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Thoroughbred Industry Careers launches hunt for new trackwork riders

Accelerator Program will endeavour to find talented horsemen and women, giving them the chance to learn from leading jockeys

Leading industry education body Thoroughbred Industry Careers (TIC) yesterday launched the Accelerator Program in an attempt to recruit some of Australia's leading horsemen and women as track riders.

The Accelerator Program is a 12-week intensive training course in which participants will be critiqued and mentored by some of

the best jockeys in the world, including Hugh Bowman, Glen Boss, Tommy Berry, Kerrin McEvoy, Kathy O'Hara, Nash Rawiller, Rachel King and Sam Clipperton. They will also be overseen by one of the best to ever take to the saddle in Hall Of Fame rider Darren Beadman.

Based at Western Sydney University's Richmond campus, the program is open to Australian residents with applications open from today until August 21. The 12-week program itself will begin on September 14.

The latest initiative launched by Thoroughbred Industry Careers is another crucial step towards bringing skilled and talented people into the game, according to chief executive Lindy Maurice.

"The last 18 months have taught us that there are some very talented riders out there who haven't known anything about careers in our industry, so the Accelerator Program is about lifting the lid specifically on track-riding jobs to convert those good riders into skilled track riders," Maurice told ANZ Bloodstock News. "Also track riders are the greatest skill shortage facing our industry right now.

"We are looking to take 12 or so on in this first intake as we need enough ex-racehorses at all different levels to match the riders' progression throughout the program. However, if it is as popular as we hope it will be, we can take up to 15 participants."

The Accelerator Program joins the Explorer Cadetship Program in being offered by the not-for-profit Thoroughbred Industry Careers, which was established in late 2018 to promote opportunities and vocations within the racing and breeding industries.

"The Explorer Program is our 12-month see-all program where young people get to experience both the racing and breeding sectors before deciding where their interest lies," Maurice said. "We currently have 52 Cadets on this program across Australia with the next intake to commence in February 2021.

"What is satisfying is finding these fantastic young people and introducing them to our industry. When you find great people, well, I imagine it is similar to how trainers feel when they find a good horse. It's very exciting."

The Accelerator Program has been backed by some of Australia's leading stables, including key stakeholders Gai Waterhouse, Chris Waller and Tony McEvoy, as well as Godolphin and Lindsay Park. Employment is guaranteed for those that complete the course.

"Good track riders are an essential part of any racing stable, both here and overseas," Waterhouse said. "Horses need skilled and competent riders who can educate them, help keep them fit, and assist us in the

training process. There has never been a better time for capable horsemen to be involved in racing."

Waller added: "Whether you train two or 200 horses, one of the main areas that trainers struggle with is finding good track riders. It is so important to have good riders that you can rely on for accurate feedback and to help educate and prepare your horses for their race targets.

"We have already taken on a number of staff through Thoroughbred Industry Careers, two of which are riders and they have already become a big asset to our team. I consider the Accelerator Program another string to their bow and the very fact that you have some of the biggest industry names backing it, shows how important it is to keep our wonderful industry moving forward and to ensure the future of the sport."

Among the jockeys who will act as a mentor is Group 1-winning rider Clipperton, who has plied his trade with success in Hong Kong and has had the opportunity to see a number of different stable environments.

"We all think we've got the best job in the world; riding the fastest horses for a living," Clipperton said. "The Accelerator Program is about creating opportunities to become a part of that. If you've always wondered what it would be like to ride some of the world's best racehorses and get paid to do it - whether you're into bull riding or showjumping like I was - this is your chance to start the journey."

Eleven for Headwater

Vinery Stud's Headwater (Exceed And Excel) sired his 11th winner when Stormborn (2 f ex Quick's The Word by Shamardal) scored at start four at Pakenham yesterday. Stormborn, twice city-placed from her first three starts, started favourite and was ridden as though she was the best horse by Daniel Stackhouse. She proved superior, too, defeating Kick It Baby (Shamus Award) by three-quarters of a length with Licciardi (Street Boss) a further length and a quarter away in third. Headwater will stand at Vinery Stud for \$13,750 (inc GST) this year.

New Lindsay Park team score first win

Lindsay Park trainers Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes have scored their first win without David Hayes as a listed partner with Stormborn's Pakenham victory. David Hayes has departed for Hong Kong to set up his Sha Tin stable and was required to relinquish his Australian licence before the end of the Hong Kong season next week. "That's fantastic, we've got a 100 per cent strike-rate," Ben Hayes told Racing.com. "I would like to say we planned it, but we weren't exactly sure when the changeover would happen, so we were a bit lucky with this one. Dad has left it to Tom and I to do most of the work over the past eight months, so I don't think too much will change. Dad's taught both Tom and I well, we know the processes and we know how to train from the farm, so I'm looking forward to the future." Racing Victoria has confirmed that any of the new combination's wins until season's end will not count towards any of the trainers' premierships.

Magic Millions ready to run sale moved to November

Entries are now open for the Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs In Training Sale, with the auction moved back to November 9 and 10 from its original October date. The sale will take place after breeze-ups at Seymour, Warwick Farm and the Gold Coast throughout October and November. Ryland looks to make mark

Luke Ryland and his fiancée Bec Hausler will be looking to make their mark in the racing industry as stud masters with the establishment of Ryland Thoroughbreds. The operation, which is located north-west of Geelong, will stand two stallions in America (Snitzel) and Frankel My Dear (Frankel). "It's pretty exciting for both Bec and I," Ryland told Racing.com. "It's something we've been thinking about and discussing for the last two years. We've obviously been breeding our own mares for quite a few years now. It's going to be a lot of hard work but we're hoping it's something that can set us up for the future. We don't want to be a big-scale commercial operation, we just want to have a boutique stud where we can breed to race our own horses for fun and enjoyment and provide other owner-breeders the same sort of opportunity."

Soxagon's rise through ranks culminates in Glasshouse

After working his way through the classes, Soxagon (Rocker) will take on a solid list of rivals in the Glasshouse Handicap (Listed,

1400m) at the Sunshine Coast today. The gelding was mentioned as a possible Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) contender after running second to Vega One (Lope De Vega) in The Gateway (1400m) at Eagle Farm in December. In an era where promising horses are sold overseas or rushed into stakes races, trainer Mark Currie and owner-breeder Brian Burke have been content to bide their time with Soxagon. Burke, who races Soxagon in partnership with Currie's wife Donna, said the galloper had shown he deserved a crack at stakes company. "Mark has brought him through the classes and picked the races for him. It has been the successful old-style way with horses of not over matching them too early," he said.

Kendrick seeks cherry on top with Michelin

Enigmatic galloper Star Of Michelin (Jet Spur) can confirm a watershed season for trainer Stuart Kendrick if he wins the Winx Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) at the Sunshine Coast today. There is one thing the trainer loves and that is to win races on his home track at Corbould Park. He has 49 winners there this season and is 26 in front of second-placed Tony Gollan, meaning he will win his seventh straight Sunshine Coast trainers' premiership. The Winx Guineas is the Sunshine Coast's most important race and Kendrick would love to win it for the first time. He has no doubts Star Of Michelin can provide him with that success. "He is the highest-rated horse in the race by four points so he is well in at the set weights," Kendrick said. "Star Of Michelin had a couple of ordinary runs at Doomben but once he got back on the big Eagle Farm track last start it was a different story."

Belle Du Jour reunion with Girl Tuesday

The owner-trainer team that famously combined with Belle Du Jour (Dehere) in the 2000 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), John Singleton and Clarry Conners, will again try to take a Rosehill feature when Girl Tuesday (Street Cry) has her first run for the stable in today's Winter Stakes (Listed, 1400m). The regally-bred Girl Tuesday has joined Conners from Chris Waller and while the trainer doesn't believe he can improve the five-year-old, he does think that a different environment may allow her to recapture her form. "I was harping on him (Singleton) for a while that you better give me a horse," Conners said. "We've had a lot of success together. We've won Slippers and Magic Millions' and Newmarkets. We went to Dubai with that little mare (Belle Du Jour). I'm not going to improve one little bit on Chris Waller but we will spend time doing some different little things and a change can be as good as a holiday."

Home track to suit Tavisan in Monash

Michael Kent Jr, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, is expecting a better performance from Tavisan (Tavistock) with his return to his home track at Caulfield in the Sir John Monash Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) today. Tavisan is on the quick back-up from running in the All Victorian Sprint Final (Listed, 1200m) at Flemington last Saturday in which the sprinter finished last behind Lord Von Costa (Von Costa De Hero). Kent Jr said the 1200-metre race did not work out for the enigmatic Tavisan, who was challenged from the 600-metre mark and wilted in the run home. "He's a horse that wins his races when he doesn't get pressured too far out," Kent Jr said.

"He is definitely better suited around a bend and back to 1100 (metres) at his home track. Obviously we've got to be wary of Jungle Edge who likes to roll forward, but we've got a good jockey (Ben Melham) and a nice barrier so we're having a throw at the stumps in a Group 3."

From O'Brien to Smith to Morrish for Never No More

Ballarat trainer Simon Morrish hopes that the addition of glue-on shoes will allow Irish import Never No More (No Nay Never) to find his best when he has his first start for the stable today. Formerly trained by Aidan O'Brien, Never No More came to Australia for last year's Golden Eagle (1500m), finishing 14th. Now part-owned by OTI Racing, he was transferred to Lindsey Smith, having two runs for him before joining Morrish. "He's an interesting horse with form in England, Ireland, America and now Australia," Morrish said. "He's well-travelled and a glorious-looking horse, a real rooster, and the only reason I got him is Lindsey has had a few little issues with him and thought he might like being trained on the uphill track. We've put a set of blinkers on and tried and reinvent the wheel with him."

Flora 'maybe a Matriarch horse'

Danny O'Brien will assess the spring credentials of his in-form mare Grand De Flora (Savabeel) when she runs in a 2000-metre handicap at Caulfield today. "If she could win on Saturday then we would definitely think about the spring," O'Brien told Racing.com. "She would be more a back-end-of-the-spring horse, maybe a Matriarch (Stakes) or something like that. She has come a long way this prep. We are certainly not in a rush with her but if she justified it on Saturday then she would."

Snowdens hoping for further juvenile success

A pair of up-and-coming youngsters will bid to continue the Snowden stable's run of two-year-old success this season when they go head-to-head at Rosehill today. Thudson (Pride Of Dubai) and Sahra (Hinchinbrook) will both make their Sydney debuts in the Darley 2YO Handicap (1100m), Thudson resuming off a Ballarat win in March and Sahra entering

after an impressive demolition of her rivals at Kembla Grange. Peter Snowden is particularly interested to see how Sahra copes with the next level of racing with a view to a potential carnival bid. "It's always a big jump from the provincials to Saturday but if she handles it and handles it well, you know you've got a nice filly," Snowden said. "We might even give her a short break and bring her back in for the spring carnival fillies races if she does run well."

Zschoke can't wait to be reunited with Eduardo

Talented sprinter Eduardo (Host) put his trainer Sarah Zschoke on the map, but a change of ownership has seen the gelding head north to stables of Joe Pride and Zschoke only hopes she can have him back once he retires. "I think what I did with him was good enough for me. What happens from here, I know that I got, if not the best out of the horse, a great part of him," Zschoke told Racing.com. "He definitely put my name out there and that's a huge thing. In Victoria there is so much competition and it was really good to have a horse like that in my name to promote me a bit more. "Unfortunately, he left my stables. I do wish the horse well. And I did ask the owner that when he is retired that they put in for him to come back to us to retire. He is a big part of mine and a big part of (my partner) Brian (Park's) life."

Bella Vella to aim at Valley sprints

Will Clarken has flagged the Moonee Valley sprint races as the spring targets for his Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Bella Vella (Commands). "She had a well-earned break after the Sangster and is back in work now gearing up for hopefully another good campaign in the spring," Clarken told Racing.com. "With her love for the Moonee Valley circuit, at this stage her program has been mapped around three big races staged there. We will go first-up in the McEwen on September 5, followed by the Moir on September 25. Logically next it would be on to the Manikato Stakes on October 23. The only deviation would be if her form was good enough to attract interest from an Everest slot-holder for the big one in Sydney the week prior on October 17."

Preusker pleased with Surprise Baby

Paul Preusker is pleased with Surprise Baby (Shocking) as the promising stayer gears up for another tilt at the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). Surprise Baby, who produced one of the runs of the race in last year's Melbourne Cup, will kick off in the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) in September, a race in which he finished fourth last year. "I am really happy with where he is at," Preusker told RSN927. "He has come back a stronger horse and is mentally quite relaxed. We will go back to the Feehan and it's nice to kick these types off at the Valley. I am looking forward to setting him for that and hopefully we get it done." I am really looking forward to getting there (Melbourne Cup) again."

NEW ZEALAND

Riccarton team buoyed by recent developments

The last few weeks have put a spring in the step of the team at Riccarton Park. Earlier in the year, the Covid-19 pandemic had threatened to deal a cruel blow to the South Island's flagship racetrack as provisional schedules indicated that the New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) may instead be hosted at Te Rapa and Ellerslie respectively. However, things have improved: both Guineas were confirmed as remaining at Riccarton, racing resumed at the Christchurch track on June 27 with bumper turnover, and NZ\$10 million in funding was announced for the installation of an all-weather track. This week also brought the return of one of the track's most historic features, the Winter Cup (Gr 3, 1600m), which will be run on August 15. "It's been very exciting," Riccarton Park's chief executive Tim Mills said. "I think the return of the Winter Cup is a really positive development."

Jakkalbomb to face wet track test

Stakes performer Jakkalbomb (Jakkalberry) will be able to answer the question of whether she can handle a heavy track when she contests a 1200-metre race at Ellerslie today. The rising five-year-old mare has yet to race on a heavy

track in her 13 career starts, however, trainer Danica Guy is confident the Heavy 10 surface poses no concern for her charge. "She has been galloping really well on heavy ground at Matamata, but raceday can be a different thing altogether," she said. "We will just have to see, it is an unknown thing, but she has been working really well and I am hoping she will get through the ground. I am really happy with her, she is nice and bright. She had a nice trial on the bridle the other day and I am pretty happy where she is at going into her fresh-up run."

ASIA

Jolly Banner returns for Yiu as season's finish line nears

Ricky Yiu's stable stalwart Jolly Banner (Lonhro) returns tomorrow at Sha Tin with the chance of securing a vital win for his handler in the traditional end-of-season feature, the Class 1 Sha Tin Mile Trophy Handicap (1600m). Yiu leads the trainers' championship by one win, with Francis Lui in second (64-63), but with 13 intended runners to his rivals eight, the 62-year-old will be looking to secure much needed breathing room at the top of the standings ahead of the season's final race meeting next Wednesday at Happy Valley. With 808 races behind them, Yiu and Lui enter the final 20 contests of the season vying for the lead - with Tony Cruz pressing in third with 61 wins - and it is young gun Matthew Poon who is proving to be a small but crucial piece of Yiu's championship cause. "Jolly Banner is still healthy and fit, he's drawn very well in barrier three," Poon said.

Racing returns in Singapore

For the first time since April 3, racing will take place at Kranji in Singapore this afternoon with a 14-race card scheduled. Covid-19 brought racing to a halt in the Lion City and saw many of its participants depart the country. Among those horses set to step out today are the likes of Countofmontecristo (Echoes Of Heaven), Fame Star (Twirling Candy), Mr Clint (Power), I'm Incredible (Lope De Vega) and War Affair (O'Reilly). Singapore will only race twice in July, with the second meeting on July 26, before returning to once-a-week racing in August.

INTERNATIONAL

Five for Territories

Darley shuttler Territories (Invincible Spirit) sired his fifth first-crop winner when Teresa Mendoza (2 f ex Ceoldrama by Mr Greeley) took out the Irish Stallion Farms EBF Maiden (6f) at the Curragh yesterday. The filly defeated Monaasib (Bobby's Kitten) by one and three-quarter lengths with Irish Chief (War Front) coming home a further two and three-quarter lengths away in third. Teresa Mendoza is the only foal to race out Ceoldrama (Mr Greeley) who is a half-sister to Make Fast (Makfi), the dam of Thursday's July Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) victor Tactical (Toronado). Group 1 winner Territories stands at Darley's Kelvinside property in the Hunter Valley for a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

19 for Invincible Spirit

Irish National Stud stalwart Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) sired his 19th Group 1 winner when Nazeeff (4 m ex Handassa by Dubawi) took out the Falmouth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Newmarket yesterday. The John Gosden-trained and Shadwell Stud-raced mare defeated Billesdon Brook (Champs Elysees) by a neck with the same margin back to Terebellum (Sea The Stars) in third. Nazeeff is out of Listed-winning mare Handassa (Dubawi), who herself is a half-sister to Group scorers Desert Stone (Fastnet Rock) and Eugenio (Fastnet Rock). In his 20th season at Irish National Stud, Invincible Spirit stood for a fee of €100,000.

Back-to-back stakes wins for Dandalla

Dandalla (2 f Dandy Man - Chellalla by Elnadim) backed-up her impressive Albany Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) victory with a win in the Duchess of Cambridge Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) at Newmarket yesterday. The daughter of Dandy Man (Mozart) held off a late surge from her rivals to defeat Fev Rover (Gutaifan) by a head, delivering a one-two for the Nick Bradley Racing syndicate, with Santosha (Coulsty) half a length away in third. Dandalla was purchased for €22,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale and is one of two winners from two to race out of Chellalla (Elnadim), while her fourth dam is blue hen Edinburgh (Charlottown). She is one of 14 stakes winners for Dandy Man who stood for €15,000 at Ballyhane Stud in 2020.

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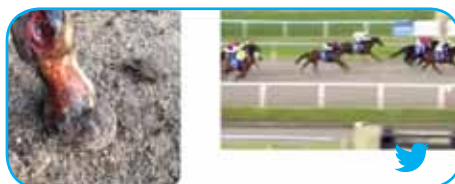
