Capitalist on top as record spending continues at Classic

*New benchmark set as Harron pays \$600,000 for a son of his
Golden Slipper gun during buoyant opening session*

A record opening session of the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale yesterday proved that the immense demand for Australian bloodstock is showing no signs of abating and confirmed that

the company's first auction of the year has a growing reputation among the industry's major players as a legitimate source of top-flight racing prospects after a new benchmark was set during a fervent day of trade.

A colt by Capitalist (Written Tycoon) became the highest-priced yearling to pass

through the Classic sale when realising \$600,000 at Riverside Stables yesterday afternoon, continuing a sparkling weekend for the Newgate Farm stallion, who on Saturday shot to the head of the first season sire and two-year-old tables through the deeds of his Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m)-winning son Profiteer.

The previous sale record was held by a Murrulla Stud-consigned Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) colt, who was sold for \$550,000 in 2019, but it was two leading industry figures with a close association to Capitalist, himself among a high-class generation of new stallions, who helped to set the new mark.

James Harron, whose high-end syndicate raced the son of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) to win the 2016 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), signed for the session-topper after locking horns with another big admirer of the stallion, Newgate Farm principal Henry Field.

"When we went back and looked at our ratings and Capitalist is the hot sire on the block, there were going to be a lot of people on him," Harron said.

"It's a very strong market and there's big demand for colts and you've got to aim up if you want them.

"He gave us all such an amazing ride. We still have a long way to go, but we've followed them all very closely and I think his yearlings will keep getting more expensive, so we will try and get as many as we can."

Describing the highest-priced acquisition of his three-yearling haul, all by Capitalist, Harron added: "He is very mature with great size, strength and substance to him with a good back page and we so often see that (pedigree) coming back alive. He's a lovely horse who is very forward."

The colt, offered as Lot 182 by Davali Thoroughbreds' David and Alison Hush, is the second foal out of the twice-winning mare Mystical

Tale (Encosta De Lago), while his third dam, Polar Success (Success Express), won the 2003 running of the Golden Slipper.

Alison Hush was taken aback when learning that Davali now holds the honour of selling the highest-priced Classic yearling.

"He was a nice foal and he just grew the right way at the right time. We probably could have taken him to other sales but we thought this was the place to take him to be a standout and that was the way it turned out," Hush said.

Davali Thoroughbreds is based on the Twin Palms Stud property at Luskintyre, which the Hushes lease from the Johnson family who also owned Polar Success.

"They have supported us with some really nice mares and backed us all the way through, so it's awesome to have a great result for them," Hush added.

With some of the biggest industry investors in the country at his disposal, Harron has the capacity to participate at the top of the market at all of the yearling sales, but he says the record of Classic sale graduates meant he had to be at this auction.

"We spend a lot of time doing our own research on the sale and we felt like we needed to be involved and make sure that we got some of horses we really like because it has been producing exactly what we are after in terms of good, precocious horses that go on and potentially find a home at stud," he said.

"Fair play to the team here at Inglis as they have really done a great job to get the sale to where it is and the graduates are getting the rewards."

Holding the honour as the leading first season sire by average at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and the overall title at New Zealand Bloodstock's Karaka Yearling Sale last month, Almanzor has a select representation at Classic. French stud Haras d'Etreham and Cambridge Stud will race the second highest-priced youngster from yesterday's session, who will be trained by Ciaron Maher and David Eustace.

Cambridge Stud chief executive Henry Plumptre called on Australian agent Jim Clarke for the final tick of approval before launching their bid.

"Henry spoke to me and said that they'd seen this horse on the farm in New Zealand a number of times and they really liked him," Clarke revealed.

"I saw him on the farm (at Lime Country) a few weeks ago and Henry asked for my thoughts and he was a lovely colt and I saw him again here at the complex and I thought he was one of the nicest physicals in the sale.

"The stallion is very, very exciting and I was lucky enough to watch him race when I was in Europe and he was one of the standout performers of that decade. He has been very well received so far and this colt is one of the nicest horses I have seen by him this year."

The colt was bred by James Chapman at Jamieson Park, a New Zealand farm that is a big supporter of Cambridge Stud and the local industry in general.

Catalogued as Lot 224, the Lime Country-consigned colt is the second foal out of Sydney winner Perfect Offering (Dubawi), herself a three-quarter sister to Listed winner My Country (Poet's Voice).

"He is a big, strong-bodied horse but he is very athletic for a big horse. He is a really laidback customer, so he's got all the credentials to be a really nice horse," Clarke said.

"He looks like he's got some precocity to get up and run early enough for a European-bred horse and he certainly has the scope to improve into his Classic year and beyond."

NSW Southern Highlands-based Lime Country has stepped up to assist New Zealand vendors at sales over the past nine months and that was again the case with Jamieson Park and its Classic draft.

"We had two horses for them back to back. Lot 223, the Per Incanto colt, had a big opening bid of \$200,000 and that probably checked the market and he made \$225,000. Then the Almanzor colt, I just loved," Lime Country's Jo Griffin said.

"He was an outstanding colt, he was really something special, I would have loved to have owned him."

She continued: "We sold for Jamieson Park up at Magic Millions and we sold for them here and they've got some very good horses coming to Easter as well.

"They are very good breeders and they are the sort of people you want to sell for. They have a beautiful farm and beautiful mares."

After day one of the third southern hemisphere yearling sale of the year, European champion Almanzor is averaging \$201,116 for his 46 yearlings to have changed hands.

Beauty Stable set to invade Australia with Moores at the helm

Hong Kong racing royalty, Simon and Patrick Kwok of Beauty Generation (Road To Rock) fame, could be about to make a significant mark on Australian racing, an investment that coincides with the return to Australia of the Asia hub's legendary trainer John Moore.

The bold statement was made before lunch during yesterday's session when Moore's agent-son George went to \$375,000 for a precocious colt by first season sire Invader (Snitzel), who is set to start his racing career at Rosehill under the tutelage of the trainer in partnership with his brother Gary.

The Kwoks launched a fleeting foray in Australian racing in 2018, including racing 2019 VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) fourth Beauty Bolt (Redoute's Choice), but since then they have focused almost solely on Sha Tin and Happy Valley. However, when John Moore's long Hong Kong reign came to an end last season, they elected to continue their association with the trainer in Sydney.

"They had quite a few horses in Australia. I think Grahame Begg had about five or six a few years ago, but (up until now) predominantly we haven't bought too many yearlings for them," George Moore said.

"I haven't bought any good yearlings for them in Australia before, but I said, 'instead of going over to Europe to buy horses who are going to take a bit more time, why don't you come to Australia? The budgets won't be too high, even though we went over budget there.

"We are trying to target three horses from around \$250,000 average, so I am just going to have to try and even it up with the next two yearlings."

<< *Continued from page 7* added: "He had 16 X-rays, so I knew there were quite a few people on the horse. I thought we were going to get him cheap at \$200,000, but James Harron was in front of me and he started bidding and once that happens it is a bit of a bidding war."

Catalogued as Lot 41, the youngster is the seventh foal out of Hussidora (Hussonet), making him a half-brother to the stakes-placed Schilladora (Artie Schiller) and Dreams Of Platinum (Dream Ahead). Vendor Bell River Thoroughbreds bought Hussidora carrying the colt from Stockwell Thoroughbreds at the Inglis Great Southern Sale in 2019.

Moore described the colt as fitting the mould he, his father John and uncle Gary were looking for.

"He had a great hip on him, he looks early, he has short cannons and he is a good mover," he said.

"It's a little bit of a risk being by Invader, an unproven first season sire, but at this sale you have to buy on type and even at the big sales you buy on type. He is a lovely horse."

Bell River's Ferguson family, who enjoyed success with Prophet's Thumb (I Am Invincible) in the Rubiton Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Caulfield on Saturday, continued their winning run with the sale of a So You Think (High Chaparral) colt for \$250,000.

"(Saturday) was a huge day, but we had to get back to reality this morning, shovelling horse s**t, but we've had two big results already today and hopefully it continues," James Ferguson said yesterday.

"We had \$150,000 on him and we would have been happy with that after buying the mare for \$62,000.

"This is one of the busiest sales we have ever been at and a lot of people had shown interest in him, but I didn't know how much, so to get that is unreal for the family and the farm and all of our clients."

Gilbert on a high after selling Capitalist filly



Lot 13 - Capitalist ex Gone To Paris filly

INGLIS

The sale of a Capitalist filly for \$300,000 earlier in the day did no harm to the harmony of the Gilbert family after Highgrove Stud consigned the six-figure yearling on behalf of studmaster Ron Gilbert's daughter, Vicki, and son-in-law, Liam Lourigan.

Gilbert's decision to wait an extra three weeks to put the filly through a sale was vindicated with the price tag after prominent owner BK Racing and Breeding signed for her.

"When the Magic Millions increased the catalogue to 1200 lots, we reassessed our draft thinking the market wouldn't be as strong as it is. She could have gone to the Magic Millions but I decided to spread them out and we brought her here because she was a standout filly and she has shown that by the price she made," Gilbert said.

"Magics had a lot of good horses and there's some good horses here as evidenced by the start of the sale. I think the good horses sell no matter where they are.

"We had a reserve well below the \$300,000 sale figure but we were expecting her to make somewhere between \$200,000 and \$300,000 and she made the top end, so everyone's very happy."

Having gone through the ring in the first half-hour of the sale as Lot 13, the filly will be trained by Joe Pride at Warwick Farm.

Her dam, dual winner Gone To Paris (Duporth) - herself a half-sister to the six-times stakes-placed Aristocratic Miss (Foxwedge) - was sourced for the Lourigans by agent Sheamus Mills. He went to \$230,000 for her from the Glenesk Thoroughbreds draft at the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale. She was then in foal to Astern (Medaglia D'Oro), with the resulting filly sold by Highgrove at last year's Classic sale for \$105,000.

Gilbert is a big fan of Capitalist, backing his judgment by sending Gone To Paris to the stallion in his second year at stud.

"I have been strong on Capitalist because of the first foals we had in his first season," the Queensland-based Gilbert said.

"We have supported him strongly and this filly is a good example of what he can throw, so hopefully she can go on and match motors with horses who are already coming out by Capitalist."

BK Racing and Breeding manager Ben Vassallo relied on Pride's assessment before having the conviction to win a competitive bidding duel.

"Joe felt she was the standout filly of the sale and we thought we would have to come into the ring and go up against those big guys and that is exactly what has happened," Vassallo said.

"These are sales where people pick a dozen or so classy ones out and you have to come in and fight for them. (Saturday's) result with Profiteer probably didn't help us much, but to get a horse by Capitalist into Joe's barn is a good thing.

"Joe has put the writing on the wall with his horses this season to get them to the races at two. It's such a progressive stable and they are always in form."

Record trade on day one of Classic

After increased demand saw the average, median and aggregate soar at the Gold Coast for the Magic Millions sale last month, the trend continued at Riverside yesterday, with the key metrics up on the corresponding session in 2020.

The average of \$106,030 was up 15 per cent on last year, while the median climbed from \$80,000 to \$90,000. A total of 235 horses were offered on day one, which resulted in 95 horses selling for \$100,000 or more, up from 79 during the opening session last year.

Seventeen yearlings also made \$200,000 or more, compared to nine last year, pushing the aggregate to \$21.418 million, the highest total grossed on a single day of trade at Classic as well as being up 21 per cent year-on-year.

Respected agent John Foote, who bought ten lots yesterday for domestic and international clients, suggested the colts market was a major reason behind the increased trade, which led to a clearance rate of 86 per cent.

"Buying colts is really hard and you have to pay a little bit more than normal. The fillies are a bit more sensible, but the colts are hard to buy," Foote said.

"The market at the Gold Coast was strong for a bit of everything really, but maybe the fillies don't have the pedigrees here that they did at the Coast whereas with the colts, there's a big demand for racing them here and in Asia."

Sebastian Hutch, Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing, could not hide his delight about what transpired yesterday.

"We were cautiously optimistic coming into today. We had done the work. We were very pleased with the calibre of horses here, there was

strong representation from buyers domestically and we worked hard to get international buyers involved," he said.

"I don't think any of us could have reasonably expected today to have gone as well as it's gone. As we sit here, to have cleared 86 per cent, for the average to be up something like \$20,000 on last year, it's almost incomprehensible at this stage."

Hutch credited the Inglis bloodstock team for compiling a desirable catalogue of horses in conjunction with vendors.

"It's not easy putting three somewhat simultaneous catalogues together in Classic, Premier and Easter, but it's something that I feel our team does really well," he said.

"We put a lot of effort into it, working with vendors to identify suitable horses for each of the sales, so to get here on day like today, and for the results to be as they are, is a great reflection of the calibre of work that the guys in the Inglis team have done. It's just really satisfying."

Day two of the Classic sale begins at 10am today.

42 for Written Tycoon

The Patrick Payne-trained Double You Tee (6 g ex Kandy Korn by Flying Spur) rewarded favourite backers when taking out yesterday's Hobart Cup (Gr 3, 2400m). Ridden by Jye McNeil, \$2.80 chance Double You Tee defeated Classic Weiwei (Shamus Award) by one and a quarter lengths, with Barade (Havana Gold) half a length further behind in third. The six-year-old gelding, who has now won nine of his 41 starts, was sold by Armidale Stud at the 2016 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale for \$115,000 to John Blacker, while the performance earned Written Tycoon (Iglesia) his 42nd individual stakes winner. The veteran stallion stood last season at Arrowfield Stud for a fee of \$77,000 (inc GST) and with Woodside Park's recent announcement of a change in direction with its breeding stock, a decision is now eagerly awaited as to whether he will remain on the leading Hunter Valley nursery's roster next season.

Two for Fighting Sun

Consistent Tasmanian gelding Newhart (5 g ex Jestig by Commands) added to his growing record with a maiden stakes victory in yesterday's Thomas Lyons Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Hobart. The Leanne Gaffney-trained Newhart, who won the Devonport Cup (1880m) at his previous outing, is the second stakes winner for Sun Stud's late stallion Fighting Sun (Northern Meteor). In upstaging Tasmania's glamour mare Mystic Journey (Needs Further), who was sent off the \$1.20 favourite, Newhart took his career record to 14 starts for seven wins and five placings. There was a three and three-quarter length margin to spare over Mystic

Journey, with Blaze Fourth (Court Command) another one and three-quarter lengths away in third. Newhart was a \$60,000 purchase by Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds and New Zealand agent Paul Willetts at the 2017 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale from the draft of Fairway Bloodstock. Yesterday's result was the second time in as many outings this preparation that the 2019 All-Star Mile (1600m) winner Mystic Journey has been beaten at long odds-on. Her last win came in the WH Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley in September.

Ten for Shamus Award

The Lloyd Kennewell-trained four-year-old mare Ethical Solution (4 m ex Miss Ethics by Count Dubois) brought up a Group 3 win for Rosemont Stud stallion Shamus Award (Snitzel) when taking out the Bow Mistress Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Hobart yesterday. Ethical Solution, a sister to five-time winner Ethical Dilemma, took out the feature fillies and mares race on Hobart Cup Day in dominant fashion to become the tenth individual stakes winner for 2013 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) victor Shamus Award (Snitzel). Racing in the same colours as her sire, she continued the great run of success for Shamus Award's progeny. He also sired Ironedge to win a maiden over 1400 metres at Ballarat yesterday. Shamus Award stood for \$19,800 (inc. GST) at Rosemont Stud last season.

19 for Night Of Thunder

The unbeaten Scott Brunton-trained Hela (3 f ex Smooth Return by Redoute's Choice) landed her maiden stakes success with a dominant display in yesterday's Strutt Stakes (Listed, 2100m) at Hobart, becoming the 19th stakes winner for Darley's Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) and the

fourth from his sole southern hemisphere crop. A half-sister to last year's Hobart Cup winner Toorak Affair (Toorak Toff), \$1.40 chance Hela defeated Chequerboard (Fastnet Rock) by three and three-quarter lengths, with Mystique Falcon (Pride Of Dubai) a further four lengths back in third. Hela was a \$30,000 purchase by Brunton from the Alva Stud draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale. Night Of Thunder will stand at Kildangan Stud in Ireland for €75,000 (approx. AUD\$117,700) in 2021.

Moody could take on training partner

Twelve months into his return to the Victorian training ranks, Peter Moody has signalled that he may enter into a training partnership in the not-too-distant future. "That was probably one of the main reasons I made the decision to come back," Moody told Racing.com. "I've got a great assistant trainer, a young lady called Katherine Coleman, and her ambition is to train and I reckon she will certainly step up to be a training partner, probably sooner rather than later," Moody is building his base back from almost scratch with a large number of juveniles, including Oxley Road (Exceed And Excel), who is a brother to Group 1 winner Exceedance. "First and foremost, I want to get the stable up and running and develop relationships with clients," he said. Moody's long-time racing manager, Jeff O'Connor, who has been by his side through both his training incarnations, could also be one to take a co-training role at the stable. "I've certainly got a couple of people around me that could fill that void and there's no reason why the three of us couldn't work together, whether it's in a training partnership or a business partnership."

New intake of Explorer cadets begin journey

Today, 23 students from all states of Australia, including remote areas of the Northern Territory and Queensland, will enter the 2021 edition of the Explorer Cadetship Program and begin their journey towards securing their dream job in the thoroughbred industry. The Explorer Cadetship is the only entry-level education program of its kind in the world, covering both the breeding and racing sectors to give people a holistic view of the industry. Over the last two years, 65 students have been through Thoroughbred Industry Careers (TIC) programs with an 89% retention rate in the industry. Since the program's inception, leading racing stables and stud farms have benefited from it, with various students now among their highly valued full-time staff. Champion trainer Chris Waller is a great advocate of the program and said: "This program has raised my awareness as to how a well-run learning program can quickly influence an industry. I have been overwhelmed by the level of professionalism and dedication shown by the students of this cadetship. This is quite simply a very important step forward in the racing industry and will no doubt be followed by other industries with critical staff shortages."

NEW ZEALAND

Stakes test for House Of Cartier

Well-travelled mare House Of Cartier (Alamosa) will have her second start back in New Zealand at Tauherenikau today with trainer and co-owner Peter Didham looking for her to provide some answers on future plans he has for the valuable broodmare prospect. House Of Cartier will tackle the Wairarapa Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Listed, 1600m) after finishing second over 1400 metres first-up at Trentham last month. "She came home from John Sargent's in good condition, so I gave her the trial just to get a feel of where she was at," Didham said. "She went huge, running third under a hold which may have just taken a bit of the sprint out of her legs. They crawled early at Trentham and then sprinted home and although she got home nicely, I think she might have been able to win that day if she didn't have the trial. We were really happy with the run and she has improved out of it for (today)."

Magneto confirmed for Sistema

Trainer Steven Cole has confirmed that Saturday's Woburn Farm 2YO Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Magneto (Showcasing) will be aimed at the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ellerslie next month, with the trainer delighted at how the two-year-old colt has come through the run. "He travelled home on Saturday night and he couldn't have been in more of a rush to get to his feed bin, which is a great sign. He has bounced through the run, but he will be heading to a nice paddock at Haunui Farm for a few days before we bring him back to get ready for the Sistema Stakes at Ellerslie next month. He has been up a while so a freshen up will be good for him and when we see how he goes we will think about whether we try for the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes or put him out for a decent break," said Cole.

Concert Hall on the mend

Group 1 winning mare Concert Hall (Savabeel) is recovering well from her barrier mishap at New Plymouth on Saturday. Co-trainer Roger James admits he feared the worst as he watched his star crash through the outside fence after escaping from the starting gates prior to the start of the Taranaki Cup (Gr 3, 1800m). The last start Zabeel Classic (Gr 1, 2000m) winner was a hot favourite for the feature event and was calmly being loaded into her barrier when she suddenly lurched backwards, dislodging rider Danielle Johnson, before careering away from the start at full pace. "We brought her home last night and she had plenty of anti-inflammatories, but this morning she came out of her box and took us for a walk which was so pleasing to see," James, who trains in partnership with Robert Wellwood, said. "It was just one of those freak things and we are thankful to have the end result that we have now." Concert Hall will be on the easy list for the next few days as the trainers and owner Joan Egan discuss their future options for the mare, who was headed for a tilt at the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington on March 6.

Ellis buoyed by widespread ownership interest

Te Akau principal David Ellis CNZM retained his leading buyer status for the 16th

consecutive year at the recently completed New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sales Series at Karaka and says he is thrilled with the healthy level of ownership interest in his home country. Ellis made 39 purchases at the sale that commenced a day after Te Akau trainer Jamie Richards saddled On the Bubbles (Brazen Beau) to win the \$1 million Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) and provide the stable their fifth consecutive victory in the race. Ellis purchased yearlings at a wide range of prices at Karaka from the sale topping \$800,000 for a Zoustar (Northern Meteor) filly to \$20,000 for a Tavistock (Montjeu) colt. "I buy because I like the horse as an individual and sometimes you're pleasantly surprised to get them under budget, while other times you have to pay a bit more to buy the ones you want. I thought the sale overall was an outstanding success. Quite incredible really, when in a pandemic, I was so proud to be a New Zealander and see a New Zealand company (New Zealand Bloodstock) absolutely nail it in everything they did." Given the success of Te Akau horses recently in Australia, headed by Group 1 winners Melody Belle (Commands) and Probabeel (Savabeel), Ellis is now fielding interest and seeing a positive flow-on effect. "We've got a lot of investment from Australia in the last ten days, at all levels," he said.

Karate (5 h ex Lady No Punch by French Deputy) provided To The Glory (King Kamehameha) with his first stakes winner when taking out the Tokyo Shimbun Hai (Gr 3, 1600m) yesterday. The Yoshiyasu Takahashi-trained Karate arrived at Tokyo chasing a hat-trick after successive wins at Nakayama and he was made to work hard for his first stakes success after encountering trouble in-running. Karate tracked the leaders for the majority of the straight before running out of room, forcing jockey Akira Sugawara to shift him to the right. Sugawara then surged him through a narrow gap to defeat Cathedral (Heart's Cry) by a head, with Shadow Diva (Heart's Cry) a length and a quarter further back in third. To The Glory, a three-time Group 2 winner during his race career, has sired 92 winners from 159 runners.

Favourite Bob And Jackie (Twirling Candy) finished second, half a length in front of Border Town (War Front) in third.

148 for Medaglia D'Oro

It was a super Saturday for Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado), who sired his 147th and 148th

individual stakes winners courtesy of Risk Taking (3 c ex Run a Risk by Distorted Humor) in the Withers Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) at Aqueduct and Moonlight D'Oro (3 f ex Venetian Sonata by Bernardini) in the Las Virgenes Stakes (Gr 3, 1m) at Santa Anita. The Bill Mott-trained Candy Man Rocket (3 c ex Kenny Lane by Forestry) followed up his last-start maiden success with a comfortable win in the Sam F Davis Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Tampa Bay Downs on Saturday, earning Lane's End's stallion Candy Ride (Ride The Rails) his 97th individual stakes winner. Ridden by Junior Alvarado, the three-year-old colt finished a length ahead of stablemate Nova Rags (Union Rags) in second, with Hidden Stash (Constitution) a further neck behind in third. The Argentinian-bred Candy Ride, who has sired 16 elite-level winners, will stand at Lane's End Farm in Kentucky for USD\$75,000 (approx. Bred in Ireland and bought from Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale for £325,000 in 2018, the Klaravich Stables-owned Counterparty Risk, who is out of a half-sister to Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Steel Prince (Nathaniel), justified odds-on favouritism to defeat New York Girl (New Approach) by a length, with Margaret's Joy (English Channel) another length and a half behind in third. Australia, a three-time Group 1 winner including the 2014 Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f), has sired two top-level winners to date in Order Of Australia and Galileo Chrome. He will stand at Coolmore in Ireland for €25,000 (approx. AUD\$32,550) in 2021.

Smokin proves too hot on return

Get Smokin (4 g Get Stormy - Hookah Lady by Smoke Glacken), winner of the Hill Prince Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) in October, proved too good for his 11 rivals in the Tampa Bay Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Tampa Bay Downs on Saturday. The Thomas Bush-trained gelding, who finished fourth in the Hollywood Derby (Gr 1, 9f) on his previous start, defeated Eons (Giant's Causeway) by three-quarters of a length, with Admission Office (Point Of Entry) a further neck behind in third. "We're thrilled. We were worried about the speed in there and I knew that one horse (Proven Strategies) would be a little bit of a thorn in our side today, but (Get Smokin) was ready today. We were pretty confident. (Junior Alvarado) rode a beauty for sure," Bush said. Get Smokin' is out of a half-sister to multiple stakes winner Spanish Pipedream (Scat Daddy), who was imported to Australia in 2017. Her Capitalist (Written

Tycoon) yearling was sold to Ciaran Maher Bloodstock for \$475,000 at last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

UK: Prince Of Arran third on return

Prince Of Arran (Shirocco) made his first start since finishing third in November's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on the all-weather at Kempton on Saturday evening. The Charlie Fellowes-trained gelding lined up the All-Weather Championships Fast-Track Qualifier (2m) and was beaten three-quarters of a length into third, finishing behind Rainbow Dreamer (Aqlaam) and Ocean Wind (Teofilo) in what was a very steadily-run affair. The three-time Melbourne Cup placegetter will now travel to Saudi Arabia where he will tackle the Red Sea Turf Handicap (3000m) in Riyadh on February 20, before heading to Dubai for the Dubai Gold Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) at Meydan on March 27.

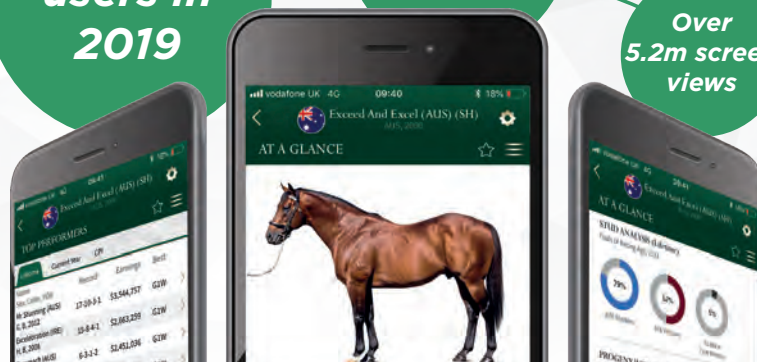

Jeremy Rogers is a self-confessed racing nut. The son of a racing journalist, he grew up in South Australia and has lived and breathed the game since he was a young boy.

"I've been going to the races since I was five years old and have always loved racing.

"Apart from my eight-year-old son, racing is my whole life. I have three channels on my TV at home, Fox Footy, the cricket and racing. I wouldn't know what's happening in the world," laughed Rogers.

A lifetime of observation and study paid off for Rogers on Saturday at Randwick when Profiteer (Capitalist) skipped away to win the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m).

It was his astute horse judgement that saw Roll The Dice Racing take a risk and venture above their usual budget to purchase the Capitalist (Written Tycoon) colt at last year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

"I did like him a lot. He had a great attitude. I saw him two to three times. Every time he just got out and walked, there was never any jacking up or jumping around and he just did his job. He had a good walk, a good body and he was a nice horse.

"He looks a lot like his father and is out of a stakes-placed Snitzel mare. I thought if he's any good he does have the pedigree of a stallion."

Foote as the greatest influences on his ability to select top horses. He worked closely with the esteemed pair during his tenure with the Darren Weir stable.

With the benefit of that experience and using the knowledge he's acquired through stints with Waikato Stud, Shadwell Stud and Derrinstown Stud in Ireland, he's been successfully specialising in selecting yearlings for the past ten years.

Profiteer is shaping as the best horse he's ever picked out and now the liver chestnut flying machine is favourite for the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Should he win the world's richest two-year-old race, his value as a future stallion at Newgate Farm, where he was bred and raised, will be assured.

Newgate's managing director Henry Field, who only recently crunched a deal with the colt's large syndicate of owners to secure him for his roster, couldn't have timed his run any better.

"He's certainly the real deal and couldn't have been more impressive. He was quite phenomenal," said Field of Profiteer's blistering success at Randwick on Saturday.

Now at the top of the current crop of two-year-olds racing in Australia, Field remembers

Profiteer being a standout when he was younger.

"He was a gorgeous foal and developed into a nice yearling. He was a really clean, good moving, nice horse. We brought him to that sale to be a stand out Capitalist of the sale.

On the advice of Rogers, Roll The Dice Racing paid \$165,000 for Profiteer, making him the dearest horse they have ever purchased at a yearling sale and that's already paid off in spades with a rich stallion deal now done.

Next, they are hoping the horse can emulate his sire Capitalist by winning the Slipper and also deliver the syndication company its first Group 1 winner on March 20 at Rosehill.

Hong Kong cast-off Grand Fighter impresses with stylish debut win

Covid-19 has brought racing on its knees, but every now and then you hear of positive fallouts for some uplift, and Grand Fighter (Per Incanto) is one of them.

The son of Per Incanto (Street Cry) was originally bought for Hong Kong interests last year, but when the pandemic struck the deal fell through.

The four-year-old eventually ended up with Singaporean handler Leslie Khoo. Hong Kong's loss has turned out to be Singapore's gain with Grand Fighter making it an instant payday at his very first race in the \$20,000 open maiden over 1200 metres at Kranji yesterday.

While his barrier trials had not been bad at all (four placings from as many trials), punters had somehow shied away from him given his generous odds of \$114, but they are likely to heed his presence better from now on.

Hot on the heels of Who Loves Bae (Deep Field) from the off, Grand Fighter bided his time before sweeping past Desmond Koh's well-trying debutant upon straightening to charge towards a comfortable two-length win.

Who Loves Bae held on stoutly for second place, three-quarters of a length clear of the odds-on favourite Malibu Beach (Malibu Moon). The winning time was 1:12.53 for the 1200 metres on the Polytrack.

"He's a good horse that was bought for Hong Kong, but when Covid-19 came, he couldn't go

there. So we raced him here instead," said Khoo.

"I was not very confident as I thought Who Loves Bae Malibu Beach would be hard to beat.

"Still, I told the jockey to jump well and sit handy. If the others want to go forward, just let them go and do your best.

"In the straight he got to the front, but when the other horse came again, he wanted to go again.

"I think he'll keep improving from today's run."

Khoo's yard was on song yesterday after they completed a double with Super Ray (Nadeem) four races later in the \$30,000 Class 5 race over 1200 metres.

The five-year-old's success also turned out to be a lucky pick-up ride for A'Isuhairi Kasim after champion jockey Vlad Duric was stood down by order of the doctors a couple of races earlier.

A'Isuhairi was also recording a brace after he saluted earlier aboard Kinabalu Warrior (Warrior's Reward).

Whiz Fizz breaks drought for Peters' Argentinian youngsters

English trainer James Peters had learned to curb his enthusiasm from the glowing trackwork shown by his Argentinian babies thus far, but Whiz Fizz (Orpen) finally bucked that trend, much to his great delight yesterday.

Forward enough in his workouts and barrier trials (won the last one on January 28), the grey three-year-old franked that form at his debut run in the \$75,000 restricted maiden (1100m), unlike his other Hardwicke Racing Club stablemates like Tesoro Pirata (Orpen) and Pini Pons (Suggestive Boy), both of whom have been unable to live up to early promise shown in trackwork.

Bustled up early from his wide alley to go and sit outside leader Bad Boy Black (Gingerbread Man), Whiz Fizz (\$76) was quick to put in the big bounds the moment jockey Juan Paul van der Merwe slipped some rein at the top of the straight.

The issue was put beyond doubt as he skipped clear to a two-length win from the fast-closing Con Speranza (Tavistock), another newcomer, with Fighting Hero (Tavistock) another one length away in third. The winning time was 1:05.35 for the 1100 metres on the Polytrack.

"To be honest, I've been left scratching my head with those Argentinian horses," said Peters.

"They all work well, but that form is not translated on raceday. That's why I was apprehensive about this one as well as he's also shown us ability on the tracks.

"He had some niggly issues like shin soreness and he was backed off a couple of times, but he's obviously come good really well.

"Whatever he did today, he will improve on fitness-wise. He's still new and he's a very nice prospect for the stable.

"A big thank you to Justin Vermaak who picked this horse and manages this racing group."

Van der Merwe is a close friend of the fellow South African and racing manager, but was pleased he had ridden a first winner for him.

"I was riding in Mauritius when Justin started to race horses back home. I know him more as a friend, this is my first winner for him," said the South African jockey.

"The horse had a wide draw, he jumped okay and I had to wake him up a little but he was able to get a nice spot outside the leader.

"He travelled well. I thought he went to the front too early, he had his ears pricked and was looking around, but the ability is there."
