

## QTIS Yearling Sale to go ahead in face of coronavirus protocols

Magic Millions to comply with 500-person gathering limit at Gold Coast auction early next week

ext week's Magic Millions QTIS
March Yearling Sale on the
Gold Coast will proceed with
appropriate health and safety
measures in place in the wake of a dramatic
federal government directive banning large
public gatherings in a bid to try and combat the
spread of coronavirus.

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch late yesterday confirmed the two-day auction would continue as planned after consulting authorities to ensure the company complies with the ban on non-essential events attracting 500 people or more.

The ban, issued yesterday by the government on the advice of the Chief Medical Officer, comes into effect on Monday, the first day of the two-day 412-lot QTIS sale.

Magic Millions is getting the right advice from key authorities and putting measures in place to hold the sale to the best of our ability," Bowditch said.

"Vendors have done a hell of a lot of work on their horses to get them here for this sale - it is their grand final. They are here and ready to go to give their horses an opportunity to sell."

Inspections started at the Gold Coast complex on Thursday and continued yesterday with a number of agents, owners and trainers viewing yearlings.

While predominantly marketed towards Queensland owners and trainers, Bowditch admitted some international investors had been forced to cancel plans to attend the sale due to the coronavirus outbreak.

"We have got online bidding, our agents are in place and hopefully over the next few days all these horses will have photos and videos to give potential buyers who can't be here all the information they need," he said.

"There are going to be plenty of opportunities in the market at this sale."

On Thursday, Inglis said it was closely monitoring the coronavirus situation and how the travel bans and pandemic could impact its Australian Easter Yearling Sale, to be held on April 8 and 9. Contingency plans were being formulated by management ahead of the key sale.

#### All-Star Mile gates closed but Rosehill open to public

Meanwhile, the Melbourne Racing Club has elected to bring forward the ban and will not have the gates open to the public for today's All-Star Mile (1600m) race meeting at Caulfield while last night's Alister Clark Stakes meeting at Moonee Valley was also closed to punters.

The MRC said it was taking "considered action" in closing the gates to protect the health and safety of its members, patrons and participants in consultation with Racing Victoria.

"In the interest of patron safety, in consultation with Racing Victoria, the MRC has taken the decision to take extra precaution and proceed with The All-Star Mile Race Day without spectators," the racing club said. *Continued on page 3>>* 

<< Continued from page 2 Other race meetings across Australia, however, including today's Group 1 card at Rosehill in Sydney and the lucrative Jewel meeting on the Gold Coast, will remain open, with the ban not to come into force until Monday.</p>

The Geelong TAB and Dederang picnic meetings in Victoria scheduled for today, as well as Sale, Benalla and Woolamai tomorrow, will go ahead as planned with crowds allowed to attend.

Racing NSW acknowledged the federal and state government advice, allowing the state's racecourses to remain open today and tomorrow.

Thoroughbred Racing South Australia (TRSA) said the state's race clubs would abide by the directive, with attendances to be capped at 500 for upcoming race meetings, including participants.

Non-cup and regional race meetings programmed will continue as normal as a crowd of fewer than 500 people is expected.

"Racing in South Australia has previous experience in dealing with a major interruption with the Equine Influenza outbreak in 2007," TRSA chief executive Nick Redin said yesterday.

"We know what it's like to have an industry-wide issue and the learnings from that experience are still relevant today. We are working closely with the Racing Minister and his office and we're constantly monitoring, discussing and updating our response."

Racing Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) will implement similar measures for its race meetings from Monday.

The Moonee Valley Racing Club (MVRC) yesterday said in a statement: "Whilst this restriction does not take effect until Monday, the decision to proceed without members, owners and racegoers attending (last night's) race meeting has been taken in light of the increased concern over the transmission of COVID-19.

"The health and wellbeing of the broader community needs to be our priority at this point in time."

The MVRC also indicated that Friday's Group 1 William Reid Stakes meeting would also likely be closed to the public, if it is run at all.

## Faatinah cruises home in Abell Stakes

Honest sprinter Faatinah (Nicconi) scored his ninth victory, his fifth at stakes level, last night by taking the Abell Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Moonee Valley. Left with just a field of five for the Abell Stakes, the Lindsay Park-prepared Faatinah was sent off as the third elect in the market. However, success for the Shadwell Stud homebred was never in doubt under a well-judged front-running ride by Damien Oliver, winning by two and a quarter lengths over Gift Of Power (Power) with Dr Drill (Dansili) running well first-up for third.

"He's been an old warrior for the yard. I got a big thrill out of that, he's been my favourite horse for a long time," said co-trainer Ben Hayes. "I went to Dubai with him twice and he's won two international races. This is the first year in some time that he hasn't gone over there. He's a horse that always wins a nice race each prep so it's nice to get that win here."

## Pride Of Dubai filly makes it two from two

Maha (Pride Of Dubai) confirmed her potential as a filly on the up when winning her second race from as many starts at Moonee Valley last night. Maha, like Pride Of Dubai, races in the Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa al-Maktoum yellow and blue colours and, as with her sire, she is a homebred from his global operation. Ridden by Michael Dee, the Tony and Calvin McEvoytrained Maha sat outside the lead before bursting away to win by two and a quarter lengths. "She can be hard work, but she has so much raw ability and is improving all the time," said Calvin McEvoy. "She's unbeaten now, two for two, and there a couple of nice stakes races coming up in Adelaide for her." Maha is from the Song Of Norway (Vain)

family that boasts Magnus (Flying Spur) and Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) among numerous stakes performers.

## Alligator Blood a confirmed starter

Favourite Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) will run in the All-Star Mile (1600m) today after his owner had threatened to scratch him because of the public lock-out at Caulfield. Managing owner Allan Endresz's wife Joy is terminally ill with cancer and had been planning on attending the \$5 million All-Star Mile to watch Alligator Blood run for the first time this autumn. A group of 80 family and friends of the horse's three owners were scheduled to attend the meeting and after racing officials were able to offer an alternative, a function room in The Glasshouse Caulfield venue on the edge of the racecourse complex, Endresz accepted the offer and consented to run the Queensland star. "Great news is Racing Victoria and the Melbourne Racing Club have really given Joy a big lift, we've got a venue that they are providing for us for the 80 family and friends," Allan Endresz said in a video on Twitter. "We're really pumped and the great news is the Gator is running."



#### Mr Quickie to fire fresh

Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) will be out to deliver on a long-range plan when he chases All-Star Mile glory first-up from a spell. Trainer Phillip Stokes said everything had gone to plan in the build-up for Mr Quickie, who finished seventh in the public poll to secure his place in the race. Mr Quickie charged home for an eye-catching third in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) first-up last spring and Stokes has taken a similar approach to prepare him for the All-Star Mile, with two barrier trials leading in. "I couldn't be happier," Stokes said. "He's shown me all the right signs. His trials have been on par with what he was doing before last prep. He's a bigger and stronger horse and we know that his first-up form is good. Damien Oliver rode him in his last gallop on Tuesday and he pulled up well in the wind so I feel his fitness and everything is good. He'll run a big race."

## Bosson chasing more Aussie riches

After recent Group 1 doubles in Sydney and at home in New Zealand, Opie Bosson is confident he can add the All-Star Mile aboard 10-time Group 1-winning mare Melody Belle (Commands). In three rides in Australia so far in 2020, the rider has finished third on Melody Belle in the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on February 22, before a memorable Group 1 double at Randwick a week later. "That was awesome," Bosson said. "It's hard to win a Group 1 in Australia, but to win two of them in the one day was great. Hopefully that was just the start of the roll." Bosson, who said Melody Belle has made "amazing" improvement since the Futurity, added: "We always knew she was going to take that run under her belt, so coming in after that gallop I'm pretty confident."

## Secret Blaze in form for Caulfield

Tony McEvoy has seen no signs that Secret Blaze's (Sizzling) performance in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) has taken a toll as he prepares the gelding for today's Mornington Cup Prelude (Listed, 2000m) at Caulfield. The four-year-old returned from an eight-week let-up at Flemington on February 29 to run second to subsequent

Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) in the Blamey Stakes and McEvoy was full of praise for the gelding's game effort in his first start since being unplaced in the Bagot Handicap (Listed, 2800m) on January 1. "He had no favours. He was three-wide facing the breeze and he was incredible," McEvoy, who trains in partnership with his son Calvin, said: "It was a really good performance." Secret Blaze is the favourite for today's race and McEvoy added: "I was very pleased with him leading into that Blamey and thought he would run super, which he did. When they run out of their skin fresh like he did you've just got to hope they don't have a flat one which can happen. But there's certainly no signs of that."

#### **Chapter And Verse ready for Goldmarket**

Having trained the runner-up in the Goldmarket Handicap (Listed, 1300m) in each of the last two years, Desleigh Forster is hoping to go one better when Chapter And Verse (Rothesay) lines up at the Gold Coast today. Forster gave the five-yearold a short break after he finished midfield in the Sunshine Coast Cup (Listed, 1400m) in January with the idea of bringing him back for today's race. Chapter And Verse lines up off the back of a trial win against smart three-year-old Guntantes (Rothesay) at Eagle Farm last week where a change of tactics saw him lead most of the way. "He won't be leading on Saturday but he should be a bit closer than usual," Forster said. "The winter is just around the corner and he should play some role but whether that is in the top races remains to be seen."

## Cosmic Gossip to fly flag for Spill The Beans

Trainer Stu Kendrick is hoping that Cosmic Gossip (Spill The Beans) is able to find a chink in the armour of favourite Rothfire (Rothesay) when she tackles today's 2YO QTIS Jewel at the Gold Coast. Cosmic Gossip was bought by Kendrick and Aquis Farm's Shane McGrath at the Magic Millions QTIS Yearling Sale last year, selling for \$80,000. "I've had a few of the Spill The Beans' that go well and Cosmic Gossip is one of them," he said. "Both Shane and I liked her, too. Rothfire is going to be very hard to beat and he's not a \$1.10 favourite for no reason,

but my filly is very honest and has already won \$150,000 and she'll be running on strongly."

#### Wide draw for Oh Five Glory

Oh Five Glory's (Unencumbered) run of wide barriers has continued as she prepares for the \$300,000 3YO Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast. There would be few horses who have had such a bad run with barriers with Oh Five Glory starting from nine, nine, 12, 12, and 13 at her past five starts. Today, she has drawn 15 and, with scratchings, will start from no better than gate 12. "The last time she drew a good barrier was when she had the rails and she was second in the Listed Mode Plate during the winter," co-trainer Peter Hulbert said. "She really should have won more races. She's won nearly \$300,000 in prize-money and been placed twice in stakes company so she owes us nothing. She will want some luck again on Saturday. Maybe a wet track will make barriers less important and we can only hope."

## Boom times to continue for Gollan

Tony Gollan will rely solely on Baby Boomer (Spirit Of Boom) in today's \$300,000 Jewel 3YO (1200m) at the Gold Coast after stablemate Sugar Boom (Spirit Of Boom) was yesterday scratched from the race. Baby Boomer has run second at his past three starts and Gollan believes he is primed to be strong again at the finish. "I don't want it too wet for him but he is very close to a good win," he said.

#### Sunlight pleases in jump out

Three-time Group 1 winner Sunlight (Zoustar) took another step towards her return to racing with her first public appearance in 2020 at Flemington yesterday morning. Co-trainer Tony McEvoy said that the jump out over 800 metres was not his initial plan for Sunlight, but he thought it the appropriate decision as she returns from a splint bone injury she suffered while spelling during the summer. "She was due for another gallop, but I thought I'd send her through the gates," trainer Tony McEvoy told Racing.com. "She just cruised around and wasn't getting tested, but she will need one or two more of those before we go to the races. She was really stimulated this morning and really chuffed to be jumping out of the gates again."

## Winx sibling to be unveiled in Monday trial

Rosehill's trial session on Monday is set to have a star attraction in the form of the Chris Wallertrained Covent Garden (Exceed And Excel), the half-sister to champion mare Winx (Street Cry), who will make her first public appearance. Covent Garden, who will contest a 900m trial, has been retained under the banner of John Camilleri's Fairway Thoroughbreds, with Camilleri having bred Winx before selling her at the 2013 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$230,000 to Peter Tighe's Magic Bloodstock. Their dam Vegas Showgirl (Al Akbar) has produced eight foals, with Covent Garden number seven. However, only two of her foals have raced: Winx and Group 3 winner El Divino (Snitzel). She currently has a Deep Impact foal at foot.

## Work cut out in Oaks for Loire

New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m)-winning trainer Tony Pike is confident his Group 1-winning filly Loire (Redoute's Choice) will be suited by the extended distance when she tries to turn the tables on rival Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) in today's renewal of the race at Trentham. Loire has clashed with the Shaune Ritchie-trained Jennifer Eccles on five occasions and has beaten the \$1.95 Oaks favourite home in three of those five contests. However, the last two clashes have gone the way of Jennifer Eccles, who displayed a superior turn of foot in both the Lowland Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) and Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m). "We have targeted Loire to peak on Saturday so it wouldn't surprise me if she finished a lot closer than her last two starts," Pike said. "Her work has been super this week. A mile and a half around Trentham is a lot different to 2000m around Hawke's Bay and Te Rapa. Loire has a touch of class, she won the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas and as long as she sees out the mile and a half, which I think she will, then I think she will be one of my better chances of winning another Oaks."

## **Unbeaten Levante chasing Guineas**

Unbeaten filly Levante (Proisir) will tackle Group company for the first time today when

she contests the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Trentham. The Ken and Bev Kelsotrained filly has been installed the \$2.50 favourite for the black-type assignment having impressed in each of her four career victories. "I'm very happy with her preparation," Ken Kelso said. "Her work on Wednesday was first-class on the course proper against the rail. She has never left the Waikato, that is probably a question mark, but she has a fantastic attitude. She is very laid back and a great eater."

#### Sinarahma seeking Cuddle

Sinarahma (Darci Brahma) will also be looking for her first Group win when she contests Trentham's Cuddle Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) today. The Allan Sharrock-trained five-year-old has won three of her five starts this campaign, including a last start victory in the Wairarapa Breeders' Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Tauherenikau. It was the daughter of Darci Brahma's first stakes victory and Sharrock said he has been pleased with her progress this preparation. "I am very happy with her, she has flown through her prep. She has had a nice, soft trial at Foxton to get her ready for it and hasn't turned a hair, her work has been super," he said.

## Ten wins deducted from Johnson's record

Veteran rider Chris Johnson is still 18 wins away from equalling David Walsh's record for the number of wins in New Zealand. Johnson recorded win number 2433 at Ashburton on Thursday and will continue his pursuit of Walsh's record of 2451 wins at Trentham and Woodville this weekend. A detailed check of Johnson's riding records by NZTR this month found that his winning tally on their website was 10 wins higher than it should have been.

Twelve overseas wins had been mistakenly added to his NZ wins for the 1983-84 season and there were two wins over the previous two seasons which had been omitted from his record. Much of the detail for the riding records in the early 1980s was input manually, which resulted in some errors.

## Ho believes Preciousship's still on the up

Rider Vincent Ho believes Preciousship's (Iffraaj) impressive improvement this season can continue when the Irish-bred aims for a fifth win of the campaign at his seventh start in today's Class 1 Lung Cheung Handicap (1600m) at Sha Tin. "I'm pretty confident," Ho said. "The handicap helps – he'll be much better carrying a light weight because he's a small horse." Ho has been in the plate for the Ricky Yiu-trained galloper's last five starts, including his four wins, but sat out the five-year-old's most recent barrier trial due to a sore knee. "I watched his trial the other day and he did it well – he seems to have kept his form," the rider said.

## **Keeneland April Sale** cancelled

Keeneland has cancelled next month's April Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale as the global coronavirus pandemic spreads. Up to Friday morning, confirmed cases of the virus surpassed 1700, with 41 deaths in the United States. Eight positive tests are located in Kentucky, home to Keeneland and the centre of thoroughbred breeding in America. The 70 lots entered in this year's sale had been posted online on Tuesday, with catalogues due to be mailed yesterday. Keeneland has also announced that its spring racing meeting will open on April 2 behind closed doors and will not be considered for reopening to spectators until April 15. "While our horsemen and fans are certainly disappointed about us having to take these measures, it is critical to protect the health and safety of our patrons, employees and participants from the spread of Covid-19," Keeneland president and CEO Bill Thomason said.

## Dubai World Cup meeting closed to public

Racing officials in Dubai have confirmed that the US\$12 million Dubai World Cup will be staged without paying spectators. The event is the highlight of the 10-meeting Dubai World Cup Carnival and takes place on a card worth a total of US\$35 million, with eight stakes races for thoroughbreds - including five Group 1 races - as well as the Dubai Kahayla Classic (Gr 1, 2000m) for the purebred Arabians. A statement from the Dubai Racing Club said: "Due to the ongoing global health implications of Covid-19 and precautionary measures being implemented by the United Arab Emirates government, Dubai Racing Club will host the Dubai World Cup meeting on March 28 without paid hospitality spectators at Meydan." Only horse connections, racing officials, accredited media and sponsors will be permitted entry. All races will be contested but supporting World Cup events have been cancelled.

## Irish racing to go ahead behind closed doors

Horse Racing Ireland on Thursday announced that racing will take place behind closed doors until Sunday March 29, in response to the coronavirus pandemic. The announcement followed government advice issued on Thursday morning by Ireland's Prime Minister Leo Varadakar that schools and colleges would close in an effort to contain the spread of Covid-19. Brian Kavanagh, chief executive of

HRI, said: "It's important that horseracing acts responsibly and plays its part in the efforts to limit the spread of Covid-19. That's why we are announcing, with immediate effect, that horse racing fixtures in Ireland will continue between now and March 29, but will be run behind closed doors with very restrictive access."

Listed and Group 3 company since. Galiway, who is also responsible for Group 3 winner Kenway, stands at Haras de Colleville in France where his fee this year is  $\in 10,000$ .

However, he managed to give her just enough space to send her out after the leader Shout The Bar (Not A Single Doubt), grabbing the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained filly on the line to inflict her first defeat. The John O'Shea-prepared All Saints' Eve (Sacred Falls) charged home for third.

Last year, Godolphin's Pohutukawa (Medaglia D'Oro) looked a potential star in the making after sweeping home for a dominant victory in this race, but she is yet to win again from 10 starts since. However, stable representative Darren Beadman said that, while Pohutukawa was already at her peak for this race in 2019, Asiago is only just starting to learn what the game is about.

"It was a very gutsy performance by the filly," Beadman told Sky Racing. "Last preparation, she went from winning a maiden to winning the Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Newcastle and it's always a good form race, that.

"It was encouraging because she only had the one trial leading into the other day and she ran a nice third first-up, she just knocked up late. There was plenty of improvement to come and the penny is just starting to drop with her now. So for her to get another stakes win against a pretty stellar type of field is promising.

"She likes give in the ground so there could be something nice there for her during the tail-end of the carnival in Sydney or even something in Brisbane. I'm sure James will work that out. She's a beautiful filly, she takes everything in her stride.

Give Hughie ten out of ten for that ride too, it was a beautiful ride."

Asiago holds entries for both the Coolmore Legacy (Gr 1, 1600m) and the ATC Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) on April 11, with Bowman suggesting the longer trip may be more suitable for her.

"I think she has Oaks written all over her," the rider said. "I don't even know what her pedigree is, I should have done my homework before riding her, but she will eat up 2000 metres. I think she will go beyond that. The team will work out what the plans are for her but she certainly has a bright future."

A Godolphin homebred, Asiago is the fourth foal - and the third to race - out of Disputes (Manton), a winner of the 2012 Reginald Allen Quality (Listed, 1400m). She is now a five-time winner from 11 starts and has \$290,745 in prize money to her name.

## Begg sets sights on spring with Nonconformist

One horse that will not progress to Sydney for The Championships is the Graham Begg-trained Nonconformist (Rebel Raider), who swept to a dominant three and a quarter length victory in the Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m) at Moonee Valley last night.

Three of the last four winners of the Alister Clark have progressed to the ATC Derby (Gr 1, 2400m), with both Hardham (Redoute's Choice) and Tally (Street Cry) placing in the blue riband event. It would seem a logical next step for Nonconformist, but Begg said that the three-year-old - still in his first preparation, having debuted in late November - would instead be bound for a paddock.

"I'm not tempted, he's going out next week," said Begg. "He'll have eight weeks out, he'll be back before it gets too cold. We might think about something in the spring with him - maybe a Caulfield Cup. You never know, he's won at Caulfield and he's run well there. His rating points will go up for that win tonight but he's probably still going to have to do a bit to qualify, I guess. It's a nice problem to have, anyway."

Nonconformist is a homebred for the Henwood family and has now won three of his six starts, banking \$288,650 in the process. He is the first of only two foals for his dam Good Thinking (Hold That Tiger); she produced a Master Of Design (Redoute's Choice) colt in 2018 but died in January, 2019.

Rebel Raider (Reset) is also deceased, having died suddenly due to a ruptured aorta at Wyndholm Park in Victoria in October last year. Nonconformist is dual Derby winner's fourth individual stakes winner, joining Group 3 victors Pretty Punk and Waging War and Listed winner Wasabi Bob.

## Globe-trotting Delectation Girl out to enhance value in Coolmore Classic

electation Girl (Delegator),
a European-bred mare who
has raced in six countries for
Newcastle syndicator Australian
Bloodstock, will get her chance to win a maiden
Group 1 race in today's fillies and mares
Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) at Rosehill.

The well-travelled six-year-old, a three-time stakes winner in the northern hemisphere, is in what is likely to be her final racing preparation with the mare slated for auction at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale in May.

The Kris Lees-trained Delectation Girl, who will be ridden by Andrew Mallyon from barrier two in the Coolmore Classic, demonstrated she was returning to peak form when runner-up to stablemate Special Reward (Demerit) in the Newcastle Newmarket (Gr 3, 1400m) 15 days ago.

In eight starts for Lees, she has twice finished runner-up at Group 3 level, with arguably her best Australian performance coming in the Angst Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Randwick last October.

Delectation Girl has raced 20 times in total, 19 of those under the Australian Bloodstock ownership banner.

"I found her off a maiden win in England, so we have had her all bar one of her runs," Australian Bloodstock's Luke Murrell said.

"The poor bugger has been everywhere. She won Scotland's only stakes race as a two-yearold, then we sent her to Germany and she did really well for us over there and won a couple of Group races.

"She had a crack in England in a Group 1 and then we sent her to America which was a disaster"

The five-start US career, spanning two preparations, occurred in 2017 and 2018 before the decision was made to bring her to Australia early last year.

"She came back in not the best of health,

oack," he said.

"She will be sold at Magic Millions, but if she could run up to the Angst when she ran second at Randwick, I have her running a really good race at huge odds.

so Kris has done an amazing job to nurse her

"She's not really a 1400-metre horse at all but she was super the other day."

Australian Bloodstock enjoyed significant sales ring success on the Gold Coast last year when they sold the dam of 2019 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Lyre (Lonhro), Street Cry (Machiavellian) mare Erato, who was in foal to Russian Revolution (Snitzel), for \$1.75 million. Murrell and Lovett bought her from the same sale two years earlier for \$120,000.

Delectation Girl is by Dansili (Danehill) stallion Delegator out of the six-furlong-winning mare Chushka (Pivotal), who in turn is a half-sister to the Group 2-successful Captain Hurricane (Desert Style).

"She's a two-year-old Group winner, she has done it in three or four different countries now," Murrell said of Delectation Girl's value as a broodmare prospect.

"If we could find the right mares race to

win here she would be really well sought after because she's a good type.

"We will have a crack here (in Sydney) and then a bit of focus on Queensland, but she is certainly going as well as she ever has in her life I think."

### Danceteria (Redoute's Choice) (Sky High Stakes, Rosehill)

"I haven't been that disappointed for a long time in a runner just because there'd been such high expectations first-up. He just couldn't go, the big fella. I am going to be more nervous with him on Saturday than any other horse because he's a very good horse but he had an issue in the spring. He worked sensationally leading up to the Sydney run - he had the third best last 600 metres of the race, but he still got beaten a fair way. I expected him to do a lot better than that. Has he not come up? All the work suggests that he has, but you have to see it on race day. We are going in a bit blind. If we didn't have that run the other day I would say he was the winner with something in hand, but given that run he is going to be 20-1 and friendless on the day."

### Attention Run (Hurricane Run) (Sky High Stakes, Rosehill)

"We have probably only brought four or five mares to Australia and four of them we have got black type with. She is flying and she got stuck on the wrong part of the track the other day, but I don't think that's her race (today), to be honest. I think she's looking for 2400 metres, but she is certainly going well. She'll show up in a BMW (H E Tancred Stakes) or a Chairman's on her way to a Sydney Cup."

## Mustajeer (Medicean) (Sky High Stakes, Rosehill)

"If we had drawn Attention Run's gate (five), I think he would be a moral. None of those horses could go with him bar possibly Danceteria. It's just a little sticky from that gate (10) and Rosehill doesn't really suit horses circling pre-bend and wide. It could look a bit ugly but I would expect he will run top two."

## Tactical Advantage (Bel Esprit) (Maurice McCarten Stakes, Rosehill)

"We didn't pay a lot for him and he's won right on \$1 million. He's been a beauty for us. As he's got older he's probably lost a little bit of that tactical speed. I will know halfway through the race if he's going to be winning or not. If he's midfield I think he'll win, but if he's last ... the Rosehill 1100 metres is a really biased track and distance course and I don't think we'd be able to give Zoustyle six lengths and round him up at Rosehill; Randwick would be a different story. If he's midfield I'll be expecting him to go really close."

### Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) (Canberra Cup winner)

"It's been a bit of a rollercoaster ride with him, but Kris has done a really good job with him. We're just trying to map where we go and I don't think the Sydney Cup will be it. We're probably

going to the Manion Cup and then that will give us some options as to whether we stay to a Queen Elizabeth Stakes path or we go to a Tancred Stakes. No one has been able to find the bottom of him yet, so I think he's a bit better than what he has shown us so far. The other thing is, he can sustain his run, which is what has really impressed me. There's no doubt he will stick on and get a trip, but he might just be a bit too classy for us to stretch him out to a Sydney Cup this year."


