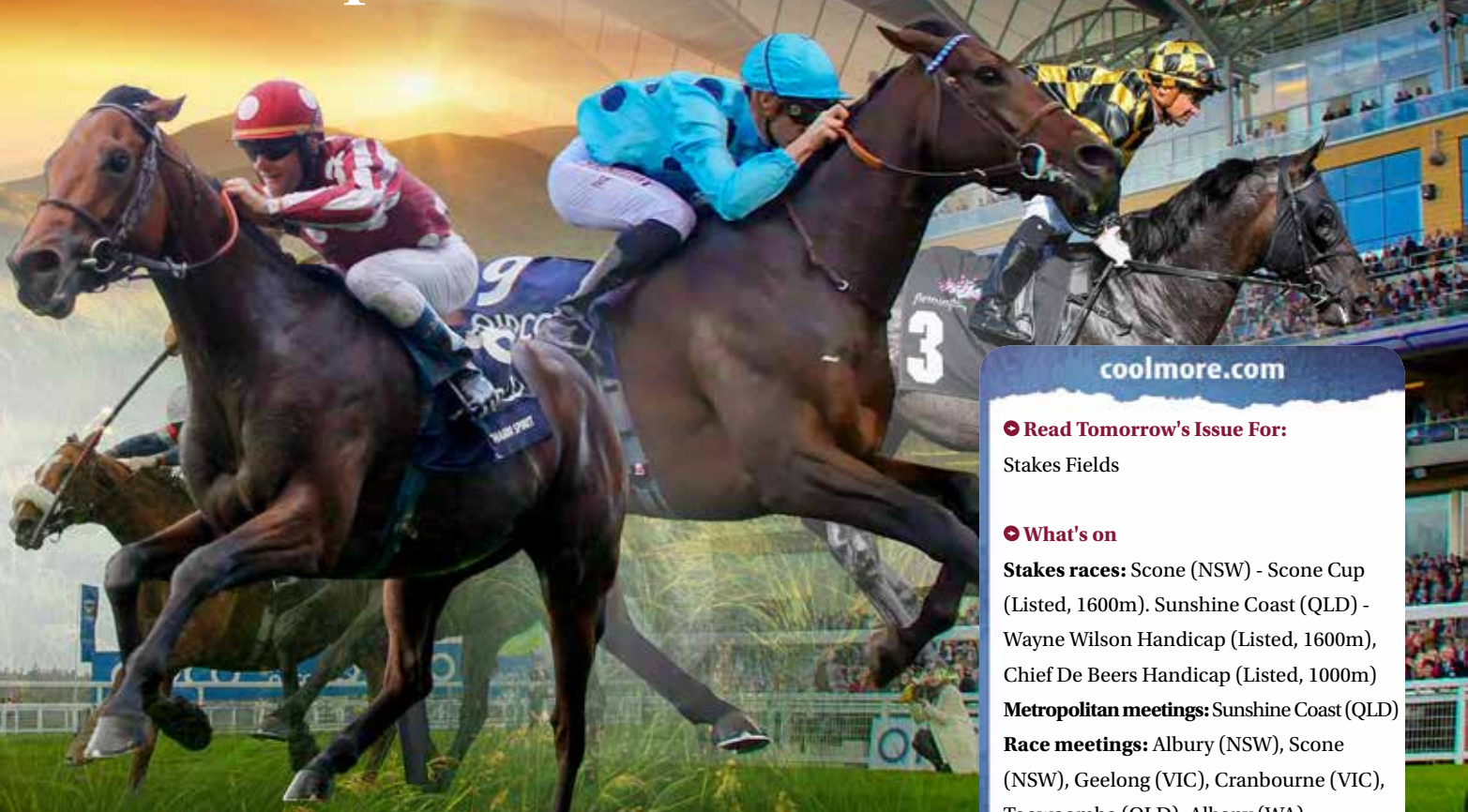

Almanzor back at Cambridge, Charm Spirit heads Windsor Park roster

Leading New Zealand farms Cambridge Stud and Windsor Park Stud announced yesterday their fees for the 2020 breeding season.

Cambridge Stud will feature French star Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) at NZ\$30,000 (all fees plus GST), with New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Embellish (Savabeel) available at NZ\$4,000.

Windsor Park's seven-stallion roster is headlined by the reliable Rip Van Winkle (Galileo) at NZ\$12,500. Three-time Group 1 winners Mongolian Khan (Holy Roman Emperor) and Turn Me Loose (Iffraaj) will stand for NZ\$10,000, Shamexpress (O'Reilly) at NZ\$8,000 and Rageese (Street Cry) and Vanbrugh (Encosta De Lago) at NZ\$5,000. Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit), a strong performer for Windsor Park this season with three-year-olds like Scorpz, Fascino and Aretha, has his price available on application.

Cambridge Stud looks ahead after horror year

After what has been a difficult 12 months, to put it mildly, Cambridge Stud is now focused on the future with the announcement of its stallion fees for 2020.

Cambridge Stud announced yesterday that French shuttle stallion Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) would again stand for NZ\$30,000 (plus GST), placing him among the top three most valuable stallions in New Zealand this season.

Almanzor, a 3YO European Champion in 2016, who won eight of his 11 starts including the Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m), the Irish Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) and its English equivalent, the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f), is set to have his first European yearlings go through the sales ring later this year.

"Almanzor attracted a high quality group of mares for his first book in New Zealand in 2018, including 50 stakes winners and stakes producers," Cambridge Stud CEO Henry Plumptre told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. "He was well received in both hemispheres covering full books of 140 and 160 mares in New Zealand in his first two seasons. The feedback from breeders on his foals is very strong and we are particularly pleased that our shareholders seem delighted with his stock."

"In his third season in France, European breeders took note of his exceptional foal sales at Tattersalls and Arqana and he is booked out at 140 mares again."

"He is a great physical specimen and has thrown a very consistent line of foals – good bone, correct with great tops. His sire Wootton Bassett has also been instrumental in Almanzor's popularity with his fee in France rising from €6,000 in 2018 to €40,000 in 2020."

Joining Almanzor on the roster is New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Embellish (Savabeel), who served his first season at stud last year. He is the only Group 1-winning son of five-time New Zealand Champion Sire Savabeel (Zabeel) at stud and will stand for a fee of \$4,000 (plus GST).

"Embellish's CV reads well from start to finish," Plumptre said. "A NZ\$775,000 yearling, a blue chip New Zealand pedigree containing the classic Zabeel/O'Reilly cross, a Group 1 and Classic-winning three-year-old and lightly raced.

"Once again, like his fellow sire Almanzor, Embellish is a great physical specimen combining the best of his sire Savabeel and maternal grandsire O'Reilly.

"As the only Group 1-winning son of Savabeel standing at stud, Embellish represents amazing value coming as he does from New Zealand's prepotent sire line and with a magnificent pedigree. He bred 138 mares last season and Cambridge Stud will again be strong supporters in 2020."

Cambridge Stud has long been one of New Zealand's leading nurseries. Under the stewardship of Sir Patrick Hogan, the farm became the home of champion stallions Sir Tristram (Sir Ivor) and Zabeel (Sir Tristram) and produced a plethora of champions.

Sold by Hogan in late 2017 to Brendan and Jo Lindsay, Cambridge Stud looked poised to enter an exciting new chapter with a five-strong roster

last season that included flagship stallion Tavistock (Montjeu), exciting addition Roaring Lion (Kitten's Joy) and reliable mainstay Burgundy (Redoute's Choice).

However, Roaring Lion suffered a colic attack soon after his arrival in New Zealand in July and after a second attack weeks later, he was euthanised.

In December, Cambridge Stud lost both Burgundy, who contracted acute laminitis in his front feet, and Tavistock, who suffered an injury in a freak paddock accident.

While Plumptre acknowledges it has been a difficult year for the operation, he is also optimistic for what the future holds, praising the Lindsays for their investment into the facilities at Cambridge Stud.

"We are in an industry that is capable of delivering both amazing highs and devastating lows, everyone involved with thoroughbreds would agree with that," Plumptre said. "At Cambridge, while the loss of those horses was keenly felt, we are firmly focused on next year.

"Brendan and Jo Lindsay have rebuilt the infrastructure at Cambridge and given us amazing facilities to work with. That encouragement and

support has been a fantastic boost for the Cambridge Stud staff."

Covid-19 has thrown in another curveball, creating an economic climate in which pricing stallions is difficult. While it is affecting farms on both sides of the Tasman, it is also clear that both the racing and breeding industries in New Zealand have been harder hit by the downturn.

"New Zealand is obviously in a different space to Australia with the

breeding industry here declining, unlike Australia where it is increasing," Plumptre said. "However, pricing stallions in the current climate is part of the equation of evaluating the future and what it might hold. We are looking forward to what lies ahead, rather than what has happened in the past. In dealing with our clients and supporters, our fees for Almanzor and Embellish are pitched at what we believe is the right level for them to get a solid return."

Rip Van Winkle and Charm Spirit head Windsor Park roster

Reliable stallion Rip Van Winkle (Galileo) sits atop the Windsor Park Stud roster in 2020 after a season in which Group 1 winners Te Akau Shark and Jennifer Eccles reminded the market of the quality of stock he is able to produce.

Windsor Park Stud yesterday released their fees in a "Spin To Win" video highlighting each of their seven stallions.

Rip Van Winkle will stand for an unchanged fee of NZ\$12,500 (plus GST), one of three "experienced" stallions on the roster alongside Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit), whose fee is available on application, and Shamexpress (O'Reilly), who will stand at NZ\$8,000 (plus GST).

"This season Rip Van Winkle has been joined by Charm Spirit to provide our clients with another excellent proven stallion option," Windsor Park studmaster Rodney Schick said yesterday.

"With his first-crop three-year-olds running this season, Charm Spirit has already sired four Group winners in both Australia and New Zealand and he's got numerous high-class horses to represent him next season."

What excites Schick though is his younger brigade. Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Mongolian Khan (Holy Roman Emperor), who has only had three two-year-olds to race, will stand at NZ\$10,000 (plus GST), with his yearlings averaging more than four times that in 2020 and his rising three-year-olds set to get out to a more suitable trip over the coming months.

His former stablemate and another three-time Group 1 winner, Turn Me Loose (Iffraaj), will also stand for NZ\$10,000 (plus GST), with his first two-year-olds set to race in the spring; his yearlings averaged almost five times his fee earlier this year.

Group 1 winner Vanbrugh (Encosta De Lago) and Group 3 scorer Rageese (Street Cry) will also have their first two-year-olds in 2020; they will both stand for an unchanged fee of NZ\$5,000 (plus GST) this year.

Road to the Melbourne Cup begins with Andrew Ramsden

Tomorrow's Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) not only offers the equivalent of a Willy Wonka golden ticket - ballot exemption for the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) - but it also kicks off a strong winter program at Flemington that highlights the changing nature of race programming in Australia.

The Andrew Ramsden Stakes, formerly the Duke Of Norfolk Stakes run as an open-age handicap over 3200 metres, is now contested over 2800 metres at weight-for-age for three, four and five-year-olds. From holding little relevance on the first Tuesday in November, it has become a key guide in the space of two years.

"This is the second running of the Ramsden under its new conditions and what we wanted to do was to give those up-and-coming stayers a race of their own," Victoria Racing Club executive general manager of racing Leigh Jordon told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. "Obviously, there is a big carrot there with the winner getting into the Cup but, more than that, it encourages those younger potential stayers to train on and

gives them more opportunities to race.

"Last year proved just how good it could be with that terrific finish between Steel Prince and Surprise Baby; they both finished top 10 come November, and Surprise Baby probably could have won the Melbourne Cup if things had gone differently."

While the Duke Of Norfolk was one of only two races run over the Flemington 3200 metres, it was far from a Melbourne Cup lead-up - 1984 winner What A Nuisance (St Puckle) returned the following year to take the race that stops the nation, but most Duke Of Norfolk winners were at long odds and were well beaten come November.

In fact, from 2000 onwards, only two winners of the race now named for former VRC chairman Andrew Ramsden made it to the Melbourne Cup in the same year - Niwot (Galileo) and Unchain My Heart (Al Maher).

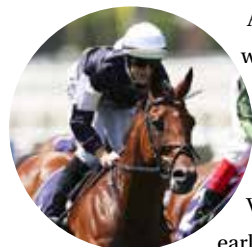

However, last year's Andrew Ramsden was a big step up in quality with Steel Prince (Nathaniel) defeating Surprise Baby (Shocking) and Eastender (Tickets). Steel Prince finished ninth in the Melbourne Cup, with Surprise Baby a fast-finishing fifth, beaten less than a length by Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War).

"The race is heading in the right direction, no doubt," Jordon said. "It was one of the great stories last year and I think this year's winner will be a big talking point heading forward."



A win to favourite King Of Leogrance (Camelot) would put Danny O'Brien in one of the strongest positions of any local trainer heading towards the Melbourne Cup in many years. In addition to King Of Leogrance, he has defending champion Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War) as well as early favourite, last week's South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Russian Camelot (Camelot).

"Not many trainers could boast a hand like that at any time," Jordon said. "When you look at all three of those horses, any one of them would be a nice addition to a stable. It will be worth watching the O'Brien yard over the coming months."

He added: "King Of Leogrance has a lot of similarities to Surprise Baby last year in that both won the Adelaide Cup. Steel Prince had won a Listed race coming in - I suppose you could relate that to a Too Close The Sun, who won the Warrnambool Cup."

"Then you have these other up-and-comers: Oceanex won a Matriarch, a Group 2 during the Melbourne Cup Carnival last year, and the Port Adelaide Cup as well. And then you have an Irish Derby placegetter in Norway too, who is improving at every run for Chris Waller and he's just hitting his straps now."

The Australian breeding and racing industries continue to move away from producing staying stock, but the Andrew Ramsden features horses by Melbourne Cup placegetters So You Think (High Chaparral) and Lucas Cranach (Mamool) and comes after last year's runner-up Surprise Baby was sired by a Melbourne Cup winner in Shocking (Street Cry).

"There are a couple of those staying-type stallions that are emerging, but it's a matter of providing a program to encourage people to race these types of horses," Jordon said. "It's the same principle behind the Mahogany Challenge, for three-year-old stayers, which starts next week."

"We're trying to encourage stayers. It's not going to happen overnight, with the way the Australian industry is set up, but the only way to encourage them is to put these races on."

Jordon previously led the international recruitment drive for Racing Victoria, and while he says there is still a lot to play out when it comes to international involvement, he believes that

a Melbourne Cup restricted to Australian and New Zealand trainees is not necessarily a negative.

"From a local perspective, this could be one of the strongest Melbourne Cup fields in some time," Jordon said. "I'm excited by Surprise Baby, I know he came back into training but didn't race and Paul Preusker has said that he will only have a light preparation into the Melbourne Cup, similar to last year."

"We've got Master Of Wine, Russian Camelot, Verry Elleegant. We don't know what will happen

with the internationals but the road to the Melbourne Cup is certainly going to be fascinating in 2020."

The Andrew Ramsden is not the only race on tomorrow's Flemington card to feature Melbourne Cup aspirants, with the Lexus Trophy (2000m) to feature the return of one-time Cup favourite Schabau (Pastorius) at his first start since winning the Roy Higgins Quality (Listed, 2600m) in March last year.

"The Lexus Trophy is heat one of the Banjo Paterson Series so it's another chance for emerging stayers," Jordon said. "Horses like the German import Schabau, you'd hope to be seeing them heading towards the Melbourne Cup. It shows though just how many options there are now for local stayers and we are trying to increase those opportunities."



The Flemington program kicks off a winter program that comes at an opportune time, with a number of trainers more inclined to stay in Victoria rather than travelling interstate in the midst of coronavirus protocols. Flemington tomorrow begins the Winter Series which culminates in Flemington Finals Day on July 4.

Behemoth seeks to go one better in Goodwood

Trainer David Jolly is convinced that his galloper Behemoth (All Too Hard), last year's runner-up in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) has had a better lead-up this year. However, the trainer also believes the gelding will be facing a stronger field than he did twelve months ago. Behemoth was a close second to Despatch (Written Tycoon) in the 2019 Goodwood off the back of an unplaced run in the Euclase Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). This time, Behemoth comes into the race after a pleasing second to Jungle Edge (Dubawi) in the McKay Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m). "He had a bit of a tough run in the Euclase last year and mentally was a bit off the boil after that," Jolly said. "I had to really play around with him after the Euclase and I was never really confident leading into The Goodwood, but he ran super."

Former Kiwi Marshal to tackle Lee

Former New Zealand-trained Mongolian Marshal (High Chaparral) will contest tomorrow's R A Lee Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Morphettville for Adelaide trainer Stuart

Gower. Previously with Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman, Mongolian Marshal won the Waikato Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) in 2018 and also placed in the Windsor Park Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) last year behind Melody Belle (Commands). The five-year-old is the winner of five of his 23 starts, placing on eight occasions and new trainer Gower is hoping to get a better read of his Kiwi import on tomorrow. "I expect him to run a good race," Gower said. "His first-up form is reasonable. It depends how he goes on Saturday what we do with him. He might even go straight to the paddock and come back for the spring."

Phaistos on song for Scone Cup bid

One year after winning a race on the undercard to the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m), progressive four-year-old Phaistos (Helmet) is set to return to the Hunter Valley course as a leading contender for the main event. Trained by James Cummings, Phaistos is challenging for favouritism for today's Scone Cup. A winner of six of his 15 starts including a last-to-first victory over 1400 metres on Randwick's Kensington track last time, Phaistos will be having his first attempt at stakes level today. "This is a target race for him and he could hardly have arrived here in better fashion," Cummings said. "His two runs this time in have been first class and he's continued to train well." Phaistos will also be trying to win over 1600 metres for the first time.

Proven Everest path for Ranier

A race which helped launch two Godolphin sprinters into their Everest (1200m) slot is once again on James Cummings's radar, this time with dual Group 3 winner Ranier (Lonhro).

Godolphin has won the last two editions of the Lusk Star Stakes (Listed, 1100m) with the multiple Group 1 placegetter Osborne Bulls (Street Cry) in 2018 and Trekking (Street Cry) last year. Although the race will be run at Rosehill instead of its traditional venue of Scone, Cummings still views it as a crucial stepping stone. "We've won this for the past two years with Osborne Bulls and Trekking and it's proved a good launching pad for better races," Cummings said. "Trekking went on to win the Stradbroke and it's also proved something of a case for the Everest with both horses finishing third in that race in their next campaigns. Ranier is proving himself to be something of a dark horse. He's raced well in strong races throughout his career and pulled out some very good performances in all of his wins."

Maher-Eustace stable after more juvenile glory

Having embraced the task of leading the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace operation in Sydney, Annabel Neasham has relished the chance to educate the next generation of horses. "It's like opening a present, you don't know what you're going to get," Neasham said. "I enjoy identifying talent and some of them can surprise you. They can make fools of you too. We've had plenty who we thought would just go out and win because they do nothing wrong at home and they trial well, but they're maidens." Neasham will saddle up two juveniles for Maher and Eustace in tomorrow's Woodland Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Rosehill. Macroure (Snitzel), unbeaten in two starts, is currently favourite while Cross The Rubicon (Dissident) is the \$51 outsider. "It is a bit of a throw at the stumps but she is Macroure's workmate and you can't split them at home so she deserves to be there."

Etana out to extend Queensland streak

Etana (Shamus Award) is set to continue the run of success for the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace stable in Queensland stakes races. Etana will be joined today by stablemate Mask Of Time (Holy Roman Emperor) in the Wayne Wilson Memorial Mile (Listed, 1600m). The race is usually run at Eagle Farm or Doomben but due to the winter carnival being revised it is being held at Sunshine Coast. Etana is on her third trip to Queensland and opened her winter campaign with a solid third over 1400 metres at Sunshine Coast three weeks ago. "She appears to have gone on with it and we were very happy with the first up run," Sydney stable representative Annabel Neasham said. "Stepping up to 1600 metres will be a help and she is down on the minimum weight here which is handy for a Group Two winner ... she will probably head to the Chairman's Handicap at Doomben in a fortnight."

Home track an advantage for Baccarat Baby

Baccarat Baby (Casino Prince) will have home track advantage in her final lead-up to the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) when contesting in the Wayne Wilson Memorial Mile today. David Vandyke pointed out that Baccarat Baby was paying for her consistency in handicaps. She carried 59.5 kilograms when second to Silvera (High Chaparral) over 1400 metres on April 25 and 60 kilograms when runner-up two weeks earlier. She will drop to 57 kilograms tomorrow, stepping up into Stakes company. "She has done well and stepping up to 1600 metres is a nice progression," Vandyke said. "After this it will be three weeks into the Stradbroke."

Talented Spurcraft to debut for new stable

The coronavirus restrictions have led to Kelly Schweida taking over the training of smart sprinter Spurcraft (Jet Spur) for the Chief De Beers Handicap (Listed, 1000m) at Sunshine Coast. Racing Queensland has cut the state into regions with trainers and jockeys unable

to move between them. Spurcraft's trainer Charlotte White is based in Toowoomba and thus unable to move beyond the southwest metro zone. However, regular rider Les Tilley is restricted to the north metro zone. It was decided to reunite Tilley and Spurcraft by sending the gelding to a north zone trainer in Schweida. "It is a roundabout story. The way I understand it they wanted Les to ride Supercraft and the way to do it was send him to a trainer in this area," Schweida said.

Command'n'conquer after first Stakes win

The Steve Tregear-trained Command'n'conquer (Warhead) will aim for his first Stakes win on Saturday when taking on the Gold Coast Guineas (Gr 3, 1200m). The Toowoomba trainer ran Command'n'conquer in a 900-metre handicap at the Gold Coast last start so the gelding could familiarize himself with the course. He finished second, ending his unbeaten start to his career. "He made up more ground than he was actually entitled to," Tregear said. "It was always going to be the problem that some of them might run him off his feet early. I just wish the 900-metre race had been on the Wednesday and not the Friday. It would have given him that extra two days between runs. But that is just the way things turned out."

Oceanex takes shot at Melbourne Cup berth

Undefeated in two starts at Flemington, the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained Oceanex (Ocean Park) will race for her biggest prize when she lines up in The Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) on Saturday. "I'm assuming Too Close The Sun, Runaway, once they get rolling, that she'll be fourth or fifth in the running I guess and she doesn't need to do anything brave," Price said. "It's a tough race for us to win, but she's there, the timing of her preparation allows her to run in the race. It's a step up in distance again, another 300 metres, but (Mark) Zahra will be there to put her to sleep and we'll see if she's got that real staying gene to be effective over 2800 metres. I'm sure she will be brave and it would be her biggest win ever if she can pull this off."

Schabau set for race return after injury

Promising stayer Schabau (Pastorius) is set to make his race return over 2000 metres at Flemington on Saturday, having been off the scene since March last year because of a tendon injury. "He had an eight per cent lesion - a grade one lesion - but there is never a good tendon injury if you do one," trainer Robert Hickmott said. "He just gave it a bit of a tweak but we still gave him all the rehabilitation time that he needed. He had 11 months off and then commenced an off-track toning up program which has all gone well." Hickmott, a dual Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning trainer, believes Schabau has what it takes to win the feature staying race. "He's got to realise that and still go ahead and take every run under his belt and continue to improve," he said.

Rawiller booking a key pointer for Sirius Suspect

Brad Rawiller is shedding weight to ride Sirius Suspect (Wanted) at 56.5 kilograms on Saturday, in a move trainer Saab Hasan says is a good pointer to his horse's chances at Flemington. "I couldn't tell you the last time he wanted to ride at 56.5 (kilograms)," Hasan said. "I rang him on Monday and said he'd get 56.5 and I asked him what he wanted to do. I think the horse is very well weighted, a half-kilo above the minimum and I'm not getting cocky, but I think they have to beat him."

Three-year cobalt bans for Pateman and wife

Champion jumps jockey Steven Pateman and his wife have been disqualified for three years on a cobalt charge. A dual licence holder, Pateman and Jessica Barton were yesterday handed their penalties by the Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Board after being found guilty of a race-day administration charge in March. They were charged after the Pateman-trained Sir Walter Scott (Galileo) returned a high cobalt reading in a pre-race urine sample at Coleraine in September, 2017. The penalty carries a minimum three-year term unless special circumstances could be proven.

Premier defends Tasmanian stance

Tasmanian premier Peter Gutwein has defended the decision to shut down racing, saying the state was trying to protect their vulnerable older population. "In Tasmania we have a higher number of older people in percentage terms compared to any other state or territory," Gutwein said on RSN927. "Our main aim has been to protect our older population, who in many cases reside in regional areas of Tasmania. With racing, the view of public health was when you bring people from across the state together from different regions and from different areas to congregate in one particular location and then they move back through the state, in many cases into regional areas, that it posed a risk. Importantly, public health made the decision, which I was very comfortable to back, to ensure we protected our population and unfortunately as a result, racing was shut down."

Trinder in strife during Tassie ban

Speaking on Racing.com's After The Last yesterday, Adam Trinder said the shutdown of Tasmania racing has thrown his business into turmoil. "I ignorantly acted as if we'd be racing this weekend on May 15, that was my advice," Trinder said. "I'd been involved in working parties and the like and my advice that came direct from a Government representative was that we'd be back for this weekend, so I proceeded as if that were the date. Obviously, with the changing of landscape on Friday with the announcement we wouldn't be returning until June 13, which was another five-week period, threw me into turmoil personally. With no racing available, there's nothing coming in. We're operating close to the bottom line."

ASIA

Japan, Broome entered for Takarazuka Kinen

Aidan O'Brien four-year-olds Japan (Galileo) and Broome (Australia) have been entered for the rich Takarazuka Kinen (Gr 1, 2200m) at Hanshin in Osaka next month, one of two Japanese fan-vote races each year. Japan,

winner of the Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m) and the Juddmonte International (Gr 1, 1m 2.5f), and two-time Group 3 winner Broome are both part-owned by Masaaki Matsushima in partnership with the Coolmore team. In the past 20 years, only one international raider - Hong Kong Horse of the Year Werther (Tavistock) - has tackled the Takarazuka Kinen, finishing second in 2018. The Takarazuka Kinen was last year won by Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry), who went on to add the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and the Arima Kinen (Gr 1, 2500m) before her retirement.

INTERNATIONAL

68 for Lope De Vega

Former shuttler Lope De Vega (Shamardal) sired his 68th stakes winner yesterday, courtesy of Arapaho's (3 c ex Alzubra by Dansili) victory in the Prix du Pont Neuf (Listed, 1400m) at Paris Longchamp. The Coolmore Stud-owned colt defeated Mageva (Wootton Bassett) by a short head with Brave Shiina (Bated Breath) coming home a further three-quarters of a length back in third. Arapaho, who was second in the Prix Francois Boutin (Listed, 1400m) last year, is the only named foal out of stakes-winning mare Alzubra (Dansili) who herself is out of the stakes scorer Azabara (Pivotal). Lope De Vega, who now permanently resides at Ballylinch Stud in Ireland, shuttled to Australia for four seasons and is responsible for Group 1-winning sprinters Santa Ana Lane and Gytrash. The son of Shamardal is now represented at stud in the Southern Hemisphere by Haunui resident Belardo. Lope De Vega stands for €100,000 at Ballylinch in 2020.

314 for Galileo

Champion sire Galileo (Sadler's Wells) landed his 314th stakes winner when Magic Attitude (3 f ex Margot Did by Exceed And Excel) took out the Prix Vanteaux (Gr 3, 1800m) at Paris Longchamp yesterday. The filly, who was bred by Katsumi Yoshida, defeated Emoji (Soldier Hollow) by two lengths with Flighty Lady (Sir Percy) finishing a short head away in third. Out of Nunthorpe Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) winner Margot

Did, Magic Attitude is a sister to Group 2 scorer and Group 1 runner-up Mission Impossible. She was passed in for €850,000 at the Arqana Deauville August Yearling Sale. Galileo is in his 19th year at Coolmore Stud, standing for a private fee in 2020. Of his 314 stakes winners, 84 have won at Group 1 level.

61 for Sea The Stars

Leading European stallion Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) sired his 61st stakes winner yesterday when Raabihah (3 f ex Garmosha by Kingmambo) took out the Prix de la Seine (Listed, 2200m) at Paris Longchamp. Bred and raced by Shadwell Stud, the three-year-old filly defeated American Apples (American Post) by a comfortable margin of four lengths with Seachange (Siyouni) a further length and a half away in third. Raabihah is out of the unraced mare Garmosha (Kingmambo) making her a half-sister to the stakes-placed Filfila (Kitten's Joy). Garmosha is out 2005 Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Eswarah (Unfuwain) who herself is out three-time Group 1 scorer Midway Lady (Alleged). Sea The Stars is a half-brother to champion sire Galileo and stands at Giltown Stud in Ireland for a fee of €150,000.

Four for Olympic Glory

Group 1 placegetter Grand Glory (4 m ex Madonna Lily by Daylami) broke through for her first black-type win in the Prix Zarkava (Listed, 2100m) at Paris Longchamp yesterday and in turn, provided her sire Olympic Glory (Choisir) with his fourth individual stakes winner. The four-year-old defeated Romanciere (Dansili) by a length and three-quarters with Bolleville (Camelot) a further length and a quarter away in third. Grand Glory is out of the placed mare Madonna Lily (Daylami) who herself is a half-sister to Group 2 winner Minakshi (Footstepsinthesand). The mare's third dam, Light Of Hope (Lyphard), also produced Happy Heart (Exit To Nowhere) who is the granddam of last year's VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Miami Bound (Reliable Man) and 2017 Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 3200m) winner De Little Engine (Encosta De Lago). Olympic Glory stands at Haras de Bouqueto in France for a fee of €10,000.

Pao Alto lands Prix la Force

Last year's Grand Criterium de Bordeaux - Prix du Hong-Kong Jockey Club (Listed, 1600m) winner Pao Alto (3 g Intello - Peaceful Love by Dashing Blade) returned to the races yesterday to take out the Prix la Force (Gr 3, 1800m) at Paris Longchamp. The three-year-old colt defeated the Coolmore-owned Ocean Atlantique (American Pharoah) by a length and a half with Chachnak (Kingman) a further three lengths back in third. Pao Alto is one of 12 stakes winners for his French-based sire Intello (Galileo) who is also responsible for N E Manion (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Young Rascal. Intello stands for €12,500 at Haras du Quesnay.

Guineas takes centre stage in UK return

British racing is scheduled for a blockbuster return as the first two Classics of the season remain scheduled for the first weekend in June in the latest provisional program by the British Horseracing Authority. On Monday, the

government announced that professional sports will not take place until June 1 at the earliest, forcing the BHA Flat Pattern committee to adjust its revised schedule published on May 1. It had been hoped that several high-profile stakes races during the final weekend in May would be run in the lead to the 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) but instead a number of pattern races will be staged in the first week and open to international runners. Royal Ascot, set to take place behind closed doors, remains in its usual slot of June 16-20 but there will be changes to the order of the races. Epsom will then host the Investec Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) and Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f)

on July 4, after receiving official local approval to stage the Classics on Tuesday, with normal public access to racecourse land forbidden for 24 hours.

Santa Anita given green light

Santa Anita Park has received approval from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to resume racing on May 15 as part of the United States' revision of its 'Safer at Home' guidelines. Racing will take place behind closed doors with essential participants following strict protocols, including mandatory face masks, sanitation procedures and daily health screening such as temperature checks. There will also be mandatory social distancing while on the property and a Restricted Zone housing jockeys, valets and other essential personnel who must have a negative Covid-19 test to access. There will be revised saddling and pre-race protocols to increase physical distancing. Santa Anita has been closed since March 27. The May 15 card features nine races with purses ranging from \$17,000 to \$51,000.

Purton maintains his edge with Happy Valley double

Zac Purton and Joao Moreira continued their back-and-forth battle for the Hong Kong champion jockey title at Happy Valley on Wednesday with the Australian outpointing the Brazilian two to one.

Purton arrived at the city-side track one win ahead of his rival but with six mounts to Moreira's eight; his brace ensured he heads to Sha Tin on Sunday with a lead of 116 to 114 over his fellow three-time champ.

After Purton hit the board on Compassion Spirit (Supreme Class), Moreira struck back aboard Smart Leader (Delago Deluxe), but the former responded immediately with a comfortable success on Victoriam (I Am Invincible).

Moreira partnered Victoriam four times earlier this term, bagging a front-running win two starts back, but Purton held the reins for the first time tonight and made it count in section one of the Class 3 Cheung Lin Shan Handicap (1200m).

Francis Lui's four-year-old settled just behind the pace, peeled out and quickened emphatically off the final turn for an easing-down length and three quarters score that sets him up for a first tilt at Class 2 the next time he steps out.

"I think he has enough about him for Class 2," Purton said of the top-weight. "He carried a heavy weight tonight and he's had to come from a bit of an awkward gate (seven) but he's shown there that he's a little bit more versatile than having to be up there breaking the wind. He's learning so I think there's more there."

Compassion Spirit made light of an eight-point rise in the ratings from a last-start win, a 132-pound burden and a wide draw in gate ten to kick away in the straight and roll past the post two lengths ahead of the field.

The impressive manner in which the Manfred Man-trained three-year-old swept

aside his rivals in the Class 4 Mount Kellett Handicap (1200m) suggested Class 3 next time should be well within his compass.

"I wasn't surprised by that, he showed last time that he was improving," Purton said of the 3.1 favourite. "It was just a matter of getting a nice run from the gate, which wasn't easy early; it looked like we were in trouble but fortunately the race opened up for us a little bit, he got a nice run and he did the job well."

Smart Leader gave Moreira his win in race six, section two of the Class 3 Cheung Lin Shan Handicap (1200m). The Tony Cruz-trained five-year-old tracked the lead and when his rider's vigorous urging demanded a tough response, his constitution ensured a gutsy three-quarter length success.

"He was ready, he felt ready on the way to the gate," the Brazilian said. "He had a good draw (two), circumstances meant that we were able to make good use of it and he responded well when I needed him to."

Happy alliance for Moore and Borges

John Moore and Vagner Borges are the unlikely dynamite partnership in Hong Kong these days. The trainer and jockey ended the night with four wins from 16 pairings after the "lazy" Beauty Happy (Elzaam) took the Class 3 Ma Kong Shan Handicap (1800m).

The 28/1 shot maintained the double-digit trend of the Moore-Borges combination's previous successes, achieved at odds of 28/1,

10/1 and 11/1, and all within the last three weeks.

"The jockey's doing the job and I'm his instructor, in that I'm just trying to help him with regard to race tactics and what's expected – not just me but other trainers too – trying to give him some insight. He's very open to criticism and where he can improve," Moore said of the rider, a four-time champion in Brazil.

Borges went winless through a short debut contract in Hong Kong last July but Beauty Happy's victory took his tally to eight wins since his return in mid-March.

"If we can just reboot the mindset a bit, I think he can do even better. He has the components to make it in Hong Kong, he just needs to tweak a few things," Moore continued.

"I think he's a welcome addition but he just needed someone to pick him up and give him some reasonable rides, where he can show what he was doing in Brazil; he can ride light and that's a big plus so I hope when he starts to ride winners the local trainers will give him better rides."

And the Australian handler, now in the final weeks of his record-breaking Hong Kong career, believes a bit of language tuition will help Borges lift his game further.

"The language will take time – his interpreter rides for Frankie Lor and he interprets really well – but it would be good if he comes back next season and learns a bit of English. He is picking it up but it's very basic stuff and any improvement will only help him."

Hamelin hammers a double

Antoine Hamelin is another rider making hay after his recent arrival. The Frenchman landed a double with Victorious Leader (Alamosa) and Surrealism (Exceed And Excel).

Hamelin hit double figures with his tenth win from as many race meetings and he achieved it in what is becoming a familiar style

– a power-packed thrust, wide and late, to mug the leader by a short-head.

This time it was Victorious Leader, returned at 15/1, who benefitted to give trainer Dennis Yip his 20th win of the campaign in section two of the Class 5 Siu Ma Shan Handicap (1200m).

The French Derby-winning jockey closed the nine-race card with a half-length triumph on the David Ferraris-trained Surrealism in the Class 3 D'Aguilar Handicap (1650m).

"I'm very happy – if I come back next season and can win like this I will be very happy. I try to do the best every time and I have good support from trainers and owners," he said.

"It's very different here, there's a lot of respect in the jockeys' room here and you see that respect in the races. It's competitive but there is respect in a race and that is important because it makes it easier to ride a race: we have only 20 jockeys and while it's hard because the competition level is so high, it's easy because you know everyone out there knows their job. When you ride with the best, you learn more."

Blake Shinn swept rail-side for a deserved success aboard the Douglas Whyte-trained three-year-old Daily Delight (Smart Missile)

in the Class 4 Mount Collinson Handicap (1000m). The short-head score, Shinn's 11th this season, was just reward after the bob went against him not once but twice in the first half of the card, with those narrow reversals taking his tally of second placings to 41 for the term.

Matthew Poon has notched one win for the Michael Chang stable in each of the past three seasons and he maintained that record when driving the 20/1 shot Indigenous Star (Exceed And Excel) through a strong, wide run to nick the Class 4 Pottinger Peak Handicap (1650m), the rider's first score for the yard this term at the 16th attempt. The six-year-old gelding was on the mark at his fourth start for Chang, having transferred from the Ricky Yiu stable.

Victor Wong kept his head aboard the Tony Millard-trained Yee Cheong Lucky (Acclamation) to switch out on the home turn, duck to the rail midway down the run, and then weave out and dash late to snatch the opening section one of the Class 5 Siu Ma Shan Handicap (1200m) by a short-head in a three-way call. The winner, a Hong Kong International Sale graduate, returned a 17/1 chance for his first win at the 17th try.

Liza With A Zee - who races in striking leopard print silks - was having her second start on Wednesday. She had finished ninth of ten on debut at Eagle Farm in December.

Sent out as an odds-on favourite against the older horses, Liza With A Zee sat handy early under Jim Byrne before powering away in the straight. At the line, she had a three and a half length margin over the Barry Baldwin-trained Booming Town (Better Than Ready), having covered her last 600 metres in a slick 33.62 seconds.

While Liza With A Zee does hold an entry for the J J Atkins, Gollan said that other black-type races were likely to be on her radar.

"She is more likely to run in a Listed race at Doomben in two weeks. I think she is definitely a Saturday horse and black-type is also on the cards," Gollan said, referring to the Bill Carter Stakes (Listed, 1110m) for the two-year-old fillies.

"I have always had a big opinion of her but we probably made a mistake running her in December. She came back from a break a stronger filly. Not many two-year-olds beat older horses at their second start.

"The ladies came up with the colours hence she races in leopard print with salmon sleeves and cap. The colours certainly are a talking point. Hopefully one day the talk will also be about Lady With A Zee's stakes racing."

Liza With A Zee was purchased at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$150,000 by a consortium including Gollan, John Foote Bloodstock and Brian Siemsen's Black Soil Bloodstock, from the draft of Widden Stud.

She is the first foal out of the Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock) mare Leap Lively, who raced three times for Gerald Ryan and Rodney Northam for a placing at Wellington.

Leap Lively's second foal, a Star Witness (Starcraft) yearling, went through the Inglis Classic sales ring earlier this year, fetching \$37,000 to Hancox Bloodstock.

Leap Lively, though, is well-bred, being out of the Listed winner Jade Diva (Jade Robbery), making her a half-sister to dual Group 3 scorer Bliss Street (Flying Spur) and Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) conqueror Jade Marauder (Fastnet Rock).

Further down the page is three-time Group 1 placegetter Thunder Fantasy (Lucky Owners), winner of the Autumn Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and the Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m), as well as Group 1 winners Cracksman (Frankel), Golden Horn (Cape Cross) and Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War).

Leap Lively has a Nicconi (Bianconi) weanling filly, while she visited Star Witness again last year.

W eek after week, Tony Gollan's juvenile team continues to impress. He has the favourite for the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m), unbeaten filly Isotope (Deep Field), as well as up-and-comers like Starosa (Starspangledbanner) and Corvo (Spirit Of Boom).

RITA to announce closure of New Zealand tracks

A major announcement is expected today that will likely see up to 10 thoroughbred tracks throughout New Zealand closed, including the Auckland metropolitan track, Avondale.

On top of the New Zealand government's emergency support package announced earlier this week, such a shake-up could well have been expected as the new season calendar is expected to show severe reductions and cuts.

The closure of Avondale will be the most striking element as it occupies prime land in suburban Auckland. Some estimates value the land at between NZ\$150 million and NZ\$200 million.

It will become clearer on Friday as to how many of the recommendations listed in the Messara Report will feature in the announcement; however, in submissions made in March to a select committee formulating policy for the upcoming Racing Reform Act, Messara himself believes that consolidation and rationalisation are vital to improving the industry's future.

If and when legislation is passed, it will mean that those tracks will be denied the opportunity to hold meetings and the respective tracks will be sold. Presumably, the proceeds will channelled back to the industry.

Proceeds from any potential sale of Avondale, if applied to the industry at large,

could alleviate the industry's current financial woes. However, officials of the Avondale Jockey Club have, in the past, been willing to fight for their survival and it will be no surprise if they seek legal help.

Racing is due to recommence on July 1, having been closed down when the government put the country into lockdown late March. This may also have been the catalyst for today's announcement.

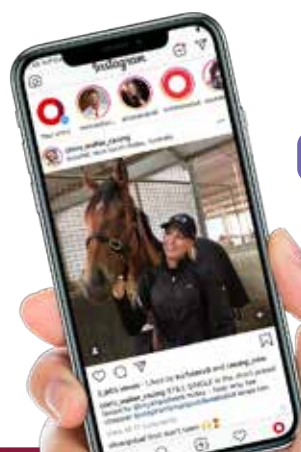
