# Breeze Up Bloodstock makes mark on final day in Adelaide

*Sons of Zoustar and Nicconi fetch \$140,000 as Magic Millions sale comes to a close*

Chinese owner Gu Tao and his expatriate New Zealand trainer Quinton Cassidy yesterday added two colts and a filly to their burgeoning Breeze Up Bloodstock operation on the final day of the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale.

The pair landed a colt by Zoustar (Northern

Meteor) and a son of Widden Stud-based barnmate Nicconi (Bianconi) for \$140,000 each as well as adding a filly by Darley shuttler Frosted (Tapit) for \$30,000.

The trio of yearlings, to go with a \$110,000 Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) colt bought on day one, brings Breeze Up Bloodstock's 2020 Australasian yearling sale tally to 38 with the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale still to go.

Cassidy, who trains from Wuhan in

mainland China, and Gu have been in Australia since early January with no chance of returning home due to the coronavirus outbreak.

While concerned with the growing crisis and the wider ramifications, Cassidy said yesterday the pair have used their time in Australia and New Zealand to ramp up Breeze Up Bloodstock's thoroughbred interests.

"We do plan on getting a racing team up and going, which is already under way, and we will also have some that will be re-offered (at two-year-old sales) and the ones we think are suitable for China will go back there later on.

"We are covering all bases and once everything settles down - we've still got Easter to go - we will decide which ones do what. It is exciting times ahead and really looking forward to what we are establishing."

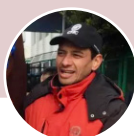
The Zoustar colt, catalogued as Lot 324 who brought \$140,000 yesterday, is the first foal out of the three-time winner I'm A Flying Star (Starcraft) who in turn is a half-sister to Hussterics (Hussonet), the dam of Inglis 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Lady Jivago (Beneteau).

"He was magnificently turned out from Leneva Park - they did a great job preparing him, so full credit to them," Cassidy said.

"He is a very athletic colt. We loved everything about him and the good thing is, the boss loved him, too. That makes the job very easy."

Beaumont admitted it had been a tough market in Adelaide, but was "very happy with the way he sold".

"He really developed throughout the prep. He is a big colt with the biggest overstep and he was extremely busy throughout the parades, he was never in his box and paraded beautifully and very professionally throughout the week," Beaumont said.

"I think the real selling point with him was his walk, he used every part of his body to walk and just improved and improved and I think in six months time we will see an even bigger and better colt."

The Nicconi colt, who brought the same price for Breeze Up Bloodstock, was offered by Balcrest Stud as Lot 364. He is the first foal out of the two-time winner Life's Zerprise (Choisir).

"It will be a tough decision with what we actually do with him. Initially, we did have plans to breeze him up but looking at him two or three times, we might have to re-strategise our plans (and add him to the racing team)," he said.

On the coronavirus that has prevented Gu and Cassidy from returning to China, he said: "It has been very tough on both of us but it has enabled us to do now what we were going to be doing later in the year.

"We have brought that plan forward and our racing team has given us something to do until everything settles down over in China.

"When it is time to go back we will pursue our projects over there, but it's a million-dollar question at the moment (when that will be)."

There were five yearlings who reached six figures on day two, bringing the total number of lots to make \$100,000 or more at this year's Adelaide auction to 14, down from 19 in 2019.

Among them was the half-brother by Shamus Award (Snitzel) to Group 3 winner Li'l Kontra (Krupt), who also ran fourth in last year's star-studded Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington. *Continued on page 4>>*

The colt was bought by Newcastle-based syndicator Australian Bloodstock who went to \$135,000 for the Golden Grove-consigned yearling who was catalogued as Lot 362.

By the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner, who relocated to Rosemont Stud last year, he is the seventh foal out of nine-time winner Li'l Cashy (Keltrice) who has had four foals to race for four winners including Li'l Kontra and the stakes-placed Cashed (Krupt).

Australian Bloodstock's Luke Murrell believes the colt was a clear stand out, not just in Adelaide but at all sales he had attended this year.

"I spent three days down there looking at him and as soon as he walked out he was just the best looking colt and also moved so well," Murrell said.

"I thought he was in the top ten balanced horses I'd seen all year - I just loved him. I was hoping, it being Adelaide, that I didn't have to spend that much, but he was worth every cent and I guess in 12 months we will find out if it was a good decision or not."

Shamus Award is best-known as the sire of Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Mr Quickie and Murrell believes he is an underrated stallion.

"He is 60 per cent runners to winners and I think his colts are about seven per cent stakes horses and this is coming off probably not the best batch of mares he would have covered in those seasons," he said.

"We bought a filly, Enchanted Heart, off the same farm a couple of years ago and she has won four from seven for us."

Earlier, Leon Macdonald went to \$120,000 to secure the Palentino (Teofilo) half-sister to Tequila Time (Stratum), the Group 3-winning sprinter under his care.

The veteran trainer, who runs a Morphettville stable with son-in-law Andrew Gluyas, prepared Tequila Time to win at Morphettville on February 29.

By Sun Stud's first season sire, the Willow Grove Stud-bred and sold filly is the seventh living foal out of El Milagro (Encosta De Lago), making her the half-sister to not only Tequila Time, himself a \$170,000 Adelaide graduate, but also the Tasmanian Guineas (Listed, 1600m) winner Inner Warrior (God's Own) and two other winners. She was catalogued as Lot 278.

The top-priced lot in Book 2 was a Puissance De Lune (Shamardal) filly sold to Ballarat trainer Mitch Freedman from the draft of Phoenix Broodmare Farm for \$90,000.

Golden Grove also sold a Shamus Award colt in Book 2 for \$85,000 to Gold Coast trainer Michael Costa.

The Book 1 sale last night closed with 288 yearlings changing hands at a clearance rate of 79 per cent, at an average of \$38,318 (down 3.7 per cent) and a median price of \$30,000 held steady from 2019. The aggregate was \$11,035,500, up 11 per cent on the previous year but in line with the larger offering.

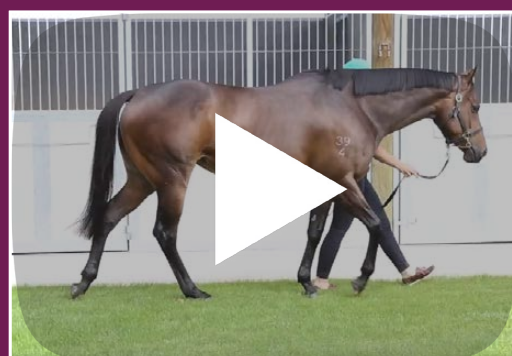

"I think the way the sale results were, was reflective of some of the stock. I thought the Magic Millions Gold Coast sale was very even across the board," Australian Bloodstock's Murrell said.

"But the last two Inglis sales (Classic and Premier) and now this Adelaide one, I thought those better horses were standing out because the difference between the top horses and the bottom horses is big.

"When you look at every one of them you get those lesser horses out and they really stand out when you've just looked at a good horse. I saw all the horses (in Adelaide) and if you were to rate them out of 100 there were a lot of horses at 90, but there were a lot of horses at ten as well and all in between and I would think that is reflected in the results."

While the overall yearling market has been up this year, Murrell was well aware that there were breeders who had lost money.

"The whole industry is pretty tough at the moment. There are some very good prices there, but there are a lot of costs associated and I am sure there are a few people that have done it a bit tough in all the sales," he said.

"But if you have the right product they will certainly pay for it."

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch again reiterated that it was "a very selective market" that played in Adelaide.

"Buyers came here, they knew what they wanted to buy and they had to pass all their criteria to bid and in those cases they did bid strongly, but in other cases a lot of horses slipped through the cracks," Bowditch said.

### Lees has numbers on side in Coolmore

Trainer Kris Lees will have four chances to add to his family's legacy in the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) when he seeks an elusive victory in the feature on Saturday. Lees' father Max still holds the training record for the Coolmore Classic with five wins and, despite coming close to victory in 2019 by saddling up both minor placegetters, the younger Lees is yet to taste success. "I had three in it last year. I think I need 16 to get a win," Lees said. "But it's a typical Coolmore, there are no standouts." Lees sends out topweight Invincible Gem (I Am Invincible), 2019 runner-up El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethiscity), globetrotter Delectation Girl (Delegator) and blueblood Miss Fabulass (Frankel). "El Dorado Dreaming has been a long time out of the winner's stall but she ran second last year and I feel she is going as good as last year at home. And Miss Fabulass, she is one of those mares where, if we get the right set up, she is going to be strong late and she could easily run a race," Lees said.

### Akari to bypass Phar Lap

Trainer Brad Widdup has decided against starting Akari (Snitzel) against benchmark fillies Funstar (Adelaide) and Probabeel (Savabeel) in the Phar Lap Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m), favouring tomorrow's Kembla Grange Classic (Gr 3, 1600m) instead. Widdup accepted for both races but confirmed she would head to the latter. "I think it's just a safer option. I've got James McDonald on Friday and I'm happy with that from the draw (three). I think she gets her chance," Widdup said. Akari has finished midfield at two runs from a spell in

the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) won by Flit (Medaglia D'Oro) and the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) won narrowly by Probabeel. Her latest effort has given Widdup confidence to test her over a mile at Kembla and if she runs to expectations, she is likely to face a rematch with Funstar and Probabeel in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Rosehill later this month.

### Marquand returns for Slipper contender

Jockey Tom Marquand has been a golden boy for Ciaran Maher and David Eustace and the co-trainers are banking on his magic touch to help qualify Prague (Redoute's Choice) for Saturday week's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). The UK-based Marquand enjoyed a successful summer stint in Sydney, landing a stakes-winning double for the stable aboard Away Game (Snitzel) and Prague at Randwick last month before returning to England. He is back in town on Saturday to reunite with Prague in the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), while the trainers have also booked Marquand for Dottie Dee (Brazen Beau) in the Magic Night Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), although the filly is not entered for the \$3.5 million Golden Slipper. Marquand has five rides on Saturday, including Spanish Whisper (Lope De Vega) in the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m), while the 21-year-old will stick around to ride for Maher and Eustace in the Golden Slipper.

### McEvoy booked for Hanseatic

The Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) picture is starting to take shape with only nine days until the \$3.5 million juvenile feature. Jockey Kerrin McEvoy was expected to ride one of Peter and

Paul Snowden's youngsters in the race, but he has instead been confirmed for the Anthony Freedman-trained Hanseatic (Street Boss). Tim Clark takes the mount on the leading contender for the Snowdens, Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Dame Giselle (I Am Invincible), with Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Barbaric (I Am Invincible) also safely in the field for the stable. Hanseatic will trial at Randwick this morning, having arrived in Sydney last weekend. "It was always in the back of our mind to bring him up for the Slipper and have the month between runs after having three runs two weeks apart," said Freedman's racing manager Brad Taylor. "It is very similar to Lyre last year and she ran very well in the Slipper. It looks a good year for the Victorians to make their mark in Sydney."

### Rawiller happy to be on Bart

Jockey Brad Rawiller is adamant that veteran Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) can upstage his rivals, some of who are one-third his age, in the second running of the \$5 million All-Star Mile at Caulfield on Saturday. Black Heart Bart has won five Group 1 races at Caulfield, all with Rawiller in the saddle, most notably the Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) twice, including last year when on the comeback trail following retirement. The nine-year-old, these days trained by Lindsey Smith, received a wild card entry into the race. "He's deserving of his chance. I know he will make his presence felt," Rawiller said. "He'll give them a run for their money. Obviously it's such a star-studded field and it's not going to be an easy race, but he'll be in it. Obviously I won seven Group Ones on Weekend Hussler and I believe he is the best horse I've ridden, but Black Heart Bart is not far behind him. I actually believe he is going better than what he was in the spring."



## Streets Of Avalon right for Mile test

Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) won his way into the All-Star Mile (1600m) and his trainer Shane Nichols believes the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner is poised to run another bold race in the \$5 million event at Caulfield on Saturday. While his on-pace racing style was suited last start, Nichols still believes there was plenty of merit to the performance, with three other All-Star Mile contenders finishing behind him. "Obviously you had to be on the speed and close to the rail but he still ran 1:21.90," Nichols said. "That's the second fastest Futurity in 20 years. He jumped out, rolled along and gave them every chance to run him down at weight-for-age. The other horses were quite a distance away, so I just thought it was an outstanding effort." Nichols has decided to remove the blinkers from Streets Of Avalon who will instead race in winkers for the first time in a bid to run out a strong 1600m.

## Lindsay Park weighing up options for blueblood filly

Ready For Caviar (More Than Ready), the fourth foal of champion mare Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), is poised to make her debut this weekend - but where she runs is still up in the air. Ready For Caviar is an acceptor for the Redoute's Choice Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield on Saturday and is also nominated for an 1106m maiden at Benalla on Sunday. Ready For Caviar has had two Flemington jump-outs, winning the most recent of them on February 28. "She has trialled nicely but we're going to weigh things up whether we run at Benalla or on Saturday," Hayes said. "She's a chance of running at Caulfield and, with only eight runners, it is tempting. I always wanted to give her a soft kill, but when I saw how easily my filly Minhaaj won last week I thought the Black Caviar filly would have been in between them."

## Rothfire scares off rivals

Brilliant two-year-old Rothfire (Rothsay) has scared off many of his potential rivals, leaving the \$500,000 2YO Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast without a capacity field for the first time.

Rothfire will start a short-priced favourite on his undefeated run of four wins and will have only nine opponents on Saturday. The gelding has won his past three starts by a combined 15 lengths. Trainer Robert Heathcote makes no secret of the fact he has little luck at the Gold Coast but believes class will see Rothfire through no matter what the track. "My best win at the Gold Coast was with Buffering in the QTIS Magic Millions race and Rothfire is an exciting horse who, like Buffering, has been set for a big race," he said.

## Master Jamie out of Jewel

Star central Queensland galloper Master Jamie (Poet's Voice) will miss the \$300,000 QTIS 3YO Jewel (1200m) after contracting Ross River fever. Master Jamie has won 11 of his 14 starts and would have been one of the favourites for Saturday's race. Rockhampton trainer Graeme Green has plotted Master Jamie's campaign perfectly, giving the gelding a short break after his last-start win at Eagle Farm. But disaster struck early yesterday when Green checked on the gelding. "You wouldn't believe it, not 10 minutes after I accepted with him, his blood count came back and showed he had Ross River fever," Green said. "It is a 14-day treatment and then he should be OK. We are now looking at the winter carnival. Talk about having bad luck as everything was going so well."

## The Odyssey on track for lucrative race

Smart three-year-old The Odyssey (Better Than Ready) is the latest example of trainer Kelly Schweida's ability to find a bargain buy as the gelding heads towards another big win. The Odyssey will move within sight of \$1 million in earnings if he can win the \$300,000 3YO The Jewel (1200m). The gelding won the \$500,000 juvenile version of The Jewel last year. "I don't think we have seen the best of him yet. I would like to ride him off the pace as we were able to do with Better Than Ready," Schweida said. "He has been leading or on the pace in his wins and around the Gold Coast it will probably be the same. But we will get a chance to try him from further back at some stage."

## Etah James joins Maher and Eustace

Etah James (Raise The Flag) will head to a new stable when she crosses the Tasman again next week, joining the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace team for a tilt at the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on April 11. The seven-year-old had spent most of her career with Matt Cumani at Ballarat before joining part-owner Mark Lupton for a two-run New Zealand campaign, finishing third in the Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) before a game fourth to Roger That (Shinko King) in last Saturday's Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "Ciaran and Dave have a Sydney base at Warwick Farm, headed by Annabel Neasham and we have an existing relationship with the Maher-Eustace team," Lupton said. "Ciaran trained her half-brother Sniper a few years ago. I didn't want to send her back to Ballarat to target a couple of races in Sydney and I spoke to Matt, who we have a fantastic relationship with, and he was very understanding."

## Talented back bigger and stronger at Sandown

Talented has lived up to her name with a first-up Sandown midweek win over 1300m that may lead the filly to better races during the autumn. Andrew Angelone, in charge of the Snowdens' Melbourne stable, said there was a stark contrast between the filly that raced during the spring and the one that scored first-up on Wednesday. "Last prep she wasn't mature enough for those spring horses, wasn't strong enough," Angelone said. "If you saw a picture of her from last prep to this prep, she is a different horse." After a debut win at Geelong in January last year, the filly finished second to Microphone (Exceed And Excel) in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) before running third to Flit (Medaglia D'Oro) in the Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m), both at Flemington. On the strength of those performances, the Snowden stable aimed high last spring but she struggled to fire. "She's probably still eligible for a Benchmark 64 race, but there might be a nice city race here in Melbourne or even a stakes race over in Adelaide," Angelone said. "She was stakes-placed as a two-year-old, so it would be nice to get a stakes win for her future as a broodmare."

## I Am Invincible filly impresses

Chianti (I Am Invincible) shaped as a promising filly in the making when powering clear to a debut win in the Coolmore navy blue at Warwick Farm yesterday. The Kris Lees-trained Chianti received a stellar ride from Hugh Bowman, who hugged the rail just behind the leader before switching off heels upon straightening. Despite showing signs of greenness, she proved much too good for her rivals in the two-year-old maiden, scoring by nearly two lengths. Passed in with a reserve of \$500,000 at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, Chianti is the fourth winner for South African Group 3 winner Sweet Sanette (Jallad), who also raced with much success in Hong Kong for trainers Gary Ng and Tony Millard. The filly was also the 11th two-year-old winner this season for I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit).

## Blinkers aid Three Phase

Blinkers have contributed to Three Phase (Charge Forward) causing one of the biggest boilovers of the season at Doomben. The race was expected to be an easy win for favourite Minjee (Not A Single Doubt) who was backed from \$1.75 into \$1.28 on debut for trainer Robert Heathcote. However, Minjee was caught three deep for the entire race and tired to finish third behind 20/1 winner Three Phase for Murwillumbah trainer Matt Dunn. The handler said the filly had been unlucky at her first start when caught up in interference in the straight. "We put blinkers on her and she worked very strongly on Saturday morning so we were confident of a good run," Dunn said. The colts and geldings division of the two-year-old was also a disaster for favourite followers when Minjee's stablemate Better Get Ready (Better Than Ready) finished third behind debutant Clairvue Star (Sebring), the second foal to race of multiple stakes winner Missy Longstocking (Sequalo).

## Il Paradiso injured

Melbourne Cup placegetter Il Paradiso (Galileo) will not race again in 2020 after suffering a tendon strain. Trainer Chris Waller advised Racing NSW stewards on Wednesday that the horse had been spelled and would not be seen until next year after a "mild" near foreleg injury. Il Paradiso finished an unlucky

third to Vow And Declare (Declaration of War) in the Melbourne Cup under the care of Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien before being transferred to Waller. He was expected to step out for the first time for his new stable in the Sky High Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Rosehill on Saturday, but he was not among acceptances yesterday morning. He is the second major injury blow for Waller this autumn following the recent retirement of The Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick) due to a tendon sprain.

## \$95,000 mare Layo Layo to visit I Am Invincible

Encosta De Lago mare Layo Layo has topped Inglis Digital's March (Early) Online Sale, selling for \$95,000 on her way to a date with top stallion I Am Invincible. Layo Layo is out of the stakes-winning mare Tantra (Royal Academy), a sister-in-blood to Liberty Rose (Royal Academy) from the family of Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) and Widden Stakes (G3, 1200m) winner Away Game. She was offered by Richard McClenahan's Mullaglass Stud in foal to Press Statement (Hinchinbrook) and with her maiden filly by Hellbent (I Am Invincible) at foot, with Brett Gall of Gall Bloodstock eventually walking away with the mare. "I really liked the mare and she will go to our stallion I Am Invincible, who I raced with my father Ray and we still own 50% with Arthur and Harry Mitchell of Yarraman Park Stud," Gall said. "We scan through every catalogue when they come out as we're trading stock all the time and the three-in-one package was a big attraction with Layo Layo - plus I find the buying process very straightforward on the platform." The March (Early) Online Sale was the 12th consecutive Inglis Digital catalogue to gross more than \$1 million.

## Trainers, jockeys welcome new RV schedule

Trainers and jockeys have applauded a Racing Victoria (RV) initiative to ease the burden on key industry figures. RV will trial in the next two seasons a race and trial-free week during July and no race meeting on Christmas Eve, while an earlier finishing time for night meetings will start next month. Australian Trainers' Association President Robbie Griffiths and fellow trainer Henry Dwyer say the week off

will allow much-needed downtime from the racing schedule. "Anything in the interests of participant welfare is positive and a week off in the middle of winter is a good start," Dwyer said. "We are always working whether we are on holidays or not, but having a week off gives us something less to focus on. We'll probably be able to give staff some time off because we won't be sending horses to the races. We can't have the Hong Kong break, but it would be nice to give everyone the chance to freshen up and even the tracks a chance to recover."

## McEvoy to leave Widden

Respected Widden Stud stallion nominations and marketing manager Ryan McEvoy will leave the Thompson family-owned farm after 15 years. "It has been a great pleasure to watch the growth and development of Ryan in the bloodstock industry during his time with us and we wish him the very best in his future endeavours," Antony Thompson wrote to Widden Stud clients yesterday. "Ryan has been a key member of our team and we know he will always be a great friend to Widden." It is believed the Melbourne-based McEvoy will soon be joining a Victorian operation.

## Former Godolphin CFO joins Maher Racing

Andrew Wiles has been announced as Ciaron Maher Racing's new chief executive officer in what is being touted by the stable as "another significant step in the development of [Ciaron Maher Racing]". Wiles, a chartered accountant by trade, returns to Australia after six years as the chief financial officer for Godolphin worldwide. He was also involved in the integration of Darley Australia with Ingham Bloodstock, while he has served as director of Hunter Valley Thoroughbred Breeders in Australia and Fasig-Tipton in the United States. "Andrew's experience at the top of the leading racing business in the world, plus his experience here in Australia, is exactly what I have been looking for. I am really looking forward to what he can bring to the stable," said Maher, with Wiles adding: "I am thrilled to be back in Australia and particularly excited by the opportunity of working with Ciaron and his team who I consider to be the most dynamic and interesting stable in the country."

## Sawden withdraws appeal

Ballina trainer Andrew Sawden has withdrawn his appeal against a four-month disqualification and a \$1250 fine in a hearing at Racing NSW headquarters yesterday. Sawden was found guilty of two charges under AR228(c), conduct detrimental to the interests of racing, after two separate incidents that occurred in Ballina on January 14 and February 10. An application for a stay of proceedings was dismissed, leading to yesterday's appeal hearing. Following Stewards' submissions, Sawden's solicitor sought leave to withdraw the appeal. Sawden, disqualified since February 18, will be allowed to return to the training ranks on June 18.

## NEW ZEALAND

### Status quo for Little Avondale

Little Avondale Stud will hold the service fees of its three stallions for the next breeding season, the farm announced yesterday. Per Incanto (Street Cry) will stand at NZ\$17,500 (plus GST), Time Test (Dubawi) will remain at NZ\$10,000 (plus GST) and Nadeem (Redoute's Choice) is available at NZ\$5000 (plus GST). "Per Incanto has produced 22 stakes winners in the last 19 months, highlighted by Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Shadow's Cast and the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Santa Monica," Little Avondale's Sam Williams said. "We received really positive feedback on the first foals of Time Test and we believe as a Group 1 winning son of Redoute's Choice, Nadeem offers great value."

### Wide draws cause Ritchie a headache

A deflated Shaune Ritchie is pondering his options with his three intended Trentham runners on Saturday after all three drew the outside gate in their respective races, including New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) favourite Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle). Ritchie was also intending to send Swisswatch (Swiss Ace) for the Lightning Stakes

(Listed, 1200m) and Bella Mente (El Roca) for the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m), but he is now considering other plans for at least one of his runners. "I have got to confirm it with the owners, but Swisswatch is highly unlikely to run from that gate in the Lightning Stakes. As a sprinter it is a nightmare draw," he said. As for Jennifer Eccles, Ritchie will leave tactics to jockey Jason Waddell. "I am going to send a box of Panadol around to Jason because it is his headache, not mine. The horse is in superb order, but we would obviously have loved to have got some cover with her and that looks unlikely now. How Jason elects to ride her will be as interesting for me as anyone else in the grandstand. I have no intention of telling Jason whether to go forward, or back, or what to do. I will leave that up to him and I daresay, knowing Jason well, that he is likely to make that call when she leaves the barrier."

### Bar to be raised for Safe Passage

Well-bred filly Safe Passage (Snitzel) impressed on debut when winning the Tokoroa Cosmopolitan Club & Trees Tavern (1200m) at Matamata on Wednesday for trainers Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman. Raced by James Chapman's Jamieson Park, Safe Passage careered away to record a comfortable victory by almost four lengths. "It was a good win. She is a promising filly," Baker said. "She is nominated for the Manawatu Sires' (Gr 1, 1400m) so we will see how she comes through this and assess where we go next." Safe Passage is out of a Deep Impact half-sister to Grade One winner The Deputy (Petardia) and champion Japanese sire King Kamehameha (Kingmambo) and fetched NZ\$380,000 to the bid of bloodstock agent Bruce Perry and Jamieson Park at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

### Terracotta comes from last

Talented three-year-old filly Terracotta (Redwood) put on the after-burners to come from

last and land her first career win at the fifth time of asking at Matamata on Wednesday when taking out the Tirau Veterinary Centre Maiden (1200m). The Gerry Harvey-bred and raced filly had been building towards raceday success after finishing second in three of her four previous starts. "It was really encouraging the way she quickened home and they came home in sub 35 seconds and she has come from last," Andrew Scott, who trains the filly in partnership with Lance O'Sullivan, said. "There was a bit of merit to the win and she has been threatening to do that for a while. Hopefully now that she has got the monkey off her back she might crack on through the grades. She will appreciate a bit of sting out of the ground over the autumn months and although she has had a bit of a campaign, there is still a bit of her and she will carry on. Like many of the progeny of Redwood, Terracotta relished being ridden patiently, which both Scott and winning jockey Danielle Johnson said was the key to the filly.

## INTERNATIONAL

### Question mark hangs over public attendees at Dubai World Cup

The Emirates Racing Authority (ERA) is in a race against time to contest the Dubai World Cup meeting in front of a crowd at Meydan after it was revealed that the next four meetings in the United Arab Emirates would be conducted without spectators due to public safety measures related to the COVID-19 coronavirus outbreak. The ERA announced that the meetings at Meydan tonight, Al Ain tomorrow night, Abu Dhabi on Saturday and Jebel Ali next Friday would be held without attendees, with only horse connections, racing officials, sponsors and accredited media personnel to be permitted entry. Similar restrictions are currently also in place in Hong Kong and Japan. The Dubai World Cup meeting will be held at Meydan on March 28.

## New Zealand reforms one step closer, so what happens now?

**T**he legislative assisted reform of the New Zealand racing industry moved a step closer to fruition last week with the final submissions made to the Select Committee which will advise government.

This poses the following questions: what's been the process and what happens now? And what is the most critical element of the reform to an ailing industry which is significant not only from the domestic perspective, but to the broader health of the industry in the region?

The committee is charged with reporting to cabinet by April 17 with the hope that new

legislation, following a second reading, will be enacted by June or July this year according to Bernard Saundry, chief executive of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, who argues that wagering management, operation and structure is the key to reinvigoration.

"It is absolutely vital that we assess the best path forward in a joint venture with an international wagering operator and while the three codes here, which have pulled together, support the independence of a TAB board we need to be part of the process which ensures that people with the right skill sets are appointed," Saundry told ANZ Bloodstock News.

This is a stance supported by John Messara, acknowledging input from Craig Nugent

(retired Chief Operating Officer Wagering and Media, Tabcorp), who said last week: "I urge the industry to make a serious commitment to negotiate an advantageous TAB NZ outsourcing deal."

The process effectively began when Messara was commissioned to write a report on New Zealand racing which was tabled in August 2018 and preceded further comment and consultation; the creation of RITA (Racing Industry Transition Agency), which replaced the New Zealand Racing Board, and further assessment and amendment from the ministerial advisory committee.

Saundry said New Zealand's "lack of scale" was the simple driver behind the need for a



joint venture partner and this was one of the major points made in NZTR's submission to the Select Committee, which also outlined the challenges facing the New Zealand industry.

They included an ageing and increasingly no longer fit-for-purpose racing infrastructure; increasing fixed costs with relatively static revenues; a declining foal crop reflecting a lack of investment and confidence; regulatory arrangements that are not fit for purpose; and declining participation and relevance.

The last, of course, is not an issue exclusive to New Zealand, while a declining foal crop - in hand with the other challenges - is a long-term threat to the viability of an industry which continues to be a major nursery for Australian, Hong Kong and Singapore racing; continues to produce world-class competitors and adds to the diversity and dynamic of Australasian breeding and to the competitiveness of Australasian yearling sales.

"We need to address all of these issues and our report identified a focus on ownership and management of intellectual property rights, TAB governance and wagering operations and clarity of code functions and powers as keys towards revitalising our racing industry," he said. "Any evaluation of the existing model will tell you the model is broken. Past research by major accounting firms including Deloitte has identified the sizeable prize which can come from a wagering partnership in terms of costs and revenue. We simply lack the scale to make this happen alone."

The NZR submission noted that "the industry's ability to successfully respond to these challenges has been severely hampered by the failure of the wagering operator over many years to deliver adequate financial returns to the industry. This is fundamentally due to its lack of scale which constrains its ability to invest or to compete successfully with globally scaled operators, together with the delayed implementation of a betting information charge scheme for offshore operators."

Saundry said that the industry's problems were, in a nutshell, "financial".

"They are not organisational and they can't be solved by legislation alone. Finance is the key. It doesn't matter how the TAB is constituted, it lacks the scale to compete with

international operators for the international and domestic wagering dollar," he said.

"As it stands, we don't have the capital and revenues required to continually improve to deliver the returns required by the industry and its participants to increase stakes and improve tracks and facilities. Without a wagering partner, further decline would be inevitable," he said.

The lack of volume is illustrated by the fact that the elimination of the 4% wagering tax is only likely to deliver \$5 to \$6 million to racing, over three years, after distribution to the other codes and other sporting bodies. Race fields fees may provide a further, and greater, boost but only if current TAB investment is maintained (or grown).

Messara also followed up his report with a presentation, last week, to the Select Committee with something of a call to arms for the New Zealand industry which has been described as "terminal" by Racing Minister and Deputy Prime Minister Winston Peters (who commissioned the initial report).

"New Zealand racing was suffering from a paucity of revenue, shortage of capital and a sub-optimal governance structure, but I also felt that this situation could be righted with a reform program aimed at modernising the industry, introducing new revenue measures and maximising the use of existing assets," Messara said.

"I should advise that this is not a time for compromise on matters that go to the thoroughbred industry's sustainability and its independence from government. A number of the Review's modernisation recommendations relate to the devolution of power to the codes, and I still hold firmly to the belief that this notion is fundamental to the success of the reform package."

Messara also commented on the need for the significant rationalisation of NZ Thoroughbred Racing venues, estimating that total capital expenditure required to bring all 48 operating venues up to an acceptable standard in terms of tracks and facilities was \$294 million; for the 28 tracks recommended to be retained plus new synthetic tracks, the estimate was \$190 million.

Interestingly, he also conceded there was a case to be made for rationalisation of tracks in

New South Wales: "However, the extraordinarily strong financial position of racing in NSW has not made that an imperative. This is not the case in New Zealand."

Messara, in closing, said that: "The 17 recommendations in the Review were designed to work as a matrix to reverse the fortunes of your industry, and any significant departure from them will affect the ultimate outcome. Simply put, cherry-picking the reform program will compromise the future success and prosperity of the entire industry and... this is, quite literally, your industry's last chance to secure a vibrant & successful role in 21st-century racing."

More than 900 submissions will have significantly amended the proposed legislation and the racing world will await the imminent final draft and then, of course, implementation.

- The need for change is highlighted by some of the key metrics detailed by NZTR including:
- The thoroughbred foal crop has declined by 22.0% over the last 10 years and individual thoroughbred starters have declined by 18.6% over the same period.
- There are 16.8% fewer thoroughbred races run now compared to 10 years ago.
- More money is wagered on New Zealand racing through Australian wagering operators than through the NZ TAB and total wagering on New Zealand thoroughbred racing is well below the amounts wagered on thoroughbred racing in the major states of Australia. Currently, New Zealand thoroughbred racing has only a 2.4% share of the Australian thoroughbred betting market.
- Domestic turnover on thoroughbred racing has declined by 14.4% in 10 years and on-course attendance at thoroughbred meetings has fallen by 22.3% in the last six years.

"There is much to address and you never get 100% of your wish list in these matters but the overall view is positive in terms of the legislation after the review process," Saundry said.

The New Zealand Institute of Economic Research reported that the racing industry, in 2016-17, was responsible for generating more than \$1.6 billion in value-added contribution to New Zealand's economy and for sustaining around 14,400 full-time equivalent jobs.

# No 'seconds' regret for Moreira, Purton and Yiu strike

Joao Moreira and Zac Purton look set to trade blows right through to the season's end and the two champions were at it as usual at Happy Valley last night, snaring a double apiece.

Moreira bookended the card and headed home with his seven-win advantage still intact, with 35 of the season's 87 meetings still to go. And, as the Brazilian seeks to regain the title he has watched his rival lift at the end of each of the past two seasons, he was not concerned about three runner-up finishes that slipped by this evening on the heels of six frustrating seconds at Sha Tin on Sunday.

"I don't look at the seconds and think, what if? Seconds eventually turn to firsts!" he said.

Not even an unlucky whip 'drop', which arguably cost him victory in race four, could dampen his pleasure at snaring two more wins.

"The other jockey next to me knocked my whip out of my hand, so what could I do? I can't stop them waving their whips around, it happens - I've probably knocked someone else's whip in the past," he explained.

The three-time champion opened the night in excellent fashion, creeping through a sublime rail-shaving ride aboard Break Record (Casino Prince) in the Class 5 Wan Chai Gap Handicap (1650m). The 'Magic Man' stalked coolly in a three-back position and when those ahead of him shifted out on the turn for home, he urged the Danny Shum-trained four-year-old in pursuit, shouting and coaxing for the length of the straight to nick a short-head verdict.

"Gate one helped my horse a lot. We all know that on the 'C' Course the gap on the inside will appear when we turn for home and I gambled on that - luckily I was able to go through," he said.

The whip 'drop' incident came 200m out in section two of the Class 4 Tai Yuen Handicap (1200m), just as he was getting a grinding,

deep-closing drive out of the neck runner-up Victory Mastery (Foxwedge). Vincent Ho and his old boss Caspar Fownes took the spoils for their seventh win together this term thanks to top-weight E Master (Dreamscape).

But Moreira, in fine form even in defeat, wrapped the card with a punchy success on David Ferraris' terrier-like Blastoise (Ambidexter) in the Class 3 Queensway Handicap (1800m).

"What a brave little horse - he's small in size but he has a big heart. He got a perfect run through but he had so many horses attacking him once he got in front, but he just didn't give up. Good horses with big hearts don't give up," Moreira said.

## Purton's 50% strike

Purton too was in eye-catching form. The reigning champion's own double maintained his relentless pursuit of his trail-blazing rival. And, in Ricky Yiu, Purton may have a burgeoning ally through the back half of the season.

Yiu, setting the pace at the top of the

trainers' table, provided Purton with the second of his evening's scores, aboard Villa Fionn (Sebring) in section one of the Class 4 Thomson Handicap (1650m).

"Every time I put Zac on, I want it to be a decent chance, there's no point putting him on average rides, they need to be good rides, and so that's why he has a good percentage for me - 50 percent!" Yiu said.

The victory was Purton's second for Yiu this term, from only four rides.

"It would be nice if I could keep that up; maybe he needs to give me more rides!" Purton said.

Yiu has his own battle on his hands, with Francis Lui pressing closely for the trainers' title, but the handler admitted that he's happy to oblige Purton.

"Zac wants to keep his premiership so I'll give him a hand," he said, and then added: "Whoever comes along and is available, I don't mind who gets on my horses; it just depends on who approaches me first. Joao and Zac both are good riders."

Purton enjoyed a smooth break from gate two on Villa Fionn, settled in a midfield berth

on the rail, shifted out at the 400m point and rolled down centre-track to an authoritative one-length win.

"He was perfect today," the rider said. "He has a habit of being slow out of the gates and being out the back but he jumped brilliantly today and travelled like a winner the whole way. The pace was nice, he had a beautiful run and he came into it like he was going to win easily and he did that."

Earlier, Purton shone with a make-all ride on Mr Picasso (Exceed And Excel) in section one of the Class 4 Tai Yuen Handicap (1200m). The David Hall-trained seven-year-old defied top-weight of 133lb and won sweetly – the International Sale graduate's last three wins have come at the course and distance, off a rating of 60, and at the top of Class 4.

"I took my chance from that gate and went forward; I was lucky to get across; he's an old horse and he did a good job," the rider said.

Ho, fourth in the jockeys' standings, also left with a double. He was on the mark in section two of the Class 3 Johnston Handicap (1200m), partnering top-weight Massive Pocket (Stratum) to success for Lui, who remained one win behind Yiu in the long race for the trainers' premiership.

## Wong's the one for Speed

Last Sunday, Victor Wong enjoyed a first win since returning from injury and he followed up with a front-running score on the Frankie Lor-trained Speed Vision (Helmet) in section one of the Class 3 Johnston Handicap (1200m). The five-pound apprentice has been up top for each of the five-year-old's last four wins.

"This horse really likes this boy. This is four wins he's had – some jockeys suit a horse better

than other jockeys and this is one of those cases," Lor said.

"We can see in track work and in barrier trials that Victor is still probably not 100 percent but he's getting there and his confidence will get better now with his two wins."

Meanwhile, Shum had a double in his pocket before the night's midpoint, thanks to the success of Charity Wings (Bel Esprit) under Grant van Niekerk in race three, section two of the Class 4 Thomson Handicap (1650m).

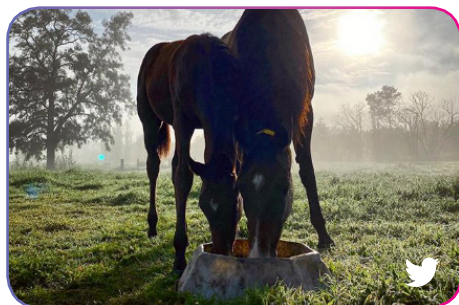

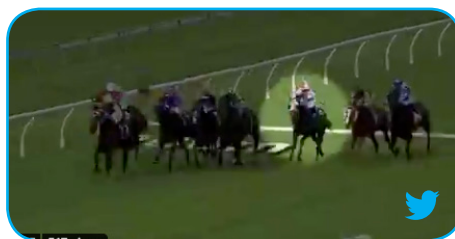

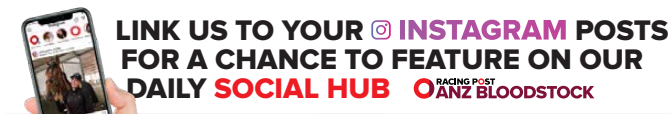
