Excel colt Exceeds online weanling record in Great Southern Sale

*Victorian vendors feel the brunt of lockdown with a limited
buying bench for trademark auction*

Vendors at this year's Inglis Great Southern Sale faced the brunt of Victoria's lockdown restrictions which disabled buyers inspecting stock across the state, however a colt by leading sire Exceed And Excel (Danehill) still managed to pull a good price as Wagga Wagga-based breeder Brett Bradley of Arlington Park Racing went to \$170,000 to secure the sale topper.

Consigned by Three Bridges Thoroughbreds as agent, the colt is out of winning mare Vicennalia (More Than Ready) and his half-brother by Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) sold at this sale last year for \$225,000.

"I was just having a look through the catalogue and came across this colt and really the main attraction was his sire Exceed And Excel, I've always wanted to send one of my mares to Exceed And Excel and it's never worked out for one reason or another," Bradley said.

"This colt was the best weanling in the sale so I knew we had to be strong and I didn't really look at anything else - the photos, videos and reports were very helpful, in fact even at a live sale I find any parade videos to be advantageous, it's like going back for your second and third looks.

"It's a fast, American pedigree - and it was good to see the dam's half sister Speaktomeofsummer win her second stakes race a few weeks ago - but for me it was all about Exceed And Excel.

"I haven't 100 per cent decided yet on the future plans for the colt, I'll get him to Kitchwin Hills first and have a good look at him, then discuss options with Mick Malone." *Continued on page 2>>*

<< *Continued from page 1* Bradley – a director of the Murrumbidgee Turf Club for almost a decade – moved to Australia from the United States 24 years ago and became interested in horses through his wife and friends.

“I honestly just really love horses, it’s evolved to an interest in breeding and I have a small collection of broodmares at Kitchwin Hills – while the name Arlington Park Racing comes from the town Arlington in Texas where I once lived,” Bradley said.

“I’m a fan of the Inglis Digital format, I have used it before and people are definitely getting more used to trading online, it’s like working from home how people are adapting – I’m happy with the process and the result.”

Three Bridges’ Toby Liston was pleased with the sale of the colt, who broke the Australasian record for a weanling sold online.

“It has been really good,” Liston said. “Obviously online is the future and the pandemic has brought these changes forward.

“I think with online sales, the more information you can give the buyers the better results you are going to have and our horses were for genuine sale and people felt they could buy with confidence.

“We sold two out of three of the horses, and I would think the other one will sell in the next day or so.

“We made a decision not to go to Sydney with our horses and I guess it has been rewarded. It is a terrific effort by Inglis, the team does a great job and the sales are a terrific example of the change in the industry that is coming.”

On the colt himself, Liston said: “I thought it was a very fair price for him, but we put him on the market early. He was a lovely horse and the brother made \$225,000 last year, but I guess this year is different with the world the way it is.

“I think it was a fair price, but in saying that I think the purchaser got a lovely colt from a big international family with very few risks. If they want to pinhook it and trade it they will make

money, but if they want to race it they will have a nice horse for the future. I think it is a win for us and a win for the purchaser which is a positive.”

Given the lockdown across Victoria, buyers have been unable to inspect stock at respective farms, but Liston said Three Bridges had successfully managed to navigate this and make the most of technology available.

“Our online presence has been good and we are pretty good with social media now, so people know what is for sale,” he said. “I guess it comes back to giving them all the information and making it as easy as possible to select your horse.

Dear Henry,

Tassort was an elite 2-year-old colt with legitimate Group 1 talent, which was well and truly on display the first time he stepped out at the races. His debut win at Rosehill returned a Group 1 class 103 WFA Performance Rating, stamped by a sharp turn of foot, terrific late strength and fast overall time.

Over the past 5 seasons, just 0.16% of 2-year-olds colts have been able to run a peak rating of 103 or higher at any stage in the season. That's a total of just 5 from 3,030 individual Colts to race (including Tassort).

To put his debut performance into context of the 2018/2019 season, Kiamichi won the G1 Golden Slipper with a 103.3 rating. Microphone won the G1 Sires' Produce Stakes with a 102 rating and Castelvechio won the G1 Champagne Stakes with a 102 rating. All of them had the benefit of a number of runs to reach that peak.

Historically, Tassort's debut 103 rating compares to the likes of:

- Capitalist: ran a 102 on debut and later won the G1 Golden Slipper with a 104.7 rating
- Estijaab: ran a 102 on debut and later won the G1 Golden Slipper with a 103.3 rating
- Extreme Choice: ran a 103 on debut and later won the G1 Blue Diamond with a 106 rating, followed by the G1 Moir Stakes as a three-year-old with a 105 rating.

There is no doubt in my mind that had Tassort not gone amiss after the Silver Slipper, he would have proven himself to have elite ability on the racetrack.

"We have all our x-rays online, we have a report online, with the agent's opinion and Inglis' opinion, a good video and conformation shots. We only had eight people come to inspect the horse, so to sell it for that is a true testament to where Inglis Digital is currently at."

Catalogued as **Lot 703**, the colt is the third foal out of Vicennalia, who was purchased by Paul Willetts Bloodstock for \$400,000 at the 2017 Magic Millions Broodmare Sale after originally being secured by Sheamus Mills Bloodstock and Yulong Investments for 80,000gns at the 2016 Tattersalls July Sale.

She is out of dual stakes scorer Silver Reunion (Harlan's Holiday), making her a half-sister to Grade 2 winner Speaktomeofsummer (Summer Front) and Listed scorer Proud Reunion (Proud Citizen). Further back, this is also the family of late stallion Comic Strip (Red Ransom) and champion sprinter Lucayan Prince (Fast Play).

Vicennalia's first foal, the unraced three-year-old filly Hare (Frankel), is in training with Lindsey Smith, while her second foal - a colt by pensioned Arrowfield sire Not A Single Doubt - sold at last year's Great Southern Weanling and Bloodstock Sale for \$225,000 to Fernrigg Farm. She is currently in foal to Dundee (High Chaparral).

The Vicennalia colt is one of 64 horses to sell for \$100,000 or more on the Inglis Digital platform since 2018, while the August (Early) Sale is the seventh consecutive to gross \$2 million or more.

Overall, the sale had a 70 per cent clearance rate and grossed more than \$3 million.

Burnewang North feel the brunt of weak market

Lot 602 Caravaggio - National Velvet colt

Burnewang North presented a high class draft at the sale, including the equal second top lots - colts by former Coolmore shuttler Caravaggio (Scat Daddy) and late Widden sire Sebring (More Than Ready) who sold for \$90,000 apiece, but the Victorian farm's owner Cathy Hains was disappointed with their overall results amid the difficult time in the world.

"These are difficult times," Hains said. "We completely anticipated that people in every area of business and life in general are facing some real challenges at the moment so a non-essential, a luxury item like horses is going to represent a challenge."

"A couple of our horses sold okay. We're disappointed across the board at the results."

"We had a pretty outstanding draft but that's for us to say and unless the potential buyers are able to view them, we completely accept that it's very difficult to buy them. I think the limited interest in them online is evident in the prices."

"I think that from the top down to the lesser end, these horses at a normal auction would've bought considerably more money. 30, 40, 50 per cent, I don't know but we've passed in a few and we'll wait and see what we do with them but my opinion is very guarded."

"I think it was always going to be a difficult sale and that's what it turned out to be.

"It's been a huge road to the end result because we would've loved to have sold them in June onsite, and then we accepted that the sale would be pushed out to July, and then we accepted of course that with the Covid problems in Melbourne that we were pushed to go to Sydney. But that all fell in a heap so it's really been a whole set of very unsettling circumstances but we're able to absorb all of that.

"There's plenty of other businesses that are in a lot more trouble than us, and whilst we're disappointed and it's been detrimental to our results, there's a lot worse problems out there.

"I do understand it's a luxury buying horses and a lot of people aren't looking at that kind of investment right at the moment.

"We are very pleased the horses that sold went to discerning judges and look forward to their progress."

Following an active year at the yearling sales, Ciaran Maher went to \$90,000 for the Caravaggio (Scat Daddy) colt after being impressed by the stallion when seeing him at Coolmore in Ireland.

"I saw Caravaggio at Coolmore when I was travelling around and I really liked him then and thought he had the right credentials, but I also really liked the horse as an individual," Maher said.

"I'm not too sure what we are going to do, but we really liked the horse and a few clients were keen so we thought, why not?"

Catalogued as **Lot 602**, the colt is the second foal out of winning mare National Velvet (Commands).

Her first foal, a filly by Nicconi (Bianconi), was passed in for \$175,000 at this year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale after being purchased

National Velvet is out of Nonchalance (Lonhro), making her a half-sister to Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) fourth Niccolance (Nicconi). Further back, this is also the family of Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Complacent

(Authorized), Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) scorer Dracula (Quest For Fame) and New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) victor Sentimental Miss (Reliable Man).

Maher also snapped up another colt in their draft, a Dundee (High Chaparral) youngster out of Blendwell (Hard Spun) for \$70,000. He was catalogued as **Lot 742**.

The second colt, who was catalogued as **Lot 508**, sold for \$90,000 and is by Sebring out of unraced mare Midnight Fantasy (Commands), who herself is a daughter of Group 1 winner Ancient Song (Canny Lad), making her a half-sister to stakes performers Tampiko (Lonhro) and War Hero (Sepoy).

Further back, this is also the family of champion stayer and multiple Group 1 scorer Preferment (Zabeel) as well as Group winners Rezoned (Zabeel) and Is Amazing (Laranto).

Hydro Star set for Vain Stakes

Raw talent may be enough to see exciting colt Hydro Star (Headwater) play a big part in Saturday's Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) with trainer John McArdle describing the three-year-old as a 'big baby'. The son of Headwater (Exceed And Excel) caught the eye when charging home from the rear to convincingly win on debut at Sandown last month and makes the step up to Group 3 company at Caulfield at just his second start. "We've never been to the bottom of him, he's an exciting colt but he's still very new," McArdle said to Racing.com. "But would it shock me if he won this weekend or a race this spring? It certainly wouldn't. If the penny drops even a little bit it might just be enough to get him over the line." Hydro Star, who cost just \$15,000 out of the Inglis Classic Sale, will be nominated for both the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1200m), with the latter the most likely port of call.

Vain test for Ranting

Zoustar (Northern Meteor) colt Ranting looks set to continue in Group company, despite still holding his maiden status, with jockey Dwayne Dunn having confidence that the three-year-old can be competitive in the Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) on Saturday. Dunn rode the Troy and

Leon Corstens-trained colt on debut, finishing second at Caulfield prior to his third-placed finish in the Breeders Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m), and points to his recent trial as evidence that he is up to the challenge. "He has trialled up really well and turned from a boy into a man," Dunn said to Racing.com. "They could have taken the soft option and gone into a maiden and he would have got that job done. But I think he's going well enough to go to the Vain Stakes." Ranting's dam, Vanilla Ice Cream (More Than Ready), was purchased for \$280,000 at the recent Magic Millions Broodmare sale.

Smith changes up training for Adelaide Ace

Adelaide Ace (Savabeel) has been putting a nice record together of four wins from nine starts for trainer Lindsey Smith, and stretched out to a mile and a quarter when second in the Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m) at Moonee Valley. However, the trainer believes he is best suited at a shorter trip. "As a three-year-old you always try to see how far they can go when they show staying ability," Smith said to Racing.com. "I think a mile to 1800 metres is the perfect distance for him, so we'll train him for that this preparation and try to keep him with a turn of foot." The four-year-old holds a nomination for Saturday's Hyland Race Colours Handicap (1400m) and Smith is plotting a route to

the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) for the Group 2 winner.

Holyfield can send Neasham out a winner

Annabel Neasham will saddle up her final runners as assistant trainer to the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace stable on Saturday before she embarks on her own training career, and is hoping Group 3 winner Holyfield (I Am Invincible) can send her off a winner in the Up and Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m). "He looks like a real Guineas sort of horse," said Neasham. "He will improve off what he does and he will improve the further he goes, but even so, he should give a good account of himself first up." Holyfield will face eight rivals in the Randwick feature after acceptances yesterday.

Behemoth to kick off in Spring stakes

The David Jolly-trained Behemoth (All Too Hard) will stay in Adelaide this weekend after an improvement in the weather should see the son of All Too Hard (Casino Prince) avoid a wet track and take on the Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). "We were nervous about potentially being faced with a Heavy track at Morphettville, but the weather looks better so we'll stay at home this weekend," Jolly said to Racing.com. The handler has Group 1 aspirations for the five-year-old, with this weekend's performance dictating his spring program. "This weekend will tell us a lot, then we'll decide whether we keep him at Listed level second-up or whether we put him up against the big guns in the Memsie," he said. "While I think a race like the Group 1 Toorak Handicap could potentially be his grand final, we won't rule out potentially heading to Sydney following his good performances last year."

Barman brother wins at Sandown

His revered half-brother was renowned for his exploits over a staying trip, winning a Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) and placed in a Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), however Ears The Barman (Ghibellines) is turning out to be a very different prospect to Who Shot Thebarman (Yaminin Vital) after claiming a second career victory over 1300 metres at Sandown yesterday. "Speaking to the owners I thought he would run a good race today, I wasn't expecting him to win but I thought he was a top-three chance and Luke (Nolen) gave him a lovely ride," trainer Phillip Stokes said to Racing.com. Ears The Barman is the seventh foal out of Ears Carol (Carolingian) with six of his siblings winning beyond the mile. "Last time in we stepped him up to 1700 metres and we walked away scratching our heads," Stokes said. "You would think on pedigree he would get over a trip, I had always thought that, but maybe he's a better fresh horse kept to this trip."

Leneva Park to stand Lucas Cranach

Luke Vandersluys' Leneva Park will host its first stallion when Lucas Cranach (Mamool) makes the short move from Bullarook Stud. Lucas Cranach claimed two Group 2 wins in Germany and Australia in an injury-shortened career, and has sired 42 winners in seven years at stud. He will stand for a fee of \$5,500 (inc gst) in 2020. Vandersluys purchased the property in 2019 and has invested in stallion shares for Rosemont's Strasbourg (I Am Invincible) and Swettenham's I Am Immortal (I Am Invincible).

Sherry celebrates another Sydney milestone

Apprentice Tom Sherry is continuing his fruitful start to the new season, claiming a double at Warwick Farm yesterday. Sherry teamed up with his master Mark Newnham to

claim a first metropolitan win on the opening day of the new season aboard Fulmina (Snitzel) and struck a race-to-race double at Warwick Farm, winning on Bothered (Shamexpress) before steering favourite Wander (Lonhro) to victory for Richard Litt. A four-time winner in New Zealand, Bothered remains unbeaten in two starts for trainer Clare Cunningham after relishing Wednesday's heavy conditions. "She just travelled so well. She feels very comfortable in the going which is a big help," Sherry said.

Williams returns to the fold at Caulfield

Champion jockey Craig Williams will return to race riding at Caulfield on Saturday after a three-week absence, where he will attempt to win the P B Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on Morrissey (Snitzel). "He's well set up for a race like this. He's racing well and he should be ultra competitive," said Williams, who has four further rides at Caulfield. He has also become acquainted with several potential stars of the spring, including Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) and Vow and Declare (Declaration of War). "I've got to say the horse I'm most excited about riding going into the spring is Loving Gaby," Williams said. "She's quite relaxed and she looks bigger and stronger. We know what she can do and if she's come on physically and mentally, which I think she has, she's going to be a really exciting sprinter. Vow And Declare looked good and felt happy. He's in a good spot."

Rawiller lodges appeal against riding ban

Nash Rawiller has appealed against the punishment which sees him banned until the start of September after being found guilty of careless riding and for breaching the whip rules at Rosehill last Saturday, ruling him out of the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on August

22. Rawiller was also ordered to see a sports psychologist. His appeal will be heard on Friday, a day after Adam Hyeronimus faces charges of providing false or misleading evidence to stewards as part of a betting inquiry. Hyeronimus was last month charged with 30 betting offences and faces a minimum two year disqualification.

NEW ZEALAND

Sydney off for Jennifer Eccles

New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) will not make the trip to Sydney to contest the upcoming spring features, but trainer Shaun Ritchie indicated he may still target the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) after looking to races closer to home. "We have elected not to campaign Jennifer Eccles in Sydney," Ritchie told the NZ Racing Desk. "We would need to get into Victoria, which is not open anyway. We have got a lot of options in front of us with the likes of the Cox Plate or the Mackinnon (Stakes) and felt that a hit-and-run with the mare in Australia might be better than just campaigning."

Catalyst pleases in trial

New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) Catalyst (Darci Brahma) warmed up for his Sydney campaign in good order after winning an 1100-metre trial at Taupo yesterday. Trainer Clayton Chipperfield was encouraged by the run, and said there was more to come from the four-year-old. "To see him bounce out of the gates like that and put himself right there was quite encouraging going forward with the Australian plans," he said. Catalyst will link up with the Tony Pike team in Sydney and Chipperfield still has his eyes on a berth in The Everest (1200m) in October. "At this stage he is due to fly out on the 14th of September and his first start will be the 19th (in The Shorts)," added Chipperfield.

Richards pleased with star triallers

Te Akau trainer Jamie Richards was pleased with what he saw from his contingent of trialists at Taupo yesterday, where multiple Group 1 winner Advantage (Fastnet Rock) took 1100-metre trial. “She is coming up really nicely,” said Richards. “She is a good mare. Opie was really pleased with how she felt and she is on track to head to the Foxbridge and then the first couple of legs at Hastings.” Scott Base (Dalghar), who finished fourth in the trial, will also follow the same route, while in an earlier trial Richards was pleased by Group 1 performers In A Twinkling (Fastnet Rock) and Prise De Fer (Savabeel). “I thought In A Twinkling trialled really nicely,” he said. “He is a horse who has had a few little problems. He seems to have come back well. He will trial again and then we will find a suitable race to kick him off in and hopefully end up in the 2000 metres race at Hastings on the last day.” On Prise de Fer, he added: “Prise De Fer also trialled well. If anything he looks like he might be a little more settled this year.” Cambridge Stud-owned Vernazza (More Than Ready) will be Sydney bound after her hit-out on Wednesday. “She will trial the week after that on the 25th (of August) and all going well she will follow a similar path to what Probabeel did last spring. Two runs into the Flight Stakes, all going well.”

Regional roadshows postponed

Following a return to alert level 2 and 3 restrictions, New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing has decided to postpone the regional roadshows scheduled in the South Island this week. The situation will be monitored, with a decision on the meetings due to be held in North Island from August 24 to be made at a later date. “While we understand that stakeholders and participants may find this disappointing our focus currently must remain on doing everything we can to ensure race meetings, trials and training can continue,” NZTR said in a statement.

Meetings to be run behind closed doors

Following a meeting between NZTR, stewards and club representatives it has been decided that Wednesday’s meeting at Taupo and Friday’s at Waverley will be closed-door events. While gatherings of up to 100 people are permitted under alert level 2, the short lead in time to allow for preparations led to the decision to return to closed-door meetings to protect industry participants. Contact tracing, temperature checks, social distancing and encouraging the liberal use of hand sanitizer will also be reintroduced at these meetings. NZTR stated: “At this stage we have made the decision, following discussion with stewards and club representatives, to hold today’s Taupo meeting and Friday’s Waverley meeting behind closed doors.”

Laburnum is the tenth foal out of the Robert Sangster-owned mare Secret Garden (Danehill), with four now stakes winners, including Irish 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Roderick O’Connor (Galileo).

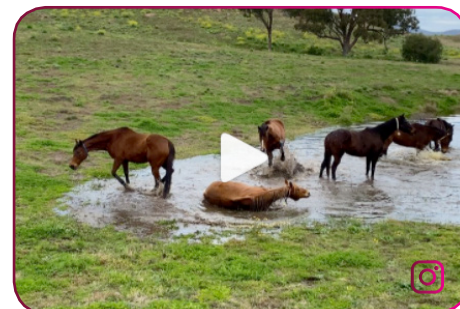
