Squillani Park's Kermadec colt tops day one with \$270,000 bid

Momentum picks up at Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale after slow start

Caulfield trainer Clinton McDonald continued his strong yearling sales season by landing the highest-priced lot on day one of the Magic Millions Adelaide auction, going to \$270,000 for a colt by young Darley stallion Kermadec (Teofilo), in a session that got off to a "very sticky start".

The auction opened with a six-figure lot while, another broke the \$100,000 mark about an hour into the sale, before heating up late in the day when four were sold for the figure inside 18 lots to enter the ring, including the most expensive yearling of the day.

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch said vendors and buyers took time to find a happy medium on the value of stock, but once that was achieved the clearance rate picked up.

It was at 76 per cent last night after being around 60 per cent earlier in the day.

"The buyers are doing their due diligence. They are being very selective on what they walk in and bid on," Bowditch told ANZ Bloodstock News last night.

"If they meet all their criteria - be it pedigree, type, vet - they bid up and on those right horses they were very strong, but if they were at all off the pace, the market has become quite polarising."

With the momentum of the sale picking up, the median of \$30,000 was up \$2000 on the same session last year, while the average of \$39,617 was down four per cent year on year.

The slight decline in the average is against the trend of the 2020 yearling sales and that of pre-sale expectations, but Magic Millions has compiled a larger Book 1 catalogue in Adelaide this year, enabling buyers to be even more selective.

The financial markets have also fluctuated wildly in recent weeks as the seriousness of the coronavirus outbreak sweeping the world becomes apparent, which comes as Hong Kong deals with political unrest.

Bowditch said: "Who knows whether that is having an effect. It is hard for me to comment, but it is affecting the world, so why wouldn't it be affecting a horse sale?"

"Of course, that may have a significant bearing on what is going on, but the sale, from lot 70 or 80 onwards, was quite pleasing,

"Vendors were meeting the market and buyers were bidding with confidence. To have the clearance rate finish, from where it was earlier in the day, at 76 per cent was a great effort."

Agent Will Johnson, who was involved in the purchase of a \$140,000 Street Boss (Street Cry) colt yesterday, admitted that the economic downturn could have clouded the opening session.

"The sale was strong in parts, but after a very turbulent week on the stock market with uncertainty surrounding the coronavirus, this matched the atmosphere in the air at the sale and the economy at large," Johnson said.

"Like any sale the nicer horses were well found and vendors have to meet the market to ensure that trade is strong, so no doubt there will be plenty of trade on those horses that didn't sell in the ring after hours."

The session-topping Kermadec colt, who was bought by McDonald and Hong Kong-based Australian agent Justin Bahen, was consigned by South Australian farm Squillani Park Thoroughbreds.

Offered as **Lot 211**, the colt is a half-brother to the Listed winner Falcool (Falvelon) and the stakes-placed I'm Cool (Falvelon). He is the eighth foal out of the placed mare Bay Breeze (Belong To Me), who has the perfect record so far, with five foals to race for five winners.

He was bred by the late Terry Board, the proprietor of Squillani Park, who lost his battle with cancer last November, and the first yearling the operation has sold for more than \$100,000.

"It's just fantastic, it's absolutely brilliant. It definitely exceeded our expectations and we are thrilled to bits," Squillani Park's Kerrie van Tijn said.

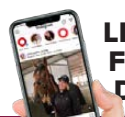
"He spent more time out of his box than in it over the past few days. He was extremely popular and he sold himself. He's a nice colt. He is impressive to look at, from a good family, so there wasn't a lot not to like about him."

Bahen was given the authority by McDonald to keep bidding to ensure the son of Kermadec returned to Victoria.

"I thought he was one of the nicest colts on the complex," Bahen told Racing.com.

"We got pushed pretty hard on him. He was a nice relaxed colt and I've got a good opinion of Kermadec.

"Clinton was very keen on him, he popped over and looked at him over the past couple of days and said 'just buy him.'"

So, yesterday, he landed another filly by the champion first season sire of 2017-18, for \$160,000 from the draft of Tasmanian farm Armidale Stud, in conjunction with his agent Damon Gabbedy of Belmont Bloodstock.

"Zoustar I love, of course, and she was very different to my star mare Sunlight, this filly," McEvoy told Racing.com.

"She has a lot of scope and reminded me a lot of a filly I train called Zoulah who won really well the other day and I think is up to black-type standard.

"She's just a beautiful, flowing filly with a lot of scope who looked to have a lot of class, to me.

"I've seen her five times and her temperament has stayed the same all the way through. Zoustar fillies can be a bit feisty but I think this filly was just gorgeous, so I am very happy to buy her."

Catalogued as **Lot 35**, the filly is a half-sister to three multiple winners, being the fifth foal out of the juvenile-winning mare Phyl's Choice (Savoire Vivre), who in turn is a sister to the stakes-placed, 11-time winner With Decorum.

Later, McEvoy Mitchell Racing and Belmont Bloodstock combined for another six-figure yearling, going to \$110,000 for a colt by Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) from the draft of NSW vendor Edinburgh Park Stud.

Murphy snaps up I'll Have A Bit's brother

Well-known South Australian trainer Sue Murphy also struck for a yearling from the draft of Armidale Stud, purchasing a Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock) brother to the Group 2-winning, Group 1-placed sprinter I'll Have A Bit.

The Naracoorte-based Murphy was taken with the look of the colt as soon as she inspected him at Morphettville and stretched the budget to ensure he joined her stable.

"He is a lovely type and he attracted us as soon as he came out. The full-sister has also done well," Murphy told Racing.com.

"There's a limit to what you can go to, but we thought we might just go that little bit higher to try and purchase him.

"He has a top page, a lot of black type, and that is the sort of gamble you have got to take if you find a nice yearling at the sales and we're happy with what we've got."

Offered by the Tasmanian stud as **Lot 126**, the colt is the sixth foal out of Melbourne winner Take All of Me (Jeune) who in turn is a daughter of the Group 2 winner Tickle My (Perugino).

The colt will be immediately broken in at Ballarat before heading to Murphy's care.

Armidale Stud was the leading vendor (three or more lots sold) by average, selling five yearlings for \$88,500 apiece.

Moore buys Starcraft colt for \$140,000

The purchase of a Starcraft (Soviet Star) colt first-up at the Adelaide sale yesterday was the biggest indicator yet that champion Hong Kong trainer John Moore will continue his career in Australia as soon as next season.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club has so far rejected pleas to extend Moore's training career in the Asian hub, having already done so past the initial compulsory retirement age of 65 by five years.

The Gold Coast and Sydney have been suggested as potential locations for Moore to set up a stable and his brother, Rosehill trainer Gary, yesterday said: "Brother John's coming back to Australia to train, but that can change every week, so he is going to be a nice addition to his stable with my assistance."

Offered by Miranda Park as **Lot 1**, the Starcraft colt is the first foal out of the six-time-winning sprinter Nadeem's Melody (Nadeem) who hails from the family of Group 3 winner Vivacious Spirit (Bel Esprit).


Selected by Moore and John's son, agent George, he was signed for by Queensland-based breeze-up operation Symphony Lodge.

"I just thought he presented well. He has a lovely temperament and he looks like he will go early when you think that the dam's won six races and came off a good farm as well," Moore said.

"The dam sire is Nadeem who we have had a lot of luck with through Happy Galaxy. Like I said, he's one of the best horses on the ground.

"We probably had a little more. Brother John really liked the colt when we presented the videos and photos to him. You have got to pay that sort of money for nice colts these days. Look at all the sales of recent times. They have been very expensive, these good colts."

Melbourne trainers were also active at the Adelaide sale, with Mick Price and Michael Kent Jr teaming up with agent Suman Hedge for the Akeed Mofeed (Dubawi) sister to stakes-placed Sunset Watch and Anthony Freedman to train a colt by Street Boss (Street Cry). Both yearlings made \$140,000.

Bahen partnered with fellow agents Johnson and Julian Blaxland to buy the Street Boss colt for Freedman.

It was the same sale that Johnson, under the De Burgh Equine banner, secured this season's Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Warning (Declaration Of War) for \$65,000.

Catalogued as **Lot 146**, the Rushton Park-consigned Street Boss colt is the third foal out of the five-time winner Truffle (Testa Rossa), whose third dam is AJC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m)-placed mare The Cloisters (Godswalk).

"He is a strong precocious two-year-old type. He looked like a running colt and between the Freedmans, Julian Blaxland and Justin Bahen, we went through a few horses that we liked and thought he was worth teaming up on," Johnson said.

"Anthony and Sam know the breed well and Anthony liked the colt when he was in Adelaide this week.

"He looks like a type that will be able to target those early two-year-

old races. Given he is by Street Boss and out of a Testa Rossa mare, who is proving to be a good broodmare sire, he certainly ticked a lot of boxes which gives us a lot of confidence going forward."

Freedman trains Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) contender, the Street Boss colt Hanseatic, who was runner-up in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Day two of the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale, which will see the completion of Book 1 and a Book 2 session, starts at 10am local time.

Ilovemyself on target for Pago Pago

Cranbourne trainer Greg Eurell made a flying visit to Sydney to watch Ilovemyself (Ilovethiscity) in a Rosehill gallop ahead of the colt's late bid to earn a Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) start via the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). A big performance on Saturday from Ilovemyself, who won a Listed race at Flemington on debut, could earn him a start in the \$3.5 million Golden Slipper a week later. The colt's owner/breeder Neville Murdoch would need to pay a \$150,000 late entry for the Slipper

if he qualifies. "He would have to win to help us bounce into the Slipper, for two reasons," Eurell said. "One is to obviously get the automatic entry and be free from the ballot, but it's also a nice little lift with the prize-money to help you pay that late entry fee getting into it. He would certainly have to win or be desperately unlucky and run second to push us over the line. And if he misses out, we'll put him away and get him ready for the spring."

Phar Lap for Probabeel

Star New Zealand filly Probabeel (Zavabeel) will not take on older horses in Saturday's Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) but will instead renew her rivalry with Funstar (Adelaide) in the Phar Lap Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill. With Opie Bosson riding stablemate Melody Belle (Commands) in the All-Star Mile (1600m) at Caulfield, Kerrin McEvoy takes the ride on the Jamie Richards-trained Probabeel who beat Funstar in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick last Saturday week. That result reversed the placings from the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in spring but the markets have Funstar favourite to bounce back on Saturday.

Alligator Blood All-Star favourite

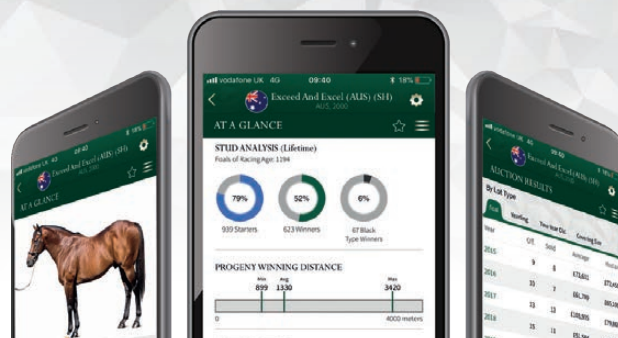
Queensland star Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) continues to astound his trainer David Vandyke as he prepares to cap a memorable season in the \$5 million All-Star Mile. Alligator Blood, who will be ridden by Ryan Maloney, is favourite for Saturday's All-Star Mile and Vandyke said the three-year-old will front up in great order for what will be his tenth and final start of the season.

"I'm happy with barrier 10," Vandyke said after yesterday's draw. "We've been drawing some very good barriers of late, one and two at his past two starts, so I was expecting a double figure and 10 is OK. Streets Of Avalon is on our outside in barrier 11. We'll probably go forward with him and as Ryan said it gives him a bit of time to think." The winner of ten of his 11 starts, including the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at his most recent appearance, Alligator Blood was \$2.70 favourite after coming up with barrier ten of 15. New Zealand champion Melody Belle is second-favourite at \$4.50 and has barrier five in a field that includes ten individual Group 1 winners.

Bosson pleased with 'outstanding' Melody Belle

Jockey Opie Bosson has given All-Star Mile contender Melody Belle the tick of approval following her gallop at Caulfield over 1200m yesterday morning. Bosson made a special trip to Melbourne ahead of Saturday's race to give the ten-time Group 1 winner her final workout.

"Her work was outstanding," he said. "She has improved so much from that first-up run. I couldn't fault her work one bit." After learning that his mount had drawn five, the most successful gate at Caulfield over 1600m, Bosson added: "I definitely didn't want to be out too wide. If there is no speed on it would be nice to just sit and get a nice track into the race."

Fierce Impact in top order

Trainer Matthew Smith and jockey Craig Williams believe Fierce Impact (Deep Impact) could not be in better shape ahead of the second running of the All-Star Mile following an away day workout for the six-year-old at Sandown yesterday. "He's quite a lazy horse in his own surroundings so we thought we'd come out to Sandown to stimulate him a bit," Smith said. "We wanted to see him chase today, do a little bit of work and luckily we got the right bit of work into him." Williams, who has ridden Fierce Impact three times in Melbourne, for two Group 1 wins and a Group 1 second, said: "He didn't have the blinkers on this morning and he wasn't out here to beat the clock. But he came out and achieved what we wanted him to, have a nice gallop, a nice blow on a beautiful, safe surface and he came through that with flying colours."

Dalasan given one more chance

Leon Macdonald is hoping that a good pace will help Dalasan (Dalakhani) find the necessary improvement to be competitive in the \$5 million contest after finishing fifth in both the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) and Australian Guineas. "In my opinion he's been slightly disappointing, but when you get a run in a race like this you have to take it," the Hall Of Fame trainer told Racing.com. "We'll have one more

throw at the stumps for a race which would be pretty important if he could win it. Obviously it's a very strong field, but what will help him is there looks to be genuine pace which I think he's been missing of late. His late sectionals have been pretty good, but the races have been sit and sprint races and he's been left flat footed a few times."

So Si Bon out to cause All-Star surprise

Lindsay Park trainer Ben Hayes is also hoping a strong gallop will suit his All-Star Mile representative, So Si Bon (So You Think). "Last start he led and was ridden outside of his comfort zone, so we'll be able to ride him back like we normally do and he should get a nice run," he told Racing.com. "Barrier nine is lovely for him especially with Alligator Blood and Streets Of Avalon drawn outside of us. He's got a great record at this track, he came second in the spring in the Group 1 Memsie Stakes, he won the Lord Stakes and he's placed multiple times, so it's probably his favourite track. He runs well around this time of year, he's got a sneaky chance, he's the kind of horse you wouldn't be surprised to see running on late."

McDonald taken by Olmedo

European import Olmedo (Declaration Of War) pleased connections in a gallop at Canterbury yesterday as he builds up to a possible tilt at Saturday's Ajax Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill. The Group 1 winner did a one lap canter then a solid 1000m gallop under James McDonald after which trainer Kacy Fogden told Racing NSW: "Considering the way he pulled up he's where we need him to be at for this time of his program. By the looks of it James got along with him pretty well. We'll weigh up a few things before we confirm whether or not we're running.

He's settled in perfectly, he's been a dream since the day he got here. The more he works the more he eats, it's indicating he's perfect. We couldn't have asked for a better horse to come over." McDonald was complimentary of the five-year-old, adding: "He's a nice horse and he's very athletic, he did a nice bit of work."

Victoria to have race-free week

Racing Victoria yesterday announced plans for a race-free week as part of its ongoing review of the working week which has been carried out with the Australian Trainers Association, Victorian Jockeys Association and Racing Clubs. RV will implement a series of initiatives on a trial basis to determine their impact on participant welfare, customer engagement and industry funding. The first round of initiatives will be captured within the 2020-21 race dates, which will be formally released before the end of this month. As well as the race-free week at the end of the season for the next two years, other initiatives announced include plans to have no racing on Christmas Eve, an increase in race-free days and earlier finishes to night meetings

Thompson to represent Qld

Rising star Adin Thompson will represent Queensland in the National Apprentices Challenge Series at Ascot in Perth on Wednesday. Thompson rode his first metropolitan winner on January 18 and in the two months since he has moved that tally on to 18 and is riding for many of the top stables. The Apprentices Challenge is for young jockeys from all Australian states (except NSW) with New Zealand and Singapore riders also in the mix. Thompson will sport the Bob and Sandra Peters' colours in Wednesday's race aboard the Grant and Alana Williams-trained Picture Perfect (Rest), a winner of two of his six starts.

Trials scheduled for Ipswich

Racing Queensland yesterday announced that there will be official trials conducted at Ipswich Turf Club on March 30, prior to the return to racing at the venue on April 8. The trials follow the track refurbishment and irrigation project which has been ongoing at the venue since November 2019. The meeting's program will comprise a series of heats over 800 metres and 1000 metres in which a maximum of 50 horses will be permitted to trial. The trials will commence at 9.00am and nominations will close at midday on March 27.

Vale Trevor Stuckey

Respected racehorse owner Trevor Stuckey has died aged 91 in Sydney. Stuckey raced horses with the suffix 'To Win' including multiple Group 1-winner Racing To Win (Encosta De Lago). A crowd favourite, Racing To Win was trained by John O'Shea to five top-level victories including the Doncaster Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) in 2006. After O'Shea went to Godolphin, Stuckey and his long-time partner Penny Yan raced horses with Peter and Paul Snowden, most notably Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor), who landed the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in 2014. Nicknamed 'Lucky Stuckey' after his many Group 1 successes, Stuckey had a brief stint as a harness racing driver before becoming a bookmaker and then a successful owner and breeder. His funeral takes place on Friday.

NEW ZEALAND

Hasahalo offered for sale on Gavelhouse

Group 1 winner Hasahalo (Savabeel) is likely to prove a big draw for online auction site gavelhouse.com after it was revealed she will be the opening lot in their upcoming sale. The New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner raced 16 times in her career, also landing a Group 3 contest for her owners Go Racing. "There's been a lot of interest in her as news of her retirement's filtered out and I know gavelhouse.com is the right place to sell her as the timing is right with a good lead into the breeding season for people to plan their matings," Go Racing's Albert Bosma said. Hasahalo is out of the Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) mare Halloween, a half-sister to Generous Nature (Carnegie), the dam of Group winners Savvy Nature (Savabeel) and Addictive Nature (Savabeel). "We're thrilled to have been entrusted with presenting such a high class mare to the market and having seen her

last week, she looks magnificent and has the physical attributes to back up her outstanding race record and pedigree," gavelhouse.com general manager Haylie Martin said. The auction closes at 7pm on March 16 and features 111 lots in total, with Hasahalo kicking off the night selling action as **lot 1**.

First Group 1 for former shearer

Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Roger That (Shinko King) looks likely to be staying close to home after providing his trainer, former shearer Anthony Fuller, with a first elite level winner from just his second runner in the highest grade. "I think it is still sinking in to be honest, but I do find myself walking around and grinning," Fuller said of Saturday's surprise success. A Sydney campaign had been under consideration for Roger That, but Fuller said he has decided to stick with his original plan for the gelding. "We have given it a fair bit of thought, but I don't see how it could successfully work, so we will give it a miss and stick to our original plan," he said. "He will be having a couple of weeks off and prepare for a winter campaign here. He is going to get a bit of weight, but I'd rather have a horse that has got a problem with the handicapper than one that can't beat a three-legged donkey home."

Phantom Chance Jillings' number one

Hall of Fame trainer Colin Jillings has many achievements to look back on, however it is his victory in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) in 1993 with The Phantom Chance (Noble Bijou) that stands out above the rest. Jillings was a part of the Cox Plate tour at Karaka on Monday ahead of its 100th running in October and he recalled the win with great fondness. "It's a great thrill to win a Cox Plate," Jillings said. "You are very lucky to have a runner in it, let alone win it. I'd

say that would be my greatest thrill in racing. I have won three Auckland Cups and five Derbys, but the Cox Plate still stands out as the highlight. It's the best weight-for-age race in Australasia, so it speaks for itself."

ASIA

I'm Incredible nears return

Singapore Horse of the Year I'm Incredible (Lope De Vega) is close to making his return to racing after taking part in a barrier trial yesterday morning. "It was an easy trial today. Matty (Kellady) rode him today as Vlad Duric is away," trainer Shane Baertschiger said. "He is making his comeback in a Class 1 race over 1200m on April 3. It's a Polytrack race, which is not ideal, but there was nothing else. He had six weeks off after the Gold Cup and he's come back in good shape. He's been very good in his trackwork. I was happy with his trial today. He will need one more before that first race. Second-up, he will then run in the Moonbeam Vase and third-up will be the Kranji Mile."

INTERNATIONAL

Study Of Man has seven of his first eight mares covered scanned in foal

Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m) winner Study Of Man (Deep Impact) has had seven of his first eight mares covered scanned in foal. The five-year-old became the only son of Japanese super-sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) standing in Britain when he retired to Lanwades Stud in Newmarket for this year. Among the mares in foal to the grandson of the legendary mare Miesque (Nureyev) are Group 1 winner Lady Jane Digby (Oasis Dream), who is already dam of five winners with her first five foals, and Almiranta (Galileo), who is the dam of two Group winners.

Saudi Cup winner Jason Servis among 27 facing doping-related charges in US

Jason Servis, who saddled Maximum Security (New Year's Day) to victory in the world's richest race last month, is among 27 trainers, veterinarians, drug distributors and others connected to US racing who face charges as part of an alleged widespread doping scheme.

An indictment released on Monday in the United States District Court specifically states that a designer, performance-enhancing substance was administered to Maximum Security in 2019, when he was named champion three-year-old colt in the US.

Jorge Navarro, whose horses have earned more than \$37 million since 2008, was also among the trainers listed in a 44-page indictment that listed 18 other individuals. Eight more were listed in three other indictments on similar charges.

In the indictment of the 19 individuals that included Navarro and Servis, it said the charges result from a "widespread, corrupt scheme by racehorse trainers, veterinarians, performance-enhancing drug (PED) distributors, and others to manufacture, distribute, and receive adulterated and misbranded PEDs and to secretly administer those PEDs to racehorses under the scheme's participants' control".

Servis, who won last month's US\$20 million Saudi Cup (1800m) with Maximum Security, is accused of covertly obtaining and administering

adulterated and misbranded PEDs, including one called SGF-1000, to "virtually all of the racehorses under his control".

The indictment says that from February 2018, Servis entered horses in approximately 1,082 races and his co-conspirators concealed the administration of PEDs from federal and state government agencies, racing officials, and the betting public.

It also states that PEDs were covertly transported between barns where Servis's horses were stabled by falsifying vet bills to conceal administration of SGF-1000 and using fake prescriptions.

Navarro, who has enjoyed big-race success in Dubai, is accused of "orchestrating a widespread scheme of covertly obtaining and administering various adulterated and misbranded PEDs to horses under his control" the indictment alleges.

The court papers state that SGF-1000 is a customised PED purportedly containing "growth factors" including fibroblast growth factor and hepatocyte growth factor, which are intended to promote tissue repair and increase a horse's stamina and endurance beyond its natural capability.

A statement from the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, in the name of president and chief executive Alex Waldrop read: "The charges documented in today's

federal indictment against 27 individuals in horseracing are abhorrent. There is no place in our sport for individuals who treat horses with disregard for their well-being or who undermine the integrity of our competition for personal gain.

"We support the effort to bring these charges to light and are hopeful that their swift adjudication will help assure other horse racing participants and the public at large that our sport will not condone or tolerate the behaviour alleged in the indictments."

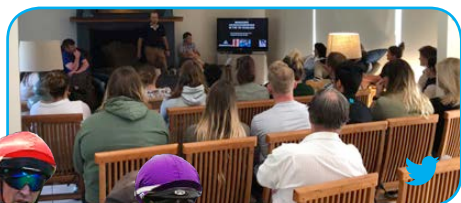
