an average of £6,678 (approx. AUD\$12,100) and a median of £4,000 (approx. AUD\$7,250). Indianapolis, who began his career in the hands of Aidan O'Brien, is impeccably bred, being out of Breeders' Cup Distaff (Gr 1, 9f) heroine Adoration (Honor Grades). High-class handicapper and Royal Ascot winner Dash Of Spice (Teofilo) added further lustre to the sale when selling to the Ontoawinner Syndicate for £29,000 (approx. AUD\$52,500). Trained and consigned by David Elsworth's Egerton House Stables, Dash Of Spice struck in the Duke of Edinburgh Handicap (1m 4f) in June 2018. Godolphin's ten-strong draft proved popular and the gelding Civil Law (Dark Angel) topped the consignment when selling to Guy Stephenson for £24,000 (approx. AUD\$43,450). The three-year-old, who raced in the colours of Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum, is related to the Group-placed Buthela (Acclamation) and Listed winner Deemster (Invincible Spirit), and was a €450,000 purchase from Arqana's August Yearling Sale.

## Boomba toughs it out to win Singapore Golden Horseshoe

he Barree Stable colours flew high for the second year running in the Singapore Golden Horseshoe (Gr 3, 1200m) when Boomba (Showcasing) came with a grinding run to claim top prize right on the line.

Last year, the Australian outfit headed by Glenn Whittenbury were successful with their stable superstar Inferno (Holy Roman Emperor), even if the two-year-old feature race was then staged as the culmination of a fiverace series sponsored by Aushorse.

As it has been across the board on the racing calendar, Covid-19 has turned the juvenile series upside down this year – no lead-up races, only one race and downgraded from Group 2 to Group 3 with prize-money halved, and probably the most significant change and a bit of an anachronism, it's open to three-year-olds given its late date of December, having been switched from July.

While Inferno is indisputably from another stratosphere, his Cliff Brown-trained stablemate Boomba fully deserved his own moment in the sun, albeit from a watered-down version of the Golden Horseshoe.

The son of Showcasing (Oasis Dream) is certainly not without budding qualities, boasting one win on debut and a last-start third in a novice race, but his barrier 13 raised some concerns in a wide-open race where no standouts jumped off the paper.

Regular partner Ruan Maia, however, rode Boomba like he was the best horse in the race, parking him behind the leading trio in a three-wide position, punching the wind outside stablemate Golden Way (Swiss Ace), but seemingly galloping comfortably within his own steam.

Any doubts whether the New Zealand-bred had any petrol left in the tank were quickly answered when he was clicked up for the moment of truth.

Infinite Wisdom (All Too Hard) was first to throw down the gauntlet when he collared the leader Ablest Ascend (Charm Spirit) and looked to be holding sway, but Boomba was hot on his heels.

At the 200 metres, the well-backed pair were running away from the weakening Ablest Ascend, with Infinite Wisdom in front and Boomba steadfastly wearing him down.

The pink and white Barree silks were in hot contention for a second hurrah, even if it was definitely not in the same mould as Inferno's dominant romp from last year, not to mention a late intrigue was thrown into the mix when an orange flash burst onto the scene.

After wedging his way through a tight passage, the Arexevan Stable-owned Relentless (Hallowed Crown) was sailing home at the rate of knots, and for a split second, gave the impression he could finish over the top of the fighting duo, but despite hie rider's desperate urgings, Tim Fitzsimmons' runner got to the wire too late.

In a thrilling three-way go, Boomba lunged at the post to down Infinite Wisdom by a short head, while Relentless had to settle for third place, another neck away.

Favourite Lim's Straight (Strategic Maneuver) had every chance after settling

nicely tucked away in the box-seat, but did not reproduce the same dash as at his impressive winning debut. He stayed one-paced to run a disappointing ninth.

Sent out at \$25, Boomba ran the 1200 metres on the short course in 1min 10.9secs.

Not only did the gutsy win conjure up echoes of last year's success for Brown and Barree, but it also served as the perfect appetiser to their main course next Sunday, Inferno's daring raid on the Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m).

With Brown and racing manager Chris Bock already in Hong Kong to oversee their champion's preparation, it was left to senior track rider Tony Lane to give the debrief on Boomba's pulsating win back home.

"Boomba is still immature and can only improve further, but he showed a great fighting spirit today," said Lane.

"There were no specific instructions from Cliff, he told Maia to just ride him where he was comfortable. If they go quick, the plan was to try and get in behind as he has natural speed, too, and it's worked out well.

"He's not in the same league as Inferno, that's for sure, but he's done very well for us. It's up to Cliff to decide what he would like to plan for him now." Maia for one was delighted he had notched a third 'black type' race, even if a Group 3 race may not carry the same hype as the Kranji Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and Raffles Cup (Gr 1, 1600m), both captured with Aramaayo (Poet's Voice).

"I've always believed in this horse. I've ridden him from his first trial," said the Brazilian jockey.

"He has really improved a lot and I was confident he would run well today even if I was scared of the barrier.

"But I know he has good gate speed and he jumped very well. I wanted him to travel near the leaders today.

"At his last start, I waited for the last 200 metres but he was a bit flat and ran third. I was closer this time, and waited a bit longer, and it worked out better"

With an earlier win aboard Eunos Ave Three (Swiss Ace), Maia was ringing up a double which has enabled him to chip away two precious wins from leader Vlad Duric's nine-win lead, reigniting a small hope he can still catch the three-time Singapore champion jockey, who came home empty-handed yesterday, with three race meetings remaining in the Singapore season

The leaderboard now stands as Duric on 63 winners with Maia trailing by seven winners on

#### Harry steady as a Rokk in his choice

Here's an easy one for you: Would you turn down a ride on a confirmed starter when your horse is the second emergency acceptor?

The answer would be a no-brainer: 'hell no'.

Jockey A'Isisuhairi 'Harry' Kasim said 'thanks, but no thanks' to trainer James Peters when approached for the ride on Arc Triumph (Showcasing) in yesterday's Pitstop 2012 Stakes (1100m).

The runner A'Isisuhairi had been booked

well before, the Lee Freedman-trained You Rokk (Artie Schiller), was only the second standby starter – hence needing two scratchings to get promoted into the line-up.

Given the remote chances of getting in, the Malaysian jockey could have told Freedman to let him off for the Arc Triumph booking, but he took a very big punt. He stuck solid with the You Rokk booking.

And he was well rewarded for his blind faith in the entire when Surpass Natural (Elvstroem) and Nimble (Patronize) were scratched on Thursday, meaning both You Rokk and stablemate Augustano (Hard Spun) were in.

That was one prayer answered and only half the battle won. A'Isisuhairi still had to go out there and win the race for the gamble to be fully redeemed.

He didn't need to pray too hard this time as the seven-year-old was clearly on song, aided by a bit of ducking and weaving into the home straight, which saw the last-minute pairing sneak in for a half-length win over Altair (Zoustar).

Webster (Showcasing) ran third another

neck away. Sent out at lukewarm odds of \$50, You Rokk was timed at 1min 4.38secs for the 1100 metres on the Polytrack.

"I was so confident You Rokk would win this race going on his last run and at the handicap," said A'Isisuhairi.

"That's why both Lee and myself were disappointed when he was only the EA2. I ride him in work and he has really improved from his last start, he needed the run then.

"I actually got an offer to ride James Peters' horse but I turned it down. Somehow, I still hoped I could get in, it's crazy, I know, but I believe in miracles.

"It was a big gamble and it's paid off. The horse was super fit and Lee just told me to settle him where he is comfortable.

"We knew there would be plenty of speed, and he was travelling so well when we straightened up. When I saw a gap to my inside, we went through and he gave a strong kick to win."

A five-time winner in Australia, You Rokk was bringing up his second Kranji win from 11 starts for owner Tony Torcasio.

His stablemate Inspirational Girl, who was far more favoured in the betting, settled in second-last place from her outside barrier (17) and was still well back before William Pike switched her deep upon turning for home. She then ran on strongly with a late bid to take second, her difficult barrier proving costly. The three-year-old Dom To Shoot had a nice trip in fifth place, got into clear running at the home turn and kept fighting on well for third in a good performance in this class. Too Close The Sun settled outside the leader (Gailo Chop),

challenged rounding the turn and fought on well for (3.5 lengths) fourth, with **Gailo Chop** fading late for (4.1 lengths) fifth after leading until halfway down the straight. [KB]

### ANOTHER NZ BRED WINNER

Analysis: Several sharp Group 1 performances last season were rewarded in a clear-cut win by Rock On Wood here, taking his record to eight wins (two stakes) at start 17. He was away well, yet wide, and steadily drifted to settle third-last inside the 1200m. Starting the big Trentham bend he improved three wide to be midfield and kept gaining on the leaders from the 600m to turn in widest. With about five lengths to make up at the 400m, he balanced and then charged hard, was a length away at 200m, but was going well and then levelled up at the 100m, before drawing clear by a length for a deserved victory. **Concert Hall** was a clear second-last leaving the back straight, went forward to track the winner from the 800m and was right on his heels turning in. While he accelerated quickly, she took longer to wind up, but from the 200m she finished strongly, taking ground off the winner but too late. Deerfield was more than a length clear at the 1000m, was eased soon after but tried to slip them rounding into the straight. Away by two at the 400m, he was not caught until near the 100m, but fought hard to hold third. Hypnos turned in second, caught the leader near 100m but had to settle for fourth when passed. [LJ]

To the line the lead was too great, despite a late lunge from Fonsalette, who sat wide and last at the 800m, moved closer to the rail near the crossing but shared last into the straight. From the 400m she made a strong run through the middle and once into the clear chased hard after the winner but the post arrived too soon. Taioseach had two behind him at the 400m, then ran on best of the rest for a distant third. Callissident was handy enough and had every chance in a battling fourth. [LJ]

Analysis: The most experienced runner in the field, Opalescence chased down the pacemaker with good determination to score win four (maiden stakes) at start ten. She was quickly away but was outsped, being the main chaser all the way to the top of the straight. When the leader shot clear by four lengths she dug in, chased hard, levelled up near the 100m and then strode into the lead, three quarters of a length in front when it mattered, for a solid performance. Jason Belltree sat fifth, one out past the 1000m, held his position inside the 600m and then went widest into the straight. Keeping up a strong run he found third at the 200m and continued strongly for a good second. Explosively led to the 600m, shot clear rounding into the straight, and was four lengths clear starting the run home. He was caught at the 100m before holding on for third. Perfect Scenario turned in third and kept on solidly in the straight for fourth. [LJ]






