Cash keeps coming for Capitalists as another new record is set at Classic

Life-changing result for Scone veterinarian Richard McClenahan after sale of \$625,000 colt

Champion trainer John Moore is noted for his patience with horses but he is in no mood to play the waiting game now that he is domiciled in Sydney, with his agent-son George yesterday helping young sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) to set a new Inglis Classic Yearling Sale record in as many days.

The Team Moore operation of John, Gary, George and James, backed by prominent Hong Kong and Australian clients, has made its mark during the opening two days at Riverside Stables and they upped the ante early in the afternoon of yesterday's session, going to \$625,000 for a colt by the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m)-winning young stallion.

Another family training partnership, the powerful Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes

team, was the underbidder on the Kitchwin Hills-consigned colt, who hails from the family of Group 1-winning sprinter Pierata (Pierro).

Capitalist also had a colt realise \$600,000 on Sunday, which surpassed the previous record high price for the Classic auction, held by a \$550,000 son of Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) who was sold in 2019. *Continued on page 2>>*

"In my opinion he is the right size for a Capitalist. He is not overly big, he is just a powerhouse and he's got a great temperament," said George Moore, who signed for a \$375,000 Invader (Snitzel) colt and a \$140,000 son of Maurice (Screen Hero) on day one and a \$220,000 Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock) colt late yesterday.

"As James Harron said the other day, the Capitalists have got the right head mindwise for racing in Hong Kong and every time I saw him he was professional. He has a great hip on him and he is a correct horse.

"He had all the right attributes but we paid quite a lot for him."

The colt, catalogued as Lot 374, is the first foal out of the twice-winning Theatric (Casino Prince), who is from the same family as Aquis Farm sire Pierata, Group 3 winner Ashokan (More Than Ready) and this season's Stan Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) placegetter Jet Propulsion (Rubick).

"We have noticed right now that we have got a lot of late two-year-olds in the stable and I said to dad, 'let's go to the sales and buy those early, precocious two-year-old types, so we can

race them early next season, rather than constantly waiting to try and win races with our older horses right now," George Moore said.

"We are just buying the best types in the sales, like we usually do. We look at pedigrees but it is mainly a type thing.

"We are going to buy a lot more at Easter, too. We will probably buy six or seven at Easter, so we are going to have a good string of two-year-olds to target the races in October and November."

The Classic expenditure by the Moores coincides with the arrival in Sydney of John, a 39-time Group 1 winning trainer, who has gone into partnership with his brother, Gary.

"Everything is coming together for the stable. Dad's been in town for about a week now and I came in about two weeks ago," George Moore said.

"I was dad's travelling assistant trainer for about eight years, so I know his attention to detail and exactly what he wants, so we have changed quite a lot in the stable to dad's standards, which are very, very high."

The record-holding colt was consigned by Kitchwin Hills on behalf of Scone veterinarian Richard McClenahan who, along with his wife Kim, oversaw the preparation of the youngster.

The victory of Profiteer (Capitalist) in Saturday's Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) has helped to boost the profile of Capitalist's second crop of yearlings, according to Kitchwin's Mick Malone. *Continued on page 4>>*

"It is a perfect storm, isn't it? The horse wins the Millennium and here we are - Profiteer just added so much value to the colt," Malone said.

"It would be interesting to know what that horse was worth if that horse hadn't won. It probably added \$200,000 to \$300,000 to his price.

"The other thing about him was, he never put a foot wrong. He just walked up and down and every parade was the same and there were huge numbers, there were massive X-ray numbers, so he was always going to make a lot of money.

"The reserve played no role because we knew it wouldn't, it was just wherever it ended up."

Irishman McClenahan was in disbelief following the massive result after buying Theatric from agent Damon Gabbedy.

"It's been stressful getting him here, we knew he would be a popular horse and everybody that looked at him seemed to like him, but I never in my wildest dreams believed we could get a result like that," he said.

"That's life-changing for us. It literally is life-changing. I liked (Theatric's) family and know it well through Kitchwin Hills and we bred her to Capitalist.

"He's always been an outstanding colt from the day he was born. Sorry, I'm just speechless, I can't believe this has really happened. It's unbelievable."

Breeders have held Capitalist in high esteem from the time he retired to stud in 2017, covering in excess of 200 mares each season. However,

mare owners paid heed to the whispers surrounding the early talent of his first crop, sending him 237 mares in 2020 - his biggest book to date.

Capitalist, who has had 15 yearlings sell for an average of \$226,000 after two days, also had a filly make \$380,000 yesterday to Woodpark Stud's Jean Dubois.

The Newgate Farm-offered youngster, catalogued as Lot 396, is the first foal out of the US stakes-winning mare Tricky Zippy (City Zip), who was bought by SF Bloodstock for US\$135,000 at the 2017 Keeneland November Breeding Sale.

"She's by the right stallion at the moment, I guess, that's why I have had to pay that price and she is out of a very fast American family," Dubois said.

"She is crossed four ways with Mr Prospector, so I like it. She looks precocious, you never know if they are going to be fast. City Zip bloodlines are full of speed and speed-on-speed was the idea."

Almanzor craze continues on day two

Trainer Liam Howley believes a colt by boom Cambridge Stud shuttle sire Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) is the complete package and the best of the European champion's first southern hemisphere crop, which has left an enormous impression on buyers this year.

Following a drawn-out bidding process, which started at \$40,000 early on day two, an online buyer and Howley - with the support agents Andrew Williams and Bevan Smith - went head-to-head before the tripartite eventually landed the colt for \$360,000.

"The boys thought he was the standout of the crop to be honest. We talked about him a couple of weeks ago and as soon as I saw him walk out of the box here, I was blown away by how good an athlete he is," said Howley, who later bought an Ilovethiscity (Magic Albert) colt for \$140,000 ten minutes before training Almighty Will (Medaglia D'Oro) to score at Wodonga.

"He certainly stacks up with the best of them, so it was a matter of coming here and having a good look at him. As soon as he walked out of the box, we were going after him."

Almanzor yearlings have sold up to \$800,000 for far in 2021, including a \$400,000 colt here on Sunday, while he was also the most sought-after stallion at last month's New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale.

Last year, Coolmore bought Almanzor's sire Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) from Haras d'Etreham in France to stand him in Ireland and the global powerhouse is considering him for shuttling duties to Australia later this year. That development is one reason why Howley is far from shocked about the hype surrounding his sire-son's yearlings.

"Wootton Bassett is firing in Europe and he was a star racehorse himself and when you see them, I am not surprised (by how well they are selling)," he said.

"Some look like they are going to run early, some look like they are going to be three-year-olds, but what people are struck by is the fact that they are athletes.

"We tried to buy a couple on the Gold Coast and we couldn't get near them and (yesterday's purchase) probably impressed us a bit more than those on the Gold Coast."

Bred and consigned by New

Zealand farm Wentwood Grange as Lot 309, the colt is the second foal out of the stakes-placed New Zealand mare She Is Stryking (Stryker), while his third dam is the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 900m) winner Fashion Victim (Rory's Jester).

She Is Stryking was purchased by agent Guy Mulcaster for NZ\$70,000 at the 2018 NZB Karaka May Sale when in foal to Astern (Medaglia D'Oro).

Wentwood Grange's Dean Hawkins was delighted with the "massive result".

"We watched the 'sale day live' coverage on our phones and it was just amazing to see it all unfold," Hawkins said.

"It's been a team effort by everybody given the circumstances. The horses travelled on Sunday and we've had Brad Molamberg and Mitch Roach looking after them for us and they've done a marvellous job.

"He was a lovely colt from the day he was born. He's never missed a beat, always so relaxed and he has this great mental capacity that not all yearlings have.

"He hasn't stopped all week with parades but he hasn't put a hair wrong. Every parade he's been a superstar."

Victorian Howley won two Group 1s with Homesman (War Front) and Almandin (Monsun) when he was the private trainer to owner Lloyd Williams at Macedon Lodge, but for the past 12 months he has been building up his own stable on a property near Kyneton.

He currently has 15 horses in work, including an unraced Frankel (Galileo) two-year-old half-sister to Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner All Legal (Al Maher), who was a \$300,000 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale graduate last year.

"I've got a good young team. Some guys have come across from Macedon with me and I've got a couple of great riders, so I am slowly building the stable. Start small and dream big," he said.

The unnamed Frankel filly is scheduled to have a jump out at Kyneton tomorrow.

Written Tycoon's fillies also do the talking

James Harron had already made his mark on the Classic sale, buying the \$600,000 Capitalist colt on Sunday, but he also targeted a filly by the stallion's own sire Written Tycoon (Iglesia) yesterday, going to \$380,000 for the yearling who is to be trained by Richard and Michael Freedman.

Written Tycoon is the sire of this season's MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Odeum as well as fellow exciting three-year-old filly Written Beauty and Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Enthaar.

"He's been a revelation, hasn't he? He just keeps on lifting the bar and to have the quality of two-year-old he's producing has been outstanding," Harron enthused of Written Tycoon.

"Enthaar has been a flagbearer for him in terms of the fillies, but there are some very good sprinting fillies by Written Tycoon. He's a stallion that everyone wants to get behind."

As for the yearling herself, she joins a growing fillies partnership between Harron's syndicate and the Sydney-based Freedmans, with the first group of now two-year-olds set to race in the coming months.

"She looks to have great strength and a great mind. She has got growing and developing to do but she looks like a really good, strong sprinting type," Harron said.

"She is out of a Charge Forward mare, and he's done very well as a broodmare sire, and she's from a good-running, fast family and is a fast-looking filly."

The sale of the filly by Woodside Park Stud capped a successful Classic auction for the Victorian farm, which was last night the second leading vendor by average, having sold its four lots for an average of \$220,000 each.

The highest-priced of Woodside's quartet, the Written Tycoon filly is the second foal out of the juvenile-winning, Group 3-placed mare Ariaz (Charge Forward). She was catalogued as Lot 461.

Outgoing Woodside Park Stud chief executive James Price admitted pre-sale expectations were ramped up the more the filly was paraded at Riverside this week.

"Two weeks ago, I most definitely would have been surprised, but she arrived at the sale and didn't put a foot wrong," he said.

"She walked beautifully and when you get the judges like James Harron mentioning that she was perfect (on Sunday), it puts a good feeling in your stomach.

"When he is standing out the back nodding away behind a post, you are thinking, 'oh gosh, I just hope there's someone there to go with him'.

"The \$380,000 is a lot more than what we could have hoped for."

Zoustar colt joins Newgate-China Horse Club partnership

One of the major colts syndicates, the international China Horse Club-led operation, backed its judgment on a colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) who major partner Newgate Farm knows closely.

The youngster, who made \$425,000, was bred by Lightning Thoroughbreds' Greg and Donna Kolivos with Newgate selling him on their behalf as Lot 492.

"He was a lovely, good-moving colt out of a fast Snitzel mare and he looks like he'll be a pretty precocious sort and we were delighted to be able to buy him," China Horse Club's Michael Smith said.

"We haven't had too many Zoustars, but obviously he's a proven stallion that is on the rise. He's had plenty of good horses and we are keen to find that next good one."

The colt is the fifth foal out of the winning Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Blazing Snitzel, herself a half-sister to Listed winner Excuse My French (French Deputy).

"I think he looks like one of the more precocious Zoustars, but you have to take into account that they seem to come into their own as autumn two-year-olds as he did himself, and then into the spring as three-year-olds," Smith said.

The sale of Kolivos' colt helped Newgate Farm to the top of the leading vendors table by aggregate, having sold 25 yearlings for a total of \$3.61 million at an average of \$144,400.

Market holds up on day two

After a record opening day, the appetite for horses continued yesterday. This was fuelled by a deep spread of buyers seeking new stock, led by the Moore family, while Melbourne trainer Mark Kavanagh has attempted to rejuvenate his career with the addition of 12 horses to his stable thus far.

Agent John Foote has bought a total of 16 yearlings for clients, while Warwick Farm trainer Matthew Smith has secured eight lots, syndicator Darby Racing with agent Will Johnson have bought seven, as have Inglis Millennium-winning trainers Mick Price and Mick Kent jnr.

Overall, there have already been 22 yearlings sold for \$250,000 or more, up on the 12 who reached the mark last year with a session still to go, helping the aggregate to \$43,974,500.

With a clearance rate of 89 per cent, the average was sitting at \$103,959 and the median price was \$80,000.

"As was the case on Sunday, there were a number of pleasant surprises throughout the day and it has led to another very positive day's trade," Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing, Sebastian Hutch, surmised last night.

"The clearance rate has actually increased from Sunday, today's grossed more than the day before and the average is still very strong.

"All the metrics are important. Turnover is a very important figure to us as an auction house to stay attuned to and the turnover is very strong."

The Classic sale, which is on track to set a record, will conclude today and Hutch reinforced the importance of buyers not to let an opportunity pass.

"We are really looking forward to (today) because there are some really nice horses to sell, with the remaining 80 lots of the main session, while the Highway Session is a really popular part of the sale," he said.

"There are people looking for value and likely to find it in that sale - I think there will be some real gems there. Such has been the level competition through the first two days, there are still plenty of people looking to fill orders at a variety of different levels. (Today) is a good opportunity to fill those."

Important Saturday looms for Waller

Chris Waller will begin the roll out of his carnival big guns this weekend with Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Verry Elleegant (Zed) leading the charge when she launches her campaign in Randwick's Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) alongside stablemates Funstar (Adelaide), Kolding (Ocean Park) and Toffee Tongue (Tavistock). Verry Elleegant already has six Group 1 wins in the bag but Waller believes she has only just begun to fully mature. "She has come back stronger but so has Rafael Nadal and Roger Federer. Does it make them better? Probably not, but I think it makes the coach's job easier knowing that you're not having to nurse a horse through a Group 1 preparation," Waller said. "That's a big deal because there is no room for error. She has been very good, she has overcome immaturity, that's how good she is." Waller expects Verry Elleegant to prove hard to beat on Saturday, providing the track has some cushion. "Conditions could have some bearing because if it was a lightning-quick track she might not be as effective, but if it's soft she is going to keep them all very honest," he said. The premier trainer will also have a major hand in Melbourne where Nature Strip (Nicconi) and September Run (Exceed And Excel) are due to take on Godolphin sprinter Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) in Flemington's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m).

Fifty Stars cleared for Apollo

Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) looks set to make his belated reappearance by taking on Verry Elleegant et al in the Apollo Stakes. Last year's Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner was

scheduled to run in last Saturday's C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield before a pre-race scope showed traces of mucus. "The plan was the Orr - it looked the perfect way in - but he has won in Sydney and has gone to Sydney and come home and run well," Tom Dabernig, who trains Fifty Stars in partnership with Ben Hayes, told Racing.com. "He's a tough horse and it (travel) won't worry him. First-up in the Blamey wouldn't have been ideal and we can't wait for the Futurity (Saturday week) so this is the only way really. We scoped him this morning and he was as clean as a whistle. He'll have a gallop (today) and if he gallops well and pulls up well as I expect he will, he kicks off in the Apollo and then he can come back for the Blamey and then the Australian Cup." The Australian Turf Club extended nominations for the Apollo after receiving nine entries yesterday, among them Golden Eagle (1500m) winner Colette (Hallowed Crown) and All-Star Mile (1600m) hopeful Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator).

Chairman's Sale-bound Pippie set for grand final

Co-trainer Chris Meagher believes Pippie (Written Tycoon) will be entering the Lightning with a clear edge over her main rivals on what could be her final racetrack appearance before she goes under the hammer at Inglis's Chairman's Sale in May. "This is her grand final. Horses such as Bivouac and Nature Strip are being set for races down the track. I think that will give us an advantage," he said. Pippie boasts a brilliant first-up record having been undefeated in four appearances fresh, while Meagher issued an upbeat bulletin from Damian Lane after he rode the five-year-old to a five-length jump-out win over 900 metres

at Mornington last Wednesday. "Damian was really happy with her. She led easily and could have won by at least another three lengths. He had her under a good hold. She'll be up against more seasoned Group 1 performers such as Nature Strip and Bivouac but our plans have been all around this race. I think Nature Strip, Bivouac and her will set the pace. She will keep running so it's going to be a big assignment for them to out-speed her first up." Pippie is \$11 in the TAB fixed odds market for the Lightning with Bivouac the \$2.60 favourite.

Elite Street given Lightning green light

After days of uncertainty, trainer Dan Morton has confirmed star sprinter Elite Street (Street Boss) will take his place in the Lightning. Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Elite Street and stablemate Kissonallforcheeks (Written Tycoon) were set to fly to Melbourne last week, but those plans were put on hold after Perth went into a Covid-19 lockdown. Morton contemplated staying in Perth and running Elite Street in Saturday's Cyril Flower Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Ascot, but had a last-minute change of heart and committed to his original plan. "Sunday he was not going and I was staying at home, but the plan all along was to go for the Lightning and Newmarket," Morton told The Races WA. "Because of Racing Victoria's Covid-19 restrictions I will have to hand him over for a week, but for the sake of a few days I was comfortable to do that. Nick Ryan will oversee his preparation this week and is a very good horseman who rides work himself. The prospect of a small field in the Lightning Stakes was also an opportunity for good prize-money. He had a good gallop at Pinjarra on Saturday and is in good order."

Rosehill trial for Forbes

Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m) runner-up Forbes (Capitalist) will ramp up his Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) campaign with a barrier trial at Rosehill on Thursday. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained colt, one of the James Harron Bloodstock colts syndicate-owned juveniles, is pencilled in to resume in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill on Saturday week. "I left (his campaign) up to Anthony and Sam and this is the path they want to take, which is exciting," Harron said from the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. "I think they have got a lot of time for the colt. He has to come to Sydney now and prove himself, but he has shown us really great ability and it's good to see the form franked from the Merson Cooper with (the winner) Anamoe running well in the Blue Diamond Prelude."

King's Legacy also slated for Rosehill

King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) is set to have his second trial ahead of an autumn preparation at Rosehill on Thursday. Connections have the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Rosehill on February 20 pencilled in for King's Legacy's first-up run with the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) two weeks later the immediate goal. "He's going very well, I'll be gobsmacked if he doesn't get back to his old form on what we've seen," Peter Snowden, who trains the dual Group 1 winner in partnership with his son Paul, said. "He seems very much switched on. Colts can do that, I've seen it before." King's Legacy contests heat two over 1030 metres at Rosehill on Thursday alongside David Payne's star filly Montefilia (Kermadec), who will also be having her second trial.

Newgate pays out Capitalist bonus

The \$250,000 Newgate Farm first season sire bonus has been paid out, having been won by Roll The Dice Racing and Jeremy Rogers for Profiteer's (Capitalist) scintillating victory in last Saturday's Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m). By Australia's leading first season sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon), Profiteer was a \$165,000 yearling purchase out of Newgate's draft at

last year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. He is now the pre-post favourite for next month's Golden Slipper. "It's most fitting that our Golden Slipper-winning stallion Capitalist has been the first sire that we've paid out this huge bonus on. The Capitalist syndicate is made up of nearly all his original owners as well as some of the leading stud farms in Australia and the syndicate couldn't be more thrilled to be paying out this significant bonus," said Newgate managing director Henry Field.

RV investigate positive cobalt swab

Racing Victoria stewards are continuing their investigations after the Aaron Peterson-trained Approved Anger (Authorized) tested positive for cobalt. The stewards received a report from Racing Analytical Services Limited confirming that a pre-race urine sample taken at Geelong on Boxing Day contained cobalt at a mass concentration greater than 200 micrograms per litre. The Racing Science Centre conducted a separate test which confirmed those findings. Approved Anger finished ninth of 14 over 1500 metres. Cobalt is a prohibited substance in accordance with the Rules of Racing at a concentration in excess of 100 micrograms per litre in urine.

Russian Camelot to trial at Werribee

Russian Camelot (Camelot) is set for his first public outing of the year when the dual Group 1 winner takes part in a trial over 1100 metres at Werribee this morning. The Danny O'Brien-trained four-year-old has six rivals, headed by fellow Group 1 winner Mr Quickie (Shamus Award), in the opening heat of just two trials at 9am. The co-favourite for the \$5 million All-Star Mile has not raced since finishing eighth in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

Queen set to trial but Pike remains uncertain

Arcadia Queen (Pierro) will be ridden by William Pike in a trial in Western Australia today but the leading jockey has yet to decide whether he will partner the mare in her Melbourne assignments this autumn. Owner Bob Peters said he had spoken to Pike and

asked him to confirm whether he would be happy to undertake two quarantine periods in order to ride in both the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and the All-Star Mile. "I spoke to him this morning and we had a bit of a discussion and I've asked him to check on the Covid situation because, at the moment, it's a six-day lockdown in a (Melbourne) hotel but that is really seven days because they don't count the day you get in," Peters told Racing.com. "So, if that happens, he couldn't ride here (Perth) on Saturday and he'd have to come over sometime during the week. It's all a bit up in the air at the moment." Under current conditions, Pike would also face a two-week quarantine period on his return to WA.

Behemoth takes ASM voting lead

Behemoth (All Too Hard) yesterday replaced Arcadia Queen at the top of the voting for the All-Star Mile at Moonee Valley on March 13. The South Australian star had last night polled almost 8,500 votes as the duo switched places at the top of the table ahead of Verry Elleegant. Voting, which opened on January 22, closes at midnight on Sunday, with Racing Victoria set to announce the final top ten vote-getters to accept a spot in the field by February 19. 'We have a few cannons with votes to fire yet'

Mr Quickie is just ahead of Mugatoo in the battle to gain the final guaranteed berth in the All-Star Mile and connections remain confident they will bag the coveted spot. "We have a few cannons with votes to fire yet," Wylie Dalziel, who manages syndication company Dalziel Racing, told Racing.com. "There is a bit more of a push to come and I'm confident he will hold that tenth spot. If there was one thing I would say it is that he is being aimed at the mile this preparation."

Strong autumn book but Bowman tight-lipped on Slipper

Hugh Bowman is assembling a strong book of autumn rides but remains some way off making a call on who he will partner in the Golden Slipper. Bowman revealed yesterday that he is

set to partner New Zealand star Aegon (Sacred Falls) when he arrives in Australia, while he is also excited for Montefilia's return. Bowman has a strong hand heading towards the Slipper, having ridden the Mick Price and Michael Kent jnr-trained Profiteer to victory in the Inglis Millennium last Saturday, having already claimed last month's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) on Shaquero (Shalaa). "I won't be locking into anything at this stage, there is a long way to go," Bowman told RSN927. "They are both exciting horses, of course, different types of horses, but both are ultra-exciting. It's too far out to be locking into anything at this stage." Profiteer is \$4.40 favourite for the Golden Slipper with Sportsbet, while Shaquero is a \$15 chance. Meanwhile, Bowman is indisposed and will not be riding at Hawkesbury today or at Warwick Farm tomorrow.

O'Brien in no rush with Vow And Declare

Danny O'Brien will take his time with Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War) before bringing the 2019 Melbourne Cup winner back this autumn. The five-year-old was last seen finishing 18th in last year's Cup and has since been at O'Brien's Barwon Heads property. "We gave him a good break after the spring just to try and reset him," O'Brien told Racing.com. "The signs have been promising so far. You won't see him until later in the autumn, potentially first-up in the Easter Cup on Easter Saturday (April 3). That will give him an opportunity to get ready for the Andrew Ramsden here on his home track in May."

Sydney autumn the plan for Dalasan

Dalasan (Dalakhani) is another who has enjoyed a lengthy break following his spring campaign having last been seen in action when finishing seventh in the Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on November 7. Like Vow And Declare, the four-year-old is edging closer to a return to action with connections contemplating tackling the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington first-up on March 6 before aiming at the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on April 3.

Co-trainer Trent Edmonds is delighted with the four-year-old's progress since returning to training following a luckless spring carnival in Melbourne. "She just had her first gallop last Tuesday and looked pretty good to me," Edmonds, who trains in partnership with his father Toby, said. "She's on track to trial at the end of the month. The Hollindale Stakes and Doomben Cup will be her two main aims. Dad and I spoke tentatively about a plan of two starts, possibly three, then into the Hollindale. She looks great and I'm looking forward to running her in some of the bigger races here in the winter."

MRC begins training time trial

The Melbourne Racing Club yesterday started a trial designed to ease the morning toll on trainers by extending its trackwork opening time by an hour. As part of a Racing Victoria-funded three-month trial, Mornington-based trainers will now be allowed to use facilities until 10:30am, rather than 9:30am. Mornington opens to trainers from 4am. The trial will run until the end of April.

Symons 'surprised' as newcomer shortens significantly

Rod Symons has expressed his surprise at a strong market move for Kaniva (Kuroshio) who makes her debut in a maiden over 1112 metres at Kyneton today. Kaniva opened as high as \$13 with one betting operator on Sunday afternoon before firming into

favourite with all firms by yesterday morning, with Sportsbet's opening price of \$9 slashed to \$3.60 favourite 24 hours before the jump. "I'm surprised by the strength of the market following," Symons told Racing.com. "She's trialed okay but it's a bit different then going into a race." Kaniva has contested multiple jump-outs ahead of her debut, most recently at Bendigo on January 19, where she broke quickly from the barriers to lead before being restrained to finish fourth of six starters.

Family affair for Nolen's first runner

Shaun Nolen's training career almost got off to a fairytale start at Wodonga yesterday when his first runner Turoar (Sizzling) beat all of his rivals bar Broccobama (Unencumbered), who is trained by his father, Vincent. The pair started as the first two in the betting for the 1100-metre maiden in which Broccobama led throughout to score by two and a quarter lengths from the fast finishing runner-up. "The old man owns 50 per cent of both horses, so he was going to be happy either way," Shaun Nolen told Racing.com.

Williams suspended for Ballarat win

Craig Williams will miss two metropolitan meetings after pleading guilty to careless riding aboard winner Saif (Pride Of Dubai) on his sole ride at Ballarat on Sunday. Williams, who is attempting to win his sixth consecutive Melbourne jockeys' premiership, picked up an eight-meeting suspension which starts after this Saturday's Lightning Stakes meeting and concludes after Moonee Valley's night meeting on February 19.

Newcastle transferred to Muswellbrook

The Newcastle meeting scheduled to take place next Monday has been transferred to Muswellbrook on the same day. As a consequence both Benchmark 58 handicaps will now be run over 1280 metres, the Class 2 handicap is now over 1450 metres, the Class 1 handicap will be run over 1280 metres, as will the maiden handicap, while the country maiden plate will be run over 1450 metres.

NEW ZEALAND

112 for Savabeel

Perennial champion sire Savabeel (Zabeel) produced his 112th individual stakes winner yesterday when Tabata (4 m ex Splitsecond by Pins) prevailed in a desperate finish to the Wairarapa Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Tauherenikau. Owned by former Black Caps captain and cricketing legend Brendon McCullum, the progressive four-year-old made it three wins from ten outings when she came home with a sustained late thrust under Danielle Johnson to collar Cruz Ramirez (Myboycharlie) by a half-head. Serena (Swiss Ace) was a further long-neck back in third. Tabata was purchased by McCullum under his Vermair Bloodstock banner alongside Hughes Bloodstock for \$100,000 from the Waikato Stud draft at Book 1 of the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale in 2018. She is from the extended family of Group 1 winners Xtravagant (Pentire), Legs (Pins) and Sixty Seconds (Centaine). Waikato Stud flagbearer Savabeel stood for a fee of \$100,000 (plus GST) last year.

Tabata completes red-letter 48 hours for Marsh

Tabata's trainer Stephen Marsh was delighted with yesterday's victory, his third black type win in 48 hours after securing a Group 3 double on Saturday with Vernanme (O'Reilly) and Belle Fascino (Per Incanto). "To get any stakes win is always a thrill but to pick up three over the weekend is very satisfying," he said. "Tabata has got a very good finish on her and when she started to pick up halfway down the straight, I started to think we might snatch third but her last 50 metres was just phenomenal." Looking ahead, Marsh added: "Her breeding and the way she handled the 1600 metres today suggests to me a race like the Travis Stakes in April might be an ideal target."

Benner and Wynyard double up at Tauherenikau

Training partners John Benner and Hollie Wynyard saddled three horses at Tauherenikau yesterday and the pair came within inches of landing a memorable treble. The duo kicked off their day with an impressive victory by

promising two-year-old Hillaby (Shooting To Win) over 1000 metres, while progressive stayer Springsteen (Stratum) made it two wins from three starts this campaign when he took out the Wairarapa Cup (2050m). Between those two successes, lightly-raced three-year-old Meg (Sebring) was beaten just a half-neck in the 1600-metre maiden. Benner was delighted with yesterday's results as he and Wynyard moved into the top ten on the national trainers' premiership. "It was certainly nice to get the two wins and we went pretty close to the third," Benner said. "It was a good day all around and Meg will keep improving as she is very smart and will pick up black type at some point. She is just a little confused at the moment as she is working out what she is doing. Once the penny drops, I think you will see a pretty progressive type." Regarding Hillaby, he added: "We have her nominated for the Sires' Produce at Awapuni, which is a good race to work towards, although in the meantime we might take a look at the Matamata Breeders' Stakes later this month."

Herbie Dyke then Australia for The Chosen One

Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) third and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) fourth The Chosen One (Savabeel) will prepare for a return to Australia when he lines up in the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. The five-year-old, who is trained by Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman, will make his sole domestic outing this preparation as he embarks on a path to the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) in April, having finished runner-up to Etah James (Raise The Flag) in the race last year. The Chosen One warmed up for his return to the track with two trial outings last month, although Forsman anticipates the entire will improve for his first-up run. "He is very well but it's not easy going into a Group 1 over 2000 metres first-up," Forsman said. "I think he is as ready as we can have him and he did win first-up in Melbourne in the spring. A similar sort of run would see him in it, although I'm not sure just what sort of field he will be up against other than Melody Belle. He is ready, but we also know we have to get to Sydney yet and have the necessary improvement in him."

Aegon and Quick Thinker also Sydney-bound

Following his run in the Herbie Dyke, The Chosen One will join stablemates Aegon (Sacred Falls), who is unbeaten in four outings to date, and last season's Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Quick Thinker (So You Think) on the plane to Sydney. "All three of our Australian team fly over early next week," Forsman said. "At this stage we don't really have anything locked in for Quick Thinker, it's really a matter of getting him going on the right-handed tracks and hopefully with some give in them. We will play it by ear with him and if he comes up well then the Sydney Cup could be an option." Regarding New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Karaka Million 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) winner Aegon, Forsman continued: "Aegon has done well since his win on Karaka Million night and is very fresh. We haven't done much with him and he will probably have a gallop on Tuesday and another on Saturday before he gets on the plane. He will go into the Hobartville Stakes first-up and then two weeks after that the Randwick Guineas."

INTERNATIONAL

UK: Marquand departs for Australian stint

Tom Marquand yesterday flew out of Heathrow to begin his latest two-month stint in Australia. Marquand, who partnered 36 winners during his successful Sydney foray last year, said before his departure: "I'm looking forward to finally getting out to Australia for six weeks in the saddle, but not so much the first fortnight when I have to stay in a hotel room. Thankfully, I've already found a company that rents bikes with a smart turbo trainer on it, so I'll probably spend most of my time on that. In an ideal world I would be doing Saudi Arabia, Dubai and then Australia, but with all the restrictions this year that's not possible, so I had to choose. Australia rather picked itself really and sometimes that can be a good thing. I had planned to go out a few weeks ago but when Emirates stopped direct flights it was a bit tricky, but thankfully I'm on an Etihad flight with a stop in Abu Dhabi,

which is the first I could get." Newmarket trainer William Haggas is still waiting to hear whether visas will be issued to his staff for them to be in place in Australia in time to welcome Addeybb (Pivotal), who won the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) with Marquand aboard last year, and his stablemate Favorite Moon (Sea The Moon) from off the plane.

USA: Spendthrift acquires half of Keepmeinmind

B. Wayne Hughes' Spendthrift Farm has acquired a 50 per cent share in Keepmeinmind (Laoban), who won the Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at Churchill Downs back in November. The promising three-year-old is trained by Robertino Diodoro and he also achieved top-flight placings in the Keeneland Breeders' Futurity (Gr 1, 8.5f) and Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) prior to his Grade 2 victory. Keepmeinmind is set to make his reappearance next week and he currently sits

second on the road to the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) leaderboard with 18 points. "We are delighted to be a part of such an exciting young racehorse as Keepmeinmind and thankful to Cypress Creek and Arnold Bennewith for the opportunity to join the team," Ned Toffey, Spendthrift general manager, told Bloodhorse.com. 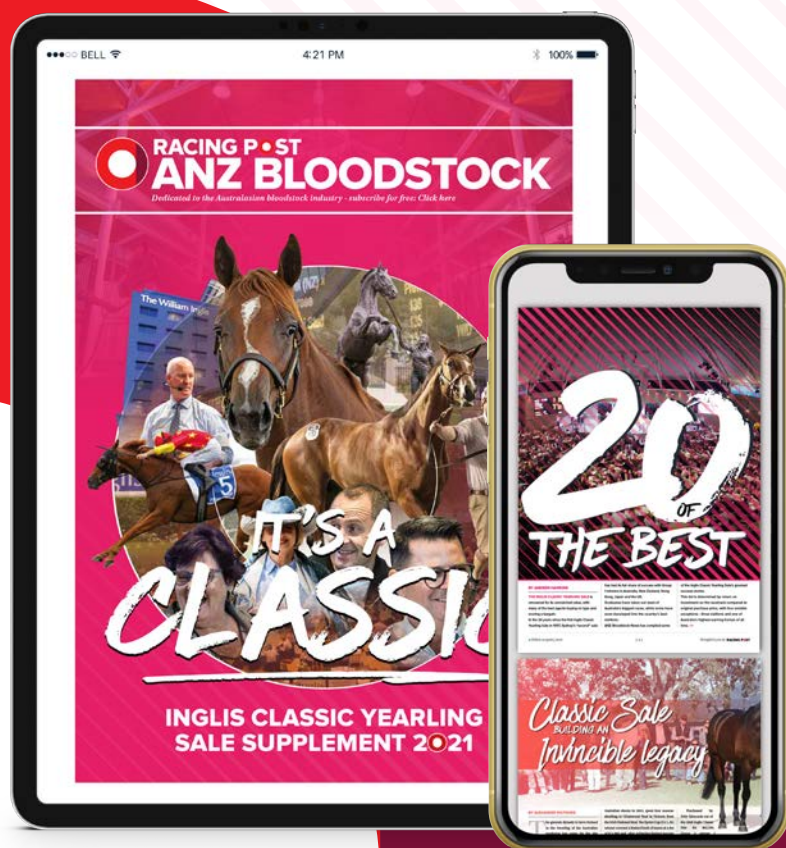

Oghill House Stud has also been responsible for producing another sire in Washington DC (Zoffany), who in that same season landed the Windsor

Castle Stakes (Listed, 5f) at Royal Ascot prior to running second in the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at the Curragh. The Hyland family were later honoured with the special recognition award at the Irish Thoroughbred Breeders' Association's annual ceremony. Under the late Pat's astute, hands-on guidance, Oghill House has produced the likes of smart French Group-class filly Mixed Intention (Elusive City), while its most recent flagbearer has been Rose Of Kildare (Make Believe), winner of last year's Musidora Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2.5f) at York.

Sydney stable allocation issues force Moore family north

Former Hong Kong champion trainer John Moore plans to expand his presence at the Gold Coast after expressing frustration with the Australian Turf Club's allocation of stables at Rosehill.

Moore, who has been active at this week's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale alongside his agent-son George, is beginning to find his racing ambitions thwarted in Sydney after only receiving 20 boxes from the ATC.

"With only being able to get 20 boxes at Rosehill expansion is difficult. We are buying all these horses but where do we put them?" John Moore told ANZ Bloodstock News.

Aggrieved with the struggle to negotiate more space for his high-quality racing stock, Moore - who will train in partnership with his brother, Gary, having returned from Hong Kong - is now making plans to set up on the Gold Coast where the duo are being welcomed with open arms.

"In the future we will be opening up a stable at the Gold Coast because of limitations here," he said.

With major track and facility upgrade plans well in place, and night racing to come in the not-too-distant future, the Gold Coast is becoming the place to be for leading trainers, including Lee Freedman who is returning from Singapore next month.

"Ian Brown (Gold Coast Turf Club's racing manager) was very kind to give me the plans of the future including a change of tracks, lighting and stables. It's all a big plus for the Gold Coast and Queensland racing," Moore said.

"He said he would love to have the Moore family come up there training. In the interim it will be more on a transient basis but once the changes are in place I will be more than glad to have a big stable up there."

There is no question that Sydney's potential loss will be Queensland racing's gain. The

Moore's currently have five boxes at the Gold Coast and will have more by season's end.

"Once my wife comes back I will be in Queensland and that will fit nicely with respect to the carnival there. I have had a home at the Gold Coast for a long time," he said.

"I will be up there and training them there with staff we are taking from our Sydney stable. I love the Gold Coast and of course Dad (George) was there and that's where it all started."

The ATC was approached for comment yesterday but did not respond.

The Moores have so far purchased five lots at the Classic auction for a total spend of \$1,440,000, ending day two as the sale's leading buyer.

Yesterday, they jumped on the Capitalist (Written Tycoon) bandwagon and went to a record-breaking price of \$625,000 to secure Lot 374, a chestnut colt from the Kitchwin Hills draft.

The big-money purchase followed on from a productive opening session, during which they refused to be outbid by James Harron and paid \$375,000 for a son of Invader (Snitzel) on Sunday.

He was bought on behalf of billionaire Hong Kong owner and businessman Simon Kwok, suggesting Moore will be steering some

of his high-profile Chinese clients towards racing in Australia, which is positive news for the entire industry.

"We have some clients that have given us good budgets to buy at this sale and others. They are not all destined for Hong Kong and we hope to keep them here and compete at the highest level," said Moore, who was released from hotel quarantine on Monday.

Closing in on his 71st birthday, Moore is still operating at his usual frenetic pace and he is determined to tick one last thing off his bucket list - to train a Group 1 winner in his home country.

"This is one reason I kept a trainers' license. It's the chance of buying a champion like an Able Friend at these sales. It gives me incentive to keep going," he said.

Long term, Moore's strategy is to travel between Hong Kong and Australia and continue marketing and promoting the stable to the Hong Kong scene.

"At the moment I will be in Australia up until restrictions are lifted as the whole idea of coming back was to base myself here and be able to travel back to Asia and sit down with the clients there and build the stable here with our China clients," he said.

"Connections in Hong Kong are still there and we can nurture them here in Australia.

"There are clients in Hong Kong that would like to come down to Australia when this pandemic will allow the freedom of travel.

"They will participate during the carnivals and we can give them a very good insight into Australian racing and how much it's improved with the prize-money being very, very good."

A high-energy character, Moore's renewed vigour is evident and he is clearly pleased to be back in Australia with some fresh challenges ahead.

He hasn't lost any of his quirky sense of humour since leaving the Hong Kong training ranks either. While Group 1 races are his main aim he says he harbours a personal ambition

"I never won it as an amateur jockey. I have a horse for it, he's my lead horse at the moment. He was a Group 2 winner in Hong Kong and

the lead horse there for Beauty Generation," he said.

Laughing, he added: "He's a ten-year-old now and he might have his last chance to win a race at Bong Bong."

Smith triumphs first-up with Hong Kong cast-off Digital Victory

Wayne Smith pulled off a masterly triumph with his Hong Kong cast-off Digital Victory (Bernardini), who won like a good horse in Friday night's Class 4 over 1350 metres under Peter Ho, landing some confident bets in the process.

Digital Victory, who only touched down in Macau on November 23, made light of his quick prep and maiden local opposition when he powered away to beat race-favourite Blackjack Mok (All Too Hard), with Harvest Year (Power) back in third.

A son of Bernardini (A P Indy) from Miss Zapper (Red Ransom), Digital Victory's story started off as a NZD\$100,000 purchase at the 2017 NZB 2YO Ready To Run Sale. Sent to the Hong Kong stables of Jimmy Ting, the gelding showed ability as Digital Triumph, and ran a nice race on debut in Class 4 off a wide trip at Sha Tin over 1200 metres. Problems then arose for the gelding and he was retired from racing in Hong Kong.

"He suffered a bad quarter crack in his hoof and then a collapsed heel. I went over to Hong Kong to have a look at him and suggested they send him back to New Zealand for six months or so to see how he went," Smith said.

"Joe Barnes, the former Macau trainer, took care of him for us and he recovered well, so it was decided to send him back to Macau and give him a go."

He continued: "I usually like to take plenty of time with my horses, but he did so well after he got here and he gave me a very nice feel in the morning.

"So, I decided to give him a soft trial behind the Class 1 horse Golden Conqueror, and while he finished a distant third, he went well traveling alongside good class horses. He thrived after the trial and I gave him a super chance on Friday night and it paid off."

Smith made it a double for the weekend on Sunday when Ocean Warrior (Ocean Park)

led throughout under Japanese rider Shogo Nakano for an easy win in the Class 4 (Division 2) over 1500 metres on turf, defeating race-favourite Ronson (Eurozone).

Ocean Warrior made it win number two in Macau with three placed efforts from his 12 runs to date. Smith was full of praise for Nakano after the win as he got the keen-going son of Ocean Park (Thorn Park) to relax in the run.

"I told Shogo not to push him out of the gates, just let him jump himself as he fires up and races too hard," Smith said.

"There was no other speed in the race and he got him to really relax well, and got a nice kick around the bend just by letting him slip. He was nice and strong at the end today."

Smith is doing a fine job with his smaller team of 16 horses and has now posted 11 winners from only 73 runners this season with seven placed efforts.

Japanese import Satono Eternal (Deep Impact) scored a dominant win in Sunday's Class 5 & 6 over 1800 metres to give jockey Peter Ho three winners for the weekend.

Prepared by K H Leong, Satono Eternal settled at the tail of the field with Ho bidding his

time until the 400 metres, when he allowed the son of Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) to slide off the back of the tailenders and straighten up in clear running.

The lightly-framed gelding showed a glimpse of his famous sires amazing finishing burst when he zoomed down the outside and put paid to his rivals in a twinkling.

It's hard to imagine that it was only win number two in the enclave for the gelding, who is one of Macau's smallest horses at 970 pounds. His only other win was also at 1800 metres in a similar dominating fashion. The gelding definitely looks far classier than Class 5 & 6 and should at least win in Class 3 & 4 over staying trips.

Satono Eternal is bred in the pink. As well as being by the great Deep Impact, he is out of So Many Ways (Sightseeing) who was unbeaten as a two-year-old and a winner of the Spinaway Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at Saratoga.

Nuclear Fusion (Sebring) gave popular owner Mr Mok Shing Fung another bargain-priced winner when he ran away from his rivals under a superb Eric Cheung ride to win the Class 3 Handicap over 1500 metres on Sunday.

Prepared in Macau by Sio Cheong, it was the first win for the former Australia-trained gelding, who raced there as Mandela, winning a three-year-old maiden at Randwick when prepared by Peter and Paul Snowden.

Originally a AUD\$280,000 purchase at the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the son of Sebring (More Than Reay) obviously did not live up to expectations and was put through the Inglis February (Early) Online Sale last year, where he was picked up by a bargain-hunting Mok for AUD\$47,500.

From his five starts in Macau, the gelding's record reads one win and two placings.

Mok's shrewd buying on the Inglis Digital platform has seen him pick up a host of former expensive horses for cheap money, such as Rock To Road (Stryker), Simon Fubuki (Medaglia D'Oro), Casino Mok (Casino Prince) and Blackjack Mok (All Too Hard), all of whom have won in the enclave.

Gon Sai Baau (Smart Missile) is another Australian import that is paying his way in

Macau, scoring his second win in the enclave when he powered to the line late to win under Luis Corrales for trainer Danny Wong in the Class 2 over 1200 metres on Sunday.

In a race run at hot speed, Gon Sai Baau came with a rush late to down Loxwood (Pierro) by a neck, with Famous Medal

(Benfica) a further three-quarters of a length away in third.

A five-year-old son of Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock), Gon Sai Baau raced in Australia as Final Award and he won the Canberra Guineas (Listed, 1400m) and a maiden on the Kensington track at Randwick when trained by Mark Newnham.

New stakes winners

Australia - The Chad Brown-trained Counterparty Risk (4 f ex Anklet by Acclamation) followed up her last-start Listed second with a win in the Endeavour Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Tampa Bay Downs on Saturday, becoming Australia's (Galileo) 17th individual stakes winner. Bred in Ireland and bought from Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale for £325,000 in 2018, the Klaravich Stables-owned Counterparty Risk, who is out of a half-sister to Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Steel Prince (Nathaniel), justified odds-on favouritism to defeat New York Girl (New Approach) by a length, with Margaret's Joy (English Channel) another length and a half behind in third. Australia, a three-time Group 1 winner including the 2014 Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f), has sired two top-level winners to date in Order Of Australia and Galileo Chrome. He will stand at Coolmore in Ireland for €25,000 (approx. AUD\$32,550) in 2021.

Candy Ride - The Bill Mott-trained Candy Man Rocket (3 c ex Kenny Lane by Forestry) followed up his last-start maiden success with a comfortable win in the Sam F Davis Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Tampa Bay Downs on Saturday, earning Lane's End's stallion Candy Ride (Ride The Rails) his 97th individual stakes winner. Ridden by Junior Alvarado, the three-year-old

colt finished a length ahead of stablemate Nova Rags (Union Rags) in second, with Hidden Stash (Constitution) a further neck behind in third. The Argentinian-bred Candy Ride, who has sired 16 elite-level winners, will stand at Lane's End Farm in Kentucky for USD\$75,000 (approx. AUD\$97,700) in 2021 as he closes in on a century of stakes winners.

Capitalist - Brilliant Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) winner Profiteer (2 c ex Athena Lass by Snitzel), the centre of a recent stallion deal involving Newgate Farm, enhanced his own profile and that of his first season sire Capitalist

(Written Tycoon) with his emphatic Randwick performance on Saturday. The victory provided Newgate Farm's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Capitalist with his first stakes winner, having already had five first-crop, stakes-performed two-year-olds. Capitalist covered 237 mares in 2020, his fourth season at stud, at a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

Dark Angel - The Karl Burke-trained Exalted Angel (5 g ex Hurryupharriet by Camacho) battled well to see off Fizzy Feet (Footstepsinthesand) in the Kachy Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Lingfield on Saturday to book his

place at the track's All-Weather Championships Finals Day on April 2. In doing so, he became the 68th individual stakes winner for Yeomanstown Stud stallion Dark Angel (Acclamation), who will stand for a fee of €60,000 (approx. AUD\$94,150) in 2021.

Declaration Of War - Former Coolmore shuttler Declaration Of War (War Front), who now stands in Japan, on Saturday sired his 32nd individual stakes winner when the Matt Cumani-trained Declares War (5 g ex Kristeva by Encosta De Lago) proved successful in the SAJC Birthday Cup (Listed, 2040m) at Morphettville. Ridden by Kayla Crowther, Declares War finished a length and a half ahead of Eperdument (Americain), with Medieval Miss (Camelot) a further head back in second.

Dubawi - Saeed bin Suroor trained the first three home in the Meydan Cup (Listed, 2800m) on Thursday as Dubai Future (5 g ex Anjaz by Street Cry) provided in-form jockey Frankie Dettori with his fifth winner of the Dubai World Cup Carnival and Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) with his 197th individual stakes winner. Darley stallion Dubawi, who is edging closer to his double century of individual stakes winners, will once again stand at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket for a fee of £250,000 (approx. AUD\$447,000) this year.

Fighting Sun - Consistent Tasmanian gelding Newhart (5 g ex Jestling by Commands) added to his growing record with a maiden stakes victory in Sunday's Thomas Lyons Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Hobart. The Leanne Gaffney-trained Newhart, who won the Devonport Cup (1880m) at his previous outing, is the second stakes winner for Sun Stud's late stallion Fighting Sun (Northern Meteor). In upstaging Tasmania's glamour mare Mystic Journey (Needs Further), who was sent off the \$1.20 favourite, Newhart took his career record to 14 starts for seven wins and five placings. There was a three and three-quarter length margin to spare over Mystic Journey, with Blaze Fourth (Court Command) another

one and three-quarter lengths away in third. Newhart was a \$60,000 purchase by Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds and New Zealand agent Paul Willetts at the 2017 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale from the draft of Fairway Bloodstock.

Flatter - Mouheeb (3 c ex Shananes Song by Eltish) bested a small-but-select field to take out the UAE 2,000 Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) under a beautifully timed ride from jockey Ryan Curatolo at Meydan on Thursday, earning Flatter (A P Indy) his 55th individual stakes winner. Mouheeb was narrowly denied in the Guineas Trial (1600m) last month but made no mistake this time for trainer Nicholas Bachalard, running down and overtaking Mashakel (Shamardal) just before the line to win by a neck. Naval Crown (Dubawi) was a further three and three-quarter lengths back in third. Flatter, the sire of four top-level winners, will stand at Claiborne Farm in Kentucky for \$35,000 (approx. AUD\$45,750) in 2021.

Into Mischief - The Charlie Appleby-trained Man Of Promise (4 g ex Involved by Speightstown) trounced his 13 rivals in the Dubai Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Meydan on Thursday, a race the trainer won with Baccarat (Dutch Art) in 2016 and 2018, earning Into

Mischief (Harlan's Holiday) his 85th individual stakes winner. Ridden by William Buick, Man Of Promise defeated the Frankie Dettori-ridden Final Song (Dark Angel) by three lengths, with Fleeting Prince (No Nay Never) a further one and a quarter lengths back in third. Into Mischief, sire of 2020 Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) and Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f) winner Authentic, will stand at Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky for \$225,000 (approx. AUD\$294,000) in 2021.

Jakkalberry - The late Jakkalberry (Storming Home) produced his first stakes winner on Friday when Explosive Jack (3 c ex Extra Explosive by Ekraar) took out the Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m) at Hobart. The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Explosive Jack, a \$100,000 Karaka Premier Yearling Sale purchase from the Novara Park draft, took his record to three wins from four starts, having won a 1600-metre maiden at Swan Hill and a 2400-metre Benchmark 64 at Kembla Grange prior to Friday's win.

Medaglia D'Oro - It was a super Saturday for Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado), who sired his 147th and 148th individual stakes winners courtesy of Risk Taking (3 c ex Run a Risk by Distorted Humor) in the Withers Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) at

Trained by Chad Brown, Risk Taking followed up his last-start maiden win with a devastating performance at Aqueduct, justifying favouritism to defeat Overtook (Curlin) by three and three-quarter lengths. Second favourite Capo Kane (Street Sense) finished five lengths behind the winner in third. At Santa Anita, Moonlight D'Oro also followed a last-start maiden success when landing the Las Virgenes Stakes. Trained by Richard Mandella, the three-year-old filly saw off the Bob Baffert-trained favourite Kalypso (Brody's Cause) by one and a half lengths, with Moraz (Empire Maker) another one and three-quarter lengths back in third. Medaglia D'Oro, the sire of 26 individual top-level winners, will stand at Jonabell Farm in Kentucky for a stud fee of USD\$150,000 (approx. AUD\$195,350) in 2021.

Night Of Thunder - The unbeaten Scott Brunton-trained Hela (3 f ex Smooth Return by Redoute's Choice) landed her maiden stakes success with a dominant display in Sunday's Strutt Stakes (Listed, 2100m) at Hobart, becoming the 19th stakes winner for Darley's Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) and the fourth from his sole southern hemisphere crop. A half-sister to last year's Hobart Cup winner Toorak Affair (Toorak Toff), \$1.40 chance Hela defeated Chequerboard (Fastnet Rock) by three and three-quarter lengths, with Mystique Falcon (Pride Of Dubai) a further four lengths back in third. Hela was a \$30,000 purchase by Brunton from the Alva Stud draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale. Night Of Thunder will stand at Kildangan Stud in Ireland for €75,000 (approx. AUD\$117,700) in 2021.

Orfevre - Lagom (3 c ex Sugar Shock by Candy Ride) became Orfevre's (Stay Gold) 13th individual stakes winner when he took out the Kisaragi Sho (Gr 3, 2000m) at Chukyo on Sunday. Lagom finished a narrow second to Wonderful Town (Rulership) in the Kyoto

Nisai Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) on his last start and stepped up from that performance to defeat Yoho Lake (Deep Impact) by a neck, with Land Of Liberty (Deep Impact) another three and a half lengths back in third. Orfevre, best known as the sire of Group 1 winners Epoca D'Oro and Lucky Lilac, stood at Shadai Stallion Station for JPY3,000,000 in 2020.

Per Incanto - Belle Fascino (7 m ex Playing For Keeps by Keeper)'s victory in the White Robe Lodge Stakes provided Little Avondale Stud sire Per Incanto (Street Cry) with his 18th individual stakes winner on Saturday. Ridden by Samantha Wynne, the seven-year-old got the better of Ray's In Command (Raise The Flag) by a half-neck, with a further half-head back to Goodanya (Zacinto) in third. Per Incanto is best known as the sire of Group 1 winners Shadows Cast, Dal Cielo, Santa Monica and Bonham, while Belle Fascino gained just reward for a string of consistent efforts, including a long-neck second in the Timaru Stakes (Listed, 1400m) seven days earlier.

Playing God - Ex Sport Man (2 g ex Buhn Lert by Oratorio) broke his maiden at the third attempt when taking out the Magic Millions WA 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) at Pinjarra on Saturday, earning Darling View Thoroughbreds stallion

Playing God (Blackfriars) his fourth individual stakes winner. Ex Sport Man is the first named foal out of Buhn Lert (Oratorio) and he was a \$40,000 Perth Yearling Sale buy for Commercial Bloodstock Services. Playing God is the sire of 2019 Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) winner Kay Cee and he stands for a stud fee of \$13,200.

Raise The Flag - A joint venture between owner-breeder John Phillips and Riccarton trainer Danny Crozier produced a dream result in Saturday's Dunedin Gold Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Wingatui as Madam De Soir (9 m ex Grace De Soir by Volksraad) secured her first stakes win at her 66th start. The victory was a first stakes winner for Crozier as well as the eighth individual stakes winner for White Robe Lodge resident Raise The Flag (Sadler's Wells).

Savabeel - Tilianam (2 f ex Spending by Pins) maintained her unbeaten record with an impressive come-from-behind victory in the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) at Randwick on Saturday, becoming champion New Zealand stallion Savabeel's (Zabeel) 111th individual stakes winner. Tilianam, who was an NZD\$270,000 purchase by Waterhouse and Bott at last year's New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale, had won her first start at Canberra before defeating Jamaea (Headwater)

and Testimonial (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Listed race. Fellow Sydney trainer Mark Newnham bought Tilianam's brother for NZD\$120,000 at last week's NZB sale.

Scat Daddy - Great Island (5 m ex Voyage by Rahy) took out the Suwannee River Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) at Gulfstream Park on Saturday to provide the late Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) with his 134th individual stakes winner. The Chad Brown-trained Great Island built on her last-start third at Listed level to justify favouritism at Gulfstream Park, narrowly defeating Drop A Hint (Into Mischief) by a head. Mylastfirstkiss (Flatter) was half a length further behind in third. Scat Daddy, the sire of Justify, Lady Aurelia and Caravaggio amongst a plethora of top-level performers, died as an 11-year-old at Ashford Stud in December 2015.

Shamus Award - The Lloyd Kennewell-trained four-year-old mare Ethical Solution (4 m ex Miss Ethics by Count Dubois) brought up a Group 3 win for Rosemont Stud stallion Shamus Award (Snitzel) when taking out the Bow Mistress Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Hobart on Sunday. Ethical Solution, a sister to five-time winner Ethical Dilemma, took out the feature fillies and mares race on Hobart Cup Day in dominant fashion to become the tenth individual stakes winner for 2013 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) victor Shamus Award (Snitzel). Racing in the same colours as her sire, she continued the great run of success for Shamus Award's progeny, while he stood for \$19,800 (inc. GST) at Rosemont Stud last season.

Showcasing - Former Haunui Farm shuttler Showcasing (Oasis Dream) sired his 51st individual stakes winner on Saturday when Magneto (2 c ex Trivial Pursuit by Nom Du Jeu) took out the Woburn Farm 2YO Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at New Plymouth. Showcasing's 2021 fee at Whitsbury Manor Stud in England is set at £45,000 (approx. AUD\$81,000) and he is the sire of Group 1 winners Advertise, Quiet Reflection and Mohaather, with the latter set to cover his first book at Shadwell Stud this year.

So You Think - The Mike Moroney-trained Poland (3 g ex Sun Song by Desert Sun) won the Autumn Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield on Saturday to become the 31st stakes winner for Coolmore's So You Think (High Chaparral). Selected by the trainer's agent-brother Paul Moroney from the Segenhoe Stud draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the \$170,000 purchase, who was bred by Eric Lucas, has won twice from five starts and has earnings of \$159,300 so far. So You Think, meanwhile, covered 260 mares in 2020 at a fee of \$38,500 (inc GST).

Street Boss - Darley's Northwood Park-based US shuttler Street Boss (Street Cry) unearthed his second leading Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) contender in as many years when his daughter Arcaded (2 f ex Glorette by Lonhro) won the Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 2, 1100m) at Caulfield on Saturday. The Godolphin-bred and owned, James Cummings-trained filly is Street Boss' 45th individual stakes winner, joining the likes of Hanseatic and Group 1 scorer The Quarterback as black type winners for the sire. Street Boss covered 98 mares at a service fee of \$27,500 (inc GST) in 2020.

Street Sense - The unbeaten Concert Tour (3 c ex Purse Strings by Tapit) made the step up to Graded company with ease in the San Vicente Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Santa Anita on Saturday, landing the contest to earn Street Sense (Street Cry) his 77th individual stakes winner. The Bob Baffert-trained colt finished half a length in front of stablemate Freedom Fighter (Violence), while the pair finished well clear of The Chosen Vron (Vronsky), who was another two and three-quarter lengths back in third. Street Sense, the sire of 11 individual top-level winners, will stand at Jonabell Farm for a stud fee of USD\$60,000 (approx AUD\$78,150) in 2021.

Super Easy - Spine Tingle (3 f ex Myback by Dubawi) stamped her credentials for the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Trentham in March with a stunning victory in the Oaks Prelude (Listed, 1800m) at New Plymouth on Saturday. In doing so, she became the fifth individual stakes winner for Hallmark Stud sire Super Easy (Darci Brahma). Bred and raced by the Hawkins family under their Llanhennock Trust banner, Spine Tingle went into Saturday's Listed contest as an unheralded \$17.60 chance despite a last-start victory over 1400 metres on

Spine Tingle joined Prom Queen, Easy Eddie, Super Strike and Sheezallmine as stakes winners for her sire.

To The Glory - Karate (5 h ex Lady No Punch by French Deputy) provided To The Glory (King Kamehameha) with his first stakes winner when taking out the Tokyo Shimbun Hai (Gr 3, 1600m) on Sunday. The Yoshiyasu Takahashi-trained Karate arrived at Tokyo chasing a hat-trick after successive wins at Nakayama and he was made to work hard for his first stakes success after encountering trouble in-running. Karate tracked the leaders for the majority of the straight before running out of room, forcing jockey Akira Sugawara to shift him to the right. Sugawara then surged him through a narrow gap to defeat Catedral (Heart's Cry) by a head, with Shadow Diva (Heart's Cry) a length and a quarter further back in third. To The Glory, a three-time Group 2 winner during his race career, has sired 92 winners from 159 runners.

War Front - Masteroffoxhounds (4 c ex Outstanding by Galileo) took out the San Marcos Stakes (Gr 2, 10f) at Santa Anita on Saturday to earn Claiborne Farm stallion War Front (Danzig) his 96th individual stakes winner. The winner of two of his previous eight starts, Masteroffoxhounds defeated seven-year-old favourite Acclimate (Acclamation) by one and a quarter lengths, with Starting Over (Liam's Map) another one and a half lengths back in third. War Front will stand at Claiborne for USD\$150,000 (approx. AUD\$195,350) in 2021.

Written Tycoon - The Patrick Payne-trained Double You Tee (6 g ex Kandy Korn by Flying Spur) rewarded favourite backers when taking out Sunday's Hobart Cup (Gr 3, 2400m). Ridden by Jye McNeil, \$2.80 chance Double You Tee

defeated Classic Weiwei (Shamus Award) by one and a quarter lengths, with Barade (Havana Gold) half a length further behind in third. The six-year-old gelding, who has now won nine of his 41 starts, was sold by Armidale Stud at the 2016 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale for \$115,000 to John Blacker, while the performance earned Written Tycoon (Iglesia)

his 42nd individual stakes winner. The veteran stallion stood last season at Arrowfield Stud for a fee of \$77,000 (inc GST) and with Woodside Park's recent announcement of a change in direction with its breeding stock, a decision is now eagerly awaited as to whether he will remain on the leading Hunter Valley nursery's roster next season.

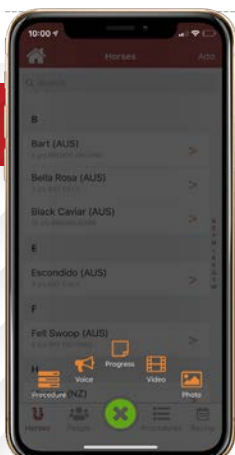

Going strongly, she looked the winner at the 100m as well as short of the post but was cut down in the last stride. Serena was third (rails) at the 600m, moved out starting the run home, challenged at the 100m and held on well for third, while House Of Cartier came from beyond midfield and ran on well between runners for fourth.
