Group-winning son of Zoustar to stand at Telemon Thoroughbreds

Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Sun City finds home at Queensland stud

Group 3-winning juvenile Sun City (Zoustar) has been retired and will stand his first season at stud at the growing Queensland enterprise Telemon Thoroughbreds, an opportunity farm principal Dan Fletcher said he could not ignore.

Fletcher secured the former Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained sprinter to join Sidestep

(Exceed And Excel) and Jungle Cat (Iffraaj) on the Telemon stallion roster this year, courtesy of his strong relationship with the sire prospect's major owner Qatar Bloodstock.

Sun City was victorious in last year's B J McLachlan Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) with a performance that catapulted him to the top of the betting for the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) before he was struck down with a joint infection.

One of three sons of Widden Stud's Zoustar (Northern Meteor) at stud in 2020, Sun City will stand for an introductory fee of \$7,700 (all fees inclusive of GST).

Sidestep, the sire of 2019 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi, has had his fee reduced to \$16,500 while multiple Group 1 winner Jungle Cat will enter his second season at an unchanged fee of \$13,200.

Fletcher, who races three-time Group 1-winning mare Sunlight (Zoustar) with Qatar Bloodstock and partners, believes Sun City is deserving of his place at stud and the syndicate behind the colt are committed to sending mares to him.

"We're really trying to make our name through how selective we are in what we will stand," he told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"In that sense, that determination to focus on quality hasn't changed and won't change, but the thing is that this horse meets our criteria and he's affordable. For these horses to be affordable, there's always going to have to be a bit of a story.

"There's horses going to the Hunter this year who have 'could have been anything' type stories but for whatever reason things don't go quite right and they didn't finish up as a \$50,000 first season horse.

"This guy, you pull him apart and do all the due diligence that we've

done and the figures we've got, he does stack up.

"There's every chance that he was a Group 1 horse, so that's the reality of this market: to try and offer breeders that have got that limited capacity and can't access Zoustar himself or spend \$50,000 on a service fee, to still give them that potential. All these other factors create the price."

His pedigree and the success

of the Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) sire line also appealed to Fletcher who is offering equity and breeding right shares in Sun City.

A \$525,000 yearling purchase from the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, he is out of the Listed-winning sprinter Roulettes (Flying Spur), making him a half-brother to the dual Group 2-placed sprinter Spin (I Am Invincible).

"It makes sense with what Northern Meteor's done; what Deep Field and Zoustar himself are doing and Rubick's another one - that's a really potent sire line," Fletcher continued.

"It's every probability that's where you need to be and the horse who went to Victoria last year (Lean Mean Machine) was really well supported, so the market's intelligent enough to recognise that. I think the horse will work well."

Sun City raced just six times after the infected joint hampered his career.

Tony McEvoy said Sun City's ability was obvious from his early two-year-old career when running the second fastest closing sectionals of the meeting when runner-up in the Maribyrnong Trial (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington in October 2018.

"He was quite clearly our sharpest and best two-year-old and whilst we were disappointed he bungled the start, we weren't surprised with the splits he ran. He could sprint at Sunlight sectionals. That's the level of ability we were seeing at home," McEvoy said. *Continued on page 4>>*

Matt Rudolph, also a part-owner of Sun City, believes an agreement to stand the rising four-year-old at Telemon Thoroughbreds would give the well-bred stallion a strong platform at stud.

Rudolph said: "The farm's record of producing exceptional stallions combined with Dan's own success assures Sun City every opportunity.

"More than a third of Australia's early season two-year-old races are run in Queensland so this is an ideal location for him."

Meanwhile, Fletcher is bullish about the upward trajectory of the Darley owned **Sidestep** who enters his third season at Telemon Thoroughbreds after starting his stud career at Kelvinside in the Hunter Valley.

On the back of Kiamichi emerging in his first crop, Sidestep's service fee jumped to \$22,000 last year but given the coronavirus pandemic, Darley and Fletcher have elected to drop his fee this year.

"He's a horse we think is going really well. Every time you turn around he's got another quality runner even though he hasn't got the depth of numbers," Fletcher said.

"I think he'd only had three two-year-old runners this season, so we always knew he was going to be quiet in that respect, but he got a really good quality book of mares last year.

"At the fee that we've set him at, we think he's probably going to benefit from these (Covid-19) conditions with people looking for that proven quality horse with the profile that he's got but remaining budget conscious because of the economy. *Continued on page 6>>*

Sidestep, a dual Group 2 winner, is one of a number of sons of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) at stud and that line-up will be boosted by the addition of Microphone and Exceedance to the Hunter Valley ranks this year.

“Of the three big colts who won Group 1s last year, two of them are off

to stud and I think when you compare Sidestep to them, he’s right up to the mark with Exceedance and Microphone in terms of his race record,” he said.

“He’s a proven horse who’s delivered what everyone else is trying to do. Everyone’s trying to breed a Golden Slipper winner and Sidestep can take you there - he’s proven that.”

Jungle Cat, winner of an Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) in Dubai and Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield for Godolphin trainer Charlie Appleby in 2018, rounds out the Telemon roster.

“He’s a really fast horse with a high rating. He’s the right sort of horse for what people want to breed down here,” he said.

“He’s a beautiful horse and a really straight-forward horse and when you look at him, there’s not much that can go wrong and that’s why we will get really excited if they come out looking like he does - they’ll have to be able to run.”

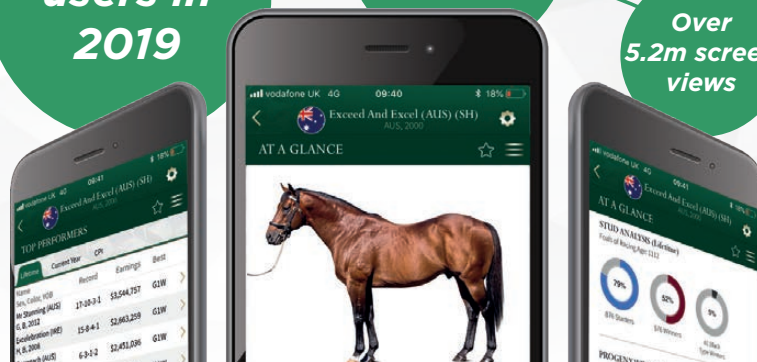

Mare in foal to Deep Field tops online Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale

Four mares made more than \$200,000 at the digital Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale yesterday and it was Yulong Investments who featured prominently on the buyers' list, securing ten lots including the top-priced Villa San Michele (Medaglia d'Oro) for \$260,000.

The daughter of the Group 3 winner Florentina (Redoute's Choice) and a half-sister to the stakes-placed Villa Carlotta (Street Cry), who is in foal to Newgate Farm's Deep Field (Northern Meteor), will be added to the significant and quality broodmare band put together by Yuesheng Zhang in recent years.

Wilf Mula purchased Listed winner Kentucky Miss (Foxwedge), who is in foal to the Aston Bloodstock-raced Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) in partnership with the late Paul Whelan, for \$250,000 from the unreserved Luskin Park Stud dispersal while Taqaareed (Sepoy) was bought by Widden Stud for \$215,000. A half-sister to Group 2 winner Wawail (Lonhro), she was sold in foal to Pierro (Lonhro),

The other mare to break the \$200,000 mark was La Pomme De Pin

(I Am Invincible), who is in foal to Coolmore's shuttler Justify (Scat Daddy).

Offered by Middlebrook Valley Lodge, she was bought by Torryburn Stud whose obvious attraction to the family is the fact that La Pomme De Pin's dam Crimson Lane (Danehill) is a half-sister to John Cornish's Group 3 winner

Crimson Reign (Red Ransom). La Pomme De Pin, who was trained by Lloyd Kennewell, made \$205,000.

Yulong's activity in yesterday's sale was, in part, prompted by the fact that the Nagambie stud recently announced the retirement of C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) to join its foundation sire Grunt (O'Reilly).

Villa San Michele's commercial appeal shone through to Yulong's chief operating officer Sam Fairgray.

“She's from a very good family, a mare with a pedigree behind her, a lovely mare to have in our ever-expanding broodmare band. We're undecided who she will go to as of yet,” Fairgray said.

"Overall we've bought some really nice mares by really nice stallions in foal to some really nice young horses and proven stallions. We're happy."

"It's great to get mares by Street Cry, Redoute's Choice, More Than Ready etc, really nice mares for the Yulong broodmare band to support our stallions."

Segenhoe's Peter O'Brien said the John Camilleri-bred and raced Villa San Michele's price befitted her quality.

"I'm delighted, completely delighted. She was a queen of a mare with a pedigree to die for so she deserved a good price and she absolutely got that and more," O'Brien said.

"It's not often you get a Medaglia d'Oro mare that ticks every box, being in foal to a hot stallion the quality of Deep Field."

He added: "Yulong have been great supporters of us in buying weanlings, yearlings

and broodmares for a long time and the most important thing for us was that this mare went to a good home and that's absolutely the case with Yulong purchasing her, which is fantastic."

Yulong was the leading vendor by aggregate and number of mares bought, with the ten lots costing a combined \$1.043 million.

Segenhoe was the leading vendor by aggregate and average (three or more lots sold), with 22 of its 19 mares selling for \$1.15 million at an average of \$104,591.

"We supplemented some of the better mares into the sale and they have sold brilliantly," O'Brien said.

"It's really a huge credit to Inglis for how they promoted the sale, their professionalism in the lead-up and during, under challenging circumstances, given the global outlook and the quality and ease of the overall format of the Inglis digital auctions. It really is beyond reproach."

dispersal also wound up yesterday, with the vendor selling all 16 mares yesterday headed by Kentucky Miss who was raced by Whelan and Mula to four wins when trained by Joe Pride.

"By winning the Cap d'Antibes (Listed, 1100m) and running third in the San Domenico (Gr3, 1100m) - beating home Capitalist that day - she proved herself on the track multiple times and I think she's definitely a mare of the future," Mula said.

"We had a bit of a fight on our hands to get her but we're very happy we did."

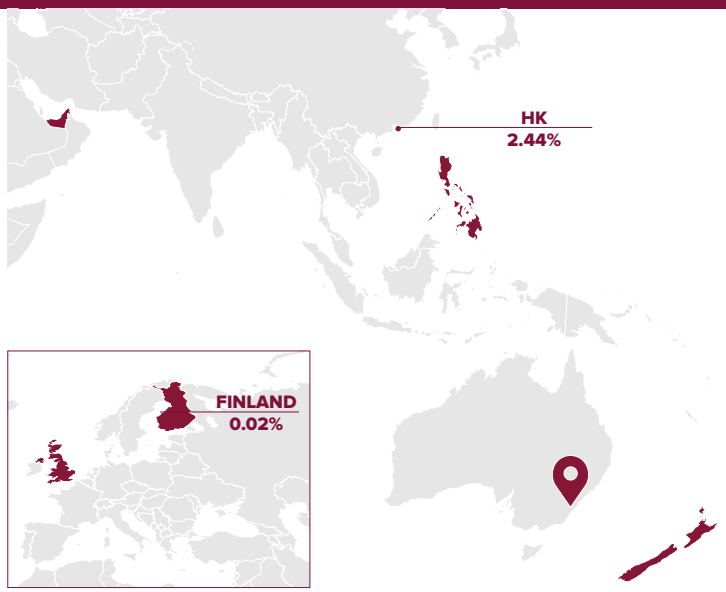
John Whelan was delighted that it was Mula and his wife Rosemary who ended up with Kentucky Miss.

<< *Continued from page 10* were able to pick her up. We'll be cheering her progeny on from the grandstand and lounge room for many years to come," he said.

Inglis has handled the dispersal of all Luskin Park's stock, with all 16 mares in yesterday's catalogue grossing \$947,600 at an average of \$59,225.

"People seem to have embraced this format and it's proving very successful. It really works well," Whelan said.

"It's an emotional thing, we put our trust in Inglis and as usual they've delivered in spades and some. Jonathan (D'Arcy) and the team have been exceptional and we're thrilled with the overall results."

With Friday's virtual Chairman's Sale of elite breeding stock and yesterday's solely online Australian Broodmare Sale, Inglis had achieved a turnover of more than \$32.5 million.

The increase in quality lots in yesterday's sale compared to last year saw the average of \$41,058 hold up well against last year's \$41,940 figure but the median fell away this year to \$22,500, down 25 per cent, with a stretched buying bench due to the economic downturn.

The clearance rate was last night at 67 per cent, compared to 76 per cent at the same time last year.

Given the circumstances, Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch was happy with the way the sale turned out.

The live public auctions were banned due to federal government restrictions on the operation of businesses that attracted large public gatherings while the country attempted to slow the spread of Covid-19.


Of the thoroughbred auction houses, Inglis

has been hardest hit with the ban coming into place prior to its Australian Easter Yearling Sale, which was subsequently held as a virtual auction as was the Chairman's Sale, the Australian Broodmare Sale was held online and its weanling sale was deferred.

Inglis and rival Magic Millions are hopeful of being able to hold live auctions in July.

AUSTRALIA

Four for Headwater

Maya Bay (2 c ex Commitment by Testa Rossa) recorded a strong first-start victory at Toowoomba yesterday for the local training combination of Tony and Maddysen Sears to provide his sire Headwater (Exceed And Excel) with his fourth individual first crop winner. Maya Bay, who won the QTIS 2YO Maiden Handicap (1000m) by three quarters of a length over Dragon Miss (Hidden Dragon) and Count The Coin (Spirit Of Boom) who was another four and a quarter lengths back in third, was a \$55,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs in Training Sale purchase by Pinhook Bloodstock's Dave Mee and Sears Racing from the Nolen Racing draft. He joins the exciting Wisdom Of Water among the winners for the young Vinery Stud sire who will stand for a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST) this year.

Expensive colt to debut in Adelaide

After being scratched from a two-year-old handicap at Caulfield on the weekend, the equal third highest priced lot at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, a colt by champion Japanese sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) out of Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Gritto, will make his debut at Morphettville on Saturday. Now named Kazuhiko and trained by Lloyd Kennewell, he was purchased for \$1.7 million by Kennewell in conjunction with Spendthrift and Group 1 Bloodstock and will debut in Saturday's National Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). "He's a high class horse with a huge pedigree that we paid a bit of money for," Kennewell said. "We just felt

that with the rain coming ahead of Saturday's race that was a little hiccup heading to his first start. Next Saturday is a Group 3 race and as a two-year-old, being a son of Deep Impact, if he can get off to a good start it will be good for his future."

Santa on track for second Goodwood

If Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) takes out The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) on Saturday, he will become the first horse in over 100 years to win Adelaide's feature race twice. The Anthony Freedman-trained five time Group 1 winner has not won since his dominant victory in the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in April last year. He finished second in his defence of that race last month before failing to fire in the All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at his last start. "Everyone is saying he's not going as well. Two starts ago he was running down Nature Strip who's probably now the best sprinter in the world," Freedman's racing manager Brad Taylor said. "If people put a line through last start and go back to two starts ago when he was running second in the TJ Smith, that's going to make him awfully hard to beat in a race like this."

Options open for Camelot

Danny O'Brien believes his South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Russian Camelot (Camelot) will begin his spring campaign in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) but he is unsure of where the colt will go from there. "He's only had the five runs, so it's a little bit hard to assess whether he could line up against the best horses in Australasia in the Cox Plate or whether we'd stick to the handicaps like the Caulfield and the Melbourne Cups," O'Brien

said. "We'll just give him the chance over the next few months to mature and then we'll kick off in something like the Makybe Diva. Maybe the Makybe Diva then the Turnbull and that will tell us where he goes. There's probably a good case for saying in the spring he could win a big race at the mile or certainly a mile and a quarter, he probably does have that little bit more versatility than (Melbourne Cup winner) Vow And Declare."

Dalasan off for well-earned break

After a gallant runner-up performance in the South Australian Derby, Dalasan (Dalakhani) will head to the paddock for a spell. "He's done a mighty job and we could not be more proud of him," co-trainer Leon Macdonald told Racing.com. "He has come through the run in perfect order. He ran his heart out but the winner was simply too good on the day. "Looking ahead to the spring he'll kick off in Adelaide with a run in either the Spring Stakes or the Penny Edition, possibly even both. At this stage the first big race we have penciled in is the Group 1 Makybe Diva Stakes at Flemington on September 12. Beyond the Makybe Diva if all is going well certainly the Cox Plate and/or Caulfield Cup would be high on our agenda."

Kendrick chasing first Stradbroke

Caloundra trainer Stuart Kendrick is hoping to have a Stradbroke Handicap (Gr1, 1400m) winner with his first runner in the iconic race, after Tambo's Mate (Mossman) gained an automatic entry to the feature race when he won the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben on Saturday. "I have never had a Stradbroke runner before. Every trainer wants to win Group 1s and every Queensland trainer wants to win the Stradbroke," Kendrick said. "After all it is Queensland's signature race and has been won by some great trainers. Of course I am hoping to win it but I also want to enjoy the experience of having a genuine chance." On Tambo's Mate, Kendrick added: "The start to his campaign was mixed up because we had to come back in distance for his previous run. But he will go into the Stradbroke with four runs under his belt and hopefully he will improve that little bit."

O'Dea weighs up options for Gotta Kiss

Steve O'Dea is weighing up the options for classy filly Gotta Kiss (Not A Single Doubt) and could miss a much-anticipated return clash with top filly Isotope (Deep Field). A potential option for the two-year-old's next start is the Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm on May 23 where she would meet Isotope, but O'Dea is also looking at putting blinkers on Gotta Kiss and running her in a Listed race at Doomben on May 30. "Before the coronavirus we were only giving her a light winter and skirt around the better races," he said. "That's changed and it will either be the Doomben race in three weeks or the Champagne Stakes."

Baker keen on prospects of stable addition

A gritty victory last Wednesday by recent stable addition Starspangled Rodeo (Teofilo) has Bjorn Baker excited about the immediate prospects for the former New Zealand-trained five-year-old. A pair of trial victories had the Warwick Farm trainer believing a winning debut was on the cards and despite having to lump the topweight of 62.5 kilograms, Starspangled Rodeo had enough class to salute first-up for Baker over the 1250-metre journey. "He was very good and it was a big effort with the weight after losing his momentum on

the corner," Baker said. "He had trialled really well around a horse called Three Beans that won well at Newcastle on Saturday while Ilwendo, who placed second in the Gosford Cup yesterday was also in one of the trials he won. It's easy to say in hindsight but the trial form was good and he's a big, strong horse with a lot going for him."

Moody returns with a winner

Over four years since saddling his last runner at the races, Peter Moody returned to the training ranks as a winner yesterday when Shepard (Sea The Moon) took out a 2000-metre handicap at Ballarat. Purchased by Moody for 30,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale, Shepard had previously been trained by David Brideoake for his first six starts, registering three wins. Moody said the gelding was a lovely staying horse and everything panned out well in yesterday's race when they went along at a nice gallop. "And he did the rest," Moody told Racing.com. "Much thanks to my great mate, David Brideoake, (Brideoake's assistant) Alex Woodhams and his team. They've done a tremendous job and they've looked after this horse very well his whole career. So thanks to them. I reckon I've improved him in seven days though, just to let David know that."

Hawtin out to increase footprint

Former New Zealand-based trainer Brendon Hawtin is looking forward to taking the next step in his career after making a successful move to Australia eight months ago. Hawtin took up the position of assistant trainer Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young in September last year, and now looks after the pre-training and development of the stable's younger horses, while under his visiting trainer's licence he prepares progressive sprinter/miler Simply Optimistic (Encosta De Lago). "I'm currently still on my visiting trainer's licence but I'm going to hand in the paperwork to apply for my full licence in the next couple of days," Hawtin said. "It has just been terrific over here so far with the horses going so well and with my new license I will be able to take over a few more in my own right."

Payne inquiry concluded

After sending a raceday bag containing medications to Geelong last month, dual

license holder Michelle Payne has been fined \$1000 for negligence but has been cleared of any intentional wrongdoing by RV Stewards. "In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account her guilty plea, her record, and her forthright evidence throughout the investigation; and also considered that whilst the products were of a therapeutic nature, bringing them and the syringes to the racecourse or in a motor vehicle used for the purpose of transporting a horse to a race meeting, without the Stewards written permission, was nonetheless a contravention of AR251. The Stewards were satisfied on the evidence available to them, including a cleared post-race blood sample from Jukila, that none of the mentioned substances were administered to Jukila in contravention of the Rules."

"I think it was a fair price although we thought she may have been worth more before this whole Covid-19 situation came along," Richardson said. "It was a strange feeling when she sold as I put her in the same category as Platonic who was one of the best mares I had early on in my stable. Both horses I feel were as good as each other and they were part of the stable, of the family and it is always sad to see that end."

Real Impact shuttled to Arrowfield Stud for three seasons, producing 231 live foals at a fee of \$19,250 (inc GST). He now resides at Japan's Shadai Stallion Station for a fee of ¥2,000,000 (approx. AUD\$29,000).

Five for Lohengrin

Lex Stud resident Lohengrin (Singspiel) landed his fifth stakes winner yesterday when Tosen Surya (5 c ex Tosen Gracia by Durandal) won the Niigata Daishoten (Gr 3, 2000m). Trained by Jiro Ono, the five-year-old defeated Atomic Force (Workforce) by a length and a half with three-quarters of a length back to Precious Blue (Deep Impact) in third. Lohengrin stands for a fee of ¥800,000 (approx. AUD\$11,500).

A report on Friday suggested a late challenge may be made to the government's decision to allow racing to return today, with France Galop and its trotting equivalent confirming they had been in discussions regarding the resumption plans. 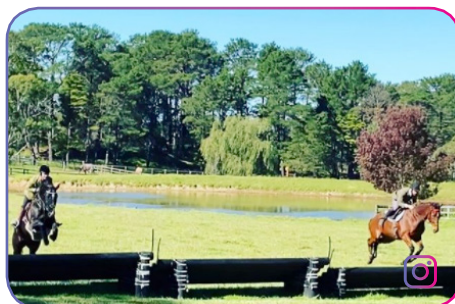

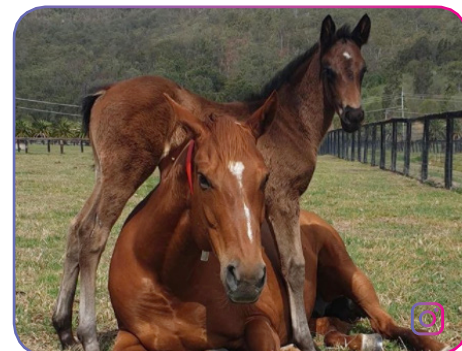
