## Bell River Excited about Snitzel mare's Lightning tilt

*Pfeiffer-trained five-year-old given chance in Group 1 despite Nature Strip stumbling block*

**M**eticulous planning to gain a Group 1 credit for valuable broodmare prospect I Am Excited (Snitzel) could come to fruition in the \$750,000 Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington tomorrow.

Prominent breeder James Ferguson said the time-honoured sprint provides the perfect

opportunity for the dual Group 2 winner to enhance her credentials at the elite level.

"We have no doubt she is a Group 1 mare and they are the races we are specifically targeting this autumn," Ferguson told ANZ Bloodstock News, whose family's Bell River Thoroughbreds part-owns the five-year-old.

The winner of six races and \$758,325 in prize-money, I Am Excited has yet to be placed in the highest company but still rates as an outstanding breeding proposition. *Continued on page 2>>*

Her dam, Lady Beckworth (General Nediym), has also produced the Group 3 victor Flippant (Hinchinbrook), while Lady Beckworth is herself a half-sister to Regard (Zabeel), who is the dam of two of the best fillies of their generation in Atlantic Jewel (Fastnet Rock) and Commanding Jewel (Commands).

"Even if she can run a place on Saturday it will add a lot to her value," Ferguson said.

I Am Excited will tomorrow kick off a campaign that is earmarked to include the \$1,250,000 Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on March 7 and the \$1 million Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville on May 2.

Straight course specialist Nature Strip (Nicconi) dominates betting for the Lightning but the event is far from a one-act affair, according to Ferguson.

"Funny things can happen in small Group 1 fields," he said.

"My father (Andrew) was involved in He's No Pie Eater and I can vividly remember watching him win his first Group 1 as an 80-1 chance."

He's No Pie Eater (Canny Lad) caused a boilover with Zac Purton aboard in the 2007 Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Warwick Farm before winning the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) at a much shorter price three weeks later.

I Am Excited proved herself to be a giant-killer when she upstaged Redzel (Snitzel) in the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm last April.

Ferguson has advised punters to overlook I Am Excited's four subsequent failures, including two in Melbourne in the spring.

"She had some issues last year and the only time we had her right was when she beat Redzel," he said.

"Her last campaign was a write off but she is back with a bang."

Warwick Farm trainer David Pfeffer has primed I Am Excited for her first-up assault with two barrier trials at Randwick.

"She's had a couple of trials and David has kept her fresh for the 1000 metres," Ferguson said.

"It's probably short of her best distance but when the speed is on she can unleash a devastating turn of foot.

"And there looks to be plenty of pace in the race."

I Am Excited meets only six rivals in a select line-up tomorrow, with the septet boasting combined earnings of more than \$24 million in prize-money, topped by dual Everest (1200m) winner Redzel on \$16,093,500.

Nature Strip is unbeaten in four starts at Flemington, with his latest appearance resulting in a devastating all-the-way win in the \$2 million VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) on November 9.

I Am Excited could cap off a huge week for Bell River Thoroughbreds, which achieved outstanding results at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale in Sydney.

Bell River sold a Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) colt for \$300,000 and a son of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) for \$280,000 from a star-studded draft.

"It was a phenomenal result," Ferguson said.

"We started planning for this three years ago and to see it come off was extremely rewarding."

### MM National Sale open for entries

The sale begins with the National Weanling Sale on May 21 and 22, followed by the National Broodmare Sale from May 26 to May 29 and then the National Yearling Sale from June 3 to 5, concluding with the National Racehorse Sale, also taking place on June 5. Entries for the weanlings, yearlings, race-fillies and broodmares close on March 13. Entries for racehorses close on May 25.

### Dame Giselle to start Slipper campaign

The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Dame

Giselle (I Am Invincible) will begin her tilt towards the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) when she runs in the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) at Randwick tomorrow. The filly has not been seen since her terrific victory in the Golden Gift (1100m) where she defeated current Slipper favourite Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook). Despite the expectation of a heavy track at Randwick, Peter Snowden says Dame Giselle needs to run to keep to her autumn schedule. "The good thing about her is she's got her money. I can set a target and if it doesn't come off it's not the end of the world for her so I can take my time," Snowden said. "She's in good order, her trials have been good, she looks great. I'm really happy with her and she's coming along nicely."

### Freedmans chasing more juvenile success

Fresh from winning the \$2 million Inglis Millenium (RL, 1100m) on Wednesday, Richard and Michael Freedman have now turned their attention to securing a spot in the Golden Slipper with Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) Ticket To Ride (Vancouver), who also runs in the Lonhro Plate. "I'm hoping we can somehow qualify her to get into the Slipper," Michael Freedman said. "Her next two starts will probably determine that." While the filly is untested on a heavy track, conditions she is likely to face at Randwick, her two runs have been full of merit, both from wide draws. "The sectionals she reeled off (last start) were pretty good and hopefully from a slightly better draw on Saturday we might be able to position her a bit closer to the front, certainly not leading, but she can be a bit handier and be that bit closer when she lets down," Freedman said.

### Valuable Akari ready to resume

Brad Widdup's dual stakes-winner Akari (Snitzel) faces a tough first-up assignment in tomorrow's Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick and the trainer admits she will need to have improved during her time off to compete with the likes of Libertini (I Am Invincible) and Lyre (Lonhro). "She probably has to improve to be getting near them as well," Widdup said. "But they're the only three-year-old fillies races that are available and I wanted to have her ready for them. I'm more than prepared to give her a crack at them."

### Light Fingers to determine Libertini's autumn

Anthony Cummings will determine the autumn targets for his star filly Libertini, who holds nominations in both the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Arrowfield Sprint (Gr 2, 1200m), after she runs in the Light Fingers Stakes tomorrow, but he is hopeful she will finish her campaign with a Group 1 on her resume. "In a perfect world she has won a couple of Group 1s and established herself as the best three-year-old filly," Cummings told Racing NSW. "That's the wish list isn't it? And a couple could be four."

### 'Lyre's back to her best'

After a winless spring campaign, connections of the Anthony Freedman stable believe their 2019 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Lyre is back to her old self and is ready for a fruitful autumn, starting with the Light Fingers. "She's done very well and seems to be back to her old self," assistant trainer Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "She never looked great in the spring, her coat never really came through. But she's looking much better, her trials have been better and we're looking forward to her showing her two-year-old form."

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## Cummings unsure about Alizee on wet

James Cummings is in two minds about running triple Group 1 winner Alizee (Sepoy) in tomorrow's Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) with concerns she will not be suited to the likely wet track. "At this stage it doesn't seem likely that she'll get the track she prefers at Randwick and might be kept for the Futurity (February 22)," Cummings said. "She motored home stylishly in the Expressway behind a very promising three-year-old. Since then she's had a very sensible and straightforward build-up."

## She's Ideal to continue progression

She's Ideal (Dundeel) is the dominant favourite to take out tomorrow's Catanach's Handicap (2400m) at Randwick and land a hat-trick of wins. While Bjorn Baker is hopeful she can take the next step in her career, the trainer isn't taking anything for granted. "It's another step up and it's further (in distance) but she has handled a wet track in the past which gives me a bit of confidence," he told Racing NSW. "You have some fit horses in the race who have been over the trip and can handle wet as well so it is definitely not a gimme. I was thrilled with her last win and I'd like to think in time over ground she is up to black-type, especially if she continues to improve the way she has."

## Straight track to aid Tofane

It's a tough assignment first-up, but Mike Moroney believes Tofane's (Ocean Park) perfect record down the Flemington straight will hold her in good stead for tomorrow's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and is the most suitable option leading into her target race, the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at the same track. "We thought this was suitable for two reasons, being three weeks to the Newmarket and a bit more practice down the straight," Moroney said. "She's had a little bit of practice down there having trialled two or three times. The small field will no doubt help. She won't get as far off them, but we're well aware it is only 1000 metres. She will be solid at the finish and is a more mature mare now. I just want to see her working home and giving a good indication of what might come in the Newmarket."

## Catalyst primed for Aussie debut

The Oaks Stud general manager Rick Williams is predicting a career-best performance from star New Zealand three-year-old Catalyst (Darci Brahma) in tomorrow's CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington. "Any horse that travels is at a disadvantage and we've seen that with the good Aussie sprinters that have come over here and been beaten. It's been a long time since an Aussie horse won a Group 1 race over here," Williams said. "But he's got the perfect temperament to do it because quite simply nothing bothers him. He's settled in over there like he hasn't even left home and we think he's due a career-best performance on Saturday. He's a much-improved horse physically from where he was in the spring. Damian Lane came out and galloped him at Mornington this week and gave him the thumbs up and Clayton (Chipperfield, trainer) said he couldn't be happier with him."

## Alligator Blood on song for C S Hayes

Set to take on Catalyst in the CS Hayes is star Queensland gelding Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) and David Vandyke is delighted with how he has settled into his Melbourne. "Ryan (Maloney, jockey) rode him in his gallop on Tuesday and that was an excellent piece of work and this morning Ryan said 'I can't believe how well he feels'," Vandyke said. "So that's a good enough rap for me." Alligator Blood was the \$2.15 favourite yesterday ahead of Catalyst (\$2.50) and Dalasan (Dalakhani) (\$6). It's going to be a wonderful contest," Vandyke said. "Dalasan, what a great horse. He had his excuses in the Caulfield Guineas Prelude and indeed the Caulfield Guineas. And Catalyst, how can we say anything except positive comments about Catalyst. It was a fantastic win at Ellerslie recently. It's going to be a great contest. We could finish third and Al could still be putting in his best performance."

## Vanity kick-off for Pretty Brazen

Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Pretty Brazen (Brazen Beau) will begin her campaign in The Vanity (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington

tomorrow and Calvin McEvoy, who trains in partnership with his father Tony, is hopeful the three-year-old filly can carry her spring form over to the autumn. Pretty Brazen won a recent 800-metre jump-out at Flemington, lowering the colours of Despatch (Written Tycoon) and Tofane, both entrants in the Lightning Stakes. "We were very happy with Despatch's jump-out but I think the jump-out of Pretty Brazen would have taken the cake," Calvin McEvoy said. "She's a miler, or we think she's a miler, and to beat a 1200-metre Group 1 winner over 800 metres is pretty impressive. Luke (Currie, jockey) thought she felt very sharp and was in the right order for The Vanity on Saturday for her first-up run."

## Eric The Eel on Sydney path

Stuart Kendrick's promising three-year-old Eric The Eel (Olympic Glory) will begin his campaign towards the Sydney autumn carnival tomorrow when he runs in the Class 3 Plate (1200m) at Eagle Farm. "I am really keen to get him going. The 1200 metres should be too short but he will get back anyway and be running home late," Kendrick said. "Everyone who rides him says the same thing - he wants ground. And I am looking forward to seeing him on the big Randwick and Rosehill tracks." Kendrick has Eric The Eel nominated for the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) and Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

## High expectations on Xerri

A \$410,000 purchase at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Xerri (Snitzel), will make his debut in the \$125,000 QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap (1000m) for Toby and Trent Edmonds at Eagle Farm tomorrow. "He is named after the boom Cronulla rugby league player Bronson Xerri," Toby Edmonds said. "If our Xerri is half as good a horse as he is a footballer we might have something." By champion sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) out of Sempre Libera (Medaglia d'Oro), Xerri comes from the same family as Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Merlene (Danehill) and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Dear Demi (Dehere). "His trial win at the Gold Coast was good and he has the right bloodlines," Edmonds said.

## Scales Of Justice to William Reid

Lindsey Smith has ruled Scales Of Justice (Not A Single Doubt) out of a potential tilt at next month's All-Star Mile (1600m) and the seven-year-old will instead return to the track and distance of his recent Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) success to contend the William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Moonee Valley on March 20. Writing on Twitter, Smith said: "Scales Of Justice will not be progressing to the All Star Mile. Instead we will freshen him up and bring him back for the G1 1200m William Reid Stakes at Moonee Valley Friday March 20."

## Eagle Farm track holding up

The Brisbane Racing Club is confident Eagle Farm will have a soft surface at worst for tomorrow's fixture, despite being hammered by 325 millimetres of rain in the past ten days. Rated as a soft 5 yesterday, Racing Queensland tracks manager Mick Goodie, who oversees Eagle Farm, said the track would remain in the soft range and would probably get to good, despite rain being forecast for today. "It was what this track is designed to do - take a lot of rain. The only problem would be visibility with heavy rain on the raceday," Goodie said.

## Doomben abandoned

Racing at Doomben was abandoned yesterday due to an unraceable track. Stewards inspected the course yesterday morning and said more than 60 millimetres of overnight rain had rendered the track unraceable. Doomben has received around 320 millimetres of rain in the past week, while yesterday's abandonment was the second week in a row Doomben lost its Thursday fixture.

## Moody to keep numbers 'manageable'

Peter Moody, who has reapplied for his training license almost four years on from saddling his last runner, does not want to become the big commercial trainer he once was and is aiming for a team around a quarter of the size he had in his pomp. "One thing I've learnt in the last four years is there's more to life than being a horse trainer," Moody told RadioTAB. "I want to make sure I time manage myself so much better than I did previously to have time to do other things, experience other walks of life. I've enjoyed that in

the last four years and I don't want that to end." Before relinquishing his license in March 2016, Moody had between 350-400 horses on his books, with 100-110 in work at his Caulfield stables, another 100-110 in pre-training and another 100-150 in the spelling paddock. This time around, he wants to keep those numbers to around 40 in work, another 30 in pre-training and another 30 spelling."

## Cripps receives TIC Chairman's Award

Jack Cripps, a 22-year-old former truck salesman in Western Australia, received the prestigious chairman's award from Thoroughbred Industry Careers (TIC) for his attitude towards learning at the graduation ceremony of the inaugural intake of explorer cadets on Wednesday. Cripps, who now has a fulltime job at Tony and Calvin McEvoy's Flemington base, was a shining star amongst an impressive group of cadets who made the most of the opportunity to participate in the 12-month stud and stable training programme. Two other cadets, Kiara Henderson from Murrumbidgee, NSW and Kaitlyn Summers from Murrumbidgee, NSW, were also recognised on the night, sharing the outstanding achievement award in all areas of horsemanship.

## Big crowd tipped for Buchan

A 3,000-strong crowd is expected to descend on the 133rd Buchan Cup meeting tomorrow as the Canni Creek track continues to recover from being ravaged by the recent Gippsland bushfire. Buchan and Gelantipy Racing Club's secretary manager Ian Dunkley said 1,400 racegoers usually attend the fixture, which will feature a six-race programme, but he is expecting that figure to double given recent events. As well as the action on the track, which is headlined by the \$6,000 Buchan Cup (1700m), there are children's activities, a footballers' gift race over 100 metres and fashions on the field. In addition, the Melbourne Cup will also make a special appearance accompanied by Cup-winning jockeys Greg Hall and John Letts.

## Bunbury redevelopment expected in May

The construction tender for the new racing and training surfaces at the Bunbury Turf Club,

including an engineered drainage system, is due to be released next week, with the construction tender for the replacement of raceday stalls set to be distributed by the end of this month. As such, training will continue to be available at Bunbury until at least the end of April, with the civil works expected to commence on the track in May. Following the start of the construction, training will not be available at Bunbury for approximately 12 months. Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWAA) expects to be able to schedule a return to racing at Bunbury in late 2021.

## NEW ZEALAND

## Scorpz maintaining top form

The Stephen Marsh-trained Scorpz (Charm Spirit) will continue on his path to the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) when lines up in the Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2100m) at Ellerslie tomorrow. A Group 3 winner in November, Scorpz was last seen running third in a 1600-metre open handicap at Te Aroha last month. "We were rapt with that third. He's a horse that's going super," Marsh said. "Getting him back to Ellerslie and back over ground is the real key to him. He's going really well and I can't wait to see him get to the 2400 metres. He's right on track."

## Tylers aim trio at Southland Guineas

Kelvin and Aimee Tyler are set to launch a three-pronged assault on the Southland Guineas (Listed, 1600m) at Ascot Park tomorrow. The trio are headed by last-start Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m) winner Lightning Jack (Per Incanto), who has been installed as the \$2.70 favourite, and he will be joined by stable companions He's Got Power (Power) and Kitty Power (Dalghar). Regarding Lightning Jack, who has drawn the outside barrier in the 11-horse field, Kelvin Tyler said: "From the outside gate he will probably have to go back a bit. I don't like hunting them out too much - hopefully he can get a nice run. The Invercargill track sometimes has a front-runners bias, so he'll probably need a bit of luck, but I couldn't be happier with the horse."



# Not A Single Doubt colt speeds to Valley track record

**S**tronger (Not A Single Doubt) found his Hong Kong feet in fine style at Happy Valley on Wednesday, blitzing the Class 3 Fanling Handicap (1000m) in a track record time of 0.56.11.

The Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) colt arrived in town with a smart juvenile profile from his time in Australia, having landed a Group 3 contest at the Gold Coast on his final start before import. And the three-year-old repaid the faith of trainer John Moore with his local breakthrough on Wednesday.

"He wasn't cheap because he's a good looker and he's still an entire because he's got a great disposition. George (Moore, son and agent) and I actually bid on him back when he was a yearling but we stopped because he ended up going for about \$1.1 million," Moore said.

"He's a handy horse otherwise he wouldn't

be in Hong Kong. He's here because they (the previous connections) didn't see a lot of upside but we hope we can take him well up into Class 2 and then into the bottom of Class 1. I still think there's some upside."

Champion jockey Zac Purton got a smart break out of Stronger from gate two and opted to stalk the front-running Multimillion (Tycoon Ruler) on the fence. His mount loomed up powerfully on that rival's near flank when switched out at the top of the straight.

"Zac got off and said that was easy," Moore added, having watched his charge sprint away to a cosy length and three-quarter win.

"He said that in the gate tonight he was really quiet for an entire; he jumped smartly and had the gun run all the way.

"It was just how much gas was left in the tank at the corner? He just quickened really

nicely. I think we've got him in the right place now – there's another two wins in him this season. He won facile today."

Purchased at the Inglis Sydney Easter Yearling Sale by James Harron Bloodstock, Stronger realised \$1.05 million from the draft of Arrowfield Stud.

Subsequently trained by Peter and Paul Snowden for a partnership that included Harron's colts syndicate, Stronger won three of his seven starts in Australia, including the Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) last May.

Purton snared a double on the night, having taken his strike-rate this season for trainer Benno Yung to 26 per cent when Amazing (Medaglia d'Oro) became his fourth winner for the stable. The Australian delivered the 21-race maiden with a late inside run to nick the opener, section two of the Class 4 Sai Kung Handicap (1200m), by a short-head.

## Galaxy sparkles at long odds

Ping Hai Galaxy (The Factor) was an unconsidered 159/1 chance to win Wednesday evening's finale, the Class 3 Fo Tan Handicap (1200m), but John Size's charge belied those odds with a comfortable win under Matthew Poon.

The four-year-old had been unplaced at each of his five previous starts, which included running last of 14 at Sha Tin on his most recent outing. But the grey – unbeaten in two outings in Queensland pre-import – put those reversals behind him on his first start at the Valley with a half-length score in a time of 1.09.14.

"I think the key is that he travelled really smoothly," Poon said. "His last couple of starts he fought and used his energy early and couldn't finish.

"Mr. Size decided to bring him to Happy Valley over 1200 metres and this time there was good speed and he travelled really well. He was breathing very well, he was smooth, and that's why he could hit the line.

"He ran a good time, so he just needs the race to be smooth so he can get a rhythm and then he will be able to show this ability again."

show when Heavenly Thought (So You Think), runner-up to Dark Dream (All American) in the 2018 Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2200m) and now under the watch of trainer Frankie Lor, finally broke his Hong Kong duck. The five-year-old took section one of the Class 3 Kwai Chung Handicap (1650m) under premiership leader Joao Moreira.

Moreira completed a race-to-race brace aboard Farshad (Kendargent) in the night's penultimate contest, section two of the Class 3 Kwai Chung

Handicap (1650m). The Me Tsui-trained grey was another to earn a first Hong Kong win.

Bulb Elite (Iffraah) also broke his Hong Kong maiden – at the 25th attempt – in the Class 4 Tai Po Handicap (1650m). The Dennis Yip-trained six-year-old had dropped to a career-low rating of 43 and plugged on dourly from a handy spot under Alexis Badel to hold off race-favourite Everyone's Elite (Dalakhani).

Grant van Niekerk made the most of a spare pick-up when he filled in aboard Takingufurther (Exceed And Excel) in section one of the Class 4 Sai Kung Handicap (1200m) after Keith Yeung was ruled out due to sickness. Van Niekerk took the five-year-old to the lead and was never headed in posting an easy three and a half-length win – trainer Jimmy Ting's first for the month.

Acclaimed Light (Acclamation) relished the good tempo in the Class 4 Tsuen Wan Handicap (1800m), so much so that he surged away to a two and three quarter-length win in a class-record time of 1.48.10. The eight-year-old's success marked jockey Neil Callan's fourth win for the Paul O'Sullivan stable this term, at a strike rate of 23 per cent.

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin on Sunday, February 16.

The David Payne-trained Bazooka looks to have the potential for longer distances after breaking through for his first win in three starts at Warwick Farm on Wednesday.

Racing on a heavy 9 track, the gelding began well and settled back in third place on the rails before improving nearing the home turn. He got to the front at the 200 metres and then drew

away to score comfortably by two and a quarter lengths, running the 1300 metres out well.

One of two winners from five foals out of Valerina (Val Royal), Bazooka is a half-brother to the stakes-placed Reckless Russel (Excellent Art) and was purchased at the Scone Yearling Sale by Payne for \$14,000 from the draft of Sledmere Stud.

Valerina, who was placed in Australia, is a half-sister to the Group 2 winner Spuruson (Flying Spur) as well as the stakes-performed Flying Tamari (Flying Spur).


Bazooka's third dam is french Group 3 winner

and Group 1-placed Kanmary (Kenmare), who produced the champion sprinter in the USA in 1996, Lit De Justice (El Gran Senor). She has also produced the Racing Post Trophy (Gr 1, 1m) winner Commander Collins (Sadler's Wells) and Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f), Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) and 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) placegetter Colonel Collins (El Gran Senor).

Bazooka's sire, Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock), is responsible for 16 individual Group 1 winners and he stood at Twin Hills Stud for a fee of \$22,000 (inc. GST) in 2019.



# ON THE WATCH

## Unbeaten Hanseatic produces another brilliant closing sectional at Caulfield

**H**anseatic (Street Boss) stamped himself as a high-quality colt in overcoming difficulties when taking out Saturday's Blue Diamond Prelude (C&G) (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield to remain unbeaten in three starts, yet again producing brilliant closing sectional times.

Appreciating a good barrier (2) on this occasion, Hanseatic settled closer in sixth place, but he was shuffled back badly nearing the home turn. Luke Currie could only manage a clear run by taking him widest of all on straightening but had to concede the leaders many lengths in doing so.

Hanseatic then produced his now trademark turn of foot to grab a neck victory over talented colt Rulership (I Am Invincible), who looked the winner after dashing clear at the 200 metres.

The stopwatch subsequently confirmed what most onlookers had come to realise - they had just seen a brilliant performance from an outstanding colt.

And the best demonstration of Hanseatic's pace was his closing sectionals, using the following breakdown from the 1000-metre point: 21.35 (400m), 11.66 (200m) and 21.87 (400m) to give the colt a brilliant 54.88 for his last 1000 metres.

The Godolphin-raced and Anthony Freedman-trained Hanseatic has now appeared in On The Watch after all three of his starts, with all of those victories being highlighted by outstanding sectional times.

Hanseatic now heads to the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday week as the dominant favourite. He is a \$2.30 chance with the TAB, with Rulership next at \$6.00 and the filly Letzbeclam (Snitzel) at \$8.00.

**Letzbeclam** was the surprise \$31.00 winner of Saturday's Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 2, 1100m) but her performance was very good, despite what her odds may have indicated.

The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained filly was advancing quickly in class after winning a Two-Year-Old Fillies' Maiden (1100m) first-up at Werribee on January 21.

After a good beginning from the outside barrier, Letzbeclam was the widest of three vying for the lead before going to the front halfway down the straight. She then drew clear to score decisively by two and a quarter lengths

from the well-performed filly Muntaseera (I Am Invincible).

Significantly, the race time of 1:02.79 was 0.29 faster than the 1:03.08 recorded by Hanseatic in winning the colts' division.

However, while excellent, Letzbeclam's closing sectionals were not as good as Hanseatic's, with the filly clocking 55.02 (last 1000m), 44.74 (last 800m) 34.30 (last 600m) and 22.93 for her last 400 metres.

But she now remains as a live chance in the Blue Diamond Stakes, especially considering she worked most of the way on a solid pace before drawing away to win convincingly in an impressive performance at only her second start.

In the feature race of the day, the CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), the Mike Moroney-trained

colt **Alabama Express** (Redoute's Choice) also overcame a wide trip to score in a smart time, his fourth win from only seven starts to date.

He settled nicely in fifth place but he was trapped three wide most of the way before improving rounding the home turn. Alabama Express took the lead at the 200 metres and then fought back gamely to defeat Group 1 winners Fierce Impact (Deep Impact) and Kings Will Dream (Cassamento).

The time for the 1400-metre journey was 1:22.07 and Alabama Express returned excellent closing sectionals, with his last 1200 metres in 1:07.64, last 1000 metres in 56.19, last 800 metres in 44.87, last 600 metres in 33.56 with his final 400 metres in 22.37.

But the sectional star in the CF Orr Stakes was Godolphin's three-time Group 1 winner **Avilius** (Pivotal), who ran on well from back in third-last place in the 12-horse field to finish (1.7 lengths) fifth.

Having his first start since finishing seventh in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) in October, Avilius returned the fastest closing sectionals of the race, with his last 1200 metres in 1:07.27, last 1000 metres in 55.35, last 800 metres in

44.18, last 600 metres in 33.22 and final 400 metres in 22.11.

On a day of fast times in windy conditions at Caulfield, one of the fastest-run races was the Rubiton Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) won by the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained filly **Anaheed** (Fastnet Rock).

Having her first start since finishing a good third in the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Moonee Valley in October, Anaheed tracked the free-running leader Sartorial Splendor (Brazen Beau) who set a breakneck pace.

Sartorial Splendor (from the 1000m to the 200m) clocked 20.66 (400m), 31.86 (600m) and 42.86 (800m) before fading halfway down the straight to finish last.

Anaheed dashed clear at the 200 metres and then went on to win well by a length and a quarter from recent Kensington Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Bold Star (Needs Further).

The time for the Rubiton Stakes was only 0.39 seconds outside of the 1100-metre track record, with the race being clocked at 1:02.12 (11.29 200m rate), which is equivalent to 1200 metres in 1:07.76.

Anaheed's closing sectionals were also impressive, with her last 1000 metres in 53.99, last 800 metres in 43.69, last 600 metres in 33.13 and last 400 metres in 21.99.

It was Anaheed's fifth win and her fourth at stakes level from 12 starts, with the talented filly looking primed for a very good preparation.


The runner-up **Bold Star** also deserves mention as the consistent South Australian-trained gelding made up many lengths after racing back in second last place in the nine-runner field.

Bold Star returned some of the fastest closing sectionals of the race, with his last 1000 metres in 53.97, last 800 metres in 43.66, last 600 metres in 32.78 and final 400 metres in 21.73.

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


