Magic Millions National Sale catalogue goes live and so will the auction

Stakeholders allowed at the Gold Coast complex for pivotal trade market

The Magic Millions Gold Coast National Sale, the biggest breeding stock auction in the southern hemisphere, is certain to be conducted as a live event after the company released its catalogue and schedule for the major bloodstock trading market.

A relieved Magic Millions managing director

Barry Bowditch last night revealed a seven-session format for the broodmare, weanling, yearling and racehorse sale which is set to start with a 147-lot day one race fillies and mares offering highlighted by Sunlight (Zoustar) on Monday, July 20, from 2pm.

Three days have been set aside for the broodmare sale, which will precede a condensed two-day, 399-lot weanling sale to take place on July 23 and 24. *Continued on page 2>>*

<< *Continued from page 1* The yearling and racehorse sale will take place the following week on July 27 and 28.

World thoroughbred auctions, like almost all sectors, have been thrown into chaos due to government-imposed restrictions placed on businesses during the coronavirus pandemic, and there was some doubt about whether stakeholders would be allowed to attend the upcoming Australian breeding stock sales.

The country's last live auction was the Magic Millions March Yearling Sale held at the Gold Coast on March 16 and 17 but the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale was forced into a "virtual" event as was its Chairman's Sale.

The pandemic forced Magic Millions to push its National sale, which last year turned over \$145.84 million, to late July from its traditional late May slot in the hope of allowing vendors and buyers to be on the ground.

"The National sale catalogue shows that the vendors have stuck by our thought process and our willingness to hold a live auction. Their faith and support has been greatly appreciated," Bowditch told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"We've got a CovidSafe plan in place, which we will be abiding by, so there will obviously be some restrictions, but this is a sale where we welcome the participants of our industry to come and support the sale as vendors and buyers. We can't wait to have everyone back here on the Gold Coast."

The Queensland border currently remains closed but the state government, including Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk, have publicly indicated that it will be reopened on July 10, if not sooner.

The Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale Round 2, Australian Weanling Sale, Great Southern and Melbourne Gold Yearling Sale, which were also rescheduled due to coronavirus restrictions, will also be conducted as live auctions next month.

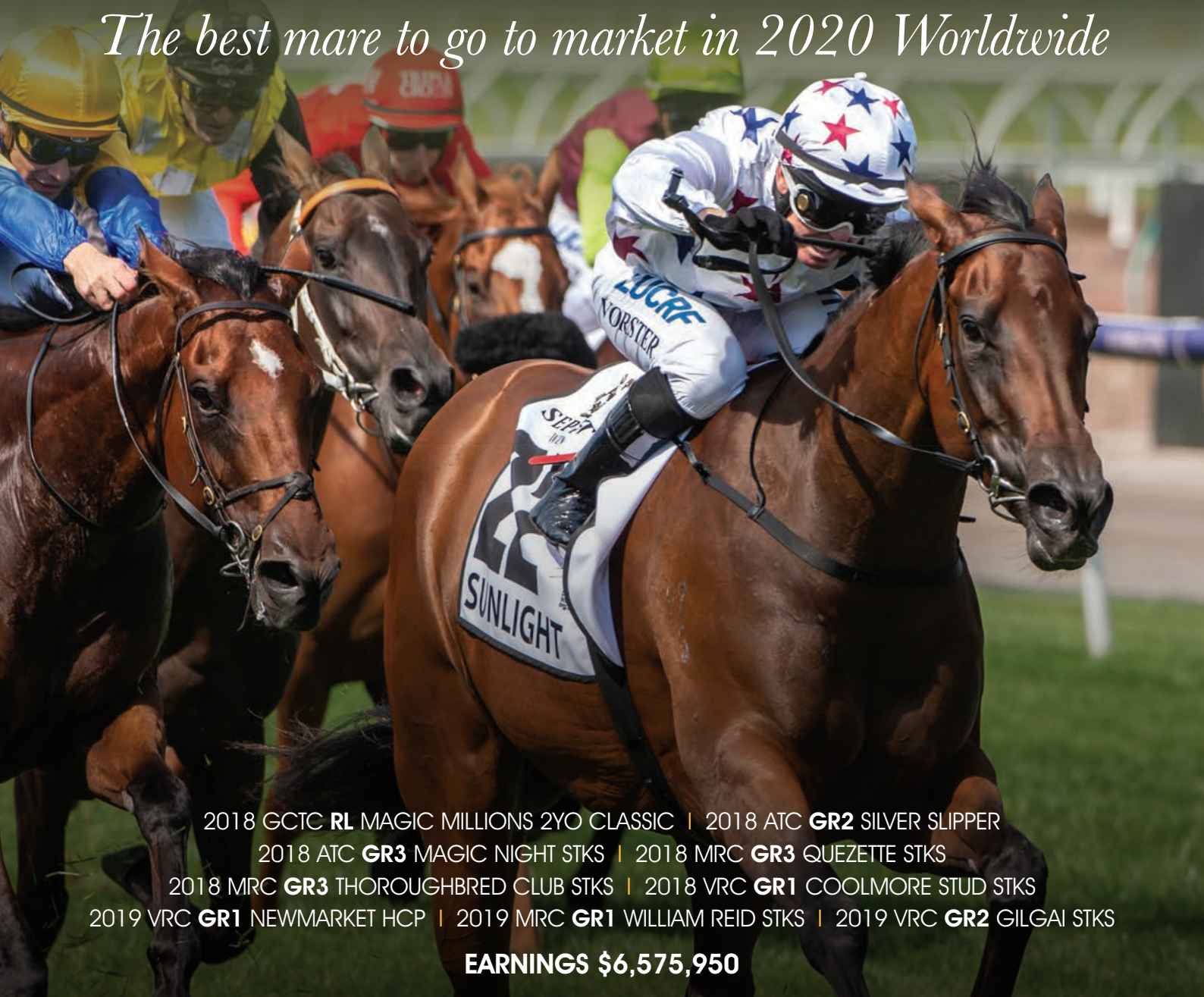

Bowditch said: "There have been a lot of unknowns throughout this period and there's been a lot of waiting games, but with the further clarity that we've got now, it gives us every opportunity to conduct the best auction that we possibly can."

Despite it being almost impossible for international buyers to be in attendance at this year's sale - last year's highest-priced lot Missrock (Fastnet Rock) was sold to the UK - Bowditch expects overseas investors to pay close attention to the 2020 edition.

"Our race fillies section, which will kick off the sale this year, will command huge anticipation globally and a mare like Sunlight is a rarity in the market," Bowditch said. "She's probably one of the most outstanding prospects to go to sale in this part of the world for as long as I can remember."

"To have some great fillies and mares around here with the likes of Invincibella, Unforgotten, Etana, Champagne Cuddles, just to name a few, we're very excited to have them as part of our offering."

The National sale will feature:

- 54 per cent of broodmare lots being either maiden or at first cover;
- Mares on early covers, particularly September, being sold in absentia;
- Large commercial broodmare drafts from Godolphin (49), Willow Park Stud (42), Aquis Farm (38), Widden Stud (34), Bhima Thoroughbreds (28), the Blue Sky Premium Consignment (23) and Baystone Farm (23); and,
- The weanling catalogue will see progeny of 19 first season sires represented including Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock), Hellbent (I Am Invincible), Russian Revolution (Snitzel), Impending (Lonhro), Pariah (Redoute's Choice) and Spieth (Thorn Park)

Among the Godolphin draft highlights will be the half-sister to Alizee (Sepoy) and fellow Group 1 winner and stallion Astern (Medaglia d'Oro) in the unraced Leopard (Animal Kingdom). She is being offered in foal to champion stallion Snitzel (Redoute's Choice).

Skagerrak (Dawn Approach), a half-sister to this season's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Hanseatic (Street Boss), will also be offered by Godolphin in foal to its young shuttle stallion Ribchester (Iffraaj).

"I think the mares in-foal section, on a whole, is fantastic this year. We've got a huge amount of mares on their first and second covers and some extremely young mares such as (Group 1 winner) Viddora who is in foal to Lope De Vega," Bowditch said.

"Having the Baystones and the Willow Parks complementing the Godolphin and other feature drafts ... I think it is a really attractive

catalogue that the buyers can sink their teeth into and take home mares that they can breed out of with confidence."

The delayed National sale has also seen a decline in the number of weanlings offered this year as breeders elect to hold back more of their young stock in the hope of a smoother economic outlook at next year's yearling sales.

"Obviously it's a condensed version given the timing of the sale and the uncertainty behind the market, but the vendors that are supporting this sale have earmarked their best quality stock, as they have in years gone by," he said.

"This will create great opportunities for the buyers whether they be end users or pinhookers looking to trade into the yearling market next year."

Supplementary entries for the broodmare and weanling sessions will be accepted up until 10am on July 6 while the National Yearling Sale catalogue is set to be released in the coming days.

2020 ROYAL ASCOT DAY ONE

Third time lucky for Battaash in King's Stand

Runner-up in the last two editions of the race, Battaash (Dark Angel) finally landed a well-deserved victory in the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) at Royal Ascot yesterday, the fourth elite-level win of his career.

Battaash had finished second to Blue Point (Shamardal) in the race in 2018 and 2019 but with the entire retired to the breeding barn last year, the Shadwell Stud-raced six-year-old was a bridesmaid no more.

Trained by Charlie Hills and ridden by Jim Crowley, Battaash led from point to post and was never challenged, kicking clear in the final furlong to score by two and a quarter lengths.

Stablemate Equilateral (Equiano) was second with Liberty Beach (Cable Bay) a short-head away in third, providing Woodside Park Stud shuttler Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit) with his best result as a sire.

"Fantastic, he was really on his 'A' game today," Hills said. "He was beautifully relaxed before the race and as soon as the gates opened you could see he was going to be very hard to beat."

"He has been quite relaxed in his work at home, until Saturday when he was really quite strong in the first half of the gallop. I think he'd got to the point really when we needed to get a race into him. The race will do him the world of good, we can train him off today.

"It is a real shame that Sheikh Hamdan is not here to witness it, but it's great to finally win a King's Stand with him.

"I was slightly tense, but I've lived every emotion with him now. We have been beaten

here twice before and, three times, I don't think I could have dealt with that.

"He is just an amazing horse. Everyone in the yard is so lucky to have a horse like him - he is the horse of a lifetime. It is not just that, but also the character he has at home.

"Bob [Grace, groom] probably gets a stride slower every year, but the horse now goes at the same pace that Bob does. It is amazing the connection the two have. He might be one of the fastest horses in the world, but he walks so slowly.

"Everyone has done a great job with him at home including Victoria who rides him out.

"I watched the race where no-one could see in the concourse. I just thought thank god for that when he won and that he got the job done."

Among his four Group 1 victories, Battaash has also won the last three editions of the King George Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) at Glorious Goodwood, and Hills said that looks like the likely next target for the star sprinter.

"Obviously we will have to speak with Sheikh Hamdan, but I am really looking forward to going back to Goodwood to try and win the King George there for the fourth time - I think that would be some achievement to do that," the trainer said.

"Battaash has always been pretty good first time out and it would be fantastic if he could come back next year at the age of seven.

"He will obviously have had a race less this year too, so hopefully he is a fresh horse going into the autumn."

As the retained rider for Shadwell, Crowley has formed an incredible association with Battaash having ridden him in 13 of his 21 starts and the jockey was thrilled with the performance.

"Every time he wins, this horse, it feels special, because when he wins, he wins well," Crowley said.

"He was always doing plenty enough with me early on and I was a little bit worried that the stiff uphill finish might find him out, obviously having this first run, but you know, he's a real superstar and he has done the three now - the Abbaye, the Nunthorpe, this and hopefully we're not finished yet.

"He has shown no signs of slowing down that's for sure! It was nice to come here and win and he seems to be getting quicker.

"He has just got so much speed it is just hard to find horses to lead him, you would love to have a tow to the furlong, but it is just not happening!"

Bred in Ireland by Ballyphilip Stud, Battaash (6 g Dark Angel - Anna Law by Lawman) was snapped up by Hamdan Al Maktoum's Shadwell operation for 200,000gns from Book 2 of the 2015 October Yearling Sale - a bargain, relatively speaking, when compared to his seven-figure earnings, boosted by more than his own purchase price yesterday.

A son of Dark Angel (Acclamation) - the

Group 1-winning juvenile who retired to stud at two - Battaash has now won 11 times, accumulating £1,542,758 (AUS\$2.8 million approx) in career prize-money.

The gelding is out of Anna Law (Lawman), who is herself a half-sister to Group 2 winner Etlala (Selkirk) and Bird Key (Cadeaux Genereux) - the dam of fellow Shadwell-raced Group 2 winner Tasleet (Showcasing).

Further back this is the same family as Group 1 winner Braashee (Sadler's Wells) and Group 3-winning pair Adam Smith (Sadler's Wells) and Ghariba (Final Straw).

Battaash is one of seven Group 1 winners for Yeomanstown Stud resident Dark Angel, who is represented at stud in Australia by Darley shuttler Harry Angel.

A winner of the July Cup (Gr 1, 6f) and Haydock Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 6f) Harry Angel will stand at Darley's Kelvinside property in the Hunter Valley for a fee of \$16,500 (inc GST) in 2020.

Dark Angel stood at Yeomanstown in Ireland for a fee of €85,000 (AUS\$139,000 approx) in 2020.

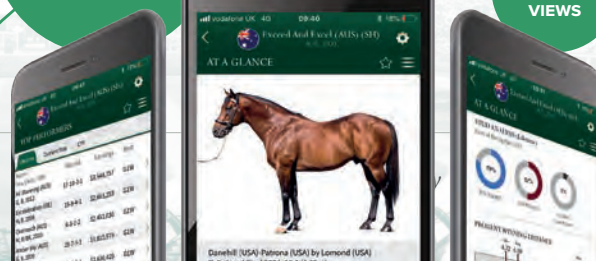

O'Brien, Moore and Max edge out Gosden, Dettori and Terebellum in Queen Anne

The Frankie Dettori and John Gosden partnership looked set for a host of duals against the Ryan Moore and Aidan O'Brien axis this week and the latter came out on top in their first big clash in yesterday's Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) as Circus Maximus (Galileo) lunged on the line to defeat Terebellum (Teofilo).

At his first start in 2020, last year's St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) and Prix du Moulin (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Circus Maximus dictated the tempo of the race and was challenged by Terebellum with two furlongs to go.

The pair then kicked clear of the rest of the field, with the John Gosden-trained and Godolphin-owned filly getting the better of Aidan O'Brien's colt before he fought back and got the bob on the line.

The Mark Johnston-trained Marie's Diamond (Footstepsinthesand) came home a further three lengths away in third.

"We're delighted," O'Brien said. "He's very tough and travels with a lot of speed. Ascot is usually a very busy week for us so it has been brilliant to see all of the preliminaries. We don't usually get to see it when we're at the races.

"I think he's sometimes underestimated but he's very solid. His best form is at a mile, which makes him more valuable and interesting. He loves getting eyeballed and toughs it out really well. He's a very good horse.

"He is a Galileo from a good family and has a great pedigree. He is tough, has pace and is brave - he is a trademark Galileo.

"I think a mile is his trip. The problem is he is lazy and that is why he wears blinkers. It is only when the tempo is really high that he actually races so I think a mile and a quarter and a mile and a half trips don't allow him to focus. So, I would imagine he would stay at a mile.

"Like a fighter, if you don't get his blood up,

he doesn't really bother. The pace of the mile races allows him to get his blood up.

"I would say the Sussex Stakes is the race for him. He is very comfortable racing around a bend."

The son of Galileo's (Sadler's Wells) victory provided the champion Irish trainer with his 71st Royal Ascot win and his fourth in the Queen Anne.

Moore, who was celebrating a 59th Royal Ascot success, said: "He is a very straightforward horse. They had their chance to come and beat him, but he battled away and fought all the way. I am delighted with what he has done today."

Gosden, meanwhile, was pleased with the efforts of his runner-up.

"She ran a great race," he said. "They didn't go any pace which probably played against her as she gets a mile and a quarter. She hit the front and the other one just came back on the run to the line under a rousing ride."

Bred by the Niarchos Family's Flaxman Stables, who also race the colt with Coolmore, Circus Maximus (4 c Galileo - Duntle by Danehill Dancer) has now won five of his 12 career starts, which has allowed connections to

pocket £1,083,049 (AUS\$1.98 million approx) in prize-money.

The son of Galileo is the first foal out of the Flaxman Stables-owned mare Duntle (Danehill Dancer), who won twice at Royal Ascot for David Wachman, with her first victory coming in the Sandringham Handicap (Listed, 1m) in 2012 before she landed the Duke of Cambridge Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) the following year.

Duntle herself is out of the regally-bred Lady Angola (Lord At War), who is herself a blood-sister to Listed winner Lovat's Lady - the dam of fellow Listed winner Chetten County (Giant's Causeway).

Meanwhile, Lady Angola is a three-quarter sister to Grade 1 winners Honor In War and La Gueriere - the latter producing the Grade 2 winner Last Approval (With Approval) and Grade 1 winner Icon Project (Empire Maker), herself the dam of Fashion Business (Frankel).

Lady Angola's other three-quarter siblings include Listed winner Lord Of Warriors and Lady Lochinvar - the dam of Grade 2 winner Master Command (A.P. Indy), Grade 3 winner Aurora Lights (Pulpit) and Listed scorer Street Lad (Street Cry).

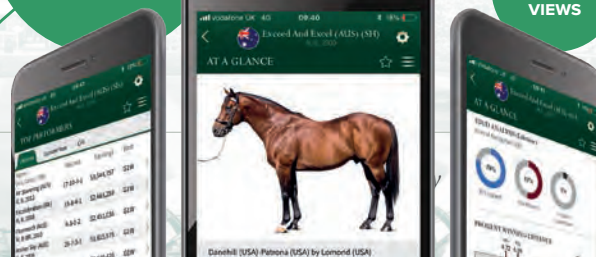

Furthermore, the colt's fourth dam is Lady Winborne (Secretariat), the dam of Grade 1 winner Al Mamoon (Believe It), Group 3 winner Lost Soldier (Danzig) and Born Wild (Wild Again), while the page also features Grade 2 winner Munnings (Speightstown).

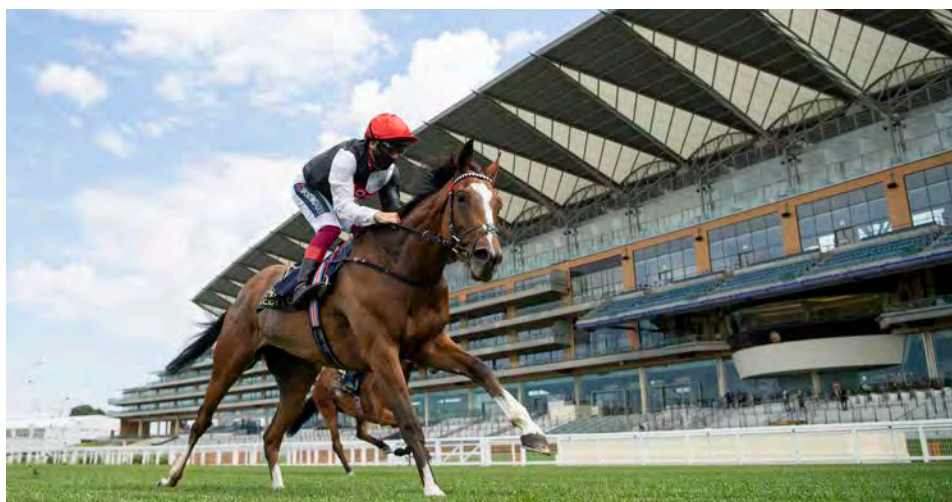
Circus Maximus is one of five Group 1 winners produced on the cross between Galileo and Danehill Dancer (Danehill) mares which runs at 25 per cent stakes winners to runners. Other Group 1 scorers produced on the cross include champion mare Minding, Alice Springs and The Gurkha.

Galileo himself is responsible for 85 individual Group 1 winners, the most of any sire in the world, after breaking Danehill's (Danzig) record when Peaceful took out the Irish 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) last Saturday.

The champion sire stood at Coolmore Ireland for a private fee in 2020.

World feed issue affects Sky and Racing.com

There was widespread uproar last night as, far from the pomp and pageantry of a traditional Royal Ascot, it seemed that Australian viewers were set for limited coverage from the prestigious meeting. Both Sky Thoroughbred Central and Racing.com were supposed to be showing Britain's terrestrial ITV feed, which was due to kick in from the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m), the second race on the card. However, Racing.com was largely silent except for race commentary, while Sky Thoroughbred Central featured static shots, markets and music with little coming through from the track. The backlash was swift, with many prominent Australian racing identities - from Tom Magnier and Nick Williams to Mark Waugh and Peter O'Brien - expressing their disappointment at the coverage. Racing.com tweeted after the Queen Anne: "We are currently experiencing problems with the coverage of Royal Ascot. The feed we are receiving is incorrect and

a new feed is being sent. The correct coverage should be re-established shortly." Within minutes, their feed was fixed, with Sky Thoroughbred Central following about 15 minutes later - just before the third race, the Ribblesdale Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f). Ascot director of racing and public affairs Nick Smith said: "We apologise to all watching remotely for the temporary incorrect feed, which saw Racetechn's clean feed sent instead of the ITV coverage they were promised. This was addressed as quickly as possible."

53 for Frankel

Few horses are associated with the opening day of Royal Ascot like Frankel (Galileo), who won both the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) and the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) on this card. He added a 53rd individual stakes winner yesterday with Frankly Darling's (3 f ex Hidden Hope by Daylami) win in the Ribblesdale Stakes. Frankly Darling, who had won first-up over a mile and a quarter at Newcastle, never looked in much doubt, defeating Ennistymon (Galileo) by a length and three-quarters with Passion (Galileo) a further two and a half lengths away in third. Frankly Darling is a homebred for Anthony Oppenheimer's Hascombe and Valiant Stud, being out of the Listed winner Hidden Hope (Daylami); the Ribblesdale

winner is also a three-quarter sister to stakes-placed Frankellina (Frankel). Frankel stands at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud; his fee was £175,000 in 2020.

Gosden brings up half-century

Thirty years on from his first Royal Ascot winner - Chicarica (The Minstrel) in the 1990 Chesham Stakes (Listed, 7f) - John Gosden made it an even 50 with the Ribblesdale Stakes win of Frankly Darling. "Any time you have a winner here - I can remember during this week scrambling one winner, one year having no winners, having six seconds and finally a winner one year," said Gosden, who made it 51 with Nazeeb (Invincible Spirit) in the Duke Of Cambridge Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) later in the day. "Look, it is not an easy place to win races - as you saw in the Queen Anne." Winning rider Frankie Dettori, who brought up his 68th success at the Royal meeting, said: "It is now 50 winners for John Gosden, who is an amazing trainer. Look, we are racing and the racing is magnificent. Of course we miss the crowd, but we are putting on a show for the people watching at home who are enjoying the races." Frankly Darling is now the general 3-1 second-favourite for the belated Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f), behind 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Love (Galileo).

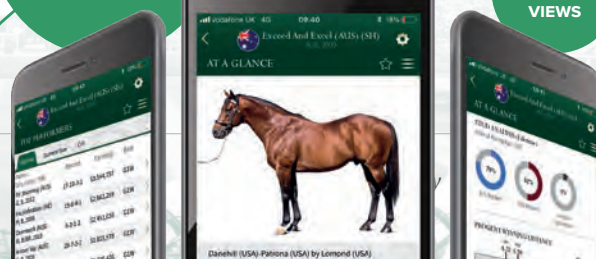

Pyledriver delivers knock-out blow in King Edward shock

Having gone close to posting a seismic shock when 66-1 chance Jack's Point (Slade Power) finished second in the opening Buckingham Palace Handicap (7f), jockey Martin Dwyer and his father-in-law trainer William Muir still managed to produce the biggest upset on day one of Royal Ascot when Pyledriver (3 c Harbour Watch - La Pyle by Le Havre) got the better of his five rivals in the King Edward VII Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f). Sent off at odds of 18-1 after finishing second in a Listed contest on the all-weather at Kempton on his previous start, the colt relished the step up in trip as he galloped on strongly in the closing stages to beat the Aidan O'Brien-trained Arthur's Kingdom (Camelot) by two lengths. The David Simcock's Mohican Heights (Australia) was the same margin away in third with another O'Brien runner in Mogul (Galileo), the brother of last year's King Edward VII winner Japan, finishing a disappointing fourth. The win was a second at Royal Ascot for Muir who said: "I was quite confident he would run a massive race because he's really come to himself in the last few days. He started to spark. He's won really well there today and he can only get better. I'll monitor him and if he does well we'll go for the Derby." The bookmakers reacted by giving the winner quotes of as short as 14-1 to follow up in the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) on July 4. Now successful in three of his six starts, including a Listed race at Haydock at two, Pyledriver is the first foal out of the winning Le Havre (Noverre) mare La Pyle. She herself is a sister to the Group 3 winner Normandel and a half-sister to the Group 1 winner Helene Charisma (Air Chief Marshal).

Crowley and Hamdan treble as Nazeef scores

On what was a big day for Sheikh Hamdan al-Maktoum's Shadwell operation, Nazeef (4 m Invincible Spirit - Handassa by Dubawi) defied a late drift to take the Duke Of Cambridge Stakes

in a tight photo finish. The John Gosden-trained Nazeef, ridden by Jim Crowley, ran down the long-priced Agincourt (Declaration Of War) to win by a short-head, with Queen Power (Shamardal) back in third. Nazeef took her record to five wins from six starts and looks a horse capable of stepping up to Group 1 company in the coming weeks. "It's testament to the owner," said Gosden. "He has many horses in training and a treble on the first day is a great achievement. Nazeef is very genuine and did nothing but improve last year. She deserves a little rest after winning the Listed Snowdrop Fillies' Stakes at Kempton earlier this month and then coming here. We won't rush her back but you'd love to see her have a go at a Group 1." Nazeef is out of the Listed winner Handassa (Dubawi) from the family of Group 1-winning sprinters Pastoral Pursuits (Bahamian Bounty) and Goodricke (Bahamian Bounty).

Shadwell strikes in opener

First blood at Royal Ascot went the way of Shadwell's Motakhayyel (Heeraat) as those horses drawn high in the straight seven-furlong contest dominated the finish of the reinstated Buckingham Palace Handicap (7f). Trained by Richard Hannon, the four-year-old was one of a quartet in the 23-strong field for the owner, but retained rider Jim Crowley proved to have chosen

the right one as his mount scooted up the stands' side rail at odds of 14-1 from stall 26 to beat outsider Jack's Point by a length and a quarter. Another of the Shadwell brigade, Mutamaasik (Dubawi), was a further length and a half away in third, with Cliffs Of Capri (Canford Cliffs) filing fourth spot, another two and a quarter lengths adrift. A 100,000gns purchase at Tattersalls Book 2 Sale in 2017, Motakhayyel is the second foal out of the Elusive Quality (Gone West) mare Virtuality, who is a half-sister to Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) runner-up Retrieve (Rahy) and the Listed-winning pair Abduction (Street Cry) and Reparations (Exceed And Excel).

Hammer times it right as Lion roars in finale

Coeur De Lion (Pour Moi) swooped late and wide under Thore Hammer Hansen to give the apprentice a first win at the Royal meeting when taking out the concluding Ascot Stakes (2m 4f). Lining up in the race for the third consecutive year, the Alan King-trained seven-year-old came from well back in the field to catch Verdane Blue (Getaway) close to the line, denying the favourite by a length. Summer Moon (Sea The Moon) was a neck away in third with Smart Champion (Teofilo), another doing his best work late on to finish a further neck away in fourth spot.

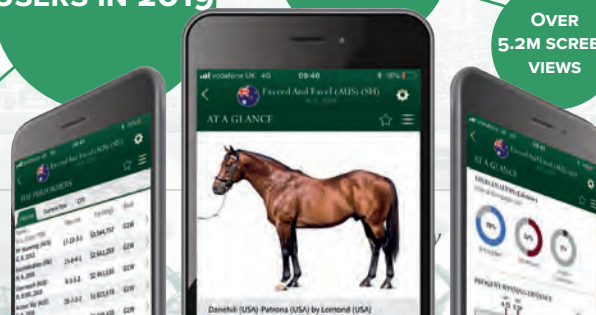

2020 ROYAL ASCOT PREVIEW

Distinct Australian flavour to day two at Royal Ascot

Even with no Australian-trained runners at Royal Ascot this year, the second day of the five-day festival has a strong antipodean flavour, even behind closed doors.

Day two at Royal Ascot this year features a horse coming off two top-level wins down under and the son of a four-time Australian Group 1 winner seeking to stamp his Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) credentials.

Once again, seven races will feature on today's card instead of the usual six, with two new handicaps among the races on offer.

Silver Royal Hunt Cup

One of the new additions to Royal Ascot this year, the Silver Royal Hunt Cup (1m) acts as a consolation for the Royal Hunt Cup (1m) later in the card with those on the cusp of gaining a run instead lining up here.

With just eight handicap points between top-weights Sir Busker (Sir Prancealot) and Home Before Dusk (Medicean) and the one at the bottom, Goring (Areion), it is a very

competitive race on paper and a case could be made for most runners in here.

The veteran So Beloved (Dansili), the outsider of the field, ran well in the Royal Hunt Cup proper last year and is 10 points better in the ratings. He made no impression at Newcastle last start, but this race may prove more suitable and he could cause a shock in a wide-open affair.

Others to consider are Ouzo (Charm Spirit), Maydanny (Dubawi), Presidential (Invincible Spirit) and Ambassadorial (Elusive Quality).

Hampton Court Stakes

Like the King Edward VII Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f) last night, the Hampton Court Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) is in an unusual position this year, shaping as a trial for the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) next month rather than as a stepping stone to races later in the season.

In fact, two of the last three winners raced in Australia more than a year after their success in the Hampton Court Stakes, with Benbatl (Dubawi) winning the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and finishing second to Winx (Street Cry) in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and Hunting

Horn (Camelot) taking out last year's Moonee Valley Cup (Gr 2, 2500m).

Other winners have included Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Glass Harmonium (Verglas) and Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) winner Collection (Peintre Celebre).

This year, all Australian eyes will be on Russian Emperor (Galileo), with Atlantic Jewel's (Fastnet Rock) son looking to score a first stakes win after striking defeat as favourite in the Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial (Gr 3, 1m 2f) last week.

At Leopardstown, Cormorant (Kingman) was just able to control things in front under Padraig Beggy and Russian Emperor still ran well without taking victory. With a run under his belt, he looks capable of stamping himself as a legitimate Classic contender here.

The Queen will be hoping to celebrate a unique Royal Ascot victory - one in which she is not trackside - with First Receiver (New Approach), while Juan Elcano (Frankel), New World Tapestry (War Front) and Kenzai Warrior (Karakontie) all come out of the 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) at Newmarket; as the market suggests, Juan Elcano is the one to beat after his fifth to Kameko (Kitten's Joy).

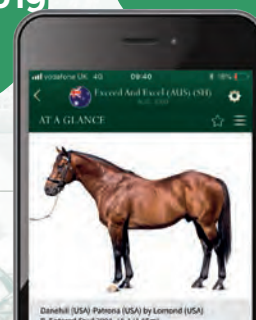

King George V Stakes

Ever since the King George V Stakes (1m 4f) winner went on to place in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) two years in a row - with Give The Slip (Slip Anchor) and Beekeeper (Rainbow Quest) - the handicap has been a happy hunting ground for Australian owners and for potential raiders down under.

Winners like Fantastic Love (Peintre Celebre) and Dandino (Dansili) went on to take out the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2500m) on the final day of the Melbourne Cup Carnival, while the race has also produced the likes of Melbourne Cup winner Cross Counter (Teofilo) as well as Australian stakes winners like Dwindraft (Camelot), Homesman (War Front), Shraaoh (Sea The Stars), Arab Dawn (Dalakhani) and Spillway (Rail Link) in recent years.

Last year, eventual Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) favourite Constantinople (Galileo) was beaten a neck in this event.

Therefore, it stands to reason that this race will be watched closely by bloodstock agents on both sides of the world.

Perhaps this is the race for the well-named Bodyline (Australia) to stamp himself as a stayer of the future.

The Sir Mark Prescott-trained Bodyline performed well at his first start beyond 7f last start, staying on for second at Yarmouth behind Celestran (Dansili). He should relish the mile and a half and he looks well-weighted here.

Other sons of Australia (Galileo) in Win O'Clock and Convict look strong players too, while Trumpet Man (Golden Horn) - the half-brother to Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Polarisation (Echo Of Light) - steps out as a first-time gelding and he represents the Mark Johnston yard, which has won this race six times since 1995.

Prince Of Wales's Stakes

Addeybb (Pivotal) could potentially create history by adding the Prince Of Wales's Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) to his victories in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in Sydney during the autumn.

In a normal year, it would be difficult to see a horse returning from Australia to win the middle-distance highlight of Royal Ascot, but in a year where most of his rivals are lacking for a proper preparation, perhaps he will be able to take benefit for being able to race through the first few months of 2020.

Japan (Galileo) is a logical odds-on favourite and it's hard to argue his position at the top of the market. Although he was able to stretch out to a mile and a half last season, it wouldn't surprise if a mile and a quarter ends

up being his best trip this season. However, he did take time to find form last preparation and it seems likely that could be the case again as a four-year-old.

Cambridgeshire Handicap (1m 1f) winner Lord North (Dubawi) has always shown promise but, on his return victory in the Brigadier Gerard Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) at Haydock, he looks capable of making an impact at the highest level this season. Whether it is here remains to be seen, but he's worthy of consideration at a decent price.

There is also an Australian link through the John Gosden-trained Mehdaayih (Frankel), who races in the colours of Emirates Park. On the basis of her runs last year, she'd be best suited with the ground remaining good-to-soft - anything beyond that and she may struggle.

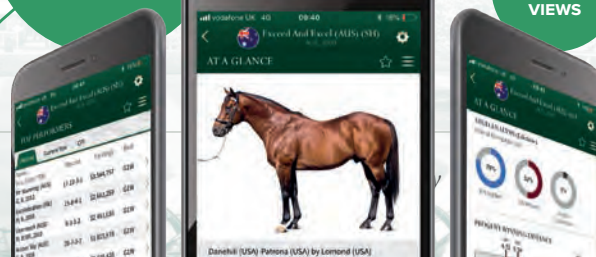

Royal Hunt Cup

The feature mile handicap of Royal Ascot is the Royal Hunt Cup (1m). Normally featuring 30 runners, this year the field size has been reduced to 24.

It is a race where it is worth looking away from the market fancies and it wouldn't surprise to see outsider Baltic Baron (Shamardal) bounce back here. On a similar mark last year, he ran a decent fifth over a mile at Goodwood behind Golden Eagle (1500m) sixth Beat Le Bon (Wootton Bassett). He has mixed his form since but if he can produce that run with no weight on his back, he can surprise.

Last year's winner Afaak (Oasis Dream) has a good record in this race and, with Cieren Fallon's three-pound claim, is not without claims, while Bell Rock (Kingman), Fox Power (Dark Angel) and the lightly-raced Lord Tennyson (Poet's Voice) are other contenders.

Windsor Castle Stakes

The first of the juvenile races at this year's Royal Ascot, the Windsor Castle Stakes (Listed, 5f), sees American trainer Wesley Ward send out two contenders in Sunshine City (Creative Cause) and Sheriff Bianco (Speightster).

Ward has struck success by bringing across precocious horses with speed the likes of which the locals simply haven't seen or experienced. Horses like Strike The Tiger (Tiger Ridge) and Hootenanny (Quality Road) have won this race for the American before.

However, Ward hasn't had the same success stateside this season, with his usual starting point - the Keeneland spring meet - being postponed until July. He has instead been preparing most of them from Gulfstream and the different training regimes have wreaked havoc with his juvenile crop.

Instead, it may be worth looking towards Chief Little Hawk (Air Force Blue) as he looks to

give his first-season sire a maiden stakes winner. The colt, who is out of American Grade 1 winner Marylebone (Unbridled's Song), appeared the ultimate professional when winning on debut at Navan and looks capable of making his mark very quickly.

Copper Horse Handicap

Another new addition for 2020, the Copper Horse Handicap (1m 6f) looks a potential stepping stone for Melbourne Cup contenders, should they be able to make the trip later in the year.

Late Melbourne Cup winner Dunaden (Nicobar) is represented by four-year-old Ranch Hand, while owner Ronald Arculli - best known for his gallant globetrotter Red Cadeaux (Cadeaux Genereux) - has two entrants in Amazing Red (Teofilo) and Here And Now (Dansili).

However, the most likely winner - and potentially the horse with the best Melbourne Cup credentials, should he remain sound - is the Roger Varian-trained Fujaira Prince (Pivotal).

He's only had six starts as a six-year-old, but his efforts last season - which culminated in a good third in the Duke Of Edinburgh Handicap (1m 4f) - suggested he could make a nice handicapper later in the term.

Fujaira Prince didn't race again in 2019, but he will have every chance to make up for lost time this season, likely pushing towards the £1 million Ebor (1m 6f) at York before a Melbourne Cup bid is considered.

He can begin his 2020 on a high here.

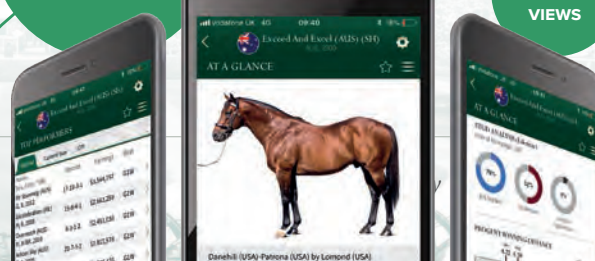

11 for Spill The Beans

The late Spill The Beans (Snitzel) extended his dominance as the leading first season sire by number of winners when Little Miss Pixie (2 f ex Pixie Miss by Lucky Unicorn) won at Toowoomba yesterday. Trained by Tony and Maddysen Sears, Little Miss Pixie took the 1110-metre handicap by a neck over Dragon Miss (Hidden Dragon) with a length and a half back to Five Oxford (Golden Archer) in third. Spill The Beans died in November 2019, having served four books of mares at Aquis Farm.

Six for Headwater

Vinery Stud's Headwater (Exceed And Excel) recorded his sixth individual winner yesterday when Ashra Jahre (2 f ex Jahre by Encosta De Lago) broke through against the older horses at Nowra. Tested in the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at her first start, she finished midfield on the Kensington track and at Canberra in her second preparation before returning a winner over 1000 metres yesterday. Sent out as a hot favourite, she defeated another two-year-old in Titan Star (Rubick) by three-quarters of a length with six-year-old Gullen Glory (Laguna De Bay) a further three lengths away in third. Headwater will stand for \$13,750 (inc GST) in the upcoming season.

Creswick beckons for Hi Stranger

Trainer Shane Fliedner will drop Hi Stranger (Zoffany) back to the 1200 metres of Saturday's A R Creswick Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Flemington with an eye to giving the three-year-old numerous options on Winter Finals Day next month. Fliedner will either step the

gelding out over 1200 metres or 1600 metres at Flemington's feature winter meeting and he says that it makes sense to be running over the shorter trip at this juncture. "The 1200 metres down the straight is about the same as a 1400-metre race," Fliedner said. "It seemed to be the logical race to run him in. He's been thereabouts in shorter races and he goes alright down the straight. There was no speed in the race last time which didn't work for him at all and he was probably badly weighted as well. He's no superstar but he's a handy little horse who should be around the mark."

Corstens filly to back up at Flemington

Kalkarni Royale (Nicconi) is set to back up in Saturday's Creswick after pleasing her trainer Kevin Corstens with her recovery from her dominant weekend win at Moonee Valley. Corstens said the Creswick Stakes had always been an option for the filly who, after arriving in his care with some minor knee issues, has benefited from working on the beach. "She came through the run super, she's eaten really well in the last two days and she was on her toes down at the beach this morning so she's really bouncing out of her skin," Corstens told Racing.com. "You only get one Creswick a year for the three-year-olds so it seemed like the choice for her. I think she's definitely a progressive filly and it wouldn't be out of the question for her to be very competitive in stakes grade."

Edmonds team loses two stable stars

Gold Coast trainer Toby Edmonds, has confirmed two of his best young horses will leave his stables. The Drinks Cart

(Unencumbered), who ran third in the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m) two weeks ago is headed for Hong Kong, while Wisdom of Water (Headwater), who was unplaced in the JJ Atkins after winning two races this campaign, will be prepared by Mick Price and Michael Kent jnr in Melbourne for the spring. Edmonds, who trains in partnership with his son Trent, was philosophical about the decisions. "It was the owners' calls and they are entitled to do what they want," Edmonds said. "The Drinks Cart will be vetted on Thursday and if he passes he will go to Hong Kong to be trained, I understand, by Tony Cruz. Wisdom of Water will head south. He is now part-owned by Aquis who are looking at him as a sire later in his career."

Harbour Views to have one more winter start

Matthew Williams is planning to give Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) hopeful Harbour Views (Le Havre) one more start this winter in a bid to improve his rating ahead of a spring campaign. Harbour Views raced to an impressive win at Moonee Valley on Saturday and Williams is now targeting the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) on September 5 to try to gain the import a Cox Plate ballot exemption. After Saturday's win, Harbour Views' rating has risen from 88 to 94, which Williams believes should be high enough to get him into the Feehan, but he does not want to take any chances of being balloted out so he will run the five-year-old on Saturday week at Caulfield. "Last year he would have got a run in the Feehan but you just don't know," Williams said. "Because we've got a bit of time we're going to go to Caulfield on Saturday week in a 2000-metre open handicap with a view of getting his rating up a bit more."

Covid protocols to ease for NSW riders

Restrictions on where New South Wales-based jockeys can ride across the state are soon to be lifted with a further easing of Covid-19 protocols. Racing NSW announced yesterday that effective from July 1 the jockey zones in NSW would be removed, allowing all NSW-based jockeys to ride at any meeting across the state. In late March, NSW-based jockeys had to choose which of three specified zones - metropolitan, north or south/west - they would ride in as part of the protocols in place for racing in the state during the Covid-19 pandemic. The current protocols for interstate jockeys or those who have travelled back from an interstate jurisdiction will remain in place. Riders will still have to adhere to a number of raceday protocols including temperature checks and maintaining social distancing. Jockeys will also remain segregated on race day from trainers and other racecourse attendees.

SA sets date for return of spectators

The South Australian Jockey Club is preparing to allow racegoers back on track at Morphettville for the first time since the Covid-19 shutdown at their meeting scheduled for July 18. Under current guidelines the venue has a capacity of 300 people, however, it is likely that from June 29 there will be no overall capacity, provided the 4 metre square per person rule is adhered to. "It has been decided after discussions with Thoroughbred Racing South Australia and other Industry bodies the meetings on July 18 and the following week July 25 will be somewhat of a soft opening," chief executive Grant Mayer told Racing.com. "These race dates will be limited access events for industry stakeholders and members. We are also considering having owners on track in a separate area for these two days, but they are very much part of our plan moving forward beyond July."

Big spring ahead for Brandenburg

John Sargent is eyeing some lofty spring targets with Brandenburg (Burgundy) following a three-year-old season in which he won the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) as well as placing in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m). Connections

have knocked back some sizeable offers for the New Zealand-bred colt and he is now being prepared for what could be a lucrative spring. "I think he will be a different horse in the spring," Sargent told Sky Sports Radio. "You will see him up with the big boys because he has matured a lot to make up that sort of gap between three and four. He will probably kick-off in the Winx Stakes at Randwick." Although Brandenburg has only been tested up to a mile, Sargent believes he could possibly handle the longer trip of the Cox Plate. "We only went to a mile, but I think he would get 2000 metres."

Maher and Eustace fined for positive swab

Ciaron Maher and David Eustace have been fined \$7,500 by the Victorian Racing Tribunal after one of their horses returned a positive swab following a victory at Sale. Piccatric (Fastnet Rock) won a maiden race on February 28 before returning a positive test for Furosemide, a diuretic. Furosemide is permitted in racing but must not be in a horse's system come race day. Ciaron Maher Racing issued a statement saying the VRT had taken into account the stable's guilty plea and training history in issuing the fine. "We accept the findings of the Victorian Racing Tribunal hearing," the statement said. "While the incident is regrettable, we are pleased that the tribunal has acknowledged the role of human error and the measures that have been implemented to prevent a reoccurrence." Piccatric was disqualified as the winner of the race at Sale and is eligible to race again in maiden company.

Feel The Rush heading to Maher and Eustace

New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) third Feel The Rush (Proisir) is set to continue her career with Ciaron Maher and David Eustace following a deal which has seen the former buy a 60 per cent share of the filly. Bloodstock agent Will Bourne, who brokered the agreement told Racing.com: "She's out of a Zabeel mare and in the back of my mind her target might be the Sydney Cup. She looks a genuine two-miler, but we've got all the time in the world for her to develop. Etah James won the race this year as a seven-year-old. These Kiwis just keep getting better with age so we're in no big rush. But it's good to have

a horse that's landed in Australia, had six weeks of pre-training and is ready for the spring." Feel The Rush won three of her 12 starts for training partners Kelvin and Aimee Tyler.

NEW ZEALAND

Richards eyes Melbourne spring

New Zealand trainer Jamie Richards may have lost Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) but he still has a strong contingent gearing up for the spring. Te Akau Shark remained in Sydney after the autumn carnival with stablemates Melody Belle (Commands) and Probabeel (Savabeel) but requires surgery for an eye injury. Melody Belle and Probabeel have returned to work in Sydney under the care of Te Akau Racing's Ashely Handley, and Richards said their early progress would determine a spring path. "They'll be nominated for the Cox Plate and we'll see how they come up," Richards told RSN. "They'll probably trial in Sydney and then we'll make a bit of a plan for when they head down to Melbourne. Whether they have a run in Sydney first or whether we think they're better to go and get settled in and race exclusively in Melbourne, we're not entirely sure yet."

Waimate couple enjoying online challenge

Anna Miles and Michael Simpson of Pear Tree Farm are looking forward to Sunday when their two weanling colts go under the virtual hammer in New Zealand Bloodstock's Weanling Sale on plus.gavelhouse.com. "We have been really lucky because we drew lot 1 with the Proisir colt out of Joan's Girl," Miles said. "He is a lovely, kind, strong, well conformed horse. He is a full-brother to a filly we sold through the South Island Sale a couple of years ago called Harlow who was a winner on debut as a two-year-old for Te Akau. She is back in work and looking like she is going to have a really nice season ahead of her." Miles said there has also been plenty of interest in the farm's other weanling offering, lot 47, the Belardo (Lope De Vega) colt out of Darci Brahma (Danehill) mare Works Wonders. "Belardo has been super exciting. Over the last week he has had four debut winners in Europe from his first crop. The timing has just been perfect for this sale."

ASIA

Prize-money increases for Group 1 events

Hong Kong racing will offer record prize money of HK\$1.4 billion (AUS\$261 million approx) for the 2020/21 season, with the Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) featuring prominently among the Hong Kong Jockey Club's upward adjustments revealed yesterday. The Hong Kong Sprint will regain its position as the world's most richly-endowed Group 1 turf sprint with a value this year of HK\$22 million, an increase of HK\$2 million. Five other Group 1 races – Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m), Stewards' Cup (Gr 1, 1600m), Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (Gr 1, 1400m), Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) – will receive HK\$2 million increases, taking their value to HK\$12 million.

Hong Kong Derby soars in value

Also receiving a prize-money boost is the historic Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m), Hong Kong's most important domestic contest. It will be

worth HK\$24 million, a HK\$4 million increase on the 2020 renewal. The 2000-metre contest is a key race each year, being a vital springboard for the next crop of Hong Kong's stars, and regains its position as the second-richest Derby in the world, behind only Japan's equivalent, the Tokyo Yushun (Gr 1, 2400m) and ahead of the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f), the UAE Derby (Gr 2, 1900m) and the original Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Epsom. The Hong Kong Derby is the final leg in the three-race Four-Year-Old Classic Series and the Hong Kong Jockey Club has also taken the decision to up prize-money for the first two legs: the Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) and Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) will both be worth HK\$12 million in 2021, an increase of HK\$2 million to each race.

INTERNATIONAL

First for Vadamos

Rich Hill Stud shuttle stallion Vadamos (Monsun) secured his first win as a sire when Sa Pala Umbrossa (2f ex Grain de Beaute, by Lawman) won on debut at Chilivani in Italy on Monday. Trained

by Antonio Cottu, she beat Lory Di Toni (Adaay) by two and three-quarter lengths with Capo Testa (Duel) another six and a half lengths away in third. Vadamos' first crop led the way at New Zealand Bloodstock's National Yearling Sale earlier this year with 31 of his yearlings selling for a total of \$3.1 million in the Book 1 and 2 sessions, at an average of \$101,550, crowning him as the leading first season sire by average. He will return to Rich Hill Stud this coming breeding season where he will stand for a fee of NZ\$15,000 (plus GST).

147 for Shamardal

An all the way win in Monday's Prix Etalon (Listed, 2000m) at Le Lion-Dangers by Half Light (4f ex Northern Melody by Singspiel) provided Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) was his 147th individual stakes winner. The Godolphin four-year-old, who was having her fifth career start, beat No Tinc Por (Authorized) by a neck with Thalyia (Motivator) the same margin away in third. Half Light is the eighth foal out of the Singspiel (In The Wings) mare Northern Melody, an unraced half-sister to Prix du Jockey-Club (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Anabaa Blue (Anabaa).

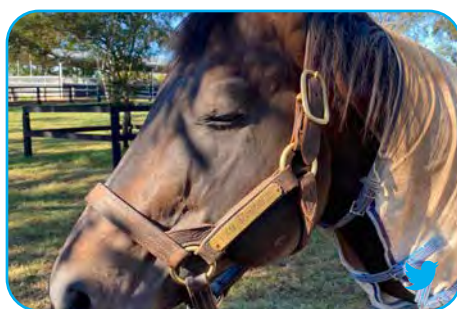

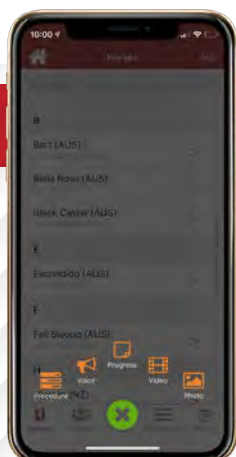

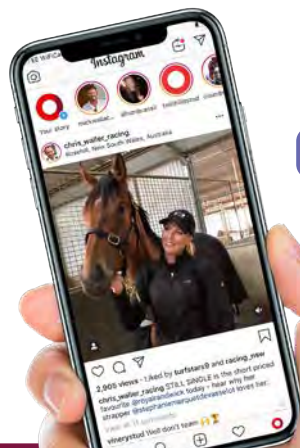
