## **Star and Marquand shine** bright in rescheduled **Inglis Millennium**

China Horse Club-owned colt provides Freedman brothers with their biggest success as a training duo to cap big week for Fairview Park Stud

wenty-four hours on from a successful foray at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, the China Horse Club and their head of bloodstock Michael Wallace saw the investment made at last year's auction bear fruit as Prime Star (Starspangledbanner) landed the rescheduled

Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) at Warwick Farm.

Wallace signed for three high-priced lots across at this year's Classic sale, spending \$450,000 on two colts in conjunction with Newgate Bloodstock and \$320,000 alongside both Newgate and Starlight Racing for a highlyprized son of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) on Sunday. Continued on page 2>>

#### **Aquis and Australian Bloodstock combine to secure** high-class sprinter Graff

Group 1-placegetter Graff (Star Witness) has been acquired by Aquis Farm and Australian Bloodstock as a racing and breeding prospect and will stand at Aquis when his career on the track concludes.

Replicating the partnership that combined to race dual Group 1 winner and Aquis' current Hunter Valley resident Brave Smash (Tosen Phantom), Graff will continue to be trained by Kris Lees and is likely to resume in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) at Rosehill on March 21. Stud News page 8 >> << Continued from page 1 However, it was the relatively cheap Prime Star - a \$55,000 purchase alongside co-trainer Michael Freedman at the corresponding auction in 2019 - who grabbed the lion's share of yesterday's \$2 million prize for his syndicate headed by the China Horse Club, providing Freedman and his brother Richard with their biggest success as a training duo in their first full season in partnership together.

The Inglis Millennium had originally been programmed for Saturday, but was washed away by the torrential rainfall that hit Sydney towards the end of last week. With the wet weather persisting, yesterday's meeting was only given the green light following a further inspection on race-day morning.

As such, Prime Star's victory was achieved by a neck in atrocious underfoot conditions, but the win was another feather in the cap of visiting British rider Tom Marquand, whose successful Sydney stint also includes a Group 3 double on the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained duo Away Game (Snitzel) and Prague (Redoute's Choice) on February 1.

Their stable companion Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook), who had been red-hot favourite for the Inglis Millennium following her six-length Rosehill romp last month, was predictably scratched at the eleventh-hour, as Maher suggested she would be, with the promising juvenile set to line up in Saturday week's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m).

Her defection gave yesterday's contest an open look and the finish was dominated by on-speed horses who were deep in the betting, with \$18 chance Prime Star getting the better of the Lindsay Park-trained Bella Nipotina (Pride Of Dubai) (\$8.50).

Larimer Street (Brazen Beau) (\$19) was a further length back in third for Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young, while \$4.40 favourite Marnix (Written Tycoon) ran tenth for Godolphin, beaten seven and threequarter lengths.

There was drama before the race with Fayerra (Valentia) and Slice Of Heaven (Rubick) both being scratched late at the barrier, but Marquand acknowledged how the heavy 9 surface was the crucial factor in determining yesterday's result.

"To be fair, it was in the lap of the gods today as to what handled the ground," he said.

"Credit where credit's due, they brought the horse here and were ballsy enough to give it a go and it's paid off."

Marquand, who will return to Britain following Saturday's meeting at Randwick, is set to fly back to Australia next month with a view to riding in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Rosehill on March 21, a trip that could be extended with momentum on his side.

"I'm planning a bit of a return around the middle of March, currently for a week but it may be a good bit longer, all being well," he said.

"There are some massive targets and while I'm getting the opportunities I may as well make hay while the sun shines."

A jubilant Michael Freedman suggested the blinkered Prime Star, who cornered three-deep yesterday and showed a fine attitude for a two-yearold, is unlikely to make next month's Golden Slipper, for all the progressive juvenile is now set for a rise in class.

"For a \$55,000 purchase last year, it's just a big thrill for Richard and I and all the team back at home," Freedman said.

"We will have to rethink what we do with him from here. If he comes through today OK we will certainly look at some of the upcoming twoyear-old races.

"He's probably still a long way off getting into a Slipper or anything like that, but there are lots of races for two-year-olds outside the Slipper."

Like the \$320,000 Deep Field colt purchased by Wallace, Newgate and Starlight, Prime Star was offered by Fairview Thoroughbreds, who sold 13 of their 14 offered yearlings for an aggregate of \$1,208,000 at this year's Classic sale.

"Classic is our main sale so to produce the winner of the Millennium in just its second year is a real feather in our cap," Fairview Park's Linda Duckworth said.

"Like everyone you work hard, it's just great, great for the team, great for the farm and I'm super excited for the breeders Chris and Lynne Lawlor, who are fantastic clients of ours."

Breaking his maiden at his fourth start yesterday, Prime Star (2 g Starspangledbanner - Barinka by Shinko King) has now amassed \$1,209,000 in prize-money having finished second on a further two occasions.

He is the best-performed of four winners out of Barinka (Shinko King), who numbered among her eight victories a neck success in the 2011 running of the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

This is also the family of Group 2 winner Tawlord (Tafiq) and Singapore stakes scorer Ferrous Cardio (Amyntor).

Rather fittingly, Barinka has a filly foal by Deep Field and was served by Dundeel (High Chaparral) on November 30. Her yearling filly by Kermadec (Teofilo) will be offered at next month's Inglis Premier Yearling Sale, going through the draft of Maluka Thoroughbreds as Lot 43. *Continued on page 4>>*

#### Progressive Rubisaki sprints to big pay-day

Improving filly Rubisaki (Rubick) came with a withering late surge to land yesterday's \$1 million Inglis 3YO Sprint (1200m) later on the Warwick Farm card.

Trained by Patrick Payne, last season's Taj Rossi Series Final (Listed, 1600m) runner-up appeared to be in a compromising position at halfway, but she went from seventh to first within the space of 200 metres and eventually won eased-down by a length and a half under Billy Egan.

Returning the \$3.30 favourite following a first-up success in a Flemington handicap last month, Rubisaki has now won five of her seven starts. She proved too strong for the Gregory Hickman-trained Rari (Sizzling) (\$14) yesterday, with Chris Waller's True Detective (Shamus Award) (\$4.80) a further neck away in third.

"She was really suited to the speed and the drop back in distance. The little freshen up and the travel up here really brought her on, so credit to Paddy," Egan said before dashing off to Melbourne to ride the unplaced Keymaster (Oratorio) at Sandown's twilight fixture.

"She is an absolute sweetheart and she gives you everything she's got so she deserved it."

Part-owner Joe O'Neill suggested Rubisaki could press on to the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on February 29 if the wet weather continues, while Payne admitted he was uncertain as to whether Rubisaki was capable of cutting it with yesterday's opposition. "She's got good ability. I wasn't sure if she was quite up to the class but her attitude just carries her a long way," Payne said.

Rubisaki (3 f Rubick - Senro Kisaki by Danehill Dancer) was purchased by Prime Thoroughbreds at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale in 2018, realising \$85,000 from the draft of Edinburgh Park. She has now

accrued \$853,800 in prize-money, while Prime Thoroughbreds purchased four yearlings at this year's Classic sale for an aggregate of \$450,000.

From the first crop of Coolmore stallion Rubick (Encosta De Lago), who is also the sire of recently-retired The Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes, Rubisaki is one of four named foals, all of whom have won, out of the two-time winner Senro Kisaki (Danehill Dancer).

Her second dam, Liefling (Alleged), is a winning half-sister to French stakes scorer River Cara (Irish River).

Since foaling Rubisaki, Senro Kisaki has produced a yearling colt by Sizzling (Snitzel) and a filly foal by So You Think (High Chaparral). She was served again by Rubick on December 13.

#### 12 for Starspangledbanner

Rosemont Stud resident Starspangledbanner (Choisir) landed his twelfth individual stakes winner yesterday when Prime Star (2 g ex Barinka by Shinko King) took out the Inglis Millenium (RL, 1100m) at Warwick Farm. Starspangledbanner covered 83 mares at a fee of \$22,000 (inc. GST) last year and is resurgent as a sire having suffered from fertility issues early in his career. The fourtime Group 1 winner, who is also the sire of late Swettenham Stud shuttler The Wow Signal, has five lots catalogued at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale next month.

#### **Two for Akeed Mofeed**

Swettenham Stud-based stallion Akeed Mofeed (Dubawi) landed his second individual stakes winner vesterday when the Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Jyoti (2 f ex She Can Skate by Bradbury's Luck) took out the Gold Sovereign (Listed, 1220m) at Launceston. Ridden by Jamie Kah, the two-year-old filly defeated Gee Gee Josie (Wordsmith) by a neck with the Lindsay Park-trained Avenue Of Pleasure (I Am Invincible) the same margin back in third. Bred by Goldin Farms, Jyoti is the second foal and second winner out of AR Creswick Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner She Can Skate (Bradbury's Luck), who was purchased by Goldin Farms for \$210,000 at the 2015 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. She returned to the same sale in 2019 where she was knocked down to Colm Santry Bloodstock for \$45,000. Akeed Mofeed stands for a fee of \$15,000 (plus GST) and has seven lots on offer at next month's Inglis Premier Yearling Sale.

#### Field of seven for Lightning

Seven runners are set to line up in Saturday's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington, headed by VRC Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Nature Strip (Nicconi), who has drawn barrier five and will be partnered by James McDonald. Also set to feature are VRC Classic runner-up and Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), dual Everest (1200m) winner Redzel (Snitzel) and Goodwood Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Despatch (Written Tycoon).

#### **Despatch ready for Group 1**

Despite his outsider status in the Lightning Stakes, co-trainer Calvin McEvoy insists Despatch is worthy of his place in the Group 1 sprint. "It looks a nice target to start off this weekend although he is a better 1200-metre horse," McEvoy said. "It's a small field, with quite a bit of quality, but he is a Group 1 winner and has earned a go at a race like this. But he'll improve out of it on whatever he does." McEvoy added that Despatch performed creditably in a jump-out over 800 metres at Flemington last week. "He had a good, healthy blow but it would have cleaned him up nicely for this weekend," he said. "We'll learn a bit more on Saturday but races like the William Reid at The Valley might be the next target and then possibly aim him back at The Goodwood, which looks his most suitable race."

#### **Dalasan primed for Guineas warm-up**

Eight runners have accepted for Saturday's traditional Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) lead-up race, the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington. They include Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) runner-up Dalasan (Dalakhani), who is out for redemption after a luckless Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) run. "I think it's a very hard race and we're looking forward to the clash," co-trainer Leon Macdonald said. "You go back to the Caulfield Guineas Prelude, maybe Dalasan should have won that. Alligator Blood has been very good since then. He's a very good horse and then you've got the New Zealander (Catalyst) thrown in there as well. It's against top-class horses, obviously, but we're hopeful that things go right for us and if they do, I'm sure he's very well suited at Flemington. So we go in there hoping."

#### **Futurity next for Seth**

Dalasan's CS Hayes task got significantly easier when connections of the Anthony Freedmantrained Caulfield Guineas winner Super Seth (Dundeel) decided to bypass Saturday's race in favour of the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield the following week. Caulfield Guineas third and stablemate of Super Seth, Groundswell (Fastnet Rock), will also bypass the CS Hayes. "Both Super Seth & Groundswell will bypass Saturday's CS Hayes," Freedman Racing said on Twitter. "Super Seth will be given his opportunity in two G1s (Futurity & Randwick Guineas), meaning he is likely to bypass the Australian Guineas. Groundswell will run next Saturday in G3 Zeditave Stakes at Caulfield."

#### Katalin set for stakes test

Undefeated Godolphin filly Katalin (Medaglia d'Oro) will make her first start in stakes company when she contests The Vanity (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday. The three-year-old began her career with a narrow win in a 1200-metre Warwick Farm Maiden against her own age and sex last month before striding clear to win a Class 1 over 1400 metres at Newcastle by almost four lengths on January 25. "Two impressive wins from two outings has earnt this filly a trip south and a crack at blacktype in this Group 3 event," James Cummings said. Katalan will face Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Pretty Brazen (Brazen Beau) and Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Fascino (Charm Spirit), who are both resuming since last spring.

## Black Caviar's nephew to debut at Flemington

Set to debut in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Flemington on Saturday is a twoyear-old colt out of Naturale (Bel Esprit), who is a sister to Black Caviar. Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) is trained by Team Hawkes and has had two trials down the Flemington straight, finishing fifth and fourth respectively. He was sold for \$675,000 at the 2019 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale and is part-owned by Neil Werrett, who had shares in Black Caviar, and Gilgai Farm, who bred the champion mare.

#### Darose to make Sydney debut

After steering Jungle Edge (Dubawi) to victory in the WJ Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and landing her first stakes win, dual-license holder Jade Darose will make her riding debut in Sydney this weekend as the wettrack specialist lines up the Southern Cross Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Randwick. Trainer Mick Bell said he was pleased to offer Darose



the ride again. "It's a great part of a great story that Jade won on him and I reckon we'll get the conditions (heavy track) and he'll be really hard to beat again."

## Heathcote set to saddle progressive Rothfire

Robert Heathcote is set to present undefeated gelding Rothfire (Rothesay) with his biggest test in the \$125,000 Two-Year-Old Handicap (1000m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. "He needs to run and Saturday's race is worth \$97,000 to the winner with the QTIS bonus," Heathcote said. "It is a good field on Saturday and this will be a good test for him. Robbie Fradd, who has been riding Rothfire, rates him very highly and hopefully he will live up to that on Saturday." Rothfire, who won an Eagle Farm handicap by six lengths on November 2, is being set on a campaign towards the \$500,000 The QTIS Jewel (1200m) on March 14.

#### Pike lands Oakleigh Plate ride

Star Western Australia jockey William Pike has been locked in to ride the John McArdle-trained Humma Humma (Denman) in Saturday week's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) at Caulfield. "He (Pike) was coming across anyway, he was available and Dwayne Dunn couldn't make the 52 kilograms she is most likely to get," McArdle said. "We were limited with options with the weight and a lot of horses (in the Oakleigh Plate) would be down in the weights. So when he said he was coming over we thought we'd give him a shot. She is a pretty strong mare, so someone that is at full strength (at that weight) certainly (is beneficial)."

#### Bright future tipped for Cloudbreaker

Cloudbreaker (Fastnet Rock) might not be in Lindsay Park's top echelon of two-year-olds but after the filly's metropolitan win at Sandown yesterday, co-trainer Ben Hayes believes there could be some bigger and better things in store for her in the future. "We were going to run her on the 19th (February) but she had done so well that we decided to come to this race," Hayes said. "It was a good decision as she is now a city winner. We've got the luxury now of throwing her in the deep end in something like the Thoroughbred Breeders or the Sires' Produce. On the corner she hit a flat spot but she picked up and I thought the strongest part of her race was the end. I think the way she won today stepping up to 1400 (metres) won't be an issue."

#### Sandown double for Busuttin and Young

After narrowly missing out in the Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) with Larimer Street (Brazen Veau), who finished third by a neck, Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young landed a consolation double at Sandown yesterday. "I've been nauseous all day," Young said of Larimer Street's defeat. "It was just one of those things and a nano-second later that gap opened up and had he poked through it, who knows. Glen Boss came in and said he was a bit unlucky and probably should have won. I would have taken the \$2 million win to be honest, but to get a city double is a nice consolation. At least it shows when Trent goes away I can still get the job done here."



#### **Three suspended** at Warwick Farm

Three of Sydney's leading jockeys will miss key carnival mounts after being suspended at Warwick Farm yesterday. Unless he is successful in an intended appeal, Tommy Berry, who was outed for not riding Kentucky Wildcat (All American) to the line in a benchmark race, has been ruled out of the ride on Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) if she runs in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) on Saturday week, as well as Libertini (I Am Invincible) in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) a week later. Glen Boss, who pleaded guilty to and was suspended for careless riding on Larimer Street in the Inglis Millennium, misses the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on Kolding (Ocean Park) on February 22. Nash Rawiller will miss the same day and the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) meeting the following week.

#### **NEW ZEALAND**

#### **Derby tilt confirmed** for Two Illicit

Exciting three-year-old filly Two Illicit (Jimmy Choux) will contest the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Ellerslie later this month after pullingup well from her victory in the Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. "She has come through the run really well," said Robert Wellwood, who trains the filly in partnership with Roger James. "It was a credit to Te Rapa, they had the track in great order. She has trotted up nice and freely and is just having a nice quiet week this week. She will head to the Derby, we just have to have a chat with the owners regarding the late nomination payment. It is our full intention to head to the Derby next."

#### **Concert Hall set for Avondale** Cup

Things didn't go the way of Two Illicit's stable companion Concert Hall (Savabeel) in the City Of Auckland Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) last start, but Wellwood is hopeful she can turn her luck around in Saturday's Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m). "It really just didn't suit her at all (after the false start)," co-trainer Robert Wellwood said. "Ryan (Elliot, jockey) said the first time going past the post he had a whole heap of horse under him and the second time they jumped out she wasn't the same horse. She still stuck on well and ran very genuinely, so we weren't disappointed, but the way the race unfolded really didn't work for her. We will just put that behind us. She has had a good time between runs now. We have just got to look forward and not back."

roup 1-placegetter Graff (Star Witness) has been acquired by Aquis Farm and Australian Bloodstock as a racing and breeding prospect and will stand at Aquis when his career on the track concludes.

Replicating the partnership that combined to race dual Group 1 winner and Aquis' current Hunter Valley resident Brave Smash (Tosen Phantom), Graff will continue to be trained by Kris Lees and is likely to resume in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) at Rosehill on March 21.

"Having partnered with Australian Bloodstock in dual Group 1 winner Brave Smash, who covered an outstanding first book of mares last season, we're excited about joining forces to race the very talented sprinter Graff," said Aquis' managing director Shane McGrath.

A three-time winner who was unbeaten as a juvenile, Graff landed the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) in August 2018 prior to running third in the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) that September.

Having represented slot holder Max Whitby when running fifth behind Redzel (Snitzel) in the 2018 running of The Everest (1200m), Graff was subsequently beaten a length into fourth in both the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) last autumn.

Last seen running down the field at Newcastle in November, Graff's new connections are confident the four-year-old can secure a top-tier success before retiring to the covering shed.

"As an unbeaten two-year-old, an explosive Group 3 winner and multiple Group 1-placed sprinter, the future prospects for Graff are very exciting, not just on the track as he targets Group 1 races, but also when he retires to stud," McGrath continued.

Australian Bloodstock's Jamie Lovett concurred. He said: "We were delighted to secure Graff recently with the backing of some of our most loyal clients and breeders. He is a SPORTPIX

proven Group 1 horse and we are confident he will retire a Group 1 winner.

"He will be sought after by breeders and we were very keen to have Aquis involved in partnership from the outset. We have seen firsthand the support Aquis has attracted for our Group 1 sprinter Brave Smash."

One of 15 stakes winners by Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) scorer Star Witness (Starcraft), Graff is the highest-earning colt by his sire having amassed \$1,101,560 in career prize-money so far.

He was purchased by his former owner Alan Bell at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in 2017, realising \$200,000 from the draft of Widden Stud.

A brother to the stakes-placed Steel Diamond, Graff is the best-performed of three winners out of Group 3 scorer Dinkum Diamond (Keep The Faith), herself the daughter of Group 3 winner Raja Lane (Devaraja). This is also the family of Aquis' part-owned Rosebud Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Dawn Passage (Dawn Approach).
