

# Eureka sticks solid with Spirit Of Boom at \$44,000

ureka Stud will maintain the status quo heading into the 2020 breeding season with its proven pin-up stallion Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo) to remain at an unchanged service fee this year on the basis that the outcross stallion fits a rare niche for breeders. *Continued on page 7* >>

# Exceedance's fee set at \$38,500 to headline Vinery roster

<< Continued from page 1 Successful in last year's Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m), Exceedance's fee has been set at \$38,500 (all fees inclusive of GST), the same mark as Darley's son of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) in Microphone and Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick).

Vinery Stud general manager Peter Orton believes the former Team Hawkes-trained sprinter, who created a rivalry with Coolmore's Yes Yes Yes and Darley's Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) during his nine-start career, was "a superior athlete" who he hopes is capable of passing on those attributes to his progeny.

"When you are looking to breed to a mare you are looking for a genuine sire line and a depth of pedigree with consistency there and you are looking for a superior athlete to sort the good ones out of the group," Orton told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He certainly proved multiple times what a great athlete he was, so he ticks all those boxes. He did win one of the better races, the Coolmore, which is regarded as a high-profile race for stallions going to stud.

"It's nice to do that, but what you are looking at, in a broader sense, is a stallion that may not necessarily have won and been unlucky in some

races and there's others who have won races but have been a bit lucky to win them."

Considered by many pundits to be an exceptionally strong three-year-old crop, Exceedance returned after a two-start juvenile career to take out the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) first-up before finishing third to Bivouac and Yes Yes in both the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) and Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

Once the target race was identified - the Coolmore Stud Stakes - Exceedance came up trumps when overhauling Bivouac in the \$1.5 million Flemington feature.

<< Continued from page 3 Previous winners of the Coolmore to go to stud include Zoustar, his sire Northern Meteor and grandsire Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) as well as Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock), Flying Artie (Artie Schiller), Sepoy (Elusive Quality) and Star Witness (Starcraft).

Vinery Stud's **All Too Hard** (Casino Prince), whose son Alligator Blood landed the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in February, will remain at a fee of \$27,500 while **Star Turn** (Star Witness) will stand for \$16,500.

Orton said All Too Hard's consistency as a stallion was starting to be rewarded, on the track and in the sales ring, and was at an affordable fee during the coronavirus pandemic.

"He's proven that he gets so many runners and so many winners week in and week out, which supports breeders with their mares and their produce records," he said.

"Commercially, they sell well in the ring and those who buy them to race find they are genuine horses who run for a good time and over a variation of distances.

"He's certainly earned his spot and probably more, but in this environment we will keep him at this fee and in comparison to horses at a similar level, he is a great value horse."

Emerging Vinery stallions **Headwater** (Exceed And Excel) and **Press Statement** (Hinchinbrook) had their fees lowered to \$13,750 after making encouraging starts with their respective first crop two-year-olds this season. **Casino Prince** (Flying Spur) will stand for \$5,500.

The appeal of Headwater and Press Statement could receive a boost during the Queensland winter carnival, specifically the J J Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1400m), with the Toby and Trent Edmonds-trained Wisdom Of Water (Headwater) heading in that direction and a possible clash with Sydney colts Spokesman (Press Statement) and Newsreader (Press Statement).

On Headwater, Orton said: "They have taken a little bit of time to mature, which is interesting for that horse, but the ones we're involved with and the ones we're talking to are just coming into their own and we're quite excited with what's going to go on in the next six months.

"He's a beautiful horse, he's a great type and he's got a pedigree who could throw up anything.

"Wisdom Of Water has that much talent about him and hopefully he flies the flag for us and there's quite a few others mustering in behind him."

Orton was not surprised that Press Statement's stock are starting to show their wares as they matured.

"We did expect that the Press Statements would be hitting the board about now. Trainers love them because you can see that they are getting better and better and there's a lot of variety in what they will do. They will be sprinter-milers," he said.

"We've got a good one of Chris Waller's, Spokesman, heading to the J J Atkins - he's a quality horse - and maybe Newsreader will head up there, too. He's a really popular horse."

Star Turn's first yearlings sold up to \$550,000 this year and Orton is confident the stallion can make his mark early in the new season with his first crop two-year-olds.

"We've got great faith in this horse. He's a real bull and was such a great racehorse and people did accept his types (at the sales)," he said.

"They look strong, early going horses, so they were well sought after. He's certainly well set-up to have a real crack with his first runners. Anyone coming in on the back of that will do very well."

Like all studmasters, the impact of Covid-19 has weighed heavily on service fee decisions and for Orton it was no different.

"With our returns this year, we are going to do it on a pay on live foal so breeders are paying for what they get to just give them a bit more time to get organised and be as fair as possible and to increase that opportunity for them," he said.

"They are paying for what they get, rather than what they hope they get, which is the way it should be. We always trust our clients and look after them and this is guaranteeing them that."

As expected, record-breaking shuttler **More Than Ready** (Southern Halo) will not return for a 20th southern hemisphere season while his son Pluck will also not stand at Vinery this year.

"More Than Ready's in America and covering well and he is in great health," Orton said.

"It's great what he's done for the farm. We'll give him the respect that he deserves. He's very popular over there where he stands for US\$80,000, so that is the respect he is given over there. He can continue to cover a book and be ready to go next year."

Vinery's Adam White and Harry Roach are available to discuss breeders' mating plans for this year and the stud's fee announcement, and that of a raft of other stallion farms, comes just days out from the Inglis Chairman's Sale on Friday for elite breeding prospects.

<< Continued from page 1 The Group 1-winning Spirit Of Boom, who is in the top 15 Australian sires for winners and fourth by two-year-old winners this season, will remain at \$44,000 (all fees inclusive of GST) this year while his roster cohorts Encryption (Lonhro), Defcon (Choisir) and Red Dazzler (Red Ransom) will also hold their 2019 fees.</p>

They will stand for \$13,200, \$4,400 and \$4,400 respectively.

"We had a fair bit of back and forth with what to do, but in the end we decided that we are going to stick solid on our fees from last year," Eureka Stud's Harry McAlpine told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"With Spirit Of Boom, we already came back 20 per cent last year and, in comparison to the rest of the market, he fits into a pretty rare niche of being a proven horse who has a lot more upside than most other proven horses.

"He fits into that bracket of being a proven stallion who has got the upside and that he handles Danehill as well with the likes of Jonker and Ef Troop and Outback Barbie all being out of Danehill line mares.

"Between the shareholders and ourselves (as well as outside clients) he can cover another good strong book this year."

Spirit Of Boom stood for \$55,000 in 2018 after his first crop two-yearolds dominated on the track, with the sprinter siring 18 individual juvenile winners to lead Zoustar (Northern Meteor) by eight, before McAlpine and his family dropped his fee by \$10,000 last year.

While mindful of the economic outlook, McAlpine says the quality of foals born and the book of mares Spirit Of Boom covered last year leaves him confident the best was yet to come for the son of Sequalo (Rustic Amber).

It's a bit of a rare option and those who have been supporting him over the past couple of years have been indicating that they have been happy to go again with those good quality mares.

<< Continued from page 7 With the emergence of Jonker, Ef Troop and Outback Barbie before Christmas of his first crop two-year-old season in 2017, interstate breeders flocked to Spirit Of Boom with a dramatically increased quality of mares.</p>

McAlpine says that Spirit Of Boom's improved book has resulted in some impressive weanlings on the ground.

"We see first-hand a lot of Spirit Of Booms on the farm here and the types that he leaves out of the better mares and the shareholders who have gone and bought mares to send to him have certainly taken the foals up a level physically," he said.

"I think we've bred the right mares to him and, looking at the stats, he's covered over 160 individual stakes-performing and/or producing mares in his last two years alone.

"It's a fairly significant upgrade that I don't think you can really underestimate. He's proven when you give him a good mare that he can make the most of it."

McAlpine added: "He's in the top five two-year-old sires by winners in Australia. His first crop is now 8.3 per cent stakes winners to runners, which is pretty elite.

"He's a proven horse with upside. He's produced stakes winners in NSW, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia and New Zealand."

Meanwhile, Eureka Stud launched the stud career last season of the beautifully bred Group 2 winner and Group 1-placed sprinter **Encryption** who will enter his second season this year at an unchanged fee of \$13,200 after covering 134 mares last year.

"Being a second season is a tricky one. You don't want to devalue them and he was very popular last season and, being a four-year-old, we capped his booked around 135 mark which he covered," he said.

"His pedigree has had another large upgrade with Bivouac stepping out, winning a Newmarket and Golden Rose - he is a three-quarter in blood to Encryption being by Exceed And Excel. It's one of the biggest families in the Australian Stud Book and it just continues to grow every year."

Eureka sent a significant number of mares to Encryption last year, while the stallion's co-owner Darley also committed eight mares to him.

"Last year they sent eight mares to him, which was terrific, including Kanzan, the dam of (Group 3 winner) Ranier, so he's had some quality

mares there and we, ourselves, sent 28 of our own mares which I think is an indication that when Eureka does stand a stallion we do get behind them with everything we've got.

"We find the right stallions we think we can breed our mares to and we'll support him to that level again this year, if not more."

In conjunction with Darley, Encryption's service fee will also be under a pay on live foal agreement. The terms will also apply to fellow stallion **Defcon** (\$4,400) whose first crop turns two next season.

"His yearlings sold up to \$100,000 this year, which was good, off limited numbers," he said.

"We are hearing good things about his first crop from the breakers, as you would expect. They are very forward and tough, so hopefully we will be seeing some of those stepping out before Christmas.

"He's got a couple of half-relations that are quite handy with a half to (Oakleigh Plate winner) Pippie and a half to Boomsara, so he's got quite a few handy related ones that hopefully can step out for us."

Eureka Stud stalwart **Red Dazzler**, the sire of 2014 Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Tinto, will also stand for \$4,400.

# Exceed And Excel colt with big engine joins Riverdene

SW operation Riverdene Stud has called on Group 3-winning juvenile McLaren (Exceed And Excel) to bolster the Riverina-based farm's stallion roster.

The Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winning McLaren, who was rated highly in the arsenal of valuable colts owned by the China Horse Club-Newgate Farm partnership, will stand for an introductory fee of \$6,600 (inc GST) this year.

The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained colt came under public notice with three consecutive barrier trial victories before backing that up with a first start win in the Canonbury in February of last year.

He went on to finish fourth in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) and third in the Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) to complete his two-year-old season.

But it was McLaren's Canonbury Stakes success that left jockey James McDonald under no illusions that the colt was an elite talent.

"He's got that much speed, he doesn't know how to harness it yet. That's the exciting thing. Once he does learn to harness it, he is going to be a very good horse because it's all on raw ability at the moment," McDonald said at the time.

"I love his acceleration. He has a great will to win. He is a real racehorse and it will take him a long way."

Peter Snowden said: "What he does at home is really, really good.

I only let him go once and that was enough for me. I saw what he could do."

#### Oaklands Stud announce 2020 fees

Fees for Oaklands Stud's two resident stallions, Power (Oasis Dream) and Neorealism (Neo Universe), will remain unchanged in 2020 as the stud continues to commit to offering the stallions at competitive pricing. New Zealand Champion First Season Sire in 2016/17, Power, will stand at the Queensland farm for \$11,000 (inc GST) while Neorealism, a three-quarter brother to Japanese stallion Real Impact (Deep Impact) will stand for a fee of \$9,900 (inc GST). "We have been delighted with how well the progeny of Power have continued to perform on the track and with the support that Neorealism continues to receive, however we remain aware that these are challenging times for everyone," Alistair Stewart, Oaklands Stud co-principal said. "As such, we have priced our stallions with the view to offering value to breeders, many of whom are returning clients."

#### Field of 14 for SA Derby

Dalasan (Dalakhani) will face 13 rivals in his bid to win the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville on Saturday. Trained locally by Leon Macdonald and Andrew Gluyas, the colt has drawn barrier nine in Saturday's race, where he will be ridden by Jason Holder. Dalasan is chasing his third win in a row having won the traditional lead up races, the Port Adelaide Guineas (Listed, 1800m) and Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 2035m), both at Morphettville. The Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Warning (Declaration Of War) has drawn barrier three and will be ridden by last week's Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m)-

winning jockey Damien Thornton. Three fillies, Moonlight Maid (Puissance de Lune), Silent Sovereign (Dalakhani) and Zayydani (Savabeel) will back-up after contesting last week's Oaks.

#### **Camelot on target for Derby**

Danny O'Brien said his colt Russian Camelot (Camelot) could not be going better in the lead up to the South Australian Derby and believes missing a planned lead-up will not be an excuse. The Derby will be his biggest test to date but has been a long-term target for the colt, who is northern hemisphere-bred and six months younger than his rivals. O'Brien scratched Russian Camelot from a 1700-metre race at Flemington last Saturday week because of an inflamed throat and instead directed him to the Derby, giving him a solid 1600-metre jumpout. "He couldn't be better," O'Brien said. "He had a searching trial on Friday on the course proper at Flemington which just rounded out his preparation for the Derby. We're very, very happy with him."

## McDonald eyeing third SA Derby

On Saturday, Dalasan is out to provide trainer Leon Macdonald with a third win in the South Australian Derby and a sixth Derby success all over. Should Dalasan win, it will be a first Derby victory for Macdonald since he began training in partnership with his son-in-law Andrew Gluyas and a first Group 1 combining with his former apprentice Jason Holder. "They have both been part of my life for as long as I can remember," Macdonald told Racing.com. "Andrew went to school at Sacred Heart with

my daughters Sue and Christine and Sue and him have been together virtually since that time. You will be flat out finding anyone who would say a bad word about Andrew and he is the workhorse of our stable, which helps make it tick."

#### **Gosford Cup to suit Glamour**

After bypassing the Wagga Wagga Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) with Greysful Glamour (Stratum), Mark Newnham is now aiming his mare at the Gosford Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m). She had been an early favourite for last Friday's race at Wagga but Newnham withdrew her because the track was heavy. "It was too wet for her," Newnham said. "Her best form is on top of the ground. I wouldn't have thought she would have been competitive on that sort of ground." Greysful Glamour has 55 kilograms and will again be ridden by Rachel King. ## Alexander to double up at Caulfield

Archie Alexander is unsure how imported gelding Southern Rock (New Approach) will fare on his Australian debut at Caulfield. He is set to join stablemate Kiwia (Reset) in a handicap over 1600 metres on Saturday, a race that will give Alexander more insight into his four-year-old's capabilities. The gelding has won four of his eight starts and started his career with Andre Fabre before joining David O'Meara's stable in England. "He's a bit of a weird horse to get a guide on so it will be interesting to see him kick off, but he has got a lot of ability," Alexander said. "We've got no idea where this horse will get to, whether he's a benchmark horse or whether he might be a Group horse. And I've got no idea if he's a miler, 2000 or 2400-metre horse. He's run in Listed races in England but we'll start him off quietly and see where he gets to."

#### **Command set for Wangoom**

Danny O'Brien is confident Order Of Command (Squamosa) is in the right form and will get

the right conditions to give today's Wangoom Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Warrnambool a shake. The five-year-old has been aimed at the Wangoom and showed he was on target when he returned from a spell in style with a convincing win last month over 1200 metres on a soft track at Caulfield carrying 60 kilograms. "You can pretty much rely on Warrnambool being rain-affected and we were looking to run him in a nice race on rain-affected ground," O'Brien said. "The first-up run was a bonus. We got the rain that day as well. He prefers that soft six or soft seven which it should be for him tomorrow. The question is whether he can carry the 62 kilos. We're expecting him to be very hard to beat."

The majority of the top Australian stables including Chris Waller, Ciaron Maher and David Eustace, Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, Peter and Paul Snowden, Bjorn Baker and John Thompson have entries among the 100 nominations.

#### Queensland in strong I I Atkins hand

The J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m) has attracted 140 nominations for this year's two-year-old feature, including the fancied Queensland-trained trio of Isotope (Deep Field), Wisdom Of Water (Headwater) and Rothfire (Rothesay). Peter & Paul Snowden feature 14 entries for the race, including Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) winner Wild Ruler (Snitzel), while Matt Cumani has entered Showdown (1200m) winner Khoekhoe (Turffontein). Among Chris Waller's nine nominations is the unraced Foscolo (Not A Single Doubt), a three-quarter brother to 2018 winner The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice).

# Star Of Michelin cleared to race again

Promising three-year-old Star Of Michelin (Jet Spur) has been passed fit to continue his winter campaign after recovering from a second episode of cardiac arrhythmia. The Stuart Kendrick-trained gelding is rated among the top three-year-olds in Queensland

and scored a brilliant win at Eagle Farm in late March. He ran a long last in a Doomben benchmark race at his next start on April 11 when he was found to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. It was the second episode of cardiac arrhythmia for Star Of Michelin and Kendrick sent him to the university veterinary hospital for tests. "They have done all of the tests and he has been cleared of damage," Kendrick said. "We trialled him and he won easily and passed the vet's test. He can run in the QTIS three-year-old race at the Sunshine Coast on Friday week."

## Pateman hospitalised after fall

Dual-license holder Steven Pateman was taken to hospital with concussion after a fall in a maiden hurdle at Warrnambool yesterday. Pateman was riding the \$2.50 favourite Sir Issac Newton (Galileo) who was in front when he fell at the final jump in the Carlton Draught Maiden Hurdle (3200m). The jockey was ruled out of the remainder of the all-jumps program on the opening day of the two-day carnival and was taken to Warrnambool hospital for further tests and observation. He was discharged later that evening. Sir Isaac Newton, a winner of the Wolferton Handicap (Listed, 1m2f) at Royal Ascot in 2016, suffered a fractured shoulder in the fall and was euthanised.

## Rawiller injured at Randwick

Group 1-winning jockey Nash Rawiller sustained facial injuries at the Randwick barrier trials yesterday. "It is suspected Nash (Rawiller) may have been struck in the face after his mount reared up and is being attended to by ambulance officers," Racing NSW said in a statement. Rawiller is second in this season's Sydney Jockeys' Premiership

with 72 winners, trailing James McDonald on 76.5 wins.

#### Nothdurft inquiry to resume

Leading Brisbane jockey Baylee Nothdurft will front the resumption of an inquiry into his ride on Vega One (Lope De Vega) at the Sunshine Coast. Nothdurft rode Vega One when the gelding finished fourth in an Open Handicap (1000m) after coming from last on the home turn on April 25. Stewards took evidence about aspects of Nothdurft's ride in the straight before adjourning the inquiry to examine betting records and will continue the hearing tomorrow. Nothdurft, who currently leads the metropolitan and state in senior and apprentice premierships, missed last Saturday after serving a seven-day suspension for excessive use of the whip.

## Filly sets tongues wagging at Cambridge Stud

Emotions were high on Saturday for the team at Cambridge Stud, as Toffee Tongue (Tavistock) won the Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m). It had been a turbulent few months last year for the stud when losing three stallions, including their flag bearer Tavistock (Montjeu). Whilst it was Tavistock's first Oaks success, he is no stranger to siring Classic winners, siring three to Derby success. "For him to get an Oaks winner was particularly satisfying because he has been close a number of times before," Cambridge Stud's Head of Sales and Nominations Scott Calder said. While they lost Tavistock last year, Calder said the farm can continue to look forward to watching his final few crops compete on the racetrack. "In the next 12 months you are going to have those NZ\$65,000 stud fee foals turning three and that's when you would like to see that momentum building," he added.






