Gytrash to hit the road for shot at Everest riches

Adelaide sprinter to wear Inglis colours in \$15 million slot race

ark Webster is confident that Group 1-winning sprinter Gytrash (Lope De Vega) is Inglis' best chance of collecting a major share of the \$15 million up for grabs in this year's The Everest (1200m).

The sales company yesterday confirmed that the Gordon Richards-trained Gytrash, this year's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner, would be its representative in the fourth edition of the rich slot race to be run at Randwick on October 17.

Inglis managing director Mark Webster revealed that the auction house, which has a non-compete clause written to its Everest contract preventing Magic Millions or another rival from participating, had cast the net far and wide, including internationally, searching for potential Everest candidates, but it was Gytrash who stood out.

<< Continued from page 1 "Nature Strip is the favourite, who is another Inglis graduate but he's out of play, so we've selected a horse who has beaten Nature Strip and a number of other horses who are in the market for the race. From our end, he ticks a lot of boxes," Webster said yesterday.

"An important way to look at it is, yes, he's got ability and he's won at Group 1 level but what I really like about this horse is that he's run 19 times and he's run top three in 18 of those starts.

"There's only one occasion where he hasn't finished top three and that's in all his races, as a two-year-old, the whole lot. Even in his trials he's always a top three finisher. He has something about him and he doesn't like being beaten.

"That consistency of being a top-three performer is really important for The Everest because the prize-money of the top three is where it really makes a difference when you have to pay \$600,000 for a slot.

"You want to be top-three otherwise it's costing you as a slot owner."

The Adelaide-trained Gytrash (\$15) is the third sprinter to be locked away for this year's 12-slot race, joining Nature Strip (Nicconi) (Tabcorp) and Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) (Bon Ho).

Rubisaki (Rubick), an Inglis Classic graduate, and \$22,500 Inglis Digital buy Bella Vella (Commands), a last-start Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner for Will Clarken, were also contenders for the auction house's slot, as was Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible).

Because of the Covid-19 pandemic, particularly given the rate and

racehorses from that state are currently prevented from racing or being trained in NSW in a ruling implemented by Racing NSW chief executive Peter V'landys.

"We did raise that with Racing NSW a week or so ago as a slot owner that it is something that needs to be clarified because we all need to be locking in horses and it's difficult to do that when there's no guarantee that the horse can come," Webster said.

"It's not only about attending on race day, but it's about being

able to come up and settle in as horses like to do.

"We did raise that and we were told that it wasn't going to be changed right now and that it would be reviewed in a few weeks.

"I still think, in the end, and we went through a very thorough process, that Gytrash was right up there anyway. I am not saying we chose him because we couldn't have a Victorian horse, but it did make it easier for us to make that decision." Continued on page 4>>

<< Continued from page 2 Gytrash, who has not raced since finishing runner-up in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) in May, will have an exhibition with two stablemates at Morphettville today before Richards and his wife Jacqui set off with the five-year-old gelding in tow for a three-day, 1650-kilometre trip.

A mirror in the float will keep Gytrash company until they arrive at Clare Cunningham's Warwick Farm stables on Tuesday.

"We'll have a good sleep Saturday night and then we'll head off just before midday on Sunday to head to Broken Hill. We can't go through Victoria to get there, so we have got to go through NSW," the trainer said.

"He's used to travelling in the float. I have towed him to Melbourne when we used to take him across and race him and bring him back the next day.

"They are ten-hour trips, so he will take this trip in his stride. It's probably five and a half to six hours to Broken Hill. We will stay the night and then it's about eight to Dubbo and then five or six into Warwick Farm, so we will break it up into three days and stop overnight.

"He's a pretty casual bugger, so I don't think that will worry him too much. I'd rather do it now so he has time to get up there and he is going to trial at Warwick Farm next Friday. It's only 800 metres and it's just to give him a go that way of going."

Richards said there was interest from two other slot holders but when

Inglis returned with an offer this week, connections jumped at the chance to link with the sales company which sold Gytrash to the Adelaide trainer for \$40,000 at the 2017 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

He said: "It's fantastic, it really is. Inglis approached me six weeks ago I suppose and just asked what our intentions were. All the time our intentions were to go to Sydney with him to race this preparation in the hope that we get picked up.

"I never heard from them again and I had interest from two other slot holders and I was doing presentations for them, but then Inglis came back the other day and jumped in. They trumped them and the others were still thinking about it.

"We bought him at the Inglis sales, so we're rapt. We would have been happy to get a slot with anyone, but I am really happy that it is with Inglis. It's great."

Richards and his wife will stay at the William Inglis Hotel for the duration of Gytrash's Everest campaign, which is expected to start in the Concorde Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at Randwick on September 5 before using The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) or the Premiere Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as the gelding's lead-up run.

"I know it's an old cliche, but he seems to be getting better every prep. You can see little things that he's doing wrong in other preps (that he isn't now)," he said.

"Until he starts racing you're not going to know, but to me he has come back bigger and stronger. Proof of the pudding will be in the eating I guess, but I am really happy with him."

Fell Swoop (Not A Single Doubt) (2017, 12th), Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) (2018, sixth) and In Her Time (Time Thief) (2019, ninth) represented Inglis in the first three runnings of the race.

Pressure off Bowman's Mother

Daniel Bowman isn't under the same pressure as he was going into last year's Regal Roller Stakes (Listed, 1200m) with his stable star Begood Toya Mother (Myboycharlie). Last year, Bowman said the stakes were high as the gelding needed to win the Listed sprint to boost his rating high enough to get into the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). History shows Begood Toya Mother ticked both boxes, winning the two races to catapult Bowman into the spotlight. Bowman is hoping to win both races again this spring but pointed out that Begood Toya Mother is not as forward in fitness as he was last year. "This is a kick-off point and there's definitely improvement to come but we've got bigger fish to fry," Bowman said. "He's coming off a good spell though, compared to last year where he had been in work the whole time." Bowman is pleased with how the six-year-old has returned to racing. "He's had a couple of trials. He's more relaxed and hopefully that's a sign that he'll get a mile this time in," the trainer added.

Smart Image out to remain unbeaten

Smart Image (Smart Missile) will undergo his toughest test when he steps up to black-type company for the first time in today's Up And Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) at Randwick. The now three-year-old has been winning through the winter to earn his place in today's Group 3 race as co-trainers Peter and Paul Snowden look to get a better gauge on his ability. He is the second pick in early betting behind the Hawkes Racing-trained colt North Pacific (Brazen Beau), who Peter Snowden concedes is the benchmark. "No doubt. He is lightly-raced but

from the couple of starts he has had he looks well above average," Snowden said of North Pacific. "For me, he is the yardstick there. He is definitely the one to beat and if we can finish close to him I'll be happy." Snowden might have a healthy respect for his runner's rival but he is not conceding defeat. "He's a nice horse. He is two from two now and you don't do that unless you've got some ability," Snowden said. "This is his biggest test by far but I'm happy with him and he will give a good account of himself."

Rondinella to step out for O'Shea

make her raceday debut for John O'Shea when she lines up in today's Spring Preview Handicap (1400m) at Randwick. The six-year-old mare has finished unplaced in trials over 1040 metres and 850 metres since switching to O'Shea from Roger James and Robert Wellwood, but her new trainer is pleased by what he has seen so far. "She has trialled well and she is going well, so I expect her to race well on Saturday," O'Shea said. "But her campaign is not based on Saturday's run, it's about what is going to happen in a couple of months' time. It's about getting started on Saturday and having a positive outing." Rondinella has drawn barrier 17 for

today's race and O'Shea said she will be taken back by jockey Sam Clipperton to find some early cover. "She will go back and get cover and it might not be that big of a disadvantage at that stage of the day to be wide anyway," he added.

'All Saints' Eve a talented mare'

Earlier in the day stablemate All Saints' Eve (Sacred Falls) will have her first start of the campaign when she contests the Everest Carnival On Sale Handicap (1400m). She has won two of her six starts to date and O'Shea expects her to add to that tally at short notice. "All Saints' Eve is a talented mare evidenced by her record. She looks to be well placed and has got a bright future," he said. "We expect a pretty forward showing on Saturday."

Class rise a query for Super Contender

The bookmakers may have priced Super Contender (Kodiac) in the 'good thing' category at Eagle Farm today, but connections are keeping a lid on expectations. A winner of two of his three starts at the Gold Coast in his first racing campaign, Super Contender is an early \$1.85 favourite to win the Welcome Back To Your Track Handicap (1400m). The five-year-old was a dominant winner of a Gold Coast class 1 handicap over 1300 metres on August 1 and drops from 60 kilograms to 54 kilograms today. "He was really good last start but I guess there's got to be a question mark over what he's been beating," Super Contender's trainer Chris Waller's Gold Coast stable manager Paul Shailer said. "He's got an awkward barrier that he's got to contend with at seven furlongs, which is also a question mark. The horse is going well but there's certainly a couple of negatives against him."

Dunn hints at full-time Sydney move

Murwillumbah trainer Matt Dunn, whose Impasse (Sepoy) will be striving for his first open company win when he lines up at Eagle Farm today, is hoping to make a full-time move to Sydney. "I've currently got 15 in work at Rosehill in Sydney but I might have to move from there if something more permanent pops up at another track," Dunn told Racingqueensland.com. "The plan is to have the majority of our better horses in Sydney with the rest at Murwillumbah so they can race in the Northern Rivers and Brisbane. I'll spend most of my time between both places but eventually I'll probably move to Sydney full-time."

McAuliffe foresees Clairvoyance improvement

Darren McAuliffe is predicting Clairvoyance (Nostradamus) will put in a dominant performance when she tries to stretch her unbeaten run to three when lining up at Belmont today. The three-year-old filly will face just four rivals in the second race on the card as she reappears off the back of two exciting efforts. "A lot of trainers have been asking when she's going to the paddock and where she was starting next, so I'm not surprised it's a small field," McAuliffe told Racing.com. "It's a great opportunity for us to see her over 1200 metres and we go against a quality filly in Watch Me Dance, which deserves full respect from what she did last prep."

Farnan wins Kenso trial

Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) signalled he was on target for a lucrative spring with an impressive win over Slipper placegetter Mamaragan (Wandjina). Stepping out for his first trial of the season at Randwick yesterday, the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt and current Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) favourite made the running and was strong to the line. The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Prague (Redoute's Choice) responded to the addition of blinkers to upstage the older horses in the second heat. Jockey James McDonald gave Prague his seal of approval and predicted there was

good improvement to come from the Group 1 placegetter. "He did everything pretty well. He attacked the line well and he pulled up well too, albeit still a little bit hairy in the coat but he will come to (hand) pretty quickly," McDonald told Sky Thoroughbred Central.

Mamaragan pleases Thompson

Mamaragan's trainer John Thompson was delighted with the effort of his charge after he beat all bar Farnan in yesterday's trial. "It was great," Thompson told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "He was following probably the best two-year-old colt in the land, who looks to have come back great as a three-year-old. We are very pleased to see our colt improve from first trial to second trial and that trial will top him off nice to go to the races now." The San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) on August 29 is earmarked as the likely starting point for the Group 2 winner.

Racing Victoria monitoring allegations made against Phoenix founder

Racing Victoria has confirmed it is in discussions with its international counterparts operations of regarding the Phoenix Thoroughbreds and the allegations of money laundering against its founder Amer Abdulaziz Salman. Racing Victoria said that it was "aware of allegations" and would be "continuing to follow the associated legal proceedings in the USA", where last year Abdulaziz was alleged in court to be a key money launderer for fake cryptocurrency scam OneCoin. Abdulaziz denies the allegations. Racing Victoria said: "It is not our position to comment on matters that may or may not be the subject of investigation by Racing Victoria. What we are prepared to say with respect to this matter is that we remain in contact with international jurisdictions regarding the allegations and are continuing to follow the associated legal proceedings in the USA. We note the most appropriate forum for consideration of the allegations raised in media reports is the legal system. Should any information come to light via legal proceedings or other means that warrants any action being taken within our jurisdiction then we will consider it at the time."

Stablehand banned over Covid breach

A part-time stablehand employed by Mike Moroney has been suspended for a breach of racing's Covid-19 protocols. Victor Suarez Garcia failed to report to Moroney that he had been in contact with someone who had tested positive to coronavirus. After a stewards' inquiry, Suarez Garcia, who does not attend race meetings as part of his duties, was charged and pleaded guilty to breaking rule AR 232, failing to observe processes and directions. The stewards suspended Suarez Garcia from working in a racing stable from July 20 (the point at which he was officially stood down) until midnight on September 30. In accordance with government directives, Suarez Garcia undertook and completed the minimum mandatory period of isolation. He was twice tested for Covid-19 and returned negative results on both occasions.

Gow-Whyte outed over cobalt administration

South Australian trainer Jenny Gow-Whyte has been suspended until the end of the year after being found guilty of a cobalt charge by the Victorian Racing Tribunal. Gow-Whyte pleaded guilty to breaking rule AR 245, the administration of prohibited substance in a sample taken from horse before/after running in race, following Soul Fire's (Churchill Downs) high reading for cobalt prior to finishing third in a race at Geelong in August, 2018. The pre-race swab returned a reading of 3500, well above the permitted threshold of 100 micrograms per litre of urine. Gow-Whyte told the tribunal she had been using a product called Beachport Minerals, which was recommended to her by a friend. The product is essentially made out of seaweed, which Gow-Whyte said appealed to her as she favours natural products. She said the last dose of Beachport Minerals was given to Soul Fire at least two days before the race. The trainer said she was guilty of presentation in not researching the product as thoroughly as she normally would. She emphasised she had no intention of trying to cheat. Judge John Bowman accepted Gow-Whyte's explanation. She was suspended until 11:59pm on December 31, 2020.

Brett Dodson and fellow Coffs Harbour trainer Brett Bellamy were yesterday issued fines totalling more than \$16,000 after pleading guilty to a number of charges surrounding the tubing of the Dodson-trained Blevio (More Than Ready) in May. Dodson was fined \$13,900 by Racing NSW stewards after pleading guilty to tubing and injecting Belvio prior to her scratching from a race at Coffs Harbour on May 22, while Bellamy, who also pleaded guilty, was given a fine of \$3,000.

Two Vic country cups cancelled

Country cup meetings at Gunbower and Manangatang have been cancelled and the Mildura Racing Club has been forced to transfer two upcoming meetings as part of Racing Victoria's latest changes to the spring program. As part of the Covid-enforced announcements made yesterday, RV also ruled that jockeys will only be allowed to ride at one meeting per day for the time being.

Happy Star shooting for the hat-trick

Happy Star (Fabulous) will attempt to keep his undefeated record this preparation inact when he contests today's Winning Edge Presentations Winter Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) at Riccarton Park. The Johno Benner and Hollie Wynyard-trained fiveyear-old has won both of his starts this time in and connections are hoping he can continue his picket fence formline. "He's been going super," Benner said. "He has done nothing wrong this whole preparation, he has won two trials and two races. He has travelled down really well. He is a very sensible horse and takes everything in very easily. He has been pretty much set for this race and I am pretty happy with him." While pleased with his charge heading into today's race, Benner said Happy Star's wide barrier (19) could be an issue. "The wide barrier is my biggest concern, I am not worried about a dead track, he is fine on that. Lisa (Allpress, jockey) is going to have to produce a pretty good ride. He hasn't got the right draw, so he is going to have to be good and we are going to need a bit of luck in running."

Floral Arts to set to bloom in Classic

The Winter Cup was Central Districts raider Floral Art's (Road To Rock) main target this preparation, however, missing out on a start could work in her favour according to trainer Peter Didham. The six-year-old is first on the ballot for the feature race, but will likely start in the Christchurch Casino Winter Classic (2000m) and Didham believes the extra distance will benefit his mare, who favours wet tracks. "The idea was to get into the Winter Cup on a wet track and try and get some black-type, but that doesn't look like it is going to happen now," Didham said. "The only concern that we have got is the track (rated Dead 6 yesterday morning) is way better than what she performs best on." Floral Art has drawn barrier 14 for the Classic, but that poses no concern for Didham. "She has drawn wide nearly every start this preparation," he said. "We haven't had a lot of luck there but she will get back midfield somewhere and hopefully get a spot."

Riccarton to run with restrictions

The Canterbury Jockey Club, together with New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, has made the decision to plan for today's meeting to be run under the regulations applicable to a Level 2 alert. As was the case with the Taupo and Waverley race meetings this week, this will mean that only people essential to running the race meeting will be permitted on course. Owners, members, and ticketed guests will not be able to attend due to there being insufficient time to make compliant arrangements as required by the regulations.

Breeder of the Year finalists announced

The four finalists for the Sir Patrick and Justine Lady Hogan Breeder of the Year Award have been announced by the New Zealand Breeders Association. Last year's winner Nearco Stud is nominated, along with The Oaks Stud, Trelawney Stud and Waikato Stud. The NZTBA have also announced the nominees for the Eight Carat Broodmare of the Year as Bak da Chief (Chief Bearheart), Evana (Entrepreneur), Meleka Belle (Iffraaj) and Platinum Elle (Elnadim).

Trained by Rebecca Menzies, the three-year-old belied her starting price of 22-1 as she beat Jouska (Cable Bay) by a length and a quarter, with Magical Journey (Night Of Thunder) another length away in third. Stormy Girl, who was previously trained by David Loughnane, has now won two of her eight starts to date. Night Of Thunder shuttled to Australia for one season, covering 96 mares in 2016.

Master of Reality edged out again

Master Of Reality (Frankel), the second past the post in last season's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), again missed out by the narrowest of margins when going down by a nose behind the Aidan O'Brien-trained three-year-old Delphi (Galileo) in yesterday's Irish St Leger Trial Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 6f) at the Curragh. The Lloyd Williams-owned and Joseph O'Brientrained five-year-old kept on well in the closing stages but just failed to reel in the longtime leader Delphi, who was following up his win in a Listed race at Leopardstown last time out. There was a further two and a half lengths back to Micro Manage (Rip Van Winkle) in third.

Armory battles to Royal Whip win

Another Joseph O'Brien-trained runner came out on the wrong end of a close finish at the Curragh yesterday when Numerian (Holy Roman Emperor) kept on well but just failed to get to Armory (Galileo) in the Royal Whip Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f). The Aidan O'Brien-trained winner crossed the line a neck in front of the runner-up, with Sinawann (Kingman) a further length away in third. Armory was posting his fourth win in ten starts so far, and a third in stakes company.

Frenetic in control

Odds-on favourite Frenetic (Kodiac) gave his backers few causes for concern as the juvenile led from start to finish in the Curragh Stakes (Listed, 5f) for a second career stakes victory. The Ger Lyons-trained colt struck the front and never looked back along the nearside rail, as he defeated the Aiden O'Brien-trained Chief Little Hawk (Air Force Blue) by one and three-quarter lengths, with Blue Cabochon (Holy Roman Emperor) third, a further one and a half lengths back. Frenetic is one of 35 juvenile stakes winners for his sire, Kodiac (Danehill), who stood this year for €65,000 (approx AUD\$107,000) at Tally Ho Stud. A half-brother to American stakes winner Big Handsome (Street Boss), Frenetic is out of Moojha (Forest Wildcat), a half-sister to stakes winners Kiss Moon (Malibu Moon) and Kiss Mine (Mineshaft).

Juddmonte International to feature in Plate boost series

The Juddmonte International Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) which takes place at York next week will be the only European leg to feature in the 2020 Ladbrokes Cox Plate Boost Series. The winner of Wednesday's race, which has attracted 14 entries including Benbatl (Dubawi), winner of the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) in 2018, will be eligible to win a \$1 million bonus should they travel to Melbourne and win the Plate. Last year, the Moonee Valley Racing Club launched the promotion with the Champion Japanese mare Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry) collecting a bonus for connections after adding the Plate to her win in another of the qualifiers, the Takarazuka Kinen (Gr 1, 2200m).

Dettori heading to France despite new quarantine rules

Frankie Dettori will miss the ride on leading International Stakes hope Lord North (Dubawi) after electing instead to travel to France and ride his John Gosden-trained stablemate Palace Pier (Kingman) in tomorrow's Prix Jacques Le Marois (Gr 1, 1600m) at Deauville. Dettori was forced to make the decision after the UK government brought in a change to their restrictions which mean all arrivals from France must now spend 14 days in quarantine. The new regulations have also resulted in Ryan Moore no longer heading to France,

with Christophe Soumillion taking over on board Circus Maximus (Galileo) in tomorrow's feature race. James Doyle, meanwhile, has been booked as Dettori's replacement on board Lord North.

Hope of imminent racecourse return for spectators in Britain

Hopes that spectators could return to Britain's racecourses in a limited form at pilot events have been raised after the UK government said this weekend's World Snooker Championship final in Sheffield could host 300 fans. Goodwood was 24 hours from hosting 5,000 spectators on the final day of its Glorious meeting a fortnight ago when the government halted plans because of concerns over infection rates. Doncaster's St Leger (Gr 1, 1m 6.5f) meeting starting on September 9 and Newmarket's Cambridgeshire (1m 1f) meeting, which begins on September 24, are among the options being considered for pilot events.

Adena Springs to offer southern hemisphere season breedings

Kentucky's Adena Springs Farm will offer the service of its US stallions for the upcoming southern hemisphere breeding season, starting from today. Topping the roster at a fee of US\$20,000 (approx AUD\$28,000) is Ghostzapper (Awesome Again). The perennial leading stallion is represented by 12 Grade 1 winners and nine millionaires. All stud fees are No Guarantee payable at 90 days in foal or upon entering quarantine. Multiple mare discounts may be available. Coolmore pull off big coup as they buy rising stallion sensation Wootton Bassett

ootton Bassett (Iffraaj), sire of 2016 European champion three-year-old Almanzor from his first crop, has been purchased by Coolmore from Haras d'Etreham.

The news stacks up as a big deal in more ways than one - certainly, buying one of France's top-tier stallions just as he is reaching his prime would not come cheap.

"From his initial small crops in France, Wootton Bassett has achieved outstanding results," said Coolmore's David O'Loughlin.

"His first crop of just 23 foals included Classic winner and European champion three-year-old Almanzor, he's had two other colts finish second in the Prix du Jockey Club and two fillies finish second, beaten only a nose, and third in this year's French Guineas – and this all from €6,000 nominations or less.

"He strikes us as a real Classic stallion, he gets a very good type and is a total outcross with his pedigree free of the major European forces like Sadler's Wells, Galileo, Montjeu, Danehill, Green Desert, Invincible Spirit, Danehill Dancer and Dubawi."

O'Loughlin added: "We are thrilled that he is coming to Coolmore and are very excited about what he might achieve when paired with our Galileo mares."

Unbeaten in five starts as a juvenile for Richard Fahey, Wootton Bassett, now 12, landed two valuable sales events before running out a decisive winner of the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1400m), after which he was rated champion two-year-old colt in France.

Wootton Bassett's first crop conceived after a fee rise from $\[\epsilon 6,000 \]$ to $\[\epsilon 20,000 \]$ are now two-year-olds.

They already include Richard Hannon's unbeaten Listed winner Chindit and a pair of first-time-out winners at Deauville in Hiroo Shimizu's Midlife Crisis, who won well by five lengths, and Fabrice Chappet's Early Light, who won in similarly great style on Tuesday.

Wootton Bassett's 2020 yearlings were sired at &20,000 and his 2020 foals at &40,000, while he also stood at &40,000 (approx AUD&66,000) in 2020.

"It has been an amazing journey, a real pleasure and a great pride for everybody at Etreham to be involved in Wootton Bassett's stud career as he established himself as the most exciting up-and-coming sire in Europe," said Haras d'Etreham's Nicolas de Chambure.

"With his best-bred crops yet to run I have

no doubt that he has a brilliant future ahead of him and the quality of the broodmare band at Coolmore will give him a wonderful opportunity to continue his upward trajectory."

He added: "It is of course with a touch of sadness that myself and the team at Etreham will see him leave the farm, however we are looking forward to the first yearlings this year by his best son Almanzor, and to current dual Group 1 winner Hello Youmzain when he retires here in 2021.

"I would also like to thank all the shareholders and all the breeders that have supported Wootton Bassett during his eight seasons at Etreham."

Wootton Bassett is a son of Iffraaj (Zafonic) out of the Primo Dominie (Dominion) mare Balladonia, and was bred by Laundry Cottage Stud in Hertfordshire. He was picked up by Bobby O'Ryan for £46,000 as a yearling at the 2009 St Leger sale.

trip, stays on the road trip and that could well ring true when a journalist is allowed on a tour with a rising bloodstock consultant and a knowledgeable veterinarian with worldly experience and considered views on all manner of topics.

ANZ Bloodstock News on Thursday spent a day on the road traversing the Riverina potential candidates for the auction house's 2021 yearling sale series.

This week's southern NSW stint for the pair was an entree of what is to come for the Magic Millions bloodstock team, and that of rival Inglis, over the next few weeks. It will gather pace in the next fortnight when inspections at large commercial stud farms in the Hunter Valley are in full swing.

Thursday's inspections started at Mundagil, near Deniliquin, necessitating a 5.30am start for Robinson and Rose who had only reached Wagga late the previous night. Thankfully, this writer was not asked to attend the early leg of the trip even though it was later revealed that the Jerilderie bakery and accompanying Ned Kelly history lesson was well worth the effort.

I caught up with the pair at Noel Penfold's Murray Cod Thoroughbreds, a property about 15km east of Wagga, for the second leg of the trip at a much more gentile time of 11am. They are there to look at an attractive Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact) filly who is likely to be put through a sale ring next year.

The Riverina is noted for its rich agricultural land while its "capital" Wagga has a long history of producing sports stars and successful business people.

"Little Barry" Bowditch, as the boss of Magic Millions was referred to by those Riverina breeders who have known him since he was a boy, spent his formative years in Wagga.

Referred to as the City Of Good Sports, Wagga is also the town where Test cricketers Mark Taylor, Michael Slater and Geoff Lawson, AFL Brownlow Medallist Paul Kelly and premiership hero Wayne Carey grew up in.

Wagga also lays claim to rugby league identities Peter Sterling and the Mortimer brothers Chris, Peter and Steve as well as Wallabies legend and former captain Nathan Sharpe as well as that of businessman Geoff Dixon, the former Qantas chief executive, and well-known racehorse owner Richard Pegum who also called the city home for a time.

It soon emerges that there is a photo of Bowditch displaying his exploits on the rugby league field as a youngster when John Keough,

the third vendor we visit, was calling the shots as coach. The said photo is yet to surface, but perhaps Bowditch can add an extra tick or two to Keough's sale-bound yearlings before selections are finalised to ensure that it doesn't enter the public domain.

We also inspect a few Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) yearlings who are by a sire who has made an encouraging start to his stud career with seven individual first crop winners. The Woodside Park Stud stallion certainly stamps them, that's for sure, as there was no issue distinguishing his stock in the paddock.

Keough, a matter-of-fact Wagga businessman, owner and breeder, reveals that his prized mare Lycra Lass (Shamardal), the dam of the stakes-placed Colin Little-trained Vegas Knight (Declaration Of War), is due to foal soon to Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock). "That's her in that paddock there," he says.

She will return to Twin Hills this year to be covered by Hallowed Crown (Street Sense) after Keough sold a colt out of Lycra Lass by the same sire at the Inglis Classic sale earlier this year for \$155,000 to Gold Coast trainer John Morrisey.

Keough, who gives us a good push for a mare he races called Sumdeel (Dundeel) being a future city winner, also asks about the merits of first season Widden Stud sire Zousain (Zoustar) as an option for one of his mares this year.

"Matty Comerford (also a Wagga export)

gave him a big rap, but would he say anything different?" Keough ponders. Over to you, Matt. We can split the commission.

Earlier on in our travels a Supido (Sebring) colt catches our eye. A later foal, he is well developed and moves athletically. The Adelaide (or Classic) sale could be an option for him.

He was a surprise packet early in the day, while at another farm an Overshare (I Am Invincible) colt created some conversation, as did a son of Toronado (High Chaparral) who has some substance.

A Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) filly at Riverdene had a good profile and a Territories (Invincible Spirit) filly from Riverina Downs appeared to be "a natural runner".

Trying to look at horses objectively and not letting personal biases take hold is one factor Robinson, still early in his bloodstock career, says he is mindful of.

He has to think about what type of buyers the horse is most likely to appeal to. Pedigrees



will be assessed at a later date. This is about rating the yearlings' conformation.

It is the reason why the sales companies usually have at least two consultants inspecting the horses because judging them is subjective. It can be easy to miss something or be too harsh on a perceived fault, particularly when they are looking at such a large volume of horses in a short space of time.

Rose, a highly respected veterinarian from Western Australia, assists Magic Millions with post-sale scopes as well as some pre-sale yearling inspections and will remain in NSW until the end of the month to help complete the process.

He makes an interesting point, to me at least, about the preparation of young horses and not having them too heavy at this stage of their development.

"You don't see fat kids running fast," or words to that effect he says. There were many words of wisdom from the Doc throughout the day, not least that Thailand has largely escaped the devastating impact of the Covid-19 pandemic because of their culture, where bowing and acknowledging people rather than hugging and kissing, is custom.

At Riverdene, where colts by Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible), another Supido and an Exosphere (Lonhro) filly catch the eye, we also

get a close-up look at Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner McLaren, the son of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) who will stand his first season at stud this year.

Bred by Gerry Harvey, he's an imposing type who is sure to throw size and scope into his stock - he just needs support from the breeders. Sizzling (Snitzel) has also made Riverdene his new home and farm manager Amanda "Froggy" Elliott reports that there has been plenty of interest from the breed-to-racers ahead of the September 1 kick-off.

We head east to Tarcutta for our last stop of the day where we see Riverina Downs' Mario Cesnik, who shows us around his 1000-acre beef cattle, sheep and horse property which is divided by Wokolena Road.

We cut across the bitumen which intersects

Cesnik's home block and paddocks where his mares and yearling fillies are grazing. It was hard to see if there was any oncoming traffic given its on a steep hill and a tight corner. Mario later discloses that he has indeed rolled the odd ute or two in his time down the now green paddocks.

"I remember Ian McPherson (from Inglis) was the first to come onto the place and he said, 'geez, no wonder your yearlings look good," Cesnick says.

"They just develop natural muscle before you bring them in to try and build them up that little bit more. That's our motto: we breed naturally to run hard."

He says the yearlings we see will look vastly different in two to three months' time.

"The bottom line here is, we're behind Scone because it's so cold. It's only in October and November that they jump out of the ground whereas they start growing in August up in Scone because it's not as cold," he tells me.

"They are like wombats here at the moment, but you come here at the end of October and you won't think it's the same horse once they lose all their hairy coats."

Cesnik's brand is gaining recognition, too, with a Street Boss (Street Cry) colt making \$200,000 at the Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale earlier this year. He also took a draft to

Adelaide but elected to retain a Rubick (Encosta De Lago) filly to race after she was passed in as her stakes-winning dam Pinezerio (Danzero) is getting on in years.

Cesnik, 65, reveals that he had overnight rejected a massive six-figure offer for another horse he races, homebred mare St Edward's Crown (Epaulette), who is the Listed-placed half-sister to Viridine (Poet's Voice). She is set to run in race three at Caulfield today.

He admits to the discussions about parting with the four-year-old getting "a bit hot" on the homefront. His wife Jenni put her foot down and said no - she wasn't being swayed by the dollar signs. They have a valuable mare who will sit atop the Riverina Downs broodmare band when her racing career comes to an end.

Instead, Jenni bought a Welsh pony from France for €3,000. It will cost another \$30,000 to have the pony flown to Australia. Mario just shakes his head.

I tell Mario that I will use this anecdote when I get around to declaring to my wife that last week I also bought a share in a horse.

He says: "We are breeders, we're not dealers. First off it was \$250,000, which is not life-changing, and then it was \$500,000 and there were a few hot air moments at home, I can assure you."

mare from Coolmore called Bint Cherokee who is in foal to Darley's Harry Angel (Dark Angel) for \$17,500.

"Peter Heagney when he was at Inglis and 'Little Barry' (Bowditch) said to us, 'come Mario, work out your figures, do your homework, then sit there and watch," he said.

"Anything that's too dear for us we let go, but there's some that fall through the cracks like Patina. She had a disastrous breeding record and we bought her in foal to Epaulette because we couldn't go to Epaulette that year.

"When we came home, about two months later, we started getting phone calls asking what we were doing with the Epaulette filly (St Edward's Crown) and what were we doing with the mare because Viridine came out and won a stakes race."

The breeding industry is as much about relationships as it is the horses and the Cesniks have done well buying mares from Darley/Godolphin.

Cesnik praises Darley's Adam Brayshaw for his assistance over the years while he has also received plenty of sound advice from the recently retired Steve Brien, the long-time manager of the Woodlands-Darley and now

Olly Tait-run Twin Hills at Cootamundra.

We breed 12 to 14 mares a year and if we breed that we work on having ten for the yearling sales and it's only extra income for the farm," he said. "I love my broodmares, but I am not a yearling or a weanling person. I don't have the patience for them but the girls, my daughter and my wife, like preparing them."

The southern NSW inspections undertaken by Robinson and Rose, which started on the Wednesday, continued yesterday and they are set to join their colleagues Clint Donovan and Bowditch in the central west today before the next fortnight is spent viewing a large number of yearlings throughout the Hunter.

They were at Kooringal Stud early yesterday where Angus Lamont was expecting another three foals to have been born overnight by the farm's first season sire Prized Icon (More Than Ready).

The few on the ground so far have impressed the young studmaster and gives cause for optimism about the dual Group 1 winner's prospects.

It was an enjoyable trip for ANZ Bloodstock News to undertake and we thank Rose and Robinson, whose town name pronunciations will be "better for the run", for allowing us to tag along.




