# Shadwell to relinquish Australian interests

Golden opportunity looms for buyers as Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum-owned stock to sell unreserved in coming months

fter 36 years of heavy investment and involvement in Australia, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell Stud will disband its thoroughbred holdings in the region.

The shock news was delivered in an official statement by the organisation vesterday, with Shadwell's racing manager Angus Gold citing Sheikh Hamdan's inability to work as closely as he'd like with the operation in Australia as the prevailing reason behind the decision.

"Sheikh Hamdan has had a long and successful involvement in Australia, initially thanks to his close friendship with Colin Hayes and subsequently with his son, David, when he took over the licence," said Gold.

"However, as those who know him will attest, Sheikh Hamdan is very much a "hands on" man who likes to be closely involved with the Shadwell horses, and due to his commitments in the United Arab Emirates he has not been able to devote as much time as he would like to following his horses in Australia. Gold confirmed that Shadwell's entire Australian yearling crop will be offered at public auction, with the cream of the youngsters bound for the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

Shadwell's unreserved dispersal of broodmares, weanlings and the reduction sale of race fillies will provide the market with an opportunity to acquire top quality bloodstock from one of the most substantial investors in the Australian racing and breeding scene over the last three decades. Some of the high-class broodmares set to go under the hammer at Magic Millions include South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Qafila (Not A Single Doubt), Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Rimraam (Commands) and 2015 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Reemah (Redoute's Choice). Grade 1 winners in South Africa will also be sold.

Older mares such as Rewaaya (Singspiel) will not be auctioned and will instead remain in the first-class care of the team at Yarraman to see out their living days on the farm as nannies.

"It will be a good dispersal. There's some very good stock there and we will be sad to have them leave the farm," Mitchell said.

Gold paid tribute to the Mitchell family along with David Hayes for their professional support during Shadwell's long involvement with breeding and racing in Australia.

"On Sheikh Hamdan's behalf, I would like to thank the extended Hayes family, namely Colin, Peter and David, as well as Tony McEvoy, and latterly Ben Hayes and Tom Dabernig, together with their excellent staff, for the outstanding job they have done over the years for Sheikh Hamdan and Shadwell," he said.

"Equally, I would like to pay tribute to Arthur and Harry Mitchell and their team at Yarraman Park for all their hard work in looking after our breeding stock for the last twenty years or so."

Shadwell has been a huge supporter of the Australasian yearling

market for many years and has been rewarded with numerous stakes winners both in Australia and South Africa.

Sheikh Hamdan's famous blue and white colours were carried to victory in two Melbourne Cups (Gr 1, 3200m) by At Talaq (Roberto) in 1986 and Jeune (Kalaglow) in 1994 and they won three editions of the Blue Diamond with Mahaasin (Biscay) in 1990, Nadeem (Redoute's Choice) in 2006 and Reaan (Hussonet) in 2008.

"Although it is very sad that we will no longer be represented on the track in Australia I would like to take this opportunity to thank Sheikh Hamdan for his loyal support of the industry over so many years, and to wish all prospective purchasers the best of luck in the years ahead," Gold said.

"As we have seen from the recent successful yearling sales on the Gold Coast and at the Classic sale in Sydney, there certainly couldn't be a more exciting time to be involved in such a thriving racing industry."

#### Victoria in lockdown again

Racing will continue through Victoria's five-day hard lockdown, which began at 11.59pm last night. Last night's meeting at Moonee Valley was run as planned but without crowds, while the gates are closed to the public for Black Caviar Lightning Stakes day today at Flemington. It's a significant blow for the Victoria Racing Club, which planned to have 15,000 people on course for the Group 1 meeting. Victorian premier Daniel Andrews announced the state would go into Stage 4 lockdown yesterday afternoon with concerns that the mutant UK strain of Covid-19 could spread quickly through the community. The restrictions limit the reasons for leaving the house, with residents not allowed to go further than five kilometres from their address. In a media release yesterday, Racing Victoria CEO Giles Thompson confirmed the sport would continue under the same guidelines as when Victoria was last in Stage 4. That includes racecourses only being open to essential personnel and the mandatory wearing of face masks.

# Thompson's lockdown statement

"As we have done throughout the pandemic, we will continue to take decisive action to ensure that we provide the safest environment possible for both those participating in Victorian racing, as well as the wider community," Thompson said. "With immediate effect all spectators, including owners, are banned from attending race meetings in Victoria until otherwise advised, with a return to essential staff and active participants only, who will be continuing to complete daily health checks as they have done throughout the pandemic. I also want to take the opportunity to remind everyone within the Victorian racing industry of the critical need

to abide by all government directives in the days ahead. Please also get tested, isolate at home and contact us immediately if you or a close contact have been to an exposure site or are displaying any Covid symptoms." Andrews said professional sport would be treated like an essential workforce, who are still allowed to travel.

# Tasmanian Yearling Sale on track for Quercus Park

Magic Millions are expecting their Tasmanian Yearling Sale at Quercus Park to take place as planned on February 22. In a statement released yesterday, Magic Millions said they were continually monitoring the current Covid-19 outbreak in Victoria but, at present, nothing has changed. "Magic Millions, Tasracing and Tasbreeders will keep industry participants informed and up-to-date with all news in relation to the sale as soon as practical," the statement said. "Our priority is providing Tasmanian breeders with the best possible commercial opportunity to present their yearlings for sale whilst conducting the auction in a Covid-safe environment."

#### First for Under The Louvre

Grandview Stud's Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Under The Louvre (Excellent Art) sired his first winner yesterday courtesy of the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Cadboll (2 c ex Eschaton by Domesday). Racing in the same colours as his sire, Cadboll followed up his unplaced effort on debut at Moonee Valley with a narrow victory in the 1100-metre maiden at Sale. The homebred defeated \$2.40 favourite Tramontana (Toronado) by a short head, with Metzarro (Pierro) almost a length behind the winner in third. Cadboll is the first winner out of Domesday (Red Ransom) mare Eschaton, who produced foals by Woodside Park's Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact) in 2019 and

2020. She once again visited Under The Louvre last spring, with the sire serving 108 mares - his biggest book yet - at a fee of \$4,400. Under The Louvre has had three runners from 20 named foals to date, including the twice-placed The Love Of Mary.

#### 147 for Dansili

British import Starcaster (6 g ex Shirocco Star by Shirocco) landed the Torney Night Cup (Listed, 2500m) at Moonee Valley yesterday evening to become Dansili's (Danehill) 147th individual stakes winner. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained Starcaster, who had his first run in Australia last spring after arriving from Jedd O'Keeffe's Yorkshire base, followed up his Benchmark 70 courseand-distance success on his previous start with a commanding two and a half-length win last night. Ridden by Jamie Kah, the six-year-old defeated Stars Of Carrum (Fiorente) into second, with Vadiyann (Footstepsinthesand) a further head back in third. Starcaster's victory meant that Shirocco (Monsun) mare Shirocco Star has now produced three stakes winners from as many runners, with Telecaster (New Approach), winner of the Dante Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 2.5f) and Grand Prix de Deauville (Gr 2, 2500m), and Sir Henry Cecil Stakes (Listed, 1m) winner Al Suhail (Dubawi) her other raced foals. Juddmonte's Dansili retired from stud duties in 2018 due to declining fertility.



#### 'If that's the case he'll be hard to beat'

The magic hands of Jamie Kah could prove the difference for Nature Strip (Nicconi) in the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington today. That is the view of trainer Chris Waller, who believes the enigmatic sprinter will win if Kah can get him to settle. "If it all works out he can race smoothly, get into a nice rhythm, get comfortable and if that's the case he'll be hard to beat," Waller told RSN yesterday. "Last year he went too quick and didn't respect the 1000 metres." On that occasion, Nature Strip started a \$1.45 favourite and finished fourth of seven behind Gytrash (Lope De Vega). Waller said Nature Strip would go into today's edition of the Black Caviar Lightning in the same condition as last year. "It's a fine line between getting it right and wrong. He's so quiet in track work but when barriers crack back, he's a different horse," he said.

# Morton returns to Lightning stage

Daniel Morton confesses it feels like a lifetime ago since his globetrotting sprinter Scenic Blast (Scenic) won the Lightning in 2009. A dozen years later he is back to try and relive those glory days with up-and-coming speedster Elite Street (Street Boss) in today's \$750,000 renewal. He will be reliving those memories in a different way, however, as Morton can't attend a Victorian racecourse until next Tuesday under Racing Victoria's Covid-19 restrictions. "The horse arrived late Monday night and has settled in well at Nick Ryan's at Caulfield," Morton told Racing. com. "He has had a faultless preparation and is in a good frame of mind for Saturday. The speed will suit his pattern to sit off them and I am confident in my horse's ability, but you never go in overconfident into a big race. He is ready to rock and roll." Elite Street's Melbourne campaign is also set to include the \$1.25 million Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) on March 6.

# Lindsay Park out to land first CS Hayes

Lindsay Park are hoping Aysar (Deep Field) can end his string of runner-up finishes to provide them with their first winner of the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington today. Aysar has been beaten less than a length in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) and Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on his last three starts and a first stakes success still eludes him. Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes will be hoping that changes today in a race they are desperate to win. "It is a race we've tried to win many times, with it being named after my Pa (Colin Hayes), but unfortunately haven't been able to," co-trainer Ben Hayes told Racing.com. "We have a very high opinion of him and he really deserves a good race win. It was always our plan to arrive at the CS Hayes, his grand final is obviously the Australian Guineas, but we would love to win the CS Hayes along the way. If he can win it will be a huge thrill for us."

# Cambourne to resume progress in Group 3

Among Aysar's opposition is Cambourne (Redoute's Choice), who co-trainers Mick Price and Michael Kent jnr believe can have a real impact on the race. Winner of two of his four starts, the three-year-old resumes after running unplaced in the Caulfield Guineas on his last start. He has drawn barrier four and Kent jnr is

expecting him to make his presence felt under Mark Zahra. "He's had a perfect prep, he's a lovely horse and I'm thrilled he's drawn barrier four," Kent jnr said. "It'll be a typical Mark Zahra ride, he will be in the right spot. I think he will give that race a real shake, no doubt. He will love Flemington, he's a big horse with a big stride. He's quite exciting. He's dynamic, he's got a turn of foot and can sustain a nice gallop to the line. He is a horse we have got programmed to go to the Australian Guineas and he's nominated for the Randwick Guineas and we hope to end up in the Rosehill Guineas."

# River launches last-ditch ASM bid

The Mike Moroney-trained Buffalo River (Noble Mission) will be one of many horses making a last-ditch effort to win All-Star Mile (1600m) votes today, as he lines up in the Seppelt Wines Plate (1400m) at Flemington. Buffalo River, third in the Sandown Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) when last seen in the spring, sat 20th in the leaderboard prior to last night's blackout, with voting set to close at midnight tomorrow. "For people to vote for him he needs to win on Saturday," Moroney told Racing.com. "We are serious about running in the race, otherwise we have to get in via the Blamey Stakes, which is a win-and-you're-in race." Buffalo River finished runner-up behind Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) in the spring and Moroney believes it will take something special to beat him if he brings that level of form to today's contest. "He has earned his weight as Group 1 placegetter and it is going to need to be a Group-class horse to beat him," Moroney said. "He does give an in-form horse (Regardsmaree) a bit of weight so we will find out." Meanwhile, Sir Dragonet (Camelot) will be one of the horses just inside the top ten who will be eagerly awaiting tomorrow's results, with the likes of Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) and Crosshaven (Smart Missile) also vying for the final few places on the leaderboard.

Winter carnival options are on the horizon for Garibaldi (I Am Invincible) if he can extend his winning sequence at Doomben today. Garibaldi was the odds-on favourite last night to make it four wins in a row in the BRC Like Nowhere Else In BNE Plate (1200m), following wins at the Sunshine Coast, Eagle Farm and Doomben. Tony Gollan hinted the winter will be the focus for Garibaldi if his red-hot form continues. "If he can do what we think he can in this race then we can cool our jets and see what our options are with him in a couple of months," Gollan said. "This is a big step up. It's a very competitive race with good depth and although it's a long way away from being carnival quality, it's a good test for him."

# Buchan Cup meeting postponed

Following yesterday's lockdown announcement in Victoria, Buchan and Gelantipy Race Club have decided to postpone the 134th running of the Buchan Cup (1800m), which was due to take place today. "It is just so disappointing, everyone has put in 150 per cent," club president Ian Dunkley told Racing.com. "We have put all the marquees up and sold-out last Monday. This is just devastating. Up here we have run Black Saturday, got through the bushfires, we have had floods and everything, we are a bit flabbergasted."

# Ranting and Hustle lay down Plate credentials with pleasing trials

Connections of both Ranting (Zoustar) and Brooklyn Hustle (Starspangledbanner) are feeling bullish ahead of next weekend's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m), after both trialled successfully yesterday. Winner of the Blue Sapphire Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in the spring, Ranting impressed at Flemington yesterday ahead of his first-up assignment at Caulfield in seven days and Leon and Troy Cortens are excited for his return. "I just reckon it's a really good race for him, he loves Caulfield, the 1100 metres is going to suit, the speed will be on," said Troy Corstens. "If he can draw a gate ... he's got that explosive turn of foot, we've seen it down the straight at Flemington, he's got a really good 200 metres where he can just pick

them up quickly." Brooklyn Hustle performed encouragingly in the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last year, finishing fourth in both, and co-trainers Dean Krongold and Jason Warren believe she is as good a chance as anything in the Oakleigh Plate. "Very happy with her trial." Warren said. "Importantly, she pulled up well and she's bounced through the trial, she's eaten everything, and we're pleased with her. I think with her first-up record and the weight she'll be carrying, dropping from weightfor-age to handicap, she's in the race (Oakleigh Plate) up to her ears. She's as good a chance as anything and they'll know she's there."

#### Vale Ray Huxley

Renowned racing journalist Ray Huxley sadly passed away yesterday after a battle with cancer. Huxley, 76, was a leading figure in the written press, being just one of three chief racing writers for the famous Melbourne Herald masthead after succeeding Jack Elliott in 1986. He was recently awarded the prestigious Bert Wolfe Award for overall contribution to the sport in recognition of 60 years working in the media.

#### Equestrian Western Australia establishes bushfire relief fund

Equestrian Western Australia (EWA) has established the EWA bushfire relief fund to assist those with horses who have been impacted by the devastating Wooroloo bushfire. Racing and Wagering Western Australia's (RWWA) community TAB program has donated \$10,000 to the fund. EWA established the fund through the Australian Sports Foundation to assist those in need and support their equestrian community, as many lost their homes or sustained damage to their property. "The EWA bushfire relief fund provides the opportunity for both cash as well as new product donations, and the funds are able to be distributed to support the owners of horses with the replacement of any equipment or property repairs that are horse related," said EWA CEO Dwight Pedlow said.

# McIver banned for 12 months

Queensland jockey Chris McIver will be out of action for 12 months after receiving his third ban

for mistreating horses. The 33-year-old returned to the saddle in November having received a seven-month lay-off for whipping a horse over the head, while that sentence included an extra month activated from when he was found guilty of misconduct in 2019 for kicking and punching a horse after a race, resulting in a three-month ban, of which a month was suspended. In the latest incident, McIver was suspended by the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission having been found guilty of twice forcibly stomping on the hindquarters of his mount, Or Else (Smart Missile), at the barriers before a race at Rockhampton on January 23.

# Newitt cops ten-meeting suspension

Group 1-winning jockey Craig Newitt received a ten-meeting suspension for his ride aboard runner-up Always Definite (Choisir) in the second race at Pakenham on Thursday night. Newitt pleaded guilty after using his whip ten times prior to the 100 metres, which is five more than permitted, while he used the whip 16 times in total. His suspension will start at midnight today and will expire at midnight on February 21. He was also fined \$200. When assessing the punishment, stewards took into account his guilty plea, record and totality of whip strikes.

# Wishart returns from long lay-off

Apprentice jockey Madeleine Wishart will return to action at Rockhampton today following extensive rehabilitation after a fall at Toowoomba back in September. Having parted company with Alert And Ready (Defcon), Wishart suffered a dislocated and fractured elbow, as well as tearing the medial collateral ligament in her knee. However, the 23-yearold believes the enforced absence has been beneficial and she told Racing Queensland: "It has been a long time, but it has done me good. I am in a much better head space now. I was probably not as dedicated as what I should have been before the fall, but now I am putting 100 per cent everything into my racing. I am excited for tomorrow." Wishart is booked for five rides, including Daunting Queen (Daunting Lad) for Bundaberg trainer Mary Hassam, who she won aboard earlier in her career.

#### **Balranald postponed**

Racing NSW have postponed today's meeting at Balranald given the proximity between the racetrack and the Victorian border, following yesterday's announcement from the Victoria state government in relation to Covid-19.

# Trelawney's Group 1 winner Pernod dies

Trelawney Stud farewelled one of its favourite mares this week following the death of Group 1 winner Pernod (Centaine) at the age of 23. "We bred her and got great joy out of her racetrack success including her Group 1 win. She has been a wonderful broodmare for us and her legacy lives on in her daughters. She was also a valued nanny in her later years," Trelawney said on Twitter. Trained by Mike Moroney, Pernod won eight of her 19 starts, achieving her biggest day when downing Bel Esprit (Royal Academy) in the 2002 Dubai Racing Club Cup (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield. Having amassed over \$2 million in earnings on the track, she went on to produce 11 foals, nine of whom raced and seven of whom won. The headline act among that septet was dual Group 3 scorer Martini Red (Red Ransom).

# May thriving ahead of Group 1 mission

Trainer John Bary believes Callsign Mav (Atlante) is thriving ahead of his outing in the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m) at Te Rapa this afternoon. The four-year-old sprung a major surprise when taking out the Tarzino Trophy (Gr 1, 1400m) at Hastings last September, but he has continued to hold a high level of form since, placing in the Windsor Park Plate (Gr 1,

1600m) and the Manawatu Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) in December. He was last seen defying 63 kilograms at Awapuni on January 9 and Bary said: "It was a different plan to what we all envisioned, but he got around, balanced up in the straight and came home hard at them. It has really helped with his confidence again and ticked the box of winning away from the Hastings track." Bary continued: "He had an exhibition gallop with Jonathan (Riddell, jockey) on him here at Hastings at the end of January and that went extremely well. I have held him here at home for the fact that I have my own track and I know he gets the first use of it and it's always watered - it's perfect for him. He is fit, he has been racing all season, so I am not going to make him any fitter. I am really happy with where he is at."

# Improving Ocean set for Riccarton return

Southern Ocean finished runner-up to subsequent Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) winner Waisake (Zed) at Trentham last month and trainer Terri Rae has taken a lot of confidence out of that run. "He just got crowded on jumping and ended up back a little bit more in the field," she said. "Running second to Waisake, who went out and won the Wellington Cup, is pretty good form. He was only having his fifth start and he is only a four-year-old, so it was a pretty good effort. It was his first trip away. He sweated up a bit on raceday and took it all in." Regarding today's assignment, Rae added: "The only thing is that it's an open race, although the top rater is only an 84, so it's probably not a true open race, and just coming back to the 1800 INTERNATIONAL

#### US: Gatewood Bell announced as Keeneland vice-president

Keeneland has announced the appointment of bloodstock adviser Gatewood Bell to the position of vice-president of racing, a role which will begin later this month. Bell, who founded the renowned Cromwell Bloodstock in 2011, had served as the operation's president for the last decade and purchased the likes of top-tier winners Undrafted (Purim), Hootenanny (Quality Road), Mastery (Candy Ride) and Con Te Partiro (Scat Daddy) at public auction. A member of the Jockey Club, Bell previously served on the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission and as the American representative at Goffs, and joined Keeneland's board of directors as an advisory board member last month, a position he will now relinquish. "Gatewood brings a unique set of skills and experiences encompassing aspects of both the thoroughbred racing and breeding industries to the role of vice-president of racing," said Keeneland president and CEO Shannon Arvin. "His passion for, and knowledge of, racing were honed in the trenches on his family's farm (Jonabell) and at the track, and in recent years as a bloodstock adviser. The range of Gatewood's talents and his network of relationships with owners and trainers are well suited to help Keeneland navigate the future landscape of racing."

# US: Tygart set to take over drug testing in US racing

Travis Tygart, the man responsible for exposing some of the biggest doping scandals this century in his role as US Anti-Doping Agency (Usada) chief executive, says his organisation is ready to embrace the "huge responsibility" of taking over anti-doping and medication enforcement in US racing. Usada has been behind bans for dopers such as cyclist Lance Armstrong, athletics coach

Alberto Salazar and athletes linked to the Balco labs scandal, such as Marion Jones, since coming into existence in 2000. From next summer, Usada will assume control of drug testing, anti-doping and medication violations as part of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act [Hisa], which was passed by US lawmakers at the end of last year, centralising the process for the first time. While Usada has primarily focused on doping perpetrated by human athletes, Tygart believes there are no differences in the underlying principles of breaking the rules to win and is seeking to introduce a "gold standard" for racing. Speaking on the Thoroughbred Daily News Weekly Podcast, Tygart said: "Cheating, honesty, ethics and the rule of sport are the same across all sports. While some might want to say there's a difference between equine antidoping and medication control programmes and what happens in humans, the mentality of cheating and trying to get away and get an advantage over the rules is all the same."

# Vivian, the man with the distinctive dulcet tones and gavel, announces retirement as Price rejoins Inglis

opular Australian thoroughbred sales industry identity Simon Vivian will retire later this year after more than four decades in the game, paving the way for James Price to return to Inglis to take over as the company's Victorian bloodstock manager.

Vivian, 64, announced yesterday that he would depart the auction house on his terms, bringing down the curtain on his career after the Australian Easter Yearling Sale in Sydney on April 6 and 7.

An auctioneer with a distinctive flair, Vivian started his career at Coles Brothers in Adelaide in 1997 and joined Inglis in 2004 following the company's takeover of Dalgety. He was promoted to Victorian bloodstock manager in 2016 upon the retirement of Peter Heagney.

Vivian also enjoyed stints in Western Australia, Queensland, the UK and Asia before joining Inglis where he became the company's South Africa representative in 2009.

"I have been doing this for 44 years and I have been married for 41, so it is basically the only thing I know what to do but it gets to a certain stage ... where the travel does become tiring and I just want to be able to spend a bit more time at home," Vivian told ANZ Bloodstock News while undertaking yearling inspections in regional Victoria yesterday.

"When you're young and you're etching out a career, you are working for the future and your wife and partner works with you. I have been discussing this with my wife (Carleen) for probably 12 months and she has been extremely keen on me getting to this point where we can enjoy life together and spend more time with our kids and our grandchildren."

Vivian said he felt fortunate to finish his career at Inglis, while he believes the recent Classic sale was the "strongest yearling sale" he had "ever sold at".

"I have been very lucky with where I have

been but I have ended up at the best place. I have been very fortunate working initially with Reg, Arthur and Jamie (Inglis) and then at the conclusion with Mark (Webster)," he said.

"I have been very lucky to work for a company with the integrity of Inglis. It is unquestioned and it is a privilege to work for a company like that and, in a way, it helps your own reputation.

"Anybody who pulls on an Inglis jumper needs to understand that they are very fortunate and it stands them in very good stead from an industry viewpoint." While Vivian's decision opens up the door for him to be able to participate in other facets of the industry, his new-found freedom is unlikely to see the experienced bloodstock consultant jumping on the other side of the fence on a permanent basis.

"I suppose you never say never, but I am leaving on the basis that it is a retirement," he said.

"As I explained to Mark, I don't intend to go home and grow tomatoes. I have got a lot of friends in the industry and I don't intend to walk away from all of those, so if opportunities come up for me to be involved in the industry, I would love to be able to do it. But I will be doing it pretty much on my terms and my time."

Inglis' managing director Mark Webster described Vivian as an industry "household name" whose contribution to the game, particularly in Victoria, cannot be underestimated.

"Simon has had an incredible influence over so many people during his career and his work ethic and relationship building with clients is second-to-none," Webster said. "He has always shown a unique passion for the industry, especially the Victorian industry and the Premier sale, and while he is a great loss to the company, I wish him absolute relaxation and good health in retirement and thank him dearly for everything he has done not only for Inglis but also the industry as a whole. We are all indebted to him."

Meanwhile Price, who left Inglis in 2018 to join Victorian farm Woodside Park Stud, last

week revealed he would leave the operation after nearly three years running the Mark Rowsthorn-owned farm, which is again undergoing a restructure.

"I've spent most of my professional working life at Inglis and it's a company I have always admired, from Arthur and Charlotte and Jamie and Sarah (Inglis) down, they are just fantastic people and that's important to me when choosing my career path," Price said.

"I worked under Simon for many years and I have the utmost respect for him both as a person and as a professional so to be replacing somebody I view so highly is truly overwhelming.

"He, Sebastian (Hutch), Jonathan (D'Arcy) and the entire bloodstock team have created such an amazing base and I can't wait to come in and be a part of that again and help take Inglis to even greater heights for our clients in years to come."

Vivian endorsed the appointment of his replacement, who will start back at Oaklands Junction on March 15, allowing a handover period between the pair.

"My original plan was to do it (retirement) after Premier, but I spoke to Sebastian and Mark and they asked me if I would stay on a little longer," Vivian said.

"I have agreed to stay until April 14, after Easter, which gave them the opportunity to go and get James. He will start with Inglis immediately after Premier.

"That will also give me a month to hand things over to James and acquaint him with all of the ongoing work that we have got in place at Oaklands."



# Telemon acquires neighbouring Running Creek Stud

eading Queensland operation
Telemon Stud has acquired
neighbouring property Running
Creek Stud, with proprietor Dan
Fletcher saying the new acquisition offers them
'paddock to paddock, one of the best farms to
breed a thoroughbred.'

Fletcher, along with his wife Rae, will take over the property run by renowned breeder Gary Pemberton and family.

It's been an incremental growing process for the Fletchers, who purchased their existing land in late 2016 and rebranded the farm Telemon Thoroughbreds in 2018. This opportunity, however, was too good to pass up, building the blocks for further expansion that aligns with their ambition for the historic property.

"It's a very exciting time," said Dan Fletcher to ANZ Bloodstock News. "It's one of those situations where when your neighbour's land becomes available it's probably more valuable to us than it is to anyone else and we're just delighted to be able to get it.

"Probably the biggest thing that it may allow us to do over time is that it has the potential to repurpose some of our existing stallion facilities and potentially put our stallions up there.

"We don't plan to do that immediately, but it's a foundational moment for us and allows us to plan for our long-term future. It's exciting for now and for ten, 20, years' time.

"If there is the opportunity there to expand our stallion operations then we certainly would, but we'd never, ever compromise on quality. If the right horse came along and we were able to do something then this acquisition would certainly help us in those ambitions over time.

"We're planting acorns and it will take time for those to turn in to oaks."

Although Fletcher sees their involvement in the thoroughbred business as very much a long-term project, the couple have already had

a prominent influence in racing circles, forming part of the partnership who bred champion filly Sunlight (Zoustar), while they are also involved in the ownership of dual Group 1 winner Russian Camelot (Camelot).

"In the short term it gives us some more capacity, more paddocks and is just going to allow us to treat our paddocks more kindly," said Fletcher.

"We might have 12 or 15 what I call 'mainsale mares' here at Telemon. We've started at a low base and over time we'll be looking to multiply those numbers and maintain that quality so we can look to access these mainsales. We're not there at the moment, but at this stage I feel like we're under the radar.

"What we're trying to do at Running Creek is just go about our business and have the best quality farm and produce the best quality horses we can offer.

"Hopefully this is a good statement of our long-term intentions and people can see that we're investing in what we're doing and they'll come along on the journey with us."

Telemon stands three stallions, headlined by Sidestep (Exceed And Excel), who produced

Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi from his first crop. The second crop of barnmate Jungle Cat, a son of Iffraaj (Zafonic), will be born this year while Sun City (Zoustar) will have his first foals on the ground.

"We're really looking forward to getting Sun City's first foals on the ground and, as for Jungle Cat, if you look at the foals that he's produced he's really captured a lot of attention," said Fletcher. "After a smaller foal crop initially he's got a much better second crop, and I think we're going to get an even better book going to him this year.

"The whole Iffraaj sireline is really on the move. It's so exciting to see what a horse like Almanzor has done this season and we're hoping people will appreciate Jungle Cat's representation of that sireline on our stallion roster. I'm very excited by what he might achieve.

"We'll be looking to consolidate with our stallions this year and my standpoint at this stage would be to maintain our positioning and look after the breeders that have supported us.

"We'll be judged in the long run by the results that we produce."




