## Miller makes his mark with epic \$325,000 battle for Russian Revolution colt

*Locals dominate at Magic Millions Perth sale in absence of interstate competition*

Western Australian owners and trainers have taken advantage of a decimated interstate buying bench to dominate their local Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale in which a son of first season sire Russian Revolution (Snitzel) was the scene

stealer after selling for \$325,000 early in the session.

The highest-priced yearling to sell at the Perth sale since 2017, it was Ascot trainer Simon Miller who was forced to pull out all stops, warding off Sydney-based agent Andrew Williams and Upper Bloodstock, to ensure he bought the powerful colt, one of five yearlings sold yesterday for \$200,000 or more. *Continued on page 2 >>*

While the Book 1 sale did not follow the trend of the Magic Millions Gold Coast auction or the Inglis Classic sale, which saw significant year-on-year growth, the competition for quality lots was evident throughout the day, which lasted right to the end of the 163-lot afternoon session.

The top-priced colt, by Newgate Farm's dual Group 1-winning freshman sire Russian Revolution, was bred by the Western Breeders Alliance and foaled at Darling View Thoroughbreds, making him eligible for the lucrative Westspeed bonus scheme, a major factor in the state's owners seeking their local product so strongly.

"He's from an active family that's already thrown stakes winners," Miller said.

"The Deep Field half-brother (Winner Method) in Hong Kong is clearly above average. The mare's doing a good job, he is a good type and even though he is a late foal (November 8), he still looks imposing, so I was happy to have a crack at him.

"But I didn't have any bullets left - that was about me. Now, I'll be trying to jam black type on him, in any direction, and keep him as a colt."

The colt is the seventh living foal out of four-time winner Magical Belle (Blackfriars), making him a half-brother to four winners including WA stakes winner Enchanted Dream (Patronize), the stakes-placed Mystic Maid (Patronize) and recent impressive Hong Kong scorer Winner Method (Deep Field). He was catalogued as Lot 21.

Darling View Thoroughbreds' Brent Atwell, meanwhile, has held the session-topping Russian Revolution colt in high regard from the time he was born, but he admitted the price tag surpassed his lofty expectations.

"I thought he was the star of the show and I always thought he'd make good money as he's always been a lovely colt," Atwell said.

"The fact that he can go to a really good trainer in Simon and stay in Perth is great. He's got the Westspeed bonuses, which is great for Simon and his clients, and we look forward to watching him race here."

Atwell also praised Brian Nutt of Attunga Stud at Scone for his assistance

in agisting the Western Breeders' Alliance mares and foals when they are sent to the Hunter Valley to be covered.

He said: "Our mares over the east reside at Attunga, but she came home to foal. They are always a big part of what we do over there. We love breeding to Newgate stallions. They are quality horses, so we are very happy."

Miller also bought a colt by Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) for \$140,000 from Western Breeders Alliance (Lot 126) and a Deep Field (Northern Meteor) half-brother to his high-class mare Dance Music (War Chant) (Lot 136) for \$100,000. He also paid \$75,000 for a Patronize (Redoute's Choice) colt (Lot 138).

Western Breeders Alliance sold 17 yearlings yesterday at an average of \$89,765. The draft also included a \$220,000 Choisir (Danehill Dancer) colt and a \$170,000 Zoustar (Northern Meteor) colt who were both bought by trainer Neville Parnham who also prepares stakes-winning sprinter Indian Pacific by the Widden Stud-based Zoustar.

Parnham, who is third on the WA trainers' premiership behind the Bob Peters-backed Adam Durrant and Grant and Alana Williams, will also prepare a \$200,000 Playing God (Blackfriars) filly who is the first foal out of Boutique (Discorsi), herself a half-sister to WA stakes-winning sprinters Quilista (Scandal Keeper) and Red Can Man (Gingerbread Man).

The Willaview Park-consigned Lot 105, who is by the same sire as the Parnham-trained Group 1 winner Kay Cee, was bought by Michael Fagan.

Claire Williamson sold the filly under her newly formed Willaview Park banner after the dispersal of the family's Mungrup Stud last year.

"That was probably our expectation for her. She is a beautiful filly who is a great breeding prospect (once her racing career is over). It is very exciting to get this result for our first year."

The equal second highest-priced lot of the sale (Lot 161), the Choisir colt out of six-time Perth winner Hot Goods (Time Thief), was another strong result for the Western Breeders Alliance.

Jane Beynon of Einoncliff Park, one third of the alliance, said: "I think we were a little bit surprised (he made that much) being a Choisir. Overall, the Western Breeders have done exceptionally well and better than we expected."

<< *Continued from page 2* Parnham was the leading buyer yesterday, purchasing nine yearlings for a total of \$785,000, ahead of Miller who spent \$640,000 and Ridgeport's Santo Guagliardo who bought three for a combined \$450,000. WA trainers Ben and Daniel Pearce, Roy Rogers and Dan Morton all bought five yearlings each at their local sale.

## Brockman gets his early running Oratorio colt for \$210,000

The adrenaline of a yearling sale was a welcome distraction for the staff at Yarradale after the drama they were forced to encounter when a bushfire raged near the farm earlier this month and their dedication was rewarded with a stunning six-figure result late on day one.

After a flurry of competition from a range of Western Australian buyers, it was experienced trainer Vern Brockman who won the battle for the Oratorio (Stravinsky) colt, but he had to go to \$210,000 to get him.

"He is a very strong, early two-year-old type of horse who can hopefully provide a quick return. He is an outstanding horse - I thought he was the best two-year-old type in the sale," Brockman said.

Catalogued as Lot 147, he is a half-brother to the talented Martin Allan-trained Time To Sizzle (City Place), a winner of six of her 12 starts so far. The fifth foal out of Frizzled (Dehere), his three siblings to race have all won in Western Australia.

Yarradale Stud manager Bernadette Hamill watched 12 yearlings go through the ring yesterday, selling 11 of them for a total of \$728,000 at an average of \$66,182 to be second leading vendor behind Western Breeders Alliance.

"It is good to have them selling, especially after the couple of weeks that we have had," said Hamill who declared the farm's Oratorio colt as "a belter ever since he was born".

"(The market) was right about where we thought it would be, although we did think that the War Chants might be a bit stronger, but that's OK, we're

meeting the market."

As for Yarradale's interrupted lead-up to the delayed Magic Millions sale, Hamill said: "The staff have done a tremendous job, worked really well as a team and they pulled through.

"(When the bushfires were burning near us) we had no power, so the yearlings were starting to get a bit neglected, so they've done a lot of handwalking."

## Milestone for Scenic Lodge

Yesterday's session also brought an important milestone for respected Western Australian stud Scenic Lodge after a filly by its resident sire Snippetson (Snippets) sold for \$200,000, the highest-priced yearling ever sold by the farm and the stallion.

The honour laid with the August-born half-sister to dual Listed-winner Friar Fox (Blackfriars) and the stakes-placed Friaesque (Blackfriars), who was bought by Millfields Park for the record figure.

Scenic Lodge general manager Jeremy Smith was almost overwhelmed by the result.

"It is a fantastic result and it is just nice to get that recognition because Snippetson has been doing a good job for us over here in WA. It was very rewarding," Smith said.

"The filly has been really popular, but you never know where they (buyers) are going to go. We thought she might have been around the \$100,000 mark with the amount of interest, so it was a great result for the stud."

Catalogued as Lot 41, the filly is the sixth foal out of Pearlesque (Statoblest), herself a sister to the three-time Listed winner Impressive Stats.

Snippetson (Snippets), who relocated from Widden Stud to Scenic Lodge in 2016, is the sire of the David Harrison-trained Gemma's Son, the first horse to complete the Magic Millions *Continued on page 6>>*

<< *Continued from page 4* WA 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) and Magic Millions WA 3YO Trophy (RL, 1200m) double.

Overall, he is the sire of 14 stakes winners led by ATC Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Fast Clip and Moonee Valley Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) winner My Poppette.

The previous highest-priced yearling by Snippetson was \$185,000 when the subsequent Listed-winning, Group 1-placed Nobby Snip was bought by Apollo Ng in 2010.

Smith said: "Snippetson is having such a good run lately. I think he's the leading active stallion in WA with a lot of early two-year-old horses.

"They are the horses people like, so they are ideal for the Magic Millions race concept."

Meanwhile, the Matthew Sandblom-bred Capitalist (Written Tycoon) colt, the only one in the sale by the current leading first season Newgate Farm-based sire, was bought by prominent trainer Lindsey Smith for \$220,000.

By the same sire as Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) winner Profiteer, the colt is the first foal out of two-time winner Munjai (Trusting), a three-quarter sister to ATC Breeders' Plate (Listed, 1000m)-winning stallion Whittington (Tale Of The Cat). He was catalogued as Lot 31 and offered on behalf of Sandblom by Willow Dale Farm.

## Locals make most of weaker competition

Western Australian buyers purchased 105 of the 119 yearlings sold in the Book 1 session yesterday, with interstate participation well down year-on-year. Just nine lots yesterday, compared to 31 last year, were bought by buyers outside of WA.

There were 16 yearlings bought by Victorians in 2020, but only three were purchased this year, underlining the impact the snap Covid lockdown by premier Daniel Andrews had on the Perth market.

Interestingly, four horses were bought by Hong Kong clients, two horses by Upper Bloodstock, one by Simple Bloodstock Services and one by Eden Wong and Anita Chu.

The average of \$71,374 and the median of \$55,000 was on par with the 2020 sale but the clearance rate of 79 per cent was up on the same day last year, a figure that pleased Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch.

"I think it's been a really healthy day's trade for Western Australia in a market where we have obviously had fewer interstate buyers this year given the border restrictions," Bowditch surmised last night.

"The locals on a whole have got in and participated and rightly so given the huge bonuses these horses race for, whether it be the Magic Millions race series at Pinjarra or Westspeed."

One factor that was clear, Bowditch said, was that vendors who had invested in quality mares had been rewarded in the sales ring by the buyers.

"For Brent Atwell and the Western Breeders Alliance to get a result topping the sale today, it is well deserved as they have been investing heavily for the past few years, be it in sires here in the west or mares in the east," he said.

"It was a fantastic result for them."

#### First for Kiss And Make Up

General Phelps (2 c ex Rose General by General Nediym) won the Year Of The Ox 2YO Handicap (1006m) at Grafton yesterday to provide Aquis Farm's first season stallion Kiss And Make Up (More Than Ready) with his first winner. Bred and trained by Steven Phelps at Ballina, the Matt McGuren-ridden colt overhauled the favourite Buck Pharoah (American Pharoah) who was posted wide for the trip. Baronial (Dream Ahead) ran third. Having his first start, General Phelps keeps up the perfect record for his dam, seven-time winner Rose General, who has now had four foals to race for four winners. Kiss And Make Up stood for a fee of \$8,800 (inc GST) at Aquis Farm's Canungra base in 2020.

#### Enthaar 'fine': Maher

Co-trainer Ciaron Maher insists Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Enthaar (Written Tycoon) is 'fine' despite the unbeaten juvenile having to pass a late veterinary examination if she is to line-up in tomorrow's \$1.5 million Group 1 contest. Racing Victoria vets noted Enthaar to be lame on her near-foreleg during routine inspections yesterday morning and she will have to be reassessed today before getting the all-clear to run. However, Ciaron Maher - who trains the last-start Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) winner in partnership with David Eustace - said the filly had pleased him in Thursday's work and had shown no ill-effects on pulling-up. "She worked this morning, moving lovely. We trotted her up and as far as I am concerned, she is moving no different to normal," Maher told Racing.com yesterday. "She is always a bit shuffley. She's fairly immature, still growing a lot. She galloped

this morning, maybe it was from that? She is fine. She was due to get her feet re-done today or tomorrow, but apart from that she will do what she normally does. She will go for a wade tomorrow, like she normally does. So all should be okay."

#### Clouds also over Marine One and Dosh

The Lloyd Kennewell-trained Marine One (Capitalist) and Grahame Begg's Dosh (Rich Enuff) will also have to pass veterinary inspections this morning if they are to line-up in the Blue Diamond. Like Enthaar, both juveniles were found to be lame on their near-forelegs. "There is a little bit of a pulse in that near front foot this morning and a little bit of heel pain," Kennewell told Racing.com of Marine One yesterday. "It's going to be up to the horse, the farrier and the vet. We're obviously all going to be here today doing a fair bit of work and restructuring how we put a shoe onto him. I would say he is a 50-50 of getting there Saturday and I'd hope by later today he is 80-20." Of Dosh, Begg said: "She has some bruising on the near fore that we are addressing. We have already taken the shoe off and will do some cold icing. It can go either way, if it goes the right way she will be fine to run and it could improve rapidly. She reacted to the hoof testing on bruising to the inside heel, but we won't be taking any chances."

#### Walker bullish about Jigsaw claims

There are no such concerns for Blue Diamond Prelude (Colts and Geldings) (Gr 3, 1100m) third Jigsaw (Manhattan Rain) and Michael Walker, who guided Tagaloa (Lord Kanaola) to victory in last season's Blue Diamond,

believes he has a strong chance of repeating the dose with the Cindy Alderson-trained juvenile. "I think from barrier four, I would love to get a nice sit behind Enthaar and a few others and get out late," Walker told Racing.com. "I really, really think he will sprint. We have been doing that in his work. Cindy and her team have done a tremendous job. I worked him Monday and I am as bullish as I was last year with Tagaloa."

#### 'Hopefully we can do the job again'

A star-studded field awaits Kiwi raider Probabeel (Savabeel) in tomorrow's Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield, where she is set to clash with the likes of Behemoth (All Too Hard), Arcadia Queen (Pierro), Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) and last year's hero Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) as she tries to secure a third Australian Group 1 win, having landed the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) last February and the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) in the spring. The Jamie Richards-trained four-year-old was victorious first-up in the Bellmaine Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on February 6 and she is being set for a tilt at next month's All-Star Mile (1600m). "We are just trying to replicate what we were able to achieve in the spring - third-up into a nice mile race and hopefully we can do the job again. It will be a big thrill if we could," Richards told Racing.com. "It's a great field and a great dress rehearsal for the All-Star Mile. There is nowhere to hide. This is her first decent crack over the shorter trips at weight-for-age. She ran in the Cox Plate before that and has won an Epsom under the handicap conditions, so this is a big step up for her."

## Streets returns to happy hunting ground

Conditions in the Futurity will be perfect for defending champion Streets Of Avalon as he returns to the track and distance of his last-start CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) win, and his trainer Shane Nichols believes the six-year-old is one again being underestimated by the market. "Tell me in what other year would you find the winner of the Australia Stakes and the Orr Stakes at \$12 in the Futurity Stakes? It seems over the odds to me as I think he's a great each-way chance," Nichols said. Nichols also said regular jockey Zac Spain will adopt his positive tactics from stall seven. "If we're in it, it's not going to be a sit-and-sprint race," Nichols said. "He'll go forward and settle either in the lead or close to it and there will be a fast speed, without going silly, in the early stages."

## Corstens happy to put faith in Dee

Futurity favourite Behemoth was subject to a jockey change when his intended rider Craig Williams picked up a suspension, with the last-start Durbridge Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner now the mount of Damien Oliver. Williams was also set to partner Ranting (Zoustar) in the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) later on the Caulfield card and he will now be ridden by Michael Dee, with co-trainer Troy Corstens pleased to have secured such an able deputy at 50 kilograms. "It's not fantastic (to lose Williams) but luckily for me, the second that Craig Williams got suspended, Travis Johnstone (Dee's manager) texted me, so it was pretty easy," Corstens, who trains in partnership with his father Leon, told Racing.com. "I like Mick Dee quite a lot. He doesn't ride for me a hell of a lot but that's not for any particular reason, it's just because the other boys ride a lot of work for me. He's ridden a Group 1 winner for (owner) Rupert Legh, I think he's a very capable jockey. He rides 50 kilograms quite easily, so it was a really good fit."

## Moody searching for 'courage' to run Oxley

The participation of emerging colt Oxley Road (Exceed And Excel) in tomorrow's Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield will require his trainer Peter Moody to pluck up the necessary courage at the eleventh hour. A brother to the

Team Hawkes-trained Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Exceedance, Oxley Road came a length and a half clear of his nine rivals on his debut at Flemington last month. The Zeditave Stakes line-up was weakened after Chris Waller elected to keep the unbeaten Vowmaster (Written Tycoon) in Sydney for tomorrow's Chandon Handicap (1100m) at Rosehill, but Moody said on his Moody On The Mic podcast: "I think he's a very good colt and his lack of ability doesn't scare me from taking this on, it's his lack of experience. If I get the courage over the next 24 hours to run him, jump on him because I think he'll run extremely well."

## 9,000 permitted for Blue Diamond day

The Victoria state government has approved a crowd of 9,000 to be in attendance at Caulfield for tomorrow's Blue Diamond fixture. Melbourne Racing Club CEO Josh Blanksby said the club would have patrons in three zones of 3,000 each, allowing them to maintain all of the required Covid-safe protocols. "Considering we've just had a five-day lockdown, it's pretty positive we are able to do that (have 9,000 on course)," Blanksby told Racing.com. "It's a good reflection (on us), we operated the CF Orr Stakes day under a Tier 1 application and the health department was here for a couple of hours and ticked us off with all our protocols and Covid requirements. So (Saturday) will operate how CF Orr Stakes day did. This is our big race for the summer, so it was important to get this away and get as many members back in and enjoying the racing. It was really important for the club on the back of no spring carnival to get people back on Saturday."

## Four Moves Ahead out of Silver Slipper

Meanwhile at Rosehill, Four Moves Ahead (Snitzel) has been ruled out of the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) with a minor setback. Sky Racing's form analyst Brad Davidson tweeted yesterday: "Just spoke to John Sargent - Four Moves Ahead knocked her knee. Nothing serious but needs a couple of quiet days to get over it hence scratched from Silver Slipper. Plan is to run her in the Sweet Embrace on Sat week and still Golden Slipper bound all going well."

Four Moves Ahead made a dominant debut when winning by two and three-quarter lengths on the Kensington track in Sydney last month.

## Rocket ready to launch Slipper bid

Silver Slipper hopeful Rocket Tiger (Cluster) is taking his connections on the ride of a lifetime and they hope the fairytale can continue through to next month's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Homebred and raced by a Murray River cod farmer, the unbeaten youngster is a clear underdog as he prepares to go up against a host of blue-bloods in the Silver Slipper, but his Wagga trainer Scott Spackman is excited for the task that awaits his last-start Randwick winner. "As a bloke said to me yesterday, you've got to enjoy these moments because you never know when they will come around again," Spackman said. "I have been blessed as a trainer. I don't know how these big boys do it all the time but I've had a Country Championships (qualifier) winner, I've had two Country Championships finalists and I got a horse into the first Kosciuszko. That is a feat in itself for a small stable of no more than eight in work at any given time. We strive to achieve and I think we have but we have our slow ones too. We went to Tumut last week and couldn't win a maiden."

## Waller hopes for luck with hype horse Vowmaster

Chris Waller's decision to run Vowmaster at Rosehill rather than in Melbourne hasn't been done any favours by the draw, with the unbeaten gelding berthed widest of all in gate 13. A \$300,000 purchase from the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in 2019, Vowmaster supplemented his debut success at Kyneton on November 4 with a two and a half-length win at Moonee Valley 16 days later. "There has been plenty of hype around him and it is disappointing to see him draw wide," Waller said. "He is certainly a promising horse going forward and obviously his two races in Melbourne were very good. His trial in Sydney was exceptional and his work since has been of a high standard." Vowmaster is set to be partnered by James McDonald for the first time tomorrow and Waller added: "I have found the 1100-metre start at Rosehill can suit those on-pace types so whether we use him up from his wide draw or take a sit with cover will depend on how he jumps."

## Peltzer out to break Rosehill duck

Co-trainer Gerald Ryan hopes last-start Eskimo Prince Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Peltzer (So You Think) can break his Rosehill hoodoo when he seeks to justify his prominent pitch in tomorrow's Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) market. The burgeoning talent has won six of his nine starts, with five of those victories coming at Randwick and the other, his maiden win, being produced at Kembla Grange. Despite all three of his defeats having come at Rosehill, the three-year-old has produced some creditable efforts at the track, running second to Anders (Not A Single Doubt) in the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) as well as finishing fourth in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) and fifth in the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "He ran here in an 1100-metre race, a 1200-metre race and a Golden Rose and he ran second, fourth and fifth so they haven't been bad runs and they were in good company too," Ryan, who trains in partnership with Sterling Alexiou, said of Peltzer's Rosehill performances. Peltzer was yesterday the \$4.20 second favourite for the Hobartville, with unbeaten Kiwi Aegon (Sacred Falls) heading the market at \$3.90.

## Waller hopes 'new wave' can make their mark

Chris Waller is set to saddle The Elanora (Redoute's Choice) and Wheelhouse (Pierro) in the Hobartville and the champion trainer hopes the progressive duo can form part of the 'new wave' of three-year-olds set to compete through the autumn. Both colts have developed formidable records in lesser company but are set to face their toughest task to date in tomorrow's \$400,000 contest. "This is an interesting race each and every year. We seem to have the more proven and high-profile three-year-olds that have done well through the spring and come back into the autumn, and then you also have a new wave of horses," Waller said. "I would classify my two as being in the new wave of horses and hopefully serious contenders through the autumn carnival." Of The Elanora, Waller said: "Nash Rawiller will ride him and it is questionable whether the 1400 metres could be a bit short, but it is a good stepping stone towards the Randwick

Guineas, possibly the Rosehill Guineas and even a Derby, depending on which path we take with him, whether it be a staying path or franking his speed and ability, concentrating on the lower races." Regarding Wheelhouse, Waller added: "He was very impressive in his first-up run. He is a decent type of horse - he is well bred and I loved his maiden win."

## Lion's Roar sets out on autumn trail

Also lining-up in the Hobartville is the John O'Shea-trained Lion's Roar (Contributer), who has built up a fine record so far in winning three of his five starts. The gelding has finished runner-up in his other two outings, including a valiant second in the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) last time out on October 10, beaten three-quarters of a length by star filly Montefilia (Kermadec). Raced by Champion Thoroughbreds, who went to \$65,000 to secure Lion's Roar at Book 2 of the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale, the three-year-old has produced two solid trials in readiness for his return, finishing a close-up sixth behind Discharged (Snitzel) in his most recent jump-out over 1000 metres. "We're very happy with Lion's Roar, his preparation has been faultless which has reflected in his two trials," O'Shea said. "We go into Saturday's race with a good foundation, albeit plenty of improvement. He looks to map very well and we're really happy with where he's at."

## Subpoenaed and Rouge begin Coolmore preparation

The Chris Waller-trained duo Subpoenaed (Rip Van Winkle) and Madam Rouge (Zoustar)

will make their returns in the Millie Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) earlier on the Rosehill card as they plot a path to the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) at the same track on March 13. Subpoenaed won the Golden Pendant Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on September 26 and was last seen in competitive action running down the field in the Golden Eagle (1500m), while Madame Rouge was a last-start winner of the Tristarc Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on October 17. "She has returned well from her summer break," Waller said of Subpoenaed. "She would appreciate the track improving a little and she loves Rosehill. She has trialled and worked well so I am expecting a good showing from her first-up." He continued: "It was my preference to give them both two runs into the Coolmore, but as time is likely to be against us, they will both probably have a trial to ensure they can run in the Coolmore second-up over the 1500-metre distance."

## Promising Gimmie Par set for a spell

Following her eye-catching debut at Flemington last Saturday, promising filly Gimmie Par (Not A Single Doubt) is being spelled ahead of what trainer Peter Moody expects to be a Group 1 campaign in the spring. A half-sister to Ole Kirk, from the same family as Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), Gimmie Par ran second in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) first-up, beaten half a length by Ingratiating (Frosted). "She ran up to her good recent trial, she just lacks a little bit of maturity and she's got a bright future ahead of her," Moody said on his podcast Moody On The Mic. "Very pleasing to see her hit the line like that but disappointing not to win, obviously." Much like her half-brother last year, Gimmie Par is likely to be aimed at top-tier targets as a three-year-old. "She's the daughter of Not A Single Doubt and a half-sister to a Caulfield Guineas winner so we've probably got to aim her at something like the Thousand Guineas," Moody said. "First and foremost, she's now stakes-placed and she'll come back and kick off in a little maiden somewhere and then we'll work toward a race like the Thousand Guineas and God give her strength and hope she's good enough."



## Evie faces winter acid test

Promising filly Tycoon Evie (Written Tycoon) will face an acid test to decide her Brisbane winter carnival path when she attempts to post back-to-back wins at Eagle Farm tomorrow. Tycoon Evie was an impressive winner over 1400 metres at the track on February 6 and will be stepping up to 1600 metres for the first time in the QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap. The three-year-old is a sister to Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Winning Rupert, although her trainer Rex Lipp believes Tycoon Evie's future lies going up in trip, rather than coming back to sprinting. "I think she's thrown more to her dam's sire Show A Heart than Written Tycoon and she looks a Show A Heart as she's big and strong," Lipp told Racing Queensland. "She's on the way up and is going well and if she wins or runs well on Saturday, I'll put her away for the winter. If she doesn't, we can always drop back to the Queensland Guineas. Her last win was a real gutsy effort and she did it the hard way after she had to go forward off her bad draw and sat outside the leader. This is her acid test and it will prove whether I'm right or wrong with her."

## ANZ Facebook page down

ANZ Bloodstock News has been caught up in the stoush between Australian media companies, the federal government and global social media giant Facebook. The US-based Facebook's founder Mark Zuckerberg yesterday made the dramatic decision to deny users access to Australian news sites' pages on the social media goliath. Many Australian government pages which often share news on the platform, including health authorities were also stripped of their publicly viewable content. Facebook later said this had happened in error. The federal government is attempting to introduce legislation which would force online companies such as Google, which has already reached a number of agreements with Australian media outlets, and Facebook to pay for the journalism posted on their respective sites. While ANZ Bloodstock News' Facebook page is down, our [Twitter page](#) - clearly the country's most followed account in the thoroughbred breeding media industry - and [Instagram page](#) are still operational. ## Kersley recovering from emergency surgery

Freddie Kersley hopes to return to race riding next month after undergoing surgery for a burst ulcer lodged in his intestine, which had ruptured the duodenal. In a statement released on Twitter, Kersley's agent Mark Guest said the jockey had been rushed into hospital on Sunday night, but the surgery had gone as planned and the recovery process is underway. In the statement, Kersley himself added: "I'd like to thank family and those close to me for all of the kind messages and Footscray Hospital and the VJA for their support and ongoing help."

## Country crowds cut to 300

Crowds at country racing venues in Victoria over the next week are set to be slashed from 1,000 to 300 patrons per meeting after hosts of all Tier 3 public events were advised of state government changes yesterday afternoon. Tomorrow's meeting at Yarra Valley is the only fixture to have been approved more than 300 patrons, with up to 3,500 racegoers permitted. Changes to the state government public events framework have been put in place until February 26, leaving the possibility open for larger crowds back at country tracks by tomorrow week. The meetings capped at 300 patrons are: today's fixture at Benalla; tomorrow's meeting at Woolamai; Sunday's fixtures at Werribee, Ballarat and Yea; Monday's meeting at Terang; Tuesday's meeting at Bendigo; Thursday's fixtures at Kilmore and Pakenham; as well as the meeting scheduled for Sale a week today.

## Nothdurft to link-up with O'Dea and Hoysted

Baylee Nothdurft, who became the first apprentice in 20 years to win the Queensland metropolitan jockeys' title when claiming top honours last season, will be teaming up with Steven O'Dea and Matthew Hoysted at Eagle Farm when he returns to race riding in the next month. Before Nothdurft went for a break late last year to attend to his weight and serve a suspension, he had developed a commanding partnership with Tony Gollan. However, he will be joining Ben Thompson

and Stephanie Thornton on the regular roster of jockeys for O'Dea and Hoysted on his comeback, having ridden work for the duo in recent weeks. "He just approached us and he obviously needs to be riding work most days in a full-time role, which is going to help with his weight," Hoysted told Racing Queensland. "We were at that stage looking for a rider when he asked if we had a role and he has fitted in perfectly. He is a massive asset to the stable to have him coming in and riding them each day. It is very nice for us."

## Bowditch cops eight-meeting suspension

Joe Bowditch has been suspended for eight meetings after breaking the whip rule at Sandown on Wednesday. Riding Under The Bridge (Mettre En Jeu), who was beaten 11 lengths into last in race three, Bowditch pleaded guilty to using his whip eight times prior to the 100 metres, which is three more strikes than permitted. He used the whip 17 times in total. His suspension will start at midnight, February 24 and expire at midnight, March 3. He was also fined \$200. In assessing the penalty, stewards took into account his guilty plea, good record and totality of whip strikes.

## Il Affare to handle quick back-up

Il Affare's (Dundeel) iron constitution will serve her well as she continues her Classic preparation at Ellerslie this weekend. That's the word from the filly's co-trainer Peter Williams as he puts the finishing polish on the two-win filly ahead of tomorrow's Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2100m). Il Affare will back up from her fourth placing in last Saturday's David & Karyn Ellis Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa and shapes as a winning chance, according to Williams. "She's fine. She's one of those fillies that does pretty well and we wanted to give her one more run before the Derby," said Williams, who trains in partnership with his wife Dawn. "She'll run this weekend and then it's two weeks into the Derby. They've got to be fit to run the Derby."

## ASIA

## HK: Southern Legend primed for Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup

Southern Legend (Not A Single Doubt) will attempt to prove that age is no barrier to success when the eight-year-old lines up as the senior member of the field in Sunday's Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (Gr 1, 1400m) at Sha Tin. "He's just a happy horse, we just try to keep him as sound as we can - it's pretty tough over here to keep them sound, especially when they are his age but he just has such a passion for racing," Caspar Fownes said of last season's Champions Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner. A regular presence in this weekend's other Group 1 contest, the Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m), Fownes has instead opted to step back in distance with the hope that his consistent charge is able to fully capitalise on the absence of Golden Sixty, (Medaglia D'Oro) who instead steps up in distance for the Hong Kong Gold Cup. "That's the thing (to having no Golden Sixty in the race), we looked at that and said let's freshen him up and have a crack - we know he is up to the task," Fownes said. "He's beaten the best horses on his day in Hong Kong and he got close to the Golden Sixty last month - I'm expecting a big run from him."

## HK: Aethero returns to work

After completing key gallops on the grass at both Sha Tin and Conghua, Caspar Fownes appeared satisfied with his gun sprinter Aethero's (Sebring) progress as he builds towards a return from injury. "He's going really well - fingers crossed - he will have a trial soon so let's just hope everything goes smooth at this stage," Fownes said. The talented chestnut, who lowered Sacred Kingdom's (Encosta De Lago) long-standing 1000-metre track record at Sha Tin in 2019, had question marks placed over his future after bleeding when finishing last of 11 in last year's running of the Chairman's Sprint Prize (Gr 1, 1200m), before sustaining a tendon injury in September. The son of Sebring (More Than Ready) is yet to have a run for Fownes after switching stables at the conclusion of last season, having previously been trained by John Moore.

## 149 for Medaglia D'Oro

Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) edged closer to another significant milestone when New Trails (7g - Issaqueena by Mr. Prospector) returned from a 12-month absence to provide the Darley stallion with his 149th individual stakes winner courtesy of a two-length success in the Curlin Stakes (Listed, 2000m) at Meydan yesterday. Trained by Ahmad Bin Harmash, the seven-year-old emerged from deep in the pack to get up late and register a first win since taking out a handicap at the same track back in January 2019. Now the winner of four of his 15 starts, New Trails ran on to defeat the Godolphin pair Dubai Icon (New Approach) and Real World (Dark Angel), who were split by a short head crossing the line. New Trails is out of the winning Mr. Prospector (Raise A Native) mare Issaqueena, who herself is a half-sister to US Listed winner Charley Tango (Maria's Mon). He is a half-brother to four winners including US Grade 2 victor Tizaqueena (Tiznow). Former shuttler Medaglia D'Oro stands for US\$150,000 (approx. AUD\$193,800) at Jonabell Farm in Kentucky this year.

## 65 for Empire Maker

Mnasek (3 f ex Washington Bridge by Yankee Gentleman) proved to be in a different class to her six rivals as she stretched clear to take out the UAE Oaks (Gr 3, 1900m) in effortless fashion and in the process become the 65th individual stakes winner for the late Empire Maker (Unbridled). Away smarter than on her previous start when second in the UAE

1,000 Guineas (Listed, 1600m), the Doug Watson-trained filly made it two wins in three starts as she came home six and a half lengths clear of the running-on Nayefah (Super Saver). Last Sunset (Teofilo) was another two and a half lengths away in third. Mnasek is the sixth foal out of the US Grade 2 winner Washington Bridge. Empire Maker, the sire of 13 individual elite-level winners, including the likes of Royal Delta and Pioneer of The Nile, died last year at the age of 20.

## UAE: Equilateral backs up for Group 2 win

Equilateral (6 g Equiano - Tarentaise by Oasis Dream) appears to have finally found some consistency at the age of six as he followed up his recent course and distance win in handicap company with a victory in yesterday's Meydan Sprint (Gr 2, 1000m). Second in the corresponding race behind the reopposing Waady (Approve) 12 months ago, the Charlie Hills-trained gelding beat the fast finishing Acklam Express (Mehmas) by a length with A'Ali (Society Rock) another neck away in third. Equilateral has now won seven of his 24 starts, with three of those victories coming in stakes company. He also finished second in the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) at Royal Ascot in 2020 when beating all bar Europe's champion sprinter Battaash (Dark Angel).

## UAE: D'bai pounces in Zabeel Mile

A perfectly executed ride by William Buick resulted in D'bai (7g Dubawi - Savannah Belle by Green Desert) hitting the front in the lunge for the wire as the seven-year-old became Charlie Appleby's third successive winner of yesterday's Zabeel Mile (Gr 2, 1600m). Dropping back in trip after a barren spell in which he went six races without striking, D'bai returned to the winner's enclosure for the eighth time in 35 starts as he came out on top in a tight four-way finish. First Contact (Dark Angel) was a head behind the winner in second, with Art Du Val (No Nay Never) another neck away in third.



## UK: Epsom Derby prize-money boosted

Top-level British racing received a welcome shot in the arm yesterday when Jockey Club Racecourses announced the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) will have a seven-figure prize fund again in 2021. The race will be worth £1.125 million (approx. AUD\$2.023 million) in June, more than doubling the £500,000 purse that was on offer at Epsom last year. The £625,000 (approx. AUD\$1.124 million) boost comes despite the continued financial impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, which cost JCR more than £90million in revenue in 2020 across the 15 courses it operates. The economic position is little better for tracks this year, with racing still taking place behind closed doors and the closure of betting shops hitting media rights payments. But JCR is keen to maintain the status of the Derby, which was run with an advertised value of £1.5 million in 2019. Andrew Cooper, head of racing and clerk of the course at Epsom: "Safeguarding the Derby's

position at the pinnacle of Flat racing globally is really important to us given the role our sport's top races play in supporting the racing and breeding industries as a whole. Continuing our track record on prize-money funding,

the Jockey Club is doing everything we can to maximise our investment into the Derby and across our race programme as a whole within the financial constraints this pandemic has created."

Bourbon Flyer (Flying Artie) emerged as a potential latecomer for next month's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) when he made a deep impression with a first-up win on the Kensington track in Sydney on Wednesday.

Trained by John Thompson and sent off at \$6, Bourbon Flyer showed a professional attitude under Hugh Bowman, leading the ten-runner field into the straight before finding

plenty for pressure as the tempo increased. Challenged in the closing stages, he put a length and a half between himself and runner-up Syracuse (Sebring) in the Stud & Stable Staff Awards Plate (1100m), coping well with the Soft 7 track and looking a juvenile with a bright autumn in prospect.

"He's a very professional colt and has been from day one a very straightforward horse," Thompson told Sky post-race as he confirmed Bourbon Flyer will be set for a Slipper trial at his next start.

"He has a good horse's attitude and aims to please so there is more to come from him. We'll have a throw at the stumps at one of those nice two-year-old lead-up races and see how we go. It's up to him from here on."

Bourbon Flyer's victory was a significant one for his sire, Newgate Farm resident Flying Artie (Artie Schiller), who himself ran third in the 2016 Slipper prior to taking out the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). The exciting juvenile became his fifth individual two-year-old winner of the campaign, taking him to the head of the first season sire table by winners, one clear of barnmate Capitalist (Written Tycoon). Kitchwin Hills' Sooboog (Snitzel) has also sired four individual victors, while fellow Newgate resident Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) has three. Flying Artie stood for a fee of \$16,500 (inc GST) in 2020.

Bourbon Flyer's success was also the first score for Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) as a broodmare sire, the two-year-old being the first runner out of Cap d'Antibes Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner and San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) third Kentucky Miss.

Bourbon Flyer was a \$50,000 purchase from the 2020 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. He is owned by a syndicate that includes Wilf Mula, who also raced Flying Artie with the late Paul Whelan, John Whelan and Newgate's Henry Field. John O'Shea paid \$52,500 for his sister at the 2020 Inglis Australian Weanling Sale.

Kentucky Miss, who was bought by Mula for \$250,000 at the Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale last year, has a weanling sister to the pair and she was covered by I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) in December.

Kentucky Miss is herself out of four-time US winner Twelve Pack Shelley (Deputy Storm), who was twice successful at Listed level as well as being Grade 3-placed.
