Serious accusations of surrogate mares being used by prominent breeder

Investigation underway after dam of Nature Strip and Miss Andretti allegedly involved in embryo transfer scheme

An investigation into explosive allegations of illegal artificial insemination and the use of surrogate mares at a Group 1-producing Victorian farm, contravening the Australian Stud Book rules, has been welcomed by the national and state breeding bodies.

Ultra Thoroughbreds, owned by Sean Buckley,

the breeder of Saturday's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Nature Strip (Nicconi), was last night identified as the operation being investigated for conducting the alleged scheme.

Racing Victoria yesterday confirmed an inquiry into the allegations was under way.

"The stewards are in the formative stages of an investigation that relates to thoroughbred breeding," an RV spokesman said.

Enthaar draws wide in Diamond

"We don't intend to comment on the specifics of that investigation at this time."

The stunning accusations were first published by the Herald Sun yesterday, which alleged a surrogate was used for a champion mare, believed to be Miss Andretti (Ihtiram), that was struggling to conceive.

Thoroughbred Breeders Australia chief executive Tom Reilly said he supported any investigation into illegal breeding activity: "TBA fully supports the rules of the Australian Stud Book, including those that ban breeding through 'artificial means.' Given allegations of the potential

breach of these rules in today's Herald Sun newspaper, it is appropriate that these claims be investigated."

Thoroughbred Breeders Victoria echoed Reilly in being supportive of the RV-led investigation.

"Thoroughbred Breeders Victoria is aware of allegations of breaches of the Australian Studbook rules relating to embryo transfer and artificial insemination (AI) made in

today's Herald Sun newspaper," TBV said in a statement.

"TBV do not condone any breaches of the Australian Stud Book rules and are supportive of Racing Victoria's investigation into the matter."

Last night, The Age claimed surrogates were used in 2019 for the now 20-year-old Strikeline (Desert Sun) - the mother of star sprinter Nature Strip (Nicconi) - and Miss Andretti, who has proven difficult to breed from since she was retired to stud in 2008.

The report also claimed that Miss Andretti had a filly, and Strikeline a colt, born last spring by embryo transfer to Buckley's sire Addictive Nature (Savabeel), who is based at his Barree Stud near Kilmore in country Victoria.

A mare return has not yet been lodged for either Miss Andretti or Strikeline with the Australian Stud Book. However, Strikeline and 19-year-old Miss Andretti, whose last recorded foal is the 2017-born Mr Raikkonen (Shamus Award), were both covered by Buckley's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m)-winning sire Shamus Award (Snitzel) at Rosemont Stud last December.

<< *Continued from page 2* The Herald Sun published text messages it says were in a file handed to Victorian stewards by a former employee of the operation.

“Glad to say that (horse name redacted) has read the textbook this cycle,” the text message allegedly sent by a veterinarian said.

“I have done a split AI 6hrs before and during ovulation. The rest is up to her. I have two mares in synchrony so as well as it can be here.

“Let you know in just over a week if we recover an embryo.

“(Horse name redacted) still holding a HF but hope to see it move this week and will time nicely with other recipis (recipient mares).”

The source of the dossier is said to be seeking indemnity in return for his cooperation.

A veterinarian once associated with Buckley denied any knowledge of the alleged breaches of the Australian Stud Book rules by Ultra Thoroughbreds when contacted by ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. He would not comment further, citing the media guidelines of his current employer.

ANZ Bloodstock News makes no suggestion the veterinarian had anything to do with the alleged rule breaches or that he was the source of the text messages and it has also chosen not to name him. He was not associated with Buckley in 2019.

Racing NSW chief executive Peter V’landys and general manager of

integrity Marc Van Gestel also declined to comment on the Racing Victoria investigation when contacted yesterday.

Buckley, who paid \$800,000 for a colt by Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) at last month’s Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, confirmed to The Age that he was aware of the Racing Victoria investigation.

“I have been advised

by RVL that they are making enquiries. I intend to fully cooperate with any enquiry as is my duty and responsibility. I have a completely clear conscience,” he said.

Artificial insemination and the use of surrogate mares is permitted in the standardbred industry, but a bid to have the practice allowed in Australian thoroughbred breeding was rejected by the High Court in 2014 after a four-year legal battle by former bookmaker and Sydney Turf Club chairman Bruce McHugh, a fight that cost him millions of dollars.

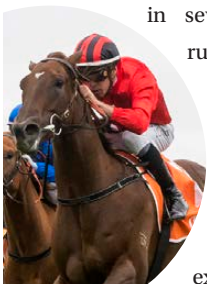
Enthaar draws wide in Blue Diamond

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Enthaar (Written Tycoon) drew barrier 14 in last night's televised draw and was subsequently pushed out to \$2.30 from \$2.10 with TAB. The unbeaten Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained filly, who has taken out the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) and Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) in her only two starts, will have Mark Zahra onboard. General Beau (Brazen Beau), who was given a late entry to the \$1.5 million contest by David Moodie and will be ridden by Jamie Kah, firmed from \$11 to \$9 after favourably drawing barrier three. Of the others towards the head of the market, Anamoe (Street Boss) will jump next to Enthaar in barrier 15 and Dosh (Rich Enuff) will break from gate eight, beside Ingratiating (Frosted) in seven. Godolphin's other runner, Arcaded (Street Boss), has been handed barrier one. Damien Oliver is torn between riding Ingratiating or Anamoe, with a decision expected imminently.



Begg chases second Diamond win

Grahame Begg will be hoping Dosh can provide him with his second Blue Diamond Stakes win on Saturday, after he took the honours with Written By (Written Tycoon) in 2018. Dosh will arrive at Caulfield following her win in the Blue Diamond Preview (Fillies) (Gr 3, 1000m) last month and is an \$11 chance with TAB following last night's barrier draw. While Begg is happy with his filly ahead of the Group 1, he is unsure whether Dosh will successfully step up to 1200 metres. "Obviously, they've all got to run 1200 metres, so that's the great unknown," Begg told RSN927. "The most important thing is to have them fit and well and ready to go on the day, but I don't think it will be any problem. She has been very determined both times that she's raced. She's been challenged and has fought back and won, particularly her race at Flemington where she wanted to roll out under pressure. I think that is one of her greatest attributes, she is very determined and really wants to find the line. She'll be spot on for Saturday."

McEvoy: Pegasi is underrated

Calvin McEvoy, who trains in partnership with father Tony, believes Pegasi (Star Turn) has a better chance of Blue Diamond glory than his odds of \$34 suggest. The colt was last seen finishing third in the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) and has drawn barrier nine for Saturday's contest. "I like the horse a lot, I think he's underrated and hasn't done much wrong at all," McEvoy told Racing.com. Of his performance in the Inglis Millennium, McEvoy added: "It was a bit of a strange run, he looked like he was beaten and then it looked like he fought back and ran

third, beaten a pimple for second by Baranof at his first attempt racing right-handed. He arrived back here in Victoria straight after the race and he's trained on beautifully. He's been a jump-and-run sort of horse but I think now that he's had that hard run in the Inglis Millennium I think he's now wiser." Pegasi was purchased for \$80,000 at last year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale and has yet to finish outside the top three in his first three outings, with his sole win coming in a Geelong maiden last month.

Freedman confident Artorius will impress

The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained Artorius (Flying Artie) put himself into contention for the Blue Diamond Stakes with a devastating four-and-a-half-length victory at Sandown last month and, after the training partnership mulled over whether to start Artorius in the race, they decided to let him take his chance. Artorius has drawn barrier ten and will be ridden by Luke Currie. "He's really well. We mulled it (the Blue Diamond) over for a while as to whether we go to the Blue Diamond or not," Freedman told Racing.com. "Ultimately we felt that in any case it is the right race to go to and it is a stepping stone potentially to some races in Sydney or even the Sires in Melbourne. He's an exciting horse, we've put the blinkers on him, he worked in the blinkers this morning in company. It certainly woke him up a bit, he was a bit more willing and keen. He's a very laid back horse typically. We've been thinking the blinkers were going to be required for some time, even probably prior to his last run. Luke Currie rode him this morning and was very happy with him. He's heading there in really good order."

Farnan wins trial

Last year's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) made a pleasing return to the public eye with a trial win at Randwick yesterday. The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt had a difficult spring, finishing unplaced in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) and Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), and connections will hope he can bounce back to top form following his comfortable win yesterday, where he saw off The Irishman (Tavistock) by one and a quarter lengths. "He seems to be going well," jockey Tim Clark told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "This morning he indicated that as well, he showed good speed and got into a nice rhythm bowling along. I just sort of shook him up for a little bit of the straight, not fully extended but allowed him to quicken for a furlong and then eased down the last bit. He was able to win his trial well." Farnan is expected to return in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) at Rosehill on March 20 and will trial once more beforehand.

Forbes scratched again

The Golden Slipper campaign of exciting colt Forbes (Capitalist) is under a cloud after the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained two-year-old was declared a late scratching from a Randwick barrier trial yesterday. Forbes injured his off-hind leg in the process of trying to be loaded into the barriers after multiple attempts. It is the second time he has been withdrawn from a trial within a week. "He refused to load this morning. It hasn't been an issue for us in the past with him, but I just think from last Thursday, it set him off," Sam Freedman told Racing.com "There was a bit of a delay last Thursday, it was a hot morning, and they were around at the gates for five or so minutes and he just got himself worked up. He was in and then he got his leg up in the gates so they scratched him there. This morning he got around there and obviously remembered what

happened last week." Forbes was nominated for Saturday's Silver Slipper (Gr 2, 1100m) but Freedman confirmed the colt wouldn't take up that assignment: "He won't be running Saturday. We will be doing a bit of work with him, get him back to the jump outs as soon as we can and when we feel he is ready to go back."

Slipper hope Captivant dominant in trial

The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Captivant (Capitalist) won his 1050-metre trial convincingly yesterday morning as he builds up towards a shot at the Golden Slipper. Winner of the Victory Vein Plate (1000m) on debut at Randwick in the spring, Captivant was last seen finishing fourth behind Sneaky Five (Fastnet Rock) in November's Golden Gift (1100m). He coasted to win his trial by three and a quarter lengths under James McDonald yesterday and will resume in the Skyline Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on February 27.

Jolly delighted with Behemoth ahead of Futurity

David Jolly believes he has Behemoth (All Too Hard) exactly where he wants him ahead of Saturday's Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) after the gelding impressed in his final piece of work at Strathalbyn yesterday morning. "He looked pretty happy, I can't fault him," Jolly told Racing SA. "He worked with Bajan, they both worked pretty well. It was better work. The other day he dropped the other horse coming up the hill - sometimes they can do that at Strath, lose a bit of concentration. But this morning was a little bit different." The dual Group 1 winner cruised to victory in the Durbridge Stakes (Listed, 1100m) on January 30 and Jolly believes he is in a good place. "He had a little blow before the Durbridge, but after he did what he did, I was pretty happy," Jolly said. "He's had three nice solid gallops since then. I'm happy with where he sits knowing he's got some

improvement. He's where I want him to be - he's still got a little bit to come. He's probably not quite where he was heading over there last time but knowing we've got the trip over and then heading to mile, I think he's in a good place."

Russian Camelot out of Futurity

Russian Camelot (Camelot) will not appear amongst Behemoth's opposition in the Futurity, after trainer Danny O'Brien confirmed he will just have a two-start autumn campaign consisting of the All-Star Mile (1600m) and the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). "We're happy with him and he'll go to the course proper (Flemington) on Friday for a trial from the 2000-metre mark," O'Brien told Racing.com. "He'll have a nice strong trial there and then it's three weeks to The All-Star Mile. He had a big spring and really the only races we are missing are the two 1400-metre races, which would not have really suited him anyway. We are conscious of the fact the horse was pretty busy in the spring and we don't want to tax him too much, so it's The All-Star Mile and then the Queen Elizabeth (Stakes)."

Zoutori bids for Oakleigh Plate redemption

The Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra-trained Zoutori (Zoustar) is set to resume in the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) on Saturday and will aim to go one better than his effort in the race last year, when he finished second to Pippie (Written Tycoon). The five-year-old gelding won the Bobbie Lewis Quality (Gr 2, 1200m) and Gilgai Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in the spring and Zahra believes he is in better form this year than last. "I think he is going better than last year heading into the race," Zahra explained. "He had a good spell and not an over-taxing spring. His trial last Friday was awesome." Zoutori is likely to line up in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) on March 6 after Saturday's contest.

Litt considers Hobartville for Black Duke

Richard Litt is weighing up his options for Black Duke (Fiorente) and may line him up in the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Rosehill on Saturday. Black Duke was last seen finishing fourth in the Vo Rogue Plate (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm on January 2 and is among 18 entries for the \$400,000 Hobartville Stakes, while he is also nominated for a Benchmark 72 contest at Canterbury on Friday. "He ran a nice trial last week and Nash (Rawiller) was very pleased but he suggested the 1400 metres might be a little sharp for him fresh so we may opt for the 1250 metres at Canterbury," Litt said. "But the horse is going really well and while it's a very strong race, we think he's up to that company. I'll accept for both races and we'll see where we end up."

Harmony sets out on Oaks path

Mark Newnham believes Harmony Rose (Glass Harmonium) is a genuine Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender and expects her to run well as she returns to action in a Benchmark 72 over 1400 metres at Randwick today. The filly, who has two wins from three starts, is currently a \$26 chance with TAB for the Oaks and Newnham is confident she will prove up to the grade. "I thought she would run very well, her trial was good, I'd say she's made good physical improvement from her first prep," Newnham told Racing NSW. "She has a good racing style, she's able to take up a position. The area she needed to improve was mentally more than physically, she can be a bit hot, but she seems more relaxed and catching up." On her path to the Australian Oaks, Newnham added: "I put her away with this prep in mind to get towards the Oaks so I have a good enough opinion of her. How we get there is yet to be determined but it could be the Kembla Classic followed by the Vinery or the Adrian Knox. Provided she runs up to what I think she will, I'd say we will remain on that path."

Strong interest in Flemington features

First acceptances were announced yesterday for three of Flemington's autumn features - the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Australian Cup

(Gr 1, 2000m) and Newmarket Handicap - with all attracting strong interest. A total of 28 three-year-olds remain in the Australian Guineas on February 27, while the Australian Cup and Newmarket Handicap take place a week later, with 35 horses remaining in contention for both races. Victoria Racing Club executive general manager of racing, Leigh Jordon, is pleased with the level of interest. "Numbers are up across all three races compared to the first declarations last year, which is a good sign that each of the Group 1 feature races is on the radar of trainers and jockeys across Australia," he told Racing.com.

Marquand booked for La Mexicana in Surround

Tom Marquand has been booked to ride the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained La Mexicana (I Am Invincible) in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on February 27. The British jockey is over halfway through his quarantine period and will be straight into top-level action aboard La Mexicana, who won the Kevin Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) earlier this month. "She is in great order, she worked this morning at Pinecliff, worked strongly, this looks the perfect race for her," Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "Hopefully we get a bit of rain and that would really bring her into calculations in what looks like a pretty even bunch of three-year-olds up here. She is a filly on the rise and keeps thriving. She deserves her chance now. She has done her yards to get to this sort of level, so hopefully it can all come to fruition."

Late decision expected for Echoes

Michael Hickmott will make a late decision on whether to run promising filly Echoes In Eternity (Reward For Effort) in the Typhoon Tracy Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on Friday night at Moonee Valley. The three-year-old, who was bought from the 2019 Inglis Melbourne Gold Yearling Sale for just \$2,000, has won her last two starts and Hickmott is confident she can hold her own in stakes company. She is also entered for a Benchmark 68 contest at Morphettville on Saturday and Hickmott is yet to make a decision on where she will run. "We're going to accept in both races, look at our options and work out a bit of a game plan," Hickmott told Racing.com. "The travel schedule (to Melbourne) is the only headache because I would've brought her over myself and had that

extra flexibility to travel her at our own leisure. My original plan was that Jess (Eaton) was going to come over and ride the horse but that's not going to be allowed to happen now so if we do run in Melbourne, Glen Boss will ride her again. There's a race for her in Adelaide on Saturday so, if she doesn't go to Moonee Valley, she can stay home. She's a very talented filly and she worked well this morning, so I'd be confident about her chances in either race."

Ranvet an option for Dragonet

The Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) is a second-up possibility for last year's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner Sir Dragonet (Camelot), who was last seen finishing unplaced in the CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on February 6. The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained five-year-old is in need of soft ground for his next assignment, with the Australian Cup, All-Star Mile and Ranvet Stakes all being considered. "They are all options for him," Maher told Racing.com. "The distance doesn't matter as he's fit enough but we just want to make sure he gets a nice surface. His aim has always been the Queen Elizabeth (Randwick on April 10). I wouldn't mind if he had a run up there earlier (Ranvet)."

Wilde weighs up Adelaide trip for Tralee

Symon Wilde will be waiting until later in the week to decide if Tralee Rose (Tavistock) will run in the Lord Reims Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Morphettville on Saturday. Wilde is hoping to run the four-year-old mare this weekend en route to the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) next month but is yet to make up his mind, with complications relating to the Victoria lockdown at the forefront of his mind. "She's very well," Wilde told Racing.com. "She's been nominated (for the Lord Reims Stakes) and we're just trying to work out plans around getting her over there if we can. I know the weather looks like it's going to be quite hot as well so we've got a few things to weigh up. In an ideal world, we'd love to go to the Lord Reims, bring her home and, if she ran well enough in the Lord Reims, head to the Adelaide Cup two weeks later." Tralee Rose has won four of her nine starts including a seven-length win in the Bagot Handicap (Listed, 2800m) on New Year's Day.

Ayrton set for quiet autumn

The Mick Price and Michael Kent jnr-trained Ayrton (Ifraaj) is set for a quiet autumn, with connections targeting the Queensland carnival as his main objective. Unbeaten in two starts, Ayrton was last seen on Boxing Day winning a Benchmark 70 contest by four and a quarter lengths and Kent jnr said they are keen to take their time with the exciting three-year-old, who recently returned to pre-training at Leneva Park following a six-week spell. "Timing wise, it makes sense for us to aim him towards the Queensland carnival," Kent jnr told Racing.com. "Without getting too deep into it, a race like the Queensland Guineas appeals, in June, a mile, three-year-olds, Group 2. There's a race there for him a couple of weeks later. We are thinking of having a three or four-run prep with the idea also being that, at the conclusion of his preparation, he can have a freshen-up in the Queensland winter and then head back to Melbourne for the spring."

Lafferty questions new whip rules

Apprentice jockey Laura Lafferty, who won the first race conducted under Racing Victoria's experimental whip rules, is concerned the new five-strike limit impacts the safety of jockeys. The series comprises five 1600-metre races, culminating on All-Star Mile day at Moonee Valley, and Lafferty won the Benchmark 64 contest at Colac aboard Jazz Star (Zoustar) on Sunday. "We can't speak to these animals and tell them when we need to focus and quicken up. The whip is our communication tool," Lafferty told RSN. "They are creatures of habit and it's a tool they respond to."

Hayes and Dabernig not impacted by Shadwell exit

David Hayes and Tom Dabernig are confident the departure of Shadwell Stud from Australian racing will not impact their stable. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell have previously been one of Lindsay Park's most successful clients and the training partnership have been aware of Shadwell's intentions for a while, with their runners halving from about 40 in recent seasons. "We've sort of been aware for some time that he was reducing numbers

in Australia," Dabernig told RSN 927. "We have a handful of them still in training, mostly two-year-olds. A year ago, they (Shadwell) stopped buying yearlings down here and that has been the same this year. It's been an amazing relationship for our business, much like the relationship with the Sangster stable. But as time has moved on there has been a less of a focus in most stables down here away from the big single owner to syndicates."

Cassidy contemplates joining training ranks

Hall of Fame jockey Jim Cassidy, who has 104 Group 1 winners to his name, is contemplating becoming a trainer. The 58-year-old retired from racing over five years ago has been attending trackwork with Randwick-based trainers Jim and Greg Lee for the past few months. "I am not confirming it but I am not denying it," Cassidy told Racing.com. "I started off going down for two weeks and I have been there three-and-a-half months. I am learning a few tricks of the trade. It would be a dream. It's nice to ride one but when you are on the other side of the fence doing the hard yards ... I had it pretty easy in my time, you get on and get off and you go home but when you are training it is 24/7 looking after them. It would be a great feat, but it would also be a challenge."

Keating saddles first runner

Pat Keating, stable foreman for Grant and Alana Williams, will saddle his first runner as a thoroughbred trainer at Bunbury today. Keating will saddle Shooting Shirocco (Shooting To Win), who was formerly in the care of the Williams', in the 1216-metre maiden. "It's been something I had been planning to do for a while after leaving harness racing," Keating told The Races WA. "I went over and worked with Darren

Weir in Melbourne with the intention of getting my license. When he got into trouble I came back and teamed up with Justin (Warwick) before joining Grant and Alana. It just felt the right time to give it a crack after thinking about doing it for some time. At this stage of my life it just felt like the right moment to do it."

Mornington homestead up for sale

A unique property that might be familiar to the eyes of Victorian racegoers has been put on the market. Mornington homestead, situated on the back straight of Mornington Racecourse, has been home to Melbourne Racing Club board member Nick Hassett and his wife Sue for over two decades. "We saw a picket sign with 'for sale' written on it in 1998 and jumped the fence to see what the block was like and couldn't believe our luck," Nick Hassett told Racing.com. "You've got all the race meetings but, not only that, you've got trackwork six mornings a week to enjoy a morning coffee over and we're right at the 900-metre start for the jumpouts." Cautious approach with Catalyst

A spring return is likely for 2019 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Catalyst (Darci Brahma), who suffered joint issues in two recent Australian campaigns, the latter featuring just one start when finishing last in The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) at Randwick. Trainer Clayton Chipperfield will be taking a conservative approach with the four-year-old. "He has been on the water treadmill for a month and he is back at The Oaks spelling again," Chipperfield said. "We are being cautious as well, taking him home and giving him a nice break like he has had, and getting him ready through the winter so we have got him ready for the spring." Chipperfield suggested another Australian campaign was not out of the question, adding: "I would say he will have one run here and then we will make a decision."

Shockallia skips NZ Derby

Promising three-year-old Shockallia (Shocking) will not contest the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on March 6, with trainers Shaune Ritchie and Colm Murray electing to take a cautious approach with the son of Shocking (Street Cry). The gelding, who impressively won a maiden event at Te Rapa on February 3, could be seen in Classic contests in Australia later in the season. "He got a very deep-seated stone bruise basically the day after his Te Rapa win and we have just got him right the last couple of days," Ritchie said. "It just cost us, it is not possible to get him to the Avondale Guineas based on the work he has missed which is obviously a hell of a shame for us. We think a lot of him and we aren't going to push a horse that has had an issue and if we get him right there is perhaps Queensland or something on the programme for him."

Johnson keen to make history at Te Aroha

Jockey Danielle Johnson is on the verge of becoming the 34th jockey to achieve 1,000 winners in New Zealand after being left on 999 following her rides at Te Rapa on Saturday. The 29-year-old is looking to reach the milestone as soon as possible, and has a book of nine rides at Te Aroha on Wednesday. "I hope that monkey doesn't just sit there. I want it off my back as quickly as I can," Johnson said. "It's just

a number to me at the moment but once I get to 1,000 I'll appreciate it that much more. What people are saying to me makes me realise what a big achievement it is. Even just saying 1,000 wins - wow, that's a lot of winners. It's a pretty big deal the more I think about it." Among her 999 wins, Johnson has ridden 76 stakes winners, with six at Group 1 level.

HK: Ho happy to step Sixty up in trip

Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro) will bid for a 13th consecutive win as he steps up in trip for the Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin on Sunday, with regular jockey Vincent Ho saying the five-year-old is in prime form to add to his tally. "He's feeling well and we're confident," Ho said of Golden Sixty, who chases a 16th win from 17 starts for trainer Francis Lui. "A mile and 2000 metres, I don't think there's a problem," Ho said. "He can still sprint home

over the last 400 metres in the same time." Golden Sixty will take on Hong Kong Horse of the Year Exultant (Teofilo) for the first time. "He's (Exultant) one of the best stayers," said Ho. "He can maintain a high speed for 2000 metres, 2400 metres, so it's (stamina) not a problem for him. He is a totally different horse to Golden Sixty. It's going to be fun."

HK: Confidence key as Derek Leung targets PB

With his recent run of good form, jockey Derek Leung is on target to eclipse last season's tally of 29 winners, with 22 winners already this term, and has a full book of nine rides at Happy Valley today. "This season I have the horses, I'm getting the chances from a broad range of stables and they have quite decent chances - I just need to perform and I'm sure the horses will keep coming, this season is a great opportunity to break my record and do even better," Leung said, who rides Wood On Fire (Per Incanto) in the third division of the Class 4 Mut Wah Handicap (1200m). "In the beginning he was very immature in the mornings and at the races, now he's getting better and better, he always used to make mistakes and he needed everything to go right for him before," said Leung. "He's a lot smoother now in the beginning and in the run, he's not as keen and with the racing he's improved a lot."

HK: Maldives to atone for Purton

Zac Purton is hopeful that the David Hall-trained Maldives (Burgundy) can atone for his wayward misfortune last start in today's Class 4 Tsun Yip Handicap (1650m). 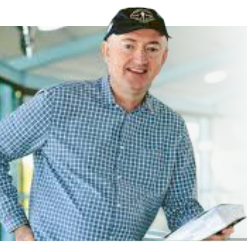

Sandblom takes shine to the West with standout Perth colts

One of the east coast's biggest breeders will switch his attention to the west tomorrow when he offers the only horse by leading freshman sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) and a Deep Field (Northern Meteor) half-brother to one of the state's best mares at the Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale.

After breeding and selling two of the country's most exciting two-year-old colts, Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) winner Profiteer (Capitalist) and the unbeaten Stay Inside (Extreme Choice), who both produced blistering displays in Sydney earlier this month, Newgate Farm partner and Kingstar Farm principal Matthew Sandblom's focus is on what will unfold in Western Australia

Willow Dale Farm will consign the two Sandblom-bred yearlings, the Capitalist colt being the first foal out of Munjai (Trusting), a three-quarter-sister to ATC Breeders' Plate (Listed, 1000m)-winning sire Whittington (Tale Of The Cat).

"The Capitalist we sent over to Perth, Magic Millions actually asked us (if we would) as they'd really appreciate having a Capitalist in the sale because I don't think there were any at this point," Sandblom told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"Henry (Field) and I, who bred him,

decided to send him over there and I think he's a real standout as a type. He should be well appreciated over there."

The growing reputation of Capitalist - a yearling sales standout sire at the Magic Millions and, more recently, at the Inglis Classic - was only enhanced at yesterday's Randwick barrier trial session which saw the return of the Newgate-China Horse Club syndicate-raced Captivant and the performance of a Mark Newnham-trained colt, Russian Standard.

“Capitalist has really got a kickalong and he’s getting an awful lot of trial winners at the moment, so there will be a few more winners coming out soon,” added Sandblom.

“Captivant won his heat this morning and then there was Russian Standard, the Capitalist-Real Stolle, who was impressive, too.”

The other eastern seaboard-linked Willow Dale Farm-consigned colt is a son of Deep Field who is the half-brother to the four-time stakes winner Dance Music (War Chant) who Sandblom bred in partnership with Perth businessman Neven Botica.

Sandblom’s Hollymount Stud races Dance Music with Botica, while Simon Miller also trains the three-year-old half-sister, recent Pinjarra maiden winner Dance Shoes, a daughter of Kingstar stallion Bull Point (Fastnet Rock).

“Because of Neven, the Deep Field colt is Westspeed eligible and he’s a nice horse,” he said.

“We thought the mare was a good cross with Deep Field because he would give the foal a bit more size. Dance Music is not very big and I have a Bull Point over there out of the mare who has won and she’s not very big either.

“He’s also the first colt out of the mare and he looks a ball of muscle type. They tend to come into their own as three-year-olds, but he might go a bit earlier.”

Sandblom added: “I am getting plenty of feedback on both colts and particularly the Capitalist, being the only one in the sale. He is getting lots of looks.

“The Deep Field, we like him as a horse and if we don’t get a reasonable price we will probably keep him and race him over there but he is certainly for sale.

“They are two nice horses to have and they should be among the leading ten per cent of what’s over there, I’d say.”

Education entrepreneur Sandblom has closely observed, as well as participated, in the surging Australian yearling market so far this year and predicts the Perth sale to continue the trend.

“WA, from what I hear, is absolutely booming. They haven’t been as affected by Covid. The mines are all going gangbusters and

Newgate investment starting to pay off: Sandblom

A major backer of Henry Field’s Newgate Farm as well as running Kingstar, Matthew Sandblom is riding the wave by virtue of the rising success of young stallions Deep Field, Capitalist, Extreme Choice, Flying Artie and Winning Rupert.

The latter quartet have all sired first crop two-year-old winners racing this season and Sandblom has been responsible for breeding two of the biggest stars, Profiteer and Stay Inside.

“When we launched four stallions in the one season, a Golden Slipper winner (Capitalist) as well as a Blue Diamond winner in Extreme Choice, a Coolmore winner in Flying Artie and Winning Rupert as well, this really is our best shot of getting a top-quality stallion,” Sandblom said.

“We’ve worked our way up to getting these stallions and now we’ve got four very good horses in one season.

“They are all very fast, precocious sprinters so you would be worried at this time of year if you didn’t have some good horses out there.

“But I think it’s even exceeded our expectations. Extreme Choice has a lot of horses getting to the track and they are all metropolitan class horses who are competitive and look like being competitive in some of the better races.”

While breeding Profiteer, who Newgate

Farm and partners have since bought back into, Sandblom also co-owns an Extreme Choice colt in Tiger Of Malay who is trained by Stay Inside’s trainers Michael and Richard Freedman.

“With Tiger Of Malay, he didn’t trial super impressively (in October). He ran second from memory,” he recalled.

“I know Henry was a bit doubtful whether he should have been running in a race straight away but Michael said, ‘no, he keeps improving every time I put him on the track’ and he was right. He was backed in from 20-1 and won easily.

“He trialled better this time with a couple of good horses around him in Remarque and Shaquero and I watched Stay Inside’s first trial, having bred him, and I said to Michael, ‘what do you think?’ and he thought he went pretty well. His second trial was nice and he went to the races and blitzed them and did it again the second time.

“I don’t know if it’s the way the Freedmans train, but they definitely leave a bit in the tank. They do improve from trial to race one, to race two, so it will be interesting to see if Tiger Of Malay is on the same sort of trajectory.”

lots of other things are, too, so realistically the WA economy is as healthy as any in Australia,” he said.

“People can’t travel to other sales, so if they want to buy a horse, Perth’s where they are going to buy them. It should be reasonably strong.”

As for reasoning why demand for bloodstock has skyrocketed on an already high benchmark, Sandblom said: “When I speak to my accountant who deals with lots and lots of different businesses, he says, ‘there’s hardly anyone not doing well unless you’re in one of

the sectors which has really been whacked like tourism.’

“Everyone else, between all the various government programs and the fact that people aren’t travelling, is spending money. With people buying furniture at a rate of knots, Gerry Harvey will have his best year in history, I think, after talking to him up at the Gold Coast.

“It’s a fairly domestic business, horses, and people are looking for entertainment options and they can’t travel and do other things.

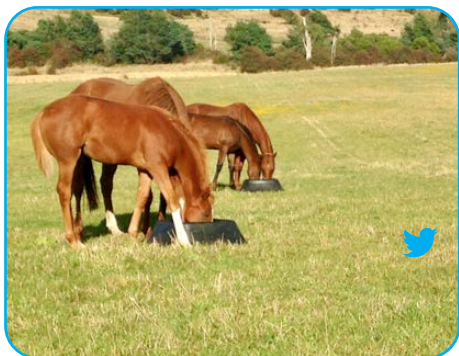
