Small field but Blue Sapphire provides plenty of talking points

Ranting causes upset in Group 3, Coolmore next for Corstens' son of Zoustar

The three-horse field drew derision from some in the lead-up to the Blue Sapphire Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) but the trio's clash provided a spectacle worthy of the \$400,000 on offer and it was Ranting (Zoustar), a maiden before yesterday, who rallied to take the major prize.

In doing so, Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and Danehill Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) placegetter

Ranting (\$11) enhanced his own credentials by downing last season's brilliant two-year-old Hanseatic (Street Boss) (\$3.90) and Anders (Not A Single Doubt) (\$1.35 favourite).

Ranting, remarkably, over raced early and was caught three wide outside Hanseatic, who kicked up to sit outside the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Anders, who was having his first start back from an elevated temperature which ruled him out of the A J Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) last month. *Continued on page 2>>*

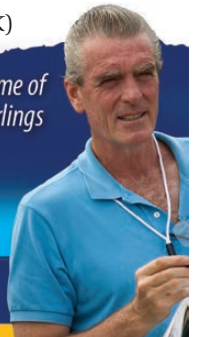

<< *Continued from page 1* Just as Hanseatic, who finished second, and Anders appeared to be fighting it out, Ranting balanced up to close well in the last 50 metres to win by a half-neck.

Hanseatic, who was found to have bled from both nostrils and will incur a three-month ban from racing, had a short-head to spare over third-placed Anders in a thrilling finish. Anders was later diagnosed with heat stress.

Such is Troy Corstens' belief in Ranting's ability, he refused to send the colt to a maiden and now, after the colt's breakthrough Group 3 win, the trainer will attempt to land the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), a victory that would ensure the son of Zoustar's (Northern Meteor) appeal as a stallion prospect.

"I've got two really nice horses going to the Coolmore. He's going to be a very valuable colt one day and hopefully we can run really well in the Coolmore."

Corstens, who trains in partnership with his father Leon, already has three-year-old filly Swats That (Shamus Award), the winner of Saturday's Thoroughbred Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield.

Ranting's jockey Ben Melham admitted to some curse words at the 600-metre mark, but was confident the colt would be able to run on under pressure.

"They got away from me a little. I let him drift a bit in the straight away from them and he was too strong late," Melham said.

"It was no surprise to me that he won today. Onwards and upwards for him."

Jockey Mark Zahra admitted Anders, who was secured by Widden Stud for stallion duties, after his stunning San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) victory on August 29, ran a disappointing race and also said he was shocked that his two rivals were able to remain so close to him early.

Ranting, who was bred by Gerry Harvey, was purchased by Flemington Bloodstock and Malua Racing for \$280,000 at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Westbury Stud draft.

From six starts, he has now been placed on five occasions including his Blue Sapphire Stakes success. He has now earned \$323,800 in prize-money.

He is the first foal out of the placed mare Vanilla Ice Cream (More Than Ready) who in turn is a daughter of the five-time stakes-placed mare Villa Bled (Danehill), a sister to Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Danelagh.

Corstens also sought out the second and last foal of Vanilla Ice Cream, a Tarzino (Tavistock) colt, who made NZ\$95,000 at this year's New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale.

Vanilla Ice Cream died before foaling in 2019.

Zoustar, who stands at Widden Stud for a fee of \$121,000 (inc GST) this year, is the sire of 15 stakes winners including Group 1 winner Sunlight who sold for \$4.2 million as a broodmare at the Magic Millions National Sale on the Gold Coast earlier this year.

Sovereign Award latest Shamus Award to hit the board at Caulfield

The hot run of form by Rosemont Stud's recruit Shamus Award (Snitzel), the sire of three stakes winners already this season including Saturday's Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) scorer Mr Quickie, continued on the middle day of the Caulfield Cup carnival with two victories yesterday.

The Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m)-winning stallion started the day with Embolism winning a three-year-old ratings race, with trainer Danny O'Brien indicating the colt would step up to a Group race next start, before it was stablemate Sovereign Award who made it seven wins from 15 starts in the MRC Ladies' Day Vase (Gr 3, 1600m), her first at stakes level.

The Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) looms large for Sovereign

Award as O'Brien looks to capitalise on her strong form this campaign.

"We'll think about it (the Empire Rose)," O'Brien said.

"We'll possibly go back to Moonee Valley (for the Tesio Stakes) on Saturday week. She does love The Valley. But she's in a rare vein of form so we certainly won't be turning her out."

Sovereign Award, a winner of her previous start at Moonee Valley, defeated stablemate Fabric (Ocean Park) by a long neck with the previously unbeaten Chaillot (Testa Rossa) another short-half head away in third.

O'Brien praised Jamie Kah for her connection to Sovereign Award.

"She's really clicked with Jamie Kah. She's had two rides on her now for two wins," the trainer said.

"She has been a challenging mare so credit to everyone at home that they've persisted with her so far.

"You would have got long odds about her being a stakes winner 12 months ago but she's won a Group 3 race here today so it's fantastic."

Kah said: "She's a different horse when she doesn't get cover.

"She got going at the 800 metres - she really wanted to win today. She was probably a little plain late but that was only because she wanted to get going a bit early.

"She's just in form at the minute. She's going super, she's got a lot of talent. When she learns to drop the bridle a little bit more, I think she'll be a really nice 2000-metre horse."

Sovereign Award, a five-year-old mare who is from the first crop of Shamus Award who relocated from Widden Stud to Rosemont Stud in Victoria last year where he covered 149 mares, has earned \$347,175 so far in her career.

She is one of two winners and the first at stakes level out of six-time winner Sovereign Charm (Show A Heart) whose third dam Sixpence (One Pound Sterling) is responsible for producing Western Australian stakes winner Potential (Southern Appeal).

Sovereign Award has an unraced three-year-old sister Seaflare in training with Will Clarken and a yearling colt, also by Shamus Award. She was not covered last year.

The Leon and Troy Corstens-trained Swats That won the Thoroughbred Club on Saturday, while Shamus Award has also had Flying Award and Shamino placed at stakes level since August 1.

Overall, the Rosemont Stud stallion is now the sire of nine individual stakes winners and he stands for a fee of \$19,800 (inc GST) this season.

Begg happy to play by his own rules with Nonconformist

Grahame Begg will resist the temptation to test progressive middle-distance four-year-old Nonconformist (Rebel Raider) over a longer distance despite the merit of his Coongy Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) success at Caulfield yesterday.

The experienced trainer plans to take the lightly-raced Nonconformist, who won the Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m) in March, to Flemington for the carnival and has designs on the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on Derby Day.

By the late Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m)-winning sire Rebel Raider (Reset), Nonconformist has had an interrupted spring preparation, resuming with a placing over 1400 metres in late August before a seventh over 1700 metres at Caulfield on September 26.

Third-up from a spell, with regular jockey Jordan Childs remaining in the saddle yesterday, Nonconformist defeated dual Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Harlem (Champs Elysees) by a long neck.

Kiwi (Reset), the 2017 Coongy Cup winner, was another three lengths away in third.

The Coongy Cup win guaranteed Nonconformist a start in Saturday's Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) but Begg had no qualms in bypassing the race.

"It was a good watch, (Childs) gave him a perfect ride, presented at the right time. It was really good to get the horse back on track because he had a bit of a hiccup along the way and a lot of people bagged him after his last start," Begg said.

"It's good to get him back on a good track, it was the right race for him today with the weight concession he got for his rating.

"We will make our mind up (where we go next). There's a couple of races at Flemington, I have got at the back of my mind a race like the Cantala.

"A bit of a freshen up, back to the mile. He certainly needed to win today to be able to do that, get his rating points up.

"We will see what happens."

Trainer Rob Hickmott suggested Django Freeman (Campanologist), who ran fifth as the \$4.20 third favourite behind Nonconformist (\$3.30) and Al Galayel (Zoffany) (\$4), would lower his expectations for the five-year-old and might start him in the Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) on October 28.

The European import was later found to be lame in the near foreleg by Racing Victoria stewards, while Al Galayel also pulled up sore after the Coongy.

Homebred Nonconformist is the first of just two foals out of the three-time winner Good Thinking (Hold That Tiger), who died in January 2019, five months after having a colt by Master Of Design (Redoute's Choice).

Nonconformist, who has had nine starts for four wins and four placing with prize-money earnings of \$433,150, is from a family light on for stakes performers in his first three dams.

However, his fourth dam Dancing Maid (Sovereign Edition) is the dam of four-time Group winner Waikiki (Crested Wave) and Listed winner Happy Features (Famous Star). It is also the same dam line which produced this year's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle).

Rebel Raider, meanwhile, died 12 months ago as he was undertaking his ninth season at Wyndholm Park Stud in Victoria.

Headed by Nonconformist, Rebel Raider is also the sire of Hobart Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Pretty Punk, SAJC Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 2030m) winner Waging War and the Listed Adelaide winner Wasabi Bob.

Nine for Shamus Award

Rosemont Stud's Shamus Award (Snitzel) registered his ninth individual stakes winner yesterday when Sovereign Award (5 m ex Sovereign Charm by Show A Heart) took out the Ladies' Day Vase (Gr 3, 1600m) at Caulfield. Shamus Award, who has had three stakes winners in four days, stands at Rosemont for a fee of \$19,800 (inc GST) this season.

Back-to-back Listed wins for Coruscate

It may have taken Coruscate (6 g Exceed And Excel - Dazzler by More Than Ready) 21 starts to break his stakes maiden, but the well-performed Godolphin charge made it two stakes wins in a row yesterday by taking the Village Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield under Damian Oliver.

Coruscate, a brother to Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) winner and Everest (1200m) runner Bivouac, prevailed by a length over Excess Funds (Rubick) and William Thomas (Nicconi). "He is a pleasure to have in the stable," said Godolphin's Melbourne representative Sean Keogh. "He left the gates really well. Damian has had a sit on him, so he knows the horse well. He got him in a lovely spot, three pairs back, and just at a vital time he

took off, found a nice gap, got him to the middle of the track and found the line really well. He's in really good order; to carry weight like that in a Listed black-type race was a good effort."

Carbine Club on cards for Embolism

A 1600-metre three-year-old restricted event that has a proven track record of producing stakes horses may have unveiled another yesterday as Embolism (Shamus Award) stamped himself as a potential spring contender. The Danny O'Brien-trained colt, who races in the same Ultra Racing colours as his sire Shamus Award as well as his dam's sister Miss Andretti (Ihtiram), won on debut at Bendigo before striking trouble at Flemington last month. Yesterday, though, he was never in much trouble, strolling clear for a three-length victory over Miss Inbetween (Fighting Sun) and putting himself forward for some mile assignments over the coming weeks. "I'll have a chat to Sean (Buckley, Ultra Racing principal) but I think Carbine Club, Sandown Guineas, he's got a bit of tactical speed and while we didn't have him ready for the Caulfield Guineas this spring, I'd love to think we could get him ready for the Australian Guineas in the autumn."

Waller concedes weight concern for Elleegant

Chris Waller sends out three runners in Saturday's Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) in Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) trifecta Verry Elleegant (Zed), Toffee Tongue (Tavistock) and Finche (Frankel), with the trio set to jump from barriers nine, five and ten respectively should the emergencies fail to gain a start. Sydney's champion trainer admits all three are

"completely different horses," but recognises that Verry Elleegant faces a task with 55 kilograms. "I think their form is franked, they're going well so that's got to be good going into a Caulfield Cup," Waller said. "Verry Elleegant has got a big weight and that has to be respected. It has made it hard for a lot of mares in the past and that's my concern. Finche had no luck in the race last year from the draw and still ran well. His run the other day was very good and he's better suited at the weights than Verry Elleegant. Toffee Tongue, who knows? Up to 2400 (metres), she might be the one."

Allen to ride Avilius in Caulfield Cup

John Allen will ride Avilius (Pivotal) in the Caulfield Cup, with James Cummings and the Godolphin team electing to send him to Melbourne instead of running him in the Craven Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) in Sydney. The three-time Group 1 winner will be aiming to give Godolphin a third Caulfield Cup victory after the wins of All The Good (Diesis) in 2008 and Best Solution (Kodiac) in 2018, but he would be the first to be prepared locally. "He's sailing along beautifully and he's highly likely to produce the best run of this campaign," Cummings told godolphin.com. "There are

some quality horses around him in the weights, but his last run in Sydney was very good and we suspect the form from that race is pretty good. There are few things that would give me more pleasure than to see Avilius storming home in a Caulfield Cup. He deserves it."

Cummings up for Everest ride

Anthony Cummings is preparing to saddle up his first Everest (1200m) runner and he figures his famous father Bart would approve of the innovative race concept. While the late Bart Cummings is legendary for his record in one of Australia's most traditional races, the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), Anthony Cummings says he also recognised the importance of keeping up with the times. "The money gets everyone's attention and the format is different, and once again gets everyone's attention," Cummings said of his Everest runner Libertini (I Am Invincible). "There are so many moving parts and the whole thing changes right up until the last minute. You can't blink because you might miss something. It's as fun as the horse lets it be but right now we've got a place and we'll be laughing all the way."

Anethole's owner enjoying Kosciuszko climb

With \$1.3 million in prize-money on offer for the Kosciuszko (1200m), it's not just the lucky sweepstake winners who are preparing for a big payday. Andrew Clout, a member of the A S C T racing syndicate which owns ten per cent in the Cody Morgan-trained Anethole (Exceed And Excel), says it is just as exciting for the regular ownership group. "Everyone talks about how great it is for the sweepstake slot winners, but it means just as much to the regular owners who

are lucky enough to secure a run in the race," Clout said. "It gives us the chance to experience the big race build up and see what it's like to have a runner on a day as huge as Everest day. For us, this is our Everest." Anethole, a former Godolphin-owned gelding, won first-up at Tamworth on August 31 and has had two barrier trials since.

Roche confirms Cox Plate bid for Nettoyer

Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Nettoyer (Sebring) will line up in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) at her next run, despite finishing last in the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at her most recent outing. Nettoyer was denied a run in last year's Cox Plate, having not won a Group 1 at the time, but trainer Wendy Roche has been informed by Moonee Valley Racing Club management that she would likely gain a start this year. "I had her prepared last year and everyone thought I was crazy," Roche told Racing.com. "She was flying last year leading into the Cox Plate, but then she didn't get a run because she hadn't won a Group 1. She was only a and mares prospect in most people's eyes. Then she took that form into the Doncaster. This preparation has been just as good, just not as good on paper. It's not been very good watching. It's just her pattern of racing means her form is either good or bad. If they have pace on in front, then she is in the race because it allows her to run her pattern of racing, which is to get back and then find her way home."

Wichita injured in trackwork

Well-performed northern hemisphere galloper Wichita's (No Nay Never) future is in doubt after he sustained a serious leg injury at the Werribee International Horse Centre. The Aidan O'Brien-trained colt suffered a fracture to his right hind leg yesterday, which was detected after he had completed his trackwork and returned to his box. Racing Victoria and stable veterinarians are currently assessing the horse's injury to determine an appropriate management plan. Wichita's primary target during the spring racing carnival was the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 31, for which nominations are yet to close. In his nine starts to date, Wichita has won the Park Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at

Doncaster and also has three Group 1 placings, including a second in the English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) at Newmarket.

No issue for King's Legacy

King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) will take on the older horses in the Cantala Stakes after it was revealed that he had not pulled up with throat abnormalities as had been previously reported. King's Legacy finished ninth in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and was originally earmarked for a spell. However, co-trainer Peter Snowden yesterday said that, provided he continues to show positive signs, he will line up at Flemington on Derby Day. "We are going to push on and reassess him," Snowden told Racing.com. "He will probably have a jump-out here at Flemington (next) week, then we will reassess. But at this point of time we are heading towards the Cantala. We can't find a fault with him, his bloods are good. It certainly wasn't him, not at all. He has never ever run a bad race, ever. We can't put our finger on why. The horse pulled up well."

Farnan wins Gosford trial

Glen Boss is relishing the opportunity to ride Farnan in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) after partnering the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner to an impressive success in a barrier trial over 1000 metres at Gosford yesterday. The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt made virtually all the running under Boss before stretching clear of his rivals for an effortless victory. "Wow, what a feel this colt gave me this morning at the trials, can't wait to see him at Flemington!" Boss tweeted. [Click here](#) to view Farnan's barrier trial.

Spanish Whisper breaks records with bidding ongoing

Triple Group 2 winner Spanish Whisper (Lope de Vega) has broken the record price for online thoroughbred auctions with one day of bidding left. Listed for unreserved sale on Gavelhouse Plus on Monday, feverish bidding has ensued, seeing her smash through the previous record of NZD\$670,000 - set by New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Hasahalo (Savabeel) earlier this year - to reach AUD\$800,000 with the auction set to close from 5pm AEDT this afternoon. "Obviously every day counts with mares at this time of the year so it was important to get her online as quickly as possible and the immediate interest was no surprise," gavelhouse.com general manager Haylie Martin said. "She's a magnificent specimen and a valuable outcross mare in any country. John Kelly really nailed it earlier this week when he noted that she's as nice a type as has ever set foot on Newhaven Park and that those that talk of queens will need to find a new superlative for her."

Two Illicit nearing peak

Two Illicit (Jimmy Choux) will be near her potent best when she races at her pet distance in Saturday's Livamol Classic (Gr 1, 2040m) at Hastings, her co-trainer Robert Wellwood has said. Wellwood, who trains in partnership with Roger James at Cambridge, was satisfied with the four-year-old's fourth-placing in the Windsor Park Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) considering how the race was run, but there is an expectation that with a more suitably-run middle distance contest on Saturday, Two Illicit can prove even more competitive. "We were happy with the way she ran. The race just didn't pan out to be run the way that suited her," Wellwood said. "It was a torridly-fast pace and she's really a 2000-metre horse, so going that fast throughout a mile, she wasn't ever in her comfort zone. It's hard for any horse to sprint fast at the finish off a pace like that. She's better suited up over 2000

metres now and with a more evenly-run race, we expect her to run well and be able to finish off that little bit stronger. But we were happy with her run there last time and it's no shame to be beaten by horses the quality of the three that beat her home either."

ASIA

SGP: Duric escapes punishment as apprentice is banned for two months

Multiple champion jockey Vlad Duric escaped with just a warning from the stewards after they looked into his riding of War Pride (Tavistock) who finished second, beaten less than a length, in a race at Kranji on Saturday. The stewards studied Duric's level of vigour in the home straight after the gelding's trainer Jason Ong expressed his dissatisfaction with the ride. Not so lucky, however, was apprentice Mohammad Nizar who was banned for two months for his ride on Well Deserved (Dalghar), who finished unplaced in a race on the same card. Nizar was suspended until December 12 after pleading guilty to a charge of failing to ride with sufficient vigour and determination.

INTERNATIONAL

130 for Invincible Spirit

Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) sired his 130th individual stakes winner when Irish raider Traisha (4 f ex Dress Rehearsal by Galileo) proved to be a cut above her rivals with a comfortable victory in the Beckford Stakes (Listed, 1m 6f) at Bath yesterday. The Joseph O'Brien-trained filly was ridden prominently by David Egan throughout before scooting clear up the far rail in the closing stages to beat favourite Urban Artist (Cityscape) by three lengths with Hereby (Pivotal) another neck away in third. It was the third time she has been victorious in 12 starts to date. Bred by Ben Sangster, Traisha is the sixth foal out of the Grade 3-winning Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Dress Rehearsal. Among her other offspring is Traisha's full sister Baby Pink, a winner in Listed company and Christophermarlowe (Tapit), a multiple winner in Hong

Kong. Invincible Spirit stood at the Irish National Stud for a fee of €100,000 (approx. AUD\$163,850) in 2020.

USA: Spendthrift acquires rights to Jackie's Warrior

Jackie's Warrior (Maclean's Music), the undefeated juvenile who stretched his record to four wins with victory in last week's Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Belmont, will stand at Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky after he is retired, it was announced yesterday. "Jackie's Warrior is proving to be one of the fastest two-year-olds to come around in the last decade or more and we are extremely excited to follow his racing career and witness the special things he can accomplish before he joins us at Spendthrift," said Ned Toffey, Spendthrift general manager.

Trained by Steve Asmussen for owners Kirk and Judy Robison, Jackie's Warrior figures among the leading fancies for next month's Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) following his latest success.

IRE: Goffs catalogue released

Siblings to Group 1 winners Ghaiyyath (Dubawi), Sea Of Class (Sea The Stars) and Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega) headline the world class collection of Ireland's best foals catalogued for the 2020 Goffs November Foal Sale. UK: Kameko out of QEII with Breeders' Cup now on the agenda

English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Kameko (Kitten's Joy) will bypass Saturday's Queen Elizabeth II Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Ascot and instead be aimed at next month's Breeders' Cup meeting at Keeneland. Connections had warned the colt could miss the race, for which he was one of the leading fancies, due to testing conditions and confirmation of that came yesterday, when the ground was described as soft, heavy in places by officials at Ascot.

Lope De Vega colt leads the way at 675,000gns as intense Book 2 trade continues

Six-figure bids came thick and fast on Tuesday as Book 2 of the October Yearling Sale continued to buck the market trends seen elsewhere during a sales season that has supplied more than its share of challenges.

A session of selling that was widely considered exceptionally strong, not least given the wider financial circumstances, saw turnover rise by four per cent year-on-year to 17,987,500gns (approx. AUD\$34 million); an average of 84,450gns (approx. AUD\$166,750) - up one per cent; and a median of 52,000gns (approx. AUD\$95,250) - down 20 per cent on the 65,000gns returned last year.

The clearance rate was a healthy 85 per cent as 213 of 252 offered lots changed hands.

Heading the market was a striking grey son of Lope De Vega (Shamardal) offered by Newsells Park Stud. The Park Paddocks ring was as bustling as social distancing measures allowed but it was Anthony Stroud, standing by the parade ring in the driving rain, who went to 675,000gns (approx. AUD\$1.275 million) to see off the frustrated underbidder, Andrew Balding.

The agent was active for a variety of clients throughout the day but confirmed this colt will join the Godolphin ranks. Stroud said: "He's a very nice horse bred on a good cross being by Lope De Vega out of a Galileo mare. He's an attractive horse and has been bought for Godolphin."

The colt is out of Loch Ma Naire (Galileo)

a winning half-sister to Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) heroine Simply Perfect (Danahill), who in turn is the dam of stakes performers Mekong River (Galileo) and Simply Beautiful (Galileo). Another sibling, One Moment In Time (Danahill), is the dam of Bondi Beach (Galileo) and Constantinople (Galileo).

Loch Ma Naire is a member of the St Albans Bloodstock broodmare band, and Newsells Park's general manager Julian Dollar said breeder Andrew Stone deserved the plaudits for producing the sought after youngster.

"The team did a great job with him but we've only had him for eight or nine weeks so we can't really take much credit, that must go to the breeder, Andrew Stone," said Dollar. "We were allowed to put the polish on but we didn't do much more than that."

Newsells Park topped the consignors' charts during Book 1 when 15 of their lots grossed 6,942,000gns and the Hertfordshire farm was on course to repeat the feat at Book 2. Dollar reflected on the strength of trade seen this week, saying: "In this climate we didn't think it would be easy at all but this sale seems to have taken off in a big way."

"Thanks to all the people who are prepared to take their hands out of their pockets and

spend big money on racehorses. Long may it continue."

Godolphin's haul also included the 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$567,500) Siyouni (Pivotal) colt out of Oh So Sharp Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) winner Havant (Halling) offered by Newsells Park Stud and a 400,000gns (approx. AUD\$757,000) son of New Bay (Dubawi) from Ballylinch Stud.

"New Bay, a son of Dubawi, has started off really well," said Stroud having seen off the challenge of Demi O'Byrne. "I thought this was a very athletic horse. He cost a bit more than we wanted to pay for him but a very astute judge was the underbidder."

The New Bay colt was bred from the Radley Stakes (Listed, 7f) scorer Need You Now (Kheleyf), who joined the Ballylinch broodmare band at a cost of 275,000gns.

"He has a good pedigree but I think it's more about the individual with this colt," said Ballylinch's John O'Connor. "He's got an extraordinary action, he's so light on his feet and with a lot of quality and he had a lot of second views down at the barn."

O'Connor also looked back on a productive session of selling for the Ballylinch stallions, saying: "We're delighted with the way the

market has received the progeny of our stallions, although I think they deserve it. The reason they're selling so well is because the sires are getting winners at the right tracks and at a high level. That's what it should be about."

Bernick's big ambitions

Just a few lots after the Lope De Vega colt, Hubie de Burgh and Fozzy Stack went to 460,000gns (approx. AUD\$870,500) to see off Juddmonte's Simon Mockridge and secure the Frankel (Galileo) filly out of Love Is Blindness (Sir Percy) offered by Norelands Stud. The unraced dam is a sibling to three black type winners, namely Group 1 hero Reliable Man (Dalakhani), dual Group 3 scorer Imposing (King's Best) and the Listed-winning Gale Force (Shirocco).

"She's been bought for Craig Bernick of Glen Hill Farm and will go into training with Fozzy," said De Burgh. "We tried all last week but couldn't get anything. We've been trying to get a Classic filly and she's by one of the great sires of the modern era and from a great Classic pedigree, so she could be a Guineas or Oaks filly."

De Burgh was returning to familiar territory with the well-related youngster as he partnered with James Harron at €380,000 to secure Love Is Blindness on behalf of John Camilleri's Fairway Thoroughbreds at Goffs in 2016.

Tuesday's transaction was another successful one for Fairway Thoroughbreds, having also bred the 400,000gns (approx. AUD\$757,000) Kingman (Invincible Spirit) colt who topped day one of Book 2 when bought by Godolphin.

"She's beautiful and comes from a farm that I keep a lot of stock on," continued De Burgh. "I've known about her since she was foaled as I bought the mare for John Camilleri and every time I've

seen her she's got better and better. I just hope she's as good as we think she's going to be."

Glen Hill Farm may be based in Florida, but Bernick has enjoyed some notable success in Europe, not least with One Voice (Poet's Voice), winner of the Blue Wind Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) and runner-up in the Nassau Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f).

"Craig Bernick is a great lover of the horse industry and he's going to be a very serious breeder as he has some wonderful stock," said De Burgh. "He wants to collect this quality of stock as he's thinking 20 years ahead. Hopefully she'll be a foundation mare."

Punchy pinhook pays off

Nine yearlings fetched 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$567,500) or more on Tuesday, including the Camelot (Montjeu) filly out of Matorio (Oratorio) from Baroda Stud who went the way of Simon Crisford's Gainsborough Thoroughbreds at 340,000gns (approx. AUD\$643,500).

Strong trade also brought with it some notable pinhooking successes and among those toasting a good sale was Gerry Ross after seeing a Showcasing (Oasis Dream) colt pinhooked for 70,000gns go to Demi O'Byrne, acting on behalf of Peter Brant's White Birch Farm, at 310,000gns (approx. AUD\$586,000).

"Me and a couple of mates bought him here last year," said Ross, manager of Kenilworth House Stud. "He had a good walk when we bought him - if they can't walk as a foal, they won't talk as a yearling but he's just been magic. He's been flat to the boards here and every show was as good as the last one; he's been a pro so far and I just hope he can fulfil his potential."

The colt is out of the unraced mare Harlequin Twist (Acclamation) and shares his page with talented juveniles like Jewel In The Sand (Bluebird), winner of the Cherry Hinton Stakes (Gr 2, 6f), and Woodcote Stakes (Listed, 6f) scorer Smokey Storm (One Cool Cat).

"I would've never dreamt of that sort of money a week ago, but once you've a couple of big players involved you just don't know where it'll end," added Ross. "Monday's trade was the best I've seen all year. There's no vendors going into the ring with their chest puffed out but at least you can have a bit more confidence than at earlier sales."

Pleasant surprise for Horse Trader author

Horse Trader, the story of Robert Sangster's involvement in the boom and bust of the thoroughbred industry, rates as essential reading for bloodstock aficionados.

On Tuesday co-author Patrick Robinson landed a touch that would not have looked entirely out of place on the pages of his classic tale when the Ribchester (Iffraaj) filly he co-bred with Norelands Stud sold to Peter Brant's White Birch Farm for 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$567,500).

The six-figure filly is out of Hint Of Pink (Teofilo), an unraced half-sister to Listed scorer Pelerin (Shamardal), who was acquired through BBA Ireland for 70,000gns in 2016. The page boasted a significant update as the filly's half-brother Parchemin (Lope De Vega) colt bought by Godolphin for 110,000gns, made a winning debut for Andre Fabre earlier in the month.

"We were pleasantly surprised by her," said Norelands' Harry McCalmont. "She's a beautiful filly and the brother having won first time out for Andre Fabre was a big plus - timing is everything in this business. I'm particularly pleased as I owned her in partnership with an old friend of mine, the author Patrick Robinson."

"He wrote Horse Trader and Lone Survivor, which became a movie starring Mark Wahlberg. Patrick decided to retire from writing and took up breeding horses! He gave me a few quid to spend on mares and Hint Of Pink was one of the ones we bought."

Hint Of Pink produced a colt by Saxon Warrior (Deep Impact) earlier this year and

is back in foal to Ten Sovereigns (No Nay Never). On what led to the Ribchester covering, McCalmont said: "We've used quite a few first-season horses and we liked Ribchester; he's a good-looking horse and was a good racehorse. It's nice when a plan comes together, although it doesn't happen very often!"

Ribchester stood his debut season at Darley's Kildangan Stud for a fee of €30,000.

Big result for Baroda's Bated Breath

Another pinhooking outfit to land a handsome profit was David Cox's Baroda Stud, which saw a Bated Breath (Dansili) colt picked up for €95,000 go Stroud Coleman Bloodstock's way at 260,000gns (approx. AUD\$492,000).

The May foal is out of the unraced mare Guana (Dark Angel) and is a half-brother to two black type performers, namely Molecomb Stakes (Gr 3, 5f) scorer Rumble Inthejungle (Bungle Inthejungle) and the Group 2-placed Great Prospector (Elzaam).

"During the year I was a bit worried about whether he'd be big enough," said Cox. "Obviously you had to take into account his date of birth, but in the last few months he's just thrived. He's going to continue to improve as well so I think he'll turn out to be a smashing horse. I know Simon Crisford has the two-year-old Twilight Son half-brother [Caribbean Sunset] and they think a lot of him. It's a fast family."

Cox added: "He was bought off Acorn Stud at Goffs last year for €95,000 so he was an expensive pinhook, but it's worked out

well. We've had a nervous few months with him trying to figure out which sale to send him to but we picked Book 2 to give him as much time as possible and it's worked out so it's a great result."

Cox also reflected on trade witnessed during the first half of Book 2, saying: "I thought it was strong. I sort of knew from the days of showing that trainers were here looking for horses at all different levels. We were very happy with trade and considering what else is going on in the world, we're very lucky this is going ahead."

Bred by Patrick Gleeson, the colt becomes the most expensive yearling by Bated Breath.

Pier House pinhook sitting pretty

Updates don't come much bigger than the one that Pier House Stud's colt out of Lady Gorgeous

(Compton Place) boasted, as the son of Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) is a half-brother to none other than Pretty Gorgeous (Lawman), winner of the Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) on her latest outing.

The colt was pinhooked by Peter and Ross Doyle at 90,000gns at last year's December Foal Sale, when Pretty Gorgeous was simply listed as a 2018 filly by Lawman (Invincible Spirit).

Since then the Joseph O'Brien-trained Group 1 winner has revealed herself to be one of the season's leading lights, which no doubt contributed to Alastair Donald needing to go to 250,000gns (approx. AUD\$472,000) to secure her sibling on Tuesday.

"The pedigree went the right way and he's improved all year," said Pier House's Brendan Morrin. "He's a very nice horse; he's got a great temperament and I'd be very hopeful he could be a very good horse."

IT'S IN THE BLOOD

The best-known link between Denmark and Australia probably comes in the form of Mary Donaldson, the former Tasmanian advertising worker who married the heir to the Danish throne and is now Crown Princess Mary.

But you wonder if anyone in Denmark knows there's an extremely formidable branch of Australian thoroughbred royalty that traces back, the other way, to their country.

Do any of the 8,225 residents of Helsingør, 45km north of Copenhagen, know an unraced mare bearing their town's name gave birth to one of the greatest racehorses the world has known, the unbeaten Black Caviar? And to her half-brother All Too Hard, the quadruple Group 1-winner now sire of turf stars like Alligator Blood and Behemoth?

And would the Danes know of Scandinavia – the horse, not the peninsula – and her impact on a sport more popular at the other end of the earth than in any other country? (Some will have heard of Danehill but perversely, for Australia, he doesn't even get a mention in today's pedigree!)

One name the Danish will know is Ole Kirk.

But again we need to distinguish between versions.

The two-legged variety was the inventor of perhaps the most famous thing of all about Denmark – Lego – with former carpenter Ole Kirk Christiansen coming up with the little plastic blocks in the 1940s.

The four-legged edition named after him, meanwhile, set himself up to continue Australian racing's famed Danish line with a lucrative stud career in claiming Saturday's renowned stallion-maker, the Caulfield Guineas, to follow his first Group 1 triumph in the Rosehill's Golden Rose two weeks earlier.

From somewhat frustrating beginnings of one win in six starts, Ole Kirk is now not only Australia's most precious racehorse, with a value of around \$40 million, but is also the latest generational flag-bearer for his Scandinavian-themed female line. To find when and how it all started, all (not too hard) roads lead back to a giant of Australian breeding.

David Hains, the Melbourne finance billionaire, had his best-known impact on Australian racing in the mid-1970s by importing

an unraced German mare named Ada Hunter. She had four foals here, two of whom raced, and one of whom was named Kingston Town.

(Ada Hunter's dam, by the way, was called Almah, thus complying with a quirky rule of the German stud book, that foals must have a name starting with the same letter as their mum. Melbourne Cup winner Protectionist was out of Patineuse. Fadango, imported here to race as Lord Fandango, is out of Fitness, and so on. But I digress...)

That Hains, in cahoots with his very well-connected friend, breeder and champion golfer Norman Von Nida, took a plunge on buying a German broodmare, at a time when such beasts were extremely rare in Australia, speaks volumes for his adventurous spirit. That Hains, acting alone, looked to Denmark soon afterwards was quite astounding.

To this day, the grey mare he bought, Love Song, remains one of only five entries – out of more than 1.1 million in the Australian Stud Book – with the suffix DEN beside its name.

There's a dash of the unusual in Ole Kirk's paternity as well. Grand-sire Iglesia, a half-brother – out of the Marscaj mare Yodells – to the outstanding dual Group 1-winner and Melbourne Cup runner-up Yippyio, descends from the lesser-known Try My Best branch of the Northern Dancer line.

But that goes nowhere near the moon-shot status of Hains' foray to Denmark.

Love Song, a 1976 offspring of British pair Warpath (by Sovereign Path) and Folk Song, won twice from 11 starts, including the Group 1 Danish Oaks, and ran second in the Swedish Oaks before Hains bought her, he recalls, for around £15,000 – a truly princely price for Denmark.

In Australia, Hains' gamble reaped no immediate dividends. Love Song dropped only two fillies at Hains' Kingston Park Stud on the Mornington peninsula, and both were unraced. Sold on, she had another filly, her third and last foal, in 1987, who earned the inglorious descriptor – “placed”. But rich success was to come.

The unraced Song Of Kingston, by Kingston Town's sire Bletchingly, produced Muirfield Village, who for Hains and Von Nida won a Group 2 Hill Stakes, came second in a Victoria Derby and a Spring Champion Stakes, and contested that Cox Plate of 1992 as a three-year-old.

The placed Lover's Chariot threw Bit Of A Ride, whose mating with Flying Spur produced Caulfield Cup winner Boom Time.

But the most successful was the unraced Song Of Norway, who threw Scandivania, who threw Helsing, who threw Black Caviar (named for the town Helsing's most famous product) and her full sister Naturale, who has continued the form of unraced mares in this distaff line by bearing Ole Kirk – the son of Written Tycoon who is thus far her only progeny to race.

Among those four Australian-born females, only the Snippets mare Scandinavia raced, and did so very well. The John Sadler-trained sprinter won at Group 2 and was placed at Group 1 four times, including a third in the Flemington Newmarket to General Nediym, coincidentally prepared by the man who'd enjoy quite the ride with Scandinavia's granddaughter Black Caviar, Peter Moody.

But what an incredible legacy Hains' vastly speculative Danish purchase has had.

“Norman was a great authority on bloodlines at that time. I knew nothing about it,” Hains, now 90, tells ANZ Bloodstock.

In the mid-1970s, Hains and Von Nida had looked to Italy's famous Dormello Stud to procure Ada Hunter and Ursula Lauderdale, dam of dual Oaks winner Lowan Star. In 1978, the pair also bought the stallion Claude from the stud to stand at Kingston Park, in a move to bring a Nearco outcross to Australian stock. He sired Rose Of Kingston, a triple Group 1 winner and Australia's Horse of the Year in her ATC Derby-winning three-year-old season, and later the dam of Hains' Melbourne Cup winner Kingston Rule (Secretariat).

But a couple of years after buying Claude, Hains struck out on his own, looking to Denmark.

“I guess Denmark was pretty unusual for here, but I just saw Love Song's pedigree in a catalogue and saw she'd won an Oaks and was placed in another. I don't think I even knew Denmark had an Oaks!” Hains said.

“I saw she was by Warpath, and thought that would be an unusual breed for Australia – I'll see if I can buy her and cross her with our horses here.

“I was always on the lookout for some European blood to outcross with Australian blood, particularly their stayers with our sprinters. I either bought her before an auction, or at an auction, or she was passed in, I can't really recall, but it was pretty simple. It wasn't what you'd call a serious purchase. It was just one of those speculative things you try to see if it works, and it did. You have plenty of misses but this one worked.

“If I'd known then what I know now, I'd have never sold her or her progeny, but we liked to keep young mares at the stud.

“But it does give you a good feeling to see the impact she's had. I know when Black Caviar was racing, it was a real thrill to think she'd come from this Love Song line.”

The line hasn't only produced strong females, with Scandinavia also delivering the redoubtable sprinter and sire Magnus (by Boom Time's sire Flying Spur), and Helsing's meeting with Casino Prince bearing All Too Hard.

Ole Kirk, raced by a group including three of Black Caviar's owners – with Neil Werrett's stake in Vinery Stud signalling his likely home after the autumn – might just be the colt to add the cherry on top of this Danish affair.

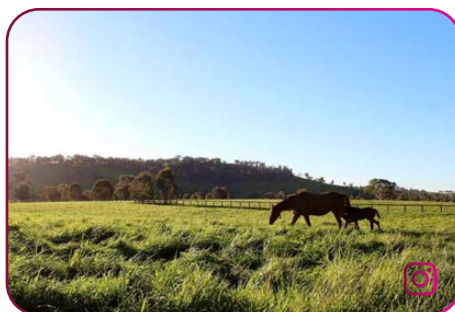


