## Classic format set to stay after resurgent Inglis opener

*Smaller catalogue achieves balance as Deep Field continues momentum at Riverside*

The format of this year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, a condensed three-day auction consisting of 613 Book 1 horses, is set to be replicated in 2021 after the company's season opener was deemed a success by the management.

The sale's "consolidation" this year, which resulted in an average increase of nearly 15 per cent compared to the expanded 2019 auction, came despite the coronavirus outbreak in China impacting a number of international buyers as well as heavy rain making it difficult for domestic owners to travel to Inglis' Riverside Stables this week. *Continued on page 2 >>*

#### Waller thrilled with Nature Strip

Nature Strip (Nicconi) is TAB's red-hot \$1.55 favourite to land the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m), which would enhance his record up the Flemington straight to five wins from five starts, and Chris Waller was delighted with the gelding yesterday morning, who completed his weekend preparations with a track gallop under James McDonald. "To my eye, it looked pretty good," Waller told Racing.com. "I haven't spoken to James yet, but it took a while to pull him up and he was nice and relaxed when he did pull up and walked back without a care in the world, so he's a pretty happy horse. He's in a good space and his confidence is at an all-time high and obviously, up the straight, his record is impeccable." *Morning Briefing page 7 >>*

There were four yearlings who made \$200,000 or more on the final day of the Classic sale, taking the total number to reach that mark to 33, helping the Book 1 aggregate hit \$41,690,500 with a median of \$75,000. The clearance rate had climbed to 84 per cent last night.

Inglis' managing director Mark Webster is confident the company has got the balance right between buyer demand and vendors' need for opportunities to sell stock at the Classic sale.

"Last year we had 2600 entries and we had 800 the year before, so it was difficult (not to increase the size of the 2019 catalogue)," Webster said.

"We put 200 more in last year than what we would have liked to have done to try and help clear their stock, but it didn't quite work.

"I think this year's results feel better and I think it is more workable for the buyers to get it done in three days, rather than five, which is what we did last year."

Star Thoroughbreds and Randwick Bloodstock Agency were the leading buyers by aggregate and average (three or more lots), with a spend of \$1,320,000 on six yearlings, while Darby Racing and Will Johnson Bloodstock combined for seven Book 1 yearlings.

Ciaron Maher Racing was active, buying 15 lots with various partners.

"There's a good spread of buyers and I think that is healthy for the industry," Webster said.

"The other big story is that, aside from the local trainers, there are a lot of people here from Hong Kong. Upper Bloodstock, Ricky Yiu and the Hong Kong Jockey Club were able to get on the sheet and they weren't here last year, while George Moore was here buying, and they are the ones who are targeting

the better types.

"If you go back five years you wouldn't find anyone from Hong Kong at a Classic sale, so it has evolved."

Hong Kong buyers or agents acting for clients from the region secured 39 yearlings, including the top-priced \$380,000 Deep Field (Northern Meteor) colt and three others inside the top ten lots.

Webster said the presence of

Godolphin continued its "measured" approach to the yearling sale market with the addition of a Written Tycoon (Iglesia) filly, who is out of a half-sister to Group 1-winning mare Single Gaze (Not A Single Doubt), who recently had a colt by star Japanese stallion Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha). "We have made no secret that our primary objective is to source fillies from big families that can not only do it on the racecourse but ultimately will join our broodmare band and can contribute over a long period of time," Godolphin bloodstock manager Jason Walsh said. Godolphin also bought a Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock) filly on day one for \$140,000 and a Teofilo (Galileo) colt for \$105,000 yesterday. "We are measured in what we are doing and assigning values and participating in the market, but not in any way underpinning it," he said. "It is all about sourcing quality for our broodmare band and if we find colts we like, particularly by our stallions, we are very interested as well, and it's great to be back participating in the market."

Asian buyers could have been even higher had the coronavirus emergency not occurred in recent weeks.

"Could the sale results have been better than they are? Yes, they could, there is no doubt that we were missing a bunch of buyers," he said.

"I am estimating around 15 or so that we know of that didn't come from either Singapore, Hong Kong or China and even some from New Zealand because they didn't want to travel during the outbreak of this virus.

"Then, from a weather sense, there would be others, but I can't quantify it at this point in time. There are people who normally drive in from the south coast (of NSW), the north coast and people who come in from over the mountains to buy one or two, and there is no doubt that some of those people didn't come and that it has affected us.

“The results, particularly noting that, are very good and the format and everything else for next year is unlikely to change because under better circumstances it will be even better.”

## Session-topping Deep Field colt set to return to sales ring

Meanwhile, the highest-priced yearling sold on day three was a son of Newgate Farm's Deep Field after a consortium of buyers joined forces to secure the colt with the intention of trading him on as a two-year-old.

New Zealand's Regal Farm Partnership, the Hong Kong-based Upper Bloodstock, Tang Long and McKeever Bloodstock all signed for the Canning Downs Stud-offered colt, who commanded a price tag of \$230,000.

Shane Crawford of Regal Farm revealed the partnership of mates came together during the week as the desire to land a Deep Field colt grew.

“Deep Field is definitely a sire on the move, I've looked at a few and I am happy to finally get one. It hasn't been easy,” Crawford said.

Arrowfield's Paul Messara said yesterday's \$210,000 colt, who will be trained by Kim Waugh at Wyong, continues buyers' strong endorsement of Maurice (Screen Hero) at the first three Australasian yearling sales of 2020. “They have sold really well and good judges have been all over them. I guess the great thing going forward is that the buying bench, the true professionals in our industry, have such a high opinion of his progeny,” Messara said. “They have been all going to top-end stables and that helps.” The colt himself also provided a strong tick to the Japanese miler. “To be honest, he is an image of his father. I don't think we've had a horse on the farm that is closer to their sire than he is,” Messara added. “He is an absolute spitting image and a fantastic example of what the stallion can produce. He's out of a Not A Single Doubt mare and we know that works here.”

“He has a good scope, clean x-rays, so he ticked all those boxes. He looks like a real runner as he is a really nice mover.

“We weren't confident of being able to get him, but we were hopeful, and we went quite hard on the horse. We went a little bit over budget.”

Crawford added: “He will go back to us (at Cambridge) and we will break him in, get him going and he could possibly come back here for the Ready 2 Race Sale.

“Karaka is also a possibility, but I think it is more likely that he will come back here.”

Catalogued as **Lot 563**, the colt is the second living foal out of the twice-winning sprinting mare Wind Shout (Exceed And Excel), who is from the Godolphin family that has produced this season's MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Flit (Medaglia d'Oro).

Deep Field was the leading sire by aggregate, with 20 yearlings selling for a combined \$2,832,000 at an average of \$141,600.

## Snowdens in no doubt about colt's credentials

The recent announcement that Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) has covered his last mare and is living out his days in luxury at Arrowfield Stud was not lost on buyers at this week's Classic sale, with the consistent Group 1-producing stallion's stock highly sought after.

That trend continued yesterday, with leading trainers Peter and Paul Snowden securing a colt by the sire of 69 individual stakes winners for \$200,000.

The Snowdens' racing manager Colum McCullagh signed for the colt on behalf of the Stambe family, who also race seven-time winner Signore Fox (Exceed And Excel) with the stable.

“He is very typical of Not A Single Doubt who looks like he could go early and we loved him from when he first saw him,” McCullagh said.

“I think he is well bought at \$200,000 and we were just reaching our limit and hopefully he will be up and running early this time next year.

“The sire can do no wrong and as we know he is finished up covering now, so hopefully this guy can continue his legacy.

“He's a great mover, has a great body, great length and he handled everything really well throughout the inspections.”

<< *Continued from page 4* Emirates Park as **Lot 551**, the colt is the third foal out of the twice-winning sprinting mare Vivid (Eavesdropper).

The Snowdens have trained 15 individual winners by Not A Single Doubt, including high-class, Group 1-winning mare Miracles Of Life for the latter part of her career.

Given that, McCullagh was excited to be able to buy the colt for the price he did.

"It has been a fantastic sale and, as I said in the past, we have always had good luck at this sale," he said.

"It is starting to increase in quality and it is getting better and better every year. If you are looking for an up-and-running type at a lower price, it's definitely the sale to go to."

Not A Single Doubt was the leading sire by average, with four yearlings selling for \$206,250 apiece.

Meanwhile, the Highway Session, which was held two days after Book 1 finished last year, followed on yesterday, with the 195-lot catalogue averaging \$38,178, significantly more than the corresponding sale in 2019.

The highest-priced yearling of the session was a Scissor Kick (Redoute's Choice) colt, who made \$160,000 to the bid of John Foote.

He was sold by Arrowfield Stud and is the fourth foal out of the Hussonet (Mr Prospector) mare Phaedra, whose two winners produced so far include successful Hong Kong gelding Invincible Missile (Smart Missile). He was catalogued as **Lot 727**.

### Gaby pleases Williams

Craig Williams is looking forward to being reunited with Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) at Flemington on Saturday as the star three-year-old prepares for a rematch with Nature Strip (Nicconi) in the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m). Trained by Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, Loving Gaby was beaten three and a quarter lengths by Chris Waller's crack speedster in the VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) last November, but Williams said: "She looks like she's trained on really well and I know the stable is very happy with her." On the rematch with Nature Strip, he added: "He is a serious, specialist sprinter and is undefeated at the track, so it's a track that suits him to do his best on. But I'm looking forward to my girl stepping up and I'm expecting her to run a race, but he's the deserved horse we all have to beat on his form."

### Libertini to Light Fingers

The Anthony Cummings-trained Libertini (I Am Invincible), who holds nominations in both the Lightning Stakes and the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on the

same afternoon, will contest the latter option. Cummings said owner Gerry Harvey preferred the Light Fingers for his returning three-year-old, who is the TAB's \$2.50 favourite to beat her own sex having ended her last campaign with a two-length third to Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m). "She's going to stay in Sydney," Cummings said. "I discussed it with Gerry. We spoke about the weather and the tracks and he said he'd rather take the odds to it and stay here and take what comes."

### Futurity next for Kolding

Inaugural The Golden Eagle (1500m) winner Kolding (Ocean Park), a stable companion of Nature Strip who ran fourth in the Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on February 1, is being set for the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on February 22. "Kolding's come through his first-up run in Sydney well and it was good to get a run into him," Waller also told Racing.com. "He'll run at Caulfield next in the Futurity, which is three weeks before the All-Star Mile, providing he gains a start there. The last six months have been very impressive. His win in The Golden Eagle was something special."

### Bart Victoria-bound

In other Futurity news, Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) was yesterday one of three horses to leave Lindsey Smith's Western Australia yard bound for his Warrnambool satellite stable. A six-time Group 1 winner, Black Heart Bart trialed impressively at Lark Hill on Monday morning ahead of his All-Star Mile (1600m) campaign, and he made the journey east alongside stable companions Achernar Star (Gingerbread Man) and Too Close The Sun

(Carlton House). "He dropped the bit, rolled to the front - which surprised me - and ran through the line strongly," Smith told @theracesWA on Monday. "He'll now go first-up into the Futurity Stakes at his favourite track, Caulfield."

### Maloney sends Alligator warning

Regular rider Ryan Maloney cut a delighted figure after he galloped Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) at Flemington yesterday ahead of his tilt at Saturday's CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m). "He is really starting to mature and come around and know what it's all about," Maloney told Racing.com. "The penny is really starting to drop with him. He's a real competitor. His work this morning indicates how well he is considering he's had a tolling sort of prep. He certainly doesn't show any signs of stopping. He's in really good form and I couldn't be happier going into Saturday."

### Dreamforce back for Apollo

John Thompson is hoping the forecast rain for Sydney does not materialise as he prepares to take the wraps off Dreamforce (Fastnet Rock) in the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday. The seven-year-old enjoyed a fruitful spring campaign, beating subsequent Group 1 winner Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) in the Tramway Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) before running second to Avilius (Pivotal) at weight-for-age in the George Main Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). Runner-up in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) last autumn, Dreamforce has won both of his recent trials at Randwick. "He is the stable stalwart - he is a beautiful animal," Thompson said. "Hopefully the weather stays fine. He's won both his trials, but he doesn't want it too wet."

## Verry Elleegant to relish wet

Meanwhile, testing conditions will aid the cause of the Chris Waller-trained Verry Elleegant (Zed), with last season's Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine set to resume in the Apollo. "She has had two quiet trials and is a noted wet-tracker," former trainer Nick Bishara, who retains a share in the four-year-old, said. "It is shaping as a good field, but I think she will appreciate the wet track, especially over a shorter distance like the 1400 metres of the Apollo." Looking ahead, Bishara added: "She will run in the Apollo, we will clash with Te Akau Shark in the Chipping Norton, then go to the Ranvet and then to the Queen Elizabeth. That will be her prep this time unless things change, which they often do with horses, and Chris will make those calls. She is nominated for the Australian Cup and for the All-Star Mile, but they seem unlikely to be honest. I think she would prefer to stay in Sydney, especially with a bit of aqua around."

## Railway winner bound for Melbourne

Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Regal Power (Pierro) is set to arrive in Melbourne next week ahead of his interstate autumn campaign. The four-year-old, who is a six-time winner from just 17 starts, will be stabled with Brent Stanley in Sutton Grange, although he will remain under the care of Grant and Alana Williams. "He'll go to the Peter Young Stakes at Caulfield on February 22, with William Pike to remain in the saddle," owner Bob Peters told Racing.com. "All going well, we'll then go to the Australia Cup at Flemington and then the All-Star Mile if he gets in." Regal Power sits inside the top 20 for the All-Star Mile with voting closing later this week.

## All-Star still on the cards for Puissance

The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune) will not be ready to contest the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on February 29, but the Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) third could return in the All-Star Mile two weeks later if plans run smoothly between now and then. Having watched Heart Of Puissance complete an easy jump-out under Mark Zahra at Caulfield yesterday morning, Eustace told Racing.com: "The All-Star Mile is still a possibility, but everything would have to go A1 to get there. He's a horse with a big future and we don't want to force him into something he's not ready for. If he shows any signs of not getting there and if the time is a bit close, we won't force him."

## Derby target for Vegas

Colin Little is looking to target an autumn Derby with his Bill Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) runner-up Vegas Knight (Declaration Of War), with the three-year-old set to resume over a trip short of his optimum on Saturday. Vegas Knight holds nominations in a 1200-metre handicap and the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington, while he impressed in an 800-metre jump-out at Caulfield yesterday. "I am just a little apprehensive running him off one trial further than 1200 metres first-up," Little told Racing.com. "He is a stayer and a lot of stayers do run 1400 metres first-up, but I just feel more comfortable running him in the 1200 metres on Saturday. But Craig (Williams) and I were quite impressed with his trial this morning. He's a very tough horse. He doesn't look it as he's a lean individual."

## Rich Charm nearing return

Udyta Clarke's Group 2-winning sprinter Rich Charm (Danerich) is nearing a return to the races after completing a soft jump-out at Cranbourne on Monday. The seven-year-old has been sidelined since he finished down the field in the Kevin Heffernan Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) in November 2018. "He's been back in work for almost four months now, we've been taking it nice and slow with him," Clarke said. "He wasn't out

there to do much in the trial, it was his first one back, so I told Daniel (Stackhouse) not to move on him. I was happy with it, he pulled-up bright and well, but he'll need another two or three before we even think about going back to the races. I'll only race him again if he looks like he's going as good as he was, if he's not then I'll retire him."

## Black Caviar to make Flemington appearance

Undefeated champion Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) is to return to Flemington on the raceday named in her honour. The mare will be paraded in the Flemington mounting yard before the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) on Saturday. "Black Caviar transcended racing. She is a national treasure, a sporting hero who brought Australians together," Victoria Racing Club chairman Amanda Elliott said. "I give huge thanks to her ownership group for recognising the importance of these champions to everyone and allowing racegoers at Flemington to see her again. Black Caviar, The Great Horse Race Day, is named in honour of this wonderful mare and celebrates all great horses past and present."

## Tough going for VIC racing participants

Racing industry participants in Victoria are calling for an earlier finish to night meetings with jockeys citing fatigue from too much racing. The racing calendar has expanded in the state in recent years to include twilight meetings during summer along with two night meetings a week. Jockeys say they are finding it hard, while trainers and their staff are also working longer hours. Caulfield trainer John Moloney says he almost needs two sets of staff in his stable. "If I give them a night meeting, they're tired the next day and almost need the day off," Moloney said. "My foreman can back up, I can back up, but my staff do not back up when they are out doing this type of work. You nearly need two sets of staff, one that's doing the race meeting and one that's doing your work at the stable, because you need to give them time off to get over their night at the races."



## Vale Pam Cornish

Respected NSW racehorse owner and breeder Pam Cornish has died after a long illness. She and her husband John, the inaugural chairman of the Australian Turf Club, ran Torryburn Stud in the Hunter Valley and their horses race in distinctive white colours with a red heart. "Pam was a wonderful woman who battled illness for many years later in her life but continued that brave fight right to the end," ATC chairman Matt McGrath said. "Even two Saturdays ago she was at Royal Randwick in searing heat to cheer on another of the Torryburn team, continuing a life so well lived with her dear and beloved family. The Cornish family is not only part of the Australian Turf Club family, but also a highly-respected and popular part of the entire Australian racing industry. We send our deepest condolences to John and the family, and especially thank Pam for the great passion and contribution she has given to our club and racing."

## Doubt over Warwick Farm

"With further rainfall predicted for later today and tomorrow, Racing NSW Stewards and ATC Officials will conduct a track inspection commencing at 5:30am tomorrow morning to ascertain if the track conditions are suitable to race," Racing NSW chief steward Marc Van Gestel said yesterday.

## Meghan emerges as Oaks contender

After landing her second win in a row on the weekend, Lance Noble's Meghan (So You Think) will now aim towards some black-type in the the Sunline Vase (Gr 3, 2100m) at Ellerslie on February 29. She will then press on to the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Trentham on March 14 and the trainer doesn't think she will be out of place. "I think she is a genuine stayer," Noble said. "She ran through the line on Saturday really well and took an age to pull-up. I don't think 2400 metres will worry her and the way the fillies are, there are a few heading in the Derby direction and there are a few who look like they might not stay. As long as she runs creditably in the Sunline Vase, we will be heading towards the Oaks."

## Werther retired

Former Hong Kong Horse of the Year Werther (Tavistock) has been retired after a failed attempt to bring him back from a suspensory injury. The eight-year-old's career began in New Zealand before being transferred to Hong Kong where he won the Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and was runner-up in the Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2400m). After sustaining an injury, he returned to the care of his original trainer Andrew Campbell to get him back to the races but has ultimately been retired. "He has been a fantastic horse," Campbell said. "Even

when we sold him we got a great thrill watching him race in Hong Kong. It has been a hell of a ride. He will get the best treatment and we will get him the nicest home. We will do the right thing by him for sure."

## Lui pleased with Classic pair

Francis Lui's Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) winner Golden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) is in doubt for the Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) after an elevated temperature setback his campaign. However, his stablemate and Classic Mile runner-up More Than This (Dutch Art) is on track for the race. "He's still a chance," Lui said of Golden Sixty. "His temperature is back to normal but we still have to monitor him for these few days. If he's okay we will work him next week. We'll see how he is and check his blood and if everything is normal we might carry on. Everything depends on how he works in his track work - he looks okay because he trotted in the trotting ring and he was fresh, but we'll see."

## Victory In Hand aims for hat-trick

Lui has more immediate business at Happy Valley tonight when Victory In Hand (O'Rielly) will be one of three horses seeking a hat-trick in the Class 3 Fo Tan Handicap (1200m), a race which also features the impressive first-up winner Californiadeepshot (Deep Field). Karis Teetan partnered Victory In Hand to his two previous wins in Class 4 company, but has jumped ship, leaving the way open for Alexis Badel to take the ride. "Karis is riding Tony Cruz's horse, Californiadeepshot," Lui said. "He thinks that's a better horse but I'd planned to go for this race. I'm not sure he can win this race but when you compare the race times, they are nearly the same, so he's in there with a chance in a strong field."

## Bella Fever and de Kock break fresh ground for Uruguay in Dubai

It was perhaps the most probable of improbable wins and the most remarkable of stories - albeit somewhat unheralded - and one which may have only just begun.

Mike de Kock won the Meydan Classic Trial in Dubai last Thursday with the Uruguayan-bred, three-year-old filly Bella Fever (True Fever).

The filly was first-up at 1400 metres despite not having raced beyond 1100 metres in the country of her birth. As a southern hemisphere three-year-old, she conceded weight to all of her northern hemisphere-bred rivals, including runner-up Final Song (Dark Angel).

Last season in England, Final Song was twice stakes-placed behind Raffle Prize (Slade Power), who was rated equal second-best two-year-old filly in the European classifications.

Bella Fever, who was foaled as late as July 2016, might have had nine months in age on Final Song but conceded her the same number of pounds.

She had also travelled more than 16,000 kilometres from Uruguay to Dubai via England and endured two surgeries on a hind fetlock.

The pundits largely dismissed her and, more surprisingly, her trainer - who may not be enjoying his best Dubai season with quarantine horrors diminishing his barn to just four - but he remains the man who put the jurisdiction on the international racing map and has won more than 20 of the major races conducted there.

In hindsight, the 20-1 (and better in some

places) bet against her (and him) was patently absurd, even if she did become the first Uruguayan-bred to win in Dubai.

Bella Fever had won her four races in Uruguay by an aggregate of 27 lengths and clearly de Kock was on to something to be stepping her out to 1400 metres. She is raced by Jorge Wagner's JLC Stables, who won the 2017 Dubai Golden Shaheen with now Shadai stallion Mind Your Biscuits (Posse), and Victor Azambullo.

"She'd shown us a lot of ability in her work," de Kock told ANZ Bloodstock News from Johannesburg.

"I'd met Victor many years ago and

he contacted us out of the blue, via Jehan (Malherbe), to see if we'd train the filly in Dubai.

"Naturally, you're always a touch sceptical when someone says they have a very good one, and not many horses come out of Uruguay, but we were happy to take her.

"She'd had surgery on a hind fetlock in Uruguay but was clearly uncomfortable when she arrived in England around August last year.

"She had surgery again on the same fetlock to remove the pin, and Jane Chapple-Hyam did a great job nursing her, and then pre-training her, before she came to us late in the year."

The protracted and adventurous undertaking was rewarded when Bella Fever,



somewhat contrary to expectations, settled off the speed and finished with gusto to win in quite commanding fashion at Meydan.

"I expected her to race much handier but she missed the kick, which might have worked in her favour as they did run along," de Kock continued.

"She settled well in running and finished the race off. I was quite impressed. She's a beautiful filly, a very nice specimen. She is very temperamental, in an aggressive sense, but with a lot of ability."

Stepping out to 1400 metres, despite her form profile, was not an issue according to de Kock.

"She wants a mile to be honest," he said.

And a mile she now gets, all being well, with the \$US800,000 Saudi Derby on February 29 her immediate target, a race run on the new programme at Riyadh, which features the inaugural \$US20 million Saudi Cup.

"It's on the dirt but we're keen to have a crack and it's a very good dirt track with minimal kick back," de Kock added.

Looking further ahead, the UAE Derby - which de Kock has won six times - may beckon, but nothing is locked in according to the trainer, whose missions this year include establishing his operation in Australia with son Matthew, and re-establishing the strength of his Dubai stable.

Three of de Kock's Derby winners have been South American-bred - Lundy's Liability (BRZ) (Candy Stripes), Asiatic Boy (ARG) (Not For Sale) and Honour Devil (ARG) (Honour And Glory) - and he wrote of past forays on his website immediately after the win.

"This was an amazing win for Uruguay - well done to owners Jorge Wagner and Victor Azambullo. They took a gamble, had the courage to send her here when they knew how arduous the trip would be and saying that they could've kept her in Uruguay where she was beating everything," he said.

"This reminded us of days gone by when we visited South America often and came back with horses that were competitive in Dubai. Belle Fever was courageous tonight after she played up a bit at the start. She's a nice filly and was well prepared by our Dubai team of Declan Cronin, Shorty Feni and Thomas Ncume."

Bella Fever is by Texas Fever (Victory Gallop) from the maiden Passionbypassion (Unbridled's Song). Texas Fever's dam, Fortyniner Fever (Forty Niner), was an unraced half-sister to Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr Prospector), and Texas Fever himself was a Grade 3 winner in the USA before finishing sixth in the 2007 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

Texas Fever is also the sire of Sir Fever, who came close to being Dubai's first Uruguayan winner when he finished second to Muhtahij (Dubawi) in the 2015 renewal of the Al Bastakiya. Muhtahij was trained by de Kock and he went on to win the UAE Derby before beating all bar California Chrome (Lucky Pulpit) in the following year's Dubai World Cup.

Sir Fever was trained by Charlie Appleby after being transferred from Jorge Piriz, who originally trained Bella Fever.

Texas Fever originally stood at the late Bob and Janice McNair's Stonerside Farm, which they sold to Sheikh Mohammed in 2008. The

McNair's had bought the property in 1994 from Arthur Hancock III, whose father Arthur Hancock jnr had trail-blazed when he bought the Argentinian-bred Forli (Aristophanes) in 1967. Forli ran a track record at Hollywood Park on debut in North America.

The likes of Bayakoa (Consultant's Bid), who won the Breeders Cup Distaff twice, and countless other North American stakes-winners were to emerge from South America.

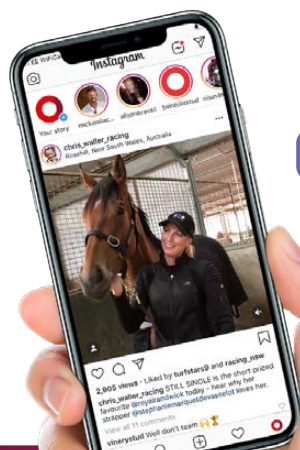
They included the mighty Uruguayan-raced and owned (but Argentinian-bred) Invasor, who won 11 of his 12 starts, including the Breeders Cup Classic and Dubai World Cup. Brazil's Gloria De Campeao (Impression) also won the World Cup.

Of course, a good horse can come from anywhere, which makes you wonder whether the South Americans and South Africans are generally underrated in the official world rankings.

The recent Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini winner Nao De Mais (T. H. Approval) just might be a whole lot better than his official equal-112th world ranking suggests. We may find out later this year as his Argentinian success has secured him a place in the Breeders' Cup Turf.

Of course, Australians have dabbled with South American stock. Breeder Ted Cockram imported a number of Argentinian mares in the 1980s and, on the track, we've seen stakes winners Savage Toss (Egg Toss) and Cefalu (Dushyantor) arrive from Argentina and Chile respectively, while Hussonet (Mr Prospector) has succeeded at stud.

However, just four of the 2267 horses imported to Australia in 2018-19 were from that continent. They might be worth a bigger punt than that!

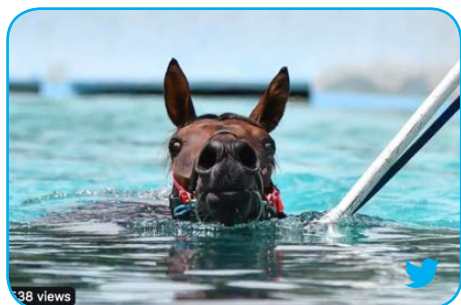

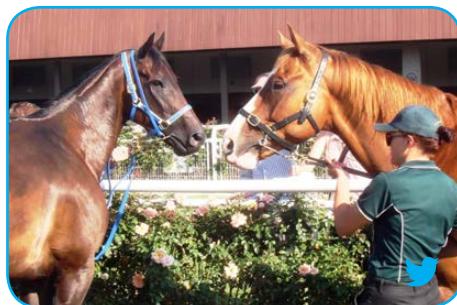
