Exciting US stallions join Spendthrift Australia roster

Grade 1 winners Omaha Beach, Vino Rosso to stand alongside Overshare, Swear and Gold Standard at the Victorian farm

Grade 1 winners Omaha Beach (War Front) and Vino Rosso (Curlin), two of the most exciting young stallions among the American breeding ranks, will shuttle to Spendthrift Australia this spring, headlining the Victorian farm's five-stallion roster in 2020.

"It's a massive vote of confidence in the Victorian market by Spendthrift's owner Mr Hughes to shuttle such elite American horses to Australia," Spendthrift Australia's general

manager Garry Cuddy told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. "They are proper horses that won multiple Grade 1 races - not just handy horses, but elite.

"One of the reasons Spendthrift Australia was established was to give Spendthrift horses of this calibre an opportunity to succeed in both hemispheres. They'll be afforded every chance at success with the support of our broodmare band and we will be active at the sales over the coming months to purchase mares that specifically complement their profiles.

Cambridge Stud and Te Akau Racing join forces for Melbourne spring

Two of New Zealand's thoroughbred powerhouses are set to join forces to tackle Melbourne spring racing.

Te Akau Racing and Cambridge Stud principals Brendan and Jo Lindsay have already experienced success across the Tasman with Group 1-winning filly Probabeel (Savabeel) and they are hoping to try and extend that winning formula this coming season.

Probabeel will be joined in Te Akau's Melbourne spring team by five additional Lindsay-owned fillies, including Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Vernazza (More Than Ready) and the exciting two-year-old Pazienza (Written Tycoon).

The joint venture has the blessing of Cambridge Stud's private trainer Lance Noble who will continue to train approximately 28 horses from his Karaka base.

“Both covered full books in their debut seasons at Spendthrift America, yet the amazing opportunity for Australian breeders is they will stand at a fraction of the service fee here. These are two superstar horses standing at incredible value and we're very proud to have them join our roster.”

Omaha Beach will stand at \$22,000 (inc GST) for his first Australian season, with Vino Rosso available at \$13,750 (inc GST). That compares to US\$45,000 (AUD\$69,400) and US\$30,000 (AUD\$46,200) respectively.

Both Omaha Beach and Vino Rosso are among a slew of new stallions joining the Australian ranks this season, but few can match the racetrack feats of the pair.

A veteran of just ten starts, Omaha Beach was a three-time Grade 1 winner as a three-year-old, proving his versatility by taking the Arkansas Derby (Gr 1, 9f) early in the season before adding the Santa Anita Sprint Championship (Gr 1, 6f) and the Malibu Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) before 2019 was out.


“Omaha Beach was brilliant once he hit his straps,” highly-respected American racing analyst Candice Hare told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. “He showed precocity and yet somehow still managed to improve over the length of his career.”

“In recent years, we have looked to Bob Baffert as holding sway over the three-year-old races and Omaha Beach put away his best two three-year-olds, Game Winner and Improbable, quite easily.

“Being a Grade 1-winning sprinter as well as a horse who was able to stretch out, I think the speed he possessed will be a drawcard to Australian breeders. Though he excelled on dirt, he ran well on the turf and his pedigree lends itself to turf racing, being by War Front from one of the best sprinter-miler families in the American stud book.

“His brother Courage Under Fire ran second to Caravaggio in the Phoenix Stakes, an Irish Group 1 on turf, so I think he will be the type to produce good, fast turf horses who will be well-suited to Australian racing conditions.”

Omaha Beach is a half-brother to champion two-year-old filly Take Charge Brandi (Giant's Causeway), a dual Grade 1 winner, while their dam Charming (Seeking The Gold) is a half-sister to Grade 1 winners and sires Will Take Charge (Unbridled's Song) and Take Charge Indy (A P Indy). Charming, Will Take Charge and Take Charge Indy are all out of Take Charge Lady (Dehere), a three-time Grade 1 winner and the US Broodmare of the Year in 2013.

"Omaha Beach, being a son of War Front from one of the best families in the American studbook, has great genetic appeal," Cuddy said. "War Front has shown his qualities as a sire of sires through the deeds of Declaration of War."

Omaha Beach's racing connections have been associated with some of the finest thoroughbreds to have graced the American turf, but all could recognise that the dark bay colt was something out of the box.

Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella, who has prepared top horses like Beholder (Henny Hughes), Pleasantly Perfect (Pleasant Colony) and The Tin Man (Equiano), told Bloodhorse: "I can't think of one better than him. He hasn't been around as long as the likes of Beholder, she was a champion, but probably the few times he ever got beat were my fault. I wish I could take the credit for him, but I think he's just a very good horse and he has been a great pleasure to have around the barn."

Owner Rick Porter, whose portfolio has included Songbird (Medaglia d'Oro), Hard Spun (Danzig) and Havre De Grace (Saint Liam), added: "He and Songbird were the two best horses I ever had, and I've been fortunate enough to have some good ones. This guy, between his personality, his talent, and his bad luck, was special."

Vino Rosso raced at the highest level at both three and four, winning two Grade 1 races - the Gold Cup (Gr 1, 10f) at Santa Anita and the Breeders'

Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f), the traditional season-ending championship on the American calendar.

"Vino Rosso is by a Champion sire in Curlin, who has sired over ten per cent stakes winners to runners, which is exceptional by any standards," Cuddy said.

Hare added: "His career was hallmarked by a similar toughness to his sire Curlin. He was better as he got over more ground and also as he got older, but what I think was most memorable about him was his tenacity; if you were in a stretch duel with him, you were going to lose."

“Vino Rosso was born the day after Triple Crown winner Justify at the same farm, John and Tanya Gunther’s Glennwood Farm in Kentucky. Justify may have overshadowed him early with his exploits as a three-year-old, but long after Justify had been shipped to the breeding barn, Vino Rosso was demonstrating his soundness and his physical maturity by performing at the highest level, culminating in the Breeders’ Cup Classic last year.”

The addition of Omaha Beach and Vino Rosso to the Victorian ranks adds to the renaissance of American shuttle stallions, which had tapered off in recent years. The pair join two Triple Crown winners, American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) and Justify (Scat Daddy), as well as Grade 1 winners Frosted (Tapit) and World Of Trouble (Kantharos), in making the trip down under for the 2020 southern hemisphere breeding season.

The move has been lauded on both sides of the Pacific, with American experts believing that both Omaha Beach and Vino Rosso have the potential to follow in the footsteps of More Than Ready (Southern Halo) in finding success with their progeny in the sales ring and on the race track in both the United States and Australia.

“They are a classy pair - actually, all of the American stallions set to shuttle to Australia are incredibly classy this year - and both are really fast, which is key,” Hare said. “I think when we, as analysts in America, look at our top horses today, even if they are winning over a mile and a quarter, we are still noting how fast they are and how fast they have to be.

“If you are bred to win over a mile and a quarter, these days you have no chance of winning a Kentucky Derby because you don’t have the natural pace that’s required to perform at the highest level in the United States.

“Our horses are fast, which is why I think they translate well to the Australian breeding barn. Not to mention that our breeding industries aren’t really that different when you look at the influence that Danzig and his sons have had across the board.”

Both Omaha Beach and Vino Rosso will join three promising Spendthrift Australia stallions: Swear (Redoute’s Choice), whose first yearlings went through the sales ring earlier this year, as well as Overshare (I Am Invincible) and Gold Standard (Sebring), who had their first foals on the ground last spring.

Overshare will stand again at \$11,000 (inc GST), the same fee at which his sire I Am Invincible stood for his first four seasons. The Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) line is proving tremendously popular and, as a colonial sire from that line, he shapes as an exciting prospect.

“We couldn’t be happier with Overshare’s start to stud,” Cuddy said. “The proof is in his numbers - he covered 150 mares last season after the quality of his foals were seen. He’s an incredibly good looking horse himself and it’s very encouraging to see this coming through in his foal quality.”

Swear’s first yearlings sold for up to \$80,000, more than 15 times his service fee of \$5,500 (inc GST), a level at which he remains for the upcoming season.

“As we continue to see each season with Snitzel and Not A Single Doubt, it’s hard to fault a son of Redoute’s Choice and Swear has all the credentials to succeed,” said Cuddy. “John Hawkes, Swear’s own trainer, purchased the first colt of his through the ring which is a great tick of approval.”

Gold Standard also remains at \$5,500 (inc GST). As a rare son of the late Sebring (More Than Ready) at stud, he holds plenty of appeal, particularly given the physical similarities to his sire.

“Gold Standard is the image of his sire and his foals are showing that class and quality too,” Cuddy said. “The word that springs to mind when I see him and his foals is athleticism. Again he covered a bigger book in his second season than his first, that only happens when the foals are excellent types.”

All three of Spendthrift Australia’s returning stallions are available to breeders under the Breed Secure payment scheme. This allows breeders to pay the service fee once the resultant foal has been sold, having recouped expense allowances and secured financial upside.

Victorian government package guarantees stakes

A \$44 million state government aid package for the three racing codes will mean that Racing Victoria won't have to address any further prize-money reductions until the end of September. Of the \$44 million allocated by the Victorian government to racing under the heading 'Experience Economy Survival Package,' \$16.6 million will be received by thoroughbred racing with the remainder going to harness and greyhound racing. Racing Victoria said of the package: "Victorian thoroughbred racing generates \$3.2 billion in annual economic activity for the state and supports the equivalent of more than 25,000 jobs. Overall, there are 110,000 people who are employed or participate in Victorian thoroughbred racing and close to 10,000 racehorses in training each year."

Reykjavik scratched from Lee

The Lindsey Smith-trained Reykjavik (Artie Schiller) has been injured, forcing the five-year-old to be scratched from Saturday's R.A. Lee Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Morphettville. Reykjavik was favourite for the \$120,000 race however a foot injury will see him stay put to recover. "It's really disappointing. He pulled his shoe and then stood on the nail when he was coming out of the pool, he's pierced the sole," Smith told Racing.com. "We were with him at the time so he didn't do any additional damage, but he will definitely have to miss this weekend. Hopefully it will heal up soon and he will now be set to try and go back-to-back in the Listed Winter Championship at Flemington, which he won last year."

Good Idea to chase Cup berth

Good Idea (So You Think) will be given the chance to try and secure a place in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) when he lines up in the Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) at Flemington on Saturday. Phillip Stokes believes the gelding deserves his chance in the Ramsden having finished second in the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) earlier this campaign. He finished a respectable third to import Haky (Muhtathir) last time out over 2600 metres at Flemington. "I thought if he went straight and didn't hand in, as he can do sometimes, he probably would have nearly got there last start," Stokes said. "We're hoping with Ben Thompson on, he's a natural left hand whip rider, that will be a plus. It is a big carrot (Melbourne Cup qualification) so we thought we'd give him his chance while he is going well."

Young trainer Julius dares to dream with Super Girl

Bendigo trainer Josh Julius will be dreaming of Melbourne Cup glory should his stable star Super Girl (So You Think) go out and win the Andrew Ramsden Stakes on Saturday. "Potentially lining up on that first Tuesday in November with a homebred trained out of Bendigo would be pretty cool," Julius told Racing.com. "We're just rapt to be fit enough and well enough to be part of the day and so whatever happens, happens." Julius, who has trained 26 winners so far, said he and owner/breeder Jim Middlemiss opted to aim for the stars after Super Girl ended her spring campaign with a win at Bendigo. "Myself and Jim, her owner, at the end of last prep we looked at the autumn and threw a few crazy ideas around," Julius said. "We saw the Ramsden there in May and thought we might be able to target that race."

Berry's big chance to unmask Crusader's true potential

Tommy Berry believes he has had the chance to sit on some horses who could be in the calibre of the great Chautauqua (Encosta De Lago). One of those is Masked Crusader (Toronado), who has been the subject of hype after his impressive three-length win at Randwick on May 9, ahead of his run in the \$200,000 Inglis Guineas (RL, 1400m) at Rosehill on Saturday. "There's been horses like Libertini and Exceedance, nice fresh blood coming through, that you don't know where their top is and this guy is a bit the same," Berry told Racing NSW. "He's so exciting because we don't know how good he is yet and he has the potential to be very good." Masked Crusader is currently at \$1.70 for the race and a \$26 chance for the TAB Everest (1200m).

Air To Air faces big step up at Rosehill

Jason Coyle knows Air To Air (Smart Missile) faces a mammoth task in the Inglis 3YO Guineas on Saturday, but the trainer thinks enough of the filly to warrant giving her a crack at the \$200,000 race at Rosehill. "Obviously it's a massive step up in grade but she's a horse who I've had a really nice opinion of," Coyle said. "She won't get to run in the race in 12 months' time and last start she did what I had probably been expecting from her, but probably not over the distance I thought she would. I thought she might have been a little bit sharper early but possibly a combination of a bit of race experience and stepping out in distance was a positive for her last start. Racing in Sydney is strong, full stop, but the race has probably come up with a couple of horses with more ability than you'd probably expect."

Black Heart Bart to complete final campaign in Perth

Veteran Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) is set to begin his last campaign in what has been a long, illustrious career. The six-time Group 1 winner will complete his last preparation in Western Australia, beginning in Saturday's Roma Cup (Gr 3, 1200m) at Ascot. The nine-year-old was first retired in October 2018 before moving from Darren Weir to Lindsey Smith for a spring campaign which yielded a win in the Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m). "He'll have four more starts for me at 1200 metres, 1400 metres, 1600 metres and 2000 metres, starting this Saturday in the Roma Cup," Smith told Racing.com. "All his races will be over there and weight-for-age. He's doing well, he's fit and over those feet issues he's had. Obviously, his glory days are behind him but I'm hopeful he's still got another win in him."

Acrophobic debuts with Warwick Farm win

After a winning debut in the Exceedance @ Vinery Handicap (1400m) at Warwick Farm yesterday, the John O'Shea-trained Acrophobic (Dissident) could be set for a tilt at the JJ Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "It was a really good effort because they never dawdled and he was off the bridle a little bit out and you could see how lost he was but he's got a great propensity to want to be a good horse," O'Shea told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "We'll get him home and see how he pulls up and see what Mac (James McDonald, jockey) has got to say. As always we value his opinion and we'll give some consideration to what we do with him. He's in at Queensland and whether he's ready for that, we'll make a decision after the next week or so."

Liza lights up Doomben with promise

Returning for her first start since her debut in December, Tony Golan's Liza With A Zee (Zoustar) took out a 1050-metre maiden at Doomben against the older horses by a comfortable margin of three and a half lengths yesterday. "I have always had a big opinion of her but we probably made a mistake running her in December," Gollan said. "She came back from a break a stronger filly. Not many two-year-olds beat older horses at their second start." While she is nominated for the JJ Atkins Stakes, Gollan said Liza With A Zee is unlikely to target the juvenile feature. "She is more likely to run in a Listed race at Doomben in two weeks. I think she is definitely a Saturday horse and black-type is also on the cards," Gollan said.

Maloney to help Tarzan defend sprint crown

Ryan Maloney will reunite with Tarzan (Drumbeats) as the gelding fights off challenges to his crown as the king of the Sunshine Coast. The seven-year-old will be attempting to win his second Listed race when he resumes in the Chief De Beers Handicap (Listed, 1000m) on Friday night. Tarzan has had 17 starts at the Sunshine Coast 1000 metres for 10 wins, four seconds and a third with one of those wins in the Queensland Lightning (Listed, 1000m) in 2018. "Ryan suits him and Tarzan has had a nice trial where he ran second," trainer Stuart Kendrick said. "His first-up record (eight starts for four wins and two seconds) is good but the outside barrier is no help."

Krone ready for Stradbroke bid

Tony Gollan's latest stable addition Krone (Eurozone) will attempt to earn a spot in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) when she contests the Silk Stocking (Listed, 1200m) at the Gold Coast on Saturday. Krone raced in the south for the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jr partnership when she won the Cinderella Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville and the Darby Munro Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Rosehill. She was sent to Gollan with the aim of getting more black-type in the winter. "She has

pleased me since coming up here. Her trial win was good and hopefully she will run up to it," Gollan said.

Tasmania trials given go-ahead

Trials in the three racing codes have been given the green light to resume in Tasmania as the state eyes a return to the track next month. Trials have been permitted to resume from Monday under strict social distancing rules and with fewer officials and participants. "(The) announcement gives industry participants the chance to prepare their animals for a restart of racing from 13 June," Minister for Racing Jane Howlett said yesterday. "I hope the decision provides a much-needed boost of confidence to the industry." Trials can be held at Mowbray and Longford Racecourses in the state's north and Elwick Racecourse in Hobart, while track gallops and jump-outs will also proceed for thoroughbreds.

Rising Red retired

The injury-plagued career of Rising Red (Redwood) has come to an end. The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained gelding succumbed to his third major injury in a track gallop on Tuesday, ending his racing career. "He galloped on Tuesday and pulled up sore in a gallop," Busuttin said yesterday. "He had a fractured fetlock, so he has gone in to have surgery today, but he will be in recuperation, be retired, and we'll find a good home for him." Rising Red was restricted to just 24 career starts as a result of his two year-long layoffs as a result of suspensory ligament issues, recording four wins, including on his final start at Sandown.

Maher, Eustace internal probe discovers reason for positive

An internal investigation has found the reason why the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Piccatic (Fastnet Rock) returned a positive test to furosemide after she won her maiden at Sale on February 20. Maher released a statement confirming human error led to the positive swab. "Subject to notification by the RV Stewards, Ciaran Maher Racing conducted an internal review which led to a clear finding that human error led to the treatment of Piccatic with furosemide, instead of the intended horse Stardayz," the statement read. Racing Victoria stewards have charged Maher and Eustace with presenting a horse to race with a prohibited substance in its system and the Victorian Racing Tribunal will hear the matter on a date to be fixed.

Pollett, Lambourne charged

Controversial punter Glenn Pollett and fellow panellist Marc Lambourne have been charged by Racing NSW stewards following an inquiry into comments made about jockey James McDonald on the RacingRant. On the subscriber only show on April 20, comments were made that suggested McDonald bets on his own rides in races. Stewards have issued both Pollett and Lambourne with charges under AR228 for conduct detrimental to the interests of racing. Both have been charged under AR228(a) which states a person must not engage in conduct prejudicial to the image, interests, integrity, or welfare of racing, whether or not that conduct takes place within a racecourse or elsewhere.

Lambourne was slapped with a second charge for a breach of AR228(d). The inquiry is set to continue in the coming weeks.

NEW ZEALAND

Browne's Hill back in action

Waikato's famed Browne's Hill is back in action after a month-long hiatus. The husband and wife training duo of Emma-Lee and David Browne had the opportunity to continue ticking their team over on their private training establishment on the property during Covid-19 Alert Level 4, however, they elected to turn out their entire team in the midst of uncertainty. "We decided not to (work them) with the uncertainty about when races were going to start again," Emma-Lee Browne said. "We didn't really think it was fair on the owners to keep the horses in without a definite plan. Instead, we spoke with all of our owners and decided to put them out in the paddock. As soon as level 4 was lifted we brought everything back in. We have got 25 in at the moment."

INTERNATIONAL

Ten for Wootton Bassett

French sire Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) landed his tenth individual stakes winner yesterday when Wooded (3 c ex Frida La Blonde by Elusive City) took out the Prix Texanita (Gr 3, 1200m) at Chantilly. The three-year-old colt defeated Alocasia (Kingman) by a comfortable margin of three and a half lengths with My Love's Passion (Elvstroem) a further two lengths away in third. Wooded

is out of Frida La Blonde (Elusive City), making him a brother to the stakes placed Beat Le Bon. Out of the stakes-winning mare Firm Friend (Affirmed), Frida La Blonde is a sister to Fred Lalloupet and a half-sister to Mon Pote Le Gitan (Thunder Gulch), both of which are stakes scorers. Wootton Bassett stands at Haras d'Etreham for a fee of €40,000 (inc GST), while his son Alamanzor has shuttled to Cambridge Stud in New Zealand where he stood for a fee of NZ\$30,000 (plus GST) in 2019.

Gosden supports UK racing return

Champion British trainer John Gosden believes the strict safety measures at behind-closed-doors fixtures will make racecourses safer than petrol stations and supermarkets, as he expressed relief at knowing a likely resumption date for British racing. On Monday, the government announced no sport in Britain would return until at least June 1 and the BHA is now working towards this date for a return. Speaking on BBC Radio 4's Today programme on Tuesday, Gosden said: "There's relief that we know where we're going. Step two said that from June 1 sport can occur behind closed doors from that date onwards and we can be absolutely ready. I'll feel very comfortable [at a racecourse] with our staff because I've seen all the factors and restrictions that have been put in. I think going to the racecourse will be a great deal safer than going to the petrol station or the supermarket."

Te Akau Racing and Cambridge Stud principals Brendan and Jo Lindsay have already experienced success across the Tasman with Group 1-winning filly Probabeel (Savabeel) and they are hoping to try and extend that winning formula this coming season.



International commingling and a national pool keys to tote turnover growth?

The further growth of international commingling, of which Australia's Tabcorp is a key driver, will be revolutionary and possibly game-changing according to Paul Cross, General Manager International at Tabcorp.

"It's revolutionary in the sense of changing the way people think, with the creation of the concept of a 'World Pool' and potentially game-changing if we get Japan and Korea, two of the biggest parimutuel operators in the world, on board," Cross told ANZ Bloodstock News.

Global commingling turnover is estimated at between US\$15 billion and US\$17 billion, which makes up 15 to 20 per cent of global race betting and Cross expects that will continue to grow.

Meanwhile, Tabcorp's support of a national pool - widely mooted to happen this year - has not wavered, with media manager Rick Wallace yesterday reiterating the company's policy, which is:

"A national pool would provide deeper, more liquid betting products for customers which would strengthen the competitiveness of the tote to address the decline in parimutuel betting, which in turn would enhance the long-term sustainability of racing industry funding."

Wallace noted that "combined pooling requires agreement from a range of stakeholders and Tabcorp is working through the process with all parties."

Liquidity and co-operation are the keys to discussions nationally and internationally

which continue against the backdrop of increased racing audiences, locally and abroad, during the Covid-19 lockdown.

Sky Racing's average audiences rose by 38 per cent (year-on-year) through March and April this year and reached almost 300,000 viewers on each of the two days of The Championships. Sky Raceday (Sky 1 channel) has been the most popular program on the entire Foxtel platform for the past five Saturdays.

Similarly, live streaming on Racing.com's digital platforms surged 122 per cent year-on-year in March, while

the Sky Racing Active app has had 100,000 downloads since its launch last August.

More are also watching Australian racing internationally, according to Cross.

"Our turnover in the US has gone gangbusters and you'd hope there's a level of stickiness in exporting to the US now that they have sampled the quality of Australian racing," he said.

This is but one indicator of the significance of the internationalisation of parimutuel betting and a pointer to the most obvious means of growing pool sizes for the wagering option which provides the greatest return to the racing industry.

"When Tabcorp first kicked off commingling with New Zealand there was immediate growth of between 15 and 18 per cent and the rule of thumb is an increase of between 10 and 15 per cent with any commingled pool," Cross said.

Since then, Tabcorp commingling has expanded to include Hong Kong, Singapore, South Africa and Europe. No fewer than 65 countries now take Sky Racing which illustrates the almost unlimited potential for commingling which, against this backdrop of globalisation, has been effectively re-branded as World Pools.

The most significant of those was at the Royal Ascot meeting last year which saw a 415 per cent increase in turnover and the first ever £1 million-plus win pool on a UK Flat race. Not surprisingly, Alastair Warwick, chief operating officer at Ascot said: "This (world pooling) is the key to our future as it is going to fund it."

That World Pool was, of course, more significant for Ascot starting off a low base

with tote betting less than five per cent of the total racing turnover in the UK. However, all participants benefit with Cross noting an increase in turnover in Australia which would undoubtedly have been greater with a high-profile Australian competitor like Black Caviar in 2012.

"The key is to provide the customer with access to the most liquid pools you can get. We're in constant discussion with tote operators all around the world and pushing the momentum of co-operation. The hope was expressed, at this year's Asian Racing Conference, that by 2050 there'd be global commingling every day but I would ask, 'Why are we waiting until 2050?'" Cross said.

Cultural and regulatory differences and adhering to various policies on responsible gambling create complexities in further expansion but Cross remains optimistic.

"We import more racing than any other country in the world which gives us credibility and I think we have arguably helped along that spirit of cooperation. Tabcorp has taken an educational role and fostered relationships with regulators as well as racing bodies. We can move quickly given our expertise," Cross said.

"It's all about liquidity and therefore growing tote and racing industry revenue and the answer is to link up globally. Imagine the Melbourne Cup, for example, if the three pools in Australia and those in Japan, Hong Kong, the US and France all came together?"

As to progress with Japan, which currently takes only 25 international races per year, and Korea (none) it is a slow work in progress. "It's a time away yet but little inroads are being made," said Cross, who noted that Facebook live vision was able to give international viewers a "taste" of Australian racing in regions where it was not mainstream broadcast.

Tabcorp has entered into arrangements with Japan's "secondary" National Association of Racing (NAR) tracks including Oi or Tokyo City Keiba. "Japanese racing is popular. Interestingly, when we first began with

races listed at Oi, we established via a very simple straw poll that customers didn't know where it was. We changed to Tokyo City Keiba and turnover grew 15 per cent," Cross said.

Significant revenue, as is the case with Hong Kong Jockey Club simulcasts, is also generated to Australian racing when Japan takes the vision of a major race in which a Japanese horse is competing although there is no commingling.

A first time World Pool was scheduled for this year's Dubai World Cup meeting but that, of course, did not proceed due to Covid-19. A World Pool is proposed for Royal Ascot, if it goes ahead, and for Champions Day at Ascot in October.

It seems clear to me that is the obvious path to take in reinvigorating parimutuel betting, and therefore increasing industry revenue, around the globe.

Imagine the World Pool on a Melbourne Cup or a Japan Cup featuring European and Australian runners; or a Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe featuring runners from Japan and, dare we imagine, Australia; or a Royal Ascot race with a Black Caviar and horses from Japan, America and Hong Kong; or a Korean race with runners from several other major jurisdictions.

I know I'd get no argument from Cross, Warwick or Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges at the Hong Kong Jockey Club.

There are difficulties still to be overcome but at least, trusting the results, is no longer one of them. Cross recalled that when Australia first exported vision to France, the French sent staff to Australia to attend the various meetings and phone through the official numbers!

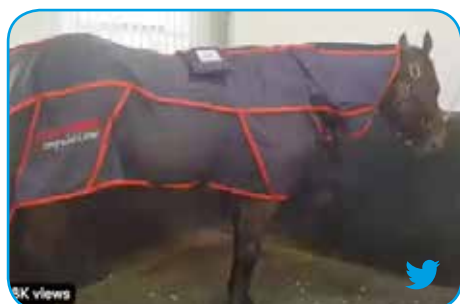
