Mr Quickie set to define stellar season for Shamus Award in Stradbroke

lmost exactly two years ago Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) burst onto the scene as a top class horse of the future with a win in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) putting his sire Shamus Award (Snitzel) on the board as a Group 1 producer. Today the five-year-old gelding represents his father on the elite stage at Eagle Farm once again but this time in one of the country's iconic sprint races - the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m).

Victory would not only cap off what has been a stellar season on the racetrack for Shamus Award, importantly, it would define his versatility as a stallion.

<< Continued from page 2 "It's interesting that he's had Group 1s in Oaks and Derbies but he does get them fast as well," said Rosemont Stud principle Anthony Mithen.

"Last time we pulled apart his stats, 80 per cent of his winners were at 1200 metres or less. I wonder if that will be an anomaly at the end of his stud career or ring true and that will be the type of horse he gets at elite level.

"Mr Quickie is versatile and a mark of the stallion. He can get you a speed horse or tough durable customer that can get a trip in its three-year-old year. It's what we are all looking for in a stallion."

Mithen has several very good reasons to hope Mr Quickie can deliver Rosemont Stud's star resident Shamus Award, his fourth individual Group 1 winner today.

He and his in-laws, the Austin family, own his best performing son who was the result of a fortuitous purchase by Mithen who bought his dam Special Favour (General Nediym) in foal with him at the 2015 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale for just \$30,000.

"To go and buy a mare in foal to a first season stallion cheaply, you don't think for one minute you are going to end up with a multiple Group 1 winner and it was a fanciful suggestion at the time to even think we would get Shamus Award," Mithen said.

"She's now the mother of the best Shamus Award yet and the stallion is now standing at the farm and putting together an amazing record in the early years of his career."

Two Group 1 wins and just over \$2 million in prize-money later, Mr Quickie has taken Mithen and his family on a wonderful racing journey for which they are enormously grateful.

"Mr Quickie is a horse we have enjoyed racing together and had some great times with and he was really the horse that got us over the line with Viv Oldfield and Sean Buckley to relocate Shamus Award to us."

Shamus Award has now produced three individual Group 1 winners this season and naturally the success has resulted in a heavy flow of mare bookings ahead of the upcoming breeding season.

"There's been a noticeable increase in the quality of mares. We


are virtually full and taking applications now. We are so tight we need the mare to match up well and we are wanting to fit these mares in because the quality is mouthwatering.

"A couple of years ago when we were trying to reinvent him we were taking what we could get so you can only imagine the job he will do with the quality of mares he has this season."

Shamus Award's success has fuelled some of Rosemont's confidence to dive even deeper into the bloodstock business.

<< Continued from page 3 "Our ability to manage Shamus Award and build nice books of mares are testament to the breeders that have used him and it has given us confidence to ramp things up and hit the throttle in our search for more quality stallions," Mithen continued.

That momentum is evidenced by the Victorian Alliance which was extremely active at the recent Australian yearling sales purchasing 12 colts.

"Hopefully we can find our own stallion and we are certainly on the search and have made it clear to the market that we are here with intent and want to make a roster of significance on the Australian scene and not just on the Victorian scene.

"The colts are off to a really good start and we are pleased with how those horses have broken in," he said.

The strong level of activity from the Victorian Alliance along with various other thoroughbred investors from the state at this year's sales spells an exciting future for Victoria.

"If you are an outsider looking into Australia at the moment, you would be having thoughts about investing in Victoria.

"They can achieve their goal and have success without the spectre of challenges faced in the Hunter at the moment. That's not to show a lack of

sympathy for the plight they face with water and coal, it's just an unfortunate reality.

"I'm glad to be progressing our business in Victoria and seemingly some shrewd investors are doing the same thing. Yulong is the other obvious one. It's exciting times in Victoria, the best is yet to come."

Only just emerging from yet another Covid-19 lockdown, Victoria hasn't been the most pleasant of places to be lately and due to continuing restrictions Mithen won't be at Eagle Farm today to watch Mr Quickie.

Savatoxl passed fit for Stradbroke start

Queensland Racing Integrity Commission veterinarians vesterday gave (Kuroshio) the green light to line up in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm today. The Tony and Calvin McEvoytrained five-year-old will bid for a second top-flight win, having landed The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) two starts ago. Savatoxl had to undergo a similar clearance prior to running in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at the same track two weeks ago, when he finished sixth in a blanket finish behind Vega One (Lope De Vega). Meanwhile, the Greg Eurelltrained Blazejowski (Dash For Cash) must pass another veterinary test if he is to take his place on the Eagle Farm card, having shown signs of lameness this week. Blazejowski, who ran 13th in the Kingsford-Smith Cup, is an emergency in the Stradbroke and also an acceptor for the Hinkler Handicap (Listed, 1200m) with Jye McNeil booked to ride.

Superman flying Stradbroke flag for Snowdens

Peter and Paul Snowden believe they have unravelled the key to talented sprinter-miler I Am Superman (Footstepsinthesand) in the Irish import's third campaign for the training partnership. I Am Superman will tackle the Stradbroke Handicap at Eagle Farm off a seven-week break between runs. The unconventional preparation is seen as being necessary to giving the entire his best chance at Group 1 success, with the fiveyear-old benefiting from mental and physical freshness. "This is the perfect preparation," Peter Snowden said. "He ran in the (All Aged Stakes) then had four days off and has been back in work ever since. He's had a trial two weeks ago. He's in good order and he's a really good horse fresh." I Am Superman won the Ajax Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill in March and while he beat just one rival home in Kolding's (Teofilo) All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), he finished less than four lengths from the winner.

Carif on song for Brisbane Cup

The father-and-son Snowden training partnership also has Carif (So You Think) contesting the Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) at Eagle Farm today and Peter Snowden believes the horse is well capable of winning the race. The five-year-old, who is having his fifth start back from a spell, was runner-up to Spirit Ridge (Nathaniel) in the BRC Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at the same track on May 29. "The distance is right, the track is going to be good for him, he's racing well but the only negative is that 59 kilos," Snowden said. "He won the

Sandown Cup with about 56 (kilograms). It's probably his true weight he gets from what he's done. There's not much we can do about it, hopefully he's good enough to get away with it and win." Tommy Berry takes the ride on the gelding.

Upbringing holds Forster in good stead

Desleigh Forster believes Apache Chase (Better Than Ready), her stable's first runner in the Stradbroke Handicap, is a live chance after his grinding victory in the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm last month. "He is going good, he is nice and bright and well," the Eagle Farm trainer told Racing Queensland. "We are looking forward to Saturday. He came through his last run really well, too well. He is well, happy, bright and he is playing around." The three-year-old, a winner of five from 13 career starts, is owned by local businessman Michael Sherrin. Last year, Tyzone (Written Tycoon) won for 'the bush', being owned by a couple of connections from Cairns and Tolga, and with Forster having cut her teeth in Ilfracombe, in Queensland's Central West Country Racing Association, where her father Henry still has a team of gallopers, it could be two in a row for country connections. "From day dot, I have always been around horses; that is all I did, but I did not get into racehorses until I was 16," Forster continued. "It was a very good grounding staying in the country. You do not take things for granted, I have been very lucky since I moved down here and started training, always having decent horses. In this industry, you do not take anything for granted."

Brandenburg out to cause Q22 upset

Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux) is hogging the spotlight ahead of today's Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) at Eagle Farm, but Randwick trainer John Sargent is keen to step out of the wings with Brandenburg (Burgundy). The New Zealandbred gelding finished third behind the Annabel Neasham-trained six-year-old in the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) last start after taking up the pacemaker role, and Sargent is keen for his charge to sit behind the pace this time. "I thought it was a very good effort first go over 2000 metres and having to lead at a very good pace. There was nothing wrong with the ride, he (Regan Bayliss) took the right option at the time," Sargent told Racing HQ. "Rachel (King) knows him very well and hopefully they get a bum to follow on Saturday where we can put him to sleep and see him finish off like I know he can. He has developed a lot mentally and physically. He is just a lovely horse to be around the stable. The favourite (Zaaki) is going to be very hard to beat but anything can happen."

Berry's sliding doors moment with Zaaki

Tommy Berry will reunite with Nettover (Sebring) in the \$1.2 million Q22 but in a sliding doors moment, he could easily have found himself partnering rising star and odds-on favourite Zaaki. Berry has a close association with Zaaki's trainer Annabel Neasham, delivering her first elite-level win aboard Mo'unga (Savabeel) in the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m). Neasham offered him the ride on Zaaki in the JRA Plate (Gr 3, 200m) in the autumn but ever loyal to the Hawkes stable, Berry turned it down to stick with Zeyrek (Sea The Stars), leaving fierce rival James McDonald to jump aboard Zaaki and stay there. "I actually had the opportunity to ride Zaaki the start after the Doncaster, but I chose to stick with one of Hawkes', Zeyrek," Berry said. "James (McDonald) got on him and he's obviously got the association now. It's only my bad judgement why I'm not on him now. I might get the opportunity later on: if he goes up against Verry Elleegant at some point, James is going to have to make a decision so we'll see which one he makes."



t's been a case of the triumphs and near misses in recent weeks with Eureka Stud's Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo), who celebrated a Group 2 win for Prince Of Boom in the Champagne Classic (1200m) on May 15, to become his sire's most 'boom' progeny, as a first Group 2 winner.

However, that same day there followed a second for Jonker in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m), a race in which Outback Barbie finished seventh having won the Bright Shadow Stakes (Listed, 1200m) in the previous month.

She will offer another chance to give Spirit Of Boom his first Group 1 winner today, having gained a berth in the Stradbroke (Gr 1, 1400m) due to the scratching of Madam Rouge (Zoustar) but, prior to today's feature, in the opening Oxlade Stakes (Listed, 1200m), there's a filly with a familiar pedigree that could stake her claim to be up to bigger and greater things.

Lime Soda will today look to build on her

debut win at the Gold Coast and follow her brother Ef Troop as a stakes winner for her sire. Should she succeed she would be his 14th individual black-type winner.

A homebred for S F Bloodstock and Blake Sandblom, the Toby and Trent Edmondstrained Lime Soda is the sixth foal out of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) mare Limealicious, who was purchased by Newgate Farm for \$350,000 in 2018 after the stakes-winning juvenile exploits of Ef Troop. She has four progeny by Spirit Of Boom, while her yearling colt by Capitalist (Written Tycoon) sold for \$90,000 to Kendrick Racing at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Sale, having been traded for \$80,000 as a weanling.

She has a Lonhro (Octagonal) weanling colt and was placed in foal to Newgate's stallion Brutal (O'Reilly) last year, while her star son Ef Troop returned with a second at the Doomben trials on Tuesday, his first public appearance

Sweet Deal to end career on a high

Sweet Deal (Casino Prince) will have her penultimate start in the Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Eagle Farm today before attempting to bow out as a Group 1 winner. Sold recently for \$850,000 at the Inglis Chairman's Sale, the multiple stakes winner and \$1.5 million earner has been kept in training by her new owners in the hope she can add the missing piece to her CV by claiming a major in the Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) later this month. She has raced once since going under the hammer, when a barnstorming second to Exhilarates (Snitzel) in the Helen Coughlan Stakes (Listed, 1200m) when she got back to last from an awkward gate. "She missed a bit of work between Hawkesbury and that run. She spent a week at the sales then we gave her a week at the farm to freshen up and get over the sales," her trainer John Thompson said. "As usual, she did a bit well in that time so she went into that race a little bit underdone. that's why we rode her quiet from an outside draw. From a better draw (four) on Saturday, she should be a lot closer. She is definitely back to where she needs to be (fitness-wise)." Sweet Deal is a \$4.80 chance for the 15-runner contest which includes Funstar (Adelaide), Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Odeum (Written Tycoon) and Madam Rouge (Zoustar).

Grand Piano playing to city tune

Farm life isn't for everyone, even horses. Twelve months ago, Grand Piano (Lord Kanaloa) won four of his five autumn starts and was being touted as a lightweight chance for the Stradbroke Handicap. But after struggling to force his way into the final field, he was spelled. A change of trainer followed as his owner decided to have his team of horses prepared from a rural property, however, after Grand Piano flopped in two spring runs, it became clear country life wasn't for him. He found his way back to original trainer John Thompson earlier this year and after a fast-finishing second at Eagle Farm last start, Grand Piano appears to be back on the right trajectory as he prepares to chase his sixth career-win in today's Acy Securities Handicap (1300m) at Randwick. "The owner (Paul Fudge) had a private trainer on his farm and he just didn't click with the farm life obviously, because his runs from there were terrible," Thompson said. "But back in a city stable now he seems back to his normal self. We were very confident last start in the Queensland race and we nearly pulled off a plunge there. I think he's back to going good again so if he runs to his old form, he's a super chance again."

Innes to make amends on Brutality

Lightweight Sydney jockey James Innes Jr hopes to make up for "what could have been" on the Joe Pride-trained Brutality (Shamus Award) in the Heineken Racing To Win Handicap (1600m) at Randwick today. Innes was on board last start when the four-year-old gelding finished third over 1400 metres. "In my opinion he's the pick of the race and he's only got 53 kilograms," Innes told Racing NSW. "If we get any luck he's got to be the one to beat for sure. He was a bit stiff the other day. He probably could have won had we followed the winner through, that's being critical of myself but there's only one way to change that." Brutality has won four of his 16 starts and more than \$244,000 in prize-money.

Quick-thinking Van Overmeire back in the saddle

Jean Van Overmeire's instinctive reaction means he will be riding at Randwick today instead of lying in a hospital bed. The apprentice jockey, who needs only 11 more wins to ride out his claim, had a near-miss at Gosford on Thursday when Skyray (Smart Missile) reared in the stalls prior to the running of race six. "The horse flipped over in the gates and slingshot me out the back," he told Racing NSW. "I was wedged between the back post in the gates and the horse and I couldn't move until he moved. When he moved I fell to the ground and he continued to flip out of the gates. When he hit the ground it was inches for sure, I just moved my legs in time. Otherwise he would have landed straight on my legs with his shoulder." The 26-year-old, who has had his share of injuries, only missed his one barrier trial booking at Warwick Farm yesterday but knows it could have been much worse. "I don't think I'd have been walking. I'm a bit sore in the ribs but I think it's muscular more than anything else," he added.

Promising Ranveer to resume

A winter meeting at Sandown may not usually be the time and place to see a young horse with big spring aspirations but that is the scenario for trainer Matt Laurie and Ranveer (Winning Rupert) in the Clanbrooke Racing Handicap (1000m) today. "He's had too long off so with spring coming he needs to pull some money into his bank and then we can back off and then time the next preparation around the better races," Laurie said. At his only start, in December at Flemington, Ranveer was sent out favourite when beaten by Profiteer (Capitalist) who went on to claim the Inglis Millennium (1100m) at Randwick and later finished seventh as one of the top fancies in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m). The Flemington outing was an afterthought, having been primed for an aborted debut shot at the Magic Millions Clockwise Classic (1000m) in November. "But he got quite crook and we hit him as hard as we could with what we were able to do," Laurie said. "He was fine when he went to Flemington and we were quite optimistic, but we felt he was slightly on the decline by that day." The colt is expected to need the run ahead an assignment on June 26. "He's not wound up, but we're keen to get going," Laurie said. "He runs in this and it probably brings him up to speed for a race two weeks later at Caulfield. We've always thought that he was quite smart but they've got to come back and prove it again."

Mimosas staying put

Offers from Hong Kong have not been enough to convince connections of Mimosas (Squamosa) to sell the promising two-year-old. Trainer Clayton Douglas' charge caught the eyes of investors with a smart debut win over 1000 metres at Flemington last month. "There were a few offers on the table but nothing of real big significance," Douglas told Racing.com. "We feel like he's a horse that's going to make a really nice three-year-old, he's a big, robust type, I don't think we've seen the best of him yet. I think he'll come back a nice horse once he has a break and comes back as a three-year-old." Rather than preparing to make the move to Sha Tin, Mimosas instead will take his

place in today's Clanbrooke Racing Handicap. "(It's) a good task for him, he has to carry 59 kilograms against some nice, progressive horses," Douglas continued. "We're going to probably find out if he's as good as we think he is, or whether we just have to come back and maybe look for an autumn three-year-old and race around those VOBIS races, or whether we look towards those better races in the spring, but (Saturday's) going to tell us a fair bit (as we) see how much improvement he has taken from his first-up run."

Adelaide firm back together in Melbourne

Jamie Kah will reunite with her old boss at Sandown when Arkham Knight (Reaan) makes the journey over from Adelaide. Kah was apprenticed to Arkham Knight's trainer John Macmillan who has supplied Melbourne's leading rider with 90 winners from her career tally of 1009 victories. Having been based in Melbourne since January 2019, Kah doesn't ride too often for Macmillan these days but they join forces once again with Arkham Knight in the Ladbroke It! Handicap (1300m). Macmillan, who will remain in Adelaide for today's race not wanting to tempt his luck and have to do 14 days quarantine upon return, said it was good to have Kah ride Arkham Knight. "Normally if she's available she'll ride for me as she was apprenticed to me," Macmillan said. "But I still have to deal with her manager, but he's pretty good with his form analysis, so I guess she wouldn't be on it if they didn't think it had a chance." Arkham Knight ran fourth first-up at Murray Bridge over 1200 metres on May 22 and has since had a barrier trial at Oakbank.

Dr Drill set to find old form

European import Dr Drill (Dansili) will be out to register his first win in 13 months when he runs in the Ladbrokes Bet Ticker Handicap (1800m) at Sandown today. The 1800-metre contest will be just the second time the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained six-year-old will have competed in a non-black type event since winning the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m) in May last year. Dr Drill recorded placings in the Cranbourne Cup

(Listed, 2025m) last October, a race he won in 2019, and last start, when second in the R A Lee Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Morphettville on May 15. And Eustace said Dr Drill's recent work has the team confident he can get back into winning form under the guidance of three kilogram claimer Matthew Cartwright. "He's really well and he worked really well on Tuesday," Eustace said. "We were confident he would put in a good performance in Adelaide, which he did, and he's come through it really well. I think he's got a great chance. The 18 (1800m) will pose no problems. Matthew is on board, he's riding well. He's not a big horse so the claim will really help."

Soft Sandown expected

The ground condition at Sandown today could be soft according to track manager Terry Bailey, with strong winds having had a drying effect ahead of the winter meeting. "We've had 40 millimetres of rain this week and while the wind has been horrific for the state, it has been beneficial for us to help it dry," Bailey told Racing.com. "We've posted the track a Heavy 8, but I'm confident, barring any further rain, we will be on a Soft track (today). I am really, really happy considering the rainfall we have had. We are racing on the True and the past two meetings on the Hillside have been at 8-metre and 12-metre, so the inside 12 metres is in perfect condition. It's got a great cover of grass on it. I think it will be very even. They will use a fair width of the straight. They will start on the rail and a typical wet track (but) they will be getting off the fence as the day progresses."

Valour Road on trial for Hyperion Stakes

A shot at the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in November looms as a surprising target for Valour Road (Frost Giant) if he runs up to expectations in the Hyperion Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Belmont today. The gelding has enjoyed elite success in sprinting races but has not raced beyond 1400 metres in a 24-start career for trainer Simon Miller. He heads in off a last start second in the Belmont Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) when he finished strongly behind The Velvet King (Universal

Ruler). "He was really good the other day and probably adds another dimension to his repertoire," Miller told Tabradio. "If he can run out the mile then suddenly he's a Railway horse for next prep. Can he get the mile? I don't know. All you can do is base it on his last run and he was strong through the lines. As long as he can relax there is no reason why he can't. I think the no blinkers enables him to get it as well." A \$60,000 Magic Millions Perth yearling, Valour Road's seven career wins include the Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) and the Euclase Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) in Adelaide. The five-year-old, a \$7 chance, will jump from barrier four in the Hyperion Stakes and Brad Rawiller retains the ride. Miller will also saddle Dance Music (War Chant) from barrier six under Brad Parnham.

Hometown victory for Coffey

Swan Hill native Harry Coffey partnered the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Cardigan Queen (Sebring) to win the Elvstroem Classic (1300m) yesterday, giving the rider his first "biggie" at his hometown carnival. Elvstroem (Danehill) won at his debut over the 1300-metre journey at the carnival in 2003 while his younger halfbrother Haradasun (Fusaichi Pegasus) scored a ten-length win, also on debut, three years later. "It's great to win a hometown feature. I've never won a biggie, so it's good to get an Elvstroem Classic," Coffey said. "Growing up as a kid you'd watch these nice twoyear-olds come up to Swan Hill, Haradasun, Elvstroem and you would think these horses are amazing and now all these years later I'm riding in the races that you would watch all these good horses come up for." Enjoying a good run behind the speed, Cardigan Queen defeated the \$1.95 favourite All About Eve (Star Turn) by three-quarters of a length. "Dave (Eustace) spoke to me on the phone this morning and said we've got the blinkers on, we're very happy with her and don't be afraid to stick it to them because she's tough," Coffey said. "When someone like Dave says that to you, you go out there and ride full of confidence and that's the way I rode her. She was too good."

Midships edges Golden Topaz

Midships (Atlante) edged a thrilling finish to the Golden Topaz (1200m) at Swan Hill yesterday giving connections hope that the gelding has done enough to book a ticket to Hong Kong. The David Brideaoke-trained four-year-old broke sharply under Daniel Moor who took his mount back to race fourth, one-off the fence, before asking for an effort off the home turn. Midships battled home to hold off secondplaced Dexelation (Ambidexter) by a head, with Open Minded (Jimmy Choux) half a length further behind in third. "He is sort of on a trek to go to Hong Kong for some really good Hong Kong clients and to do that he sort of needed to get enough points for the ratings and he has probably done that today, so it's a job well done," Brideaoke's assistant trainer Matt Jenkins told Racing.com. Boomer Bloodstock/Murray Thoroughbred bought Midships for \$70,000 out of the Blandford Lodge consignment at the 2018 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale. The New Zealand-bred is out of the Group 2-placed mare Queen Of Pop (Pins) and is a half-brother to Group 3 scorer Pop Star Princess (Makfi), from the family of multiple Group 1 winner Volkstok'N'Barrell (Tavistock).

Lafferty injured in horror fall

Laura Lafferty suffered concussion and soft tissue damage after a nasty fall from the Richard Laming-trained Ronniejay (All Too Hard) in the last race at Swan Hill yesterday. The rider was conscious when taken to Swan Hill hospital with possible shoulder and hip injuries. Scans revealed no fractures.

Freedman close to comeback

Lee Freedman will have his first Australian runner since his return from Singapore when Intrepidacious (Shooting To Win) steps out at Ipswich next Saturday. The handler spent three and a half years in the Lion City but now has 17 horses in work at his Gold Coast stables. "It'll take a little time for us to get going coming back from Singapore as it takes you out of the system and it takes you a while to get established no matter who you are," the

Hall of Famer told Racing.com. "We're building up steadily and we'll probably have our first runner next weekend with Intrepidacious in the Gai Waterhouse Classic and then a trickle of runners after that. I haven't a lot of older horses, as yet, we've got a lot of babies, but I'm happy with what we've bought into the stable. They all seem the right horses for up here."

Stablehand Evans suspended

Tamworth stablehand Brent Evans has failed in his appeal to have a three-month ban, two of which have been suspended, overturned after an altercation with trainer Cody Morgan last month. The NSW Racing Appeal Panel upheld the stewards' penalty related to the May 21 trackwork incident in which Evans verbally abused Morgan at Tamworth racecourse. Facts of the case show that Evans directed the abuse, such as "you are lucky I don't belt the (expletive) out of you" after Morgan sent him a text message earlier that morning saying that he no longer wished him to perform duties for him. The appeal panel heard that Evans, who pleaded guilty to the charges but was contesting the severity, was sleep deprived and the main provider for his family, including his young disabled child. The panel, chaired by Richard Beasley, agreed with those factors but determined the three-month penalty and a two-year behaviour bond was appropriate.

NEW ZEALAND

Entries open for Karaka 2022

New Zealand Bloodstock has officially started calling for entries for next year's Karaka Yearling Sale, with five days set aside for the 2022 Book 1 and 2 sales, starting on Sunday, January 23. Mapperley Stud has announced their exciting young stallion Contributer (High Chaparral) is fully booked for the 2021 breeding season. Following a successful year on the track and in the sales ring, his service fee was more than doubled to \$22,000 (plus GST) this year. His progeny's success was headlined by Lion's Roar, who won the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and placed in the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) during the autumn. Llanacord was another exciting talent to emerge from his first crop, winning the Lowland Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at Hastings and subsequently placed in the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) and South Australia Fillies Classic (Gr 3, 2500m). "We have received an overwhelming amount of interest in him early on in the year, he's had fantastic results on the track this year and it is easy to see why breeders are keen to get into him this season," Mapperley Stud principal Simms Davison said. "Lion's Roar's win in the Randwick Guineas was huge for him, getting a first crop Group 1 winner over a mile during one of their major carnivals really put him on the map. Speaking to the Australian trainers, they rate him very highly and we expect that they will be in the market for them at the yearling sales."

Trentham trek for Sharrock

New Plymouth trainer Allan Sharrock is making the long trek down to Trentham with two runners today and he has high hopes for the pair. Collinstreet (Bachelor Duke) will be vying to make it back-to-back wins in the Jennian Homes 2100 (2100m) and will benefit from apprentice jockey Callum Jones's three-kilogram claim. "He loves Trentham," Sharrock said. "I would have preferred a mile after the 1400 metres, but I couldn't slot one in. But he will be fit enough, and he will go very well. Callum is a good kid and you definitely need three kilos off when you are an 85 rater with 62 kilograms. I am confident he will race well with 59 kilos, I don't think that will stop him." Stablemate Darci La Bella (Darci Brahma) has made a pleasing start to her career, winning three of her four starts, and placing in the other. Four-kilogram apprentice Ciel Butler has been booked for the ride. "Ciel has had the benefit of a ride on her in a jump-out. She knows the filly, she is very genuine, and she will travel on the bit all the way," Sharrock added.

Grylls looks to Treasure State to continue run

Craig Grylls is enjoying his best season yet in the saddle and is keen on improving his place on the New Zealand Jockeys' Premiership at Te Rapa today. With 82 wins to his name this term, including ten at stakes level, the Waikato hoop currently sits third in the premiership. While runaway leader Danielle Johnson is firmly out of his sights with 146 wins to her name, secondplaced Samantha Collett is within touching distance, just two wins ahead of Grylls. He is keen to breach that gap this weekend and he believes he has a couple of chances at Te Rapa, including the Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott-trained Treasure State (Trust In A Gust) in the Skycity Hamilton 1200 (1200m). Grylls rode the gelding on debut at Counties where wet conditions played against the two-yearold, but he did show his best work late to run on for fourth. "It was pretty wet at Counties that day, I think we're going to cop a better track tomorrow," he said. "I think he will learn a bit from that run, I'm quite happy to stick with him. He's a really lovely type of a horse, he's well put together. I think he will be a very nice animal in the long term."

Octogenarian out to celebrate birthday with Timaru winner

South Canterbury trainer Len Stewart would love nothing more than to celebrate his 89th birthday with success in tomorrow's Dunstan Horsefeeds Waimate Cup (2200m) at Timaru. Stewart, who began his association with racing as a 14-year-old riding in saddle trots in Waikato in the 1940s, will produce Take The Deel (Dundeel) in the Waimate Racing Club feature. A \$1200 gavelhouse.com purchase out of Brian Court's stable, Take The Deel is a form runner in the Waimate Cup, albeit in the lower grades, with Rating 65 wins at two of his last three starts. He came from near last to score at Ashburton last Friday under jockey Terry Moseley, having never gained a clear run at his previous start at Wingatui when finishing sixth. "It was very good last time. He had that bit of trouble clearing traffic on the corner but he kicked on and came home really well," said Stewart, who celebrates his birthday on Tuesday. "He's kept improving. With his big frame, he's just needed time to grow into it and he's getting better all the time."

Wheeler reminisces about Rough Habit 30 years on

New Plymouth trainer John Wheeler is content to watch the Queenlsand winter carnival from afar these days, 30 years after he sent over Rough Habit (Roughcast) to win the first of his two Stradbroke Handicaps (Gr 1, 1400m). "I can't believe it's 30 years since Roughie won his first Straddie and Doomben Cup," Wheeler said. "It's hard to describe him, he was unique. He was a fierce competitor at any distance, just so long as there was plenty of pace, which meant he would settle and be off the bit. When it all came together there wasn't a horse that could match his finishing sprint, it was freakish." Rough Habit won 29 of his 74 starts and more than \$5 million in prize-money and the rugged bay with the jagged blaze made a masterpiece of the Queensland carnival. Six of Rough Habit's 11 Group 1 victories were in Brisbane, the first of them the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) in 1990 and added to over subsequent years by three editions of the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2020m) and two Stradbroke Handicaps. He also won the Hollindale Stakes (Listed, 1800m) twice as well as the Sir Byrne Hart Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m), and in an emotional Eagle Farm finale that reduced supposedly hard men to tears, the P J O'Shea Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m) as an eight-year-old in 1995.

Ex-police deputy commissioner takes on board role

Mike Clement has been appointed chief executive of the new independent Racing Integrity Board which will oversee the racing industry from July 1. "The board is delighted to have been able to secure a leader of Mike's standing, experience and impeccable integrity," Racing Integrity Board chairman Sir Bruce Robertson said. The Racing Integrity Board takes over the functions of the Racing Integrity Unit and the Judicial Control Authority for Racing, both of which will be disestablished as of June 30 with all employees transferring to the new board. "Importantly, the new Racing Integrity Board - announced by minister for racing Hon. Grant Robertson on 8 June - is independent and separate from the thoroughbred, harness and greyhound racing codes. Its establishment was a key part of the racing industry reforms in the Racing Industry Act 2020," Robertson said. Clement retired from the New Zealand Police last year after 42 years of service. He was deputy commissioner national operations at police headquarters from 2014 and prior to that he was district commander Auckland City.

ASIA

JPN: First for Satono Aladdin

Satono Aladdin (Deep Impact) sired his first winner yesterday when Omiwatari (2 c ex Petit Princesse by King Kamehameha) won over 1100 metres on the dirt at Monbetsu on the NAR circuit. The two-year-old scored at the second attempt, having placed third on debut last month in a 1700-metre newcomers contest, also on a dirt surface. Satono Aladdin won eight of 29 starts with his biggest success being the 2017 Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m). A full-brother to Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Gr 1, 2200m) winner Lachesis, he stands at Shadai Stallion Station for a fee of ¥1 million (approx. AUD\$117,900). Omiwatari is a half-brother to four winners out of Petit Princesse (King Kamehameha), whose second dam Masake (Master Willie) was a Grade 3 winner in California.

JPN: Moe to follow mum

Curren Moe (Lord Kanaloa) will attempt to follow in the swift footsteps of her dam Curren Chan (Kurofune) when she lines up in the Hakodate Sprint Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Sapporo tomorrow. Curren Chan landed the early summer speed test in 2011 as the midpoint of a five-win streak that climaxed with the Sprinters Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). The speedy mare added the Takamatsunomiya Kinen (Gr 1, 1200m) the following spring. Curren Moe has plenty to live up to with her sire being the great Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha), who was second in the 2012 Hakodate Sprint Stakes before proving to be an exceptional sprinter-miler with six top-level wins in Japan and Hong Kong. Curren Moe has won four of only ten starts across three seasons and proved up to this level in her last two outings when runnerup in the Keihan Hai (Gr 3, 1200m) at Hanshin in November and Yukan Fuji Sho Ocean Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Nakayama in March. The Takayuki Yasuda-trained five-year-old faces 15 rivals.

HK: Badel charged over V Chevaliers

The Hong Kong Jockey Club's racing stewards yesterday charged Alexis Badel, under Rules 99 (2) and (6), with failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures to obtain the best possible placing on V Chevaliers (Ocean Park) in the Ping Tin Handicap (1650m) at Sha Tin last Sunday. The stewards heard evidence from Badel, trainer Manfred Man, and Chan Wing-sum of the ownership syndicate, Musketeers Fraternity Syndicate. Badel was found to have failed to ride out V Chevaliers with reasonable vigour and purpose from the 300-metre point until after the 200-metre mark. As such the stewards also ruled

that he had not given the horse full opportunity to obtain the best finishing position. The inquiry was adjourned for a date yet to be determined when Badel will enter a plea. The inquiry comes after Vagner Borges was found guilty on May 10 of the same charge for his ride aboard Daily Charm (Not A Single Doubt) at Sha Tin on April 17, for which he received a ban from May 24 to June 27, straddling nine Hong Kong race meetings.

HK: Moreira keen on Master Eight

Joao Moreira is confident Master Eight (Oamaru Force) can confirm his status as one of Hong Kong's brightest prospects with victory in the Class 3 Hap Mun Bay Handicap (1200m) at Sha Tin tomorrow. The premiership leader believes only unbeaten Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls) is superior to Master Eight among the three-year-olds he has partnered this season. "If he's not at the top, he would be sitting second. It's just a matter of time and if he gives a little bit more he might be as good as the one that I would put at the top," Moreira said of Frankie Lor's charge, who scored an impressive three and a quarter length victory on debut last month. "He did what we were expecting. When I asked him to come back a little bit he responded like a professional horse. He's the type of horse that is going to make the trainer's and jockey's life easier." Master Eight impressed Moreira with his trackwork enthusiasm on Monday as he prepared to rise in grade from Class 4. "I was asked not to go too fast on him, but he was feeling so well in himself that we ended up going a little bit faster than what the trainer wanted but he pulled up very well after the gallop and I'm sure he's going to bring his best to the races," Moreira said before succinctly quantifying his confidence levels as "very high."

HK: Teetan hopes class drop can prove Decisive

Karis Teetan is banking on a class drop to offset Decisive Action's (Rip Van Winkle) wide draw and hefty weight in the first section of the Class 4 Silverstrand Handicap (1400m) as he bids to build on his four-timer at Happy Valley on Wednesday night. "He's got the outside gate (14) and he's got the heavy weight (132lb), so there's a few things that are not going his way but he's dropping in class, which helps him out. I think he should let down well." Teetan said of the gelding, who finished fourth in a Class 3 1600-metre contest on 16 May. The Mauritian will also partner Paul O'Sullivan's Vukan (Sacred Falls) in the Class 4 Lido Handicap (1200m) with the trainer hopeful the addition of a crossed noseband will make a difference. "The last couple of runs, he's gone forward and been far too keen in his races," O'Sullivan said. "He's come back in trip and hopefully we can switch off and hit the line."

INTERNATIONAL

Eight for Caravaggio

Coolmore's Caravaggio (Scat Daddy) sired his eighth individual winner when Silver Surfer (2 c ex Riskit Fora Biskit by Kodiac) struck in the opening maiden over six furlongs at Fairyhouse yesterday. Trained by Donnacha O'Brien, the colt was racing for the fifth time as he beat Shoebox King (Aclaim) by half a length with Schiele (Dark Angel) the same margin away in third. The fourth foal out of the Listed winner Riskit Fora Biskit (Kodiac), Silver Surfer was a 100,000 gns buy out of the Tattersalls Book 1 sale. Caravaggio, who shuttled to Coolmore Australia for one season in 2018, resides at Coolmore's Ashford Stud in Kentucky for a fee of \$25,000 (approx. AUD\$32,470).

US: Fillies lead way at day two of the OBS June Sale

A filly by Nyquist (Uncle Mo) purchased for \$420,000 (approx. AUD\$545,170) by Kim Lloyd's Sweetwater Trading Co, agent for Rockingham Ranch, topped the second session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales June Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age in Ocala, Florida. Consigned by Eddie Woods, agent, the chestnut filly is out of the stakes-winning Midnight Lute (Real Quiet) mare Midnight Ballet, a half-sister to Jala Jala (Point Determined), a Horse of the Year and champion three-year-old and older mare in Mexico, and to stakes-placed Moon Buzz (Malibu Moon). Bred in Kentucky by Stoneway Farm, the filly was acquired by Quarter Pole Enterprises for \$200,000 from the Paramount Sales consignment at last year's Keeneland September Yearling Sale. She breezed a swift eighth-mile in :10 1/5 at the under tack preview ahead of her trip through the auction ring on Thursday.

UK: Shadwell 'trimming' set to continue

Shadwell Estates will continue the process of trimming its stock with 102 horses catalogued for the July Sale at Tattersalls next month. That number is the most from any vendor and exceeds by some margin the previous high in the last decade of 76 horses catalogued before withdrawals in 2019. The reduction follows the death earlier this year of the man behind the global racing and breeding empire, Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum, but is also the continuation of a project started last year to reduce to a more manageable size going forward. "The horses in training would be selling later in

the year normally anyway, but this year we've brought it forward and trimmed those numbers a bit earlier, and we'll sell some in August at Tattersalls as well," said Angus Gold, Shadwell's longstanding racing manager. The July Sale draft also includes horses that in the past would have gone on to race in Dubai, as well as mares that might have joined the broodmare band or race on before going to auction in December.

UK: Twilight Payment among 15 left in Gold Cup

Twilight Payment (Teofilo), winner of last year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) figures among the 15 possibles left in contention for Thursday's Ascot Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2m 4f). He is one of two Lloyd Williams-owned contenders, along with his Joseph O'Brien-trained stablemate Master Of Reality (Frankel), in line to take on the reigning champion Stradivarius (Sea The Stars). Williams and O'Brien could also team up in the Britannia Stakes (1m), the day's big handicap, for which they have three entries to choose from.

IRE: Real Appeal takes Ballycorus

The Zhang Yuesheng-owned Real Appeal (Sidestep) earned his second stakes win and first Group race when winning the Ballycorus Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Leopardstown on Thursday evening. Shane Foley settled the four-year-old in midfield towards the inner before switching outside for an effort exiting the home turn. Real Appeal progressed through a wide run to lead with half a furlong remaining and drew half a length clear of runner-up Lord Of The Lodge (Dandy Man),

with Pearls Galore (Invincible Spirit) a further two and a quarter lengths behind in third. Bred by Gestut Kussaberg, Real Appeal sold privately to Con Marnane for €7,500 at the 2017 Arqana Breeding Stock Sale and landed the Prix La Fleche (Listed, 1000m) as a juvenile for trainer Matthieu Palussiere. The Marnane family's Bansha House Stables offered Real Appeal at the 2019 Goffs London Sale on the eve of Royal Ascot when BBA Ireland/Yulong Investments stepped in with a successful bid of £265,000 and the youngster moved subsequently to Jim Bolger's stable in Ireland before switching to Harrington in July last year. Real Appeal is out of the French 1500-metre winner Runaway Sparkle (Green Desert), a granddaughter of the Park Hill Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 61/2f) winner Mistle Song (Nashwan). His sire, Sidestep (Exceed And Excel), stands at Telemon Thoroughbreds in Queensland at a fee of \$11,000.
