Acrobat bounces back from life-threatening illness to target Coolmore Stud Stakes

Exciting Fastnet Rock colt on way to Melbourne to start spring preparation with Maher and Eustace

Acrobat (Fastnet Rock), a one-time Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite and this season's forgotten juvenile, will be given the chance to make up for lost time as a three-year-old after winning a remarkable life-and-death battle with illness.

In what seemed like a fairly innocuous incident in February, on the eve of the

Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) raceday at Randwick, Acrobat suffered a cut to his left hock while on the walker at trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace's Warwick Farm stables.

Initially, the injury was not thought to be serious and plans were still being made for the Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) winner to be aimed at the Sydney series of rich feature juvenile races, the Slipper being the number one target.

Member's Joy sells for \$800,000 to shine bright on Inglis Digital

But, as Acrobat's breeder and co-owner James Bester explained this week, things went from bad to worse for the colt as veterinarians struggled to get on top of a subsequent infection in his hock.

"The cut itself was not an issue, but he developed an infection there that proved very resistant to antibiotics and at one stage he was in a fair bit of trouble," Bester said.

"Thankfully, they found an antibiotic, about the fourth one they tried, that knocked out the bug.

"The process was uneventful from there on in, but he'd spent a lot of time in hospital immobile, so we sent him to Emeran Park for rehabilitation on a treadmill there.

"He did a couple of months walking and trotting on the treadmill and then he was put under saddle.

"Again, he started with trotting and he is now cantering under saddle and he has completed his rehab.

"He is 100 per cent sound, in great physical and mental shape and he travels on Thursday."

The Coolmore-raced Acrobat, a son of top-class producing mare Hips Don't Lie (Stravinsky), will be sent to Maher and Eustace's Melbourne stables today to begin what is hoped will be a Group 1-winning spring campaign.

Bester and Coolmore Australia's racing manager Rob Archibald

were on hand at Emeran Park yesterday to see Acrobat's final piece of work before heading south for "his ultimate goal of the Coolmore".

"He was hospitalised and bandaged while they were treating the infection for some time and that put paid to all Golden Slipper or Queensland carnival aspirations, so the long-term goal was set and he is absolutely on track for that now," Bester said.

"Ciaran will take him along, but all things going well, he will be set for a couple of trials during September and then in early October starting off probably down the straight at Flemington. There's an 1100-metre Listed race (the Poseidon Stakes)."

Bester has no doubt that Acrobat, who has only been seen once in public via his two-and-a-quarter-length victory in the \$500,000 Inglis Nursery at Randwick on December 12, has the credentials to win a Coolmore, the same race another son of Fastnet Rock (Danehill), Merchant Navy, won in 2017.

That belief is backed up by the statistics, which show the progeny of champion sire Fastnet Rock who are able to race well prior to Christmas in their two-year-old season generally develop into elite performers on the track.

They include Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Catchy, New Zealand's champion Advantage, Group 2 winners Smart Missile and Anaheed, and Missrock, who placed three times in Group 1 company.

"Those that have done that had a very high strike-rate of continuing on to becoming very good horses," he said.

"We're obviously very hopeful because with ... the obvious speed that he showed in the Inglis Nursery, his precocity to race before Christmas, combined with his looks make him a very exciting potential stallion.

"We're very hopeful that he

returns to his best and lines up in the Coolmore."

Acrobat, a brother to stakes winners Lake Geneva and Ennis Hill, is the seventh foal out of Hips Don't Lie, the 2008 Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner.

Her eighth foal, a daughter of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), brought \$1.95 million at this year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

The filly was bought by agent Sheamus Mills, who referenced Acrobat's ability when extending the budget to buy the valuable yearling.

But the past two years have proven tough going for Hips Don't Lie, slipping and missing in both 2019 and 2020.

"We're hoping to get her in foal early this coming season," Bester said.

"We haven't set a mating for her yet, but obviously Wootton Bassett is our hot new kid on the block and he would probably be favourite to cover her, but Justify's always there, another horse we have enormous faith in."

Six for Maurice

Maurice (Screen Hero) sired his sixth individual winner from his first Australian crop when Sharp Response (2 g ex Marli Magic by Host) got off the mark on his racecourse debut with a victory in a two-year-old maiden over 1108 metres at Sale yesterday. The Julius Sandhu-trained gelding scored by a head under Beau Mertens with Tranquil Bay (Cable Bay) filling second spot. The Art Of Flying (Flying Artie) finished a length behind the winner in third. "He was a nice-looking horse and he went a little cheaper than I thought as he had some growing to do," Sandhu said of the \$70,000 buy out of the Flinders Park Stud draft at the 2020 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale. "He was not very big at the time. We gelded him and he grew a bit and I think if we turn him out, he will grow even more and furnish into a nice horse. The one thing about him is he's very athletic and a very sound horse. He does a lot right at home. He doesn't act up a lot and is very professional on the track. It will be nice if he goes home, eats up and then we'll have the hard decision to make, but it's a good problem to have." Sharp Response is the second foal and first winner out of the Host (Hussonet) mare Marli Magic, herself the winner of five of her 30 starts. Maurice will be back at Arrowfield in 2021 for a fee of \$44,000.

Nine for Flying Artie

Newgate Farm's Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) added a ninth winner from his first crop courtesy of the highly thought of Almighty Rising (2 g ex Dawn Almighty by Danehill), who won a close finish at Canterbury yesterday,

defeating Celtic Harp (No Nay Never) by a nose in the 1100-metre two-year-old handicap. Trained by Team Hawkes, Almighty Rising contested the Blue Diamond Prelude (Group 3, 1100m) on debut, finishing at the tail of the 11-runner field having led them up to the 400-metre mark, but co-trainer Michael Hawkes said the fact he debuted in the Prelude was an indication of the ability of the Almighty Rising. "Obviously in Melbourne, Wayne had a bit of an opinion of this horse and we put him in the deep end and it just didn't come to hand that day," he said. "He went to the paddock, we gelded him and tried to make a racehorse of him. He's still wanting to learn a bit. He's still running around a little bit in the straight but when he gets his mind to it and gets his mind on the job, I think he's going to be a nice horse." Having passed in as a yearling he was retained to race by Newgate Farm, along with partners Horse Ventures and WinStar Farm. Out of Dawn Almighty (Danehill), Almighty Rising is a half-brother to New Zealand Group 1 winner Ruud Awakening (Bernardini). Flying Artie will stand the 2021 season at Newgate Farm for a fee of \$33,000 (inc. GST).

Gollan bullish on Vega One ahead of Stradbroke

Tony Gollan is confident he has Vega One (Lope De Vega) in top shape as the five-year-old attempts to complete back-to-back elite-level victories in Saturday's \$1.5 million Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm. Vega One's first three runs back from a spell dating back to last year's Stradbroke all resulted in him peaking on his run and just fading at the finish.

It was a different story in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) last month, when Jamie Kah

was able to produce him late for an explosive finishing burst. That run shot him to the top of the Stradbroke betting and Gollan believes he will be even better this weekend. "I didn't make any secret of the fact we had a minor setback from the 10,000 in. Even looking at him on Kingsford-Smith day he had improvement in him. I think he's found it," Gollan said. "I think he's at the top of his game now. It was always the plan to get to the Stradbroke as good as we could and I feel that's where we got him. It took a little while to get him into shape. He's in great shape now and he's out to his right distances in the right races." Vega One firmed in Stradbroke betting after drawing barrier four on Tuesday night. Gollan also has Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) as the first emergency in the Stradbroke.

Dabernig after one more Group 1 with Lindsay Park

Tom Dabernig is hopeful So Si Bon (So You Think) will be able to provide him with a 20th Group 1 win as a training partner with the Hayes family before he heads out on his own at the end of next month. The seven-year-old is an outsider for the Stradbroke, where he will be ridden by Blaike McDougall for the first time competitively, in what will be his 66th start. Craig Williams was on board last time out when finishing 14th of 15 runners in the Kingsford-Smith Cup and Dabernig told RSN: "He drew an inside gate and we fell into the trap of riding him forward. He did win the Caulfield race leading, but that was a different tempo. Back to the 1300 metres, the pressure had him out of his comfort zone. He was beaten 3.8 lengths and on Saturday he's drawn barrier nine, so he can be ridden where he can balance up and hopefully get dragged into it."

TAB Stradbroke Day is the Grand Final of Stradbroke Season, featuring nine stakes worth \$4.95million, headed by two Group 1 races and the new-look \$1.2M Sky Racing Q22.

The TAB Stradbroke has long been regarded as Queensland's greatest race, with the handicap conditions over Eagle Farm's testing 1400m providing the perfect challenge for horses, trainers and jockeys.

This year's field looks as even as any in recent memory, with a good spread of locals taking on the interstaters.

The Group 1 Treasury Brisbane J.J. Atkins is one of the best nurseries in Australian racing, with so many future Group 1 stars graduating from its ranks. Converge and Port Louis, second and third in the Sires Produce, head betting for this year's event.

The Sky Racing Q22 has lured the awesome Channel 7 Doomben Cup winner Zaaki, who is out to justify favouritism for the Cox Plate with another dominant weight-for-age outing.

TAB Stradbroke Day also includes the Lexus Brisbane Cup back to 3200m, the Group 2 Magic Millions Dane Ripper and the RadioTAB The Wayne Wilson Mile.

Barrier beneficial to favourite's Atkins tilt

Connections plan to use Converge's (Frankel) better barrier to their advantage in Saturday's J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) but are mindful not to dull his brilliant turn of foot. The gelding stormed from last to just miss in the BRC Sires' Produce (Gr 2, 1400m) last month after striking trouble in the straight. Off the back of that, he's been installed as a warm favourite for the Atkins, firming further after drawing gate five, compared to key betting rival Port Louis (Maurice) drawing out in 13. "No doubt there's benefit to riding him conservatively," said Adrian Bott, who trains the gelding in partnership with Gai Waterhouse. "He has a great turn of foot as we have seen, we saw that before going into the Sires' and that was the plan going into that run. From that barrier we had, it forced us to go back further than we anticipated in the run. Hopefully (on Saturday) we can land in a position where he's a bit more prominent in the race." Converge turned in a

brilliant course proper gallop before the Sires', but Bott said his work was framed differently on Tuesday as he prepared to go back to the mile. "With the benefit of that run, (Tuesday's work) was enough to keep him up to the mark. He didn't need to be asked as much. He worked over a little further, but I still really liked the way he went about it and that's the main thing."

Connections expecting improvement from Tiger Of Malay

Michael and Richard Freedman will be on the hunt for another big two-year-old prize when Tiger Of Malay (Extreme Choice) attempts to back up his win the BRC Sires' Produce in the J J Atkins. The brothers won the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) back in March with Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) and on Saturday will be out to pounce in the final juvenile Group 1 of the season. Tiger Of Malay will jump from barrier 11 under Craig Williams and Michael Freedman told Racing.com: "Obviously, you'd

want to avoid being trapped wide and all that, but I think if he can find the right spot where Craig can just get him to relax with a bit of cover or something, then I think he showed the other day having to do a bit of work, he was still there at the end and Craig was adamant when he got off the horse that the horse would run a mile." Freedman said that Tiger Of Malay's work since his last-start win had been good. "We sent him down, as we did before the Sires' Produce, he went down to Kolora Lodge, which is just outside of Brisbane," he said. "He had four or five days there, doing some equestrian work and going out in the paddock, just to keep him fresh and keep him mentally fresh."

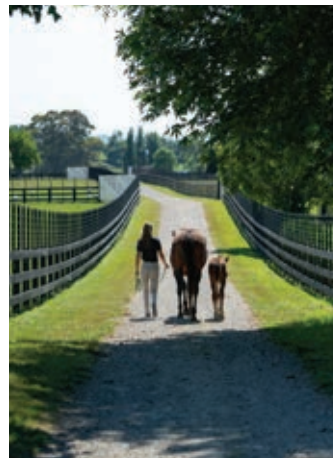

Don't write off Homesman says Freedman

The betting may suggest Zaaki (Leroidsanimaux) is already home and hosed in Saturday's Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) but Sam Freedman has warned punters not to write off the chances of Homesman (War Front). The Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner is one of three possibles in the inaugural running of the Eagle Farm heat for Freedman and his father Anthony, along with Warning (Declaration Of War) and Le Don De Vie (Leroidsanimaux). "Just watching his replay from the other day, he looks like he might want that sort of trip (2200 metres) now and I think he looks like he's primed and ready to run a big race," Freedman told Racing.com. "He worked strongly on Tuesday, he's never been a flashy track worker, but it was actually really good from him. I think he and Warning have got very similar chances in the race and one of them is 30-1 and one of them is 10-1."

Delphi set for Aussie debut

Earlier on the Eagle Farm card, the former Aidan O'Brien-trained Delphi (Galileo) will make his debut for the Freedmans when he lines up in the Wayne Wilson Stakes (Listed, 1600m) in what is likely to be his sole Queensland start. "Ultimately, the big carrot will be to go toward a Melbourne Cup," Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "That was, more or less, what he was purchased for, to go down that sort of path, but obviously there are plenty in that same boat when they're purchased and that doesn't eventuate. We'll get him to the races on Saturday and then look to map a path toward the spring." Delphi won four of his five starts

in Ireland for O'Brien, the most recent coming when defeating Master Of Reality (Frankel) in the Irish St Leger Trial (Gr 3, 1m 6f) at the Curragh back in August.

Bridesmaid Rondinella set for Brisbane Cup date

Perennial bridesmaid Rondinella (Ocean Park) looks to have her best chance of nabbing a staying feature when she contests the Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. The John O'Shea-trained mare was prominent over the Sydney Carnival, finishing runner-up in both the Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) and Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). She subsequently finished fourth in the Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at Eagle Farm late last month and O'Shea said she didn't appreciate the firm track. "She felt the ground there the other day, no doubt, so we have just spent the first week getting her through that," O'Shea told Racing HQ. "She has bounced back really well and had a lovely gallop on Tuesday morning. She is a genuine two-miler. She has had two runs in the Sydney Cup and ran fourth and second. It (Brisbane Cup) has been the target race for her all along. We got a bit bamboozled by the weights. She has ended up at the top of the weights, which may or may not be a reflection of the quality of the race. Saturday presents a good opportunity for her to get back in the winner's stall."

Boss says Brisbane Cup no longer viable

While Glen Boss might have a major chance of winning the Brisbane Cup on Rondinella, the champion rider doesn't believe the distance change back to 3200 metres is viable with just seven horses paid-up for yesterday to contest the \$400,000 race. "If it is not going to do your club any good promotion-wise or for your turnover, you have to look to get rid of it," Boss told Racing.com. "If you are running a business and something is costing you money and you can't fix it, you chop it. There's this thing about romance but it's not about that in these times. It's about running a profitable business. You don't really need a two-mile race or that sort of staying handicap at this time of year. We've got enough of them in Australia. Once you get to

that special distance, you are really narrowing the pool of horses that could possibly run in it," he continued. "That is just the way it is. It's this time of the year when the stayers just aren't around. If it disappeared, people won't miss it."

Professional Ayrton on song for Gunsynd

Mick Price believes punters will see a more professional version of Ayrton (Iffraaj) in Saturday's Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1600m) at Eagle Farm as the three-year-old continues to show signs of taking benefit from his first trip away. Stradbroke plans for Ayrton ended when he was downed by Apache Chase (Better Than Ready) in the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m), which meant Price was able to plan for his first start at 1600 metres this Saturday. "The whole purpose of this trip is to get him more professional and less anxious about the different things you have to cope with as a racehorse," Price, who co-trains with Michael Kent jr, said. "I think there will be a little bit of tempo in that race with (Ellsberg) in there. I would like to see him in amongst them, do what he has to do professionally, peel off and go bang. Jamie Kah said he was floating (in the Fred Best) and it looked to me like he was floating too. I'm hoping that doesn't happen again. I'm hoping he switches on a bit and I think he will."

Odeum expected to come on for run

Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Odeum (Written Tycoon) is set to return in Saturday's Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) as she prepares for a tilt at the Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) in a fortnight. Connections have taken the visors off and added a barrier blanket for Odeum's first run since she was down the track in the Coolmore Legacy (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick in April. "She trialled with a barrier blanket. She was deep in the trial, worked really well and found the line really well," co-trainer Mick Price said. "She had a really solid blow, blew up over the back. (Tuesday) morning she didn't blow at all. I can't get her any fitter without running her. I do think she will improve from this 1300 metres, but I reckon she will start to show up and then into the (Tiara) for her."

Patterson keen on Coventina's chances

Robbie Patterson is predicting a big run from Coventina Bay (Shamexpress) when the New Zealand raider has the first raceday assignment of her Queensland campaign in the Dane Ripper Stakes. "She trialled up really well and there were a few strong horses in that, so we were rapt with it. She has come through it great," the trainer said. "She had another gallop on Saturday and had her final gallop today (Wednesday) and Sam (Collett, jockey) was ecstatic. We couldn't be happier with her." Looking ahead to Saturday, Patterson is expecting big things from his mare and doesn't believe Eagle Farm's firm track holds any concerns for her. "I think you will see something special from her on Saturday the way she has been working," he said. "But whether 1300 metres is a fraction short for her with her racing style we will see. They tend to get out to the middle of the track here and fly home, so it could work into her favour if they go hard early. The track is not as firm as these Aussies are making it out to be. It just doesn't carry a lot of grass on it, just the way they have redone the track. It doesn't hold any concerns for me, we have got real fresh legs." All going well, Coventina Bay will return to Eagle Farm in a fortnight to tackle the Tattersall's Tiara. "Hopefully some of the better mares aren't here come Tatt's Tiara time. It might not be the strongest Group 1, but it definitely won't be easy," Patterson continued. "I think she is a genuine Group 1 horse."

Thompson's Queensland move paying off

Ben Thompson will be out to break his Group 1 duck on Saturday when he rides Signore Fox (Exceed And Excel) in the Stradbroke Handicap and Dark Rebel (Astern) in the J J Atkins. Thompson, who moved to the Sunshine State in August last year, said he has been surprised with how quickly he has been able to establish successful partnerships with several of the state's leading stables. "I was stepping into the unknown but thankfully, everything has gone above and beyond what I could've hoped for," Thompson told Racing.com. "I've received great support since I hit the ground and it's continued throughout the season, so I'm in a very lucky

spot and really enjoying it up here." Although he has never ridden Signore Fox, Thompson is keen on the five-year-old with conditions in his favour. "He's got all the credentials to run well and he gets a big drop in weight, he's only got 52 kilograms, which will only increase his chances. The biggest tick is that he handles Eagle Farm, which is a huge factor." Regarding Dark Rebel, who he is also due to ride in a race for the first time, Thompson said: "He trialled at the Sunshine Coast last Tuesday and did everything right, he's a really well-mannered colt by Astern. He's drawn really well in barrier one. It's a decent step-up but Ed (Cummings) knows how to train a Group 1 winner at the course, so hopefully it's a second one in eight days."

Noble Boy set to make debut for new trainer

Former Country Championships victor Noble Boy (Bon Hoffa) will have his first race start for new trainer Theresa Bateup in the Bob Charley AO Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Randwick on Saturday. It will be the six-year-old's first start since finishing down the field in the Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) last November and has since made the switch to the provincial trainer. "He's pleased us all the way through. We're quite happy with how he's tracking along," Bateup said. "We haven't had any issues with him all prep. I was happy with his trial and he had a gallop between races here on May 25. He seems to be a happy horse at the moment and enjoying his work. Andrew Adkins came down and trialled him for me and galloped him between races at Kembla, and even he came back and said he feels really good and that he's nice and bright and wants to be there (at the races). He's a lovely animal, he's a beautiful style of horse and a lovely natured horse. He's an absolute pleasure to have around."

Ablaze set to make return at Sandown

Star jumper Ablaze (Raise The Flag) is set to kick off his campaign on the flat at Sandown on Saturday with the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace stable eyeing off the Grand National Steeplechase (4500m). The rising ten-year-old returns in the Tile Importer Handicap (2400m) having not started since finishing second in the

last year's renewal of the Ballarat contest. Declan Maher, who runs the team of jumpers for his brother and Eustace, said Saturday's race was a nice starting point for Ablaze, who had some minor surgery after his last start. "He had a couple of little things and needed a joint cleaned up which is probably standard for horses that run over those extreme distances," Maher said. "He had two months out, a month on the water walker and then he's come back to Ballarat. He's been very sound, very happy and he's ready to get going again. Sandown is a nice forgiving track, a nice galloping track, whereas he would have to run next week in an open handicap at Flemington, so it's an easier option this week."

Classique Legends returns home

The Everest (1200m) winner Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) has returned safely to Australia after failing to acclimatise during a short stint in Hong Kong. The five-year-old gelding arrived at the Randwick stables of Les Bridge shortly before 11pm on Tuesday night. He made the trip from Hong Kong via New Zealand, where he completed two weeks of quarantine, before arriving in Sydney. The Bon Ho-owned sprinter is expected to remain in Bridge's care through the winter before defending his Everest title.

Constantinople settling into new home

Warrnambool-based trainer Aaron Purcell is hoping a change of scenery will see one-time Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) favourite Constantinople (Galileo) bounce back to form. The five-year-old, who ran fourth in the 2019 renewal of the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) for Lindsay Park, was knocked down to Purcell for \$70,000 at this month's Inglis Digital sale. "He is a high-class horse that has obviously lost his way for a few different reasons, I have been told," Purcell told Racing.com. "We will just work on them, try and get him going again and work out where we are. There's no plans. Obviously he had big expectations early on and they have disappeared now. So we can poke along and do things without much pressure and run him when he is ready. We will get him going and then work a plan out and readjust that plan as we go."

Ballarat switched to synthetic

A forecast for more rain in the central districts of Victoria has forced today's Ballarat meeting to be transferred from the turf to the synthetic track. The turf track was yesterday rated a Heavy 10 with a further 15 millimetres of rain expected and between 10 and 20 millimetres on race day. With that forecast, Racing Victoria, in consultation with the Ballarat Turf Club, elected to transfer the meeting away from the turf to the synthetic track. The transfer has resulted in two distance changes with the Benchmark 64, race six, over 2000 metres increased to 2100 metres, while the 1600-metre Class 1, race seven on the program, has been shortened to 1500 metres. All scratchings have been reinstated and trainers have until 7:30am this morning to scratch their horses.

Ancient Spirit added to White Robe roster

White Robe Lodge will welcome the addition of multiple Group 2 winner Ancient Spirit (Invincible Spirit) to their stallion roster this coming breeding season. Initially prepared by Jean-Pierre Carvalho, for whom he won the German 2,000 Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) and Oettingen-Rennen (Gr 2, 1600m), Ancient Spirit trained on as an older horse to win at Listed level on two occasions for Jessica Harrington in Ireland. "We have been looking for a European miler for five years, but nothing has caught my eye quite like this horse has," White Robe Lodge's Brian Anderton said. "We have been patient and I think it has really paid off with

being able to purchase a stallion of the quality of Ancient Spirit. He has a wonderful pedigree, being by one of the world's leading sires and sire of sires in Invincible Spirit, out of a mare by another champion in Galileo, you couldn't ask for better bloodlines. It is really exciting for us to be able to stand a stallion with a pedigree as good as that at White Robe Lodge." Ancient Spirit will stand his first season at White Robe Lodge for a fee of \$7,000 (plus GST).

Lucia Valentina son set to debut

The first foal out of multiple Group 1-winning mare Lucia Valentina (Savabeel) is set to make his debut on Saturday. Luca Deli (Snitzel) is one of 12 acceptors for the Skycity Hamilton (1200m) at Te Rapa. Luca Deli has been prepared for his debut with six trials. Although he was unplaced in his first four trials, his two subsequent trials, since being gelded and fitted with blinkers and a tongue tie, have been far more encouraging. Lucia Valentina missed to Fastnet Rock (Danehill) in 2017 before being covered by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) the following two years, resulting in Luca Deli and a yearling sister. Lucia Valentina produced an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) filly last October and was subsequently covered by Super Seth (Dundeel).

Te Rapa test for Cherry Lane

Nick Bishara didn't want to race his in-form mare Cherry Lane (Redwood) this weekend, but she's doing so well that he feels he has to. Bishara had hoped Cherry Lane's last-start victory at Ellerslie on May 29 would be enough of a lead-in to her next winter target, the Tauranga Classic (Listed, 1400m) later this month, but she has convinced him to start her in the Greene Racing Handicap (1600m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. "She's just done that well, so she'll have a run around there with Andrew Calder on board, who knows her so well," he said. "Being an older mare it's taken her a couple of runs to come right but I'm thrilled with her, and she loves Te Rapa."

Pike reveals Blue Sky thinking

Tony Pike is taking advantage of the new

Polytrack surface at his home-base in Cambridge as it enables him to prepare younger members of his team deeper into the winter months. Pike sent out impressive trial winner Mr Blue Sky (Zoustar) on Tuesday on the synthetic surface, and will likely race the youngster later this season, whereas in years gone by a similar style of horse might have gone to the paddock. Placed in two of his three starts in mid-summer, Pike can see an opportunity to clear maiden ranks for a horse he believes will make a nice three-year-old. "We would like to clear maidens with him this preparation if we can get the right track conditions," Pike said. "Then we'd give him a short break and head to the three-year-old races. We might go to Cambridge on June 30 or Ruakaka for the two-year-old races there. A horse like him is going to hate a heavy track so the Polytrack is a good alternative to get the maiden win out of the way and it makes it a lot easier in the spring."

UK: Bumper entry for July Sale

Another busy edition of the Tattersalls July Sale is taking shape with 853 lots catalogued for next month's event at Newmarket's Park Paddocks. The sale comprises a huge horses and fillies in or out of training section along with 110 broodmares, 13 of which have foals at foot. Among the Godolphin draft are Balanchine Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) runner up Prussian (Dubai Destination) and Group 3 winner Long Lashes (Rock Hard Ten), who are in foal to Ribchester (Iffraaj) and Earthlight (Shamardal) respectively, as well as Classic winner Kazzia's (Zinaad) daughter Kashira (Dubawi), carrying to Dark Angel (Acclamation). High-class sprinter Make A Challenge (Invincible Spirit), a five-time Listed winner and twice Group 2 placed for Denis Hogan, and Roger Varian's Mill Reef Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) scorer Pierre Lapin (Cappella Sansevero) are among the highlights of the horses in training section. UK: Glass Slippers notable absentee as Royal Ascot day one entries revealed

Battaash's (Dark Angel) chief rival in the betting for the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) on Tuesday, Glass Slippers (Dream Ahead), was not among the 16 runners left in the sprint for the opening day of Royal Ascot. The Kevin Ryan-trained mare, who was rated a 4-1 chance, has not been seen since her victory in the Breeders' Cup Turf

Sprint (Gr 1, 5.5f) in November. Battaash, who is set for his first start of the season at the royal meeting, could still have to overcome classy sprinters Oxted (Mayson) and Winter Power (Bungle Inthejungle), who remain in the race. In the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m), a busy campaign for Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach) shows no signs of slowing down as the English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner is one of 15 on course to run. The Jim Bolger-trained colt could feature among a strong Irish contingent including Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega), Thunder Moon (Zoffany), Wembley (Galileo) and Battleground (War Front). Sunday's French Derby (Gr 1, 2100m) winner St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni) was taken out of the race as expected.

US: Medina Spirit connections file lawsuit over Kentucky Derby test result

Attorneys for trainer Bob Baffert and owner Zedan Racing Stables have filed a lawsuit against the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission

(KHRC) seeking testing of Medina Spirit's (Protonico) post-race Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) urine sample. In the filing, the attorneys say further testing will provide evidence that the positive test for the corticosteroid betamethasone is linked to an ointment as opposed to an injection. The three-year-old, who crossed the wire first at Churchill Downs, is at risk of disqualification from the Derby after both his initial test and follow-up split-sample blood test showed the presence of betamethasone, which is prohibited at any level on raceday. The complaint argues that how betamethasone found its way into Medina Spirit is "critical", noting a "huge difference in a betamethasone finding due to an intra-articular joint injection versus one from a topical ointment - from both a regulatory and public relations standpoint." Medina Spirit's post-Derby test marked the fifth time a Baffert-trained horse tested positive for prohibited medications since May last year, and the second one specifically for betamethasone.

Member's Joy sells for \$800,000 to shine bright on Inglis Digital

Segenhoe Stud are revelling in an inspired decision to have stakes-producing broodmare Members Joy (Hussonet) act as the shining protagonist in the June (Early) Inglis Digital Sale, as the mare smashed the previous Inglis Digital record, and became the most expensive mare in foal to sell online in the southern hemisphere, when making \$800,000 in Inglis's latest digital auction that concluded yesterday.

Peter O'Brien, general manager of Segenhoe Stud, took a measured gamble with the striking grey, who is in foal to Zoustar (Northern Meteor) and dam to high-class juvenile and Group 2-winning three-year-old Pure Elation (I Am Invincible), withdrawing her from the recent Magic Millions National Broodmare sale in order to play a starring role in the online arena, with the vendors duly rewarded for their bravery.

"It was fantastic. She's a beautiful mare. She's got the looks, the pedigree and she's a produced real one and is in foal to Zoustar. She ticks every box, we thought," said O'Brien to ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"We thought we'd stand her out in an online sale and try it. After the Magic Millions sale, to be honest, we probably thought we'd made a mistake, the sale was so strong.

"But after today, I obviously don't think so. The demand for quality bloodstock is insane at the moment."

Members Joy, a three-year-old Listed winner and Group 2 placed, who was bought by Aquis Farm for \$1.45 million in 2019, was purchased by Josiah Ma, acting for Hong Kong investment group Shen You Holdings, who summoned up the eye-watering figure, which was nearly double the previous highest price paid for a horse on the Inglis Digital platform, achieved when Small Minds (Canny Lad), dam of stakes winner Beautiful Mind (So You Think) and this season's Golden Gift (1100m) winner Sneaky Five (Fastnet Rock), sold for \$410,000 in the November (Late) Sale last year.

Members Joy's I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) yearling colt sold for \$525,000 at this year's Inglis Easter sale to Annabel Neasham and Brian McGuire, while her weanling colt by Zoustar sold for \$350,000 at the Magic Millions National Weanling Sale last month.

"The owners weren't desperate to sell her," said O'Brien. "The interest in her was incredible. It surprised me, even after such a buoyant sale.

"I was worried some of the main buyers had spent their money but, as it turned out, there was a tonne of interest in her. A lot of the main players that bought mares at Magic Millions were active on her."

Shen You Holdings are a notable new

investor in Australian thoroughbred stock in 2021, having purchased eight mares for upwards of \$1 million in total at the recent Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, including stakes-winning juvenile Kinky Boom (Spirit Of Boom) for \$320,000, as well as signing for breeding rights to stallions Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) (two shares for \$220,000 each), Sooboog (Snitzel) and Grunt (O'Reilly).

"Josiah, who bought her from Hong Kong, called me during the week and I've met him

twice in Australia before, and he asked me about her," continued O'Brien.

"I think they've bought a few stallion shares in the last few months, and they're trying to set up a small group of investors, and I just said 'you won't get a nicer mare,' which you wouldn't, she's a beauty.

"But, to be honest, I didn't think they'd be that strong."

Segenhoe Stud consigned a catalogue of 14 mares and one weanling in Inglis's most recent online auction and, in addition to Members Joy, sold Fitna (Fastnet Rock) for \$70,000 with the same figure realised for Rayaheen (Redoute's Choice), as well as More Aspen (More Than Ready) and Omniscient (Exceed And Excel), who both sold for \$42,500.

O'Brien believes there is an ever-growing presence in the online marketplace, and that is translating to higher quality stock being offered for sale, including in their own drafts, while also noting the platform is leading to new participants seeking to purchase thoroughbred stock at the bottom end of the market, too.

"At the start (of the Inglis Digital Platform being launched) we were probably just dipping our toe in the water with our lesser stock, and then gradually, and particularly so in the last six months, we've been using the forum more often, and probably this group of hoes in particular (are higher quality)," said O'Brien.

"We got professional videos, professional photographs, and we spent more on advertising on social media.

"We had 15 horses online today. Fourteen of the 15 sold and the ones that sold all made overs. And there were varying degrees in value, but there was activity on all of them.

"I had 178 phone calls about 15 horses,

from (people from) all walks of life. I really enjoy it, because a lot of people are buying their first mare, from all over Australia and New Zealand and beyond. It's a terrific introductory way for a lot of people to get involved as long as they get advice."

The June (Early) sale grossed a remarkable \$5.25 million, the first time it has surpassed \$5 million, while the clearance rate was 80 per cent.

Those figures were aided by two further mares to sell for in excess of \$300,000, with five-year-old mare Street Icon (Street Boss), a half-sister to stakes winner Bons Away (Bon Hoffa), making \$355,000 when secured by Adam Mackrell of Bell View Park Stud, while trainer Steve Tregoe purchased the stakes-placed Malahide (Shamus Award), who is out of a half-sister to Group 2 winner Haut Brion Her (Zoustar), as well as stakes winners Karacatis (Hussonet) and Shamillion (Shamardal), for \$320,000.

Mackrell will now seek a suitable stallion for Street Icon, before returning her to the sale ring next year.

"I'm happy to pay the money for these sorts of mares, especially after attending the breeding stock sales, including Chairman's, and seeing mares with similar records making at least that amount," Mackrell said.

"It's been well documented how hot the market is but to be fair Street Icon is by a top

stallion, she's from a very good family that looks to have upside and is a multiple Stakes-performer herself, she ticks all the boxes from a trading perspective we just have to be smart about the mating.

"We had her inspected and she's just above 16 hands with a nice frame, plus she's Danehill free so she's easy to breed with and the plan is to put her back through the sales."

Elsewhere, Hunter Valley Bloodstock paid \$175,000 to secure three-year-old filly Alighted (Smart Missile), a recent winner at Warwick Farm and half-sister to Group 2 winner Aylmerton (Siyouni), and Ain't She Smart (Smart Missile), a half-sister to the stakes-winning Ain'tnodeeldun (Dundeel) for \$140,000 in foal to Toronado (High Chaparral).

Inglis Digital business manager Nick Melmeth said the results are reflective of a growing recognition for the online sale platform, which is offering increasing value for trading breeding stock.

"Vendors are recognising the opportunity to leverage interest in stock by getting them into an auction scenario" he said.

"Why sell privately when there is so much interest and activity being generated by the massive audience of buyers on Inglis Digital?"

"We have a database of 8000 registered bidders and this sale has seen Inglis Digital surpass \$120 million in turnover since 2018 and \$34 million in 2021 alone."

Latest cohort of Thoroughbred Breeders Australia's Fast Track Program graduate

The third crop of the Thoroughbred Breeders Australia (TBA) Fast Track Program celebrated their graduation in a ceremony at Scone on Tuesday night.

Launched in 2018 by TBA in collaboration with TAFE NSW, Fast Track was designed to create a structured pathway to bring new workers into the breeding industry.

Over the past 12 months, the group have studied for a Certificate III in Horse Breeding while completing full-time traineeships with some of the country's leading stud farms, including Godolphin, Vinery, Widden, Segenhoe, Kitchwin Hills and Twin Hills.

"The program is now in its fourth year and

it is proving a great way to bring people to our industry that would otherwise never come to work on a farm," said the TBA's chief executive officer, Tom Reilly.

"Our successful candidates have a mix of backgrounds; some having lots of horse experience, while others have never touched a horse, but have a passion for racing or interest in pedigrees before starting the course. Almost none of them, however, have a background with thoroughbreds."

Along with the formal units of study, the program also includes a number of additional lectures from leaders in the industry, ensuring trainees develop a good understanding of different aspects of breeding.

There is also a strong focus on personal development and transferable skills, with the group taking part in first aid, defensive driver training and float towing with NRMA, workshops on workplace behavior and mental health, as well as quad bike and side-by-side training.

"Fast Track does an incredibly valuable job bringing young people into the industry and we've had a great experience taking trainees every year," said Mick Malone of Kitchwin Hills.

"Everyone running a farm knows how hard it is to find staff, so this initiative is really important."

With three intakes having completed the program, some 90 per cent of graduates are still working in the thoroughbred industry.

The group that received their certificates on Tuesday included trainees from every state in Australia, with the exception of Tasmania. Due to Covid-19 restrictions the class size was limited and all students had to begin their placements on NSW farms.

"It's incredibly rewarding to see the growth and development of our trainees over the 12-month period," said program coordinator, Cecelia O'Gorman.

"Our 2020 graduates are an extremely passionate bunch and I can't wait to see what they go on to achieve. In addition to those still working in Australia, we've had graduates complete the Irish National Stud Course, a two-time finalist in the Australian Stud and Stable Staff Awards Newcomer category, and just last week, one of our alumni was awarded a spot on Godolphin's Flying Start program."

The 2021 intake for Fast Track began in Scone last month with trainees from NSW, Queensland and South Australia. Applications for the 2022 program will open early next year, with more information available at tbaus.com.

Rarely would you see the progeny of three such illustrious racemares complete a trifecta as they did in the 1100-metre two-year-old fillies' handicap at Flemington on Saturday.

Argentia powered home first on debut, one and three-quarter lengths ahead of Viviane, with Invincible Caviar a further half-length back in third.

And how's this for a trio of worthies as their dams? Princess Coup, Curtana, and one of the three great mares of the century, Black Caviar.

Princess Coup, by Encosta De Lago, won four Group 1s in New Zealand and came second in four more in Australia amid eight top-level placings overall.

Curtana, by Exceed And Excel, was a dual Listed-winning speedster, second in Star Witness' Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) of 2010, and was fourth in the Patinack Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) a year later - behind

that aforementioned stablemate, Black Caviar, whose deeds you probably already know about.

The sires from that trifecta weren't that shabby either.

Argentia's win kicked off a massive day for Frankel, in which his son Adayar won the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) to shoot his father above his own great sire Galileo at the top of this year's Britain and Ireland stallions' standings.

Viviane is by the current number one on the Australian list, Written Tycoon, while Invincible Caviar is of course by the redoubtable I Am Invincible, Australia's runner-up of the past three seasons, and the current number three.

It seems Frankel can provide you winners even when, in a way, you don't necessarily want them. As documented in this column previously, Evergreen Stud's Tony Bott sent Princess Coup to England for a southern hemisphere cover from Frankel, hoping for a colt. He flew her home once she was confirmed as in-foal, only to regret that when she was found to be carrying a filly.

Bott nimbly changed course and bought the Shamardal mare Conversely in foal, with a colt, to Frankel, and opted to sell the filly.

The colt, raced by Bott and trained by son Adrian with Gai Waterhouse, has turned out to be Converge, who's won twice and been Group 1-placed from five starts, and will attempt to break through at the top level in Saturday's JJ Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) at Eagle Farm.

The filly realised \$670,000 at last year's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, and is of course Argentia, who's promising major things for her owner John Camilleri, breeder of one of the other 'big three' mares in Winx. Tony Bott doesn't regret selling the filly - he's eyeing ample compensation through Converge - but feels he might have played things differently if given the chance again at a mating that came about through a little dose of happenstance.

“It really was the old adage - put the best to the best and hope for the best. We loved Frankel as a racehorse, and it turned out Princess Coup was empty that year - we'd given her a year off -

so we sent her over there, hoping for a colt. But I think I made a slight mistake in bringing her back home straight away,” says Bott, who could have left Princess Coup in England and tried again if she had a filly. (Most likely, Argentia would have come to Australia to race in any case, since Bott knows there'd be little sale value in a southern hemisphere-timed yearling offered in England).

“If I did it again, because of the distance and everything else, I'd probably leave Princess Coup there. But when she's the major broodmare in your band you don't want them away from home for too long. You worry about things. Still, if she'd had a colt it might not have been as good as this filly.”

It often doesn't work, of course, when the best racemares go to stud. Of these three, Curtana - she with the third-best race record - has had the most success. Her five named foals are headed by Viviane's Ellerton-Zahra stablemate Sword Of Mercy, a multiple Melbourne winner who's been twice stakes-placed. Her first one, Dame Eleanor, won three from nine in South Africa.

Black Caviar's six named foals have performed moderately, with Oscieta and Prince Of Caviar recording provincial wins before being retired after a handful of starts each, though there's more hope in the great mare's physical likeness, Invincible Caviar.

But what we may be seeing in Argentina, with help from Frankel, is the crowning glory of Princess Coup's stud career.

Bott struck hard in buying the mare at the 2009 Magic Millions Broodmare sale. In fact, the \$3 million he paid was the most expensive price for any horse sold through a Magic Millions ring, a record that stood until Listen Here went as a broodmare for \$3.4 million in 2016, topped by Sunlight's \$4.2 million last year.

“Her pedigree and race performance attracted us first,” Bott says, “and then seeing her in the flesh for the first time at the sale, she was one of the best moving sort of animals I'd seen.

“She ticked all the boxes. Still, we weren't planning on going that high for her, but call it the heat of the battle or whatever, we kept sticking our hand up.”

Princess Coup's direct results have been solid, if short of spectacular.

Her first named foal Vanilla Princess (Lonhro) was a Randwick winner, but her second was far better. Thewizardofoz (Redoute's Choice) raced in Hong Kong and won four of his first six starts to be named Griffin (new import) of the Year for 2015. He won only two more races - though one of those was the Premier Cup (Gr 3, 1400m) in 2017.

His sister Abatha was unplaced. Legendofoz (Fastnet Rock) has won a Goulburn maiden, while his little sister Princess Mia won at Gosford and Hawkesbury. Mistress Oz (Snitzel) was unraced, while a third Redoute's Choice, Dorothy Of Oz, won at Hawkesbury and Warwick Farm.

Next up came Argentia - perhaps the proof that, despite now rising 18, Princess Coup has ascended to a new level as a broodmare.

This provides hope for her latest stock. She has a Sebring yearling colt Bott has retained and an I Am Invincible weanling filly, and is in foal to Dundee. Yet Bott eyes his prized broodmare for more than just her offspring. For example, he still owns Vanilla Princess, whose second named foal Key, a filly by Exceed And Excel, fetched \$550,000 as a yearling on the Gold Coast in 2019, had a Group 3 second in New Zealand, and has now transferred to Matthew Dale in NSW.

“Princess Coup hasn't quite been a golden goose but she's done a more than decent job for us,” Bott says.

“I might have had a bit of a rush of blood in paying what I did for her, but she's been a good breeder, thrown a couple of handy types and we've got a number of her daughters to continue the line.

“Whether we'd be totally in the black now, I'm not sure. But it depends how you value the residuals. Her weanling is going to be a very valuable commodity, being by I Am Invincible and a half-sister to Argentia. We've already had a couple of enquiries about the weanling since Saturday.

“Princess Coup doesn't look her age and is in very good condition and everything looks rosy. She was a bit independent when she first came here, to be honest, but she seems to have settled over the past few years to be more matronly.

“We're happy to have her and she seems to enjoy life here as well.”

Karis Teetan dominates at Happy Valley with a four-timer as Me Tsui chimes in with a treble

A Karis Teetan late-season cameo highlighted a rain-drenched Happy Valley meeting yesterday evening, as the 'Mauritian Magician' posted a four-timer while Me Tsui revelled in a treble, crowned by Harmony And Rich's (I Am Invincible) success in the Class 2 Castle Peak Bay Handicap (1000m).

Teetan dominated proceedings with a double for Tsui (Happy Tango and Telecom Smart), while also teaming with David Hayes (Red Majesty) and Caspar Fownes (Sky Gem) to boost his season's tally to 72 wins.

Tsui's decision to tackle Class 2 for the first time with Harmony And Rich was vindicated when the track and distance specialist powered clear under Matthew Chadwick in 56.66s to collect a High Achievement Bonus of HK\$1 million in addition to the HK\$1.254 million winners' purse.

The bonus is available to owners of horses with a minimum rating of 80 who win a Class 2 race or above before turning five.

The I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) four-

year-old has won three of his past four starts over the 1000-metre dash at Happy Valley, each time with Chadwick in the plate.

"He's surprised me a little bit. I thought he might be a chance, but not win like that. The jockey's riding manner really helped the horse. He just got going early and didn't worry about anyone else - the horse really responded to that.

It gives the horse confidence," Tsui said, taking justifiable satisfaction from his first treble since October, 2018.

"It's really nice - I only get one or two of them a season."

Matching his quartet at the city circuit on 8 April, and further cementing third place on the jockeys' championship behind Joao Moreira (138) and Zac Purton (117), Teetan was elated with his midweek haul.

"It's just one of these nights when things go your way. It's been a long season - it's not over yet - but it's nice to get a four-timer," he said. "You have to appreciate these nights, they don't happen often. I appreciate all the support I've had from owners and trainers for these opportunities."

Teetan's victory on Fownes-trained Sky Gem (Niagara) underlined his soaring confidence as the gelding blitzed his rivals with a two-length win in the Class 5 Yan Chau Tong Handicap (2200m) in class record time of 2m 15.87s.

Starting from gate 12, Teetan unleashed Sky Gem near the 1000-metre mark with a decisive mid-race move, taking the lead leaving the back straight before careering away.

"We discussed those tactics before the race and they worked out perfectly," Fownes said. "He was the best stayer in the race but he needed to be ridden that way. He did something similar last year with Vincent (Ho)."

Fownes stretched his advantage over John Size in the battle for the trainers' championship, edging to a 69-65 advantage with nine meetings left in the season.

Teetan's ride on Red Majesty (Ferlax) from barrier eight, driving purposely to the front before leaving the front straight in the Class 4 Silver Mine Bay Handicap (1650m), was also of the highest ilk after earlier posting a race-to-race brace for Tsui aboard Happy Tango (Eavesdropper) and Telecom Smart (Smart Missile) in the first and second sections, respectively, of the Class 4 Port Shelter Handicap (1200m).

"Telecom Smart didn't surprise me because he's been so consistent," Tsui said after the gelding ended an exasperating run of three successive runner-up placings to succeed.

"Happy Tango, he's been racing on the all-weather at Sha Tin and I decided to bring him back to Happy Valley to run on the grass and it worked out well."

Danny Shum hopes Packing Victory (Reliable Man) can measure up as a Hong Kong Four-Year-Old Classic Series contender next season after the New Zealand import overcame inexperience and older rivals to post an eye-catching victory in the third section of the Class 4 Port Shelter Handicap (1200m).

Expertly handled by Purton, the gelding justified favouritism to prevail despite racing greenly in the latter stages, prompting Shum to declare the three-year-old a prospective candidate for the Classic Series, a triple-header which culminates in the Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) next March.

"Yeah, hopefully. We will see - he's got potential," Shum said, referring to the Classic Series.

"He's a nice horse, he's got ability. He'll get

further distances as he gets older - 1400, 1600 and 1800 metres, no problem at all."

Douglas Whyte anticipates a positive future with Harmony Fire (Brazen Beau) after the three-year-old snared the Class 3 Deep Bay Handicap (1000m) under Jerry Chau.

"He's progressively got better all the time, he's been a thorough professional since he stepped into my stable," Whyte said after the gelding's third win from six starts.

"He's very straight-forward. He's going to have a nice break now. He's a nice horse and I couldn't ask for more than what he's done and I look forward to seeing next season."

Whyte and Chau shared their 14th victory of the season when Mclucky (Snitzel) posted his second win in succession by claiming the Class 3 Kat O Hoi Handicap (1200m) after Alexis Badel delivered a wonderful front-running ride on the Frankie Lor-trained Everyone's Delight (El Roca) to claim the Class 3 Mirs Bay Handicap (1650m).

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin on Sunday.

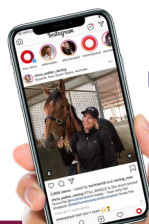
