Spring campaign being mapped out for Tatt's Tiara-bound filly Odeum

Lucrative Golden Eagle proving hard to ignore for connections of talented rising four-year-olds

The \$7.5 million Golden Eagle (1500m) is firmly on the radar of Group 1-winning filly Odeum (Written Tycoon) but not before she attempts to take out a second race at the highest level this season, taking on the older mares to bring down the curtain on a stellar three-year-old season.

Co-owner Sheamus Mills yesterday outlined the longer-term plan for the MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner, revealing that

the lucrative Sydney race, restricted to four-year-olds, was the favoured option next campaign rather than chasing the more traditional spring black-type races in Melbourne.

Odeum, who was a gallant second behind Brooklyn Hustle (Starspangledbanner) after being caught wide in the Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday, will press on to the Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) on Saturday week in Brisbane before trainers Mick Price and Michael Kent Jr map out a campaign towards the Golden Eagle at Rosehill on October 30.

"We have thought about (Odeum's spring campaign) reasonably extensively, actually, and we're thinking that we've been keeping her preps short, sharp and light just to look after her," Mills [pictured below at Magic Millions] said yesterday.

"I don't see any reason why she's not going to continue to develop as a four- and five-year-old, so I think it will pretty much be the same formula. My thoughts are to give her two runs in Melbourne and then target the Golden Eagle.

"I think the 1500 metres is her right trip. She obviously goes well on her Sydney leg. She'd have to take on Ayrton, but they don't give away these races and I think she's up to it."

The merits of such a rich restricted prize-money race, seemingly at the expense of the "pattern", has and will continue to be debated, particularly in the context of the ongoing NSW versus Victoria racing bodies competition, but it is hard to ignore the fact that many owners and trainers choose the money over Group racing with the "pop-up" races.

On Saturday, Price indicated that Odeum's stablemate Ayrton

(Iffraaj), who bounced back from a shock defeat to take his record to four wins from five starts in Saturday's Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1600m) at Eagle Farm, would also be aimed at the Golden Eagle next preparation rather than races such as the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington which falls on the same day.

Mills reasoned that Odeum could tackle an Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), a race she ran second in last year, as a five-year-old.

"She has had a crack at an Empire Rose, she's a Group 1 winner. Not to say that Group 1s matter less than money, but you only get one crack at a Golden Eagle. It's only for four-year-olds and she can have a crack at an Empire Rose as a five-year-old," he said.

"She goes (well) that (clockwise) way, the trip's beautiful for her, she's run well at Rosehill against Isotope and I think with the timing, it's pretty good for her. She can have a little break in the sunshine (in Queensland) after the Tatt's Tiara."

Early indications from Price were that Odeum, who is being trained during her Queensland campaign from Steve O'Dea and Matthew Hoysted's stables at Eagle Farm, had pulled up well from her Dane Ripper run.

"James (McDonald) got off and apologised for the ride a bit, but I think he was totally a victim of circumstances," Mills said.

"We were coming off her horrible beginning in the Coolmore Classic when she missed the start by four lengths and she was slowly away when she got beaten a lip by Isotope in the Darby Munro as well. *Continued on page 4>>*

"We took all the gear off, she went to Pete (McMahon's) at Kolora Lodge and they did a bit of barrier work with her, a little bit of dressage, got her mind in the right spot and she was good in the gates on Saturday.

"Seven weeks between runs and four deep, punching the breeze is not easy at the weight scale especially, but I was very proud of her."

In recent years, Melbourne-based Mills has been putting together a select group of high-end race fillies with staunch clients Heath Newton and Anthony Roberts' Chesapeake Thoroughbreds.

Scientific approach taken with Queen Of The Green

Odeum is the ladder leader of the Mills-managed group thus far, but the agent hopes two-year-old **Queen Of The Green** (Written Tycoon), a \$1.5 million Magic Millions purchase in 2020 and a daughter of high-class sprinter Karuta Queen (Not A Single Doubt), can follow suit.

She has been carefully managed by trainers Tony and Calvin McEvoy and her owners from the time she was broken in.

Mills compared the filly's size and bulk to champion mare Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) who trainer Peter Moody had to monitor throughout her career due to her weight and size.

"They gave her two weeks of pretty solid work and she had put on 20 kilos while in work," he said.

"She weighs in at 586 kilos as a two-year-old filly, so she looks absolutely fantastic, but she is a beast. I have enlisted the help of Dr Brian Anderson at Ballarat (Equine Clinic).

"He described her as a four-year-old entire with a two-year-old filly's skeleton and his suggestion was to be mindful of what you do with her.

"He has been really, really good. He has helped us to devise a program. She has done a lot of treadmill work, a lot of swimming. She hasn't done a lot with anyone on her back."

Queen Of The Green is currently on the water walker and treadmill at Leneva Park.

“What I have noticed in the past ten years is that there is a real shift in thinking about how to train these horses,” he said.

“You look at Peter McMahon’s place at Kolora Lodge, doing the dressage and so on, trainers are embracing more modern methods. It is something that I have enjoyed being a part of with Queen Of The Green because, if she is going to be good, she can be good at any age or stage.

“You don’t have to be early to be good. Odeum didn’t run until August of her three-year-old year and this filly is on track for that.

“We’re just mindful of not pushing her too early and taking that more scientific approach. We’ve done bone scans, not regularly, but enough to know what’s really going on. While she has had no issues, I’ve got really patient owners who want to see the best out of their horses and enjoy the experience of taking a slightly different approach on how to train her.”

Mills also said yesterday that his latest high-priced yearling purchase, the \$1.95 million I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit)-Hips Don’t Lie (Stravinsky) filly bought from the Inglis Australian Easter Sale in April, was one week into a four-week spell following her breaking-in preparation.

She will then head to Price and Kent Jr’s Caulfield stable to continue her education.

Tree change for Mills

Mills is also about to make the move to Romsey, north west of Melbourne, to a 15-acre property, but don’t expect him to be competing in

the agistment and foaling down business despite being about ten minutes from stallion operations Spendthrift Australia and Widden Victoria.

He has named the property Kilcoole Park after the town in Ireland where his late mother Eithne was born.

“It’s a little lifestyle farm, it’s not going to be a commercial operation. I’ll probably put my own mares on there, the two or three broodmares that I just tinker around with, the fillies who I have raced that I love,” he said.

“I’ll put an arena on there and that sort of stuff to get the little fella out of Melbourne ... but Odeum won’t be agisting there any time soon. I’ll leave that up to the professionals.”

Darley shuttler Territories (Invincible Spirit) sired his first southern hemisphere-bred winner when Finsceal (2 g ex Rosalita by Danehill Dancer) scored at the Sunshine Coast yesterday. Trained by Tom Button, Finsceal (\$18) won the Canadian Club QTIS 2YO Handicap (1200m) on debut by a nose over Hinged (Worthy Cause) (\$3 favourite) while Miss Pierro (Pierro) (\$4.40) was three lengths away in third. Finsceal was bought by Gerald O'Toole for \$110,000 from the Symphony Lodge draft at last year's Magic Millions 2YOs in Training Sale at the Gold Coast after he was initially purchased for the same price from Oaklands Stud at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Territories will return to Darley's Kelvinside property in NSW this year at a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST).

Tiara under consideration for Tofane

Mike Moroney wants to monitor the condition

of Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Tofane (Ocean Park) before confirming a start in the Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) on Saturday week. The Melbourne trainer, however, said the preparation of stablemate Hang Man (Windsor Knot) had come to an end after finishing well back in the Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. "I spoke to Lily (Miller, traveling stable representative) this morning and she's pulled up really well," Moroney told RSN yesterday. "Hang Man didn't, he's still very scratchy and sore so some are handling that track and some aren't but she's pulled up really well so far. We'll swim her for a couple of days before we hop on her back and start to think about making a decision. She's up there, it's a Group 1 race and she's flying so my first thoughts are that if she stays in really good form then we probably will run."

Spring plans outlined for star Ocean Park mare

Tofane is now expected to race on next season, rather than be sold privately to go to stud, and Mike Moroney has indicated that the Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington on Victoria Derby day looms as a target. After her Stradbroke victory, part-owner Rupert Legh had suggested the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) as a possible aim. "It's now my job to make sure that we make the right decision," Moroney said. "If we can win another million or so and then sell her on at the end of it then the job has been done. There are some nice races for her in the spring, the mile mares race at Flemington (Empire Rose Stakes) is one. If we go down that track then we'd probably miss the Cox Plate and those sort of races but if we have a go at 2000 metres then it might be in the autumn in the big race up in Sydney (Queen Elizabeth Stakes).

There's a lot to think about but we're in a good position."

Savatiano also heading to Tiara

Godolphin homebred Savatiano (Street Cry) will be given her chance to chalk up a second Group 1 win this campaign in the Tattersall's Tiara on Saturday week. The James Cummings-trained six-year-old has been kept on ice since finishing midfield behind Vega One (Lope De Vega) in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm last month. "We're not quite done with the preparation of Savatiano yet. She is quite likely to run in the Tatt's Tiara in a couple of weeks," Cummings said. Savatiano won the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) in Sydney earlier this preparation, her first victory at the highest level.

Anamoe back in work

James Cummings has confirmed the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) as a likely short-term target for exciting colt Anamoe (Street Boss), who is expected to be among Godolphin's major flagbearers in the spring. An unlucky second to Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) from an outside gate in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Anamoe created a big impression when he atoned with an emphatic victory in the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "He is back in light training and we're keeping him nice and warm," Cummings said. "I think we will be running him first-up in September. He is a last-start winner of the Sires' Produce and he's got a very exciting amount of acceleration. He's got plenty of energy left from his two-year-old campaign and we're well and truly looking forward to seeing what he can produce as a classic three-year-old."

Kent fears for Sandown's future

One of Sandown racetrack's most vocal supporters Mick Kent fears for its long-term viability with its main meeting shifting to Caulfield. In its place Sandown has picked up the Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) on the Sunday after the AFL Grand Final, but with an underwhelming support card. The Zipping Classic meeting has been transferred from the Saturday after Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) week to the end of November and will now sit between the Ballarat and Pakenham Cups. Also on Zipping Classic Day is the Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m) and Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m). Kent, who had a winning double at Sandown on Saturday, fears what the Melbourne Racing Club has in store for the track and the long-term future of the Zipping Classic. "I can understand what they're trying to do, but it's just blatant that the MRC want to get rid of this place," Kent said. "It's a superior track, it's the best racetrack in Australia, probably. Caulfield is not the racetrack that this place is and it will change

the dynamics of the race, but I suspect that they'll run out of horses. Something will be cannibalised. It'll either be the Pakenham Cup, Ballarat Cup or the Sandown races."

Adelaide Ace returns to form

Lindsey Smith was pleased to see Adelaide Ace (Savabeel) back in the winner's stall and taking out a nice race after he scored his first win since February last year when winning the Swan Hill Cup (1600m) yesterday. Warrnambool-based Smith said connections had knocked back an enticing offer for Adelaide Ace following his win in the Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) at Caulfield last year. Ridden by Dean Yendall and sent off the \$2.90 favourite, Adelaide Ace registered a long-neck win from Prince Of Helena (Sidestep) (\$4.80) with Zachaz (Coats Choice) (\$5.50) one and a quarter lengths away third. "I'm glad he's able to come back and win a nice race for the owner," Smith said. "As I said pre-race it has been a little bit worrying. They knocked back a lot of money and then he had to have a wind operation, so the

genius (Yendall) had to get him back into form." Smith said the telling factor in yesterday's victory was when Yendall switched the whip from his right hand to his left inside the final 150 metres.

Lafferty on the mend

Laura Lafferty was hopeful of being able to return to Melbourne last night despite being re-admitted to hospital the previous evening following a fall at Swan Hill on Friday. "I just had excruciating pain, I was on the phone to the doctors and couldn't sleep," Lafferty, who has ridden 56 winners this season, told Racing.com. "I am still in Swan Hill, I don't know if I could have done the car trip home in the pain I was in, so I will get back to Melbourne tonight hopefully and meet my mum there. The pain is in my right shoulder so I'm not sure, maybe there is some ligaments or tears. Also my left knee is quite sore. Hopefully there's a bit of a turnaround in the next few days or the next week and by then I might have more of an idea when I could be back."

Collett savours five-timer at Newcastle

Expatriate Kiwi jockey Alysha Collett set a new personal record at Newcastle on Saturday when she booted home five winners on the eight-race card. Victory aboard the Brad Widdup-trained Pensera (Pierro) in race two was quickly followed by another for Widdup aboard Queen Bellissimo (Swiss Ace) in race three, before making it three in a row in race four on the James Cummings-trained Honeycreeper (Teofilo). Collett guided home the Kim Waugh-trained Linguee (Panzer Division) in race six and made it five aboard the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Briars Kingdom (Animal Kingdom) in the final event of the day. "It was a really nice day, although I was pretty sure I had ridden five in a day once before," she said. "I was speaking with mum (Judy) in the evening, and she told me the best I had done before was four, so that made me feel even better. It was really neat to win for Brad and the Snowdens as they have been my biggest supporters since I first got here from Singapore, while I was delighted to get my first wins for Kim and James as well."

Fawke to return to Qld

Sairyn Fawke has announced he intends to call time on his successful stint in South Australia and return to Queensland. Fawke, who has ridden 35 winners this season, said the lure of friends and family, combined with his new fishing and adventure start-up Yeah The Fishos, had swayed his decision. "I've enjoyed my time here and I've made some really great connections," the rider told Racing.com. "It's been four and a half years and I think it's time to go back home. Family reasons are definitely part of the decision, a lot of my friends are up there as well and I've just started a business up there with a few friends and that's going really well. I obviously want to continue to focus on my riding up there but I will also be able to work on the business as well." The 30-year-old has ridden 219 winners in South Australia and Victoria since accepting an opportunity to work for champion trainer Tony McEvoy at the end of 2016.

Meech back among winners

Linda Meech returned to the winner's stall in style yesterday with victory aboard the Ciaron

Maher and David Eustace-trained Last Week (Tamayuz) in the Apsley Cup (2000m) at Edenhope. It was the dual Group 1-winning jockey's first win since April last year, after which she took an extended period of time out of the saddle in the lead up to the birth of her first child Meech returned to race riding last month, with yesterday's win coming at only her sixth ride back.

Hefel suffers fall at Edenhope

In-form apprentice Carleen Hefel was yesterday taken to hospital following a fall at Edenhope in country Victoria. Hefel rode a double at the Sandown meeting on Saturday which followed her breakthrough city double at Flemington on May 22. The Victorian Jockeys' Association reported that Hefel was conscious and moving all limbs after the fall, from Pres De Toi (Helmet) in the Apsley Cup, but was complaining about pain in her jaw. The 31-year-old was transported to the local hospital for scans and further observation.

Wet weather impacts Victoria tracks

Thunderstorms and heavy rain have severely impacted several tracks in Victoria, most notably at Yarra Valley, which is currently underwater. Thoroughbred racing is not due to resume at the track until Cox Plate day on October 23, however harness racing takes place at the venue, with a meeting scheduled for July 5. Also impacted is the nearby Healesville Amateur Racing Club, which races six times a year, and is currently submerged by the floodwaters. "The track went under on Thursday morning," Club president David Purcell told Racing.com. "We will have to redo carpets in the steward's room and male jockey room as well. One tree came down through one of our fences, but all in all we have been pretty lucky. We're on a floodplain and when the water banks from the Yarra we go under, like we did in December as well. At the moment we cannot move machinery to begin the clean-up, but there appears no major damage. It's probably two or three inches deep." Cranbourne Turf Club has been without power since Thursday, impacting

trackwork which has been taking place later, from first light at 7am through to 11.15am. The racecourse at Traralgon appears to have escaped any major damage.

Thoroughbreds Are Go returns to screens

Australia's only national thoroughbred re-homing program, Caroline Searcy's Thoroughbreds Are Go returns tonight at 7.30pm (AEST) helping racing's trainers, owners and breeders find good homes for thoroughbreds away from the track. TAG, which airs on Sky Thoroughbred Central's channel 528 on Foxtel, also encourages the take-up of the athletic and intelligent breed in the general equestrian world, with advice on how best to care for thoroughbreds away from racing stables and studs. Episode one contains stories on Krissy Harris and the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association which rewards thoroughbred competitors with great prizes at shows around Australia.

NEW ZEALAND

Winter Cup for Floral Art

Winter track specialist Floral Art (Road To Rock) is set for a step up in grade after revelling in the testing conditions at Trentham on Saturday. The Peter Didham-trained six-year-old registered a first win since October 2019 when taking out a Benchmark 74 contest on a track rated a Heavy 11, prompting connections to consider another try in stakes company. "It was a great day and particularly satisfying to see Floral Art back to her best," Didham said. "She had gone a good race for fifth first-up last month and although I was a little concerned she might still be one race short, she struck the track conditions she loves and just flew home to win. Her recent form reflects a couple of poor decisions I made last year chasing a start in the Winter Cup. We went down south and struck a dry track every time she ran. She tried her heart out, but she just isn't anywhere near her best on that type of track. She had a good long break and has come back well so we're going to have another crack at the Winter Cup with her."

Tauranga Classic aim for Far Site

Didham is also keen to see Far Site (Makfi) tackle stakes company with the Team Wealleans Tauranga Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Tauranga in a fortnight the four-year-old's immediate option after winning on Saturday. "It was nice to see Far Site winning again as she can be a pretty tricky mare, but she has a fair amount of ability," he said. "She is raced by Graeme and Ali Andrew, who purchased her off gavelhouse.com about a year ago for \$4,500. That is her third win for me and it came with a \$20,000 Pearl Series bonus which is a great result for everyone. She came home and licked the bowl clean on Saturday night so I might take a punt and take her to Tauranga for the stakes race there at the end of the month. If you look at her form, she has been very unlucky on more than one occasion, so if we could get some black type with her, it would be the icing on the cake."

Take The Deel grants trainer's birthday wish

South Canterbury trainer Len Stewart got his birthday wish when his stable star Take The Deel (Dundeel) stormed to victory in the Dunstan Horsefeeds Waimate Cup (2200m) at Timaru on yesterday. Stewart, who began his association with racing as a 14-year-old riding in saddle trots in the Waikato in the 1940s, will turn 89 tomorrow and has found a new lease on life with the hardy five-year-old. The \$1,200 gavelhouse.com purchase took the step up to open company with aplomb as he produced a strong staying effort in the hands of Terry Moseley to make it three wins in his last four starts. "I wasn't really expecting it today as I had my concerns about the tricky track tripping him up," Stewart said. "In the end he was very strong at the finish. We knew he had the bloodlines, but it was always a matter of getting his legs to move fast enough. He can be pretty ignorant around home, but the penny seems to have dropped now and I'm hoping he can keep improving even more."

Winners flow for smiling Joe

Having recently been named Apprentice Jockey of the Year at the Auckland Racing Club awards, Joe Kamaruddin notched

his 29th success for the season aboard Palm Springs (Super Easy) in the opening event on the card at Te Rapa on Saturday. The Malaysian-born jockey has proved a revelation in recent weeks, booting home a winning treble at New Plymouth on Thursday off the back of a double at Ellerslie three days earlier. Kamaruddin, 28, who lives with his partner Nardia Zainal, who also works for Te Akau Racing, has settled in well to the New Zealand way of life. "Every couple of days we video call our families," Kamaruddin said. "I am successful as a jockey now, and my mum and dad and brother and sister are very happy for me. I ride up to 13 horses in work in the mornings for Te Akau and there is no stress. I like the people I work with because they are happy and I enjoy seeing them every morning. It is a very good team spirit and I like the job. David Ellis (Te Akau Principal) is very good because he's helped me with everything, talks to me and helps me to understand. We are very happy here in Matamata, it is a good life. From a long time ago, I was dreaming to be a jockey and now I am here and my dream has come true, so what I am thinking now is that we want to stay in New Zealand."

ASIA

JPN: First Group winner for Tosen Ra

Zadar (5 h Tosen Ra - See The Sea by Lemon Drop Kid) scored at his first start for this year, as he flew from the pack to land the Epsom Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) at Tokyo yesterday, holding off the late charge from Satono Flag (Deep Impact) to win by a neck. In the process he became the first Group winner for his sire Tosen Ra

(Deep Impact), the 2013 winner of the Mile Championship (Gr 1, 1600m) at Kyoto. The pair drew clear of the field, with Folconia (Deep Impact) a length and a quarter further back in third. Zadar was last seen running fifth in the Mainichi Okan (Gr 2, 1800m) in October last year, and is one of two stakes winners for his sire, having won the Principal Stakes (Listed, 2000m) in 2019 as a three-year-old. He is the third foal out of Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) mare See The Sea, whose yearling by Curren Black Hill (Daiwa Major) sold for ¥31,000,000 last year. Tosen Ra stands at Breeders Stallion Station in Japan.

JPN: Bien Fait holds on in Hakodate Sprint

A frenetic renewal of the Hakodate Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) at Sapporo saw Bien Fait (4 g Kizuna - Le Sucre by Sakura Bakushin O) steal a march on his rivals and then hold off a stampede of challengers in the final stages to win by a neck. Curren Moe (Lord Kanaloa) fell short in his lunge for the line to finish second, while Miki Brillante (Deep Brillante) finished a nose third. The Kazuya Natatake-trained gelding is now a stakes winner at two, three and four over 1200 metres, having won the Hakodate Nisai Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) as a juvenile and the Aoi Stakes (Listed, 1200m) last year. Bien Fait is one of three stakes winners for his dam, the stakes placed Le Sucre (Sakura Bakushin O), who has also produced Grade 3 winner Blanc Bonheur (Deep Impact) and Listed winner Entscheiden (Deep Impact). She has a yearling filly by Heart's Cry (Sunday Silence).

JPN: First winner for Drefong

Breeders' Cup Sprint (Gr 1, 6f) winner Drefong (Gio Ponti) scored his first winner as a sire when flashy white filly Hyams Beach (2 f Drefong - Yukichan by Kurofone) won on debut in the 1400-metre Newcomers race at Tokyo on Saturday. The third runner for Drefong, who retired to stud with a record of five wins from seven starts, including three at the highest level, Hyams Beach flew home on the outside to win by a half-length over Hagino Maurice (Maurice). Drefong retired to Shadai Stallion Station, where he stands for a fee of ¥3,000,000 (approx. AUD\$35,500).

INTERNATIONAL

Eleven for Mehmas

Line Of Departure (3 c ex Entreat by Pivotal) returned with an eye-catching victory in the Cathedral Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Salisbury for Roger Varian and became the eleventh individual stakes winner for his sire Mehmas (Acclamation). A three-time winner last term, including the valuable Weatherbys Racing Bank 2YO Stakes, he disappointed on his last run in the Mill Reef Stakes (Gr 3, 6.5f) however that was his seventh run of the season and he looks a sprinter to follow. Ridden by David Egan, the three-year-old was held up, took a gap up the rail and stuck to the task to win by two and a quarter lengths from the favourite Khaadem (Dark Angel), while Cairn Gorm (Bated Breath) was a further two lengths back in third. Line Of Departure was a £260,000 Goffs UK Premier Sale yearling and he is a half-brother to Group 1-winning sprinter Golden Horde (Lethal Force) and stakes winner Exhort (Dutch Art) and is from the family of US Champion Serena's Song (Rahy). Mehmas stands at Tally-Ho Stud in Ireland for a fee of €25,000 (approx. AUD\$39,290).

207 for Dubawi

Jean-Claude Rouget took Longchamp's Prix Volterra (Listed, 1600m) with Haras de Saint Pair homebred Valloria (3 f ex Celebre Vadala by Peintre Celebre) who became the 207th individual stakes winner for her sire Dubawi (Dubai Millennium). Ridden by Cristian Demuro, she was keen early on and pulled herself to the front before picking up smartly to win cosily by three quarters of a length from the evens favourite Dolia (Invincible Spirit) and they were a further length and a half clear of Complication (No Nay Never) in third. Valloria won on debut last August and was beaten less than three lengths in a Group 3 last October and yesterday's victory took her tally to two wins from five starts. She is a half-sister to Group 1 winner and sire Vadamos (Monsun) out of the Listed winner Celebre Vadala (Peintre Celebre). Valloria is the 20th stakes winner this season for Dubawi who stands at Darley's Dalham Hall in Newmarket for £250,000 (approx. AUD\$457,725).

Nine for Olympic Glory

Runner-up on her two previous starts in May this year, Jannah Flower (3 f ex Azafata by Motivator) stepped up to Listed company in the Prix Melisande (Listed, 2100m) at Longchamp yesterday for Pascal Bary and broke her maiden to become the ninth individual stakes winner for former Arrowfield shuttler Olympic Glory (Choisir), following Mintd's victory in the US on Saturday. Ridden by Stephane Pasquier, Jannah Flower was held up, weaved a passage and flew home, seeing off the challenge of Vignny (Le Havre) by a head, while Crohanne (Havana Gold) was a further length and a quarter back in third. Jannah Flower was a €400,000 Arqana yearling purchase and is out of the Spanish Champion three-year-old filly Azafata (Motivator) who is also responsible for the Group 2 winner and Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) runner-up Fleeting (Zoffany). Olympic Glory stands at Al Shaqab's Haras de Bouquetot in France for a fee of €5,000 (approx. AUD\$7,850).

FRA: Seven in a row for Iresine who claims La Coupe

Iresine (4 g Manduro - Inanga by Oasis Dream) continued his eye-catching progression when landing a seventh consecutive win from on his eighth start and scoring a first win at Group level when claiming La Coupe (Gr 3, 2000m) at Longchamp yesterday. A six-length winner in a Listed contest at Lyon last time out, Iresine stepped up in class to justify short-priced favouritism and defeat Magny Cours (Medaglia D'Oro) by three-quarters of a length, with Grand Glory (Olympic Glory) filling third, a length behind the winner. Stuck in a pocket until the furlong pole, Iresine burst through a gap on the inside to win impressively. A €6,000 yearling purchase from Arqana, Iresine is the only winner out of unplaced Oasis Dream (Green Desert) mare Inanga.

16 for Reliable Man

Runner-up in the 2019 Preis Der Diana (Gr 1, 2400m), the talented Naida (5 m ex Nacella by Banyumanik) made a belated breakthrough at stakes level, earning black-type success at her 13th attempt, and did so emphatic fashion, as she surged clear in the closing stages at Cologne to win the Steher Cup (Listed, 3000m).

Ida Alata (Adlerflug) finished second, with Memphis (Jukebox Jury) finishing third. In the process, the grey became the 16th individual winner for her sire Reliable Man (Dalakhani). Out of the stakes placed Nacella (Banyumanik), she is a half-sister to stakes winner Nacida (Wiener Walzer) and the stakes placed Nacar (Tertullian). Reliable Man will once again shuttle to Westbury Stud in New Zealand this year, where he will stand for an increased fee of \$17,500 + GST.

GER: Best Of Lips on track for Derby

Dual Group 3 winner Best Of Lips (3 c The Gurkha - Beata by Silver Frost) proved too good as he blitzed the field in the feature Union-Rennan (Gr 2, 2200m) at Cologne yesterday for Andreas Suborics. Ridden by Lukas Delozier, the three-year-old was asked to pick up from the home turn and he showed a rapid turn of foot to run down Sky Out (Adlerflug) and win by four and three-quarter lengths, while Dolcetto (Gleneagles) flashed home to defy Sky Out second by a neck. Best Of Lips was crowned Champion German Two-Year-Old Colt last year and was bouncing back after a third place finish in the Mehl Mühlhens Rennen (German 2,000 Guineas) (Gr 2, 1600m). He has now won four of his seven starts and is the current favourite for the Deutsches Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on July 5.

82 for Lope De Vega

General De Vega (4 h ex Just Little by Grandslam) became the 82nd individual stakes winner for former Australian shuttle stallion Lope De Vega (Shamardal) when he won the Bro Park Varsprint (Listed, 1200m) in Sweden yesterday. General De Vega defeated Could Be King (Bated Breath) and Dardenne (Footstepsinthesand) to record a fourth win from eight starts. His dam, Just Little (Grandslam), was bred by Jean Dubois and General De Vega becomes the third stakes winner for his dam, after the Matthew Smith-trained Radipole (Rock Of Gibraltar), a stakes winner in France before his export to Australia, and Prix de Suresnes (Listed, 2000m) winner Naturally High (Camelot). Lope De Vega stands at Ballylinch Stud for a fee of €125,000 (approx. AUD\$196,000).

SWE: Match Maker remains undefeated in 2021

Match Maker (6 g Declaration Of War - I'm In Love by Zafonic) won at Group level for the first time for his former Australian shuttle sire Declaration Of War (War Front) when landing the Stockholms Stora Pris (Gr 3, 1750m) at Bro Park yesterday. Victory took his career record to six wins from 14 starts and added to a victory in the Danish Jockey Club Cup (Listed, 1800m) last month. Match Maker is out of US stakes placegetter I'm In Love (Zafonic), who was exported to Australia and has an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) two-year-old named Treporti, who sold to Bruce Perry Bloodstock for \$600,000 at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, and races in the Waikato Stud colour for trainer Danny O'Brien. Winless in four starts, he finished fourth in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and was last seen running third to Cheerful Legend (Shalaa) at Moonee Valley in February. I'm In Love has a Hellbent (I Am Invincible) weanling filly and was placed in foal to Magna Grecia (Invincible Spirit) last year.

UK: Leading contender for Britannia added to Goffs London Sale

The Lloyd Williams-owned Belmont Avenue (Zoffany), a winner of his only start this season

and a leading fancy for Thursday's Britannia Stakes (1m) at Royal Ascot, has been added as a wildcard entry to today's Goffs London Sale. Prospective purchasers wishing to bid online must register in advance of the sale by clicking [here](#).

Eight for Olympic Glory

Frommer Arrowfield shuttler Olympic Glory (Choisir) sired his eighth individual stakes winner as Irish-bred mare Mintd (5 m ex Lisanor by Raven's Pass) caused an upset in defeating odds-on favourite Juliet Fox trot (Dansili) in the Mint Julip Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Churchill Downs on Saturday. A crowd of almost 20,000 were in attendance to see the Brendan Walsh-trained five-year-old surge to a half-length victory, while She'sonthewarpath (Declaration Of War) finished three lengths behind the winner in third. Olympic Glory is responsible for dual Group 1 winner Watch Me, while his sole Australian stakes winner is Mick Dittman Plate (Listed, 1110m) scorer Lord Olympus. The stallion now permanently resides in France, where he commands a fee of €5,000 (approx. AUD\$7,850) at Haras de Bouquetot.

22 for Bodemeister

A shock ensued in the Salvator Mile Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Monmouth Park on Saturday, as Investor

(4 h ex Lucky Black by Hard Spun) notched a first stakes win at his 25th start when sent off a 79-1 chance. Previously stakes placed, Investor became the 22nd individual stakes winner for his sire Bodemeister (Empire Maker) as he defeated odds-on favourite Ny Traffic (Cross Traffic) by a length, with Galerio (Jump Start) a further one and a half lengths adrift in third. Bodemeister now stands at the Jockey Club in Turkey, where he commands a fee of €12,500 (approx. AUD\$19,600).

UK: Palace Pier to face ten in Queen Anne Stakes

Palace Pier (Kingman), considered by many as the banker of the meeting, will face ten rivals when he takes his chance in tomorrow's Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m), the opening race of the five-day Royal Ascot festival. Trained by John and Thady Gosden, Palace Pier will be attempting to win at Royal Ascot for the second successive year having taken out the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) 12 months ago. This year's renewal of that race has attracted a field of 13, including Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach), winner of the English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m). Europe's star sprinter Battaash (Dark Angel) will face 15 rivals when he tries to defend his title in the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f), the third Group 1 contest on the card.

From subfertile to sire sensation: how Starspangledbanner has defied the odds

It has been 11 years since Starspangledbanner (Choisir) burst onto the European scene with a dazzling display of brazen speed in the Golden Jubilee Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at Royal Ascot. That was, of course, after a highly successful time in his native Australia, where he won at the highest level on two occasions.

Four years later the son of Choisir (Danehill Dancer) once again made the royal meeting his own when his debut northern hemisphere-bred crop, which numbered just 33 foals, yielded Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) hero The Wow Signal and Queen Mary (Gr 1, 5f) victress Anthem Alexander.

Fertility issues saw to it that his trajectory since has been unconventional, to say the least, having returned to training in 2012 and 2013 after his second crop of foals yielded just 11. During his second stint at Ballydoyle there was even talk of a gelding operation.

However, against all odds, Starspangledbanner, the sire of Saturday's Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) winner Brooklyn Hustle, saw his fertility begin to improve while on duty at Victoria's Rosemont Stud, where he has shuttled to since 2011, and with his Royal Ascot heroics still ringing in breeders' ears, he made a belated return to Coolmore's Irish stud in 2016.

He has since sired much healthier numbers in the northern hemisphere, with 71 foals resulting from his 2016 book and 76 more arriving the following year, while in Australia he has sired foal crops of 48 and 52 over the last two years, but with a notably improved fertility rate.

The 2016 northern hemisphere crop contained Starspangledbanner's second Group 1-winning juvenile, with Cheveley Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) heroine Millisle joining Prix Morny (Gr 1, 6f) scorer The Wow Signal at the head of her sire's stud record, while the latter was

headlined by the Group 2-winning and Group 1-placed Aloha Star.

So far this year he has sired eight northern hemisphere two-year-old winners, supplied at a strike rate of 38 per cent. Among that septet are the Fozzy Stack-trained Castle Star and Hermana Estrella, the winners of the only juvenile Group races this season, namely the Marble Hill Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) and the Naas Juvenile Sprint (Gr 3, 6f).

Among his other juvenile winners is Flotus, with the Simon and Ed Crisford-trained filly now the ante-post favourite for the Albany Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) following a deeply impressive debut success at Goodwood.

Not only is Castle Star the joint highest-rated two-year-old this season with a Racing

Post Rating of 104, his sire is also responsible for three of the top ten, with Hermana Estrella on a mark of 97 and Flotus on 95.

In truth, such a run of results was not entirely unpredictable as Starspangledbanner's current juvenile crop is by far his biggest. He has 87 two-year-olds to run for him this season, a marked contrast to the 44 he sired in his first two northern hemisphere crops combined.

"He has received great support from breeders in Ireland, the UK and wider Europe since his return," says Cathal Murphy of Coolmore's Castlehyde Stud, where Starspangledbanner is standing for €22,500 (approx. AUD\$35,300) this year. "Working closely with the breeders, we have a system in place for managing him and, thankfully, his fertility is now very good."

"I have to pay tribute to the Stack family, who have played such a major role in his success. Liz Stack bred his first-crop Group 1 winner The Wow Signal and Fozzy obviously took note as together with Hubie de Burgh he has purchased Group winners Aloha Star and Hermana Estrella.

"He also trained Bubbles On Ice for his owner-breeder Michael Begley last year before she was sold to America, and is also responsible for Castle Star, who was owned and bred by Coolmore managers Tom Gaffney, Clem Murphy and David O'Loughlin."

Reflecting on Starspangledbanner's recent two-year-old success, Murphy adds: "To have the first two juvenile Group winners of the season in Castle Star and Hermana Estrella along with Flotus, who is ante-post favourite for the Albany after her runaway success at Goodwood for Simon and Ed Crisford, is pretty amazing stuff.

"A colt of his topped the final day of Book 2, selling for 360,000gns to Anthony Stroud on behalf of Godolphin, and he along with his other five highest-priced yearlings have all yet to appear, so there's a lot to look forward to as the season progresses."

As well as an uncommon level of speed and class, Starspangledbanner also showed a considerable amount of versatility during his racing days, with Group 1 victories registered in the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m), the Golden Jubilee (Gr 1, 6f) and July Cup (Gr 1, 6f), while he also stretched out to a mile in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) during his time in Australia with trainer Leon Corstens.

Although his stock in trade has been sprinter-milers in his own image, the success of Starspangledbanner's second career has been underpinned by an ability to work with mares from a diverse range of bloodlines and performance profiles.

"Starspangledbanner has worked well with quite a wide variety of mares," notes Murphy. "His first Group 1 winner The Wow Signal was the first foal out of an unraced daughter of top middle-distance performer High Chaparral, while the dam of multiple Group winner Home Of The Brave is by Beat Hollow and his 2021 stakes winner Bubbles On Ice is out of a daughter of Galileo.

"At the other end of the distance spectrum, the dam of his European champion two-year-old filly Millisle is by Indian Ridge, and he's also proven successful with mares by the likes of Pivotal, Danehill, Invincible Spirit, Lord Shanakill and Iffraaj."

Murphy continues: "Starspangledbanner was obviously a brilliant sprinter for Aidan O'Brien, winning the Golden Jubilee and July Cup, but he was also successful on his only start over a mile in the Caulfield Guineas before coming to Europe.

"He certainly injects speed and class into his mares, and the majority of his progeny appear to have very good temperaments."

All told, despite relatively modest numbers, Starspangledbanner is responsible for 33 stakes performers worldwide, including ten Group-race winners and a further eight Listed scorers, with his progeny recently recording noteworthy successes in Australia and Hong Kong as well as Britain and Ireland.

Moreover, this year has seen Starspangledbanner's influence reach new heights as his star-crossed son The Wow Signal, who left just 15 foals from two seasons at Haras de Bouquetot, was represented by surprise Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Coeursamba.

Although crack two-year-olds Castle Star and Hermana Estrella are set to bypass Royal Ascot in favour of races on home soil, Starspangledbanner could still be represented by the likes of Cheerupsleepy (Queen Mary), The Rosstafarian (Hampton Court) and Aristia (Ribblesdale), as well as the aforementioned Flotus.

There are, Murphy reports, bigger - and potentially better - things still in the pipeline too.

"His yearling crop is bigger again than his two-year-old crop and judging by the animals we've seen they're a quality bunch," he says. "The dams of both Castle Star and Flotus are both back in foal to him, so that's not a bad start [for this year]!"

"He already has well over 100 mares scanned in foal and, unsurprisingly, the phone has been hopping over the past month."

Starspangledbanner will once more shuttle to Rosemont Stud this year, where he will stand for a fee of \$16,500.

Size closes gap on Fownes as trainers' championship battle narrows

The battle for the 2020/21 Hong Kong trainers' championship appears destined for a cliffhanger finish after John Size ended an unlikely run of outs to move within two wins of leader Caspar Fownes after preparing a double at Sha Tin yesterday.

Trailing Fownes 65-69 before proceedings began, the 11-time champion handler's effort to triumph with Blaze Warrior (Sebring) and Dashing Fit (Smart Missile) saw the Australian improve his tally to 67, while Fownes remained winless for the day.

On an afternoon when eight of the 11 winners had been stabled at Conghua Racecourse after their previous starts in Hong Kong, the burgeoning rivalry between Size and Fownes further intensified with only eight more meetings left before the season's end on July 14 at Happy Valley.

"We're just hanging in there and we'll see what happens. I'll just do my best," Size said in typically understated fashion.

His inevitable resurgence materialised while Master Eight (Oamaru Force) preserved his unbeaten record in the Class 3 Hap Mun Bay Handicap (1200m) for Frankie Lor and a clearly impressed Joao Moreira, who took riding honours with a treble.

"I was committed to just maybe taking a sit with him (Master Eight) and having something to look at but he was just too good, he just took me to the front," Moreira said.

"At the top of the straight, he started to receive pressure from a horse on the outside (Quadruple Double) and once he felt that, he just took off by himself. It showed he has got pride in him - he's a fighter.

"At the finish, I started to push him and he responded again. He was the winner from the start to the finish. He's a good horse. He's done what I expected he would do and, once again, he's given the feeling that he's very exciting."

Lor said: "I think we'll put him away now and

get him ready for next season. He's still a young horse and he should be much better next season. He's still got a lot of improvement in him."

Moreira piloted the unraced Blaze Warrior to success in the Class 4 Lido Handicap (1200m) to end Size's 39-race run of outs with the striking three-year-old.

"We had a good expectation based on his trackwork and barrier trials and thank God he didn't disgrace, he has what we thought he had," Moreira said. "He's no doubt promising. He's very green, got a lot to learn and to start off that way has got us excited."

Moreira's boosted his tally to 141 victories for the season - a lead of 24 over Zac Purton - after Tony Millard's Ultra Express (Power) proved too strong in the Class 3 Kiu Tsui Handicap (1600m).

Blake Shinn notched a double with Size's Dashing Fit and Dennis Yip's Bulb Pals (Rip Van Winkle).

"That was a terrific win. First start on the dirt when the track is wet and slow, it's not easy to do," the Melbourne Cup- (Gr 1, 3200m) winning jockey said after Dashing Fit prevailed in the Class 4 Pui O Handicap (1200m, dirt).

"He's trained by the champion trainer John Size, so he's had a great schooling coming into

today and that made my job easier - the horse's ability carried him through."

Shinn completed a brace aboard the towering Bulb Pals, who overcame a poor start to notch his first win with a remarkable last-to-first triumph in the second section of the Class 4 Silverstrand Handicap (1400m).

"He's got a few little issues at the start, that's why he wears a hood in the barriers and he just got it wrong when they (barrier attendants) took the hood off him - he reared and missed the start," Shinn said.

"So, we just had to allow the horse to settle and find his rhythm. He's probably 17 hands - he's a big horse - and I just tried to give him confidence and galloping room in the run and he hit the line great.

"Full credit to Dennis Yip. He's obviously an injury-plagued horse and Dennis has been patient and managed him well to get him to where he is today."

Bulb Pals arrived in Hong Kong in August 2019 and has since shuttled between Sha Tin and Conghua as he struggled with a tendon injury and a slower than usual healing process before Yip was finally able to get the five-year-old to the races yesterday.

California Spangle (Starspangledbanner) justified Tony Cruz's pre-race confidence with an emphatic victory in the Tung Wan Plate (1000m) for Griffins, setting a class record 55.33s under Neil Callan.

"I expected him to win this race. He did everything well during the race and after the race the jockey's report was very good - no bad habits," Cruz said. "Neil rode him with a lot of confidence."

The win marked Callan's return to the winners' circle for the first time since Mighty Giant's (Power) success in the Chairman's Trophy Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) at Sha Tin in early April.

"It's always nice to have such a long time off - whether it's enforced or not - but to come back and show everybody that I'm still hungry and fighting for wins (is satisfying) and hopefully I can get a lot more," the Irishman said.

"I knew he was going to finish off the last 200 metres very strong. There's a little bit of greenness and immaturity still but he's definitely got ability."

City Legend (Red Giant) continued his stunning transformation for Benno Yung by winning the first section of the Class 4 Silverstrand Handicap (1400m) under Jerry Chau to post his third victory in five starts - after being winless in his first 31 outings.

Chau sealed a double by following Douglas Whyte's instructions to perfection aboard Will Power (Power) in the Class 2 Cheung Sha Handicap (1200m, dirt). Conspicuously wide and last early, the gelding surged to his sixth

win from 16 Hong Kong starts as his rivals wilted in the yielding conditions.

"He can lay-up near the speed, so we decided to stay out as wide as possible and avoid all the kickback. He got going on the turn when the others were slowing down because of the kickback. I think the tactical move helped," Whyte said.

Alexis Badel and Chris So combined to extract the best from For Fun's Sake (Manhattan Rain) to claim the second section of the Class 5 Ting Kau Handicap (1200m, dirt) at the import's 23rd start in Hong Kong.

Jack Wong and Me Tsui united to win the first section of the Class 5 Ting Kau Handicap (1200m, dirt) with Sky Treasure (Stravinsky). The win was Wong's second of the season and Tsui's fourth success from his last 11 runners.

Jimmy Ting's Man Star (Shooting To Win) posted his second win in succession and third overall from ten starts by clinching the Class 3 Hoi Mei Wan Handicap (1200m, dirt) for Karis Teetan.
