## Valuable mare Tofane could still be on the market

*Winter carnival to determine whether daughter of Ocean Park races on next season*

Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) contender Tofane (Ocean Park), whose racetrack career was extended after connections gave up a gilt-edged opportunity to sell the valuable mare at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, could still be traded before this year's breeding season.

The Mike Moroney-trained Group 1 winner, one of the high-end attractions in a star-studded race fillies and mares session at the Gold

Coast auction last month, ran on well to finish runner-up to Emerald Kingdom (Bryannbo's Gift) in the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1350m) on May 22, a performance that convinced her owners to race her on during the Queensland winter carnival.

"There's no doubt that she was highly sought after. We had a lot of enquiry for her leading into the sale and the day beforehand, but at the end of the day it was the decision by the majority of the owners that they'd like to (continue to) race her," part-owner Rupert Legh told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. *Continued on page 2 >>*

"A lot of these people (in the ownership) haven't had good horses before and I don't think it was their primary objective to be selling her as a broodmare as they have more fun racing her.

"We've been fortunate to have good horses and if it was my choice I would have put her through the sale ring and put a high reserve on her, but they're all friends of mine, so I didn't want to deny them the opportunity of winning another Group 1.

"At the end of the day, I know money's important, but it's not everything when it comes to racing, particularly when you do have a mare of her quality.

"Hopefully she can go and win another Group 1 and justify that we didn't bring her to the sale."

Legh revealed a number of high-profile domestic and international breeders had expressed interest in Tofane and connections could again reach out to those parties if the decision is made to sell the mare privately before the start of the new stud season on September 1.

"If she came out on Saturday and won it or ran particularly

well, there's no reason why we can't negotiate with some of the major studs," he said.

"For example, Yulong, the boys down at Cotton On (Rosemont Stud), obviously Arrowfield, Newgate and there's also a Japanese stud who is very keen, so that's still a possibility.

"She can still be sold between now and August."

Tofane (\$9) drew barrier 12 at last night's Stradbroke barrier draw.

"She's a very lightly raced mare and that's a good thing. Her work today was particularly pleasing (at Eagle Farm)," Legh said yesterday.

"As a matter of fact, the reports were that it was as good as, if not better than, when she won the All Aged Stakes (last year).

"She's enjoying the environment up here and she made her intentions very clear with her last run at Doomben a couple of weeks ago.

"If she comes through the race with a fair degree of luck, I have no doubt that she will be fighting out the finish hopefully with our other horse. That would be a bit more fun."

The "other horse" Legh is referring to is his Stradbroke Handicap second favourite Wild Planet (Animal Kingdom) who last night drew barrier 15, causing him to ease in the market to \$6.50 and be displaced at the top of betting by Vega One (Lope De Vega) (\$5.50).

The Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes-trained gelding has not raced since finishing second to Eduardo (Host) in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) on May 15, his first start back since the *Continued on page 4>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on Victoria Derby day last October.

The gap between his first and second-up run was a deliberate ploy by the Hawkes, believing he performs best being kept fresh.

"They jumped him out between races at the Gold Coast on Saturday with three other horses after race one and that just took the edge off him," Legh said.

"He was a bit toey and ready to race, but that would have taken the edge off him and had him ready for Saturday's encounter.

"He's obviously enjoying the warmer climate up here, as we all do. He doesn't have the best of coats, but if anything, it's probably the best it's ever looked.

"Dropping down to 54 kilos is a massive reduction in weights compared to what he has been used to.

"Hopefully once again with some luck in running he'll be thereabouts in the finish."

Legh will also have two runners in the inaugural running of the \$1.2 million The Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) at Eagle Farm, the rejuvenated Chris Waller-trained Reloaded (Snitzel) and the Moroney-trained Hang Man (Windsor Knot).

## Vivian joins Legh's team

Meanwhile, Legh also confirmed yesterday that Simon Vivian, the respected former Inglis Victorian bloodstock manager who retired from the auction house in April, has been called on to oversee his breeding interests.

"Simon has been good enough to take on the hard task of fixing our broodmare band," he said.

"We've got a lot of them and it's just a matter of getting the formula right and making sure that we've got the quality that will ensure our yearlings get into the right sales.

"Everyone would agree that if you don't have yearlings going to the Premier, Gold Coast or Easter sales, it is a tough gig and you will lose money, not make money, so there's no better person to be out there looking after the broodmares and babies (than Simon) and hopefully we can turn our breeding business into a more profitable one."

The prominent owner has shares in stallions such as Exceedance (Exceed And Excel), Tivaci (High Chaparral), Grunt (O'Reilly), Brutal (O'Reilly) and Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) and, as a result, his broodmare band has increased in size in recent years.

"It was never our intention to be a breeder but we've been fortunate enough with the stallions we've been able to create (on the racetrack)," Legh said.

"We started off with Glass Harmonium, to a certain degree, then we had Tivaci, Grunt, Brutal, Exceedance and Alabama Express and I have still retained shareholdings in all those stallions.

"It just happened because you had to have mares to go to them. I am sure Simon will point us in the right direction and hopefully turn it into a more viable business than what it has been."

At the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Sale, Legh sold dual Group 3-winning filly Chica Fuerte (Hinchinbrook), a rising four-year-old he part-owned, for \$900,000 and reinvested in a number of mares at the auction under the Simon Vivian Bloodstock banner.

Gilgai Farm's Rick Jamieson and the breeder's stud manager Kelly Skillecorn, Blue Gum Farm's Phillip Campbell and Vinery Stud's Peter Orton have also been leaned on by Legh to help advise on his breeding interests.

"We'll definitely be supporting our own stallions but that won't be the be-all and end-all. Once again, it gets down to what stallions suit these mares and that will be the job of Simon and people like Philip Campbell, Rick and Peter Orton," he said.

"They are a great group of breeders and they have got a lot of knowledge. I think between the four of them, led by Simon, we'll get those mares to the right stallions."

## Oaks winner Personal to race in the US

VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Personal (Fastnet Rock) is moving to the US to be trained in New York by Chad Brown. The Coolmore-raced three-year-old filly, who finished runner-up to Media Award (Shamus Award) in the Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) last month, will leave Australia today after 14 starts with Lindsay Park, recording two wins and over \$1.25 million in prize-money. "The fillies and mares' Breeders' Cup would be the ultimate goal but of course, she has to travel and show her form in lead-up races," Coolmore racing manager Rob Archibald told Racing.com. "They think there is more racing in her and there is a very good opportunity in America for fillies and mares and given her form again this season, it is certainly worth a try. We have to thank the Hayes family and (Lindsay Park) stable for developing her into an incredible filly." On her potential location as a broodmare in the future, Archibald added: "It's not been decided yet but obviously having operations in Ireland, US and Australia, there are some good options for her."

## Mr Quickie in perfect order

Phillip Stokes is confident Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) topweight Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) can run a big race on Saturday. The five-year-old is a \$9.50 chance for the Group 1 after winning the Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) in April and running second in the VOBIS Gold Mile (1600m) a fortnight later. "He's never been sounder, he's a more mature horse," Stokes told RSN. "I'm really happy with him. The biggest thing with him, he's got to step and hopefully take up a midfield position and show that turn

## Members Joy up to \$570,000 on Inglis Digital

Members Joy (Hussonet), the dam of dual Group 2 winner Pure Elation (I Am Invincible), tops the Inglis Digital June (Early) Online Sale ahead of bidding closing later today. A Listed winner during her 20-start race career, in which she also placed at Group 2 level, Members Joy has seen success as a broodmare, with a record of two winners from as many runners. Her latest yearling colt by I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) sold for \$525,000 at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, while her weanling colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) was bought for \$325,000 from last month's Magic Millions National Weanling Sale. Members Joy is being offered by Segenhoe Stud in foal to Zoustar and her bid at the time of publication was \$570,000. The final countdown on bidding will commence at 12 noon today.

## 'Plain' Dragonstone heads to the races

Dragonstone (Mikki Isle) is set to make his debut at Canterbury today for Mark Newnham after finishing first and second in his two trials to date. In his first trial over 742 metres at Randwick in February Dragonstone defeated subsequent Listed winner Najmaty (I Am Invincible) and he will aim to take that form into the Blue Point @ Darley Handicap (1100m) today. "He's only a little, plain, horse and I say that with the utmost respect for his ability," Newnham told Racing NSW. "He goes quite well, he's still a little new and green and because he's only small I didn't want to trial him again and bottom him out. I thought it best to just get him to the races and let his natural ability take him a long way."

## Chouxting The Mob to resume at Sandown

Chouxting The Mob (Jimmy Choux) will return to action at Sandown on Saturday after more than a year out with a tendon injury. The Simon Morrish-trained seven-year-old finished third in the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) on his last start in March 2020 and was being primed for a run in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) before the injury. He will return in the 1800-metre handicap after contesting three recent trials, including over 1500 metres at St Arnaud last week. "He led up in that trial, he's never led up in anything in his life," Morrish said. "It was good to see him competitive and I think resuming over the 1800-metre journey is a good distance, as realistically, every run he has could be his last. I don't want to waste runs at 1400, 1600 metres. At the end of the day, he's a 2400-metre plus horse. It's a stepping stone, but I'm really pleased to have the old boy back and hopefully he can stand up."

## Dream Circle chasing hat-trick

David Payne has two winning chances engaged at Randwick on Saturday, including back-to-back winner Dream Circle (Dream Ahead) who lines up in the Benchmark 94 over 1300 metres. The four-year-old was a winner at Rosehill when fresh from a break and followed that up with a win over the track and distance he'll face on Saturday. He is likely to relish the expected conditions, with his six career wins all coming on wet tracks and Payne is confident he can be competitive again. "I must say I've never had him better," the trainer said. "He'll go around on Saturday and should get a light weight. He'll be competitive again. I'd like to get a little bit of black type somewhere; I'll step him up somewhere. But I like to just go through the grades first. He's come back this prep and he's just flying." Payne will also saddle European import Thorin (Soldier Hollow), a Group 3 winner in France, in the Racing To Win Handicap (1600m).

## Paddock for Invincible Caviar

Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible), the two-year-old daughter of Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), will be spelled following her third-placed effort on debut at Flemington at the weekend. Ridden by Brian Higgings, I Am Invincible finished two and a quarter lengths behind the winner Argentinia (Frankel). "She did a good job on Saturday, bar winning," her trainer Peter Moody told Racing.com. "She's out in the paddock now, she'll have a month or so off and come back for the back end of spring into summer racing. There I think we can place her to advantage."

## Dream not over with Clairvoyance

Darren McAuliffe has not given up on Clairvoyance (Nostradamus) making a return to racing. The three-year-old filly, a winner of five of her six starts to date, underwent surgery last week after sustaining

a leg injury at McAuliffe's Baldivis stables in April. In an accident that left both the trainer and veterinarians puzzled, Clairvoyance is thought to have struck a rail that caused bleeding from her knee and tendon sheaths. "She's back home recovering after her operation last week," McAuliffe said. "They found she had torn a ligament in her knee. As amazing as it sounds, it's the best outcome we could have hoped for. Before the operation we were fearing the worst. She's back home now in the stables recovering and the hard work starts. She'll have to be confined to a small area for a month which will be difficult, then it will be up to me to earn my keep as a trainer to bring her back. It's going to be a long and slow process, but there is light at the end of the tunnel."

## Stable mourns Pinkham

The Mick Price and Michael Kent jr-trained Pinkham (Written Tycoon) has died after suffering a perforated bowel. The three-

year-old placed at Group 3 level earlier this year and last raced in a Benchmark 70 at Sandown on March 31. "She had a perforated bowel. Perfect one day, a little bit sick in the morning, straight to hospital and (she had) peritonitis, a perforated bowel," Price told RSN927. "Unfortunately it's a huge loss."

## Allen hurt in Pakenham fall

Ben Allen was taken to hospital following a fall at Pakenham yesterday. Allen was riding the Phillip Stokes-trained Sheza Sniper (Shooting To Win) in the 2200-metre Benchmark 58 handicap when he fell approaching the home corner. He was conscious following the fall and was taken to hospital as a precaution. Allen was discharged later in the evening having been cleared of any fractures. Sheza Sniper was fine following the incident.

## Richards making most of Victorian move

Apprentice jockey Josh Richards has hit a purple patch of form since joining Victoria's jockey ranks. The 27-year-old, who is from Wagga and is on a three-month loan at Cranbourne to Michael Kent, has ridden ten winners from his past 50 rides, having been supported by stables such as Lindsay Park and Ciaran Maher and David Eustace. "Probably the first couple of weeks took me a little bit (of time) to get used to the tracks, and other riders and the way they're (races) run, but I didn't quite think that I'd have the success for the trainers that I'm riding a lot for and getting a lot of good rides for," Richards, a former apprentice builder, told Racing.com. On his future, Richards added: "I'm obviously on loan for three months. We're going to see if I can get any more time extended on to that and then kind of go from there, so whether they let me stay down here or what the go is (I don't know yet), but it would be great to (stay)."

## Phelps disqualified for four months

Trainer Steven Phelps has been handed a four-month ban by Racing NSW stewards

after an incident forced his horse My Cousin James (One Lickety Split) to have his tongue surgically removed. Stewards established that Phelps applied an approved tongue tie to the four-year-old on the morning of April 1, 2021 for track work, but failed to remove the tongue tie until later that afternoon. As a result, My Cousin James lost vascular supply to part of his tongue, resulting in it becoming necrotic and having to be surgically removed. Phelps was charged with failing to take reasonable care to prevent an act of cruelty to My Cousin James and was disqualified immediately, with the ban set to expire on October 4.

## Siblings Schmetzer and Boyd penalised over altercation

Racing NSW also conducted an inquiry yesterday into an allegation of assault committed by Mark Schmetzer on his sister Tammy Boyd on May 10. Schmetzer was found guilty of improper conduct, which involved forcibly grabbing Boyd, and was handed a three-month suspension of his training licence and a fine of \$4000. However, the suspension was fully suspended on the basis Schmetzer does not offend the conduct rules for a period of two years. Boyd was fined \$1000 for entering Schmetzer's stables without his permission and \$500 of that fine was suspended.

## Swan Hill restricted to crowd of 50

The Swan Hill carnival will be restricted to just 50 people following the Covid-19 outbreak in Melbourne, leaving the racecourse facing a "massive hit" having expected crowds of up to 4500 to attend the final day of the carnival on Sunday. "We had over \$250,000 worth of ticket sales that had already been processed and they have now been fully refunded, so it's a massive hit to the club," Swan Hill Racing Club chief executive Aaron Garvie told RSN927. "The only one good thing about this is we will still be racing. It is terrible timing for us. Right now, under the rules, we can just have 50 on site, so the committee have made the difficult decision to refund all our package-holders across Friday, Saturday and

Sunday because of the unknown and know we just have to wait to hear of any easing of restrictions this week."

## NEW ZEALAND

### Sweynesse's fee confirmed

Novara Park stallion Sweynesse's (Lonhro) service fee will rise to \$9,000 (plus GST) for the forthcoming breeding season. Sweynesse was New Zealand's leading first season sire on stakes winners, winners, and earnings for the 2019-2020 season, and his progeny have continued to excel at the top level. Sweynesse was well-represented at Queensland's winter carnival by his three-year-old daughters Only Words and Signora Nera. The former won The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) having earlier placed in the Gold Coast Bracelet (Listed, 1800m), while Signora Nera also placed in the Gold Bracelet and Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m). "Sweynesse's statistics are outstanding," Novara Park principal Luigi Muollo said. "He provides proven value as a sire who is on the way up. He is an easy choice for breeders." Also on the Novara roster are Staphanos (Deep Impact) and newcomer King Of Comedy (Kingman), who will both stand for \$7,000 (plus GST).

## Talented Tevere to step up in trip

Promising filly Tevere (Contributer) will step up to 1400 metres for the first time at Te Rapa this weekend. The three-year-old filly has pleased in her previous two starts over 1200 metres, including a win at Te Rapa last month, and her connections believe she will appreciate the step up in distance on Saturday. "She has shown promise all along," Pam Gerard, who trains Tevere in partnership with Michael Moroney, said. "She was very good at the trials, and good right through, but she is a little bit of a hot-headed filly and she has just taken a little while to put it all together. We have always known she has had plenty of ability, right from when she went through her ready-to-run prep. She showed us raceday (last start) what she had been showing us in her work. She is still a little bit green and I think she is only going to get better once she gets up to 1400 metres, and I think she can go through the grades."

## Integrity Board members announced

The new Racing Integrity Board will be up and running from July 1 to ensure high standards of animal welfare, integrity and professionalism in the racing industry. Racing minister Grant Robertson yesterday announced the appointments to the new board: Sir Bruce Robertson KNZM (chair), Kristy McDonald ONZM QC, Penelope Mudford ONZM, Dr Patricia Pearce and Brent Williams. "Our racing industry relies on the highest standards of ethics and animal welfare in all three racing codes," Robertson said. "This requires constant vigilance, which is why the new Racing Integrity Board is being set up to replace the current integrity system. The board will be able to impose penalties on those who breach the industry's rules, including people who put the health and wellbeing of animals at risk. New Zealanders expect racing to be safe for the animals involved and fair for punters. The board will help provide this assurance, which can only be good for the racing industry."

## ASIA

### HK: In-form Poon to keep roll going

After riding consecutive doubles at the past two race meetings, Matthew Poon is looking to continue his fine form when he heads to Happy Valley's midweek fixture with a full book of rides and his sights on a new personal best. "Lately, the horses have had good draws and a bit of luck, so I'm pretty lucky but I'm happy that I can get on some nice horses too," Poon said. "I always feel good if I can keep improving or increase my number of winners - that's what I hope to achieve each season." Having already surged past last year's score of 29 victories, Poon is now aiming for a new high as he sits just one shy of his best ever season's tally of 35 wins, which he recorded in consecutive campaigns (2017-18 and 2018-19). "I think the most important thing is my discipline in races, I ride competitively but I'm riding more carefully by trying to make less mistakes and not causing trouble or getting suspended - I am more controlled and more disciplined in races," he added.

and played a leading role in Juddmonte's consistent and sustained success worldwide at the very highest level in racing. On behalf of Prince Khalid's family and all of us past and present at Juddmonte, I thank Teddy for all he has achieved, year after year, and we wish him the very best of good fortune for the future." He added: "We are delighted Barry is taking on the additional European racing role. He is ideally placed to take on Teddy's duties in Europe and, together with Rory (Mahon) continue to manage Juddmonte Ireland."

### UK: Vale Twink Allen

Professor William 'Twink' Allen, the leader in his field of equine fertility, has died aged 80 after a short illness. Born in New Zealand, Allen had been a well-known figure in Newmarket for many years and is the father of Catherine Dettori, wife of jockey Frankie. A graduate of veterinary medicine from the University of Sydney, he was a director of the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Equine Fertility Unit, a professor at the University of Cambridge and held numerous other research positions. He was awarded a CBE in 2002. He was particularly known for his work in assisted reproductive technologies, carrying out pioneering methods of embryo recovery and transfer in mares and studies of hormones and ultrasonography.

### US: Vale Rick Porter

Prominent American owner Rick Porter has died at the age of 80 after a long battle with cancer. Porter had huge success in ownership, racing 20 Graded winners and three Eclipse Award winners - Kodiak Kowboy (Posse), Songbird (Medaglia D'Oro) and Havre De Grace (Saint Liam). Among his successes, Porter won the Breeders' Cup Distaff (Gr 1, 9f) in 2006 with Round Pond (Awesome Again) and the King's Bishop Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) with Hard Spun (Danzig) in 2007.

## Callan twist to HKJC announcement as Ferraris accepts hometown challenge

The Hong Kong Jockey Club's (HKJC) announcement on Monday that Luke Ferraris will be licensed to ride in Hong Kong next season is a welcome tonic for a stale jockey roster, but the fact that the bright young star of South African racing is the only new name speaks volumes.

According to sources, a recent closed meeting between trainers and club officials included a forthright sharing of views, during which the HKJC's executive director of racing Andrew Harding admitted it was difficult to attract riders to the city. Covid concerns and restrictions may be one factor, while the continuing dominance of Joao Moreira and Zac Purton surely makes the proposition tougher for officials to sell; and Christophe Soumillon's pointed remarks earlier this year about the lack of quality rides during his winter stint, which was hampered by suspensions, plus the fallout from Neil Callan's harsh suspension at a controversial show cause hearing, cannot be discounted either.

Callan was not among the 22 jockeys licensed for the 2021-22 season but that strange saga continued even as the licensing committee was weighing up its options. The usual course of action would be for the HKJC to send a letter to each licensed jockey several weeks in advance of the committee meeting, asking them to apply for a new licence. Callan, sources said, did not receive that letter but was approached at trackwork last Friday by a senior HKJC executive and asked verbally if he would apply. The rider, whose wife and children are now in England, responded in the negative to the unconventional approach.



But, in an unusual twist, on Monday afternoon the HKJC made a belated formal written invitation to the jockey – with the licensing decision imminent – to apply before an extended deadline of this Friday, giving Callan an unexpected decision to make.

Hong Kong offers some of the best prize-money in the world, jockeys race twice a week and most live on-site at Sha Tin in HKJC-provided apartments: but they must also deal with intense scrutiny and the mental rigours of fighting for rides in a place where a scenario such as last weekend's widespread consternation-turned-celebration in Britain at Adam Kirby being jocked off his Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) ride, only to pick up the winner, would not have raised an eyebrow.

Whether he continues in Hong Kong or not, Callan has hacked out a niche in the ruthless environment, showing mental fortitude and an unvarnished approach that enabled him to forge a good career as a middle-ranking stalwart.

"Neil Callan has a very strong mentality and it helps. You need to be solid, to be a really tough person. Some jockeys make good

results and some just run away," said Umberto Rispoli, the Santa Anita-based former Italian champion who rode in Hong Kong from 2012 until December 2019.

Karis Teetan, meanwhile, has worked hard to advance since he arrived in 2014 and has established a position just behind the top two in the premiership but he, too, must deal with losing big-race mounts to the alpha pair.

"When I first started, I had to accept that if I was riding a good horse, Zac or Joao would take it in the big races," he said. "It's frustrating now if it happens but I still have to know this is how it goes because otherwise it holds you back. But it's a hard pill to swallow if you're taken off a good horse going into the big races."

Teetan continues to battle whereas Rispoli left the city, dissatisfied with the lack of opportunities and lamenting a lack of loyalty among trainers and owners.

"The positive is that you build a strong mind in Hong Kong," the Italian noted. "You learn how to deal with people: in Hong Kong there are no agents, so the jockey has to do it. You do that as best you can and try to pick up the best horse you can in the field: that is never easy



because trainers will always look for Zac and Joao as priority, because they think they can do something different with the horses.”

One skill vital to success in Hong Kong is that of breaking quickly from the gates and finding a position. A rider must not only have a plan A but also a B, a C and perhaps a plan D for good measure.

“The brilliance of Purton and Moreira is their gate jumping and it just gives them that added extra option after 100 metres of racing of where they want to be in the run, it just gets them so many more options,” said trainer Richard Gibson. “That’s the only advice I give these new jockeys when they arrive and they all look at me rather strangely: ‘Don’t jump last out of the gates because people will mark you very quickly.’”


Rispoli acknowledged that learning to adapt to the racing pattern in Hong Kong has helped him in his career, yet he sees problems with the strict rules enforced, for example, if a jockey crosses in the opening stages before they are fully two lengths clear.

“There’s no other place in the world where you’re watching jockeys looking on the inside for at least 300 or 400 metres before they cross. It’s an easy way to get suspended. The problem is, you then lose business, you lose rides and someone else picks up your business, so that puts you in an awkward spot,” he said.

In the past few years, the long list of riders to have failed to secure a foothold in Hong Kong features Andrea Atzeni, who lasted only a few weeks, Damian Lane, Tom Queally, Colm O’Donoghue, Gavin Lerena and Mirco Demuro, while the jury is out on current incumbents including Blake Shinn, Ruan Maia, Vagner Borges and Antoine Hamelin.

The biggest names, like Ryan Moore, Hugh Bowman, James McDonald, Christophe Soumillon and Silvestre de Sousa, have been content to commit only to short contracts or hit-and-run assaults on the majors rather than take a risk on entering the Purton and Moreira domain full-time.

This season, Moreira leads the premiership with 138 wins to Purton’s 116, with a long gap back to next-best Teetan on 68 wins. Between them, the big two have taken 14 per cent of the rides and account for 34 per cent of all winners.

Sam Clipperton appeared to have cracked the puzzle with 40 wins in his first season after arriving in 2016, but support dropped away thereafter, resulting in the offer of only a six-month contract in his third term, by the end of which he had had enough.

“I don’t begrudge someone like Zac Purton,” he said. “Zac’s been there for 14 years and those first four or five years, he had to deal with all the same pressures, getting taken off horses; and at the time he was trying to establish, he’d have probably had Douglas Whyte doing the same as he and Joao are doing now. He had to face all the same adversity.”

Clipperton returned to Sydney in early 2019 but found he was “burnt out” and took a four-and-a-half-month sabbatical.

“It was the intensity of three years of Hong Kong and then thinking I could slip back into Sydney,” he continued. “I went from riding twice a week in a pretty cushy lifestyle to riding five or six days a week with three or four hours travelling.”

Clipperton said he had pondered whether he had any regrets about moving to Hong Kong, given that Sydney racing has become “just as competitive and ruthless” therefore making it difficult to re-establish himself, but he comes down on the “no regrets” side.

“I’m pretty proud that I gave it a red-hot crack,” he said. “I sometimes go back and watch my Hong Kong replays if I need a bit of motivation for here and I look at the riders I was against, like Ryan Moore, Christophe Soumillon, Douglas Whyte and Zac.”

Rispoli believes the current crop of riders lacks the depth of quality Hong Kong had around a decade ago when the line-up featured Whyte, Darren Beadman, Brett Prebble, Gerald Mosse and Olivier Doleuze, with Purton among those grafting away in mid-table.

“The first time I went to Hong Kong, the roster was much stronger than the one they have now,” he opined. “When you have a strong roster, the jockeys actually have more opportunity. When you reduce that quality and everyone is just looking for Joao and Zac, that makes it harder to get the good rides than when the roster is strong and those rides are spread around.”

Ferraris, 19, a two-time champion apprentice, will step into the cauldron and have to prove himself quickly.

“When I got on the plane to come here, I knew, although I was top five in South Africa, I’d have to start from zero,” Teetan said. “I had this mindset that to come here and be successful, you have to take Hong Kong like it’s your home.”

That should not be a problem for Ferraris, whose childhood home is at Sha Tin where his father, David Ferraris, has held a trainer’s licence since 2003. An exciting prospect with five Group 1 wins already on the board, his supportive family, as well as the HKJC, will be hoping he can tap some Callan-like fortitude and succeed where in recent seasons his precocious countrymen Callan Murray and Lyle Hewitson, like so many talented others, found the Hong Kong challenge a test too far.

## Has The Derby - “The Derby” - lost its standing among the world’s great races?

In keeping with the spirit of mischief which was surely behind Peter Moody’s declaration that Australian trainers are better than their English and European counterparts, let’s have a crack at an ever holier grail.

The Derby. The one run at Epsom Downs which apparently, like its golfing equivalent, needs no designation other than “The”. The Derby; The Open.

Described as the “world’s greatest flat race” as recently as last week in the Racing Post. Described as the “ultimate test” and “our signature race” by ITV’s Ed Chamberlin before last Saturday’s 2021 edition of the 2400 metres Classic.

I’m not so sure. Could it be, just maybe, it’s been in decline over the past ten years and is not the hallowed race it once was?

Last year it was ranked as low as the equal 93rd race in the world. In the past decade, the Derby has yielded just one genuinely great winner in Golden Horn (Cape Cross)...plus two good winners - Australia and Anthony Van Dyck by Galileo (Sadler’s Wells). The other seven had no claim to star status on the racetrack - notwithstanding that Wings Of Eagles (Pour Moi) had just one more run and won an edition of some depth.

Only Golden Horn and Australia, among those ten winners from 2011, would go on to beat all comers at Group 1 level. From 2000 to 2010, by comparison, seven Derby winners would win against older horses at Group 1 level including three to take the Prix de l’arc de Triomphe.

The Derby, of course, may simply have gone through something of a mixed decade and will resurrect itself again. After all, the decade from 2000 was much more in line with the word Classic given the winners included Sinnadar (Grand Lodge), Galileo (Sadler’s Wells), High Chaparral (Sadler’s Wells), New Approach (Galileo), Authorized (Montjeu), Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) and Workforce (King’s Best) and was a stronger race than through the 1990s.

The Derby’s mystique seemingly remains centred on the remarkable deeds of Coolmore’s 12- time champion stallion Galileo who won the race in 2001 and has subsequently sired five winners of it. But he is simply a freak and an exception to the rule. You have to go back to the 1980s to find a previous Derby-winning champion stallion - Nijinsky (Northern

Dancer) and Mill Reef (Never Bend) who were Derby winners during a lustrous 70s decade which is now a long, long time ago.

The uniqueness of the course probably means the Derby remains a test but a test of what? Perhaps not sustained speed or class these days. No subsequent winner has gone within cooee of Workforce’s 2010 course record.

In fairness, the race’s contemporary honour roll is probably no worse (or better) than that of the French or Irish equivalent or even that of a resurgent Japan. However, it is moderate compared to the list of Kentucky Derby winners over the past decade, notwithstanding whatever shadow you may choose to believe hangs over that race.

This year’s winner Adayar (Frankel) has been tagged as the most visually impressive winner since Golden Horn but surely judgment

must be, at least, reserved as he and 50-1 runner-up Mojo Star (Sea The Stars) hugged the rail and the fresh ground throughout which earlier winners on the card Parent's Prayer and Oh This Is Us had indicated was advantageous.

Adayar, whose win was sweetly complemented for Godolphin when Essential Quality (Tapit) took the Belmont Stakes hours later, scored decisively but so too did Serpentine (Galileo) last year and he's not been competitive since.

The win was also further testimony to the capability of trainer Charlie Appleby who won Godolphin's first (Epsom) Derby with Masar (New Approach) in 2018. The trainer who became the first of his countrymen to train a Melbourne Cup winner. An Englishman who could more than reasonably take offence to being labelled as inferior to Australian trainers - especially given his record in Australia.

This year's Derby may prove to be above average. Only time will tell, but I doubt it.

I don't mind the winner's stablemate Hurricane Lane (Frankel) who was third. The Dante winner lost both front plates and may have benefitted from firmer ground at Epsom. However, 24 later at Chantilly, two horses with form around Hurricane Lane (and indeed Adayar) disappointed in the French Derby - namely Megallan (Kingman) and El Drama (Lope De Vega).

Alenquer (Alderflug) and Yibir (Dubawi), who finished alongside Adayar in the Sandown Classic Trial, are likely bound for the King Edward VII Stakes at Royal Ascot which will further add to the form story but it's one which already looks a touch suspect.

The Oaks, admittedly, has had no recent decline to suggest some endemic problem with three-year-olds crops.

Five of the previous ten Oaks winners, before Snowfall's 16-length romp last Friday,

could be reasonably described as high class - Taghrooda (Sea The Stars), Minding (Galileo), Enable (Nathaniel), Forever Together (Galileo) and Love (Galileo). All bar Minding, won by big margins - albeit well short of 16 lengths.

Snowfall (Deep Impact) set a record winning Oaks margin on ground which was much softer than on Derby day - bettering the previous best of 12 lengths by Sun Princess (English Prince) in 1983. Sun Princess, incidentally, was then beaten in the King George before taking the Yorkshire Oaks and St Leger and finishing second in the Arc.

The Oaks runner-up Mystery Angel (Kodi Bear) is prepared by young training sensation George Boughey who, earlier, on the Oaks card had further improved his outstanding record with two-year-olds, claiming the Woodcote Sakes with Oscula (Galileo Gold).

It was Boughey's win which had me musing, if only to myself watching the overnight coverage, about Moody's comments and the standing of the Classics.

The training and racing world, if not in the past, is now well and truly entwined with only the training grounds a likely significant difference between the southern and northern hemisphere feeding and methods. Boughey, who has a 31 per-cent strike rate with his juveniles on turf and excelling in just his second season as a trainer, may have learnt something about two-year-olds during his stint with Gai Waterhouse, who also housed his former boss Hugo Palmer for a time. Or maybe not. Boughey also worked for Lloyd Williams.

Just as Michael Kent junior and Calvin McEvoy, and others, may or may not have learned something different about preparing staying horses during their time as pupil assistants in Newmarket.

The top stable in Australia, right now, is of course headed by a New Zealander. Number two is the partnership of an Aussie and a Pom and it was them, Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, who tutored Australian-based English woman Annabel Neasham whose deeds with Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux) prompted Moody's musing that our trainers are better than Europeans (if you follow or, indeed, if that makes any sense?).

God bless "Moods" really. He was stirring the pot - musing rather than accusing - which he

has licence to do, unlike racing journalists who are generally expected to be cheerleaders rather than commentators. Nobody bats an eyelid if the form of a footballer is questioned but woe betide the racing scribe who dares suggest the same with a trainer or jockey or questions the quality of a horse, race or stallion.

"Maybe he beat up on old pensioners, maybe, I don't know," Moody said of Zaaki after his seven-length Group 1 Doomben Cup win - effectively answering his own question as to whether Neasham had dramatically improved the horse on Sir Michael Stoute.

It's extremely unlikely that she has done that, notwithstanding that she clearly has the horse in great order and form and deserves plaudits for that. Similarly, it's unlikely that Moody made Manighar (Linamix) hugely faster or better than Luca Cumani. He just ran him in shorter races which may have been genius on his part or the dictate of genetic testing or both.

Zaaki, like Manighar, had very good Group 2 and Group 3 form in the UK and, for as long as I can remember, that translates to Group 1 form in Australia as we simply have less depth at the top end.

The English and Irish and some European horses - at 1600 metres plus - are simply better than ours - whether trained by us or them. That's the way their breeding is slanted. The evidence is overwhelming. Perhaps even damning when you consider that Best Solution (Kodiac), Sir Dragonet (Camelot) and Rekindling (High Chaparral) - who could not finish in the first four in the Epsom Derby and had not won at Group 1 level on English or Irish soil - have recently annexed Melbourne's three flagship spring races.
