Kah drives Nature Strip back into Group 1 winner's circle

Extreme Choice colt Stay Inside emerges as genuine Golden Slipper contender for the Freedmans

Gifted horsewoman Jamie Kah arrived on the world stage as a jockey yesterday when she steered the sometimes troublesome Nature Strip (Nicconi) to victory in the Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington.

A highly accomplished equestrian with Olympic aspirations, Kah has a fierce reputation

for getting the best out of difficult horses and her unique skills came to the fore as she softly guided the six-year-old gelding down the Flemington straight.

After moving clear with 300 metres to run, Nature Strip had enough left in reserve to see off the challenge of his fast finishing stablemate September Run (Exceed And Excel) by half a length. *Continued on page 2>>*

Swats That (Shamus Award) was another length and a quarter away in third.

"What a horse, he's just unbelievable. That was amazing, it really was. Honestly, I just let him do whatever he wanted to do. He relaxed and dropped the bit and it set it up beautifully for him," said Kah.

It was the fourth Group 1 success for 25-year-old Kah who currently leads the Melbourne jockey's premiership by a staggering 20 wins.

It was also her first major win for champion Sydney trainer Chris Waller for whom she'd only ridden twice previously.

"To get on a horse like this for Chris Waller, I just couldn't imagine it."

Shortly after dismounting, an emotional Kah, who rode a treble at headquarters yesterday having taken the opener on Quantum Mechanic (Deep Field), as well as partnering Zou Dancer (Zoustar) to victory in the Vanity Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m),

was in awe of the horse she had earlier described as "like riding a Ferrari".

"In his work and trials he does everything so effortlessly. He was in a great mood today and he was when I trialled him. He's getting better with age," she said.

It was the fifth Group 1 win for Nature Strip who is Widden Stud stallion Nicconi's (Bianconi) biggest flag bearer in Australia.

The 2019/2020 Australian Horse of the Year's career record now stands at 15 wins from 28 starts and he's banked more than \$6 million.

Waller, who watched the race from Randwick, was thrilled to see Nature Strip return to the Group 1 winner's circle for the first time since landing the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last April.

"It was satisfying. We've made everybody aware that he was hard to get right in the spring and a few things went against him in his races," Waller said.

"A horse like him needs everything to go right. It was a well-judged effort and it's good to have him back."

"It's a lot of hard work behind the scenes that goes into these types of horses from a lot of people. It was an exciting race to watch."

Whilst much of the spotlight fell on Nature Strip yesterday, September Run's effort signalled an exciting autumn campaign ahead.

Waller confirmed last spring's Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner will return to Flemington for a tilt at the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) in three weeks' time.

Stay Inside enters Golden Slipper picture

Whilst Nature Strip was the sole Group 1 race winner in Australia yesterday, two-year-old Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) colt Stay Inside announced himself as one for the future with a dominant performance in the Pierro Plate (1100m) at Randwick.

Now unbeaten in two starts, the Richard and Michael Freedman-trained youngster had jockey James McDonald in raptures after the race and he's now considered a major contender for next month's Golden Slipper (Gr 1,1200m).

After defeating Godolphin's Vianello (Teofilo) by a commanding four lengths, Stay Inside joined Enthaar (Written Tycoon) and Profiteer (Capitalist) at single-figure odds for the \$3.5million Rosehill contest on March 20.

When pressed to compare him with the likes of next weekend's raging Blue Diamond (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Enthaar, McDonald said: "He's close to the top there. I love his attitude. He takes everything in his stride and is the ultimate professional. He will be very hard to beat (in the Slipper).

"I just want to get on and ride him again," said McDonald.

Co-trainer Michael Freedman was hoping for a dominant performance by the youngster to confirm connections have a genuine Slipper contender and he was content with what he saw. He is however under no illusions that Stay Inside needs to raise the bar even higher

"To keep the dream alive he probably had to come out and, not only win today, but win well in my view because he is going to have to go to the next level again in two or three weeks time," Freedman said.

"The other nice thing is it looks like he handles a wet track so that gives us a few options as well."

The Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on March 6 is shaping as the next stepping stone for Stay Inside as he heads towards the Slipper.

Stay Inside was a \$200,000 purchase by Freedman Bros at the 2020 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is one of four winners for Newgate's first season sire Extreme Choice, along with the Jamie Richards-trained colt Palamos and city winners Abseiler and Tiger Of Malay.

Colette shines on return to set up Queen Elizabeth date

The James Cummings-trained Colette (Hallowed Crown) continued to build the profile of her sire Hallowed Crown (Street Sense) when she made a stunning return to action to take out the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m).

Ridden by Rachel King, the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) and Golden Eagle (1500m) winner relished yesterday's soft track conditions at Randwick, beating a star studded field that included runner-up Kolding (Ocean Park) and 2020 Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Verry Elleegant (Zed), who got motoring late and ran an encouraging third.

The mare had never won below 1500 metres, nor first up, but neither statistic mattered as she came home two lengths clear of her nearest pursuer, producing a performance which connections hope will set her up for a tilt at the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) back at the same track in April.

Cummings was not surprised by the victory and said Colette had been working strongly at home.

He believes she has the potential to emerge as one of the new stars on the block as she continues to mature.

"She is the horse that is really improving from one prep to the next," he said.

"She got all the way to the Oaks in one campaign and she is only first-up in her third preparation so far.

"She is well and truly on her way to producing perhaps her best preparation.

"She has been going so well she has well and truly got the Queen Elizabeth on her radar and when it gets on the radar, it's hard to get it off."

King said she became increasingly confident in Colette's chances as persistent rain fell at Randwick.

"It was probably the best I've had a horse travel on that track all day and when she travelled into the straight like that and got to the top of the rise I knew I still had plenty of horse underneath me."

"To do that without the blinkers on, that's the first time she's ever done that and it didn't seem to worry her. She's beaten a really good field today and first-up over 1400 metres was a really good effort," said King.

Colette has now won six of her 12 starts, amassing almost \$5 million in prize-money in the process.

Rose blossoms in Light Fingers upset

Flashy Every Rose (Choisir) skipped away to cause an upset In the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as she posted a first success since taking out the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) back in October 2019.

Trained by Mark Newnham, the chestnut with a flaxen mane and tail and long white stockings led throughout under Josh Parr to beat the fast-finishing

Never Talk (No Nay Never) and favourite Away Game (Snitzel) with less than half a length separating the front three as they hit they line.

Newnham had been thrilled with the three-year-old leading into the race, although a soft track and outside draw dented his confidence.

"Her best runs have been when she's allowed to gallop," Newnham said.

"She has got good speed. She won the Gimcrack in similar fashion then just got beaten by King's Legacy in Brisbane doing that."

"It was heart in the mouth stuff. I was very confident at the corner but it was just a matter of whether her condition would hold out."

Newnham said the filly had suffered several minor setbacks which had prevented her from adding to her debut win.

"It has been a bit of a patience game with her after winning the Gimcrack Stakes," he said.

"She's had a few little niggles but this time in she has had a trouble-free prep and it all went to plan."

Tagaloa Guineas-bound after CS Hayes victory

The 2020 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) rediscovered that sizzling form, albeit in different silks, when he turned in a powerful on-speed effort to win the C S Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington yesterday.

Wearing the Yulong colours of bottle green, white checked sleeves and white cap after a recent part-purchase of the colt, Tagaloa was challenged inside the final 200 metres by Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) placegetter Aysar (Deep Field), but forged clear late under new rider Luke Currie to score by a length. Mo'Unga (Savabeel) was a further three-quarters of a length behind in third.

Co-trainer Natalie Young was delighted to declare: "Tags is back" after admitting the winless 12 months with the colt had been frustrating.

"Thank God, what a relief," said Young, who trains in partnership with Trent Busuttin. "It's fantastic, actually. Dominated that today, and he (Currie) gave him a peach of a ride and it worked out perfectly."

Four of the past six winners of the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) have landed the race having previously taken out the Hayes, and Young said Tagaloa will attempt to add to that tally in a fortnight.

"In a couple of weeks' time (Australian Guineas) he's going to meet half the same field with two kilos (better) at the set weights so it's really nice going forward that he's keeping his value."

"He's got that Group 3 win as a three-year-old. I think Mr Zhang, Yulong, will be happy. All the owners, they'll be at home watching and hopefully they're jumping and screaming like I just was."

Malua Racing's Zou Dancer (Zoustar) also has the Australian Guineas on her agenda after taking the step up in grade firmly in her stride with a win in the Vanity Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington yesterday.

Zou Dancer carried a low domestic rating of just 68 into the race but she emerged as a potential Group 1 winner after she spanked VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Personal (Fastnet Rock) by almost five lengths when recording a most impressive time for the 1400-metre journey.

The three-year-old filly, who was having just her fifth race start, recorded a sizzling 1:22.32 for the journey and only an hour or so early the Group 1-bound **Regardsmaree** (So

You Think) won over the same trip in a time almost one second slower than Zou Dancer (1:23.19).

Troy Corstens, who trains the filly in partnership with father Leon, said the \$1 million Australian Guineas looked the race to aim for with the Zoustar (Northern Meteor) filly, who was winning for the third time in five starts having cost \$150,000 as a yearling for owners Bennett Racing.

"I'd say you'd have to start looking at the Australian Guineas," Corstens said. "We talked about it and we don't want to put the cart before the horse but we'll have a talk to Jamie (Kah) and see what she thinks."

"We've only had her for this preparation. She came from Tony and Calvin (McEvoy) and she came to us in terrific order so we can't say we developed her from a young horse but the Bennett boys said they were giving us a really good horse and they were right."

AUSTRALIA**Five for Capitalist**

Newgate's freshman sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) became the sire of five individual winners to date after he notched a double yesterday. The John McArdle-trained Tycoon Humma (2 f ex Humma Mumma by Bel Esprit) ran out an impressive winner of a maiden (1000m) on debut at Bendigo. The filly beat Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) fourth Frostin' (Frosted) by two and a quarter lengths, while Midwest (Zoustar), who started out unplaced in the Blue Diamond Preview (Listed, 1000m) was third. Tycoon Humma was a \$240,000 purchase by Redgum Racing at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale Book 1 from Flinders Park Stud. She is a half-sister to Group scorer Humma Humma (Denman) out of Humma Mumma (Bel Esprit) who is a full-sister to stakes winner Vignette (Spectrum). Meanwhile in New Zealand, Mozzarella (2 f ex Parmalove by Snitzel) claimed her second win on the bounce at Riccarton Park. Capitalist stood for a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

Four for Sooboog

Kitchwin Hills first season sire Sooboog (Snitzel) was responsible for his fourth individual winner yesterday when Moonlit Rose (2 f ex Lune Rouge by Malibu Moon) struck on debut at Rockhampton (1100m) for John Wigginton. The winner of a 900-metre trial at the same track 12 days earlier, Moonlit Rose got the measure of Calpurnia (Holy Roman Emperor), who had the benefit of experience, by a length and a quarter, while there was a further length back to Lasco (Flying Artie) in third. Moonlit Rose was a

\$26,000 Magic Million Gold Coast March Yearling purchase by the trainer from Lyndhurst Stud Farm. She is the fifth winner from six runners out of the American Listed winner Lune Rouge (Malibu Moon). Sooboog stood for a fee of \$13,200 in 2020.

17 for Zoustar

Zou Dancer's (3 f ex Investigates by Strategic) victory in the Vanity Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington yesterday provided her Widden Stud-based sire Zoustar (Northern Meteor) with his 17th individual stakes winner. Having won her maiden on her second start last November, the three-year-old was stepping up to stakes company for the first time on her fifth outing and she looks to have a bright future with the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on the agenda for the Leon and Troy Corstens-trained filly. Zoustar is about to start his third Northern Hemisphere covering season at Tweenhills Stud in England where his 2021 fee is £25,000 (approx. AUD\$44,615).

Five for Shooting To Win

The James Cummings-trained four-year-old Tailleur (4 m ex Clothing ex Commands) stepped up to stakes company for the first time yesterday and took out the Triscay Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick to become the fifth stakes winner for Darley sire Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor). Sent off as favourite, she got the better of Tricky Gal (Magic Albert) by a long neck and the pair were a length and a quarter clear of Icebath (Sacred Falls) in third. The consistent Tailleur has now won six of her eight starts and amassed more than \$400,000 prize-money. Shooting To Win stood at Kelvinside for a fee of \$16,500 in 2020.

Cummings considering Galaxy for Tailleur

James Cummings is now considering a tilt at the Galaxy Stakes (Gr 1, 1100m) next month with Tailleur following her breakthrough victory in the Triscay Stakes. "She's got the black-type win on the board so we can plot a path now with a little bit less pressure on our backs," Cummings said. "She is clearly very talented and an exciting mare and I'd like to think it won't be her last win." The decision is far from final, however the mare's three previous wins were on heavy ground, whilst yesterday's track was a Heavy 7, so the race is tempting for the trainer. "She could be kept fresh for a really good race like The Galaxy or we could just plot our path through the mares races in the next few weeks," Cummings said. "But there is something to be said for her down in the weights in a Galaxy and it would be pretty interesting if we did get a wet track."

Ten for Toronado

Swettenham stallion Toronado (High Chaparral) recorded a stakes race double yesterday with Masked Crusader and Solaria both notching their first stakes victories, taking the sire's individual tally to ten. Masked Crusader (4 g ex She's Got Gears ex Invincible Spirit), who was making his first start at this level, landed the Southern Cross Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick for Team Hawkes, while Solaia (3 f ex Isola Blu by Blackfriars), who has been knocking on the door for a win in this grade, took out the Challenge Stakes (Listed, 1500m) at Ascot for Darren McAuliffe. Toronado is about to embark on his seventh Northern Hemisphere covering season at Haras de Bouquetot in France where his fee for this season is €8,000 (approx. AUD\$12,500).

Platoon back to winning ways

Consistent stakes performer Platoon (Playing God) returned to the winner's circle yesterday for the first time since November 2019 when claiming the Cyril Flower Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Ascot. The Neville Parnham-trained five-year-old was dropped back in trip and recorded a half-length victory over Yeah Dardy (Demerit) and the mare Cryptic Love (My Admiration) was third of the nine runners.

Diamond Dilemma for Oliver after Ingratiating wins

Godolphin's Ingratiating (Frosted) is currently the leading representative for his sire and he maintained his unbeaten record down the Flemington straight with a win in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1200m) to make it two stakes wins from four starts. The victory causes a dilemma for jockey Damien Oliver with the colt now in the mix for next Saturday's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), along with Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m) runner-up Anamoe (Street Boss). "I always thought that he might want some blinkers and when we put them on during the week, you rarely see a horse improve like he did with them," Oliver explained to Racing.com. "I was expecting a big showing from him today. Probably last Saturday (after Blue Diamond Prelude) I had Anamoe in front but with the improvement this horse has made with blinkers, it has certainly narrowed the gap. I don't think there's a lot between them. I'll speak to James (Cummings) and see which way we go. My only concern was that he had 59 (kilograms) as a two-year-old against what looked like a reasonable race. He's done a good job there today."

Ryan has spring target for Regardsmaree

Nick Ryan is planning a spell and an autumn campaign for improving Regardsmaree (So You Think) following the four-year-old's victory at Flemington yesterday. The gelding was recording his third Melbourne victory on the bounce in the 1400-metre open class event, beating previous Group 1 placegetter Buffalo River (Noble Mission), and the trainer has Group 1 aspirations for Regardsmaree next spring. "He's an emerging young

horse and it was a good tough win running a horse like that down today," Ryan told Racing.com. "We might put him away now and look for something like the Rupert Clarke (Stakes) in the spring."

Will Freedman trains first city winner

Less than 35 minutes after his uncle Michael and father Richard trained impressive winner Stay Inside (Extreme Choice), Scone-based Will Freedman produced his first city winner at Randwick. In race three, the TAB Highway (1800m) Birdonawinningpost (Shooting To Win) got the young horseman's name on the metropolitan board. "This is grand final day for me, it's a really big moment," said Freedman following the milestone win.

Williams set to miss Blue Diamond

Craig Williams will miss next Saturday's Blue Diamond Stakes meeting after the stewards at Flemington handed him a nine-meeting careless riding charge for his ride on the unplaced Impi (Crowded House) in yesterday's final race on the card. The suspension is added to the eight-meeting penalty that the rider picked up at Ballarat last Sunday, which is due to end next Friday, when the new suspension will start. Williams will not be able to ride again until February 27, the day of the Australian Guineas meeting at Flemington. Williams is currently 35 winners behind Jamie Kah in his attempt to secure a seventh consecutive Melbourne jockeys' premiership.

Childs suffers shoulder injury

Jordan Childs is set to undergo surgery after suffering a shoulder injury in a fall at Moonee Valley on Friday night. Childs parted company with Zacouver (Vancouver) in the \$60,000 Ranvet Handicap (1200m) and the Victorian Jockeys Association confirmed yesterday that he sustained a fracture in his left shoulder. Childs therefore missed the ride on Fabergino (Maschino) in yesterday's Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) with Michael Poy stepping in to finish fourth on the mare. A post-race vet exam of Zacouver determined the three-year-old was lame in the near fore leg with a vet clearance required before her next start.

Nine for Medicean

Former Cheveley Park Stud resident Medicean (Machiavellian) sired his ninth individual elite level winner when the much travelled Royal Performer (8g ex Quadri by Polish Precedent) ran out a shock winner of the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa yesterday. Trained by Bob and Jenny Vance, the gelding who boasts wins in the UK and Hong Kong among his carry tally of nine victories from 29 starts, beat The Chosen One (Savabeel) by two and a quarter lengths with On The Rocks (Alamosa) just behind in third. Related to some minor winners, Royal Performer was actually offered as a yearling at an Ascot sale in November 2014 but was bought back for just £600 and began his racing career under the name of Turn Tide for trainer David Brown and owner John Fretwell. Medicean stood at Cheveley Park for 16 seasons before his death, aged 21, in 2018.

Vance left stunned by Royal Performer

Bob Vance was as surprised by many of the onlookers after the British-bred Royal Performer made it four wins from seven starts since arriving in New Zealand in October 2020 by taking out the Herbie Dyke. "What can I say, I just can't believe it," the co-trainer said. "I knew he was a good horse, but he got the perfect run. He was only gelded 16 months ago and when he came back from Hong Kong, we were very lucky to get to work with him. He's had a lot of chiropractic work and Jenny does all the intricate details, as I just ride him. Every time he has won lately, I've told Jonathan (Riddell, jockey) that he has a real turn of foot. He is such a lovely horse to work with and you'd love to have more like him. It's my first Group 1 as a trainer."

Melody Belle beaten in bid for record

Melody Belle's (Commands) attempt to win her 14th Group 1 was not to be yesterday as the mare returned ninth of the ten runners in the Herbie Dyke Stakes. A large on-course crowd were on hand to witness Melody Belle try and break the record that she currently holds with mighty mare Sunline (Desert Sun), but they were left disappointed as a rocky run in the home straight put paid to her winning chances. The six-year-old eventually finished eight lengths behind surprise winner Royal Performer. Her trainer Jamie Richards later reported that Melody Belle had pulled up well after getting an interrupted run and that she would have further examinations taken over the next few days.

Eight for Redwood

Westbury Stud's Redwood (High Chaparral) notched his eighth stakes winner yesterday when his three-year-old daughter Tokorangi (3 f ex Agent Ziva by Savabeel) was successful in the Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa. Asked for an effort 150 metres out, she bounded to the front before clearing away from pacemaker Zee Falls (Sacred Falls) who held on gamely for second from the fast-finishing Perfect Scenario (Iffraaj). Trained by Mike Moroney and Pam Gerard, it was Tokorangi's second win from eight starts and she has nominations for both the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Ellerslie on March 6 and the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Trentham on March 20. "We'll have a chat with the owners and with Mike (Moroney) to see where we go next," Gerard said. "She may go straight across the Tasman next, but for me the Derby (Gr.1, 2400m) is the one we want to look at." Tokorangi was purchased by Ballymore Stables at the 2019 Karaka Premier Yearling Sale (Book 2) for \$30,000. Redwood stood for \$8,000 in 2020.

Te Akau has Avantage in BCD Sprint

In what most pundits deemed a match race between Avantage (Fastnet Rock) and Levante (Proisir), it was marvellous mare Avantage who triumphed as she made it seven career Group 1 wins when posting a superb victory in yesterday's BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m) at Te Rapa. The opportunity to see two of the best mares racing

in New Zealand at present go head-to-head was thwarted when Levante effectively put paid to her chances when she missed the start by a conservative eight lengths. That did not worry the many Avantage supporters who watched jockey Opie Bosson weave some magic as he had the five-year-old in the trail after 400 metres despite starting from the extreme outside barrier in the eleven-runner field. Bosson moved Avantage forward to take the lead at the top of the straight and put the contest beyond doubt as he sent Avantage three lengths clear of her rivals, a margin that she held comfortably to the winning post to defeat Callsign Mav (Atlante) and Mascarpone (Shooting To Win), with Levante putting up a herculean effort to run fifth. Purchased by David Ellis for \$210,000 from The Oaks Stud premier draft at Karaka in 2017, Avantage was bred by Southland couple Willie and Karen Calder from their Group 1-placed mare Asavant (Zabeel).

Bosson believes more in store for Avantage

Opie Bosson was thrilled the pre-race plan that had been devised for Avantage worked out perfectly in yesterday's Group 1 sprint. "We wanted to ride her aggressively, put her forward and if Levante was five lengths off us, she would have trouble picking us up," he said. "She is just a gutsy racehorse as you can ride her back, ride her forward and it doesn't matter as she is just a gun. She is very similar to Melody Belle and she has now won seven Group 1s and there is more in store for her." Jamie Richards, who prepares the mare for the Te Akau Avantage Syndicate, has his eyes on an Australian prize later in the current campaign. "You never like to see what happened at the start because as racing enthusiasts you want to see it pan out on an even-playing field," he said. "Unfortunately, that's how it goes sometimes and Avantage was able to put herself up in a good position and had them in trouble a long way from home. She is getting better now as she can put herself up in a race, which she couldn't do before. She is just getting more professional each time and her big group of owners are having the ride of a lifetime. We'll take a couple of days to think about things, but there is the Group 1 at Otaki at the end of the month. I really do believe she has a Group 1 win in Australia in her and I would like to give her that opportunity."

Amarelinha win caps big day for tangerine army

The Te Akau Racing tangerine colours were to the fore 30 minutes later when exciting three-year-old filly Amarelinha (Savabeel) scored handsomely in the David & Karyn Ellis Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) to make it three wins on the day for Richards after Festivity (I Am Invincible) had won earlier on the programme. The winner of the Eight Carat (Gr 2, 1600m) in December, she was narrowly beaten by Aegon (Sacred Falls) on her last start in the Karaka Million 3YO Trophy (Listed, 1600m) and was duly sent off as favourite back against her own sex. Getting clear running 150 metres out, she burst clear to win by four lengths from the fast-finishing Slave To Love (Savabeel), while pacesetter Needle And Thread (Makfi) stayed on for third. Amarelinha was purchased for \$300,000 from the Waikato Stud draft at the 2019 Karaka Book 1 by David Ellis and is now three wins and two seconds from five career starts for over \$264,000 in prize-money. "She is a really exciting filly and one we have held in high regard right from the time that David bought her at Karaka," Richards said. "She reminded us a lot of Probabeel and we didn't race her as a two-year-old, mainly due to coping Covid-19 at the back end of the season. She has more than made up for that this time in, as that was a pretty exciting win."

ASIA

169 for Deep Impact

Akaitorino Musume (3 f ex Apapane by King Kamehameha) took out the The Daily Hai Queen Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) at Tokyo yesterday to become the 169th individual stakes winner for her late sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence). The Sakae Kunieda-trained three-year-old broke her maiden on debut over course and distance in November and got the better of newcomer Art De Vivre (King Kamehameha) by a neck while Artemis Stakes (Gr. 2, 1600m) runner-up Kukuna (King Kamehameha) was the same distance back in third. A Kaneko Makoto Holdings homebred, Akaitorino Musume is out of multiple Group 1 winner and Champion Two and Three-Year-Old Apapane (King Kamehamha), making her a full-sister to Group-placed Jinambo and Rhinebeck.

INTERNATIONAL**SAF: Malmoos back to winning ways**

Malmoos (Captain Al) registered what is likely to be one of the final big race winners for Shadwell in South Africa when bouncing back to winning ways to land the Gauteng Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) at Turffontein yesterday. The Mike de Kock-trained colt, whose only defeat in six starts came in the Cape Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on his previous start, beat Catch Twentytwo (Elusive Fort) by a neck with Copper Mountain (Noble Tune) another length and a quarter behind in third. Malmoos has now won three times in stakes company.

SAF: War Of Athena strikes again

War Of Athena (Act Of War) kept her winning run going when scoring as favourite in yesterday's Gauteng Fillies Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m). Trained by Paul Matchett, War Of Athena was winning for the third time in succession and sixth in total as

she beat Anything Goes (Var) by two lengths with Miss Elegance (Master Of My Fate) a further four and a half lengths away in third. Twice placed at the highest level, War Of Athena now has three wins in stakes company.

SAF: More stakes success for True To Life

True To Life (Duke Of Marmalade) notched a first win in almost a year with a victory in Turffontein's Tommy Hotspur Handicap (Gr 3, 1000m) yesterday. The Johan Vuuren-trained four-year-old added to her tally of five wins by defeating Winter Stories (What A Winter) by a head to record her second win in stakes company. Despite her recent barren run she has been running consistently well in defeat, including when fourth in Grade 1 company four starts previously.

UK: New £250,000 Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Bonus

Back-on-song Sacred Croix gives Walker a treble

A big leap in class proved to be no barrier to Sacred Croix's (Savabeel) recent form resurrection on Saturday.

A four-in-a-row winner early in his Kranji career, Sacred Croix subsequently went through a barren run that was closing in on two years before he finally sprang back to winning ways at his last start, in Class 3 company.

Arguably, a similar type of race would be the safest way to let the confidence grow again, but trainer Mark Walker raised the bar even higher in this Saturday's S\$100,000 Golden Ox Stakes, a Class 1 race over 1400m.

The six-year-old was venturing into elite territory that included the likes of Muraahib (Reset), Fame Star (Twirling Candy) or former Singapore Horse of the Year, I'm Incredible (Lope De Vega).

But with only 47.5kgs and Singapore's current hottest property, Hakim Kamaruddin, on his back, it proved to be a well-calculated gamble for the horse Walker also races under the Remarkable Stable banner, though the Kiwi mentor later revealed it was more by default - there was no other race.

Well backed into S\$12, Sacred Croix came with a well-timed run to make it back-to-back wins. Upon straightening, tearaway leader Fame Star looked to have taken an unassailable lead, but the closers were not far from getting him on a level pegging as the EW Barker Trophy winner started to get the staggers at the 200m mark.

Leading the charge was Muraahib, while Sacred Croix then looked a bit of a forlorn hope, with still about five lengths to make up on Fame Star.

Hakim initially went for the rails run, but with Muraahib lugging in and narrowing down the gap, the quick-thinking lad judiciously made the switch to the outside. Once they saw daylight, his mount opened up with a pulsating

turn of foot to go and score by one and a quarter lengths from Muraahib who just nutted Fame Star out into third place by a short head.

Sacred Croix clocked the smart time of 1min 21.53secs for the 1400m on the Short Course to register his sixth win from 23 starts for prizemoney that is just a little under S\$360,000.

"The horse has struck a lot of wet tracks. He also went too quickly through the grades and lost his way," said Walker to explain the period the form was on the wane.

"He had a nice spell and has come back in good shape. He is stronger and carries a bit of condition again."

"Unfortunately, there aren't quite enough races around for him, there are limited opportunities."

The win capped a good day at the office for Walker, given he also prepares earlier winners on the card Entertainer (Zoustar) and Mustengo (Minstrel Court), with the treble taking his 2021 score to nine winners. However, reigning champion trainer Michael Clements still holds a two-win margin on Walker thanks to a double with Heartening Flyer (Excelebration) and \$140 longshot Palateas (Iffraaj) in the last race, the S\$50,000 Lucky Ox Stakes, a Class 4 Division 2 race over 1100m.

Sun Trek shows plenty of promise on debut

Australian import Sun Trek (Lonhro) franked his Melbourne form as well as his handy barrier trial form at Kranji with a slashing debut win on Saturday.

On his two thirds at Moonee Valley when known as North Trek for the leading Hayes & Dabernig training partnership, the four-year-old was clearly a cut above the lot he was pitted against in the S\$20,000 Maiden race over 1200m on the Polytrack.

Still, trainer Desmond Koh and owner Sun Bloodstock could not afford any room for complacency, especially when it comes to that first start in a foreign land.

But to their great relief and delight, the Melbourne metropolitan form stacked up from start to finish. Taking a sit on the outside of City Knight (Golden Archer), Sun Trek was off and gone in a jiffy the moment he was given his head upon cornering.

The late-closing Kakadu (Eurozone) was the one who won the battle for the minors just under five lengths astern with Rocket Ryane (Deep Field) third another two lengths away.

Backed down to S\$11 favouritism, Sun Trek reeled the Polytrack 1200m off in 1min 11.58secs.

"This horse came with a pretty good record. The only question mark was the wide barrier (nine)," said Koh.

"He did show some speed in his work, but nothing too blistering. So I wasn't sure how he would go, plus there was a bit of a ding-dong fight to come across."

"But once he settled outside the leader, he travelled relaxed and was too good in the end."

"I would say he's a middle-distance type of horse. He'll definitely get over more ground."

"It's great to train another winner for Mr Cheng (Ting Kong). He's been a great supporter of mine over the years."

Heartening Flyer even more impressive after break

The 1200m was feared as too sharp for Heartening Flyer (Excelebration) but the promising galloper still scored a scintillating win at his racing comeback on Saturday.

Not seen since his hard-fought win in Class 4 company in a 1400m race back in September, the Tivic Stable-owned four-year-old was a lot more dominant even though he was first-up and tackling stronger opposition in the S\$70,000 Fortune Ox Stakes, a Class 3 event over 1200m.

The economical rails-hugging run courtesy of barrier No 1 was a massive help, but he somehow looked to be making heavy weather of it at the 300m when jockey Louis-Philippe Beuzelin peeled him off for his run.

But once he hit top gear, he suddenly sprouted wings to go and put the race away as he pleased.

Siam Warrior (Exceed And Excel) and Makkem Lad (Kuroshio) were fighting out the finish but were swamped at the 200m with Wecando (Per Incanto) coming from well back to snatch second place two lengths away.

Heartening Flyer's stablemate Spirit Of Big Bang (Intikhab), who was coming back after an even longer time on the sidelines (13 months) for a leg fracture, stuck on nicely for third another neck away, just blousing out the duelling pair of Siam Warrior and Makkem Lad.

Sent out the short-priced favourite at S\$9,

Heartening Flyer ran the 1200m on the Short Course in 1min 9.12secs.

Champion trainer Michael Clements' assistant-trainer Michael White said he only dreaded the distance, but the horse's natural ability saw him through.

"He was going up in class after a break, and if he was to be beaten one day, today was the day," said White.

"But he's come back a better horse. He still had a look around when he hit the front, but he can switch off better and is going the right way."

"The Derby is his target – if that race takes place at some stage this year."

The Singapore Derby run over 1800m is the third and final Leg of the Singapore Four-Year-Old Challenge.

Beuzelin sent an ominous warning when he said Heartening Flyer was only at 50% of his peak ability.

"He's still a bit fresh and it took him a while to get into his strides," said the French jockey.

"It's a good thing he was drawn one and wasn't too far behind as we thought 1200m would be too short for him. It's only after the winning post that he put in the big strides."

"He'll get fitter from the run. He was only 50% of his best today."

With that fourth win from only five starts, Heartening Flyer has amassed more than S\$145,000 in stakes money for the Tivic Stable.

Ricvelo brings beginner's luck to new owner

Just a few weeks after durian trader Richard Go realised his dream to own a racehorse through the takeover of Alexander Horatio and renaming him Ricvelo (Toronado), the new venture bore fruits instantly when his new pride and joy scored at his very first start in his colours on Saturday.

And as a double happiness, Go could not have picked a more auspicious occasion than the Chinese New Year to savour his good fortune as a brand new horse owner under his stable moniker Richstad Stable.

Ridden by Louis-Philippe Beuzelin, Ricvelo (\$21) was scrubbed up from his wide alley to find the front around the first bend before trading the lead with favourite Malibu Beach (Malibu Moon) down the backstraight.

Upon straightening, Malibu Beach was not pulling away like a top pick should, but on the other hand, Ricvelo had saved his best for last as he rallied again along the rails to stride away to a brilliant maiden win by one and a half lengths.

Probably worn out by his tough run in a one-off spot in the lead, Malibu Beach eventually lost second spot to Master Sommelier (Burgundy) to run third another three parts of a length away. The winning time was 1min 40.07secs for the Polytrack mile.





ANOTHER STAKES-WINNING GRADUATE



Analysis: **Nature Strip** recorded his fifth Group 1 victory with a very smart first-up performance, aided by a perfect ride by Jamie Kah. She settled the brilliant sprinter nicely, tracking the free-running leader (Pippie) before taking him to the front on the far side at the 300m. He then fought back well to win by a half-length in the quick time of 56.91. Talented three-year-old filly **September Run** settled back in seventh place and was still about five lengths off the leader at the 300m prior to running on strongly for (half-length) second in a Chris Waller-trained quinella result. Another filly **Swats That** ran on bold race for third, resuming here. She was handy to the pace in fourth spot and fought strongly to take the minor placing in an impressive performance. Fabergino was close to the lead in third place, racing by herself on the near side and then rallied really well over the latter stages to finish (2.5 lengths) fourth. The favourite Bivouac had a nice trip in third place but raced a bit below his best form in fighting on for (2.6 lengths) fifth at his first run since taking out the VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) here in November. The fast mare Pippie showed her customary pace in leading before finishing (4.1 lengths) sixth in what is expected to be her final racetrack appearance before being offered for sale. [KB]

Analysis: Despite winning three recent open handicaps in six starts since relocating from Hong Kong (where he won twice at Sha Tin), **Royal Performer** was not expected to trouble the hot favourite here yet ran out a convincing winner to record his ninth career victory (maiden stakes) at start 29. He had three behind him with a lap to run, improved to fourth (rails) approaching the back straight then third at the 1200m. Leaving the back straight he still sat third, shuffled back to fifth inside the 600m but saved ground to share third at the top of the straight. At the 250m a lovely gap opened one off the fence and Jonathan Riddell drove him through, surged into the lead at the 200m and to the line was too strong by two and quarter lengths. 
