Toronado's Flemington breakout a boost for all Victorian stud farms

Swettenham's Sangster backs Al Shaqab's shuttler to continue his rise up the ranks

Adam Sangster is confident that last week's important breakthrough Flemington stakes double for Swettenham Stud's shuttle stallion Toronado (High Chaparral) will be a sign of things to come not just for his Nagambie stud but Victorian breeding in general.

The Swettenham Stud principal was this week still celebrating the success of four-year-

old Matriarch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Affair To Remember and three-year-old Shelby Cobra who continued his rapid progression with a victory in the Springtime Stakes (Listed, 1400m).

His belief in the local industry and that of the Al Shaqab-owned Toronado was boosted after Shelby Cobra's mother Segenhoe Valley (Dane Shadow) and three-week-old sister sold for \$325,000 in the Inglis Digital Online Auction on Wednesday. *Continued on page 2>>*

"We've known there's been some really nice horses around by Toronado, but the pattern of races hadn't really turned out as we had expected during the early spring," Sangster said.

"Since then, however, he's certainly positioned himself particularly well with the two stakes winners at Flemington "

Sangster confirmed that a deal with Al Shaqab for Toronado to return to Australia in 2021 was already locked away.

"We had to close Toronado's book in February or March for this season, which was a sure sign that he was going well and the market really likes his stock.

"There's probably eight colts who have gone up to Hong Kong and we feel he's going to continue the way of the successful High Chaparral sire line."

The emergence of Shelby Cobra promoted Queensland hobby breeder Laurelle Owen to put Segenhoe Valley on the market and Sangster was delighted that she was rewarded with a big result.

"The owner bought her for \$5000 off Makybe (in 2018),so that is an incredible return on her investment," he said.

"She is a lovely lady who owned her and she would be beside herself. We told her not to keep refreshing the Inglis Digital site and looking at it because most of the action would take place in the last 20 minutes, but there looked to be bidding going on all the way through."

Toronado's success and the Segenhoe Valley trade was, according to Sangster, not only recognition for Swettenham but all the breeders who support the industry in Victoria.

Fellow Victorian farms Yulong, Spendthrift Australia, Darley, Woodside Park, Rosemont Stud, Sun Stud, Glen Eden, Blue Gum Farm, Aquis Farm and Riverbank Farm are among those stallion operations to have invested heavily in the state's breeding industry in recent years.

While Toronado sired two cup week winners, Sun Stud's Fiorente (Monsun) had Power Scheme score last Saturday and Magnus' (Flying Spur) Kemalpassa win on Derby Day, young Woodside Park Stud sire Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) had two-year-old filly Dosh win on debut and former barnmate's Written Tycoon (Iglesia) score with Written Beauty on Oaks Day.

Written Tycoon also had juvenile colt Finance Tycoon and four-year-old Rich Hips win on Melbourne Cup day, while the late Three Bridges Thoroughbreds stallion Unencumbered (Testa Rossa) had No Restriction win at the same meeting.

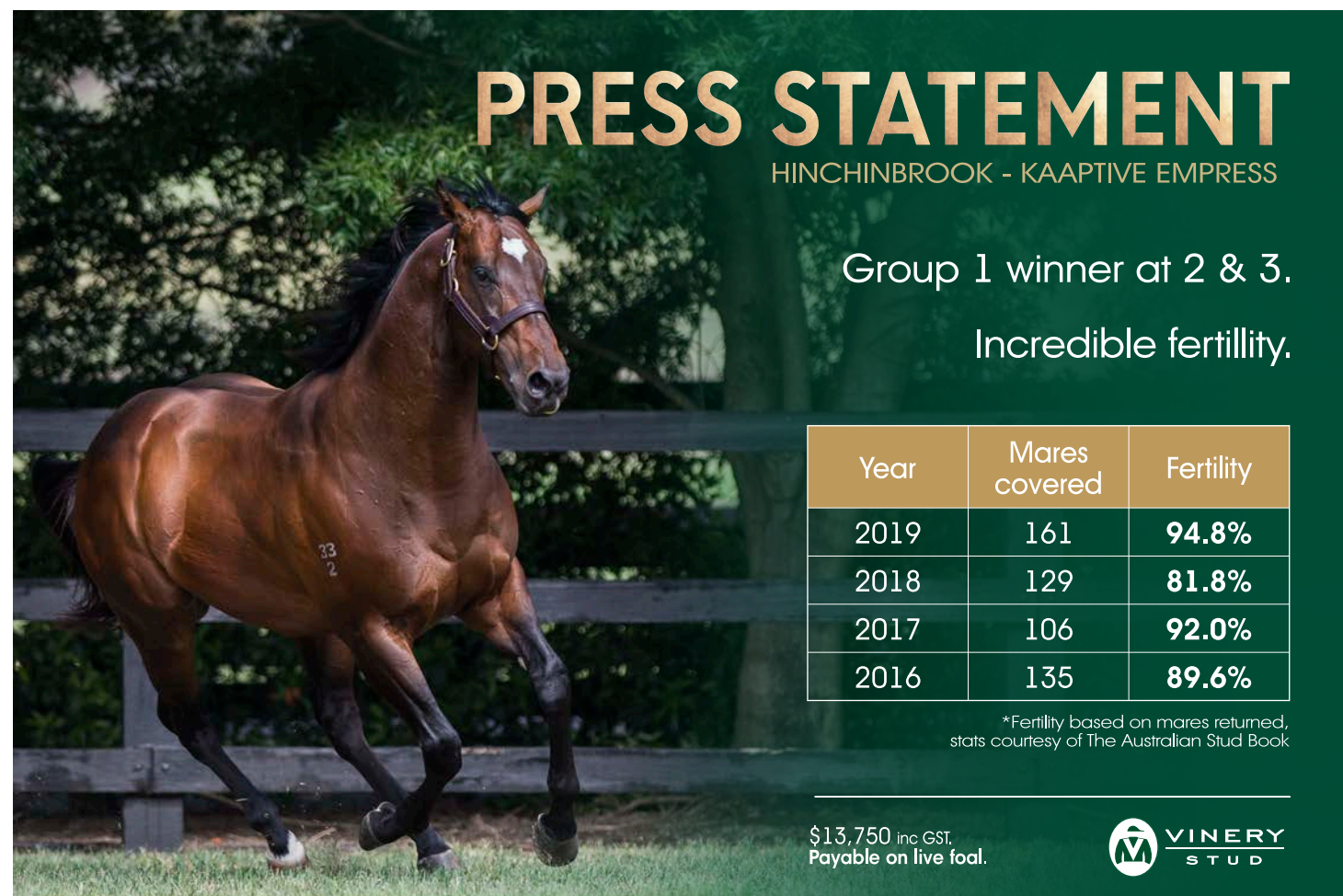

<< *Continued from page 2* “I really enjoy seeing Victorian stallions bringing the rewards for smaller breeders because it helps the whole industry with good results like this,” Sangster said.

“I am always happy to see stallions work here because then everyone makes money. If smaller breeders make money, then smaller breeders come back into the industry and Victoria has a chance to upgrade stock.”

Thoroughbred Breeders Victoria executive officer Charmein Bukovec said it was not just in Cup week where Victorian-sired horses excelled,

“I think the spring was phenomenal for Victorian breeders. We were dominant on racetracks across Australia,” Bukovec said yesterday.

“Darley’s Frosted took out the first two-year-old stakes race of the season with one of his progeny in Ingratiating; we saw Victorian-bred and sired horses such as North Pacific dominate in Sydney and dual Group 1 winner Ole Kirk’s form speaks for itself.

“There were amazing results across the board and the spring was very successful for Victorian breeders and that has been highlighted during the carnival.”

The Victorian-bred and sired honour roll suggested to Bukovec that a concerted push to upgrade the stock in the state was starting to pay off.

“For a long time we have talked about the investment in Victoria and I think we are seeing that momentum is really starting to get some wheels on it,” she said.

“It proves the results we can get in Victoria.

It's no surprise, but Savabeel set to shine at NZB's Ready to Run Sale

The numbers tell the story and it is clear that world events of 2020 have touched the New Zealand horseracing and breeding scene in a major way.

Apart from the 2016 edition of the annual NZB Ready to Run Sale, which attracted 552 lots, the normal participation rate is around the 400 to 450 mark. However, along with other industries, the New Zealand bloodstock industry has not been able to escape the effects of the coronavirus and this year the catalog (before withdrawals) sees a dramatic reduction to 311.

A few days out, the final offering will likely be close to 250 which has resulted in the auctioneers pushing the daily start times back two hours to 1pm New Zealand time.

Another change from years past is that much of the international interest will be conducted via New Zealand Bloodstock's online digital platform, such is the effect of very limited international travel. For the same reason, New Zealand-based bloodstock agents might also be busier, acting on behalf of Australian and Asian agents and clients.

Ninety sires are represented of which 48 are New Zealand-based and 56 lots were foaled in Australia.

Reliable Man (Dalakhani), with 13 lots is the most represented followed by Redwood (High Chaparral) with 11. Savabeel (Zabeel) and El Roca (Fastnet Rock) each have ten lots while Tavistock (Montjeu), Tarzino (Tavistock) and Telperion (Street Cry) have eight apiece.

With seven lots are Per Incanto (Street Cry), Showcasing (Oasis Dream), Wrote (High Chaparral) and Shamexpress (O'Reilly). Ocean Park (Thorn Park), Belardo (Lope De Vega) and Contributor (High Chaparral) will be represented by six lots each.

Westbury Stud's sire line up of Reliable Man (Dalakhani), Redwood, El Roca, Tarzino and Telperion account for 50 lots between them

which provides no surprise that Westbury Stud is also the busiest vendor with 32 lots.

The leading vendor on aggregate in 2019, Riversley Park, is scheduled to offer 25 lots, the same number as Kilgravin Lodge. Prima Park is to be represented by 20 lots with Ohukia Lodge (16), Lilywhites Lodge (14), Woburn Farm (11) and Riverrock Farm (10).

As has been the case for what seems like an eternity, Savabeel will again dominate this sale. New Zealand's multiple champion sire surpassed 100 stakes winners and \$100 million in earnings this past season. He continues to be the main attraction. Of his ten lots, any one of them might top the sale.

Even though buyers are more interested in 'how' a potential purchase moves, a sharp breeze up time of 10.28 seconds could be of such significance to result in **Lot 298** being one of the sale's stars. The fact that he is out of an O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) half sister to six-times Group 1 winner Sir Slick (Volksraad) as well as twice Group 1 winner Puccini (Encosta De Lago), is a pure bonus.

Lot 3 is a brother-in-blood to Dowager Queen, the winner of three Listed races, ran second in the VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) and third in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). This colt

breezed up in 10.52 seconds and along with Lot 2 (covered Fbelow) could get the auction off to rousing start.

One of two Savabeel fillies on offer is **Lot 83** and has residual value being from a winning Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) three-quarter blood sister to five-time Group 1-winning miler Racing To Win (Encosta De Lago). She breezed up in 10.65 seconds.

The late Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) raced to the top of the NZ Sire (earnings) List after his Aegon won last week's New Zealand Two Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). His **Lot 184** should command attention as he breezed up in 10.77 seconds. He ranks as a three-quarter brother to dual Group 1 winner Maco'Reilly (O'Reilly). His dam is seven for seven and his granddam Plume (Crested Wave) was Joint NZ Filly of the Year winning a total of 12 races, nine of which were at stakes level including the New Zealand One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

The stock by Per Incanto just keep on winning and two lots, under the same Little Avondale Stud ownership but in different drafts, are **Lot 48** (10.31 secs) and **Lot 279** (10.88 secs). The former is from a Melbourne winning Exceed and Excel (Danehill) daughter of Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Royal

Tiara (Blanco). The latter is a three-quarter blood brother to Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Dal Cielo.

The New Zealand industry recently lost the services of both Tavistock and Sacred Falls and as is often the case, we get to be reminded what a loss they are. With Sacred Falls it is the unbeaten Group 1 classic winner Aegon. In Tavistock's case it is the 2020 Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) victor Johnny Get Angry.

Patience will likely be required regarding **Lot 305**, not only because he is to be offered near the end of the sale, but also because of his bloodlines. However, if you are looking to repeat Johnny Get Angry's success, this fellow has 'Derby' and 'Cups' written all over him. His stakes placed dam (a granddaughter of Monsun) won over ground at both Longchamp and Saint-Cloud and she is a half sister the Group 2 Longchamp winner Mouramara, by Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Kahyasi (Ile De Bourbon) who is the dam of Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Mourayan (Alhaarth).

A filly with a breeding future is **Lot 49** whose stakes placed dam is a half sister to two stakes winners including the dual Group 2 South African performer Oracy (Zabeel) and from the same family as the brilliant triple Group 1 winning mare Sea Siren (Fastnet Rock).

Mentioned above is Johnny Get Angry and **Lot 11** (10.95 secs) is a Reliable Man gelding from a winning sister to the 2020 Victoria Derby winner's dam, thus providing a serious pedigree update. Their granddam Pavlova (Singspiel) took out the JRA Cup (Listed, 2040m) at Mooney Valley and is herself a half sister to dual Group winner Fubu (Last Tycoon).

Residual value is to be had with **Lot 263** (10.78 secs), a filly out of the speedy Listed winner Lady Zafira (Iffraaj) whose dam is a sister to two stakes winners, namely Vitrinite (Lord Ballina) and Exinite (Lord Ballina). Reliable Man is proving to be noted sire of good fillies plus Hypnos, winner of the Coupland's Bakeries Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) on Wednesday.

Lot 210 (10.95 secs), by Redwood, is also in receipt of a timely pedigree update being the half brother to Mascarpone (Shooting To Win), winner of the Legacy Lodge Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Te Rapa last week. This gelding is closely related to Flemington Group 3 winner

Bel Danoro (Danehill) as well as Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) victress Sofia Rosa (Makfi).

Yet another to benefit from recent winning stakes form is **Lot 30**, the half brother to Hypnos who, since the catalogue was printed, has added back-to-back Group victories to his record. Last Wednesday at Riccarton he scored the rich Coupland's Bakeries Mile and last month preceded that with the Red Badge Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m).

Up and coming sire Sweynesse (Lonhro) has two lots that are both out of Listed stakes winning mares. **Lot 284** is a colt from Madonna Mia (Red Clubs), the winner of nine races including the Wanganui Cup (Listed, 2100m) and **Lot 24** (10.84 secs) is a filly from Post Thyme (Postponed) who won at Listed level at both Caulfield and Ellerslie.

By El Roca, **Lot 76** (10.68 secs) is a colt from one the best families in the stud book, having produced three New Zealand Broodmares of the Year. He is a half brother to New Zealand One Thousand Guineas victress La Bella Diosa (So You Think) and two other stakes winners. His dam Star Affair (Star Way) scored in the Travis Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Te Rapa. There is black type everywhere on this page.

Consistently among the leading New Zealand sires for a lengthy period, Darci Brahma (Danehill) is closing in on 50 stakes winners, a record some shuttle stallions would be proud to own.

His **Lot 40** has an intriguing pedigree, a colt from an Argentinian Group 1 winner Ride The

Valkyries (Orpen). The names on his pedigree page may be foreign but there is plenty of black type (including Group 1 level) to back him up.

Lot 291 (10.28 secs) has some lovely bloodlines. Not only is he a half brother to dual Group 2 winner Platinum Princess (Keeper), his dam is by Machiavellian (Mr Prospector) and his grandam is a French Listed winner by Nureyev (Northern Dancer).

One of four lots by Iffraaj, **Lot 233** (10.84 secs) is a son of a winning Savabeel mare and grandson of the high class mare Calveen (Canny Lad) whose ten wins included the Easter Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and five further Group races.

The late Pins (Snippets) has sired 85 stakes winners and **Lot 310** (10.50 secs) is the last in the catalogue but certainly worth waiting for. He is a half brother to seven winners including the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Sentimental Miss (Reliable Man). This is the family of Group 1 winners Dracula (Quest For Fame) and Complacent (Authorized).

The northern hemisphere first crop of Belardo are making a big impression with his haul including a Group 2 winner, two Group 2 winners and a Listed winner. His future looks very bright and **Lot 278** (10.93 secs) is from a winning Per Incanto sister to Group 2-placed Nahema and to Hammer Down (O'Reilly), winner of the Cambridge Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m).

Both Tivaci and Tarzino have their initial crops on display. The Tivacis sold well this

past January and **Lot 118** (10.94 secs) is from a Waikato Stud family of copious stakes winners, this colt being out of a winning half sister to two stakes winners and from the same family as Sacred Falls. Tarzino's **Lot 34** is out of Listed Sydney winner Readyor (More Than Ready), herself a half sister to Agister (Mossman), winner of the Eskimo Prince Stakes (Listed, 1300m).

At the close of Cup week the three sires at the head of the Australian Premiership are Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice), Written Tycoon and Exceed And Excel and each has representation here. Written Tycoon, sire of Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) victor Ole Kirk, might be the hottest, currently enjoying a fabulous spring in Melbourne. **Lot 126** (10.86 secs) is a son of Absolutelyfabulous (Langfuhr), a three-times stakes winner including the Cameron Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Newcastle.

The Everest (1200m) hero Classique Legend's sire Not A Single Doubt, is represented by **Lot 2** (10.49 secs). This colt, foaled in New Zealand, is out of stakes placed O'Naturelle (O'Reilly), a daughter of Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Naturo (Postponed). Perhaps some fireworks to start the sale?

Exceed And Excel, sire of the Bivouac, brilliant winner of VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) on Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) day, has two lots on offer. **Lot 169** (10.74 secs) is from a twice Melbourne winning Pins three-quarter blood sister to dual Group 1 classic winner Katie Lee (Pins). **Lot 243** (11.05 secs) is from a half sister to Group 2 winners Miss Zoe (Zoffany) and Utzon (Nothin' Leica Dane).

And speaking of the Mackinnon Stakes, Arcadia Queen's sire Pierro (Lonhro) will be represented by **Lot 13** (10.97 secs), a half brother to New Zealand One Thousand Guineas winner Rollout The Carpet (Holy Roman Emperor) and by **Lot 174** (10.90 secs), a colt from a half sister to four stakes winners including the 2010 winner of the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Crystal Lily (Stratum).

The stunning New Zealand spring form of Need I Say More (No Nay Never) will no doubt add focus to the stock of his sire who has already sired 26 stakes winners, his oldest southern hemisphere crop being three-year-olds and oldest northern hemisphere crop just four-year-olds. He has two lots up for grabs and both are desirable.

Lot 275 (10.78 secs) is now a half brother to three winners including recent Melbourne (Sandown) winner, Group-placed Succeed

Indeed (Akeed Mofeed). His Brisbane-winning dam Lucky Morna (Ferocity) was also Group placed.

Lot 38 (10.51 secs) is a half brother to two winners, grandson of a three-quarter blood sister to Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Vouvray (Zabeel) and closely related to 2019 New Zealand One Thousand Guineas winner Loire (Redoute's Choice).

The stock of Zoustar (Northern Meteor) are always very popular at Australasian sales. Sire of the outstanding Sunlight, **Lot 31** (10.83 secs) is also a filly from the Saratoga Listed winner Queen Of The Creek (Theatrical) who is a three-quarter sister to the dam of Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) winner Big Brown (Boundary).

The reduced numbers this year may create extra demand and prove a minor blessing to vendors. Certainly there are some gems to be found and there is no doubt that many sold will add to the success of the sale's excellent history.

Now he is a Group 1 weight-for-age winner he does have a value at stud so that may be an option for him come June, July next year," co-trainer Ciaran Maher told the Moody on the Mic podcast, which is hosted by fellow trainer Peter Moody. "Hong Kong is still on the agenda. I put him in there just in case," he said. "I am probably leaning toward not going but it is there as an option." Instead, Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, indicated that he will look to claim two Sydney Group 1 events in the autumn. "He will have a couple of easy weeks. He will stay in work ticking over, he will go to Australian Cup, Queen Elizabeth and you never know, he may be looking to get some back underneath him after that," Maher said.

Back Brazen Boy at your peril: Stokes

Phillip Stokes yesterday warned punters looking to back Brazen Boy (Brazen Beau) in tomorrow's Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m) that the Sandown favourite may not be the good thing they think he is. The juvenile sits at the top of the market off the back of a 14-length romp in a Morphettville trial but his trainer issued words of caution over his chances of repeating that feat. "I think he's a nice horse, but he's very green," Stokes told Racing.com. "He will be very vulnerable from barrier 12. Back him at your peril. If he wins, I'm happy to be wrong. But I think he's got a lot of learning to do. I've won this race and I know what it takes. I'm not spruiking him at all. Let's just see how he goes. I'd like him to find a bum and I think if he goes to the front he could be run over because he doesn't really know what he's doing."

Staying trips suiting Princess Jenni

David Brideoake believes Princess Jenni (High Chaparral) can keep her winning run going when she takes her chance in tomorrow's Zipping Classic (Gr 2, 2400m) at Sandown. The five-year-old got on the scoresheet for the first time in over a year when tried over the longer trip for the first time, landing last month's Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m), and Brideoake reports the mare to have come out of that race in fine shape. "She's needed time to mature and she now has the level of maturity to cope with that trip, which I think is perfect for her," the trainer said. "She's finally got out to a staying trip and she was totally suited by it. She's very sound and has made good progression. She's ready to go. Her gallop on Tuesday was good

and her demeanour is really good. We've got Jye McNeil on again and hopefully we can have a good result."

Snowden keen on 3200-metre test for Carif

Peter Snowden is hoping his decision to bypass the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) with Carif (So You Think) for a tilt at tomorrow's Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m) will be rewarded when the talented stayer lines up against ten rivals. Last year Carif finished second to True Self (Oscar) in the Queen Elizabeth and that mare made it two in a row in the Flemington race last weekend. Snowden believes Carif would have been in the finish of that race again but, keen to see him over 3200 metres for the first time, he decided to head to the Sandown feature instead. "This is an opportunity to see whether he can run two miles, which is something we've been looking at for a while with him," Snowden said. "His last run was very good. He never got a crack at them and normally he'd back up in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes but I'm keen to see him over 3200 metres," he said.

Syndicator chasing another Newcastle feature

Australian Bloodstock have already plundered two of Newcastle's showcase races this year and they will chase another with three runners in tomorrow's The Hunter (1300m). The Kris Lees-trained trio of Tactical Advantage (Bel Esprit), Special Reward (Demerit) and Chief Ironside (Lawman) will all line up in the valuable contest as connections aim for more glory at the track. "We've won the Newmarket, the Newcastle Cup... This is now a race where we ran second in it the first year, so it's obviously going to be high on our priority list going forward," Australian

Bloodstock director Jamie Lovett said. "The three going into the race, to be fair, are probably going in off last-start performances that don't give you a lot of confidence. But on their day, they're all up to a race like this."

Weight drop to help Catesby

A significant weight drop has influenced Grant Allard's decision to start consistent sprinter Catesby (Shamardal) in tomorrow's Keith Noud Quality (Listed, 1200m) at Doomben. In addition to the 1200-metre stakes event, Catesby was entered for a Class 6 race but the disparity in weight the gelding was allotted in each event forced the trainer's hand. "I was going to run him in the 1110-metre Class 6 but they gave him 61 kilograms so I thought, while the horse is in good form and consistent, I'd give him a chance in a race that presented itself which was the Keith Noud," Allard said. "While he's fit and well and at the top of his game he deserves a crack. He gets down in the weights and he's drawn the one (gate) so he gets his chance."

Solaia on track for Champion Fillies

Darren McAuliffe is hoping Solaia (Toronado) can benefit from the vital experience she gained when fourth in Listed company last time out when she steps up in grade again in tomorrow's Champion Fillies Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Ascot. Just under three lengths separated Solaia from the reopposing Snickerdoodledandy (Snitzel), Kissonallforcheeks (Written Tycoon) and Magical Dream (Dream Ahead) and McAuliffe believes his charge can reverse the form this time round. "She had a really big blow and got trapped on the wrong part of the track," the trainer told rwwa.com. "She sort of got held up from behind and had to wait to make a sprint. She was on the wrong part of the track with all the winners winding up on the outside. I expect her to improve."

Exceed And Excel colt wins trial

Two-year-old Wizard Of Oz (Exceed And Excel), a \$1.1 million Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase by Coolmore from the draft of Milburn Creek for breeder Nick

Wakim, won a Rosehill barrier trial yesterday. Out of Frankel (Galileo) mare Dream In Colour, the Chris Waller-trained Wizard Of Oz won heat four over 900 metres by a long neck in a time of 55.80 seconds over El Parmy (Snitzel) and Civil War (Choisir) who ran third. In the following heat the John Sargent-trained Readily Availabull (Bull Point) took out the barrier trial by one and three-quarter lengths in a time of 55.19 seconds. The runner-up was another Coolmore-owned, Waller-trained colt in Zarastro (I Am Invincible) who was a \$1.05 million purchase from the Gold Coast January sale.

Flying Artie filly wins trial

Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) filly Ruby Kisses (2 f ex Kiss The Daddy by Scat Daddy) won heat seven at the Rosehill trials yesterday, in what was the quickest time for the two-year-old events, as she recorded a time of 34.92secs over the 900 metres. A \$70,000 purchase for Equi-com Syndications out of the Newgate Farm draft Ruby Kisses finished a quarter of a length ahead of Robodira (Husson) with Tapis Magique (Shalaa) third. Standing at Newgate Farm, Flying Artie won with his first starter when Princess Bojack scored at Eagle Farm on October 3.

My Gold Bracelet spelled

Group 2 winner My Gold Bracelet (Pins) has been turned out for the spring in preparation for some black-type targets in Victoria in the autumn. The four-year-old won three of her four starts in New Zealand for former trainers Johnno Benner and Hollie Wynyard, including the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m). She was then transferred to Mick Price and Michael Kent Jr's Caulfield stable where she placed on her Australian debut before two unplaced runs in the Lets Elope Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m). "She has been a little bit disappointing, but there is a reason for that," part-owner Jen Campin said. "I think the firmer tracks were against her. That's why we made the decision to put her out and wait for the autumn and get a bit of ease in those tracks for her. We haven't seen the best of her yet and Michael Kent Jr is very excited about her future."

Guineas-Oaks winner Arborea dies

Arborea (Imperial Prince), winner of the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) in 1993 has died at the age of 30. The winner of eight of her 30 starts and producer of eight winners, Arborea died of heart failure at Segenhoe Stud. Announcing the news on Twitter yesterday, Segenhoe's Peter O'Brien said: "It is with absolute sadness that we have to report that champion Arborea died as her enormous heart gave way at 30 years of age. Bred by Newhaven Park, who always checked on her welfare, and owned by John and Deb Camilleri who looked after her as she deserved." Arborea's victories in the Guineas and Oaks for her trainer Clarry Connors sandwiched another big-race win in the Wakeful Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m), while other notable successes came in the Phar Lap Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) and Chairman's Handicap (Gr 3, 2020m). Her best performed progeny was Delta Form (Marsday), who was a Grade 2 winner and Grade 1-placed in America, where Arborea spent seven years between 1999 and 2006. Her daughters Delicate Choice (Last Tycoon), Tycoon Tess (Last Tycoon), Altessa (Belong To Me) and Sunday Sensation (Royal Academy) also went on to produce international stakes winners.

Racing officials reviewing whip rule

Racing Australia' yesterday said the organisation's review of the rules around use of the whip were continuing after a study commissioned by the RSPCA found a horse's skin had a similar pain response to human skin. The study was funded by the RSPCA and led by veterinary pathologist Dr Lydia Tong and the Sydney School of Veterinary Science's Professor Paul McGreevy. It compared the outer layer of skin from horses and humans and found no significant difference. "This means that it is likely that horses respond to tactile pressure in a similar way to humans," McGreevy said. "What we found is that it's very likely that if whips hurt humans - which they unquestionably do - they also hurt horses." Responding to the announcement of the findings of the study, RA chief executive Myles Foreman said: "The Racing Australia board previously established a process to review riding protocols and that review is ongoing."

Jockey Potter injured

South Australian jockey Justin Potter was yesterday recovering from surgery on the hand and wrist injuries he suffered in a recent trackwork fall from an unraced two-year-old at Strathalbyn. "The doctor was satisfied with how the procedure went and first impressions are we will get a positive outcome," Potter told Racing.com. "I'm determined to ride again so for now we just need to be patient and then rehabilitate as best I can."

VRC welcomes new chief

Former AFL administrator Steve Rosich has officially been appointed as the chief executive of the Victoria Racing Club. Rosich was ushered into the post yesterday following a two-month transition period and replaces the outgoing Neil Wilson. The chief executive of the Fremantle Dockers for more than a decade, Rosich will also be charged with the task of steering the VRC through its emergence from the Covid-19 pandemic. Rosich says his first focus will be on getting members, owners and the general public back on course, a goal he hopes will be achieved in December, providing government restrictions continue to ease.

NEW ZEALAND

Late flight suits Tokorangi

Soliloquy Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) third Tokorangi (Redwood) is one of a number of North Island horses who caught a late flight to Christchurch yesterday morning in preparation for the New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton tomorrow. However, co-trainer Michael Moroney believes the hit-and-run raid on the fillies' Classic may work in her favour. "She just has to get down there in one piece," Moroney said. "I think the fact that she is flying in late will help her because she is not straight-forward. She has improved but temperament wise she has been a bit immature." Moroney is hoping she will shape up into a New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender before making the move to his Flemington stable in Australia. "I would think she would probably stay in New Zealand until the Oaks, if she looks like being an Oaks filly. But we are taking it a race at a time and we would like to think she is there

until at least Christmas time before we make a decision on whether she comes to Australia for the autumn."

Harlech to return to NZ

Meanwhile, Moroney reported that Benalla Cup (1406m) winner Harlech (Darci Brahma) will return to New Zealand to target the Captain Cook Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham and improve his credentials as a prospective stallion. "He is still a stallion, so we're chasing a Group 1 and we thought that the Captain Cook was ideal. There's not much left here (Melbourne) for him now and I didn't really want to back him up at Sandown this weekend," Moroney said.

Zed mare given chance in New Zealand Cup

Following her victory in the Metropolitan Trophy (Listed, 2500m) at Riccarton on Saturday, Robusto (Zed) will be given her chance by trainers Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman in tomorrow's New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m). "All she has to do is back up and reproduce that performance a week later," Forsman said. "She seems bright and well and in great order. It is just whether she can back up and again the difference between 2500 metres and 3200 metres is always an unknown. If she runs to the form she showed last Saturday she will be very hard to beat. She has drawn a middle barrier (12) again so it will be similar tactics, work forward, put yourself right there and let the others chase you."

Cup Day sold out

Tickets for New Zealand Cup Day tomorrow have sold out, resulting in no on-day sales at Riccarton racecourse. Canterbury Jockey Club reported that sales had reached the capacity of 15,000 on Thursday afternoon. A record number of horses are due to run, with 243 accepted across the 12-race card which features the 1000 Guineas in addition to the New Zealand Cup.

The Mitigator to step out at Awapuni

Group 1 winner The Mitigator (Master Of Design) will spearhead a three-pronged attack from trainer Peter McKay for today's meeting at Awapuni after the wet weather scuppered his chance of racing in the Tauranga Stakes (Listed,

1600m). "We are a bit disappointed," McKay said. "We had a lot of rain come through for Tauranga, hence why we couldn't start there in the weight-for-age. We gave him a nice trial at Matamata 11 days ago to ready him for that. This is Plan B and it will give us an indication of whether we go down to Wellington for the Group 1 (Captain Cook Stakes) or back up to Auckland for the Group 3 race (Eagle Technology Stakes) he won last year."

Karaka Million 3YO likely for Aegon

2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Aegon (Sacred Falls) will likely be aimed at the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (1600m) on January 23, but a delay in returning from the South Island could see him enter the race without a lead-up run, according to co-trainer Andrew Forsman. "There was a delay with the (Cook Strait) crossing and he should be back in Cambridge on Friday sometime," said Forsman. "We probably have run out of a bit of time and he could go into the Karaka Classic without a run at this stage. By the time he gets back he probably needs a couple of weeks to let down and get over the trip."

UK: Zoustar to stand at Tweenhills for £25,000

Shuttle sire sensation Zoustar (Northern Meteor) will stand at Tweenhills Farm & Stud in England for a fee of £25,000 (approx. AUD\$45,225) in 2021. That figure is a drop of £5,000 on his fee for 2020 and is in keeping with a number of reductions announced by the major studs in the northern hemisphere over recent days. Zoustar's first northern hemisphere-bred crop of foals will hit the European market in the coming weeks, to much anticipation. "Zoustar continues to enhance his already heady reputation and it is a real coup for European breeders to have such an exceptional young sire standing here again in 2021," Tweenhills's owner David Redvers said. "The reviews his first crop of northern hemisphere foals are receiving match our expectations and I'm really looking forward to seeing his first commercial offerings at the end of the month." Joining Zoustar at Tweenhills will be Kameko (Kitten's Joy), the fastest ever winner of the 2,000 Guineas (Gr

1, 1m) who has had his introductory fee set at £25,000 ahead of his debut season on stallion duty.

IRE: Major upgrade for Wootton Bassett as Coolmore release 2021 fees

Coolmore have unveiled the 2021 covering fees for their all-conquering roster of stallions, including newcomers Arizona (No Nay Never), Sottsass (Siyouni) and Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj), and perennial champion sire Galileo (Sadler's Wells). Wootton Bassett will stand his first season in Ireland, having been purchased from Haras d'Etreham in August, at a career-high €100,000 (approx. AUD\$162,550) - up from €40,000 during his final French term. Sottsass, who rounded out his racing days with victory in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m), has been introduced at €30,000 (approx. AUD\$48,750). Arizona retires to stand alongside his own sire No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) after a racing career that saw him land the Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) during a juvenile campaign in which he showed high-class form. He is priced at €7,000 (approx. AUD\$11,375). Galileo, who will claim his 12th champion sire crown in the coming weeks, is set to stand a 14th consecutive season at a private fee. Other fees announced include Australia (Galileo), who will stand for €25,000 (approx. AUD\$40,640), down slightly on the €27,500 he was available at in 2020. Another Derby hero Camelot (Montjeu) has seen his fee go in the opposite direction, up to €45,000 (approx. AUD\$73,150) from €40,000 on the back of another productive campaign.

IRE: Circus Maximus retired to stand at Coolmore

Circus Maximus (Galileo), the winner of three Group 1 races in a career which saw him continuously competitive in the top mile races on either side of the Atlantic, has been retired at the age of four. Racing in the colours of the Niarchos family and owned in partnership with the Magnier, Tabor, Smith axis, Circus Maximus made the breakthrough at elite level when taking out the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Royal Ascot in 2019 in what at the time looked like a bold move by his trainer Aidan O'Brien, having previously finished unplaced in the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f). The drop in distance however, proved to be the making of him as the colt added further victories in the Prix du Moulin (Gr 1, 1600m) and Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) as well as a whole host of placed finishes, including when second behind stablemate Order Of Australia (Australia) in what proved to be his final start in the Breeders' Cup Mile (Gr 1, 1m). "Circus Maximus is very tough and travels with a lot of speed," said O'Brien. "He's that type of horse that can often make very good stallions. We'll definitely be breeding to him." The winner of five of his 17 starts, Circus Maximus will be joining the stallion ranks at Coolmore in Ireland in 2021 where his introductory fee has been set at €20,000 (approx. AUD\$32,500).

EUR: Sea The Stars tops Aga Khan stallion roster as Siyouni fee soars

The Aga Khan Studs have announced fees for their five-strong stallion roster, which is spread across Giltown Stud in Ireland and Haras de Bonneval in France. Heading the list of prices

The Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) hero continues to produce some impressive stats, with his progeny operating at ratios of 12 per cent stakes winners-to-runners and 66 per cent winners-to-runners. He is joined at Gilttown Stud by his dual Derby-winning son Harzand. The seven-year-old will again stand for €8,000 (approx. AUD\$13,000). The Haras de Bonneval roster is led by Siyouni (Pivotal), who has earned a hefty increase to €140,000 (approx. AUD\$227,670), up from €100,000 in 2020.

FRA: Golden Horde to stand at Haras de Montfort & Preaux

Golden Horde (Lethal Force), an impressive winner of this year's Commonwealth Cup (Gr 1, 6f) at Royal Ascot, is to take up stud duties at Nurlan Bizakov's Haras de Montfort & Preaux in Normandy alongside leading sire Le Havre (Noverre) and the

Queen's young stallion Recorder (Galileo). His introductory fee has been set at €10,000 (approx. AUD\$16,260). The announcement brings to an end a period of speculation as to where the Group 1-winning sprinter would stand after connections drew time on his racing days in mid-October. Golden Horde was trained throughout his ten-race career by Clive Cox, who also oversaw the racing campaign of his sire.

UK: Newsells Park Stud reveals fees for 2021

Newsells Park Stud has announced their stud fees for 2021 with Nathaniel (Galileo) set to stand for a fee of £15,000 (approx. AUD\$27,125) and their new stallion, Group-1 winning miler Without Parole (Frankel), standing for £10,000 (approx. AUD\$18,000). Commenting on the fees, Newsells Park Stud's general manager Julian Dollar said: "Nathaniel's progeny have enjoyed another strong year with a further four Group winners in 2020, led by Enable, who made history this summer with a record third win

in the Group 1 King George. With ten Group/Stakes winners and performers this year, and an ever expanding list of Group winners, Nathaniel offers breeders incredible value at £15,000 for this multiple Classic-producing sire."

FRA: Mandatory Covid-19 tests for jockeys

Jockeys riding in France will have to undergo regular tests for Covid-19 from next week as authorities seek to maintain racing's reputation for operating safely behind closed doors. Three high-profile riders have been ruled out of action in recent days following positive tests, with both Christophe Soumillon and Ioritz Mendizabal missing winning rides at the Breeders' Cup and Cristian Demuro also currently self-isolating. From November 19 all riders will be required to have tested negative within a period of ten days. Any jockey that returns a positive result will subsequently need to undergo blood analysis proving the presence of coronavirus antibodies before being allowed to resume.

Daughter of Medaglia D'Oro in foal to Speightstown leads trade at \$500,000

Momentum continued into Wednesday's third session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, with the top price being the \$500,000 (approx. AUD\$688,725) paid by Coteau Grove Farms/Cary Bloodstock for the broodmare Contributing (Medaglia D'Oro), in foal to Speightstown (Gone West).

Second-top lot was the \$435,000 (approx. AUD\$599,200) given from Baccari Bloodstock for a weanling colt from the first crop of undefeated 2018 Triple Crown winner Justify (Scat Daddy).

During a day of brisk trade, Keeneland sold 196 horses for \$25,063,000 (approx. AUD\$34.52 million), for an average of \$127,872 (approx. AUD\$176,137) and a median of \$107,500 (approx. AUD\$148,075).

Cumulative results for the November Sale's first three sessions reached \$102,528,000 (approx. AUD\$141.23 million) for 521 horses, for an average of \$196,791 (approx. AUD\$271,000) and a median of \$125,000 (approx. AUD\$172,180).

"Overall, the energy today was really good," said Keeneland president-elect and interim head of sales Shannon Arvin. "We saw a lot of competition for foals. Some new buyers and many of the same buyers from the first two days continue to participate."

"We would love to see stability of the market throughout the sale, similar to what we experienced during the September Yearling Sale."

Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency consigned Contributing, a six-year-old stakes-winning daughter of Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) from the family of Kentucky Oaks (Gr 1, 9f) winner Believe You Can (Proud Citizen).

"I bought one Medaglia D'Oro mare in foal to Speightstown earlier, so I figured why not hit a double?" said buyer Andrew Cary.

"It's an awesome pedigree and Speightstown is showing again how awesome he is, with a horse like [undefeated track record-setting stakes winner] Nashville. Contributing's sister produced an Oaks winner. She's gorgeous and she could run. To me she's the whole package."

Weanlings commanded six of the day's seven highest prices.

The \$435,000 weanling, consigned by Elm Tree Farm is a half-brother to multiple Grade 2 winner Pretty N Cool (Scat Daddy) and is from the family of Grade 1 winner Sean Avery (Cherokee Run). His dam is the stakes-placed Stayclassysandiego (Rockport Harbor).

"I've been looking for a really good Justify, and he has a lot of female pedigree, plenty of size and plenty of strength," said buyer Chris Baccari.

"Anybody that looks at him when he goes to be resold will see he looks like he has plenty of bone and looks like he can take a lot of training."

"The weanlings by Justify are very good. The public is going to support him now and his yearlings. He was a very good racehorse and I'm a big fan. This colt reminds me of his sire. He has a lot of raw strength like he did."

"The mare is a good producer, and that is what I'm looking for. That is what determines the value to me. He had a good physical, but he has the pedigree to go with it."

Jody Huckabay, who owns Elm Tree with his wife Michelle, was pleased, saying: "This is [breeder] Nancy Shuford's horse, and I think we are pushing 25 years doing business together."

"He was a nice colt and we had the right people on him, but we certainly did not expect that. In this market with everything going on, we are blessed to have the opportunity to sell a horse like that."

Colts by Justify have been the most expensive weanlings of each of the first three sessions of the November Sale, starting Monday with a \$600,000 purchase, a price equalled by a colt by 2015 Triple Crown winner American Pharoah (Pioneer of The Nile) and a \$475,000 buy on Tuesday.

Larry Best's OXO Equine was the day's leading buyer, spending \$1.63 million (approx. AUD\$2.24 million) for six broodmares and weanlings. He paid \$400,000 (approx. AUD\$551,000) for a weanling colt by Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday), whose son Authentic won Saturday's Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f) at Keeneland, and \$360,000 (approx. AUD\$495,800) for a weanling colt from the first crop of champion Good Magic (Curlin), winner of Keeneland's Blue Grass Stakes (Gr 2, 9f).

"I tend to go earlier now for weanlings as opposed to waiting for them to be yearlings," he said after buying the Good Magic colt. "You take more risk, but you are not spending the same amount of money. You might get two or three shots on goal for what you'd be paying at the yearling sales."

Paramount Sales, agent, consigned the son of Into Mischief, who is a half-brother to multiple Grade 3 winner Awesome Slew (Awesome Again) and stakes winner He's Bankable (Arch). The colt is out of the stakes-winning mare Seeking The Gold (Slewfoundmoney).

"That was a gorgeous Into Mischief," said Best, who has been successful racing offspring of the stallion. "Beautiful horse – beautiful walk. You could have told me he was by any other sire and I would have bought him. He just looked so, so good."

The \$360,000 colt by Good Magic sold to Best is a half-brother to Grade 2 winner Lovely Bernadette (Wilburn) and from the family of

Breeders' Cup winners and millionaires Shared Account (Pleasantly Perfect) and Sharing (Speightstown). Consigned by Bedouin Bloodstock, he is out of the winning mare Inlovewithlove (Bernstein).

"I am trying to diversify with different sires," Best said. "I bought a Mastery, an American Pharoah filly, etc. This one is by Good Magic and

was good looking. Physically, this was about as good as you are going to get for a weanling.

"I expected to get him for \$250,000 or \$300,000. I had to go a little higher, but the right people were on it."

Paramount Sales led all consignors during the session, selling 24 horses for \$3,285,000 (approx. AUD\$4.52 million).

The Mauritian ace's fourth treble this season saw him draw level to reigning champion. Purton with 23 wins, while Moreira sits nine clear of his rivals with 32 wins.

Teetan capped his three-timer with a double for trainer Me Tsui, as Namjong Plus held off the fast-finishing Reel Bizzy (Kodiac). The seven-year-old sealed his sixth Hong Kong win at his 26th start.

"I thought he was knocking on the door - he deserved the win," Teetan said.

The veteran stepped away cleanly from the inside draw to hold a position close to the speed on the rail before peeling out at the 400-metre mark to take over with 100 metres left to play out.

"I think the draw helped him, if I hadn't drawn gate one, I could have ended up using him a bit to get a decent position," Teetan said.

"I knew the leader was going to take me into the race and I got a nice trail right through. He fought on nicely, he got lost a little bit when he hit the front because he hit it pretty early and the horse down on the outside encouraged him a little bit to keep going."

Earlier, Teetan kicked off his treble with victory aboard Chunghwa Jingshen (Rubick) in the opener, the Class 5 Sheung Wan Handicap (1000m). Peter Ho was the successful handler and he nailed a running double when Hay Run (Delightful Choice)

landed the Class 5 Victoria Handicap (2200m) under Derek Leung. The second of Teetan's and Tsui's two wins on the card came with Best For You (Not A Single Doubt) in the Class 4 Shek Tong Tsui Handicap (1650m).

"Best For You had a good spot and I was actually surprised that he broke so well, Me (Tsui) said to me he's been jumping well so if he does, take that advantage and sit him in a good position," Teetan said.

"I felt Zac (Purton) on my inside and I think my horse was not finding much until he came - it encouraged him to go again."

Sky Darci stamps Classic Mile credentials

Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) laid out his credentials for a tilt at the Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) the first leg of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series, with a win full of merit in the finale, section one of the Class 3 Belcher Bay Handicap (1200m).

"We'll go to 1400 metres in December then go for the Four-Year-Old Classic Series," winning trainer Caspar Fownes said.

The gelding mustered early from the gates to hold a midfield position under jockey Joao

Moreira, before turning for home and switching back to the inside to pull away in style for a tidy two and three-quarter length win.

"He's always indicated that he is a nice horse," Moreira said. "Today he really proved that, winning with the top weight on his back after not really jumping very well; sticking himself in between horses and just running away - that's all you can ask from a good horse."

"He just did not let us down - he's a nice horse," the Brazilian ace added.

The New Zealand-bred took his already impressive record to four wins from seven starts and maintained his unbeaten start to this term with two good Class 3 successes.

"No doubt he's smart, it's not his trip as well - we've just been trying to pinch a few races along the way. He's pretty good," Fownes said.

Fownes could have a strong hand in the Hong Kong Classic Mile on January 24, should stablemate and fellow exciting juvenile Sky Field (Deep Field) opt to go there.

"He's definitely a miler, he's another one, like Sky Field, I'm just so happy for these owners, they have two nice young four-year-olds. That was quite a good effort with 133lb, to do that," Fownes said.

South African G1 winner seals Callan double

Neil Callan secured his first double this season with some help from trainer Paul O'Sullivan, as the pair combined for two wins together, wrapped with a smart victory from Lobo's Legend (Trippi) in section two of the Class 3 Belcher Bay Handicap (1200m).

"It's always nice to get a winner, never mind a double, but we'll take as many as we can," Callan said.

"I mentioned to Paul that when he got him, he had run well over here at Happy Valley. I knew he was versatile, he can handle it, he's a small horse carrying top-weight and he knuckled down when he had to. It was a good win."

The South African import was a Group 1 winner at his final start before arriving in Hong Kong, winning the SA Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) at Turffontein in Johannesburg.

"His first run for me was good, he just found the 1000 metres a little bit short – I was working on the theory that he probably just wants to run 1200 metres and that proved that today, even though he has won a Group 1 over 1800 metres," O'Sullivan said.

"But he was aided by a good draw and a good ride – we got all of the favours today and we were lucky enough to win it."

The South African-bred six-year-old could step out on the dirt at Sha Tin next start. His sire Trippi (End Sweep) was a top-class dirt sprinter as a three-year-old, beating More Than Ready (Southern Halo) in the Vosburgh Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Belmont Park in 2000.

"I think he's placed in Class 2 previously and he's always trialed particularly well on the dirt," O'Sullivan said. "He has a lot of American bloodlines in his pedigree, so if we get the option to run in a Class 2 on the dirt that'll probably be our next move."

Initially booked to ride California Levee (Moohaajim) in the first section of the Class 4 Sai Ying Pun Handicap (1200m), the scratching

of the Irish-bred meant Callan was without a ride but the promotion of O'Sullivan's Oriental Elite (Star Witness) proved a fruitful one as the gelding went on to score by a half-length.

Vagner Borges edged closer to double figures this season with his ninth success, driving home the Ricky Yiu-trained Colonel (Ferlax) to win section two of the Class 4 Sai Ying Pun Handicap (1200m).
