Heys' desire for top-level recruits fuels million-dollar outlay at Easter

Young trainer backed by long-term owner to banish memories of Group 1 misses and prepare elite-level winner

Trainer Bryce Heys has a rising flame of ambition burning inside him.

The former handler of Spieth (Thorn Park), many will recall his tearful interview which endeared him to the industry in the aftermath of the 2016 VRC

Darley Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) after his stable star was touched off by Malaguerra (Magnus) by the narrowest of margins.

The horse would never deliver that elusive first Group 1 for Heys, falling short by a similar margin of significant millimetres in the VRC Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) in the autumn of 2017.

Yet a desire to train at the highest level, and a realisation that it comes at a notable cost, led the young trainer to turn heads late in the day of the final session of last week's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, securing a standout So You Think (High Chaparral) colt and an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) filly from a sought-after family, each for a seven-figure price, at the blue riband sale.

"The reality is that, at this moment, they're all worth the same, but what I've found over the last five years, you go into a sale now, whether it's a Classic sale or the Gold Coast, wherever it is, the buying bench is so

well researched and rehearsed on what they want and what they're looking for, everyone is just better at what they do and you see it year-in, year-out, so it's just getting harder in that respect to source horses," said Heys, who trains a small team of horses from his Warwick Farm base.

"First and foremost you've got to back your judgement on these and it's the Easter sale so it's the creme de la creme within

a small, condensed catalogue and everyone's there to play. So it's going to be expensive."

Both yearlings were purchased for a long-term backer of Heys who has been with him 'since day dot', and connections were prepared to go to the lengths required to secure the quality racing prospects, with Heys having his sights set on the So You Think colt, catalogued as lot 415 from the Segenhoe draft, a long way out from the sale, with a bid of \$1 million enough to secure the colt.

"Both are for a long-term client," said Heys. "We didn't necessarily approach the sale with a particular type of horse, ie an earlier horse or a later horse, we just came up with a list of horses and he was just a colt I fell in love with, as you've got to do, and then you've got to pay that sort of money."

"He's a colt that just got better every time you saw him, despite the first impression being pretty much impeccable."

"I felt he was a million-dollar colt and he deserved that sort of price," he continued. "Three days before the sale I pretty much turned to the buyer and said if they're not prepared to go to a million dollars on him then we're probably better setting our sights on something else."

"I felt that he was that good, so we were always prepared for him to be at that mark."

<< *Continued from page 2* Group 1 winner through Think It Over, and landing the weekend's Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) with Quick Thinker, is a sire that Heys is familiar with having worked at Windsor Park Stud when he was foaled.

"In my younger days I worked at Windsor Park Stud when High Chaparral was shuttling there and so I had a bit of experience with him up close and I've always been a huge fan.

"I was there when So You Think was foaled and I distinctly remember him as a yearling. So I've always had somewhat of an attachment to that sireline, they're just hard to buy the nice ones.

"I'm lucky enough that (the owner) backed me into choosing a couple of horses for him, but this sort of horse - So You Think, the horse himself - he's an owner that desires that sort of horse, so all the planets are aligned with him."

Six lots later and Heys found himself parting ways for another seven-figure yearling, this time \$1.4 million for a yearling by I Am Invincible, who's fillies have been sought after at the sales, with this filly one of seven to have sold for over a million dollars at this year's yearling auctions.

"I didn't expect to be able to get her," exclaimed Heys. "I knew she would be very popular and she made significantly more than I expected, but it's a very, very hard family to get into."

The first foal out of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) stakes placegetter Miles

Of Krishan, the filly is from the black-type family of Ball Of Muscle (Dubawi), Super Easy (Darci Brahma) and Terravista (Captain Rio), the horse that won out in the bob of heads against Heys' Spieth in the Lightning Stakes, while this is also the family of Cornflower Blue (Savabeel), a Group 3 winner in New Zealand this season and third placegetter in the NZ 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

"I don't know everyone that was on the horse, but I do suspect that there were obviously some breeding syndicates or studs that were on her just because of how difficult a family it is to get into.

"She will be a strong breeding proposition, we paid so much for her, but she's a very sharp filly and we'll see where we end up with her at the end of the year and what she's shown us."

Heys has a stable of 14 horses at Ellerslie Lodge, training eight winners under his name last season, and they are two statistics the New Zealander acknowledges need to head upwards in the years to come if he is to compete in the highly competitive Sydney metro environment.

"The quality and numbers are increasing. I've had no numbers the last two years really, and that's probably because I'm not the best marketer of myself," he added.

"Everyone always feels that they have a niche, but we are a small stable, and we don't necessarily rush these horses, but I do feel this year if we do get a quality horse, in time we can get something out of them.

"Here in Sydney, the bigger trainers dominate and, as expensive as these horses are, they've got to go on and hopefully be carnival horses.

"But even competing here on a midweek level in Sydney, you've only got to go and get the racebook out and have a look at the breeding of some of those horses, the high majority of them are very well bred and there's no coincidence that they're by the top stallions in Redoute's or I Am Invincible.

"Being realistic about trying to compete, these are the stallions that you've got to have."

Capricornia Yearling Sale returns strong figures

The Capricornia Yearling Sale at Rockhampton was conducted yesterday, with a colt by Raheen Stud's Heroic Valour (Fastnet Rock) collecting \$67,500 in being knocked down to Tony Fenlon, chief executive of the Rockhampton Jockey Club. The sale was held online in 2020 amidst the emergence of the Covid-19 pandemic, but returned strong figures as a live sale this year, with the gross figure of \$1,452,000 up 42 per cent on the 2019 sale, as 72 lots were sold with a clearance rate of 84 per cent, while the average of \$20,167 is up more than 60 per cent on 2019. Raheen Stud were the leading vendors, selling all 14 of their consigned lots at an average of \$24,536.

43 for Blackfriars

Divine Shadow (5 g ex Idyllic Doll by Scenic) comfortably landed the Pinjarra Cup (Listed, 2300m) yesterday to provide the late Blackfriars (Danehill) with his 43rd individual stakes winner. The Brett Pope-trained five-year-old, a three-quarter brother to Darling View Thoroughbreds stallion Playing God (Blackfriars), was winless in eight starts since June last year but returned to the winner's circle with an impressive three-and-three-quarter-length defeat of Media Baron (Written Tycoon). Warm favourite Trap For Fools (Poet's Voice) was another length and a half back in third. The win provided Divine Shadow with his fifth success in 26 starts. Blackfriars, a ten-time champion WA sire, died in 2017 aged 21.

QLD beckons for Nature Strip

Saturday's TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Nature Strip (Nicconi) is set for a trip to Brisbane for the winter carnival. Reflecting on Nature Strip's two-length win yesterday morning, managing owner Rod Lyons suggested Royal Ascot would have to wait until next year. "It was a fantastic performance, it was breathtaking. It sent shivers up my spine. It's wonderful and it endorses what a wonderful sprinter he is," Lyons said on RSN. "I spoke to Chris [Waller, trainer] briefly after the race and he said 'I'll ring you on Monday, let the dust settle'. Before the race yesterday the plan was to go to Queensland for the Doomben 10,000 and then spell him up in Queensland then come back for the spring. Because he's such a gross doer and last year he didn't come back in great form to the spring and Chris attributed all of that to the big-long break he had." On the prospects of Nature Strip heading to Royal Ascot, Lyons added: "If he's in this form next year and Covid is well and truly under control we would definitely be going to Ascot I would say for sure."

Opperman eyes carnival

Fresh from earning his first stakes success aboard Royal Mile (Danerich) in Saturday's Port Adelaide Guineas (Listed, 1800m), Jacob Opperman is hoping the Lee Creek-trained gelding can take him to further success at next month's Adelaide carnival. "I never expected to be winning races like this so soon," Opperman told Racing.com. "This horse has improved so quickly and come up so fast and to get a Listed race in my first 12 months of racing, it's really blown me away. He's an exciting horse for me to ride and probably

one of the best horses I've ridden. He's going to take me a lot of places and hopefully to bigger races – maybe even a Group 1."

Travel less likely for Pike

Willie Pike is hoping to continue his fly-in, fly-out exploits as a jockey in the future, but admits it is a lot to ask for. The Western Australian champion jockey, who will partner Laverrod (Toronado) at Caulfield on Saturday, has enjoyed short stints in Victoria during the spring and autumn carnivals. "I never thought I'd be able to do what I have done so far, so never say never," Pike told Racing.com when asked if he will continue the fly-in, fly-out pattern. "But I'm not entirely sure. It would be nice if I could pick up rides here and there and fly in and out, but I know it's such a competitive market that it might be a bit much to hope for."

Impecunious primed for Oaks test

The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained Impecunious (Sacred Falls) is in good shape ahead of her shot at the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) on Saturday. The three-year-old finished third to Hungry Heart (Frankel) in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on her last start and will likely relish her first attempt at 2400 metres. "She's come through the run really well, she had a nice week, just ticking over," Young told Racing.com. "She won't gallop again until Tuesday. She's a Sacred Falls, so she should get the trip. She's always hit the line well. If we get a bit of rain next week, even better. Hungry Heart is going to be hard to beat but I don't think she likes it wet. If we get a little bit of rain on Saturday, we will be laughing."

Jack's Derby quest not over

Connections of Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) are eying the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) on May 8 and Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on May 29 as potential targets for the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained colt. "He's been in work for a long, long time and he's been everywhere - he's been to Goulburn, he's been to Tassie and now up in Sydney," Eustace told Racing.com. "He's a bit of a sleeper as a horse, he's taken a lot of education and I think he's only just starting to work it out - even the improvement between the Bendigo run and the win yesterday was huge. He's racing very well and there are two more Derbies to go - Adelaide is in a month and Queensland is a month after that. We'll see how he comes through the run, he went to the beach this morning but he's a very sound horse and that's the plan at this stage."

Melbourne and Sydney options for Quickie

Connections of Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) are keeping an eye on the weather as they ponder the multiple Group 1 winner's next start. After winning the Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) on April 3, the Phillip Stokes-trained five-year-old was set to line up in the VOBIS Gold Mile (1600m) at Caulfield on Saturday before freshening up for the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 12. However, the All-Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on April 24 is now also an option, with Mr Quickie suited to a dry track. "He's nominated for the mile race here but the week after we're contemplating the 1400-metre All-Aged up in Sydney," Stokes said. "They are the two options. He's in form so we're thinking about going up there, but it's hard to predict the Sydney weather. He needs a dry track to show his best, so it's a little bit of a juggling act to see what suits best."

Begood Toya Mother retains zest

Daniel Bowman was rapt with the return of Begood Toya Mother (Myboycharlie) at Caulfield on April 3. Begood Toya Mother finished a luckless eighth in the Victoria Handicap and Bowman is targeting the six-year-old at the Anniversary Vase (Listed, 1400m) at

Caulfield on April 24. "Obviously we weren't rapt with the result, but with how he went," Bowman said. "He zigged when he should have zagged and that was probably the difference between him running eighth, like he did, and being in the finish. He ran the fifth quickest last 600 (metres) and that was sitting up for 300 of it. It showed the horse was back trying again and has the zest for racing, and the work we've done and the work Leneva Park has done trying to get him to settle a bit more, it looks like it's done the job. Hopefully we can go on with it a bit more now. We'll head to the Anniversary Vase in a couple of weeks and hopefully get back in the winner's stall."

Quick back-up looms for Kiwi

The Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) campaign of Quick Thinker (So You Think) is back on track after he rebounded to form with a superior staying performance in the Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) at the weekend, with Andrew Forsman confirming the four-year-old will back-up in the Group 1 on Saturday. "Obviously the track was quite testing. They were under the pump a fair way out there and he was still travelling quite well," Forsman, who trains in partnership with Murray Baker said. "Definitely the track conditions have played into his hands."

Cummings considering Oaks test for Duais

Edward Cummings will decide early this week whether Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) winner Duais (Shamus Award) will take her place in the Australian Oaks on Saturday. "We will get through Tuesday morning work and see how she is, but all things going well she'll be here and will run a really nice race," Cummings said.

Costin injured in Gundagai fall

Winona Costin has suffered multiple fractures after being dislodged from her mount prior to the third race at Gundagai yesterday. Costin was taken to Wagga Hospital and remained there overnight. She will be transferred to Sydney today for definitive management. She has fractured some of her facial bones, her nose and maxilla.

NEW ZEALAND

Promising filly opens account at Pukekohe

Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman's patience with three-year-old Francesca (Iffraaj) paid dividends yesterday when the daughter of Haunui shuttler Iffraaj (Zafonic) returned to break her maiden over 1400 metres at Pukekohe. She has not been seen since last August, having ran fourth on debut to subsequent stakes winners Miss Aotearoa (Per Incanto) and Atishu (Savabeel) and finished runner-up to Sheza Jakkal (Jakkalberry), before spelling for time to mature. Ridden by Sam Weatherley, she tracked the pace before making a move at the top of the straight, which was interrupted by Leave It To me (Makfi) ducking sharply, but she continued powerfully to the line to win impressively. "We think she has good ability, but she just needed time to fill out more as she is a very big girl," Baker said. "She was quite weak when she made her debut, so the time off has worked in her favour, although she still has plenty of maturing to do. We think she will definitely get up to a mile and maybe further, but we will just play it by ear in the meantime. We don't have any targets for her and just want to see her come through the race well before we make any more plans."

Siracusa gets second chance at Group 1

Trainers Steven Ramsay and Julia Ritchie are thanking their lucky stars as Siracusa (Sebring) gets a second chance at Group 1 glory following the abandonment and rescheduling of Saturday's Te Rapa meeting to this weekend. The four-year-old was scratched from the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) due to a swollen mouth from a wasp sting, but will now get her chance to contest the feature as the swelling had receded within 24 hours. "I think we found out there is definitely a racing God," Julia Ritchie said. "It was a pretty emotional day up until the abandonment as we were just cursing our luck that such a small thing could take a Group 1 opportunity away like that. We really felt she was a big chance to get a piece of it as she didn't mind the rain and we thought the wide draw would definitely be a help later in the day. At this stage she should be good to take her place in the race this Saturday, which is marvellous news. We know it will be a red-hot field, but we still think she is a good chance in it"

Beauden set for Riccarton feature

Team Rogerson's Awapuni Gold Cup (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Beauden (Bullbars) is set for a trip to Riccarton for the Canterbury Gold Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) in two weeks with co-trainer Graeme Rogerson and owner-breeder Joan Egan feeling the weight-for-age feature is perfect for him. "He's a big horse who carries weight extra well, so the race looks made to measure for him," Rogerson said. "We had a good talk with Joan and she thought that was the best plan for him, so we'll head down there and give the race a shake." Looking ahead at long-term plans, Rogerson is keen to consider the big Cup races for the talented galloper. "I think he's a class stayer and I would love to take him to Melbourne for the spring and have a shot at the big Cup races," he said. "I think he would be well up to them in Melbourne and the travel wouldn't faze him as he is a superb traveler. Those are just my thoughts though and I would have to talk it over with Joan, but I'm hoping she will be keen as well. He really is a lovely horse to train, with such a terrific nature and he is getting better and better as he gets older."

ASIA

Top two-year-old Sodashi returns with Classic glory

The striking pure white filly Sodashi (Kurofune) remained unbeaten and broke the track record in the Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) (Gr 1, 1600m) at Hanshin yesterday for Naosuke Sugai. Ridden by Hayato Yoshida, Sodashi hit the front in the straight and saw off the fast finishing Satono Reinas (Deep Impact) by a neck to claim the first leg of the fillies' triple crown, while there was a further half-length back to Fine Rouge (Kizuna) in third. Sodashi is now a perfect five from five, including two at the top level having signed off last year with victory in the Hanshin Juvenile Fillies (Gr 1, 1600m) and crowned top two-year-old. She is the first white horse in JRA history ever to claim a Classic, while she becomes the first Best Two-Year-Old Filly in eleven years to win the Oka Sho. This was a third Group 1 victory for jockey Yoshida, who was celebrating capturing his first classic title. "It's a great

feeling. There was a lot of pressure with many doubting how strong a white filly could be, so I'm thrilled we were able to prove them wrong. I was a bit worried that the fast track would be a disadvantage, but she responded beautifully and ran well holding off the others closing in on us which I saw and made me drive her to the wire. Her potential is limitless and I look forward to her future starts."

12 for Kizuna

Stellaria (3 f ex Pollenator by Motivator), who was only a two-length sixth in the Daily Hai Queen Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) on her return in February, bounced back to gain black type yesterday for Takashi Saito in the Wasurenagusa Sho (Listed, 2000m) at Hanshin and became the 12th individual stakes winner for her sire Kizuna (Deep Impact). Stellaria, a Shadai homebred, was not out of the first three on four starts last term and broke her maiden at the third attempt before running second in the Begonia Sho (1600m). Ridden by Yuichi Fukunaga, she got the better of A Shin Hiten (A Shin Hikari) by three-quarters of a length, with Big Ribbon (Rulership) a further half-length behind in third. Kizuna, who notched up another stakes winner on Saturday with Group 2 scorer Bathrat Leon, stands at Shadai Stallion Station for a fee of ¥10,000,000 (approx. AU\$119,636).

INTERNATIONAL

15 for Intello

Progressive Freddie Head-trained colt Adhamo (3 c ex Foreign Tune by Invincible Spirit) stepped up to Group company for the first time at Longchamp yesterday and stamped his Classic credentials when taking out the Prix La Force (Gr 3, 1800m). The three-year-old became the 15th individual stakes winner for his sire Intello (Galileo). Ridden by Maxime Guyon, the Wertherimer and Frere homebred put up a powerful performance to beat the Godolphin runner Erasmo (Oasis Dream) by three lengths and the pair were a further two lengths clear of Darkness (Siyouni). Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m) winner Intello started his stud career at Cheveley Park Stud and has switched every

two seasons between there and Haras du Quesnay in France, where his fee for 2021 was €10,000 (approx. AU\$15,614).

62 for Frankel

Three-year-old Rumi (3 f ex Secrete by Cape Cross) was stepped down in trip and up in class after her fourth-place reappearance in the Prix Durban (2100m) last week to land a second career win and first black-type success on her third start in the Prix Vanteaux (Gr 3, 1800) at Longchamp yesterday. The Carlos Laffon-Parias-trained three-year-old led home Petricor (Frankel) by three-quarters of a length for a Frankel (Galileo) one-two while Rumi also became the Juddmonte sire's 62nd individual stakes winner. Frankel stands at Banstead Manor Stud in Newmarket for a fee of £175,000 (approx. AU\$315,320).

44 for Le Havre

Wertherimer and Frere scored a second homebred stakes success on the day with the Andre Fabre-trained Solsticia (4 f Soilea by Galileo), who took out the Prix Zarkava - Fonds Europeen de l'Elevage (Listed, 2100m) at Longchamp and the filly became the 44th individual stakes winner for her sire Le Havre (Noverre). Making her reappearance after showing promise last year, including when third in the Prix Saint Alary (Gr 1, 2000m), Solsticia got the better of Control Tower (Youmzain) by a head and they were a length and a quarter ahead of Noble Music (Sea The Moon) in third. Prix du Jockey Club winner Le Havre stands at Montfort et Preaux and his fee for 2021 is €40,000 (approx. AU\$62,455).

First for Flintshire

Cheshire Academy (3 c ex Danza Cavallo by Sunday Break) stepped up to stakes class for the first time and remained unbeaten on his third start when winning the Prix Noailles (Gr 3, 2100m) at Longchamp yesterday for Jean-Claude Rouget. Although he passed the post a nose second he was awarded the race in the steward's room from Pretty Tiger (Sea The Moon), while Gregolimo (Galiway) was third. Cheshire Academy also became the first individual stakes winner for his sire Flintshire (Dansili), who stands at Hill 'N Dale Farms in Kentucky, where his fee for this year is US\$10,000 (approx. AU\$7,622)

Harcourt success for Skalleti

Multiple Group winner Skalleti (Kendargent) added the Prix d'Harcourt (Gr 2, 2000m) to his CV at Longchamp yesterday. The Jerome Reynier-trained six-year-old is a dual winner of the course and distance Prix Dollar (Gr 2, 2000m) and was last seen taking the Prix Exbury (Gr 3, 2000m) on his reappearance at Saint-Cloud last month. He is now the winner of seven Group races and a Listed contest, while he also ran second in the Qipco Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Ascot last October to Addeybb (Pivotal) prior to his trip to Hong Kong when he was beaten just over four lengths into seventh in the Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m). Sent off as favourite and ridden by Gerald Mosse, Skalleti was held up and came wide to challenge and he picked up well close home to win comfortably by a length from Mare Australis (Australia). Monty (Motivator) was a further length and a half back in third.

Bolger takes Guineas Trial with Poetic Flare

Last year's Killavullen Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) winner Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach) returned to take the 2,000 Guineas Trial Stakes (Listed, 7f) over course and distance yesterday for trainer-breeder Jim Bolger in the colours of his wife Jackie. Ridden by Kevin Manning, the colt raced close up, made his challenge two furlongs from home and kept on well in the final furlong to win by a length and a half from the Jessica Harrington-trained Ace Aussie (Australia). Shadwell runner Monasib (Bobby's Kitten) was a short head further behind in third. The Anglesey Stakes (Gr 3, 6.5f) winner A Case Of You (Hot Streak) failed to fire and returned last of the twelve runners. Unbeaten Champion two-year-old Dawn Approach (New Approach), who was also trained by Bolger, retired to Darley's Kildangan Stud in Ireland where he remained until this season when he relocated to Bolger's Redmondstown Stud in Wexford.

Seven for Mehmas

Keeper Of Time (3 fex Motheeba by Munstanfar) was a surprise 80-1 winner of the feature 1,000 Guineas Trial Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Leopardstown yesterday for John Feane. She got off the mark

last term on her third start in a six-furlong Naas maiden and ran down the field in the Weld Park Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) in September before returning three weeks ago where she was beaten four lengths into fifth in a seven-furlong handicap at the Curragh on soft to heavy ground. Back on a better surface yesterday, she was held up by Ronan Whelan, ridden to challenge a furlong from home and just held on by a head from Mehna (Frankel), while another outsider Sense Of Style (Zoffany) was a further length back in third. The Moyglare Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) winner and favourite Shale (Galileo) could only manage fifth for Donnacha O'Brien and Ryan Moore. Leading first season sire of 2020, Mehmas (Acclamation) stands at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland for a fee of €25,000 (approx. AU\$21,703).

333 for Galileo

Bolshoi Ballet (3 c ex Alta Anna by Anabaa), a brother to Zipping Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Southern France, is working his way to a crack at the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) after an impressive win in yesterday's Ballysax Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) at Leopardstown for Aidan O'Brien. The colt won his maiden on his second start last term before being beaten just over two lengths in the Criterium de Saint-Cloud (Gr 1, 2000m) on his last start. He resumed here, racing prominently and staying on comfortably to win by two and a quarter lengths from Flying Visit (Pride Of Dubai) and Taipan (Frankel), who were split by a nose for second and third. Bolshoi Ballet became the 333rd individual stakes winner for Champion Sire Galileo (Sadler's Wells), who stands at Coolmore Ireland for a private fee.

48 for Areion

Placed twice at Group 3 level last year, Zavaro (4 c ex Zavaala by Rock Of Gibraltar) finally got his day when landing the Fruhjahrs-Meile (Gr 3, 1600m) at Dusseldorf yesterday for Henke Grewe. The four-year-old took his tally to three wins from eleven starts and also became the 48th individual stakes winner for his sire Areion (Big Shuffle). Tracking the pace, he was asked for an effort in the straight and picked up well to win by a length and three-quarters from previous stakes winners Schwesterherz

(Areion) and Padron (Gris De Gris) who were split by a head. Areion stands at Gestut Etzean where his fee for 2021 is €12,500 (approx. AU\$19,517).

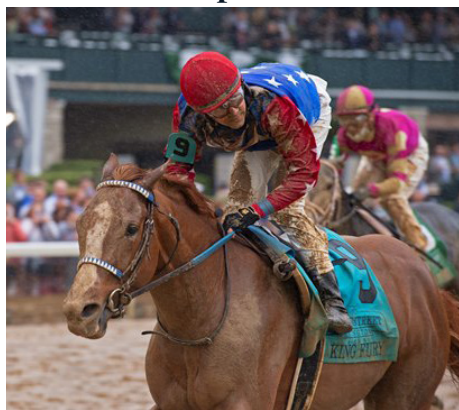
183 for Exceed And Excel

Attimo Fuggente (4 c ex Vague Nouvelle by Mastercraftsman) broke through at stakes level at the third attempt when winning the Premio Signorino (Listed, 1800m) at Rome yesterday, becoming the 183rd individual stakes winner for his sire Exceed And Excel (Daneshill). Unraced at two, he won on his second start last year before running fourth in the Premio Mauro Sbarigia (Listed, 1600m) last October. Winning on his return in March this year, he was last seen running third in the Premio Natale di Roma (Listed, 1600m) three weeks ago. Trained by Alduino Botti and ridden by Fabio Branca, Attimo Fuggente beat Axcelerator (Excelebration) and previous Listed winner and stablemate Baptism (Sea The Stars) was third. Exceed And Excel, who reverse shuttled to Europe for the last time in 2020, stands at Darley's Kelvinside Stud.

Two for Dialed In

Super Stock (3 c ex Super Girlie by Closing Argument) sprung a surprise in the Arkansas Derby (Gr 1, 9f) for Steve Asmussen at Oaklawn Park and became the second individual Group 1 winner for his sire Dialed In (Mineshaft). Having broke his maiden on his third start in the Texas Thoroughbred Futurity (Listed, 5.5f), he placed in the Iroquois Stakes (Gr 3, 8f) and Breeders' Futurity (Gr 1, 8.5f) but this is his first time back in the winner's circle since. Favourite Concert Tour (Street Sense) and Caddo River (Hard Spun) took each other on up front and Super Stock came to steal the show with a two and a half-length victory, while Caddo River got the better of Concert Tour by a head for the placings. Super Stock's victory was special for the trainer as he is owned by Erv Woolsey and Keith Asmussen, the father of the winning Hall of Fame trainer, while he was ridden to his maiden victory last year by his son Keith. Florida Derby (Gr 1, 9f) winner Dialed In stands at Darby Dan Farm in Kentucky where his fee for 2021 is US\$15,000 (approx. AUD\$11,434).

King Fury shaping into Preakness hopeful

King Fury (3 c Curlin - Taxis by Flatter) also caused an upset when taking out the Stonestreet Lexington Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at 18-1. The Ken McPeck-trained three-year-old, who beat Super Stock in the Overnight Stakes (Listed, 8.5f) last year, was making his first outing since last November and he scooted to a two and three-quarter-length victory over Unbridled Honor

(Honor Code) and Starrinmydreams (Super Saver). He is 28th on the list so is unlikely to get a start in the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f), however could be aimed for the Preakness Stakes (Gr 1, 9.5f).

22 for Dansili

Juddmonte homebred Juliet Fox Trot (6 m ex Kilo Alpha by King's Best) broke through at the highest level in the Coolmore Jenny Wiley Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at Keeneland to become the 22nd Group 1 winner for Dansili (Danehill). Making all under Tyler Gaffalione, the Brad Cox-trained six-year-old was an easy two-length winner over Tamahere (Wootton Bassett) and La Signare (Siyouni), who were split by a neck for second and third respectively. Juliet Fox Trot has now won six of her 20 races, including two other Graded wins in the 2019 Modesty Handicap (Gr 3, 9.5f) and 2020 Gallorette Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f), as well as four Group 1 placings. Bred in the UK, she is out of the stakes winner Kilo Alpha (King's Best), who has also produced stakes-placed Alpha

Bravo (Oasis Dream) and Bravo Sierra (Siyouni), while the second dam Anasazi (Sadler's Wells) is a half-sister to Dancing Brave (Lyphard) and Jolypha (Lyphard). Dansili, a son of the great Hasili (Kahyasi), was retired in 2018, however his son Bated Breath stands at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud at a fee of £12,500 (approx. AU\$22,523).

UK: Newbury spring trials fixture moved

The British Horseracing Authority has announced it will move fixtures as a mark of respect to the funeral of Prince Phillip, the Duke of Edinburgh, who died on Friday aged 99. There will be no racing between 2:45 and 4:15pm next Saturday, April 17 and the spring trials fixture at Newbury and the Scottish Grand National fixture at Ayr will instead be run on Sunday, April 18. A service for Prince Philip is scheduled for 3pm at Windsor Castle with a minute's silence observed across the United Kingdom as a mark of respect.

Analysis: The record outlay at Australia's yearling sales

This year has been celebrated among the industry as a hugely successful yearling sales season. From the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in January, where the first records of 2021 tumbled, the domino effect continued through to last week's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale that recorded the highest level of turnover on a single day in history at a southern hemisphere auction.

In ANZ Bloodstock News this week we will be offering the key statistics, in addition to the verdict from the industry's leading players on the strength of the Australasian bloodstock markets after the major yearling sales came to a conclusion with Inglis Easter in April.

Turnover across these sales this year totalled \$523,756,500, a figure that eclipses last year's covid-affected aggregate sales of \$409,889,898, while also dwarfing the 2019 figure of \$439,334,510, one which presents a more accurate comparison given the disruption of 2020.

Tellingly, in the ten-year comparison back to 2011, this year's figure compares to the \$213,915,700 spent on horseflesh at these major sales in that year, representing a 145 per cent increase in outlay on bloodstock.

These figures come with the added factor that many internationals and even interstate buyers have been absent from sales rings this

year, as restrictions on movement have dictated the buying bench.

The average spend at sales has witnessed increases across the board and, in comparison to 2011, this metric has more than doubled in three sales this year (MM Adelaide, MM Tasmania and Inglis Classic).

This insatiable demand for bloodstock saw new ceilings set for top lots at sales, notably in regional sales such as Adelaide and Tasmania, where in the former, a Fastnet Rock (Danahill) colt saw a yearling break

the \$500,000 mark for the first time, while in Melbourne the second ever million-dollar yearling was sold at the Inglis Premier as James Harron took home a Written Tycoon (Iglesia) colt for \$1.1 million.

ANZ Bloodstock News will be exploring these extraordinary figures throughout the week, offering a comprehensive overview of where spending in the yearling markets has come from, and where it's gone to and the reasons behind these record-breaking numbers.

THE VERDICT

AUSTRALASIA'S INDUSTRY PLAYERS
EVALUATE ITS VIBRANT MARKETS

TERRY HENDERSON

In a five-part series ANZ Bloodstock News speaks to some of the industry's key players for their perspective on the incredible performance of the 2021 major yearling sales season.

We asked them for their take on what's behind all the money that's been flying around sales rings since January and also for their thoughts on the current general state of the Australian racing and breeding industry.

In today's edition, Jo McKinnon talks to OTI Management CEO Terry Henderson. Terry holds a Bachelor of Business and Transport Economics. He has held numerous positions on boards and has been chairman of a number of private companies.

Terry, it's incredible how the Australian yearling sales market has performed this year. Lots of people have their own reasons and analysis as to why, what's your opinion?

It has been amazing. Internationally we are privileged to have the type of environment we have in Australia. In a macro economic sense, Australians spend about \$65 billion dollars a year going overseas and travelling each year which is a remarkable figure and that money is staying in Australia and I think our industry has been the benefit of it as have a lot of other luxury type items.

Unlike other jurisdictions we have the benefit of a good business model in racing generally and particularly in NSW and Victoria but also Queensland and West Australian stake money is good. We do have a good business space in our industry which encourages people to think they can come into the industry and buy young colts and hopefully breed a stallion and more so buy well bred fillies and see they can get a return down the track if they don't make racehorses.

I also think, although some of our racing authorities may not agree, that competition being developed between states may not be good for pattern racing but it's very good for business and it stimulates stake money and in many cases efficiencies and I think that is adding to the economic base of our game.

The fact that racing has continued in Australia during the Covid-19 pandemic without interruption, unlike some other jurisdictions, has been a blessing for the industry, would you agree?

We have been very lucky. Most have only had a hiccup. Ireland and France have virtually run straight through. Ireland had a few weeks and New Zealand stopped completely and England has been a little on and off a few times.

I think we have been very fortunate and I think great credit must go to leaders and government officials who have recognised the importance of horse racing as part of Australian business. In terms of competition on that score we are not much different to the

other jurisdictions, I just think that, basically, we are in a much better position than them generally.

Is it a false economy at the moment?

If it's underpinned by a good business base, and I think it is in Australia, I don't think it is a false economy.

I think false economies come when you get runs on the market like we did in the late 80s and saw broodmare prices plummet down to ten-15 per cent of their previous values.

Since the turn of the century we have got through a global economic crisis and we got through it very well. Globally, and in Australia, we have seemed to continue to prosper and the industry has become more economic for those participating that want to get in, like us, at the breeding level.

The other big distinction is syndication. There are not many countries in the world that have the broad ownership groups that we have. So, we have those sorts of actions underpinning our industry which makes it a real economy not a false one.

How has OTI performed through the Covid-19 pandemic?

We are different from general syndicators and more like a merchant banker. Most of our horses come from overseas and we are not actively involved in the yearling market, but the market is there and people who are involved in horses we buy are still keen to continue to do so.

We have broadened our base to cater for the middle distance market and the mares market.

We have quality mares racing for us that we didn't have five or six years ago. That's a function of the size as well as the sort of business that we run.

The biggest change for us is the ownership group. We now have 30 international owners racing with us, some French, English and Irish, who have been in horses we have purchased and decided to stay with us and come across to Australia.

I think the whole communications aspect of the way the industry communicates between trainers, owners and breeders is certainly superior to other jurisdictions and that's

helping to keep international owners involved.

Covid has, in some instances, been good for businesses and especially racing which, prior to the pandemic, had started to struggle with poor public perception due to various issues including welfare concerns. What are your thoughts on those issues, which will always remain?

I think we always have to be very conscious of social trends. We should not be beholden but aware that we have to move with the times on issues like welfare and gambling.

You see what's happening in England with gambling restrictions looking like being placed there. God forbid that doesn't happen in Australia. It's up to the authorities to be cognisant of trends that may come into the

industry that the public may not approve of and be aware of them and address them up front without kowtowing to people that don't want racing to exist at all.

We have been very responsive to welfare issues and horse welfare generally. Once they have a proper tracking and whole of life system in place, not many people are going to be able to complain about that.

Courier Wonder and Fantastic Treasure remain unbeaten at Sha Tin

Joao Moreira declared Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls) the most talented young horse he has ridden in Hong Kong this season, while David Hayes was similarly effusive about Fantastic Treasure (Written Tycoon) after the exciting duo maintained unbeaten records at Sha Tin yesterday.

Asked if Courier Wonder, a brother to Saturday's Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up Icebath, was the best youngster he had partnered this season, Moreira was unambiguous.

"For sure, this season, yes. It's been a while since I've been on top of a nice horse like him. If he keeps on tracking and keeps on learning as he should, he's going to go far – I can tell you that," the Brazilian said after winning the Class 3 D'Aguilar Peak Handicap (1200m) on the PPG (Privately Purchased Griffin).

"It was a bit more difficult because of the weight (133lbs) on his back and he had the wide gate (eight), so he had to use himself to come across and he did win with something left in hand.

"I did not use the whip on him. I showed him the whip and they were closing up but I think that's because of the weight.

"He's a young horse, only a three-year-old. He's got plenty to learn and I think there's plenty more to come from him.

"This time he won by a shorter margin and that was just because of the weight. It was still quite convincing to me and I still have a lot of faith in him that he's going to go very high."

Twice handed 14-point rating rises after his first two wins, Courier Wonder – who was prepared for a Cranbourne trial win in Australia by Robert Hickmott in March 2020 – will now rise to Class 2 company for John Size.

Size also unveiled another talent in Dragon Baby (Sizzling), who won on debut in the Class 4 Pottinger Peak Handicap (1000m) to lead the trainers' championship – 56-54 – over Caspar Fownes.

Handled patiently by Chad Schofield, the three-year-old sat back in the field before charging late to justify substantial market support.

"He was impressive, I had never sat on the horse before but I got a bit of confidence from Mr Size before the race," Schofield said.

"He didn't muster a great deal of early speed but we were able to recover and as the race went on, the more comfortable he got and he was very strong late."

Schofield, celebrating an excellent afternoon, notched a double aboard the David Hayes-trained Fantastic Treasure and was equally taken with the import after victory in the Class 3 Ma Kong Shan Handicap (1400m).

"He's still learning but he was very impressive," Schofield said.

"The horse just went to sleep on the rails, like good horses do. I felt like I was always going to win but I had to do a bit of maneuvering, when I got him into the clear and pressed the button that acceleration was there.

"He's very exciting. It's always nice getting on these nice young horses and grateful to ride them."

Hayes praised Schofield's behind-the-scenes work with Fantastic Treasure, another PPG and a son of Written Tycoon (Iglesia).

"I think Chad did a very good job, he was patient and he was educating the horse going through," Hayes said.

"If I was training that horse in Australia and he had three wins like that in a row, I'd be setting him for the (Australian) Guineas. It was the run of a good young three-year-old that you'd head to the Guineas and certainly the lead-up races with. He's a wonderful horse going forward.

"He's good in a field, he's brave and he's strong at the finish. The best work is always his last 200 metres. He's got lots of tricks and more improvement to come.

"He probably won't have much more racing this season, maybe one or two more races at the most and then we'll put him away, because he's only a three-year-old.

"This season is about getting him ready for next season. We'll train him for the Four-Year-Old Classic Series, they are the logical races. But you know that you've got to have a rating of about 85-90 to get in them and he'll be getting pretty close if he can win again."

Kentucky-bred Turbo Power (Mizzen Mast) claimed the Windy Gap Plate (1000m) – the first of the season's Griffins' contests – for Francis Lui and Vincent Ho.

Bought for US\$105,000, Turbo Power follows in the footsteps of fellow American-bred Griffin winner Chancheng Prince (Carpe Diem).

"It's the same as Chancheng Prince, same sale, American breeze-up sale," Lui said, referencing the Ocala Breeders' Sales in Florida. "We thought he could perform and we're hoping he can improve a little bit more."

Benno Yung's Hinchinlove (Hinchinbrook) claimed the day's feature – the Class 2 Cheung Lin Shan Handicap (1400m) – under Matthew Chadwick, downing Roman Turbo (Holy Roman Emperor) and favourite Silver Express (Canford Cliffs), who gave Moreira an erratic ride late in the straight.

Joao Moreira, Zac Purton, Chad Schofield and Alexis Badel posted doubles, while Frankie Lor took training honours with a treble.

Zac Purton figured on Carry The Diamond (Moshe) in the Class 5 Tai Tam Gap Handicap (1000m) for Richard Gibson before scoring atop My Ecstatic (All Too Hard) in the first section of

the Class 4 Stanley Gap Handicap (1400m) for Lor.

Alexis Badel and Manfred Man combined with Gluck Racer (Super One) to land the Class 4 Siu Ma Shan Handicap (1200m) before the Frenchman struck again – and also ensured a brace for Lor – with Everyone's Delight

(El Roca) in the second section of the Class 4 Stanley Gap Handicap (1400m).

Jerry Chau continued his strong season, notching his 34th winner for the term when Tony Cruz-trained Galaxy Emperor (Verrazano) rallied under pressure to snare the Class 5 Violet Hill Handicap (1400m).

Lor registered his treble, taking his seasonal tally to 49 to remain within touching distance of Size (56) and Fownes (54), when Moreira piloted Looking Great (Holy Roman Emperor) to victory in the Class 3 Mount Butler Handicap (1800m).

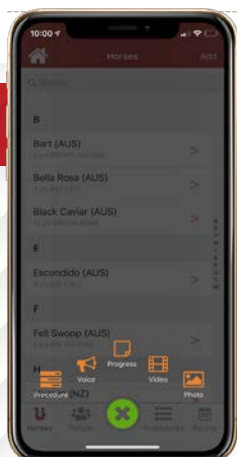

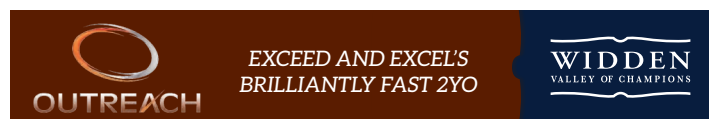
