Booming finish to Western Australian auction with two six-figure lots

Parnham happy to be Playing God on day two of Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale

he popularity of emerging stallion Playing God (Blackfriars), the sire of this season's Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) winner Kay Cee, was on show on the final day of the recordbreaking Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale, with the three of the four highest-priced lots by the Western Australian sire.

Neville Parnham, the trainer of Playing God

and his best-performed offspring in Kay Cee, came away with a colt by the Mungrup-based stallion for \$140,000 and a filly for \$90,000 in the Book 2 session where the aggregate of \$3.923 million was up a staggering 69 per cent year on year.

Fellow Perth trainer Dan Morton also parted with \$90,000 to secure a colt by the Blackfriars (Danehill) stallion yesterday, in a session that was significantly up on last year's corresponding session.

Hanseatic draws barrier one for Diamond

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Hanseatic (Street Boss) has drawn barrier one for Saturday's \$1.5 million feature but connections of the Anthony Freedman-trained colt were hoping to land a wider alley. "He is probably better drawn out a little bit," assistant trainer Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "But he drew two in the (Blue Diamond) Prelude and managed to get himself out of trouble. I'm not sure much more could have gone wrong in the Prelude and he still won." The second favourite for the race, Rulership (I Am Invincible) has drawn well with barrier seven, while Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 2, 1100m) winner Letzbeglam (Snitzel) will jump from Morning Briefing page 7 >>

<< Continued from page 1 A colt by So You Think (High Chaparral), who also had a filly make \$170,000 on day one, made \$110,000 to the bid of trainer Paul Jordan, becoming the second highest-priced yearling sold yesterday.</p>

The larger Book 1 session, held on Monday, was also up year on year while yesterday's trade came in well above 2019, with the average of \$31,894 up 41 per cent where the most expensive price in Book 2 was \$60,000.

There were 14 yearlings to make \$60,000 or more with the suggestion that Books 1 and 2 be combined in future years as local, national and international investors embraced the Perth sale.

Parnham, understandably, has an affinity with Playing God and his progeny and was pleased to be able to land the \$140,000 colt after missing out on the \$150,000 brother to his four-time winner Platoon, a winner of \$442,659 in prize-money.

"Most of the (Playing Gods) were in on the second day of the sale and I guess at the time that was where their pedigrees suggested they go but they are beautiful types," Parnham said.

"The one I really loved was the one out of Reillyanne. I race his full-brother with Bob Pearson and a few other clients and he is a much nicer horse than him and he really replicated Playing God himself.

"I was pretty keen to get hold of him and I actually liked him better than Platoon's brother and I was under bidder on him.

"This guy I felt he was the pick of the Playing Gods."

Offered by Mungrup Stud as **Lot 260**, the colt is the fifth foal out of the O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Reillyanne who is a half-sister to the Group 3 winner Pump Up The Volume (Savabeel) and a sister to the stakes-placed New Zealander Vera Pro Gratis.

The colt's brother, the mare's only foal to race, won recently at Pinjarra to break his maiden for Parnham.

Parnham also bought Lot 238 from the Mungrup Stud draft, with the filly the first foal out of the 1000-metre winner Mosstiara (Mossman).

She in turn is a half-sister to the Group 3 winner Kencella (Exceed And Excel) and the stakes-placed Bontiara. Another half-sister, Rubitawny (Rubiton), is the dam of Perth Listed winner Misty Metal (Oratorio).

Parnham bought five yearlings yesterday for a total of \$333,500 to go with the seven lots he purchased on Monday for a further \$637,500.

Morton lands first Playing God yearling

Meanwhile, Dan Morton struck first for a yearling by Playing God for \$90,000, having watched on as the sire started to make his mark, predominantly in his home state, with his now four and three-year-olds.

Group 1-winning trainer Morton thought the colt was worthy of being in Book 1 and was delighted to be welcoming the colt into his Ascot stable.

"He was one of my top picks and I was surprised that he wasn't in on day one but he has obviously come a long way since they did the catalogue selection," Morton told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"I haven't had one by Playing God yet, so he will be my first to go around. He is off to a flying start at stud and they are presenting really well as yearlings, so I needed to have one."

The colt is a half-brother to recent winner Alaskan Aura (Oratorio) while his dam Lady Alaska (Reset) is a half-sister to the Group 2 winner and Group 1-performed Great Glen (Regal Classic). He was catalogued as Lot 226 and consigned by Mungrup Stud.

"He is out of a young mare, so most of them are still yet to hit the track, but I thought he was a cracking type," Morton said.

"He is a big strong thing that might take a little bit of time but he was a classic sort of horse I thought."

Playing God's nine Book 2 yearlings averaged \$70,389 while two sold in Book 1 for \$150,000 and \$50,000 respectively.

"It's been a really fantastic sale and not just for us, but for the whole WA industry in general," Mungrup Stud's Gray Williamson said.

"To see the Playing God progeny so well received was fantastic. He's a former sale graduate and now his yearlings are proving popular in the sale ring."

Ready to run traders also came to the fore on the second and final day of the Perth sale, with a colt by first season sire Awesome Rock (Fastnet Rock), likely to be bound for an eastern state two-year-old sale.

Dean Harvey from Victorian operation Baystone Farm went to \$85,000 in partnership with Troy Corstens' Malua Bloodstock to secure the colt by the Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m)-winning sire son of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) who was consigned by Gold Front Thoroughbreds.

Catalogued as Lot 222, the colt is a half-brother to three winners including dual juvenile scorer Amarillo Rose (Slater) and is the sixth foal

out of the winning mare Kezzabelle (Zabeel). He is also from the same family as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethiscity).

Corstens and his father Leon trained Awesome Rock to win four races and more than \$2 million in prize-money during his racing career and the Flemington-based horseman was pleased to secure a first crop son.

"I have been really impressed with them. He has really thrown a really good style of horse with good bone on them with a little bit of class, so it was good to come over and see them," Corstens said.

"I really loved the colt who sold to Shane Nichols (on Monday) as well and I rated them nearly equal, so when the Kezzabelle was in today I was quite happy because I thought we'd get him at a discount and we did."

Corstens also bought a filly by Awesome Rock and a colt by Rommel (Commands) for \$40,000 yesterday.

Baystone Farm sold colts for \$220,000, \$200,000 and \$170,000 at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs in Training Sale and another colt, by Vancouver (Medaglia d'Oro), for \$250,000 at the Inglis Ready 2 Race Sale

Another colt by Awesome Rock is also set to be offered at the two-year-old sales after making \$57,500 early in the second session of the Western Australian auction.

Also consigned by Gold Front Thoroughbred Breeding and Racing, the Lot 189-catalogued yearling is the first foal out of the three-time winning Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) mare Double Jester and was purchased by trader Roger Cooksley.

\$110,000 So You Think caps satisfying sale for Mogumber Park



Lot 283 So You Think - Steps To Stardom colt

The Mogumber Park-offered So You Think colt, one of two yearlings to reach six figures yesterday, is the first foal out of the twice-winning mare Steps To Stardom (Stratum) who is a half-sister to Group 3 winner Pillar Of Hercules (Rock Of Gibraltar).

Catalogued as **Lot 283**, the colt's third dam is the Listed-winning, Group 1-placed mare Fitting (Marscay), the dam of Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Catbird (Danehill) and his Group 2-winning brother Danbird.

Mogumber Park's Colin Brown admitted the colt had developed a lot since the Magic Millions bloodstock team conducted their initial inspections in September and was optimistic about strong competition eventuating for the colt.

"He has changed a lot since then so that is certainly in defence of those who inspected him but he is furnishing into a really lovely colt," Brown told ANZ Bloodstock News.

The \$110,000 price tag was a handy return for the owner of Steps To Stardom after agent Damon Gabbedy of Belmont Bloodstock purchased the mare in foal to So You Think for \$52,000 at the 2018 Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale.

"When we looked at her at the sale in Sydney we asked Damon, 'how much do we pay for this mare?' and he said, 'as much as you can'. He really liked her, so we bought her to go to our stallions," Brown said.

"He is a first foal and he is a big, strong horse, so we could not be happier."

Mogumber Park's first season sire Rommel, a WA Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) and Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner, was also well received by the market, with 13 lots selling across the two books at an average of \$41,923.

"Overall, our new sire on the block Rommel sold really well. They have gone to all the good trainers here and one has gone to Victoria as well and Safeguard has stood up again," he said.

Brown saw this year's Perth sale as a step forward for the Western Australian breeding industry and suggested that there may not be the need for a Book 2 session in future given the depth of yesterday's market.

"With our sale, there has been a lot of discussion in the past few days saying, 'we are selling 300-odd yearlings, do we need to have two books?' because it puts the pressure on those making the selections to have day one and day two when actually when some of the day two horses sell really, really well," he pondered.

"Maybe we only need one book which has been some of the discussion going around."

Brown also praised the WA buyers for the way they supported their local sale, which led to a Book 2 clearance rate of 87 per cent.

"The biggest worry is always the second day because we are looking more at the local market only, so there is always a bit of nervousness, but the local market stood up," he said.

"The gross out of this will be up significantly on last year, the clearance rate

will be strong, so Magic Millions and the vendors will be really happy with the outcome here.

"I think we have stepped up a bit, which is great."

Mogumber Park had six yearlings sell yesterday for an average of \$43,667 while the stud had nine yearlings sell in Book 1 to a top of \$130,000.

 $\label{thm:managing} \mbox{ Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch was "delighted" with the outcome of yesterday's sale.}$

"Vendors have brought great horses, presented them well and the local buyers have got in behind the sale, supported the Westspeed product and, rightly so, with the prize-money they race for," Bowditch said last night.

"Today we had a clearance rate over 85 per cent, which is sensational, the gross went up \$1.5 million on last year to \$3.9 million and for the sale to gross \$13 million overall, up from \$9.3 last year, we couldn't be happier."

The clearance rate for Book 1 sale, which saw the War Chant (Danzig) half-sister to Group 2-winning mare Quilista (Scandal Keeper) top the session at \$240,000 on Monday, had climbed to 78 per cent last night at an average of \$69,278.

The Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale will be held next Monday in Launceston before the build-up begins to the following week's Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

Royal capable of Oakleigh Plate upset

Ciaron Maher believes All Too Royal (All Too Hard) is capable of causing an Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) boilover at Caulfield on Saturday. The five-year-old gelding, who won the Christmas Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield on Boxing Day, was third behind Anaheed (Fastnet Rock) and Bold Star (Needs Further) at his most recent start in the Rubiton Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) on February 8. "If Anaheed goes to the Oakleigh Plate we'll meet her better at the weights and I think it will swing in our favour," Maher told Racing.com. "The way he looks and the way that he's working, he could be the little smoky in the race."

Bons Away also set for Group 1 sprint

The training partnership of Ciaron Maher and David Eustace will also be represented by the ever-consistent Bons Away (Bon Hoffa) in the Oakleigh Plate after the six-year-old did enough when fourth first-up in the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on February 1. "It was a really good run the other day, he was wide the whole way and his ratings were actually pretty

good from the race," Maher said. "He's a big, strong, round horse, that run will really bring him on and his work (Monday) morning was sharp." Bons Away has finished fifth and fourth respectively in the last two editions of the Oakleigh Plate.

Bieg confident about Free Of Debt

South Australian trainer Chris Bieg does not see a lack of race experience counting against three-year-old Free Of Debt (Unencumbered) in the Oakleigh Plate. Free Of Debt will be having his sixth start in Saturday's 1100-metre scamper at Caulfield, but that is offset by the minimum weight of 50 kilograms. A ligament issue to a hind leg kept Free Of Debt out of the spring but he showed he had returned in good order when finishing second in the Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on February 1. "He worked with one of Mick Price's and sat a couple of lengths off it (at Caulfield)," Bieg said yesterday. "He really worked through the line and got his head in front, nice solid work and what I wanted to see from him. But just past the line, in true Free Of Debt style, he did a bit wrong. He jumped a shadow and pulled up quite quickly. He's still a playful colt and so well within himself and fresh at the moment, but I'm happy to see that."

Kolding and Melody Belle work at Caulfield

Two of the top three market contenders for the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield have had their first look at the track ahead of the race. New Zealand mare Melody Belle (Commands), with Paul Richards in the saddle, teamed with a member of the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace stable for a familiarisation

gallop at Caulfield ahead of Saturday's race. The Chris Waller-trained Kolding (Ocean Park), with Glen Boss aboard, worked with stablemate Kings Will Dream (Casamento), ridden by Mark Zahra, in an important hit-out at Caulfield ahead of his first Victorian start. Melody Belle holds favouritism for Saturday's Group 1 race at \$2.80 while Kolding is on the third line at \$3.50 with Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Super Seth (Dundeel) splitting the pair at \$3.

Santa Ana Lane third in trial

The Anthony Freedman-trained Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) has taken another step towards defending his TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) title with a third-placed finish in a barrier trial at Werribee yesterday. "Santa was good this morning," assistant trainer Sam Freedman said. "He just blew out a bit late, so he'll need another jump-out which might be at Rosehill next Tuesday and then he might resume in the Challenge Stakes on Newmarket day. That's only over 1000 metres, so he probably can't win it, but he's right where we want him at the moment. The TJ is his aim again, so he's still got a long way to go."

Prime Star sidelined

Last week's \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) winner Prime Star (Starspangledbanner) will not race again this season. The Michael and Richard Freedmantrained gelding has been diagnosed with a bone chip in a knee and will undergo surgery to have it removed on Friday. The \$55,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale graduate, who was selected by China Horse Club's Michael Wallace and Michael Freedman, is expected to make a full recovery and be set for the spring.

Aquis to retain Everest slot

Aquis Farm yesterday confirmed that the Hong Kong-owned operation would not be selling its slot in the rich Everest (1200m) race, which is set to be worth \$15 million this year. There has been speculation that up to four of the 12 slot holders could either trade their option on this year's edition or permanently on-sell their slot but Aquis Farm chief executive Shane McGrath said owner Tony Fung planned to remain a player in the Sydney race. "Aquis Farm received a number of inquiries for our Everest slot recently," McGrath posted on social media. "I am happy to confirm that Tony Fung sees the Everest slot as a key component of Aquis' growth portfolio long-term and is thrilled to be a part of such a game-changing concept."

Albury Cup goal for Perfect Illusion

European import Perfect Illusion (Nathaniel) will kick off an Albury Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) campaign at Sandown today in a 1600-metre race for trainer Mitch Beer. The five-year-old, who was identified as a staying prospect by agent Paul Moroney at the Tattersalls July Sale for Albury-based Beer, has had just one Australian start, at Gundagai, last November before he was again spelled. "One got loose in the mounting yard at Gundagai," Beer said. "We were stuck in there and he just melted and had run his race before the start, so we put him out straight after that and I think he's gone terrific this campaign. His two trials have been really good and I've seen a massive improvement in the horse from last prep to this prep. I think the trip down to Melbourne will help him and the mile on the big track will be plus, as will the small field which will allow him to find his feet as they won't rip along early."

Inside draw could count against Mugatoo

Apprentice Robbie Dolan is wary that promising stayer Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) faces a danger race at Randwick tomorrow but is adamant the import has the talent to keep his unbeaten

local record intact. An impressive first-up winner for Kris Lees over the Randwick mile with 50.5 kilograms on his back, the Irishbred Mugatoo faces a different scenario in the TAB Handicap (1800m) as he rises 9.5 kilograms and jumps from the inside alley. "He's a lovely big striding horse and he's way above what he's racing (class wise)," Dolan said. "But 60 kilograms with barrier one is going to be tricky. He will probably get back and hopefully sometime in the race we can get off the fence and into the clear. There should be genuine tempo, you have Knowitall Jack there, and if he is there it will break the field up and he will have his chance."

Heinrich winds back the clock

Gold Coast trainer Gillian Heinrich, who has won a five-year battle with bowel cancer, is set to take her biggest team to the races in quite some time with 11 horses entered for today's Doomben meeting. They include the promising Dixon Bay (All Too Hard) who has won his first two starts and runs in today's Memberships @ BRC QTIS 3YO Benchmark 70 (1200m) with Brad Stewart in the saddle. "Dixon Bay has won two out of two and if he can win again, we may look at taking him to a three-year-old Saturday race in town," Heinrich said. Another strong chance for the stable is the lightly raced four-year-old Liability (Redoute's Choice). "(He) is first-up but he was quite good when he won a barrier trial at the Gold Coast a few weeks ago," she said.

Dunn dominates Country Championship heat

Murwillumbah trainer Matt Dunn will saddle half the field in the rescheduled Northern Rivers heat of the Country Championships. The meeting has been transferred to Grafton tomorrow because of problems with the amount of rain at Coffs Harbour which forced the cancellation of racing yesterday. Because of the change of venue, the field will have a maximum of 14 runners instead of 16. Dunn will have seven runners in the 1420-metre race but the Aiden St Vincent-trained Hellenism (Helmet) is the early favourite. The mare is a last-start winner of a Highway Handicap

(1100m) at Randwick on January 25 and has a win over 1400 metres on her record. She is at \$3.20 in the TAB's market ahead of the Dunntrained Gracie Belle (Top Echelon).

\$500,000 race to be run at Gosford

A new \$500,000 race named The Coast (1600m) will be run at Gosford in May for the NSW Central Coast club's inaugural standalone Saturday meeting. The new race will complement the \$150,000 Takeover Target Stakes (Listed, 1200m) and the \$250,000 Gosford Gold Cup (Listed, 2100m) to be run on the May 9 card which will take the place of a Sydney metropolitan meeting. The programme will also see standard \$125,000 races as well as a \$75,000 Highway Handicap.

'Whip rules a joke'

In light of James McDonald's six-meeting suspension for overusing the whip on Catalyst (Darci Brahma) in the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) on Saturday, Ciaron Maher has called for an overhaul of the rules, labeling the current regulations "a joke". "The stewards need to be stewards," Maher told Racing.com. "They know when someone breaks the whip rules. It's very obvious. To me, that wasn't at all. I don't agree with it at all. Those horses were quickening themselves. The jockeys were just staying in rhythm with them. I think it's a joke. He (McDonald) didn't even flick the whip up. He used it backhand. He was basically swatting flies. I think we need to stop pandering to these groups or whoever. Racing is racing. Obviously, everyone supports and gets behind the push for horse welfare. It's good for the horse and good for the industry. But James McDonald, he was in rhythm. He never flicked the whip up."

Warwick transferred to Friday

Yesterday's race meeting at Warwick in south east Queensland was postponed until Friday due to the state of the track. The seven-race card will now start earlier on the new date, with the first to jump at 11.05am (Queensland time). A meeting is also set to be held at the Sunshine Coast on Friday.

Randwick track rider injured

Emmie Barrat, a work rider for trainer John Sargent, suffered a fall at Randwick trackwork yesterday morning. Barrat was dislodged at the 200 metre-mark on the Polytrack before being transported to hospital. Racing NSW's Dr. Duckworth reported that the rider had dislocated her elbow and would be discharged from hospital yesterday, before seeing the doctor today.

NEW ZEALAND

Fresh is best for Group 1-bound Germanicus

Promising miler Germanicus (Rip Van Winkle) will be tested at elite-level for the first time on Saturday when he lines-up in the Haunui Farm WFA Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Otaki. The Danica Guy-trained four-year-old has won three of his seven starts at the distance, including a last start triumph in the Anniversary Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham. "He had ten days in the paddock and had a bit of an easy time of it after

his win in the Anniversary," Guy said. "We just freshened him up again. He trialled the other day at Tauranga right-handed, just so we could tick that box off because he had a racing embargo on him to race right-handed, but that has been lifted now. I think he went great in his trial. He wasn't asked to do anything, Troy (Harris, jockey) was told not to knock him around."

Rock On Wood on target for Bonecrusher

There would be few horses in the country more consistent than Rock On Wood (Redwood) and trainer Leanne Elliot is hoping the reliable gelding can turn that form into Group 1 glory next month. The Horowhenua-based gelding is earmarked to head north to Ellerslie on March 7 where he will compete in the Zealand Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). "He is very consistent and he likes what he is doing at the moment," Elliot said. "It was a good run in the Herbie Dyke, I was very pleased. He's been good since that run and he has been working well." On a trip to Ellerslie, Elliot said: "It will be a bit further

away from home and it is a different way of going around. He has raced that way around before but it will be interesting to see how he goes."

Allpress to ride in Saudi Arabia

Last season's New Zealand Premiershipwinning jockey Lisa Allpress has been invited to compete in the inaugural Kingdom Day Jockey Challenge at next month's US\$20million Saudi Cup, the world's newly established richest horse race. While she is looking forward to the new experience, it will not be the first time she has represented her country internationally. "I was lucky enough when I was an apprentice to go to Macau to represent New Zealand," Allpress said. "I would have been 23 and I loved it. I had a second placing in Macau. It was my first time riding on the dirt, it was great. Riding against world-class jockeys is something that everyone aspires to do, so you have just got to go there and enjoy it." She will leave for Saudi Arabia after Saturday's Otaki meeting.



The Blue Diamond - as true to form as any race can be

aturday's Group 1 Blue Diamond Stakes (\$1.5 million, 1200m) at Caulfield is as guaranteed to run true to form as any race can be.

In the absence of last Saturday's highly impressive debut winner Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) - potentially the one legitimate wildcard - this looks to be even more the case in 2020 than most years with the field and barriers declared yesterday.

Chances are, and highly probable to boot, that the Blue Diamond winner won either one of the gender split Preludes run two weeks ago which narrows the race - unsurprisingly - to the colt Hanseatic (Street Boss) and the filly Letzbeglam (Snitzel).

Furthermore, if your fancy didn't win last start, chances are it's not going to win today which adds only Away Game (Snitzel) and Personal (Fastnet Rock), who would both have to reach a new rating peak to win.

If your fancy is likely to lead, chances are also it's not going to win today and that's the possible issue for Letzbeglam, although she could hardly have been more impressive in the Prelude when three wide on the speed.

The poor record of leaders is a little surprising in a 1200-metre juvenile race but no outright leader has won the Blue Diamond since Bel Esprit in 2002.

Several winners of late have raced on speed but not led. In the past ten years, we've had four winners camped on the speed; three from handymidfield and three swooping home out wide.

The issue for the strong finishing Hanseatic, some will contend, may be barrier one but the Anthony Freedman-trained colt does have more early speed than has been revealed in the circumstances of his three runs to date.

It may, I'll concede, make or break the race for him but that will remain nothing more than conjecture until they've gone 300 metres and it has almost certainly served to better the price being bet against the unbeaten Godolphinbred and raced colt.

Barriers are generally irrelevant (as is almost always the case from the Caulfield 1200-metre start) in the Blue Diamond.

What is relevant is current form with 14 of the past 20 Blue Diamond winners being last start winners (more than half having claimed a Prelude) and only two winners, in that time, having not run first or second.

The two exceptions were Undoubtedly and Nadeem which came in exceptional circumstances. Nadeem won on an unseasonal heavy 10 track while Undoubtedly's closing win was set up by an extraordinary first 600-metre split of 33.6 seconds.

The fact that we haven't had winners emerging from excellent lead-in thirds, fourth or fifths suggests that the notion that two-year-olds are open to rapid improvement is misleading. More often than not the truth is what you see is what you get.

The Diamond Preludes are, unsurprisingly, the key lead-up races.

Seven winners in the past decade are horses who have run first or second in either of the Preludes and invariably it is the juvenile who records the fastest final sectional in the lead-up, rather than running the quicker overall time, who prevails, which this year is Hanseatic.

Hanseatic's closing speed was apparent via his finishing sectionals - from the 1000-metre point: 21.35 (400m), 11.66 (200m) and 21.87

(400m) to give the colt a brilliant 54.88 for his last 1000 metres.

Godolphin, trainer Freedman and jockey Luke Currie look set - barring misadventure - to repeat last year's Group 1 Blue Diamond Stakes success, with Lonhro filly Lyre.

It's not often you get a blanket finish to the Blue Diamond Stakes. In fact you have to go back to 2010 when Star Witness (Starcraft) won and there was less than a half-length between the first three and just 2.1 lengths back to sixth who happened to be the subsequent Golden Slipper winner Crystal Lily (Stratum).


I fancy the margins will be decisive again this year with Hanseatic leading the way.

Hanseatic is the third foal and second winner out of Itameri who was purchased by Darley for \$300,000 as a yearling in 2012. Itameri

is out of the Fusaichi Pegasus mare Baltics who is a half-sister to Magnus (Flying Spur) and Helsinge (Desert Sun), the dam of Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) and All Too Hard (Casino Prince).

The in-form Freedman stable may also claim Saturday's other Group 1 - the Futurity Stakes - with Super Seth (Dundeel). He and fellow three-year-olds Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) and Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune) are nominated for the 1400-metre weight-for-age race (fields declared today).

Speaking of chances, it's more than likely that the autumn dominance of the three-yearolds (over the older horses) will continue particularly against the backdrop of the longshot greybeard wins in modestly competitive weight-for-age races last spring.


