Littleproud gives support to thoroughbred welfare initiative

Federal Agriculture Minister welcomes creation of Independent Working Group panel in statement ahead of Agriculture Ministers' Forum

he Australian thoroughbred sector's pushfor anational approach to equine welfare has earned the significant support of the Federal Government following the formation of an industry-funded taskforce to make recommendations aimed at ensuring the long-term health and wellbeing of retired horses.

Federal Agriculture

Minister David

Littleproud, who is also deputy leader of The Nationals, yesterday welcomed the establishment of the Independent Working Group (IWG) panel, whose terms of reference will be determined by an industry steering committee.

Having written to state counterparts about the issue ahead of next week's Agriculture Ministers' Forum calling for their support of the outcomes of IWG, Littleproud said "Australians want the racing industry to uphold high welfare standards".



<< Continued from page 1 "I applaud industry for taking the reins and leading from the front," Littleproud said in a statement.</p>

"Animal welfare and the regulation of horse racing has always been a state responsibility and their lack of leadership has let the industry down.

"When you have Gai Waterhouse, Chris Waller and David Hayes joining horse racing industry bodies to back the initiative, all governments should sit up and take notice.

"I'm also pleased to see both the RSPCA and Australian Veterinary Association will be on the taskforce and the industry is open to their input.

"The initiative will improve industry transparency and ultimately improve animal welfare.

"I want this to succeed, so I've offered to the Independent Panel the expertise of the Department of Agriculture, Water and Environment."

Former Victorian Premier and qualified veterinarian Dr Denis Napthine will chair the group that also includes Dr Bidda Jones, chief science and strategy officer for RSPCA Australia, Dr Ken Jacobs, a director of the Australian Veterinary Association, and Jack Lake, a senior advisor on agriculture in the Hawke, Keating and Rudd governments.

The quartet, who had an initial phone hook-up this week, will focus on horses exiting the thoroughbred industry through to end-of-life management.

The Thoroughbred Breeders Australia (TBA)-led plan to tackle horse welfare in the racing industry has the backing of the major stakeholder groups - prominent breeders, leading trainers, jockeys and high-profile owners - who have committed to financially supporting the initiative.

In a separate letter sent to TBA chief executive Tom Reilly yesterday, Littleproud said animal welfare and the regulation of racing was the responsibility of the industry and state and territory governments but reaffirmed the need for a national approach to the issue.

"Gaps in the regulation of animal welfare and the treatment of horses at the end of their racing career are failures that potentially put this billion-dollar industry and those who work in it at risk," Littleproud wrote.

"I therefore congratulate the industry for stepping in and taking the lead on a national approach and consider it is incumbent on the states, territories and the Commonwealth to back it."

When announcing the IWG last week, Reilly said the industry needed to forget about state borders in an effort to ensure the issue of horse welfare was dealt with in an appropriate manner in the wake of community concern.

"The challenges of the welfare, rehoming, retraining and endof-life for thoroughbreds are national issues that are of concern to all participants in the industry," Reilly said last week.

"We have to acknowledge that if we can improve outcomes in these areas, it is our responsibility to do so. $\,$

"Too often our industry is fragmented along state lines. This initiative will facilitate a national discussion with the aim of finding national solutions. Everybody who I have asked for support has been happy to give it and get behind this."

The IWG is expected to hand down its report and recommendations by the end of the year.

172 for Redoute's Choice

Late Arrowfield Stud flagbearer Redoute's Choice (Danehill) sired his 172nd individual stakes winner yesterday when Dabiyr (5 g ex Dabista by Highest Honor) took out the Torney Night Cup (Listed, 2500m) at Moonee Valley. Completing a quinella for champion trainer Chris Waller, the Jye McNeil-ridden Dabiyr got the better of stable companion Vaucluse Bay (Al Maher) by half a length, with the same margin back to Sound (Lando) in third. Fourth in a Rosehill Group 3 last September, Dabiyr is now a five-time winner from 13 starts, while Redoute's Choice is set to be represented by nine lots at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in April.

Oakleigh Plate first-up for Bivouac

Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) will return in next Saturday's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) having pleased James Cummings in an 800-metre jump-out at Flemington yesterday. "I was delighted with him," Cummings said. "He's going really well. The Oakleigh Plate is his first-up target and we'll be very interested to see what nominates and what weight he gets. He stormed through the line well this morning and Craig felt he had plenty in hand. He's a lovely horse and it's good to get through that trial without any concerns and we're proceeding as per the plan."

Hawkes bemoans Autumn options

The Team Hawkes-trained Exceedance (Exceed And Excel), who ran third behind

Bivouac in the Golden Rose but reversed that form when landing the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) in November, also completed a jump-out at Flemington yesterday. The three-year-old is set to have another jump-out on Friday before plans are finalised regarding his return, but co-trainer Wayne Hawkes believes options for his talented colt are limited in the autumn. "It's a bit unfortunate and something we need to address in the industry, because we have those great races in the spring for the threeyear-olds, but there's not really one that comes to mind at this time of the year," Hawkes told Racing.com. "There's a big opportunity for Melbourne or Sydney, for one of them to put up a big race and to make it a colts' grand final in the autumn."

Strip top of Ascot wish-list

Nature Strip (Nicconi), red-hot favourite for today's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington, is the horse Nick Smith, Ascot's director of racing and public affairs, wants above all others at this year's royal meeting. "Nature Strip is definitely the top target this year," Smith said at Flemington yesterday. Expanding on his recent discussions with connections, Smith added: "I had a very good lunch with a couple of them in Sydney earlier in the week and I've obviously kept in touch with Chris and (racing manager) Charlie Duckworth and the horse thrives on the straight. The form of his VRC Classic win, if you transfer it across he's the favourite for either race that he runs in, especially with Blue Point, who was our champion sprinter last year, now retired." Smith also said Exceedance and triple Group 1 winner Sunlight (Zoustar) are on the radar for Royal Ascot.

Currie purring as Caviar returns

Nature Strip might be the on-course star at Flemington today, but unbeaten champion Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) is grabbing plenty of the headlines as the three-time Lightning Stakes winner, who is honoured in the title of the \$750,000 contest and the raceday overall, prepares to parade before racing. "Outwardly I'm not a very emotional person but it's wonderful to see her again. And to see her in such great shape too," said regular jockey Luke Nolen during a media event yesterday. "She looks like she's only two weeks off a trial. She might give the Lightning a shake tomorrow if she was in it." Black Caviar won consecutive renewals of the Lightning between 2011 and 2013 during her unbeaten 25-start career and she will parade in the mounting yard before today's contest, her first racecourse appearance since April 2013.

Spend to improve in CS Hayes

Jockey Dwayne Dunn is expecting an improved performance from Spend (Snitzel) in today's CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) after the Team Hawkes-trained three-year-old finished fourth in the Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) first-up on February 1. "You'll see a much different horse," Dunn told Racing.com in respect of Spend returning to 1400 metres on a better surface. "He'll strip much fitter and he'll appreciate being on top of the ground." Commenting on Spend's opposition in the seven-horse field, Dunn added: "He is up against two king-pin horses - obviously the New Zealander (Catalyst) that we don't know too much about but Alligator Blood, you can't knock his record, and he was only just beaten in the Caulfield Guineas."

Kirk to tackle Talindert

Dunn will be aboard Spend's stable companion Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) earlier on the Flemington programme and he hopes the unraced juvenile will not be held back by his mental immaturity. "I've ridden him quite a lot and he's a lad," Dunn also told Racing.com. "He wants to play a bit so we'll see how he turns up in the yard. He's definitely got the talent so I'd like to see him cool his head and use his energy the right way. He's related to Black Caviar so there are big expectations and I definitely think he's good enough for this race." Ole Kirk was purchased by International Thoroughbred Solutions at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, realising \$675,000 from the draft of Gilgai Farm.

Final All-Star Mile audition for Raider

Also at Flemington, Galaxy Raider (Hard Spun) will get one final chance to showcase his All-Star Mile (1600m) credentials when he linesup in The Hong Kong Jockey Club Trophy (1400m). Public voting for the All-Star Mile closes tomorrow having entered the blackout phase yesterday afternoon and Galaxy Raider remains outside of the top ten coveted spots at the time of writing. "You never know your luck," trainer Grahame Begg told Racing.com. "We will let the people decide whether he goes there or not. We can only present them in good form." Galaxy Star won a Flemington handicap on January 11 and Begg added: "He has had a month between runs, that was the plan to give him a bit of a break. He has trained on nicely. There looks to be genuine speed in the race, there's three or four solid leaders in the race. He will be able to be ridden quietly and given his chance to hit the line."

Wet track ideal for Lashes in Triscay

Meanwhile at Randwick, Matt Smith expects soft underfoot conditions to suit his four-time winner Lashes (I Am Invincible) in the Triscay Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). "On top of the ground it's a very tough race. In the conditions, it might just give us another length or two and that might be enough to get us in the finish," Smith said. Lashes returned with back-to-back wins in

January before suffering her first defeat of the campaign when fourth to Roheryn (Lonhro) at Randwick on February 1. "It was a bit of a head-scratcher that run because she was in the right spot," Smith added ."She came again on the line. She did get tangled up a little bit and that might have been enough to put her off but she seemed to pull up fine after the run." Randwick was rated a soft 7 yesterday.

Sangria tests water in Light Fingers

Earlier on the card, co-trainer Peter Snowden is looking forward to wide-margin Gosforth winner Sangria (I Am Invincible) taking a significant rise in class when she tackles the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). "I don't very often do this, throw them into deep water without any floaties on," Snowden, who trains in partnership with his son Paul, said. "She is only lightly raced, but all her runs have been fantastic, and she might have a bit of a fitness edge, which will work in her favour come Saturday on the wet track." Commenting on Sangria's opposition, Snowden added: "The other fillies like Flit and Kiamichi are seasoned campaigners so she's going to find it tough. They've had another preparation and gone to Group 1 level, a different level to what she's been racing. But it's worthwhile trying. If she runs really well I know she can measure up to them and she will be better throughout the

Supreme Idea to Lonhro

The Anthony Freedman-trained Supreme Idea (I Am Invincible), who was scratched from Wednesday's rearranged Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) at Warwick Farm, will instead take her chance in today's Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) at Randwick. A two and a half-length winner on debut at Geelong in December, Supreme Idea did not appreciate being cluttered up between horses when midfield in the Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m) at Caulfield last month. "We will probably try to be positive from the inside draw and be right up there," jockey Tim Clark said. "She might even lead, she can do that, and she's fit which is going to help her with the conditions we're going to be dealing with on Saturday."

Ear muffs off Elleegant in Apollo

Clark will also partner the Chris Waller-trained Verry Elleegant (Zed) in today's Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and the dual Group 1 winner is set to race without ear muffs having trialled minus the gear under regular rider James McDonald last week. "I've seen her race a fair bit. She obviously can do a few little things wrong but they've worked hard to get her to do things the right way," Clark said. "I was actually going to trial her the other day but Chris wanted to trial her without the ear muffs and he wanted James' feedback, so I didn't get the opportunity to sit on her. But I was speaking to James briefly after the trial and he seemed to think she was a bit more switched on without the ear muffs."

Impasse up in class at Eagle Farm

Impasse (Sepoy) will try to continue his progression for Matt Dunn when the five-year-old lines-up in the Open Handicap (1400m) at Eagle Farm today. Originally trained by Chris Waller, Impasse has run twice for Dunn, finishing second at Eagle Farm prior to a last-start success at the track on February 1. "He seems to be in a good head space these days and enjoying the change of scenery to our country stables," Murwillumbah-based Dunn said. The 1400 metres suits and he will go on to something a bit better after this."

Snitch gets chance from inside barrier

Included in the opposition to Impasse is Snitch (Lope De Vega), whom trainer Tony Gollan believes can atone for a disappointing preparation having drawn favourably in barrier one. "The last time he drew barrier one he was fourth in the Listed Eye Liner Stakes," Gollan said. "To put it plainly his campaign has been frustrating mainly due to the poor barriers he has drawn. We have had to ride him upside down a few times and in a couple of others he has got caught in the wrong part of the track. His best run this time was when he drew barrier three when third at Doomben. But even then he didn't have much luck. From barrier one we will be able to ride him handier and that should make the difference."

Cruze returns to optimum conditions

Barry Lockwood's Cruze (Pierro) will also contest the Open Handicap, which is run over the five-year-old's favoured track and distance. The gelding set a 1400-metre course record at the track in December, clocking 1.21.30, while he has since finished unplaced in the Magic Millions Cup (RL, 1400m) before a third over 1600 metres at Eagle Farm. Lockwood was forced to drop him back to 1200 metres at the track last Saturday week when he was unsuited by a slow early tempo. "They walked early and then the winner got home in sub 34 seconds, which made it impossible for us to run him down," Lockwood said. Cruze has been allocated the top-weight of 58 kilograms today, although apprentice Stephanie Thornton will claim 1.5 kilograms.

Case moved for Weir et al

Melbourne Cup-winning trainer Darren Weir and others accused of torturing racehorses and corrupt betting have won a bid to move the case to regional Victoria. Weir, together with his ex-foreman and fellow trainer Jarrod McLean and stablehand William Hernan, appeared in Melbourne Magistrates' Court yesterday. A fourth alleged conspirator, stablehand Tyson Kermond, did not appear because he is on his honeymoon in Queensland. The men face a combined 34 charges, ranging from corrupt betting to conspiring to deceive stewards and animal torture involving 2018 Cup runner Red Cardinal (Montjeu) as well as Cup hopefuls Yogi (Raise The Flag) and Tosen Basil (Harbinger). Weir and McLean are also accused of conspiring "to cheat and defraud the stewards of Racing Victoria".

Weir et al continued

Lawyers for the men applied to have the case dealt with in Ballarat because it was the closest to where the most serious charges took place. Weir's lawyer Tony Hargreaves told the court the conspiracy charges allegedly occurred while his client was in Ballarat. However, the prosecution argued the conspiracy to defraud stewards, labelled "the most serious" offence, involved races at Flemington and Sandown. Because of that, they said the hearing should take place in Melbourne. Magistrate Sarah Leighfield disagreed and said the conspiracy is about the "agreement.. it's not the end product", which meant it took place outside the city. She granted the application and transferred the matter to Ballarat. Many of the allegations of horses receiving electric shocks while on treadmills took place at Warrnambool, which was also proposed as an alternate venue. McLean, Kermond and Hernan will face a further committal mention in March at Ballarat. A two-day committal hearing in June will test the evidence against the men and whether the matter should go to trial.

First success for Raymond

Maddie Raymond, who previously worked for Darren Weir and is now the Victorian foreperson for Lindsey Smith, saddled her first winner in her own name when Lil' Angel (Wandjina) won at Donald yesterday. The three-year-old, who was Raymond's second runner to hit the track, broke her maiden at the fifth time of asking when scooting to a comfortable length and a quarter success.

Wet weather forces transfers

The first heat of the NSW Country Championships will now take place at Moruya following the abandonment of Nowra because of heavy rain. Tomorrow's meeting features the south east heat of the Country Championships, which culminates in the final at Randwick on April 4. The Moruya contest is now the first heat with the Northern Rivers event at Coffs Harbour moved from today to Tuesday. Moruya was rated at soft 7 yesterday and is expected to improve. Meanwhile, yesterday's meeting at Taree was called off with several sections of the track causing concern, while the Gunnedah

programme has been transferred to Scone. In Queensland, yesterday's Gatton meeting has been transferred to Monday because of the wet.

Cahill return imminent

Michael Cahill has been given the all-clear to return from a long injury break and hopes to be back race-riding by the end of the month. Cahill has not ridden since October 25 when he was found to have a fractured right foot. He had been riding with the injury for ten days after hitting his foot in the barriers at a Murwillumbah meeting. Cahill's stay on the sidelines was complicated by a fall at home when he was wearing a moon boot. He visited the specialist yesterday morning and was given the all-clear to resume riding track work. "I'll start riding work next week and see where I'm at with my fitness," Cahill said. "It will probably be ten days to a fortnight before I'm ready to ride in races."

The Star signs deal with ATC

The Australian Turf Club has signed an expanded three-year deal with long-standing partner The Star Sydney to become naming rights partner for Randwick's autumn showpiece, The Star Championships. The two-day fixture will be held at Randwick on April 4 and April 11, while the partnership ensures that official naming rights continue through to 2022. Having already sponsored The Star Doncaster Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) for the last seven years, The Star will also have naming rights for The Star Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), run as a part of The Everest Carnival in October 2020 and 2021.

Vale Alan Ryan

Grafton-based trainer Alan Ryan died yesterday aged 65. 'Ally', as he was known by all, was a highly-respected member of the northern NSW racing community. In addition to his training business, Ally was a regular at most meetings in the Northern Rivers where he often worked as part of the barrier team. A service will be held at St Patrick's Catholic Church, Skinner Street, South Grafton commencing at 2pm on Friday. A remembrance function will be held afterwards at Grafton Racecourse.

NEW ZEALAND

Sheezallmine to bounce back at Ellerslie

Group 3 winner Sheezallmine (Super Easy) will attempt to get back into winning form when she lines-up in the Dunstan Feeds 1200 at Ellerslie today. The four-year-old finished unplaced in the Telegraph (Gr 1, 1200m) on January 18 and trainer Daniel Miller said his charge did not settle down in Trentham. "She just sulked from the moment she got to Trentham, the day before, up until she raced," he said. "She didn't eat or drink anything and it really showed in her performance." Looking ahead to today's assignment, Miller said: "She is really well, I couldn't be happier with how she has been going. Her work has been fantastic and she seems to be in a pretty good headspace, so I am expecting a bold showing."

Baker and Forsman runner joins Adelaide stable

Talented five-year-old Mongolian Marshal (High Chaparral) has joined the stable of Morphettville trainer Stuart Gower having previously been prepared by Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman. A winner of the Waikato Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) in 2018 who was also placed behind Melody Belle (Commands) in the Windsor Park Plate (Gr 1, 1600m), Mongolian Marshall was sourced by Melbourne-based bloodstock agent Lou Liparota on behalf of clients of Gower. "He is obviously an older horse who I thought would be suited to some Country Cups here in Australia," Liparota said. "He was only a length and a half from some good horses in the Thorndon Mile two starts back and I think he ran into a good one (Prise De Fer) last start, so that is very competitive going."

ASIA

HKJC Licensing committee decisions

Brazilian Vagner Borges and South African Aldo Domeyer will rejoin the Hong Kong riding ranks after being granted contracts by the HKJC licensing committee yesterday. The duo will return to the fold while Blake Shinn and Neil Callan – whose licences were due to expire at the end of the month – also received extensions until the end of the season. A new apprentice,

Go Lo King-yeung, also joins the ranks from the end of March after a stint in South Australia. Conversely, Lyle Hewitson did not apply for an extension, instead opting to take up a short-term stint in Japan, while it was also confirmed that French duo Alexis Badel and Tony Piccone will return to Europe for the summer. However, both Hewitson and Badel have extended their stays by one meeting so they can compete at Sha Tin on March 1.

Millard's duo to face Exultant in Gold Cup

Tony Millard is under no illusions of the task facing his Glorious Dragon (Teofilo) and Northern Superstar (Count Dubois) as they prepare to take on Exultant (Teofilo) in the Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin tomorrow. "Exultant looks outstanding," Millard said. "Actually, he's not just an outstanding horse, he's a champion horse." Regarding Glorious Dragon, who finished runner-up in the Centenary Vase (Gr 3, 1800m) on January 27, Millard added: "He's well. He galloped last week and then again on Monday - he went very nicely and I'm happy with him. He's coming to the race okay and we just need a little bit of luck." Of Northern Superstar, he said: "I think he will run very well too. He's been off for a long time but he's coming back."

California Chrome recuperating from enteritis after arrival at Arrow Stud

California Chrome (Lucky Pulpit) is recovering from a bout of enteritis - an inflammation of the small intestine - having arrived in Japan ahead of this year's covering season. It was announced back in November that JS Company had reached an agreement to buy the chestnut from his ownership syndicate and he would be heading to Arrow Stud. Twice the US Horse of the Year and a winner of seven Grade 1s, California Chrome had stood his first three seasons at Taylor Made Farm in Kentucky. He was also active in the southern hemisphere breeding seasons in 2017 and 2018 at Sumaya Stud in Chile and arrived in Japan at the start of last month. The JS Company tweeted a video of the stallion along with the statement: "California Chrome has a minor enteritis after arriving at Arrow Stud and is recovering now. Fortunately, he eats very well and his condition becomes better day by day. We are looking forward to a chance to show him next month."

Progressive Lily lands Balanchine

The Charlie Appleby-trained Magic Lily (5 m ex New Approach - Dancing Rain by Danehill Dancer) continued to make up for lost time when taking out the Balanchine Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) on the Meydan turf on Thursday evening. A daughter of Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Dancing Rain (Danehill), Magic Lily was off the track for almost two years having been Group 1-placed as a juvenile, but she has now won three of her six starts and showed a good attitude to win by a length and a quarter under William Buick. Nisreen (Raven's Pass) ran second, while Maamora (Dubawi) posted a clear career best when coming home a further neck adrift in third.

Capezzano back to winning ways

Capezzano (6 g Bernardini - Cableknit by Unbridled's Song), who finished last of 12 behind Thunder Snow (Helmet) in the Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) in March, resumed the winning thread with an imperious success in the Firebreak Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) later on the Meydan card. Skipping seven lengths clear under Mickael Barzalona on the dirt track, Capezzano finished much too strong for race-favourite Secret Ambition (Exceed And Excel), while Matterhorn (Raven's Pass) was beaten a further three-quarters of a length into third on his debut for Salem bin Ghadayer. Group 1 winner Capezzano has now landed six of his 16 starts.

Are star attractions Nature Strip and Catalyst beatable on an action-packed afternoon?

ature Strip's (Nicconi) reputation, mooted Royal Ascot venture and bid to become Australia's highest-rated sprinter will be tested for the first time in 2020 when he resumes in today's \$750,000 Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington.

The return of Chris Waller's star speedster and the first Australian appearance of Catalyst (Darci Brahma) in the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) earlier on the card headline this afternoon's action, which features nine stakes races from Flemington and Randwick.

Sydney's reigning champion jockey James McDonald rides both horses in Melbourne and he spoke enthusiastically of their prospects yesterday.

However, Nature Strip's capabilities continue to divide opinion, even if bookmakers have victory a near fait accompli at yesterday's quote of \$1.45.

Meanwhile Catalyst, who has been beaten only once, faces significant opposition, headed by Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) winner Alligator Blood (All Too Hard), whose sole defeat came courtesy of Super Seth (Dundeel) in last October's Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

Catalyst is also likely to divide opinion given the Australian autumn defeats of his high-profile Kiwi predecessors Extravagant (Pentire) and Madison County (Pins), not to mention that of his sire, Darci Brahma (Danehill), who succumbed to Apache Cat (Lion Cavern) in the

2006 running of the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

"He's in really good order, probably a little bit forwarder than what he was leading into his first-up run last prep," McDonald said of Nature Strip on Friday's Sky Sports Radio Racing HQ.

That may be significant given Nature Strip's previous first-up run was a disappointing fourth behind the evergreen Redzel (Snitzel), beaten two and three-quarter lengths having over-raced. The dual Everest (1200m) winner re-opposes first-up today, like he did when securing that Concorde Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) success at Randwick.

Neither the Snowden team with Redzel, or the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace stable, who will be represented by Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), second to Nature Strip in last year's VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m), have conceded the Lightning Stakes to Nature Strip.

Nature Strip's Sprint Classic success was dominant at 1200 metres, although the win was little more than a track gallop with an unpressured amble through the first 600 metres in 0.36.2. This race may set up differently with Redzel, who was ridden aggressively in his Concorde win and in his latest barrier trial, potentially applying early pressure.

"It will be handlebars down and just full-on speed," Redzel's co-trainer Peter Snowden said earlier in the week.

He then added: "Nature Strip is a good horse and he's going very well".

Those comments were echoed by Loving Gaby's co-trainer David Eustace, who said: "We're not conceding the race to him, but obviously it will be difficult to beat him (Nature Strip).

No three-year-old filly has won the race since Regimental Gal (General Nediym) in 2004 but Sunlight (Zoustar) was beaten less than half a length when third to In Her Time (Time Thief) last year.

McDonald, who rode Nature Strip in his Tuesday morning straight track work at Flemington, expects the five-year-old to race better than when beaten in the Concorde.

"He's in a good frame of mind...his action feels enormous and he couldn't be going any better," he said.

"Obviously if we get the first-half of the race right then the last-half will look after itself. There's no question he'll get it right Saturday."

McDonald will ride Catalyst for the first time for his fellow countryman Clayton Chipperfield.

The gelding, who is unbeaten in six starts since his debut, was bred at New Zealand's The Oaks Stud, owned by Australian Dick Karreman, who decided to race the colt after he was withdrawn from Karaka as a yearling.

"He looks pretty good," McDonald said of Catalyst. "I've followed him all the way through. Connections told me some time ago to keep an eye on him for when he comes over here and I'm lucky enough to jump on him now. He's pretty exciting.

"It looks a tactical race and drawing the outside gate makes it a little bit difficult, especially with Alligator Blood up front. We are going to spot him a start, but he looks exceptional and hopefully can live up to the hype."

Chipperfield said he was so pleased with

how his horse had travelled that "we could only have one excuse and that's the draw."

Chipperfield confirmed that Catalyst would be "ridden back", but hopefully "not too many lengths behind Alligator Blood", whose trainer David Vandyke has advised stewards that his eight-time winner would "attempt to lead" from barrier one.

"I'm under no illusions as I watched Catalyst win his last start and he just blew them away and was so impressive," Vandyke said.

"He is a class horse and in just about any other era a horse like that could come to Australia and quite easily be dominant.

"But there's a lot of good three-year-olds around at the moment and this carnival is very exciting because we are going to find out which one is the best."

In Sydney, the James Cummingstrained Alizee (Sepoy) and John Thompson's Dreamforce (Fastnet Rock) head the market for the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m).

"She (Alizee) motored home stylishly in the Expressway behind a very promising threeyear-old and since then she's had a very sensible and straightforward build-up," Cummings said.

The Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield next Saturday remains an alternative for Alizee if today's Randwick track has worsened from the heavy 8 rating given yesterday.

Kiamichi (Sidestep) and Flit (Medaglia D'Oro) represent Cummings in the the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and soft ground wouldn't disadvantage last year's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi.

"Both her trials have been encouraging, she won the latest one in good style and she gets the going she prefers," Cummings said of Kiamichi.

As to Flit, he added: "She'll certainly be better for this first-up run and, needless to say, she's going to be even better when she gets up to the mile."

Godolphin's third Light Fingers runner is the Anthony Freedman-trained, Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Lyre (Lonhro), who "seems to be back to her old self" according to assistant trainer Sam Freedman.

However, Libertini (I Am Invincible) clearly heads the Light Fingers betting ahead of the Godolphin trio, and trainer Anthony Cummings expects her to return to her best form, which resulted in four wins from her first five starts.

"I think we have the best filly, particularly over this course," he said.

The in-form Thompson is hopeful Dreamforce can repeat his first-up course and distance win of last spring, although he is wary of the conditions.

"I am very happy with him. His two trials, he has never looked better. He won first-up over 1400 metres (last time in) and is forward enough to do it again, but I'm aware that his best form is on good tracks," Thompson said.

"Obviously Alizee will be hard to beat. I think you have to give respect to the old horse Happy Clapper, but I would say he is probably more of a miler second-up in a race like the Chipping Norton."



Coming Through arrives in time for Beuzelin

rainer Desmond Koh is not about to change a winning formula after welcoming a fourth win from upand-coming sprinter Coming Through (El Hermano) in the S\$70,000 Class 3 race over 1200 metres on the Polytrack yesterday.

Polytrack sprints have made up the fouryear-old's main repertoire thus far, with his quartet of wins all recorded on the alternative track. At his only test on turf, he ran sixth and returned lame.

After Coming Through charged home between runners to get the better of a handy field for his first salute over the track and trip, it made sense why Koh said he would rather not take the gelding out of his comfort zone in the foreseeable future.

"If it ain't broke, why fix it? I will stick to 1200 metres, he showed a lot of fight, a lot of heart, tonight," Koh said.

"The pace was quick, if it was any slower, he would probably have needed more distance. He loves the Polytrack and I'll stick to such races for now."

Raced by Tan Huat Stable, Coming Through is shaping up as a handy moneyspinner following his fourth win in seven starts, bringing up his bank account to the \$\$110,000 mark.

After coming off a smothered run in the middle of the pack, standing the leaders around five lengths off a nippy pace, he had to do it the hard way at the business end, though.

Bullocking his way to the finishing line at

the 200 metres was Nationality (Commands) and passing him was proving to be no mean feat, but on his nearside race-favourite Coming Through stuck to the task, wearing him down every step of the way.

On the outside, last-start winner and class upgrader Beau Geste (Street Cry) was also gunning down the leaders, but under Louis-Philippe Beuzelin's powerful riding, Coming Through finished a shade better to gain the verdict by a head from Nationality.

Beau Geste peaked on his run to settle for third place another half-length away. The winning time was 1.11.33.

Beuzelin, who was securing a double after he won aboard Knight Love (Shanghai Bobby) in race two, was in the mood for love on Valentine's Day. At the winner's circle, he showed his romantic side by raising a hand heart, no doubt addressed to fiancée Zoe.

It's been a testing last few weeks for the Bajan-raised and English-trained jockey. Careless riding suspensions had ruled him out for 13 meetings since November, with the double hopefully heralding a renaissance of sorts.

"It's great, but like I said, I just want to stay away from the stewards' room," he said.

"This win means a lot to me. I rode this horse at his last start when he ran on for third, it's been teamwork, we've prepared this horse to be spot-on for this race.

"The plan was not to be so far back. At the back of my mind, the pace was too fast.

"This horse is so great, he is so brave, and caught up with the first horse. He is a gentleman of a horse and he deserved the win.

"The further he goes the better he goes. We don't know his limits, but he'll probably come on from tonight's run."


