Quality stock the safest bet at Inglis Australian Weanling Sale

Cloud of uncertainty hangs over first foal market of the year

endors and speculators involved in the Inglis Australian Weanling Sale agree that horses deemed of quality will remain highly sought after, but the prevailing uncertainty ahead of the opening session has experienced stakeholders reluctant to make bold predictions about what will unfold once the auction begins.

The 385-lot sale, the southern hemisphere's first public weanling offering this year, could at

least provide some further insight as to what those willing to financially back their judgment by securing young stock believe lies ahead for the local industry heading into the 2021 Australasian yearling sale series.

Despite the absence of Victorian agents and their New Zealand counterparts due to restrictions caused by the coronavirus pandemic, the number of inspections at Riverside Stables yesterday was strong, and how far buyers are willing to go will be revealed over the next two days.

<< Continued from page 1 Pinhook Bloodstock's Dave Mee, like most, is not going into the sale with a concrete plan but suggested a tried and true approach could serve he and his clients best.

"I am on both sides of the equation because I am managing clients who are selling and I have a couple of groups who are looking to buy," Mee said.

"With one eye to the yearling sales, there's still a lot of moving parts to it and the honest answer is no one knows how it is going to play out next year. So, broadly speaking, we are going to stick to quality and play the numbers game.

"I've come here with a strategy in mind for my clients, but having been here for several days digesting what everyone is saying about the industry and the outlook maybe it's time to readjust a few things."

For the past three years Fairhill Farm's Mike O'Donnell has put his entire foal crop through the Australian Weanling Sale and he will do so again in 2020 with a draft of 28 which includes a Pierro (Lonhro) half-sister to Group 2 winner Fiesta (I Am Invincible) and a Vancouver (Medaglia d'Oro) half-brother to the Group 1-placed Trusting (Tale Of The Cat).

He plans to "play it by ear and we will have to assess how the market is going" when determining the reserves he places on his stock.

"We are all uncertain in these times but there has been enough inspections. People who are here are here to buy, they aren't here for fun, so that's a plus," O'Donnell said.

"We are selling all of our crop, which makes a difference because they are all being sold for the right reasons. There are no culls."

Jazcom Thoroughbreds' Colin Branthwaite, who on Sunday sold a Toronado (High Chaparral) colt at the Riverside Stables Scone Yearling Sale for 18 times his weanling purchase price when bought by Hawkes Racing for \$180,000, intends to back his judgment by reinvesting at the sale over the next two days.

He was at Riverside Stables yesterday looking for his next potential rags-to-riches opportunity, his confidence boosted by "the luck we've had in the last three years", and he declared that he had not been turned off doing so despite economic downturn.


"The right horses will bring money and they will be well found, but the same people that you see at every sale are here and I am sure they will be buying horses if they like them," Branthwaite said.

"That is where we will come into play down the bottom of the market where we can scratch through them, do our notes and wait in the ring.

"Basically, buying in our market, you have to find an athlete and then look at the legs. You have to forgive. You can't be looking at legs if it's not an athlete. A lot of people in the higher market just can a horse if it's not 100 per cent."

Branthwaite says more vendors may be willing to part with their foals for under what they previously would have expected to receive because of the uncertainty of the market.

<< Continued from page 2 "There's going to be extra risk there for people wanting to buy because of the economic climate, but on the other side you have got vendors who pretty much haven't been able to sell a horse," he said.

"I am not saying they are bleeding or starving, but I am sure they are looking for a couple of bucks and they might let the odd one go for a few less dollars than what they usually would."

Middlebrook Valley Lodge's Verna Metcalfe, who is consigning a quality draft of weanlings by sires including So You Think (High Chaparral), Exceed And Excel (Danehill) and American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile), believes vendors will have to carefully consider their options if the depth of the buying bench is tested in the next two days.

"To me, we've got record inspections, so I think the good horses will sell well and people have just got to be realistic with reserves," she said.

"People have to remember, there is going to be a heap of yearlings trying to get into the sales next year and there's also horses coming from New Zealand who are going to get into next year's sales, so the market is going to be flooded."

Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch was optimistic that a competitive marketplace would occur with the company working closely with buyers who were unable to be on the ground but had expressed interest in participating in the market.

They include interstate and overseas investors, particularly from New Zealand.

"I still think we're going to see a well diversified buying bench, but people are going to be inherently conservative given the circumstances we find ourselves in," Hutch said.

"At this stage, the most commonly desired object on the salesground is a crystal ball to know what sort of market we're going to be selling into in 2021.

"The facts are that there's been over \$400 million worth of yearlings in Australia this year and that's a lot of money. So, even with a contraction of that market, there's still going to be a lot of money in the market in 2021.

"Certainly, the pinhooker wants to have the opportunity to get a piece of that money and for end users there's an opportunity to potentially buy some really nice horses at a discount.

"Graduates of the sale are evidence of that whether it's Redzel, Begood Toya Mother or Spright and countless other examples."

One aspect of the sale will be how the first season sires will be received and Hutch says the vendors have provided a quality representation of young stock by the new stallions.

"It's particularly exciting to see so many good foals here by some of the sexy stallions, whether it's Russian Revolution, Merchant Navy, Hellbent, there's some very good Highland Reel and Invader foals here and there's also Pariah, etc, etc," he said.

"There's also plenty of good foals here by the proven stallions as well. To have that great calibre of stock provides opportunity for us and, most importantly, for buyers."

The sale starts at 10am today.

Gooree reduction at Magic Millions

Gooree Park Stud will offer an unreserved draft of almost 40 lots across the upcoming Magic Millions National Broodmare, Yearling and Racehorse Sale, with race fillies to kick off the action on July 20. The Mudgee-based farm had originally catalogued a select draft for the sale but has now added 23 lots to boost their overall representation at the southern hemisphere's premier breeding stock auction. Among the supplementary lots are six race fillies by sires including I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), Lonhro (Octagonal) and Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock) and six broodmares - five of them in foal to US Triple Crown winning champion American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile). The yearling supplementary lots include colts by Exceed And Excel (Danehill) and Written Tycoon (Iglesia) as well as half or full relations to stars including Your Song (Fastnet Rock), Rock Sturdy (Fastnet Rock), Romantic Touch (Northern Meteor) and Burning Passion (Northern Meteor).

Consistent Southern Lad out for Ramornie glory

Southern Lad (Ocean Park) has been on the cusp of a victory through four placed efforts this campaign and John O'Shea believes he can finally get that elusive win in the Ramornie Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Grafton today. The gelding has finished second in the Wagga Town Plate (1200m), third in the At Sea Handicap (1100m), second in the June Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and third in the Winter Dash (1200m) this preparation. "All his runs this preparation have been really good," O'Shea

said. "He's probably desperate to get back on top of the ground. If you go through his form this preparation his best run was on a soft (7) and every other run has been on a heavy track. The drier the track, there's a strong correlation between his better performance." Southern Lad was \$6.50 third favourite with TAB last night.

Monash redemption on agenda for Jungle Edge

Rising ten-year-old Jungle Edge (Dubawi) will return to the races in Victoria for the first time since February as he aims for a seventh stakes win in the Sir John Monash Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Caulfield on Saturday. In the same race last year, Jungle Edge was in front before being caught by Oak Door (Commands) near the line. "I think he gets his chance this time," trainer Mick Bell said. "The track will be soft by the look of it and there doesn't seem to be any world-beaters amongst them, but in saying that these races are never easy to win. He seems to be in the race right up to his ears." Jade Darose, Jungle Edge's regular trackwork rider, will take her fourth raceday ride on the gelding; she won the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on him in February.

Prophet 'Ready' for Winter Stakes at Rosehill

Co-trainer Adrian Bott believes that Ready To Prophet (Smart Missile) can return to form with her return to Sydney as she prepares for Saturday's Winter Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Rosehill. Ready To Prophet was third at the course and distance in the Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) before two poor efforts in Brisbane when 11th in the Helen Coughlan Stakes (Listed, 1350m) and last in the Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). However, she has won a Randwick trial leading into Saturday's

contest. "She probably just found the tracks up in Queensland a bit too firm for her liking," Bott said. "You go back to her run before she went up there, she ran a pretty bold race in the Dark Jewel at Rosehill at odds. She can be a bit inconsistent with her form but she's capable of running a big race."

Second Australian winner for Kingman

The first European-bred son of Kingman (Invincible Spirit) to race in Australia won on debut yesterday when Kingsheir scored smartly at Newcastle. The Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes-trained Kingsheir, who races in the colours of Orbis Bloodstock, scored by almost two lengths over Requited (Vancouver). A northern hemisphere three-year-old, he joined the Australian-foaled Neptune's Choice to make it two winners from two runners for Kingman. Kingman will be represented by his first son to stand down in Australia this year with Coolmore's Calyx available at \$17,600 (inc GST).

Aquanita horses facing disqualification

Racing Victoria yesterday announced that 81 horses who came through the Aquanita Racing system face disqualification following the years-long investigation that resulted in the disqualification of trainers Robert Smerdon, Stuart Webb and Tony Vasil. The Smerdontrained mare Politeness (Street Sense) faces losing her status as a Group 1 winner with her victory in the 2015 Myer Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) under threat. Other Group 1 winners that will have performances examined are Mosheen (Fastnet Rock), Shamal Wind (Dubawi), Sniper's Bullet (Bite The Bullet), Under The Louvre (Excellent Art) and Green Birdie (Catbird), but all are for beaten efforts and do not involve their Group 1 wins. The managing owner of each starter will now receive a show cause notice about the findings and will be asked for a response before stewards decide final penalties.

Mystic Journey to return in Lawrence

Star Tasmanian mare Mystic Journey (Needs Further) will have her return delayed by three weeks, with an intended start in the Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on July 25 now off the agenda in favour of the P.B Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at the same track on August 15. "We've pushed that back, and probably for two reasons," Adam Trinder told RSN927. "Obviously the current situation in Victoria with recent outbreaks of Covid has put some indecisiveness into the decision but that being said, the (soft) ground that we saw presented at Flemington on Saturday, we just feel that ground in the Bletchingly might still be too easy for her. So the tentative plan now is to hold and kick her off in the Lawrence Stakes, which is the race she kicked off in last year and was fortunate enough to win." Mystic Journey is likely to trial in Tasmania in the next ten days.

Lung infection stalls Te Akau Shark

Last year's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) third Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) is a confirmed absentee from the 100th edition in October, with a lung infection following eye surgery causing concern. Jamie Richards said yesterday that, as long as there are no more issues, Te Akau Shark should be released from the equine clinic next week. "The plan is to spell him in NSW for probably three or four weeks to make sure everything is 100 per cent and then get him back to New Zealand," Richards told RSN927. "Then we will give him a break and get him ready for racing later in the summer and hopefully have him back to Sydney in the autumn." Richards was planning on having a small stable in Melbourne during the spring, but the Covid-19 flare-up may put paid to those plans. "The longer it goes on the more concerning it becomes," Richards said.



Peters sends four horses east

Perth stars Regal Power (Pierro), Arcadia Queen (Pierro), Perfect Jewel (Redoute's Choice) and Superstorm (Sebring) are on the road to Melbourne in preparation for the spring. Owner Bob Peters decided to send them early in order to avoid any interruptions due to Victoria's worsening Covid-19 situation. "If the horses don't go now, they can't go at all," Peters told Perth's TABradio. "As far as we're concerned, we are OK to get there, but we have to travel by truck, not by plane as would've been preferable. They're already on the road. There are always concerns as it changes every day, but hopefully things sort themselves out before we start racing our horses. Worst case scenario, they have to get on the truck and come home."

Rebecca Dunn injured in trackwork fall

Trainer Rebecca Dunn has been injured after

being dislodged during trackwork at Newcastle yesterday morning. Dunn sustained a coccyx injury as well as pain to her left knee and was transported to John Hunter Hospital.

VJA agree to template for whip penalties

Racing Victoria chief steward Robert Cram has given the VJA a template that was drawn up to provide jockeys clarity if they breach the whip rule. The Australian rule remains at no more than five strikes prior to the 100-metre mark then unlimited use to the winning post, but the template now removes any grey areas of overuse. It was generally conceded that if a jockey used the whip more than five times before the 100-metre mark, but less than 15 times in totality, a fine was issued. However if that total was over 15 then a suspension was handed out, and if the horse finished in the placings, a fine may also have been issued. The new template provides for suspensions and

Bright future for Aimee's Jewel

Trainer Trudy Keegan believes Aimee's Jewel (Proisir) is one to follow after the filly's five and a quarter length debut victory over 1200 metres at Awapuni on Saturday. Although she had a high opinion of her filly heading into the race, Keegan was delighted to see her judgment vindicated on Saturday. "We were over the moon, especially as she missed the jump. But that's just first starters for you," Keegan said. "She has got enough class and ability to be able to overcome getting things wrong. She is still very raw and there is a lot of improvement to come in her yet. We didn't expect her to miss the jump. She just pulled her head down apparently as the gates opened and did a bit of a rear and came out a bit unbalanced. For her to travel up like she did and to push up between runners and get in amongst it like that was fantastic to see."

Schofer back in business

Weight is the bane of many jockeys' existence, and late last year it became a bit too much for talented apprentice Hazel Schofer. The New Plymouth rider had been battling weight issues for some time and elected to take a break from racing. "My weight just got a bit out of control," she said. Schofer said she rediscovered her passion for racing on her hiatus, and those sentiments were reinforced last weekend. "That was my first raceday back since I took a break last year," Schofer said. "It was really nice to be out on raceday again. I really missed it and I noticed that being back on Saturday." Schofer is focusing a lot of her energy on maintaining her weight and has a strict exercise and diet regime in place to try and achieve that.

Yiu's still swinging as title challenge intensifies

Zac Purton has the jockeys' title more or less wrapped up but the trainers' race has plenty of vardage left with three race meetings to go, and Ricky Yiu is hoping to maintain his recent, dramatic form. Yiu is under intense pressure from Francis Lui's relentless pursuit, with the former leading the latter by one win - 64 to 63 - but each time Lui closes in, or ahead as he did at Sha Tin on Sunday, Yiu pulls one out of the fire late in the day. He will aim to repeat the trick at Happy Valley tonight, with Toycoon (Turffontein) primed to go in the finale and Eternal Harvest (Smart Missile) his candidate in the night's penultimate race. Vincent Ho will ride both. "Ricky is doing well winning those later races. Hopefully he can do it again because I want to win as well!" Ho said.

Three for Shalaa

Stepping up in trip from her debut last month, the Jessica Harrington-trained No Speak Alexander (2 f ex Rapacity Alexander by Dandy Man) was a decisive winner of the EBF fillies' maiden (7.5f) at Roscommon yesterday, and thus became the third individual winner for Arrowfield Stud shuttler Shalaa (Invincible Spirit). Tracking the pace, she made her move with over a furlong to run and drew clear with ease to beat the favourite Divinely (Galileo), the sister to multiple Group 1 winner Found, by six and a half lengths, while there was a further six lengths back to Dress Kode (Kodiac) in third. No Speak Alexander is the only foal out of Listed-winning sprinter Rapacity Alexander (Dandy Man), who herself is a sister to Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) victor Peniaphobia. Shalaa stands at Arrowfield for a fee of \$33,000 (inc. GST) in 2020 while his other winners include Shalaalaa, who ran fourth in the Marble Hill Stakes (Gr 3, 6f).

Nine for Sea The Moon

The Lloyd Williams-owned Pondus (4 g ex Diablerette by Green Desert) brought up his first black-type victory when winning the Lenebane Stakes (Listed, 1m 4f) at Roscommon yesterday, and in the process provided Lanwades Stud resident Sea The Moon (Sea The Stars) with his

ninth stakes winner. The Joseph O'Brien-trained gelding defeated Camphor (Camelot) by two and a quarter lengths with Helvic Dream (Power) coming home a further length and three-quarters away in third. Purchased by Stroud Coleman Bloodstock for 80,000gns at Book 3 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, Pondus is half-brother to the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Lord Belvedere (Archipenko). His dam, Diablerette (Green Desert) is a three-quarter sister to German Group 1 winner Lady Jane Digby (Oasis Dream). Sea The Moon stood at Lanwades for a fee of £15,000 in 2020.

151 for Pivotal

Cheveley Park Stud stalwart Pivotal (Polar Falcon) sired his 151st individual stakes winner yesterday when Romola (4 f ex Dianora by New Approach) took out the Pipalong Stakes (Listed, 1m) at Pontefract. The Sir Michael Stoute-trained mare defeated Iconic Choice (Sixties Icon) by a length with Salayel (Bated Breath) the same margin back in third. Bred and raced by Cheveley Park Stud, Romola is the only foal out of Dianora (New Approach) who herself is the daughter of dual Group 1 winner Nannina (Medicean). Further back, this is the family of 1990 Adelaide Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) victor Water Boatman (Main Reef) and Willow Glen Stud resident Pure Champion (Footstepsinthesand). Pivotal stood at Cheveley Park in Newmarket for a private fee in 2020.

Too Darn Hot brother set for debut

Darain (Dubawi) - the top lot at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in 2018 and brother to Darley shuttler Too Darn Hot - will face his first racecourse test when lining up in the Novice Stakes (Div II) (1m 2f) at Newbury tonight. There will be sharp contrast between the behind-closed doors meeting and the packed Park Paddocks sales ring where the son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) and Dar Re Mi (Singspiel) fetched 3,500,000gns, when signed for by David Redvers on behalf of Qatar Racing. Oisin Murphy will take the ride on the John Gosden-trained colt, who was bred by the Lloyd-Webbers' Watership Down Stud out of their exceptional racemare and producer Dar Re Mi, the Yorkshire Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) heroine whose runners are headed up by the exceptional miler Too Darn Hot and fellow Group 1 performers Lah Ti Dar and So Mi Dar, all of whom are by Dubawi.

New Zealand agents receive last-minute go-ahead to attend Magic Millions sale



Inspections at Magic Millions

ew Zealand agents Paul Willetts and Bevan Smith jetted into Australia yesterday, after receiving a last-minute lifeline from the Australian government to allow them to attend the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Sale later this month.

After initially having their travel exemptions rejected by the Australian Department of Home Affairs, as revealed in ANZ Bloodstock News last month, representation by Thoroughbred Breeders Australia with government authorities saw the decision reversed.

Smith and Willetts, along with Magic Millions auctioneer Steve Davis and former long-time Cambridge Stud manager and new Yulong recruit Marcus Corban, flew from Auckland to the Gold Coast to begin 14 days of hotel quarantine.

"It's all been a bit rushed. We only found out on the weekend that we could get over here and the first flight over was this morning," Smith said yesterday.

"I had given up hope and started to try and plan for the next couple of months of being in New Zealand, but I got a call on Saturday to say it was 'all go."

Smith was unsure whether the group would be allowed to leave the Surfers Paradise quarantine hotel on July 20, after the first session of the National mares sale, or early the following day.

"Having to serve the quarantine put a few other (New Zealand agents) off. I think we're going to miss the first day of the mares' sale, so that basically rules that out and makes it pretty hard.

"I don't think I'll be doing much on the mares side of things, but I might go there with a short shortlist and try and get something done.

"I will be mainly focusing on the weanlings with the time-frame."

Smith, Davis, Willetts and Corban were bused from the Gold Coast Airport to a Surfers Paradise hotel to undertake the quarantine.

"We had a temperature check on the way through and we had to have social distancing and face masks.

"The airport wasn't too extreme as it was basically the only flight coming in and it wasn't a very full flight, that's for sure, and I didn't have anyone else in the same row of seats as me.

"But when we got to the hotel there were police, there were camera crews. It was all pretty serious when we got down here."

Meanwhile, interstate trainers, including those from NSW, will be able to attend the Magic Millions National Sale without having to complete 14 days of quarantine.

In a statement released by Racing Queensland, the governing body said the new rules would come into effect from Friday.

This ruling is particularly relevant to NSW trainers who initially faced being locked out of attending the upcoming weanling and yearling sale due to industry regulations relating to the Covid-19 pandemic.

However, Victorian participants are still required to undertake 14 days of quarantine. Racing NSW also said, from this Friday, that any interstate licensee (excluding Victoria) can attend a racecourse and licensed premises in the state.

They must not travel by commercial aircraft to NSW on the day of the race meeting. Any Victorian resident or anyone who has travelled to that state since June 1 must undertake 14 days of isolation prior to being allowed to attend race meetings.

First crop sires seek to make their mark in Inglis Australian Weanling Sale

t has been said that we need just three things in life: Someone to love, something to do and something to look forward to. (What about something to eat?)

The third 'something', something to look forward to, certainly applies to thoroughbred racing and breeding. We are always looking forward to the next season, the next crop of two-year-olds or the next crop of foals. That next crop being the first crop of a new stallion simply adds another dimension.

Sixteen new sires are featured in this week's Inglis Australian Weanling Sale, starting at Riverside Stables today, and this year the anticipation might be heightened somewhat, due, in part, to Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock). However, his classmates have plenty of ammunition to fire and any one of them has the credentials to become a future champion or leading sire.

Ten of the 16 can claim a Group 1 success and eight of these elite performers were of sufficient class to manage more than one victory at the highest level. Of the remainder, all were either Group or Listed winners and six of them placed at Group 1 level.

In terms of Group 1 prowess, **Highland** Reel (Galileo) has the biggest bragging rights. This world traveller took his toughness to every continent, bagging seven Group or Grade 1 events. He raced against the best everywhere, including a third placing (as a three-year-old) in Australia's weight-for-age championship, the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), behind Winx (Street Cry). Yet he kept coming back for more, racing on until late in his five-year-old season; it was arguably his best season, still interested enough to score three Group 1s.

Of course buyers will have to be patient, despite his having won a Group 2 race at Goodwood as two-year-old, but he is by the hottest stallion in the world, Galileo (Sadler's Wells). Highland Reel has two lots in the sale.

Another son of Galileo, **Churchill**, won four times in the best class and was sufficiently precocious to score five from six as a juvenile including two of his four career Group 1s. While his three-year-old season didn't produce as many wins, the two he bagged were classics – Britain's 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and its Irish equivalent. Churchill has seven to represent him this week.

Also with four Group 1s to his credit is **Ribchester**, the son of Iffraaj (Zafonic). Shuttler Iffraaj has had great success in both hemispheres (72 stakes winners). Haunui Farm at Karaka, near Auckland, may have been disappointed not to have him back again but this year they will have a fitting replacement, his best-performed son.

Ribchester remained sound through his four-year-old season, which was also his best season, taking out three Group 1 miles – the Prix du Moulin (run at Chantilly in 2017), the Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot and the Lockinge Stakes at Newbury. He will have just the one weanling for sale.

Judging by the quality of first book mares that **Merchant Navy** attracted in 2018, he is due to enjoy a terrific sale. This high class sprinter (a

mere ten starts for seven wins) took his talent from a Flemington Group 1, the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) to Royal Ascot where he beat some the best sprinters in Europe in the Diamond Jubilee Stakes (Gr 1, 6f). He has nine listed for sale, representing some of the best families available.

Another exciting sprinter and - like Merchant Navy - a dual Group 1 winner, is **Russian Revolution** (Snitzel). The brilliant Russian Revolution's two premier efforts were over 1100 metres, namely the Galaxy Handicap (Gr 1, 1100m) at Randwick as a three-year-old and at four, the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) at Caulfield. He raced just 11 times, won seven and will have eight lots to represent him at Riverside.

The striking grey son of Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) and yet another dual Group 1 winner is **Caravaggio**. He was unbeaten in four starts at two, scoring the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at The Curragh as well as the Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) at Royal Ascot. Back to Royal Ascot at three he beat two outstanding sprinters, Harry Angel (Dark Angel) and Blue Point (Shamardal), with a big win in the Commonwealth Cup (Gr 1, 6f). He has four lots on offer this week.

Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact) was well above average in his homeland of Japan where he secured two Grade 3 and two Listed wins but in Australia he proved not only his soundness but also his class in winning twice at Group 1 level, his premier effort beating Happy Clapper (Teofilo) in the Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington. He has one lot in the catalogue.

There is one more new sire with two Group 1 victories and he is the second best-performed son (behind Pierro) of Lonhro (Octagonal), Impending. He ran nine times at the elite Group 1 level, won twice, was second once, third twice and was fourth three times. He gave his best against the best and just for good measure added two Group 2s in a brief career of 18 starts. Four lots by Impending are available.

In practically any other year, this first crop sire preview might be wrapped up but there are two more Group 1 winners to discuss.

The most represented among those (nine lots) is Invader (Snitzel), winner at two of the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick where he bested Champion 2017-18 three-year-old Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) by a length and half. At his last start at two he ran second, again at Randwick, in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

With six lots is Hellbent (I Am Invincible). After going close against the top sprinters in the land, the late-maturing speedster broke through at age five to claim his Group 1 victory in the William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Moonee Valley, a race he also ran second in the previous year. In all he won seven times.

Three Group 2 winners are represented: Time Test (Dubawi) scored twice, including the York Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 2.5f) and the Tercentenary Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) at Royal Ascot in track record time. His best placing in England was third in the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Sandown. As a five-year-old he raced three times in the state of New York and

twice finished second at Belmont and Saratoga against Group 1 company. There is one lot by Time Test.

Thronum (Snitzel), with two lots, scored his Group 2 win in the Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) where he also finished second in the William Reid Stakes behind Hellbent, Thronum won a further four including a Listed race at Randwick.

Menari (Snitzel), with one lot, beat first crop sire classmate Pariah (Redoute's Choice) in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) then ran second to Champion three-year-old Trapeze Artist in the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Rosehill, winning three in only eight career

Wrapping up the remaining four sires to be represented are three Group 3 winners: Pariah (Redoute's Choice), six lots, won two Group 3s, both at Rosehill and ran second to Catchy (Fastnet Rock) in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Supido (Sebring), two lots, won his at Caulfield, six other wins and also ran third in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) behind Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars). Jukebox (Snitzel), three lots, also put up his best run at Caulfield in the Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m), winning three plus three Group placings from eight starts.

Listed City Tatts Club Lightning Handicap (1100m) winner Spieth (Thorn Park), with five lots, won five races in total and was Group 1 placed twice at Flemington, in the Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and the Darley Classic (Gr 1, 1200m).

In all, a super collection of well-performed young stallions and their future will indeed be something to look forward to.

Value to the fore in English carnivals

rize-money aside, there's a myriad of reasons why English racing - so wonderfully showcased to southern hemisphere insomniacs in recent weeks - is intrinsically beautiful.

On top of the list is that the majority of races are run at a strong, rolling gallop which allows the contest to unfold and the best to often prevail. This is in stark contrast to the ugly, stop-start, dash-home races - even the so-called sprints - we endure in this country.

Second, is the beguiling variety of tracks from Ascot to Epsom, which have held court in recent weeks, and now on to Newmarket this week for the July meeting.

Thirdly, it's the fact that unexpected outcomes are rarely considered possible by the pundits and punters, which is reflected in extraordinary odds offered against many runners who do not fit the formulaic mould of a likely winner.

These three factors - along with the omnipresent influence of the prepotent Galileo (Sadler's Wells) - came together in the Derby at Epsom last weekend which saw first and third go off at 25/1 and 66/1 respectively despite being trained by Aidan O'Brien (and being by Galileo). The similarly high profile Andrew Balding prepared the 50/1 runner-up.

Serpentine beat Khalifa Sat (Free Eagle) and Amhran Na Bhfiann on the famous Surrey course which rises and falls between 15 and 50 metres. And the winner, who made the pace and simply kept running at a gallop which none

of his rivals could sustain, won by five and a half lengths.

While official Derby sectional times have proved beyond my Google capabilities, there's little doubt he was setting a solid pace. The field was strung out and few of his rivals were pulling.

This, I believe, was no fluke and I've happily backed him to win the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Paris Longchamp in October. Only three horses have recorded wide-margin Derby wins in the past ten years. Workforce (King's Best) and Golden Horn (Cape Cross) went on to win in Paris, against all comers, while the third, Camelot (Montjeu), was arguably thwarted by heavy ground.

Serpentine was seemingly dismissed in the Derby despite having led throughout to win by nine lengths at his previous start just seven days earlier. Not even the trainer can "bugger it up" in a week as wise old punters told me as a kid. No, I didn't back him so I'm not claiming that same level of wisdom.

However, I did have a few dollars on Amhran Na Bhfiann at 100/1 each way. Simple logic, which often seems to be missing in the assessment of English racing, demanded that I did.

He'd had one run at three, finishing fourth to Tiger Moth (another Galileo) who then stretched Ballydoyle stablemate Santiago (Authorized) in the Irish Derby. Santiago, like the early Epsom Derby favourite English King (Camelot) had comprehensively beaten Berkshire Rocco (Sir Percy) at his previous start, so there was an obvious link.

So why not Love, the daughter of - you guessed it - Galileo, ahead of Serpentine for the Arc? Why not indeed. She won the Oaks by a greater margin and in slightly quicker time and is certainly not dismissed but may be more ground dependent. She's unbeaten in five runs on good ground since her debut but has looked vulnerable on softer footing and I suspect the colts are stronger than the fillies in 2020.

The action continued at Sandown on the Sunday, with the Coral-Eclipse Stakes, which has been well covered. Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) was another to sustain a strong gallop to outlast a brave, returning Enable (Nathaniel) with Japan (Galileo) a solid enough third to be deemed to have enhanced the Lord North (Dubawi) form from the Prince Of Wales's Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Royal Ascot.

The Royal Ascot form, for better or worse, is gradually being put to the test. It usually takes a few weeks with horses less frequently "backed up" in the UK and often comes to something of a peak at the Newmarket meeting (Thursday, Friday and Saturday this week).

This is my look at some possibly left-field Newmarket nominated horses with Royal Ascot form. Does this obsession with the Ascot form make me money? Sometimes. Would I say it offers an excellent return on the multitude of hours spent doing the videos and follow-ups? Probably not, so take it as you will, but it's a lot of fun.

Mutamaasik (Dubawi): Thrashed the centre group horses in the Buckingham Palace Handicap (7f) and second and third, that side, have since run well.

Sir Busker (Sir Prancealot): Won the Hunt Cup (1m) consolation with top weight and running fastest closing splits. Third horse has since won a useful race at Haydock; runner-up (Salayel) also ran third in a Listed race yesterday. Previous win sound over in-form Dark Vision (Dream Ahead).

Kipps (War Command): Strong closing splits in the King George V Stakes (1m 4f) behind run-of-the-race winner Hukum (Sea The Stars). Subjectivist (Teofilo), Bodyline (Australia) and the next-time-out heavily-backed Berkshire Savvy (Mukhadram) have since run very well from that race.

Raising Sand (Oasis Dream): Nominated for strong Bunbury Cup and taking on a few others who are mentioned here but was clearly the first home on the slow side in the Hunt Cup (1m) and that form is proving very solid.

Woven (Dutch Art): Second home on the slower far side in the Silver Wokingham (6f); first home on that side has since won.

Maydanny (Dubawi): First home on slower far side in the Hunt Cup consolation.

Dancing Inthestreet (Muhaarar): Excellent behind emerging star sprinter Art Power (Dark Angel) (won again) in the Palace Of Holyrood House Handicap (5f). Had "no" weight but that's the case again.

Threat (Footstepsinthesand): Suited back in trip and, likely, on firmer ground after fitness testing run fresh in the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m).
