Neighbours turned life-long friends celebrate 'dream come true' after Oaks win

Matthew Irwin and Peter Harris claim first Group 1 success with Edward Cummings-trained Duais

With a love of the Aussie bush that developed during his time studying agricultural economics at the University of New England, Matthew Irwin always dreamed of racing a horse in the country.

So, he contacted leading Tamworth trainer Sue Grills to ask her if she could buy a horse for him.

She answered the challenge and purchased

him a filly for just \$22,000 at the 2009 Inglis Scone Select Yearling Sale that went on to race as Meerlust (Johannesburg).

She won her debut on March 11, 2011 at Grafton but, due to knee problems, she never realised her full potential on the track and was retired after only five starts.

Meerlust's racing journey might have been short but what a producer the mare, who's now 13 years of age, has since gone on to be.

Her crowning glory was on Saturday when her daughter Duais *Continued on page 2 >>*

"It's been a big dream come true.

"We were all there yesterday. If you saw a bunch of yahoos in the background celebrating, it was us. You don't miss being there for one you have bred from humble beginnings," said Irwin.

The victory shared between the former neighbours, who are now great

friends, was made even more meaningful by the fact that it was trainer Edward Cummings' first Group 1 winner since branching out on his own, away from the comfort of a training partnership with his father, Anthony, to set up at Hawkesbury.

"You are very proud to see this come to fruition, you dream of it and when it happens you need to pinch yourself," added Irwin.

"And when it's with your friends and family and someone like Ed, it makes it very special."

Irwin met Ed, the son of Anthony Cummings and grandson of Bart, over a game of golf and was impressed with the young man, who hails from one of Australia's most famous racing dynasties, so decided to back him with a horse to train.

"We decided to entrust Ed and the Cummings family with our filly. It's been a remarkable story for him to go out and train on his own.

"Duais was his first city winner, first stakes winner and now his first Group 1 winner," said Irwin.

Duais, who will now forever be remembered as the one that launched the career of Ed Cummings on the elite stage, isn't the first high class horse Meerlust has produced.

The David Vandyke-trained Baccarat Baby (Casino Prince) is another of Meerlust's progeny to provide long-time friends Irwin and Harris with stakes success.

Among her most notable wins is the Sunshine Coast Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m), while a second placing in the Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m)

added further black type.

"She's a very versatile broodmare," said Irwin. "We have always bred to race and that's the important thing, we love racing together and it makes it even more special if you can breed them yourself"

Irwin and Harris sold Baccarat Baby at the recent Magic Millions National

Broodmare Sale for \$650,000 and she will be covered by Spendthrift Farm's Dirty Work (Written Tycoon) this spring having been purchased by the Australian arm of B Wayne Hughes' global operation.

Telemon Stud sold her on their behalf and Duais will now be sent to their Queensland property for her winter break before being targeted at races in the spring.

"We have to let dust settle and we understand she has pulled up well. It's up to Ed where we place her in spring, we can only dream now."

Nowadays, Irwin, who is semi-retired, owns a farm at Armidale in the New England region but still lives in Sydney. His great friend and racing partner Peter Harris is based in Queensland.

To keep it all fair and balanced they alternate the horses they invest in together between the two states.

"It has been a partnership where we split horses going to Brisbane and Sydney and we never argue over a horse."

The system has worked so far and their friendship is still well intact after 27 years.

Furthermore, what's additionally exciting to the outcome they shared together at Eagle Farm at the weekend, is that they currently have Duais' two-year-old sister Amity Gal in training with David Vandyke.

Sue Grills hasn't been forgotten among all the city successes, either. She was one of the first people Irwin spoke to after the Oaks win and she still trains a few for them to this day.

Six for Winning Rupert

Tonneofgrit (2 g ex Istanford by Istan), the most expensive progeny of his sire Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) when sold for \$425,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale last year, improved on his fifth place finish on debut at Pakenham to win yesterday's 2YO Maiden Plate (1200m) at Geelong. Poised to pounce on the outside of race leader Titan Of Choice (Extreme Choice), the pair battled for a long way down the straight, with Tonneofgrit showing steely determination to win by three-quarters of a length over the fast-finishing Forbidden City (I Am Invincible). Titan Of Choice was a short-head further back in third. Owned by a syndicate led by Rupert Legh and trained by Team Hawkes, the gelding became the sixth individual winner for his Newgate Farm-based sire Winning Rupert. He is the first foal out of US Grade 2 winner Istanford (Istan), a \$300,000 purchase for SF Bloodstock from the Keeneland November Breeding Sale, whose yearling by Capitalist (Written Tycoon) sold for \$150,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale earlier this year. Winning Rupert stands at Newgate Farm this year for a fee of \$11,000 (Inc GST).

Third for Worthy Cause

Clearmountain Fairview's Worthy Cause (Choisir) recorded a third winner from just his sixth runner, as Constant Cause (2 g ex Equiano by Al Maher) landed the QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap (1350m) at Ipswich yesterday. A homebred for Evan Hardy's Dovedeen PTY operation, Constant Cause improved on his eighth place finish at Doomben on debut to defeat Balmaurice (Maurice) by a length and

three-quarters, with Son Of Pharoah (American Pharoah) two and a quarter lengths behind the winner in third. Group 3 winner Worthy Cause has just 27 live foals from his first crop and 18 in each of his next two crops. He will once again stand in Queensland for a fee of \$5,500 (Inc GST).

First for Lionhearted

The late Grenville Stud stallion Lionhearted (Fastnet Rock) sired his first winner when Coeur De Lyon (2 g ex Guyra Girl by Canny Lad) got off the mark at the fourth time of asking when taking out a maiden over 1009 metres at Devonport yesterday. The Cameron Thompson-trained juvenile beat Lacerate (Charge Forward) by two lengths, while Gee Gees Joe Blow (Clanalang) was a further half a length away in third. The Group 2-placed Lionhearted served one season at the Tasmanian stud where he produced a crop of 40 foals.

Akeed Mofeed back to Goldin Farms

Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) winner Akeed Mofeed (Dubawi) will return to stand at Goldin Farms in South Australia after having stood the last two seasons in Victoria at Swettenham Stud. The 12-year-old stood five seasons at owner Pan Sutong's Goldin Farms in the Barossa Valley and after an impressive start with his first crop he moved to Victoria, where he delivered 144 foals. Akeed Mofeed scored his first stakes winner in July 2019, shortly after his Swettenham move was announced, courtesy of Goldin Farms homebred Assertive Approach, and added a second through Jyoti in February last year. He has a further seven stakes placegetters, while

his progeny have proved popular in Hong Kong where has two winners. Akeed Mofeed will stand for a fee of \$8,800, down from the \$16,500 figure he stood for last year.

Subpoenaed prepares for Stradbroke

Chris Waller could have three runners in Saturday's Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) with Group 1 placegetter Subpoenaed (Rip Van Winkle) putting the finishing touches to her preparation with an exhibition gallop at Rosehill over the weekend. The Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up is set to be joined in the race by stablemate Imaging (Oasis Dream), while Waller is still mulling over whether to start Madam Rouge (Zoustar). Subpoenaed will travel to Queensland on Wednesday after tuning up for her Stradbroke tilt with a 1000-metre workout between races at Rosehill. Stable representative Charlie Duckworth said they had pinpointed the Brisbane feature as a target after her close second in the Robert Sangster. "It has always been the plan since Adelaide. She was only touched off in a Group 1 there and had Craig Williams' horse (Instant Attraction) not got such a lucky run, we probably win," Duckworth said.

Waller calls on Stewart again

While no jockey has been locked in for Madam Rouge, Tim Clark has been booked for the ride on Imaging and Ron Stewart for Subpoenaed, who has just 51 kilograms. Waller and Stewart combined for a memorable win with Selino (Champs Elysees) in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) during the autumn and stable representative Charlie Duckworth said they didn't hesitate to call on him in another major. "He's done nothing wrong for us and rides at the weight without any hassle at all," Duckworth said. "If you can't get your first Sydney picks, or you can't get one who can ride that light, you may as well stick with a local jockey who rides for the stable a lot and knows our tactics and how Chris likes his horses ridden."

Waller is weighing up whether to start Madam Rouge in the Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) on Saturday's program, or the Stradbroke in which she was runner-up to Tyzone (Written Tycoon) 12 months ago. "She's got a good race in her and she was only touched off in the Stradbroke last year, which is probably why you've nearly got to roll the dice and have another crack," Duckworth said.

Berry to ride Nettoyer at Eagle Farm Saturday

Tommy Berry will make a rare visit to Brisbane on the weekend having been booked for the ride on the Hawkes Racing-trained Wild Planet (Animal Kingdom) in the Stradbroke. Berry, who broke the 100 winners mark for the season in Sydney on Saturday, last rode the five-year-old when the pair landed the Theo Marks Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Rosehill back in September. He is also set to ride Overmann (Hinchinbrook) in the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) and Nettoyer (Sebring) in the Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m).

Firm Eagle Farm track prompts concerns

Anthony and Sam Freedman have three of the 17 entries for the \$1.2 million Q22 but underfoot conditions at Eagle Farm are set to play a big part in their participation. "Without going on about the track, it has been very firm and most of ours enjoy a bit of cut in the ground, so we don't want to ruin them on a firm track," Sam Freedman told Racing.com.

"There is a bit of rain (forecast) during the week, but I think with that track, it drains too well, so we've got a few decisions to make." The Freedman stable has Q22 entries for Homesman (War Front), Warning (Declaration Of War) and Le Don De Vie (Leroidesanimaux). "Warning is likely to run," Freedman said. "Le Don De Vie, for him we might look at an option a week later with the Ipswich Cup and then races like the Caloundra Cup. Homesman, he could potentially run in the Q22 or the mile race (Wayne Wilson Classic at weight-for-age) on the same day, so we've got a few decisions to make."

Guineas plan for Argentina

Argentina (Frankel) is set to be aimed at some big-race targets in the spring following her impressive debut victory at Flemington on the weekend. "She's come through really well," co-trainer Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "She's a filly that we've always had a lot of time for but we probably thought the 1100 (metres) could be a bit sharp for her down the straight the first time but good horses can overcome that sort of thing. We'll put her away for a little bit. She won't have long off. We'll keep her boxed at night and looking well and head towards something like the Quezette (first-up) and then to the Thousand Guineas and then we can see where she lines up."

Bargain and Splintex to spell

Mark Newnham has decided to spell Bargain (Ocean Park) after she finished fifth, beaten three and three-quarter lengths, behind Duais in the Queensland Oaks. Newnham, who said the filly didn't appreciate racing in restricted galloping room, also plans to let Splintex (Snitzel), eighth in Saturday's Moreton Cup, Gr 2, 1200m) enjoy some sunshine in the paddock.

Lord Bouzeron back in form for Hickmott

Lord Bouzeron (Burgundy) bounced back with a victory at Morphetville on Saturday that has his trainer Michael Hickmott ready for more. The rising five-year-old posted his first success in 12 starts and just his second in Australia having initially raced in New Zealand out of the Chrissy Bambry stable, where he won three races. "I had heard the horse was for sale and I know Chrissy

quite well, so I gave her a call and managed to get a deal done on him," Hickmott said. "Andrew Maloney is a very close friend, practically family, and lives up in the Alice Springs area, so the express purpose was to buy the horse and win the Alice Springs Cup with him. Things didn't pan out like we had hoped and he had some terrible luck in the race, so he ended up running a very unlucky fifth. We brought him home and lined him up last week and the bad luck continued so it was a hell of a relief to finally get that win with him on Saturday." Hickmott was full of praise for the ride by stable apprentice Jessica Eaton to land the horse an impressive three-and-a-half-lengths winner and predicts there is plenty more in store for him. "It was great to get Jess back on board as she rode him exactly to instructions and he won very comfortably," he said. "I think he is a really nice horse who will be even better this time next year, so we will give him one or two more in this prep before he goes away for a good long break and we bring him back in the autumn. He can have a break and we can then get him ready for that Alice Springs Cup again next year."

Wil John to take on Jericho once more

Wil John (Reset) is set to once again contest Australia's longest flat race following his victory in the Apian Animal Health Handicap (3600m) at Bendigo on Saturday. Trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace have earmarked the Jericho Cup (4600m) at Warrnambool in December for the five-year-old, but before then he is liking to be seen over jumps. "That was terrific," Eustace said after Saturday's two and three-quarter length win. "He's an absolute star and a genuine stayer. I reckon it's his best performance in that he travelled really well and was bobbing away with little Josh Richards on his back. He'll go over hurdles again but what he'll be is a good chaser and, we hope, a Grand Annual Steeplechase horse." Eustace said Wil John would remain in training at the conclusion of the jumps season in August to concentrate on the Jericho Cup, a race he finished third in last year. "When he ran in the Jericho he then had ten days in the paddock and we chipped away with him again, so it is the way to do it, really. Coming back after six weeks off they can end up injuring themselves, doing a ligament just getting fit again, so I think it works."

It's Me targets Kosciuszko defence

Brett Cavanough is hopeful he still has time to get It's Me (Shamus Award) in shape to mount a defence of her title in the \$1.3million Kosciuszko (1200m) at Randwick on October 16. The unbeaten mare is yet to return to Cavanough's Scone base following rehab with Lee Everson in Victoria on a tendon injury, likely suffered when winning the race last October. "I don't really know to be honest," Cavanough told Racing NSW when asked about her chances of defending her crown. "She's had a lot of rehab and done a lot of miles but until I get my hands on her I don't know. I haven't seen her since the week after the Kosciuszko. She's been in and out of the paddock doing a bit of swimming at the rehabilitation farm so we'll see what happens after. Last time she came to me I gave her a piece of work, turned her out for three weeks and brought her back and that was the preparation that led into the 'Kosi'. I've still got four months, 16-18 weeks so anything is possible."

Cummings hails son Ed's Group 1 success

Anthony Cummings has hailed the achievement of his son Edward after he became the latest member of the racing dynasty to train a winner at the elite level when Duais (Shamus Award) took out Saturday's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m). "It means he's obviously very good at it as you can't do something like that by mistake," the 21-time Group 1-winning trainer told Racing.com. "To have the determination to stick to the plan and to pull it off in such a way shows really good signs for the future." The victory of Duais saw Edward Cummings join his great grandfather Jim, his grandfather Bart, his father Anthony and brother James as a Group 1-winning trainer. "He started from scratch and he's been able to do this in pretty quick time," his father said. "He needed to get out and do it on his own. We had that discussion and that's what he did and that gives us all a great deal of satisfaction that he could do something like this."

Jockeys outed over whip use

Dean Holland was suspended for 15 meetings and fined \$1,100 for whip offences

aboard opening race runner-up Vividredsky (Alamosa) at Flemington on Saturday, while in the final contest, Mark Zahra was outed for seven meetings and fined \$600 for his whip use aboard runner-up Vegas Knight (Declaration Of War). At Bendigo Joe Bowditch received a seven-meeting suspension and \$400 fine for his whip use on second race winner Thunder Point (Host). At Eagle Farm, Rachel King was fined \$300 for using her whip two times more than allowed aboard Rocha Clock (Pierro) in the Magic Millions National Classic (1600m), while Jim Byrne was suspended for 11 meetings on a careless riding charge. Byrne will still be able to ride three-year-old Apache Chase (Better Than Ready) in next Saturday's Stradbroke Handicap as his penalty begins later that night.

Half-brother to Enable set to race in Australia

European champion mare Enable's (Nathaniel) half-brother Centroid (Dansili) could make his Australian debut later in the month. A winner of two races in Ireland, Centroid was bought by Japanese syndication group Rising Sun Syndicate for 7,000 guineas from the Horses In Training Sale in England in October, a figure Rising Sun's director and former jockey Kosi Kawakami believes was a great deal. "I think it was a great bargain. A really nice purchase from last year and he's coming on really well and we can't wait to see him racing in Australia," Kawakami told Racing.com. "He's out of Concentric, which is the same dam as Enable of course but he's a half-brother by Dansili. We bought him last year at a tried sale in England, we bought him for a really cheap price, 7,000 guineas, which is about \$15,000." Previously trained by dual

Melbourne Cup- (Gr 1, 3200m) winning trainer Dermot Weld, Centroid was switched to Jane Chapple-Hyam in England before being transported to Australia in February. "He's been galloping well," Kawakami said. "He's jumping out next week at Bendigo on Tuesday. We're just going to check out how fit he is and then we'll have to find a race, so we're looking at the end of June or early July if everything goes well."

VRC calls for prize-money increase at Winter Finals

Victoria Racing Club's executive general manager Leigh Jordon has said he would like to see an input of extra prize-money added to Finals Day at Flemington to showcase the winter meeting. Three Listed races, each worth \$160,000, will be run on July 3 and Jordon said he would like to see prize-money across the board increased to make the day a feature. "It'd be great to have all the races on that day worth a minimum of \$200,000, or over, so that it is a real focal point of our winter racing," Jordon told Racing.com. "I think most people through this period are aiming for the finals, but having it with a higher profile through the winter, increasing the prize-money across the day so that the heats lead into finals that are worth a lot more, it gives horses through that period a real focus."

Fundraiser launched for Darleen Duryea

A fundraiser has been launched for Beaudesert trainer Darleen Duryea who suffered serious spinal injuries and bleeding on the brain after a trackwork fall last weekend. Pacorus returns to winner's enclosure

Pacorus (Tavistock) turned back the clock at Ellerslie on Saturday when he stormed to victory over 2200 metres for his first win since he took out a similar event at the venue nearly two years earlier. Capably handled by Darren Danis, the nine-year-old kept up a sustained run in the home straight to win convincingly from race favourite Voler Pour Moi (Pour Moi) and provide trainer Chris Wood with a special moment. "I got a real kick out of that as he has always been a stable favourite," Wood said. "He has been with me since he was a two-year-old and probably knows more about my place than I do. He hadn't been going as well as he could, although I thought he still had a win or two left in him. Actually, I thought he might have been a run short for this one, but he came out and put them away like he used to do." Wood will now set Pacorus, who has won 11 races including the Rotorua Cup (Gr 3, 2200m), for his fourth attempt at the Kiwifruit Cup (2100m) at Tauranga later this month, a race he won back in 2017. "It would be a pretty good achievement to win that Kiwifruit Cup four years after he first won it," he said. "I'm just hoping the handicapper doesn't get stuck into him as he should get in on a competitive weight."

ASIA

51 for Deep Impact

A frenetic finish to the Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m) saw Gran Alegria (Deep Impact) denied in her late lunge to retain her title by Danon Kingly (5 h ex My Goodness by Storm Cat), who surged on the outside to deny the five-time Grade 1 winner and in turn land his first, as the late Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) quickly moved on from bringing up his half century of Group/Grade 1 winners on Friday with a 51st at Tokyo yesterday. Danon Kingly, a dual Grade 2 winner who finished third in the Satsuki Sho (Gr 1, 2000m) and second in the Tokyo Yushun (Gr 1, 2400m) as a three-year-old, returned here for his five-year-old campaign and caused a shock in defeating Gran Alegria by a head. Schnell Meister

(Kingman), the winner of last month's Mile Cup (Gr 1, 1600m), finished third, a further half-length in arrears. He felt a bit tense at first entering the track but he had good rhythm during the trip and had plenty of horse left," said winning jockey Yuga Kawada. "He responded just as I hoped turning the last corner and ran well after that. Although he hasn't been able to put in the best results in the past, he has definitely demonstrated his true strength today and I'm happy to have been a part of it in my first time in the saddle."

SGP: Moor turns down licence

Daniel Moor has decided not to take up the licence granted by the Singapore Turf Club. The Victorian-based rider was on Friday among three expatriate jockeys (Manoel Nunes and Derreck David are the other two) given a six-month licence to ride at Kranji until the end of the year. Moor, 36, applied to return to Singapore after cutting short a two-and-a-half-year stint at Kranji because of Covid-19 in April last year, and was thrilled to hear of his selection, but current circumstances have given him no other choice but to turn it down following discussions with his family. "I wish to thank the Singapore Turf Club for granting me a visiting jockey's licence for the remainder of the racing season," he said. "It's however, with sadness, that due to a number of contributing factors, it's not going to be possible for me to accept this licence. Current Covid-19 regulations from both the Australian and Singapore governments make things extremely difficult to travel internationally for employment."

INTERNATIONAL

Two for Churchill

Dual Classic winner Churchill (Galileo) sired his second winner when The Acropolis (2 c ex Hairy Rocket by Pivotal) ran out a comfortable winner of his second start at Listowel yesterday. The Aidan O'Brien-trained juvenile beat Thunder Eclipse (Holy Roman Emperor) by three and a half lengths with Swift One (No Nay Never) a further four and three-quarter lengths adrift in third. A €140,000 purchase at the Goffs

November foals sale in 2019, The Acropolis is the fourth foal out of the Pivotal (Polar Falcon) mare Hairy Rocket, herself a half-sister to the Group-placed Marsh Hawk (Invincible Spirit). Currently standing at Coolmore's Irish base, Churchill will shuttle to Australia for \$22,000 later this year. He covered 360 southern hemisphere mares during his first three years at stud and will have his first runners in Australia later in the second half of 2021.

First for Caravaggio

Coolmore's Caravaggio collected his first stakes winner yesterday when the exciting filly Dizzy Bizu (2 f ex Izzy Bizu by Kodiak) maintained her unbeaten record in the Prix la Fleche (Listed, 1000m) at Chantilly. Trained by Stephane Wattel. Dizzy Bizu followed up last month's debut win over course and distance as she defeated Anterselva (Fast Company) by a length and three-quarters. Ma Noire (American Devil) finished another length and a quarter away in third. An unbeaten two-year-old himself, Caravaggio (Scat Daddy) has sired six individual winners so far from his first crop of 140 foals. After three seasons at Coolmore's Irish headquarters, Caravaggio moved to Ashford Stud in Kentucky for this year, where he is standing at a fee of \$25,000 (approx. AUD\$32,310).

She defeated Ricla (Adlerflug) by a length, with Omnia Munda Mundis (Australia) a short-neck further back in third. Thunder Drum is the seventh stakes winner out of a

Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare to be sired by Dubawi. The Darley stallion again stood the 2021 season for £250,000 (approx. AUD\$457,000).

Rathbarry Stud's Acclamation (Royal Applause) sired his 57th individual stakes winner when Louliana (3 f ex Rosie's Premiere by Showcasing) landed the Prix Marchand D'Or (Listed, 1200m) at Chantilly yesterday. Batwan (Kendargent) finished a length and three-quarters behind the winner in third. Penny's Picnic stands at Haras du Hoguenet for a fee of €5,000 (approx. AUD\$6,460).

FRA: In Swoop continues to build eye-catching record

German Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner In Swoop (4 c Adlerflug - Iota by Tiger Hill) won for the fourth time in eight starts when claiming a comfortable victory in the Grand Prix De Chantilly (Gr 2, 2400m) yesterday. The four-year-old, who was runner-up to Sottsass (Siyouni) in the Prix de l'Arc De Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) last year, returned in 2021 with a defeat to Sublimis (Shamardal), however he overturned that result and built on a win in the Prix d'Hedouville (Gr 3, 2400m) last time out to defeat Sublimis by half a length, with Vaucelles (Le Havre) three-quarters of a length behind the winner in third.

FRA: Tahlie makes it four on the bounce

The Pascal Bary-trained Tahlie (3 f Rio De La Plata - Tianshan by Lahint) scored a fourth

win in succession when landing the Prix De Sandringham (Gr 2, 1600m) at Chantilly yesterday. Building on his win in the Elusive Quality Stakes (Listed, 7f) in April, Casa Creed won by two lengths over Chewing Gum (Candy Ride) as trainer Bill Mott saddled the first two home. Wesley Ward's Bound For Nowhere (The Factor) finished third, two and three-quarter lengths behind the winner. Jimmy Creed covered 338 mares until 2019 at Spendthrift's Victoria farm, and stood the 2021 season in Kentucky for \$10,000 (approx. AUD\$12,900).

Drain The Clock (3 c ex Manki by Arch) won in a thrilling duel with Jackie's Warrior as Maclean's Music (Distorted Humor) sired the first and second home in the Woody Stephens Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at Belmont on Saturday. The pair were split by a neck, with seven and a quarter lengths further back to Nova Rags (Union Rags) in third. Maclean's Music, the sire of 23 stakes winners after six crops of racing age, stands at Hill N Dale Farms for \$25,000 (approx. AUD\$32,000).

Flatter (A.P. Indy) added Grade 1 winner number five on Saturday when Search Results (3 f ex Co Cola by Candy Ride) took out the Acorn Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Belmont. The runner-up from the Kentucky Oaks (Gr 1, 9f) in April, Search Results defeated Obligatory (Curlin) by half a length when sent off the 9-10 favourite. "I'm just so proud of her to come back in five weeks after a real dog fight with Malathaat," winning trainer Chad Brown

said. "To bounce right back and lay it on the line again, this filly has so much talent and so much heart. She's a very rare kind of horse to have, and we're so lucky to have her."

Eight For Dark Angel

Althiqa (4 m ex Mistrusting by Shamardal) gave Godolphin a third Group/Grade 1 success in a single day on Saturday, as she won the Just A Game Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Belmont for trainer Charlie Appleby, who won the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) on Saturday with Adayar (Frankel). Althiqa, a stakes winner in France and Dubai, defeated stablemate Summer Romance (Kingman) by three-quarters of a length, with Daddy Is A Legend (Scat Daddy) two and a half lengths behind the winner in third. "We're obviously delighted with it and we knew we had two competitive fillies. It's one of those days when we prepped well, I was confident they would run a big race and they justified it," said Appleby. "They are two fillies who ran well over the winter in Dubai in Group 2s—one won the Balanchine and the other won the Cape Verdi—and they came out there to America and put it to the sword again. It's a great effort by the team there and we might think about leaving them there for Saratoga." Althiqa became the eighth elite-level winner for her sire Dark Angel (Acclamation), who stood 2021 for €60,000 (approx. AUD\$94,000) at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland.

14 for Hard Spun

Silver State (4 c ex Supreme by Empire Maker) backed up his Oaklawn Handicap (Gr 2, 9f) success with a first victory at Grade 1 level in the Metropolitan Handicap (Gr 1, 8f) at Belmont on Saturday, delivering a 14th elite-level winner for former Australian shuttle stallion Hard Spun (Danzig). The Steve Asmussen-trained four-year-old won by a length over By My Standards (Goldencents), with favourite Mischievous Alex (Into Mischief) a further three-quarters of a length behind in third. "He's a Met Mile winner. That's what he is," Asmussen said. "We built it up to this point to get him in the shape he is today, and that will get him the credit he deserves. That's a great part of racing. You have to earn it, and that's what he did today." Hard Spun stood the 2021 season for \$35,000 (approx. AUD\$45,000) at Jonabell Farm.

US: Essential Quality lands Belmont Stakes

Godolphin celebrated further big-race success on the weekend as Essential Quality (3 c Tapit - Delightful Quality by Elusive Quality) returned to winning ways with a one-and-a-quarter-length win in the Belmont Stakes (12f) on Saturday. The Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) hero of last year during an unbeaten two-year-old campaign, Essential Quality began his three-year-old year with wins in the Southwest Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) and Blue Grass Stakes (Gr 2, 9f) before tasting a first defeat when fourth in the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) behind Medina Spirit (Protonico). However, he returned in style for trainer Brad Cox, beating Hot Rod Charlie (Oxbow) with the pair drawing a further 11 and a quarter lengths clear of the field, as Rombauer (Twirling Candy) filled third spot. "This is unbelievable. This is what it's all about—the classics. Obviously, it's my first taste. Unbelievable," said Cox. A

Darley homebred, Essential Quality is out of the stakes placed Delightful Quality (Elusive Quality), herself a half-sister to Grade 1-winning juvenile Folklore (Tiznow).

US: Domestic Spending continues to make a splash

Chad Brown landed the quinella in the Manhattan Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) at Belmont on Saturday as Kingman (Invincible Spirit) four-year-old Domestic Spending (4 g ex Urban Castle by Street Cry) continued to build an enviable record with his third Grade 1 success of his career. Sent off the 6-4 favourite, Domestic Spending defeated Tribhuvan (Toronado) by two and three-quarter lengths, with Gugo (Declaration of War) third, four lengths behind the winner. Domestic Spending was a 300,000gns Tattersalls Book 1 Yearling buy for Klaravich Stables from the Highclere Stud draft and Brown compared him to 2019 race winner Bricks and Mortar (Giant's Causeway). "He's starting to look that way on his form. I hate to

use that comparison with Bricks and Mortar because they're so rare to come by and you don't want to say that the next one you have is the same ... But boy, he's on his way," said Brown. "He's gotten stronger and is going farther than we thought when he was a younger horse, like Bricks and Mortar. He just keeps progressing along. I'm so proud of him." Toronado's (High Chaparral) runner-up Tribhuvan was a winner of the Fort Marcy Stakes (Gr 2, 9f) last month.

US: Letruska marches on

Letruska (5 m Super Saver - Magic Appeal by Successful Appeal) backed up her Apple Blossom Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) win at Oaklawn in April with success in the Ogden Phipps Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at Belmont on Saturday. Letruska, the 6-5 favourite, beat the Brad Cox-trained pair Bonny South (Munnings) and Shedaresthe devil (Daredevil) by margins of two and a half lengths and a length. The daughter of Super Saver (Maria's Mon) was winning for the third time in four starts this year.

Confidence high in Ready 2 Race Sale as entries open for October auction

BY ALEX WILTSHIRE

Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales Sebastian Hutch believes the Inglis Ready 2 Race Sale can go from strength to strength as entries open for the two-year-old sale today.

Last year the sale delivered astonishing metrics, with gross figures the highest-ever for a two-year-old sale in Australia at \$11,642,000, while the average of \$97,017 was also a record and the top lot of \$610,000 was the largest sum paid for a two-year-old at an Australian sale in more than a decade.

The results seen at last year's 226-lot catalogued sale acted as the precursor to phenomenal results at the subsequent yearling, weanling and breeding stock sales in 2021. Yet, despite that making it harder for pinhookers to source stock to trade on at the two-year-old sale, Hutch believes the quality of the prospects on offer will remain high and demand strong.

Prominent consignor Matt Vella, who sold a \$550,000 Capitalist (Written Tycoon) gelding last year, has purchased yearlings for up to \$100,000 at this year's yearling sales, including colts by Russian Revolution (Snitzel) and Deep Field (Northern Meteor), while Blake Ryan went to \$160,000 for a colt by Pariah (Redoute's Choice).

"There's no disputing the fact that the yearling market being so strong has made it more difficult for traders to source stock, but I think the professionals and the huge number of participants involved has meant they have been continuously scouring the market for appropriate stock and no doubt it will

accumulate in sufficient numbers of quality horses to target to towards the sale," said Hutch.

"I think, fundamentally, the demand in the market is driven by a demand for quality stock and I think that's consistently been the case. The lengths to which people are prepared to go to identify and purchase quality stock appears to know no bounds."

A notable feature of the 2020 sale was the increased participation of the domestic market, with high-profile buyers such as bloodstock agents James Harron, Guy Mulcaster and Bevan Smith, along with trainers Mick Price, Bjorn Baker, Gerald Ryan and Annabel Neasham, with 61 per cent of the buying bench from a domestic source.

This increase was due, in part, to the barriers to participation of the traditionally strong Asian market, however Hutch sees it as a trait set to continue as the success of the sale becomes ever more apparent.

"We saw it at the Ready 2 Race sale last year where there was incredible domestic

participation and I think we are confident that can continue to be the case. There is no reason for that to change," said Hutch.

"People want to race good horses ...

graduates of our sale have done exceptionally well in the last 24 months. There are a number of high class two-year-olds out of last year's sale already, so I think buyers are going to be confident that they are acquiring stock that's been well managed, well developed and the people that are preparing this stock are performing to extremely high levels."

Last year's sale has unearthed juvenile stakes winners Lightsaber (Zoustar) and See You In Spring (Siyouni), while recent graduates include Nettoyer (Sebring) and Hong Kong star Wishful Thinker (I Am Invincible).

The prospect of the increased return of Asian buyers is expected to make the buying bench stronger still and Hutch believes the prospective quality on offer at this year's sale could unearth yet another star graduate.

"We're going to have a broad cross section of people involved. It's a sale we're absolutely committed to and have put a hell of a lot of work into. And it's a format that can evolve," said Hutch.

"We could be talking about another high-class horse emerging from the sale in years to come."

O'Brien breaks Derby duck as St Mark's Basilica romps away with Prix du Jockey Club

Aidan O'Brien landed one of the few major European races previously missing from his résumé when St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni) ran out an impressive winner of yesterday's Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m) at Chantilly.

The winner of the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m) bagged a second French Classic as he enjoyed a charmed passage from his low draw in stall two, the favourite stretching out under Iortiz Mendizabal in the closing stages to score by a length and three-quarters from outsider Sealiway (Galiway). Millebosc (Le Havre) flew home late to finish a short head behind the runner-up in third.

Carrying the same purple and white silks of Derrick Smith as Friday's freakish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Snowfall (Deep Impact), St Mark's Basilica (3 c ex Cabaret by Galileo) was winning for the third successive time in Group 1 company, having won the Dewhurst Stakes (Gr

1, 7f) at Newmarket on his final start at two. His overall record now stands at four wins, a second and a third from seven starts.

He also becomes just the fourth horse to complete the French Guineas and Derby double since yesterday's race was shortened in trip in 2005, joining Shamardal (Giant's Causeway), Lope De Vega (Shamardal) and Brametot (Rajsaman).

"We were delighted with him the last day and obviously delighted today going up another couple of furlongs," O'Brien told Sky Sports Racing.

"He relaxes and he quickens and he is a very easy horse to manoeuvre in a race. He is a very intelligent horse and to have the pace he has and to quicken, that is what makes him a special horse.

"He is out of a Galileo mare and by Siyouni and I think he has the qualities of both of them.

Mendizabal, who was capturing the race for a second successive year following his victory on the John Gosden-trained Mishriff (Make

Believe) 12 months earlier, said: "This morning I spoke with Aidan and he was very confident.

"I came [to win] a little bit early but he was the best horse in the race, the only question was the distance. But that was no problem.

"For me he is a very good horse and he has a chance over further in another two or three months."

A half-brother to O'Brien's English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner and subsequent Coolmore stallion Magna Grecia (Invincible Spirit), St Mark's Basilica is the seventh foal out of the Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Cabaret, a Group 3 winner over seven furlongs at two, who herself is a half-sister to the Group 3-winning Drumfire (Danehill Dancer). Bred by Bob Scarbrough, he fetched 1.3million guineas when sold at Tattersalls Book 1 Sale in October 2019.

Siyouni, the perennial French champion sire, is available at Haras de Bonneval during the second semester of 2021 to cover mares on a southern hemisphere schedule at a fee of €100,000 (approx. AUD\$157,230).

Sha Tin double gives Fownes vital breathing space

Buoyed by a timely show of strength, Caspar Fownes is taking nothing for granted despite edging to a three-win lead over John Size in the battle for the Hong Kong trainers' championship after scoring a double at Sha Tin yesterday.

Fownes' hopes of annexing a fourth trainers' crown were boosted with The Rock (Dutch Art) and Seven Heavens' (Frankel) victories, leaving the 2006/07, 2008/09 and 2013/14 champion shading Size 68-65 with ten meetings left in the season.

"I'm happy. I'm just getting there. Like I said before, it's going to be close. I'm just having my run again - which is expected - and long may it continue for the rest of the season," Fownes said.

"There's still a long way to go."

Fownes has prepared five winners from his past 29 starters, while 11-time champion Size's most recent triumph - Courier Wonder (Scared Falls) on May 23 - has been followed by a 32-race run of outs.

The Rock provided Chad Schofield with his 24th success of the 2020/21 season as Joao Moreira (138 wins) and Matthew Poon (33) shared riding honours with doubles.

"We tried to go forward with not much pace on paper. He took a bit of time to get there in the long run to the first turn but they left me alone and I was able to rate him as I liked," Schofield said of The Rock.

"I picked it up when I wanted to and, to the horse's credit, when I pushed the button, he gave me a good spurt - strong win."

David Hayes appears to have unearthed another decent talent after Packing Award (Shamus Award) raced erratically but was still able to win the Class 4 On Yam Handicap (1400m) for Zac Purton despite jumping from barrier 12.

"He did a great job today because he threw

his head for 600 metres, resenting the tempo and you don't often see them do that so badly and win," the dual Hong Kong championship-winning trainer said.

"He's on holiday now and will be produced next season and it will be exciting to see what he can do. To come from a wide gate and win like that, he must have a couple of classes in him."

Paul O'Sullivan attributed Fairy Floss' (Guillotine) victory in the Class 4 Ping Tin Handicap - the grey's fourth success from his past six starts - to maturity and the genius of Moreira, who brought up a double on the gelding.

"He's a horse who took a long time to adjust to Hong Kong," O'Sullivan said. "He's more relaxed now and he's found his groove. It was a good solid win today and he had a lot against him. He was out in the draw (gate 14) and it was actually an excellent ride by Joao Moreira."

"That's the end of the season for him now, but he's done a great job."

A change in tactics by Frankie Lor enabled Infinite Power (Smart Missile) to break through in the Class 4 On Ting Handicap (1200m) under Poon, who logged his second double for the week after a brace at Happy Valley on Wednesday.

"He's a big horse who likes to keep rolling, so we decided to lead on him today," Lor said. "He seems to like being ridden that way. Sometimes, in the past, he has been close in the running but hasn't been able to finish off."

Alex Lai posted his fourth winner of the season when Moon Peaks (Choisir) landed the Class 5 Po Tin Handicap (1200m) for Me Tsui before the Fownes-trained Seven Heavens broke a 23-start run of outs with victory in the Class 4 Mei Tin Handicap for Moreira.

"He's been frustrating but it's great to see him win, especially like that," Fownes said. "His ranking should be close to 80 and he was below 60 (57) heading into this race - it's great to see him win again."

Tony Cruz expressed a similar sentiment after Joyful Fortune (Nicconi) overcame a string

of leg injuries to win the Class 3 Kwong Tin Handicap (1000m) under Poon.

"He's had so many problems, so many injuries," Cruz said. "So, it's very satisfying to win like this and run a fast time (55.26s)."

Apprentice Jerry Chau continued an excellent season by logging his 44th win for the term by driving Benno Yung's Sure Win Win (Deep Field) along the fence to snare the Class 5 Yan Tin Handicap (1600m, dirt).

"It was a terrific ride, just terrific - it was brilliant," Yung said, who snaffled a double when Diamond Brilliant (Not A Single Doubt) and Karis Teetan upstaged Winner Method (Deep Field) and Drops Of God (Mossman) to land the Class 3 Lai On Handicap (1200m).

"(Diamond Brilliant) he has got ability but stops in races and slows down himself. This horse, once he has a target in front of him, he will keep running so that's why I told Karis to keep chasing Zac's horse (Winner Method)."

"You have to win the race at the right time because this horse will just follow others."

Frenchman Tony Piccone savoured his ninth victory of the season when Dennis Yip's Kasi Farasi (Reward For Effort) surged late to overhaul Leap Of Faith (Sebring) right on the line to clinch the Class 3 Lee On Handicap (1400m).

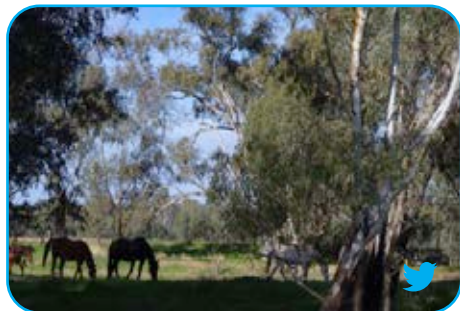

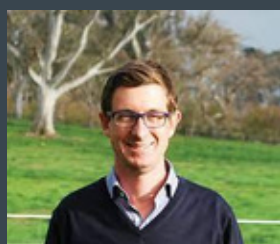
