Group 3 winner Zou Dancer relishing relaxed Geelong lifestyle

Australian Guineas likely goal for Bennett Racing's rapidly improving Zoustar filly

If Zou Dancer (Zoustar) makes it to Group 1 level, and she could sooner rather than later, Victorian breaker Brad Pearson and Geelong-based Irish track rider Niall Phillips can take plenty of the credit for helping turn the obviously talented but troublesome filly into an elite racehorse.

Syndicator Nathan Bennett, who was yesterday still savouring the three-year-old's victory in The Vanity (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington, made special mention of the unheralded duo whose hands-on roles with the Leon and Troy Corstens-trained three-year-old had seen her progress from a Dunkeld maiden last November to Saturday's breakthrough stakes success.

That came after one unplaced start as a two-year-old at Bendigo last April when trained by Tony and Calvin McEvoy.

"She just wasn't going into the barriers, which seemed a bit odd, so a change is as good as anything for a horse so we decided Leon and Troy would be the fit for her," Bennett told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"We sent her down to Brad Pearson, who did a bit of work with her and helped her relax and not be so scared of the barriers. Brad did a really good job with her and we actually took her to Moe for her first start of this prep and the barrier attendants went to put her in and she backed out a touch.

"It would be lucky to be ten seconds and the starter yelled out that she was scratched, so she went from Moe on a Monday, to the trials on the Wednesday at Geelong where she got her barrier certificate again, and then off to Dunkeld on the Saturday."

That maiden win followed two city runs, a fourth at Moonee Valley and a win at Flemington on December 19, which put her on a course towards The Vanity under the care of Leon Corstens at Malua Racing's Geelong stable.

"After her win at Flemington, we tipped her out for ten days between the 19th and the end of the year," Bennett continued.

"Niall Phillips, who rides her in trackwork, reckons the break just brought her on big time and he actually made the comment to Troy that she'd improved five lengths and he wasn't far wrong on Saturday.

"She won like a good thing, which is pretty exciting for all the owners."

Troy Corstens suggested the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) was a probable target for Zou Dancer immediately after The Vanity and Bennett reaffirmed those plans yesterday.

"We were originally thinking of the Kewney Stakes, but we didn't think she was going to come out and beat horses like Personal like she did," said Bennett.

"She has done it in pretty good fashion, so we are going to have a look at the Guineas. We will see how she works and what Niall thinks after sitting on her back and if he is happy with her and thinks she's improved, then it'll be full bore to the Guineas and then there's good races for her in Sydney - the Coolmore Classics and races like that.

"It'll be an interesting next seven days for her."

Another factor in Zou Dancer's dramatic rise through the ranks, according to Bennett, is her being trained out of Geelong, rather than the Corstens' Flemington stable.

"She is a filly you've just got to look after and make sure she is not in that environment where there's hundreds of horses everywhere and I think she just enjoys it down at Geelong where it's a little bit more low key for her," he said.

"If we need to take her down to the beach, we can do that, and keep her happy that way. She's a pretty intelligent filly, so you have got to keep on top of her the whole time."

Zou Dancer was a \$150,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase in 2019 after capturing Bennett and his bloodstock advisor Phil Wells' attention at Newgate Farm during on-farm inspections in December 2018.

"She is a lovely moving filly and she looked like an athlete who had a lot of scope, so she was one of those fillies (we really liked)," Bennett recalled.

“Everyone hopes to go to the Magic Millions to buy a two-year-old, but we don’t really go there for that.

“We’re not a big two-year-old syndicator as such ... as there’s plenty of three- and four-year-old races and we identified her as a horse who might get over a mile.

“I think a few people thought we were silly early days when she was looking like a 1000-metre horse, but not anymore.”

Premier sale next on agenda for Bennett Racing

Bennett’s syndication business is a beneficiary of the extreme demand by existing and new owners wanting to race horses and he is preparing to reload his stocks at the upcoming Inglis Melbourne Premier and Magic Millions Adelaide yearling sales.

“I suppose we were lucky in a way that we had a bit of success leading up to the sales and we had a lot of our previous clients had expressed an interest in getting involved again,” he revealed.

“Once I purchased these horses up at the Gold Coast, they were selling like hot cakes, so we have only got one horse with just 15 per cent left out of the six that we purchased.

“We spent roughly \$850,000 and they have pretty much sold. If someone told me I would be able to do that, I would have probably said they were joking.

“I am really pleased with the way the sales are going. We can go to Melbourne Premier and Adelaide Magic Millions and launch again now.”

A common theme at this year’s Australian yearling sales has been agents and buyers being unable to secure as many yearlings as intended due to the intense competition and record prices but Bennett believes value still exists in the market.

“You have just got to do the work. We do it all ourselves, we don’t use any agents or anything, but you have to stick to the plan,” he said.

“It gets frustrating at times when you get knocked down a lot, but

you have to just keep getting back up and focusing on the horses that are on your list. We found this year that the horses we purchased were all good value and they do slip through the cracks.

Stradbroke possibility for The Astrologist

Bennett Racing also has another Zoustar (Northern Meteor) horse, The Astrologist, flying the flag for the syndication company and he could also be destined for Group 1 races later this year.

Nathan Bennett yesterday outlined a possible tilt at the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) during the Queensland Winter Carnival for the Leon and Troy Corstens-trained four-year-old who ran fifth in the Magic Millions Cup (RL, 1400m) at the Gold Coast on January 16.

“We decided to leave him up in Queensland at Kolora Lodge for a spell. In the next couple of weeks we are going to start him off with some dressage work just to strengthen him up a bit and get his mind on the job,” he said.

“Sometimes he’s a bit of a big dope and we’re hoping that it will make him think about it a bit more and that it turns him into a proper horse on race day.

“I think he is right on the edge of being that sort of (Group) horse and if we can switch him on, it might be the turning point for him.

“We have left him up there and, at this stage, we will target him towards the Stradbroke.”

Leon Corstens is expected to base himself in Queensland where the father-and-son training combination is set to also campaign fellow Bennett Racing-owned last-start Gold Coast maiden winner Defiant Diva (Dissident) and stablemate Morrissy (Snitzel).

Bennett said: “The Astrologist has certainly come a long way in his last prep and even his run on Magic Millions day when he ran fifth, he was three-wide, no cover the trip and he ran a super race. He is a horse to follow, for sure.”

Ingratiating set to back up in Diamond

Saturday's Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Ingratiating (Frosted) is firming as a likely starter in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield. James Cummings yesterday said early indications were that the Frosted (Tapit) colt had pulled up well from his Listed win, his second stakes victory in four starts. "I've spoken to Reg (Fleming) a couple of times already this (Sunday) morning, he's pulled up great so I think it's very likely," the trainer told RSN927. "The strength of the win is underlined by the fact he carried a (weight) penalty from his win in the spring (Listed Maribyrnong Trial). He'd have to be considered one of the top five Blue Diamond chances if we backed him up."

Standout to run in Oakleigh Plate

Frustrated by Sydney's wet tracks, trainers Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou are expected to send dry track sprinter Standout (Exceed And Excel) to Melbourne for Saturday's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m). The Rosehill trainers elected to scratch Standout from the Southern Cross Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick on the weekend when the track was downgraded, prompting the Caulfield move. Damien Oliver, who had initially been booked to ride Godolphin's Deprive (Denman), will ride the four-year-old entire. Deprive is no longer expected to line up in the Oakleigh Plate.

Dee on Ranting

Expatriate Kiwi jockey Michael Dee has also picked up a ride in the Oakleigh Plate, with

Leon and Troy Corstens turning to the rider to partner Ranting (Zoustar) after Craig Williams was suspended at Flemington on Saturday. Three-year-old colt Ranting, who has not started since finishing unplaced in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last October, impressed in a jump-out at Flemington last Friday.

Oliver to ride Behemoth

As a result of Craig Williams being suspended, Damien Oliver will ride Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) equal favourite Behemoth (All Too Hard) on Saturday. The David Jolly-trained, Grand Syndicates-owned bargain buy produced an effortless first-up performance in taking out the Durbridge Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Morphettville on January 30. Williams completed the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m)-Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) Caulfield double on the five-year-old gelding last spring. Williams, who received two separate suspensions last week, will be free to ride again at Flemington on February 27, Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) day.

Setback for Remarque

Leading Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) contender Remarque (Snitzel), the brother to 2018 winner Estijaab, will not run in Saturday's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill. Trainers Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes last night announced via social media that the Arrowfield Stud and Katsumi Yoshida-owned juvenile, who won his first start by two lengths at Rosehill on January 16, had been treated for an elevated temperature, forcing a change in his Slipper preparation. Remarque trialled brilliantly at Rosehill last week, charging late to be beaten a nose by Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Shaquero (Shalaa).

William Reid probable for Swats That

Connections of talented three-year-old filly Swats That (Shamus Award) are considering bypassing the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) with the view of targeting another Group 1 Melbourne sprint after her excellent return at Flemington on Saturday. Runner-up in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in the spring, Swats That took on older horses at weight-for-age in the Black Caviar Lighting Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at the weekend, finishing third behind Nature Strip (Nicconi) and fellow three-year-old filly September Run (Exceed And Excel). "We had a chat last night and this morning and we are a huge chance of bypassing the Newmarket also and heading straight to the William Reid Stakes," Troy Corstens, who trains in partnership with his father Leon, told RSN927 yesterday.

Newmarket unlikely for Bivouac

James Cummings believes Bivouac's (Exceed And Excel) run in the Lightning Stakes was a pass mark but the performance was not enough for him to keep the entire in Melbourne, with Godolphin's head trainer suggesting he will stay on a weight-for-age path, which rules out the Newmarket Handicap. "He was big and blew out, that's all right, he'll improve greatly with the run," Cummings told RSN927. "(It was) an excellent race, they were running the whole way but when Bivouac is nearly settling as close as Nature Strip in the run, you know it's going to take its toll late. The horse has pulled up well and we'll press on with a weight-for-age campaign."

Brando could return to NZ

Well-backed CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) favourite Brando (Savabeel) could immediately return to Jamie Richards' stable in New Zealand after his below par performance at Flemington on Saturday. The lightly raced three-year-old colt, runner-up to Bonham (Per Incanto) in the Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at his previous start, finished last, more than 13 lengths behind winner Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa). "Jye (McNeil) was obviously disappointed with the way that he rode him (Brando), but he didn't finish off the race at all," Richards said. "The way he went, you would be surprised if you didn't find something amiss. We'll give him a good going over but it wouldn't surprise if he ended up coming home."

Wet track to blame for Kahma Lass' performance

Brendan and Jo Lindsay's New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Kahma Lass (Darci Brahma), a stablemate of Brando, however, will stay in Sydney despite finishing last of 14 in the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) first-up at Randwick on Saturday. "I think with Kahma Lass you can put it down to the track that deteriorated through the day with the rain they had in Sydney," Jamie Richards said. "We were so pleased with how she was going and had been working, we realistically thought she was a good each-way chance from her inside gate (one). She ended up in a spot where the track was at its worst. When you draw the inside, you think you have it right but when the rain comes it flips everything upside down. We'll also give her a going over to make sure there is nothing wrong, but I think it was pretty much the track that stopped her."

Quartet of Colac Cups for Wilde and Yendall

Prolific Victorian country trainer Symon Wilde and hard-working jockey Dean Yendall yesterday combined to win the Colac Cup (2000m), providing the pair with their fourth victory in the race respectively. Yendall rode the Wilde-trained Hard 'N' Tough (Hard Spun) to score narrowly over Strategic Phil (Strategic). Under Oath (Star Witness) was third. "It is not far from home and you need a certain type of

horse to win it," Wilde told Racing.com. "An on-speed stayer and that's what she is and she was beautifully weighted. She has always threatened to win a good race like this so I am pleased she has. I think we definitely stay on a country cups campaign. Her racing pattern really suits these kinds of races so I will be scouring the calendar to look for another country cup."

Taylor in hospital after horror fall

Jason Taylor suffered extensive injuries following a freak accident when entering the stalls for the fourth race at the Gold Coast on Saturday. The veteran jockey was treated at the track after his mount, Final Ascent (Jet Spur), reared up and flipped over on top of him, before being transported to the ICU unit at the Gold Coast University Hospital. He suffered eight broken ribs, a punctured lung and facial fractures but has since been moved from ICU to the Trauma Ward according to Racing Queensland Jockey Welfare.

Nowra moved to Goulburn

Yesterday's Nowra race meeting, which was hosting the South East Racing Association Country Champion heat, has been transferred to Goulburn. It will be run tomorrow, with the Country Championship field extended to 16, plus emergencies. A track gallop will be conducted on the course proper at Goulburn this morning to determine the track rating. It was rated as a Soft 7 yesterday.

NEW ZEALAND

Covid restrictions puts NZ racing back behind closed doors

NZTR was last night working through the implications of the announcement that for three days from midnight the Auckland region will be placed in Alert Level 3 - with the remainder of the country in Alert Level 2. Prime minister Jacinda Ardern implemented the new measures, which require residents to stay at home, after three new cases of Covid-19 were discovered in the country's biggest city. NZTR has announced that the trial meeting at Te Rapa today will be held under NZTR directive protocols, which can be viewed [here](#).

The race meeting at Te Aroha on Wednesday will be held 'behind closed doors' with no owners, members, sponsors or the public allowed to attend. NZTR will continue to work through the implications, and announcements regarding other meetings and trials will be made in the coming days. Although groups of 100 are permitted during Alert Level 2, NZTR, Waikato Racing Club and Racing Te Aroha have said there is insufficient time to safely plan for such measures. With Auckland in Level 3 and Level 2 in force elsewhere, the restrictions on movement of persons across the Auckland borders apply on the same basis as during last year's restrictions, whereby horses may still be moved in or out of the Auckland region, including to race meetings, provided the horse is moved by a transport company.

Vance savours Group 1 moment

Former champion jockey Bob Vance got to experience the thrill of winning a Group 1 race from the other side of the fence on Saturday and he loved every minute of it - crediting champion Hong Kong trainer Caspar Fownes in helping with the achievement. Vance, in partnership with his wife Jenny, trained Royal Performer (Medicean), who previously raced in both the UK and Hong Kong, to an upset win in Saturday's Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). While delighted by the performances of Royal Performer, who had won three of his six starts for the pair since arriving in their care in March last year, Vance had not contemplated a start in the Herbie Dyke Stakes until his charge crushed his rivals over 1600 metres at Pukekohe two weeks ago. "We had some great times up there (Hong Kong) and when I came back to New Zealand Caspar has sent horses to us to be retired or to race in a different environment to what they have up there, knowing they are coming to a good home," Vance said. "When we got Royal Performer, he had only been gelded a few months, and had won a race up there, but was probably looking for the change that we can provide. I guess I owe him dinner or the like when we can finally catch up again."

Les Crayeres a much-needed tonic for Kelsos

Trainers Ken and Bev Kelso left Te Rapa racecourse on Saturday evening with mixed emotions after contrasting performances from their two runners on the day. Two hours after Levante (Proisir) had shocked pundits with a tardy beginning that cost her all chance in the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m), exciting prospect Les Crayeres (Redoute's Choice) produced a stunning victory in the last race of the day, a \$30,000 special conditions maiden over 1600 metres. "She's got a good turn of foot and I think that might be the way to ride her, covered up and with one shot at them," Ken Kelso said. "There didn't look to be much pace in the race and we thought we might have to lead, but Danielle (Johnson) got her in a nice position and was lucky enough to get the split when she needed it. Being able to race handy is a big advantage and I think that is going to help her moving forward."

Otaki next for Advantage

Runaway BCD Group Sprint winner Advantage (Fastnet Rock) is expected to attempt to win her eighth Group 1 race at Otaki on Saturday week after her dominant display at Te Rapa. "Advantage won well, although it was unfortunate we didn't get to see Levante and her go head-to-head, which is disappointing for the sport," winning trainer Jamie Richards said. "Advantage was able to race on the speed and take bad luck out of the equation. We will have a team talk in the next 24 hours but at this stage she is on target for the Group 1 mile at Otaki in a fortnight." Meanwhile, Te Akau Racing is weighing up where to head next with talented three-year-old Amarelinha (Savabeel) who won the David & Karyn Ellis Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa. "Amarelinha has a great turn of foot and managed to find room in the straight when it was looking a little tricky," Richards said. "She is a very exciting filly and has pulled up well again. We'll have a team talk about her as well as there are a lot of moving parts in terms of where she heads to next. We're mindful of travel issues and the like, so what decisions we take will have those considerations built in."

Bonecrusher for Melody Belle

Jamie Richards yesterday committed to running star mare Melody Belle (Commands) in the Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) despite her shock defeat in Saturday's Herbie Dyke Stakes at Te Rapa. "When Opie (Bosson) needed her to improve at about the 700 metres she hit a flat spot," Richards said. "Tiptronic was dictating to her from the outside and then Camino Rocosu squeezed her from the inside. She just ended up with nowhere to go and wasn't persevered with in the latter stages. It's a great leveller this game, but she looks fine, trotted up well on Sunday morning and we will most likely press on to the Bonecrusher Stakes at Ellerslie with a little trial at Rotorua to tick her over beforehand."

ASIA

Four for Epiphaneia

Efforia (3 c ex Katies Heart by Heart's Cry) stretched his unbeaten record to three when he ran out an impressive two and a half length winner of yesterday's Kyodo News Hai (Tokinominoru Kinen) (Gr 3, 1800m) at Tokyo to become the fourth individual stakes winner for his sire Epiphaneia (Symboli Kris S). The Yuichi Shikato-trained three-year-old beat Victipharus (Heart's Cry) and Shahryar (Deep Impact), who were split by a head, and the colt will now head for the Satsuki Sho (Gr 1, 2000m), Japanese 2000 Guineas, in April. Epiphaneia, who sired last year's Triple Tiara winner Daring Tact in his first crop, stands at Shadai Stallion Station ¥10,000,000 (approx. AUD\$122,850) for 2021.

JPN: Valentines Day win for Loves Only You

The 2019 Yushun Himba (Gr 1, 2400m), Japanese Oaks, winner Loves Only You (Deep Impact) got back to winning ways yesterday when landing the Kyoto Kinen (Gr 3, 2200m) at Hanshin yesterday. The Yoshito Yahagi-trained five-year-old was sent off as favourite and duly obliged by a length and a quarter over stablemate Stay Foolish (Stay Gold) and Danburite (Rulership), who were split by half a length respectively. Loves Only You was unbeaten in the three runs prior to her Classic victory but failed to win in six starts since, although placed twice in Group 1 company.

INTERNATIONAL

Two for Shalaa

King Shalaa (3 c ex Baki by Turtle Bowl) remained unbeaten on his third start, stepping into stakes company, when taking out the Prix de la Californie (Listed, 1600m) at Cagnes-Sur-Mer yesterday to become the second individual stakes winner for Arrowfield Stud stallion Shalaa (Invincible Spirit). Trained by Francois Rohaut, the three-year-old was guided by Pierre-Charles Boudot to a half-length victory over Fort Payne (Rio De La Plata) and the favourite Summitter (Bated Breath). Bred by the trainer, he was sold for €110,000 at Arqana as a yearling and races in the colours of Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani. King Shalaa is a half-brother to stakes winner Waltham (Wootton Bassett) out of the winning Turtle Bowl (Dyhim Diamond) mare Baki, while he is from the further family of Group 1 winner and sire Anabaa (Danzig). Shalaa is due to start his fifth Northern Hemisphere breeding season at Haras de Bouquetot in France for a fee of €15,000 (approx. AUD\$23,450).

FRA: Sister to Royal Performer under the hammer

Eva Kant (Medicean) a sister to rags-to-riches performer Royal Performer, who on Saturday won the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), will be offered as **Lot 321** the Arqana February Sale which gets underway at 10am local time today. A major pedigree enhancement is not the only thing to recommend the 15-year-old mare, as she was Listed placed on two occasions during her juvenile season and has since gone on to produce three winners since retiring to the paddocks, including the useful eight-time scorer La Fibre (Whipper). FRA: More joy for Fantastic Spirit

The Jean-Claude Rouget-trained Fantastic Spirit (Charm Spirit) gained a second success at Listed level yesterday when the four-year-old took out the Grand Prix de la Riviera Cote d'Azur (Listed, 2000m) at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. He got the better of stablemate American Bridge (Kodiac) by three quarters of a length while the favourite Kenway (Galiway) was a further three quarters of a length back in third. Fantastic Spirit is now five wins from eleven starts, including the Derby du Midi (Listed, 1900m) last May.

26 for Twirling Candy

Rombauer (3 c ex Cashmere by Cowboy Cal) came from last to first in the El Camino Real Derby (Listed, 9f) at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday to become the 26th individual stakes winner for Twirling Candy (Candy Ride). The Michael McCarthy-trained three-year-old won on debut and was Group 1 placed as a juvenile last year in the American Pharoah Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) and returned in style to beat Godolphin runner Javanica (Medaglia D'Oro) by a neck, while the pair were four lengths clear of Governor's Party (Governor Charlie). Twirling Candy stands at Lane's End Farm in Kentucky where his fee for 2021 is \$40,000 (approx. AUD\$51,575).

86 for Into Mischief

Juddmonte homebred Mandaloun (3 c ex Brooch by Empire Maker) stepped up in first time blinkers and showed a good turn off foot to claim the Risen Star Stakes presented by Lamarque Ford (Gr 2, 9f) at Fair Grounds for Brad Cox and became the 86th individual stakes winner for Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday). The exciting three-year-old turned around the form with Proxy (Tapit) and Midnight Bourbon (Tiznow), who were ahead of him last month in the Lecomte Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f), to win by a length and a quarter. Into Mischief stands at Spendthrift Farm, Kentucky where his 2021 fee is \$225,000 (approx. AUD\$290,100).

USA: Leinster sprints to third Group success

Top-class sprinter Leinster (Majestic Warrior) got 2021 off to a great start with victory in Saturday's Gulfstream Park Turf Sprint Stakes (Gr 3, 5f). The six-year-old won twice at Group 2 level and was beaten a length in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (Gr 1, 5.5f) in his previous three runs. Tracking the pace, Leinster was pushed along from the turn and picked up to win by a neck from High Crime (Violence), while Harry's Ontheloose (Uncaptured) was a further length and a half back in third.

USA: Mischevious Alex justifies favouritism at Gulfstream

A dual Group 3 winner last year, Mischevious Alex (Into Mischief) returned first-up and

outclassed his rivals in Saturday's Gulfstream Park Sprint Stakes (Gr 3, 6f). Sent off as favourite, the four-year-old took over with half a mile to go and cruised to a three and a quarter length victory over Frosted Grace (Mark Valeski) and Cajun Brother (Cajun Breeze) who was another half length back in third. He has now won six of 11 races and \$449,730 in prize-money and will now be aimed at either the Carter Handicap (Gr 1, 7f) at Aqueduct or the Golden Shaheen (Gr 1, 1200m) at Meydan on the Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) undercard.

75 for Curlin

Blue blood Clairiere (3 f ex Cavorting by Bernardini) became the 75th individual stakes winner for her sire Curlin (Smart Strike) when taking Saturday's Rachel Alexandra Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at Fair Grounds on her third start. The talented three-year-old Stonestreet Stables homebred is the first foal out of multiple Group 1 winner Cavorting (Bernardini). Running down the favourite, Travel Column (Frosted) in the stretch, the Steven Asmussen inmate scored by a neck, while Moon Swag (Malibu Moon) was six and a half lengths adrift in third. The winner of her maiden on debut at Churchill Downs in October, Clairiere was returning after her length defeat by Travel Column in the Golden Rod Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at the same track in November. Curlin stands at Hill 'N Dale Farms, Kentucky where his fee for 2021 was \$175,000 (approx. AUD\$225,650).

USA: Maxfield remains unbeaten in Mineshaft

Godolphin homebred Maxfield (Street Sense) remained unbeaten when scoring five from five in the Mineshaft Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Fair Grounds on Saturday. Surging to the lead in the stretch, he drew clear to win by three and a quarter lengths from Sonneman (Curlin) and Chess Chief (Into Mischief) who was a further half length third. Trained by Brendan Walsh, Maxfield won the Breeders' Futurity (Gr 1, 8.5f) on his second start last year and also took the Matt Winn Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) and the Tenacious Stakes (Listed, 8.5f) in December. He is out of Velvety (Bernardini), who is a half-sister to Grade 1 winner and sire Sky Mesa (Pulpit).

USA: Captivating Moon gets back to winning ways

Captivating Moon (Malibu Moon) sprung a 43-1 surprise in Saturday's Fair Grounds Stakes (Gr 3, 9f). The Chris Block-trained six-year-old was winning for the first time since December 2019 and he did it in style, storming up the centre of the track to beat Logical Myth (Data Link) by a length and a three quarters with Peace Achieved (Declaration Of War) a head away in third. Captivating Moon was winning for the fifth time in 29 starts, earning \$90,000 and increasing his career total to \$608,118.

USA: Merneith lands Santa Monica for Baffert

Merneith (American Pharoah) led home a Bob Baffert-trained one-two-three in the Santa Monica Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Santa Anita on Saturday and claimed her first Graded Stakes success. The daughter of American Pharoah (Pioneer of The Nile) was coming off the back of a third place finish in the La Brea Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) in December and she blitzed the field by two and a quarter lengths with stablemates Golden Principal (Constitution) and Qahira (Cairo Prince) filling the placings. Merneith is now four wins and five placings from ten starts for earnings of \$357,900 with victories including the Fort Springs Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Keeneland in November.

KSA: Dettori booked for Prince Of Arran

Frankie Dettori will ride perennial Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) placegetter Prince Of Arran (Shirocco) for the first time when the eight-year-old lines up in Saturday's Red Sea Turf Handicap (3000m) at Riyadh. The Charlie Fellowes-trained gelding will take his chance in the US\$2.5million (approx. AUD\$3.22m) contest off the back of a third-placed finish in a conditions race on the Kempton all-weather track earlier in the month. "He's in good nick and I'm looking forward to seeing him out there, hopefully the journey goes well," Fellowes told ITV Racing. "We've got Frankie up, which will be interesting. He's never ridden him before, but you couldn't have a better jockey in the plate. I'm looking forward to it."

Cruz and Chadwick combine with Beauty Smile to win Chinese New Year Cup

Tony Cruz maintains Beauty Smile (Free Eagle) is still a work in progress after the Irish import's dominant performance to claim the Class 1 Chinese New Year Cup Handicap (1400m) with the four-year-old impressively eclipsing older and more accomplished opposition.

Contesting only his ninth start in Hong Kong, the chestnut was given a superb ride by Cruz's former apprentice Matthew Chadwick to effortlessly bridge the rise from Class 2 company and extend his winning streak to two.

A Listed winner over 1400 metres as a two-year-old when he raced as Justifier for Ger Lyons in Ireland, Beauty Smile took seven starts to break through in Hong Kong but, after a sizzling Class 2 win over 1400 metres at Sha Tin on January 31, Cruz was full of optimism pre-race.

"We came with a lot of confidence, just stepping up (in class) and all that," he said.

"We were very confident. I thought it would be a stable quinella. I'm very disappointed with the other horse (California Rad, who finished seventh) - maybe there was something I missed with him.

"But I was also very confident with Beauty Smile."

Cruz, who remains in contention for the trainers' championship after moving to equal fourth with his 34th winner behind Caspar Fownes (43), had a simple explanation for Beauty Smile's emphatic success.

"He's in good form - his run last time (in Class 2), he ran 1:21.09 (for 1400m). He's going well," Cruz said after Sunday's defeat of Star Shine (Magic Albert) and Fast Most Furious (Lope De Vega).

"There's another run in March over 1400 metres, he's eligible for that - I think I might go that way."

Cruz praised Chadwick's measured ride.

"He rode a perfect race, he's riding with confidence now, especially on this horse now," said Cruz, who previously won the Chinese New Year Cup in 2013 with Penglai Xianzi (Encosta De Lago).

Chadwick finished with a double after piloting Trust Me (Guillotine) to success in the Class 3 Good Fortune Handicap (1200m) for Dennis Yip.

Acknowledging record turnover on the meeting of HK\$1.843 billion (approx. AUD\$306.75m), the Hong Kong Jockey Club's chief executive officer Winfried Englebrecht-Bresges said: "I think it's always good to have a good start into the New Year and today the record turnover is something which was far beyond what we could expect.

"I think it's a wonderful, great start into the New Year and hopefully with the reduction of the number of positive Covid-19 cases that can, in a way, have more fans coming because the only thing we missed today was our racing fans.

"We would like to thank them for the tremendous support they showed and hopefully we can really welcome them back here at the track - so I'm optimistic for the Year of the Ox - we are strong, we are persistent and we stand for excellence and success."

Wellington claims bonus and eyes future riches

Rising sprinter Wellington (All Too Hard) claimed a HK\$1 million (approx. AUD\$167,000) High Achievement Bonus by narrowly winning the Class 2 Fat Choi Handicap (1200m) for Richard Gibson and Zac Purton.

The bonus is available to owners of horses who win a Class 2 with a minimum rating of 80 before the age of five. Wellington, who improved his record to five wins from seven starts, was rated 90 pre-race.

"We were up against some very horses today - at one stage, it looked like he was going to win the race very easily and then he was tiring in the last 50 (metres) but it was still an excellent performance," Gibson said after Wellington denied a charging Duke Wai (Per Incanto) by a short head.

"We always thought he would be better today, second-up in trip and getting some work into him - he's been off for so long - he needs the work."

Gibson makes no secret of his admiration of Wellington's ability.

"These are the horses that get you out of bed in the morning," he said. "You don't need an alarm clock when you've got Wellington."

"He's given me plenty of headaches along the way, but I've enjoyed the ride."

Gibson said an FWD Champions Day start for Wellington was a "good possibility".

Purton sealed a double in the last of 11 races aboard Super Football (More Than Ready) in the Class 3 Kung Hei Handicap (1600m) for Jimmy Ting to move to 61 winners for the 2020/21 season – 28 fewer than championship leader Joao Moreira, who is serving a two-meeting ban.

David Hayes counted his good fortune after Fantastic Treasure (Written Tycoon), originally a standby runner, capitalised brilliantly on being promoted into the field for the second section of the Class 4 Kut Cheong Handicap (1200m) to win on debut.

The three-year-old was given an excellent ride by Chad Schofield, who described the gelding as having "nice attributes."

"It was a nice win," Schofield said. "He's got good ability and he's still learning - he should make a nice horse."

Hayes, who said he had "strategically check-mated" himself with the number of young horses he has in his career, predicted the Australian import would develop into a "classy milier."

"It's great to win on any day, but to win for the owners – even from barrier 13 – at the Chinese New Year races is great," he said.

"I've got a lot of horses like this one - I've just got to be patient and let them develop."

Hayes posted his first double since the season-opening fixture (September 6) when Master Montaro (Toronado) returned to form with strong victory in the Class

"First time at 1400 metres, blinkers off and Vincent rode him a treat," Hayes said.

"He's a bit of a slow learner, so I think he'll get better with racing."

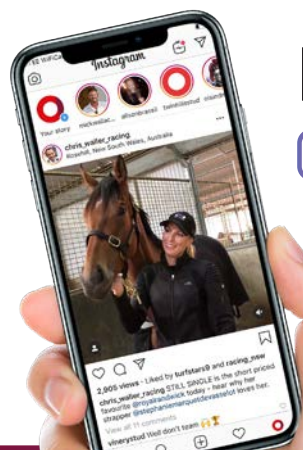
"I think he'll go up in class – he won't go crashing through with five wins in a row – but he'll get there because he's got the big engine and good constitution and I think he can run a mile, which is another string to his bow."

Ho also landed a double when Decisive Twelve (All Too Hard) broke through to claim the first section of the Class 4 Kut Cheong Handicap (1200m).

Danny Shum also celebrated a brace with Dandy Years (Dandy Man) who won the Class 4 Lucky Star Handicap (1400m) and Decisive Action (Rip Van Winkle) who scored in the Class 4 Prosperity Handicap (1600m), combining twice with Christophe Soumillon, who ended his Hong Kong stint in style.

Derek Leung continued his solid recent run of form as Kungfumaster Panda (Royal Applause) scored in the opener, the Class 5 Yue Yee Handicap (2000m).

Noble Man (Exceed And Excel) continued John Size's challenge in the trainers' championship by claiming the Class 5 Red Packet Handicap (1400m).

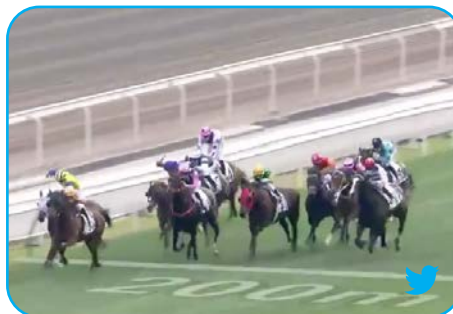

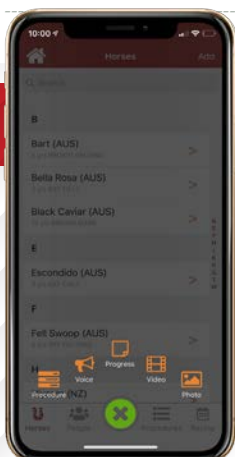
