Black Caviar to visit Written Tycoon as Prince Of Caviar retires to Riverbank

The champion sprinter will be served by a sixth separate stallion with Arrowfield Stud's new arrival her next suitor

Riverbank Farm will have close relations to two of Australia's champion mares at stud this season, with Black Caviar's (Bel Esprit) son Prince Of Caviar (Sebring) joining Winx's (Street Cry) half-brother Boulder City (Snitzel) on the roster at the Benalla stud.

It was also announced yesterday that Black Caviar will visit Arrowfield Stud's new addition Written Tycoon (Iglesia) this season, with her daughter and first foal Oscieta (Exceed And Excel) bound for Swettenham Stud's Toronado (High Chaparral).

Black Caviar has visited Yarraman Park's I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) the last three years, with her just-turned-yearling a colt

<< *Continued from page 1* and More Than Ready (Southern Halo), whose filly Ready For Caviar caught the eye on debut in March.

Oscietra, who won two of her five starts at Geelong and Ballarat, has also visited I Am Invincible the last two years, but will instead head for Victoria to Toronado, who has been one of the breakout stars of the last 12 months.

Oscietra's younger half-brother Prince Of Caviar won a maiden at Bendigo from six starts, while he was also city-placed behind Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Extra Brut (Domesday). He will stand for \$4,400 (inc GST) at Riverbank Farm this season.

For Riverbank principal Russell Osborne, the opportunity to access these top bloodlines fits into his vision for what he hopes to achieve with the farm.

"We deal in breeding to race, so we're not chasing any greatly-performed stallion," Osborne told ANZ Bloodstock News last night. "I think with the Black Caviar ownership - they really do love their horses and that's why they haven't sold any of them. It's not a commercial sort of thing. They were looking for a stud to do their own boutique breeding operation and open it up for everyone else.

"My wife Caroline had a bit of an affiliation with Neil Werrett, they just had a look at us and thought that he would suit our criteria.

"We've got to try and get the bloodlines somehow, and the performed horses are priced out of it for us. For the breeding to race market this works perfectly for them. We offer such a variety that it's like a one-stop station for them."

Prince Of Caviar and Boulder City are among an expansive eight-stallion roster at Riverbank Farm, joining Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Anacheeva (Anabaa), Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Von Costa De Hero (Encosta De Lago) and Group 1 winners Bon Aurum (Bon Hoffa) and Skilled (Commands).

Also on the Riverbank roster are blueblood Wayed Zain, by High Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) out of a half-sister to Encosta De Lago (Fairy King), and the unraced Redente, by Redoute's Choice (Danehill) out of Group 1 winner Stella Cadente (Centaine).

"The market that we're looking at is mostly that lower-end breeder who can't access the likes of Sebring or Snitzel so we get the sons of those stallions who have done really well in the breeding barn and hopefully

produce a lot of winners," Osborne said.

"The likes of Boulder City, Wayed Zain and Prince of Caviar, their sole draw would be on the bloodlines and not the performance and for the lower end bloke to get into blue blood. If they had performed on the track, then they wouldn't be here.

"Last year the farm produced 84 winners which is what our breeders want. The breeders love to race their horses and that's where I think the Black Caviar ownership really suits our set up and our niche.

"We would have about 70 mares on the farm that are residents and the majority are pretty keen to go to him.

"He's a really nice horse and nice natured and couldn't be happier to have him here."

While Winx's first foal, by I Am Invincible, is due within weeks, the unraced Boulder City offers a rare opportunity to access those bloodlines at a reasonable price of \$5,500 (inc GST). He has one crop on the ground with his second group of foals to be born this season.

Boulder City is the only one of Winx's brothers to stand at stud, with her half-brother Win Win Leader (Fastnet Rock) gelded before retiring from Hong Kong without racing and her best-performed sibling, Group 3 winner El Divino (Snitzel), euthanised after a training incident as a four-year-old.

"Boulder City has been received really, really well so far, and his foals I'd put up against any in the area in terms of quality and type," Osborne said. "From those foals we've got a massive return from him and those breeders are really keen to go back to him.

"Without a doubt, Winx and Black Caviar have been the best-performed mares in our lifetime, and to be able to have bloodlines directly associated with them out of the first dam is really unbelievable."

Ryan holds aces in Rosebud

Gerald Ryan believes underfoot conditions will be the determining factor in which of his three runners fares best in tomorrow's The Rosebud (Listed, 1100) at Rosehill. The trainer will start Return With Honour (Fastnet Rock), Kumasi (Snitzel) and The Face (Rubick) with the trio all figuring prominently in betting in the nine-strong field. "Dry track, I would say Return With Honour, soft track I would say Kumasi, heavy track, The Face," Ryan said. Punters looking for further clues will, however, be buoyed by the fact Ryan compares Return With Honour favourably to one of his former stars. "He reminds me of Hinchinbrook in his stature. Hinchinbrook was by Fastnet Rock out of Snitzel's mother and this horse is just built the same way," Ryan said. Stablemate Kumasi likewise showed promise as a juvenile with a debut win and a stakes placing at his only other start. "On pedigree, on type and the way he appeals to jockeys, he will be better over 1400 metres but at this stage of his preparation, 1100 should be right for him," Ryan said. The Face is the least experienced of the three but has he does have the benefit of recent racing. "He's got good ability. I haven't really got to the bottom of him," Ryan added.

So Si Bon a Cox Plate wildcard

So Si Bon (So You Think) will attempt to defend his title in tomorrow's Aurie's Star Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Flemington as the seven-year-old starts out on a campaign which could culminate with a tilt at the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m). "The Cox Plate may not

be as strong due to the travel restrictions," co-trainer Tom Dabernig said. "If he's going well then who knows? We might think about it but he would have to be in good form." More immediately though, So Si Bon has the matter of the Aurie's Star and ten rivals to contend with. "He'll like the conditions with a bit of rain about," Dabernig said. "There should be good pace, which he'll like, and if he's left alone early he should run a good race. The main difference is that he's got the topweight of 60 kilos and he only carried 55.5 kilos last year."

Keeper a potential Plate contender

The Cox Plate could also be on the agenda for another runner who will return in the Aurie's Star, Game Keeper (Fastnet Rock). The now four-year-old was unbeaten in his last campaign and his trainer Tony McEvoy believes there could still be plenty more to come. "He was four-from-four last preparation and is really on the way up," McEvoy told Racing.com. "So, obviously, that (the Cox Plate) is a long way to go, but it's worth putting a nomination in, especially this year where it could be a very, very different (race). We haven't made any great plans after this race. We wanted to get him to the 1200-metre race, see how sharp he is and whether he needs to go to a mile or 1400 metres."

Oaks winner on notice

Danny O'Brien is hoping a rain-affected surface can trigger a return to form for VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Miami Bound (Reliable Man) when she starts her spring campaign in the G H Mumm Plate (1410m) at Flemington tomorrow. Miami Bound has had two starts on wet tracks

for two wins and Flemington was rated in the soft range yesterday. "She seems to have come up well. She hasn't had a trial but she's fit enough," O'Brien said. "This is a run to get her going and she'll have the advantage of being on a soft track. She'll carry a big weight which will make things hard first up so we're just hoping. What I want to see is a good run and a return to good form. I won't be looking at anything or making any plans for her until I see she's back in form."

Kemp eyes Weetwood with Marbellouz

Toowoomba trainer Kevin Kemp is eyeing another hometown feature race success with Mr Marbellouz (Love Conquers All), who resumes from an injury-enforced break in tomorrow's Canadian Club Handicap (1050m) at Doomben. Mr Marbellouz has not raced since finishing eighth in last year's Eye Liner Stakes (Listed, 1350m) at Ipswich but Kemp believes the seven-year-old has retained his competitiveness. "He had a jump-out here last week and went really good so I'm sure he hasn't lost his desire to race," Kemp said. "After his last run he got a virus which hung around a bit longer than normal so I gave him a bit longer out. Then when he got over that he gave his leg a bit of a knock, nothing serious but just enough to put him back out again." Kemp plans to give Mr Marbellouz three lead-up runs before the Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m), which the trainer will be trying to win for the fifth time, and he is hoping the gelding can overcome a tricky draw tomorrow. "He's drawn a bit sticky (eight) but if he gets the right run I'm sure he'll be highly competitive," Kemp added.

Covid jockeys' inquiry adjourned

Racing Victoria stewards yesterday adjourned their inquiry into potential Covid-19 protocol breaches by apprentices Michael Poy and Teo Nugent. The pair were stood down earlier in the week after stewards launched an investigation into their recent activities. Both riders are understood to have been interviewed, along with a stablehand from the Robert Hickmott stable. An RV stewards' report on Tuesday confirmed the investigation. "Racing Victoria stewards have opened an inquiry into the conduct of licensed apprentice jockeys Michael Poy and Theodore Nugent and a stablehand registered to Robert Hickmott upon receipt of information of possible breaches of Covid-19 protocols," the statement said. "Acting on the advice from RV's chief medical officer, the three have been stood down until further medical assessments are undertaken and until such time as the stewards conclude their inquiry. The trio have been advised that they are not permitted to attend any racecourses or licensed premises until approved by the stewards to do so."

Melbourne Cup card bolstered

The Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) program was given a boost yesterday with the announcement that the Farley Maribyrnong Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) and the TAB Trophy (Listed, 1800m) for three-year-olds have been added to the undercard. The move comes as part of a number of changes the Victoria Racing Club revealed for the Carnival, which will also see a new race, the \$250,000 Inglis Bracelet (1600m) for fillies and mares, run on VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) day. Unveiled by Inglis earlier this year, the race is restricted to fillies and mares sold via Inglis as part of the Inglis Race Series. The Bracelet is one of three major Inglis races to be held at Flemington with the \$500,000 Inglis Dash (1200m) to be run in February 2021 and the \$1m Inglis Spring moving from Randwick in 2022. The Ottawa Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) for two-year-old fillies has also been moved to Oaks Day from Cup Day. Additionally, the Grinders Coffee

Roaster Trophy (1400m) on Melbourne Cup day has changed from restricted to four and five-year-olds to open age.

V'landys sets tentative deadline for Victorian participation

Racing NSW chief executive Peter V'landys has given a three-week timeframe for Victoria to improve its coronavirus situation warning that horses from the southern state will be prevented from contesting the Sydney spring features if no improvement is forthcoming. "In three weeks we will know - if by then Victoria is still recording 725 new coronavirus cases, like it did on Wednesday, well The Everest slot-holders are going to have to find a horse in New South Wales or Queensland or New Zealand for that matter," V'landys told Racenet.

"Our focus - and sole focus - is keeping the industry going. We are not going to take any risks whatsoever in maintaining our industry operation. They have gone into Stage 4 lockdown in Victoria - in the next three weeks we will know if it has worked or if it hasn't worked. I'm personally confident that come three weeks they will have it under control and the borders can reopen. We are banking on the Victorian government getting it right."

Price thrilled with stable's progress

Mick Price yesterday expressed his delight at the success he and co-trainer Michael Kent Jnr had during their first full season's work together after the pair last week finished fourth overall in Victoria on 113 wins and fourth in Melbourne on 30 wins. "He's been a bonus for the stable," Price told Racing.com. "You wouldn't find a more enthusiastic, professional, well-

mannered young man and I even find myself saying please and thank you a bit more now." Price also gave a special mention to freelance jockey Jamie Kah, who is doing more riding for the yard and is impressing each time she does. "She did a few gallops for me yesterday morning at Sandown and I love the way horses travel for her in the run," he continued. "They don't throw their head around. She's got beautiful hands and balance and the horses work themselves in races and they hardly know she's on them."

Wisdom Of Water, Parlophone head Price 3YOs

Price already has his eye on some of the big three-year-old spring races with new recruit Wisdom Of Water (Headwater) and Parlophone (I Am Invincible), who was named ANZ Maiden of the Week when getting off the mark at Sandown in June. Wisdom Of Water finished fifth in the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m) on his final start for previous connections and has some lofty targets. "I think the three races I want to run in are the Blue Sapphire, the Danehill and the Coolmore," Price said. "Toby Edmonds trained him in Queensland. He is by Headwater and he was a smart horse up there." The stable is also considering potential Group 1s with Parlophone, who completed her two-year-old season with a win in the Lightning Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville. "Damien Oliver will ride her in the Quezette," Price continued. "She's very well. She's been to an equestrian rider after Adelaide as she can get a little bit fast in the brain sometimes, so she's been enjoying some R and R."

Raymond faces highs and lows

A breakthrough win for Bureaucrat (Zoffany) at Warrnambool yesterday provided Maddie Raymond with a timely fillip. The seven-length success came a day after Raymond's four-year-old stable pony Daisy, a horse she had bred, died from a long battle with pneumonia. "It had been a really tough few days with Daisy so sick and then was devastating to actually lose her, we'd bred her and she was a stable favourite," Raymond told Racing.com. "We'd been without a winner for months just finding our feet, and it feels like she was looking down on us."

333 for Galileo

The majestically bred Shale (2 f ex Homecoming Queen by Holy Roman Emperor) provided Galileo (Sadler's Wells) with his 333rd individual stakes winner when she became the latest in a long line of smart Coolmore-owned fillies to land Leopardstown's Silver Flash Stakes (Gr 3, 7f). Lining up off the back of a win in a Gowran Park maiden on her second start, Shale belied her odds of 14-1 to score by a length and a half from the favourite Pretty Gorgeous (Lawman). Aidan O'Brien has won this race with subsequent Group 1-winning daughter of Galileo Together, Maybe, Happily and Love in recent seasons, but he was out of luck this time round with his sons Donnacha and Joseph training the first two home. The winner received quotes of 20-1 to emulate her dam by taking out next season's 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m). Europe's multiple champion sire Galileo once again stood at Coolmore in Ireland for an undisclosed fee in 2020.

93 for War Front

O'Brien senior may have been out of luck when his two runners finished out of the frame in the

Silver Flash, but he was soon back in familiar territory when Military Style (2 c ex Together Forever by Galileo) led home stablemate Van Gogh (American Pharoah) to take out the Tyros Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) and become War Front's (Danzig) 93rd individual stakes winner. Not for the first time this season, the Ballydoyle inmate benefitted from a fine front-running ride by Emmet McNamara, making all for his second win from three starts when posting a neck victory. Military Style is the second foal out of Group 1-winning juvenile Together Forever (Galileo), his year older full-brother King Of Athens has won one of his ten starts and also made the frame in Listed company. War Front stood at Claiborne Farm in Kentucky for a fee of US\$250,000 (approx AUD\$347,000) in 2020, while his sire-son Omaha Beach will this year shuttle to Spendthrift Australia where he will stand for \$22,000 (inc GST).

Military Style joins impressive roll of honour

It may not be the most illustrious juvenile race in the European calendar, but more often than not the Tyros Stakes is won by a colt who goes on to make his name at the top level and beyond. Military Style became Aidan O'Brien's 14th winner of the race the trainer first landed back in 1995 with Common Spirit (Common Grounds) and joins the likes of King Of Kings (Sadler's Wells), Rip Van Winkle (Galileo), Zoffany (Dansili), Gleneagles (Galileo) and Churchill (Galileo) on a roll of honour which reads like a who's who of Ballydoyle. More recently O'Brien won the race with subsequent Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) hero Anthony Van Dyke (Galileo) in 2018. On the few occasions he has not been successful

in that period, the winner has still proved to be top notch, with the Jim Bolger-trained pair of Teofilo (Galileo) and New Approach (Galileo) winning it back-to-back in 2006 and 2007.

Nickajack Cave bags Ballyroan as Pondus disappoints

Progressive four-year-old Nickajack Cave (Kendargent) registered the most notable success of his career to date when landing the Ballyroan Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 4f) at Leopardstown yesterday. Trained by Ger Lyons, the in-form gelding made it two wins from three starts this season as he followed up his length and a half success in a Listed race in June with a half-length defeat of outsider Fresnel (Sea The Stars). The Joseph O'Brien-trained Pondus (Sea The Moon), carrying the colours of Lloyd Williams, was sent off the 11-10 favourite but could beat just one of his four rivals home.

Feature race prize-money in Britain takes another hit

Prize-money for another of Britain's marquee meetings took a post-Covid hit when it was announced yesterday that the total purse on offer at British Champions Day at Ascot has been slashed by £1.7 million (approx AUD\$3.12 million). British Champions Day, which takes place on Saturday, October 17, will now be worth £2.5m (approx AUD\$4.5m), down from last year's £4.2m (approx AUD\$7.1m). The Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) will be worth £750,000 (approx AUD\$1.38m), and although it will be the most valuable race in Britain this year, it is substantially less than the £1.3m (approx AUD\$2.4m) on offer in the 2019 contest won by Magical (Galileo).

Heading down under? December-foaled Great House added to Online August Sale

The Donnacha O'Brien-trained maiden winner Great House (Galileo) is likely to capture the attention of southern hemisphere buyers when the son of Galileo is offered as part of the Tattersalls Online August Sale next week.

Great House was one of four wildcard entries to be added to the sale yesterday and opened his account at Limerick in June on his second start - a feat made all the more remarkable based on his birthdate in late December - to provide his trainer with his first turf winner.

The Coolmore homebred holds entries in

both a trial stakes and the actual Irish St Leger (Gr 1, 1m 6f), and would have an even better chance at the weights were he to compete down under.

His unusual background is reminiscent of Russian Camelot (Camelot), who became the first northern-hemisphere bred to capture a Derby in Australia, with success in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m). The Danny O'Brien-trained colt, who was foaled in March 2017, had to carry the same weight as his rivals, one of whom was born the previous August.

In any case, a move to the southern hemisphere would certainly help the cause of Great House, and so it will be interesting to see who the successful bidder will be.



Vinery Stud may have been beaten in Tuesday's opener on the Pakenham synthetic track with Kiani (Headwater), but they would likely have been cheering the result regardless as their shuttle stalwart More Than Ready (Southern Halo) produced another horse seemingly bound for the big leagues in Jenni's Rainbow.

More Than Ready has had 73 stakes winners in Australia to date and, while he only has a handful of crops left to step out down under, he still looks to have plenty of firepower in his locker if horses like Jenni's Rainbow continue to line up.

Market confidence was high with the David

Brideoake-trained Jenni's Rainbow, sent out as the \$3.40 favourite in the eight-runner field; by the time they reached the 100 metres, it looked some of the best value on offer all week.

Ridden quietly from gate seven by Ethan Brown, Jenni's Rainbow was at the tail in the early stages of the 1100-metre contest. Smartly ridden by Brown, she improved into a good position behind runners as the turn approached, with all that was needed was the smallest gap to appear.

However, that gap never came and Brown was forced to sit patiently, waiting for the right moment to switch over heels and push into clear running.

That moment came at the 250-metre mark,

at just about the same time as the Vinery Stud-owned filly Kiani, racing greenly, fought back from challenger Reward The Bold (Reward For Effort) to hit the lead.

For a stride or two, she looked like the winner - but that was before Jenni's Rainbow hit top gear.

Within a matter of moments, it was all over, with Jenni's Rainbow going on to record one of the most impressive maiden wins of the year. At the line, she held a three-length margin over Kiani with Orpheline (Moshe) a further two lengths away in third.

With the spring features around the corner, it would be fair to consider her a major player. However, Brideoake is planning on taking his time with the filly.

"She will make her way through the grades," Brideoake told Racing.com. "You've got to get things started now, because in the next couple of months there are some good fillies races and hopefully she'll stand up for them."

"She relaxed lovely and the pick-up-and-go to the post was very good."

Purchased by Cape Schanck Racing for \$75,000 at last year's Inglis Melbourne Premier Sale when offered by Cornerstone Stud, Jenni's Rainbow is the sixth foal out of the Irish-bred Kingmambo (Mr Prospector) mare Three Rainbows.

Five of them have raced for three winners, with the best performer being Triband (Fastnet Rock), third to Hot Dipped (Written Tycoon) in the 2017 Strutt Stakes (Listed, 2100m).

Three Rainbows' dam Dietrich (Storm Cat) won the King George Stakes (Gr 3, 5f) at Glorious Goodwood in 2001 - the same race that Battaash (Dark Angel) won last week and Australian mare Ortensia (Testa Rossa) took out in 2012 - while Three Rainbows is a half-sister to Aloft (Galileo), a Listed winner in both the UK

and Australia, as well as Irish Group 3 winner Beauty Bright (Danehill).

The family, ultimately, traces back to 1982 American Broodmare of the Year Best In Show (Traffic Judge), Jenni's Rainbow's sixth dam.

Best In Show is the matriarch of one of the great international families and is responsible for arguably Australia's most prominent family.

Her daughter Show Lady (Sir Ivor) produced Dancing Show (Nijinsky II), the dam of Umatilla (Miswaki), Hurricane Sky (Star Watch) and Shantha's Choice (Canny Lad); Shantha's Choice herself is the dam of Redoute's Choice (Danehill), Platinum Scissors (Danehill), Manhattan Rain (Encosta De Lago) and Echoes Of Heaven (Encosta De Lago), as well as Sliding Cube (Rock Of Gibraltar), who herself produced Rubick (Encosta De Lago), and The Broken Shore (Hussonet), dam of Shoals (Fastnet Rock).

The number of black-type winners that can trace back to Best In Show is really quite extraordinary. They are as varied as American

Classic winners like War Of Will (War Front), Rags To Riches (A.P. Indy) and Jazil (Seeking The Gold), European Classic conquerors such as Spinning World (Nureyev), Peeping Fawn (Danehill), Logician (Frankel) and El Gran Senor (Northern Dancer), and even Japanese champion Almond Eye (Lord Kanaloa).

Three Rainbows is looking for better luck after she missed to Free Eagle (High Chaparral) in 2018 and then produced a dead Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) foal in 2019. She is currently in foal to Queensland sensation Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo).


