## Agents head to South America in search of Argentina diamonds

*Gran Venta Selecta-purchased yearlings bound for Singapore after Dave Mee and Bevan Smith strike*

Two New Zealand agents acting for Singapore-based clients have come away from their first Argentinian yearling sale with a combined six lots in a market the duo believe represents great value, as they look to add South America as a source of high-quality horses.

Pinhook Bloodstock International's

Australian-based agent Dave Mee and compatriot Bevan Smith both made the trip to Buenos Aires for the second Gran Venta Selecta Yearling Sale at San Isidro Racecourse on Sunday.

The auction has been put together by the respective owners of Argentina's biggest thoroughbred studs, Haras Vacacion and Haras Abolengo, with the goal of attracting international buyers to the continent and build it into a mainstream market. *Continued on page 2>>*

### Alligator records positive

Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) has returned an irregularity in a post-race sample taken after his win in the rich Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) at the Gold Coast on January 11. The sample showed traces of altrenogest, a substance used to regulate breeding activity in mares. Altrenogest, also known as regumate, has been the subject of conjecture in recent seasons as it can produce an anabolic steroid positive, with Victoria and NSW adopting different positions regarding its use in mares. However, across the board, it is illegal in colts and geldings. "I was informed today that Alligator Blood has returned an irregularity to altrenogest after his win at the Gold Coast," Vandyke said in a statement. "There is a B sample under review. Altrenogest is a drug that has never been used to my knowledge on Alligator Blood or any male horse in our stable." *Morning Briefing page 5 >>*

Mee, acting primarily for a Singapore syndicate of investors, targeted fillies and came away with the highest-priced yearling in the 109-lot catalogue, a US\$125,000 daughter of South America's exciting stallion Fortify (Distorted Humor).

"They will remain in Argentina to be broken and educated and when the time is right they will be sent to Singapore in 12 to 18 months' time," Mee told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"If either can gallop and show potential, we will then strongly consider taking them to Australia. With the incredible Aussie prize-money levels and commercial marketplace being so hot for high-quality fillies that can run, there is potentially big upside "

The most expensive of the yearlings bought by Mee was Lot 2, the already named Joy Rosita (Fortify), who is a sister to the Grade 1 winner Roman Joy and a daughter of the Grade 2 winner The Rosy (Hennessy).

"Joy Rosita, although costing US\$125,000, when weighing up the relative prices from around the world with comparable fillies that are built like her with the type of page, in my opinion she still represented excellent value," he said.

"By the hottest young sire in South America in Fortify, she is a full-sister to very exciting three-year-old Grade 1 winner Roman Joy and a very close blood relation to Grade 1-placed Joy Angus.

"Her purchase tied into the fact that over the past six months or so I've been looking at South American horses to fill Hong Kong orders, so I am

aware how good Roman Joy is and I think he still has plenty of big-race wins in him."

Mee also snared Lot 8, an In The Dark (Mutakddim) filly named Laboreana, for US\$38,000. She is out of the stakes-placed La Piradita (Salt Lake), making her a half-sister to Grade 1 winner Lenovo (Roman Ruler) and the Listed winner Los Anos Locos (Peer Gynt).

"Laboreana is by a freshman sire, Grade 1 winner In The Dark from a fantastic Argentinian family and a half to champion sprinter and five-time Grade 1 winner Lenovo," he said.

Smith, in conjunction with prominent Singapore trainer Michael Clements, bought three colts from the Gran Venta Selecta sale as well as a son of Fortify privately for US\$50,000.

At the sale, the pair secured a Treasure Beach (Galileo) colt named Coordinala, a son of In The Dark named Stay In The Dark and a colt by War Command (War Front) called Impression Digital.

"We had a great guy in Agustin Villamil, who is a bloodstock agent over there, and he organised all the (inspections) and briefed us on all the breeding and we were able to buy three at the sale on Sunday," Smith said.

"The thinking behind doing it was that the South American breed have had a fair bit of success in Singapore but they have been through the tried market where you pay top dollar - US\$200,000 to US\$300,000 for stakes horses."

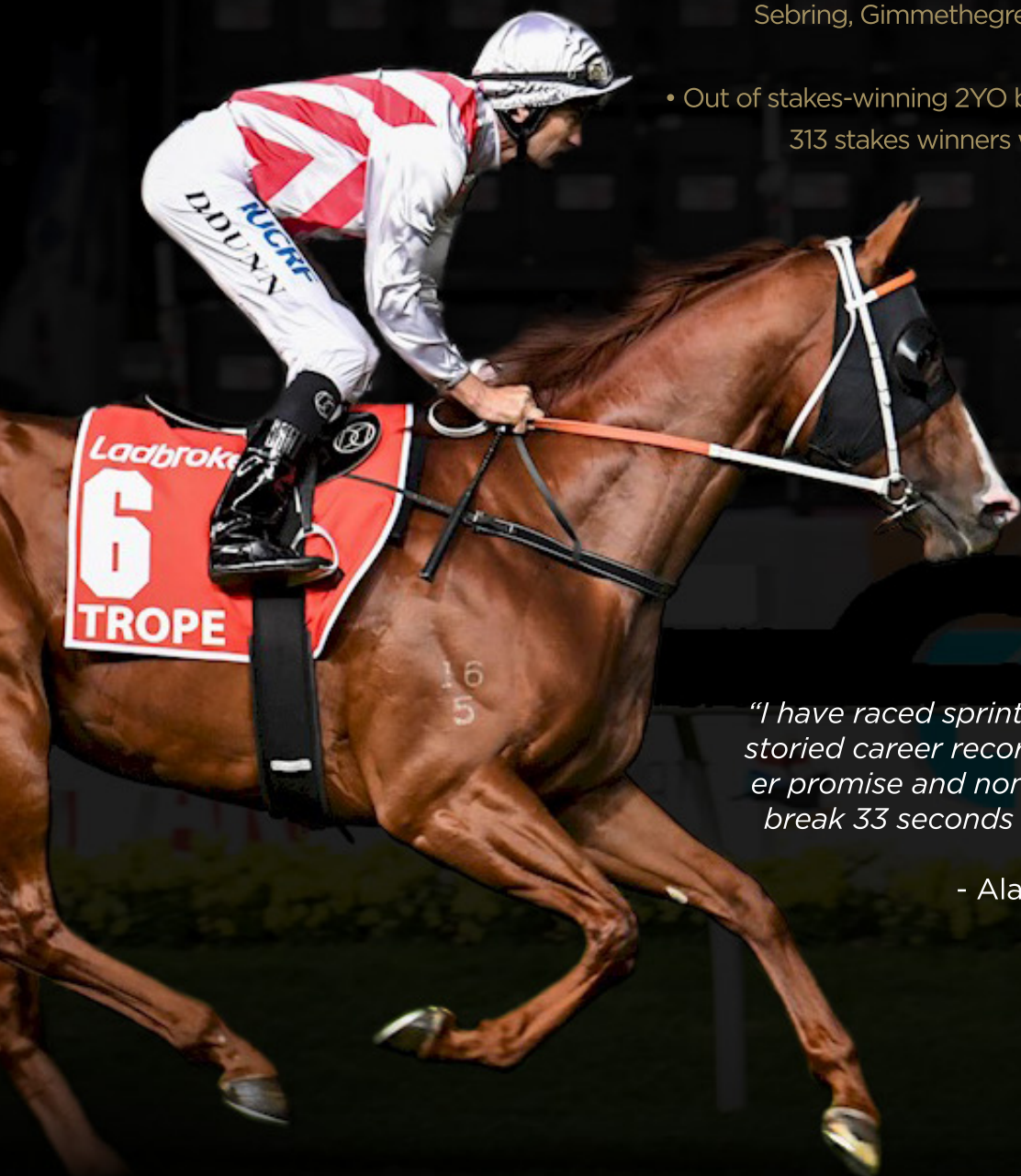

The young agent said he and Clements also wanted to have more control over the early education of the horses, so they spent more than a week in Argentina inspecting potential candidates to purchase.

"We were pretty strict on conformation, so we were buying horses who were correct, sound horses and they have got to have longevity, so we are getting in there before anyone else touches them and then get them up to Singapore," he said.

"The idea was to buy horses that we liked and it was great value. I think we paid US\$35,000, US\$38,000 and US\$40,000 for the three of them. We weren't paying overs and we also bought a horse privately as well by Fortify who is the best stallion up there and we paid US\$50,000 for him.

"We thought he was the best horse we'd seen in Argentina, so to get a horse like that by the best stallion, we were rapt to get him for US\$50,000."

South America is not a new hunting ground for Australasia, with Arrowfield Stud securing the then three-time champion Chilean sire Hussonet (Southern Halo) in 2003 who from his first Australian crop produced brilliant sprinter-miler Weekend Hussler, successful seven times at the highest level for trainer Ross McDonald.

The US-bred Southern Halo (Halo) has also proven influential in global bloodlines, in particular, via his sire son More Than Ready while Aquis Farm stallion Husson (Hussonet), best-known for siring Australian dual Group 1 winner Lucky Hussler, was bred in Argentina.

Mee said: "I came over here for a week in December with friend and partner Jesse Davison and we had a really good look around both Chile and Argentina and on numerous fronts were impressed with what we saw.

"The combination of the

wonderful natural environment for raising horses, which produces quality horses; the relatively inexpensive cost to purchase nice horses, the world-class horsemanship and very low training costs makes a lot of sense to me to be buying here and to develop things moving forward."

Smith felt the strong North American influence in the pedigrees helped him gain an understanding of the bloodlines but admitted the trip was a steep learning curve.

"I have always known the obvious stuff that comes out of here and Southern Halo was the champion sire out of there and he has become a really good broodmare sire, so I was looking for that in pedigrees," he said.

"The American-line horses I knew a fair bit about and War Command is a Coolmore stallion, so he was one that I was familiar with as well.

"I felt like I got up to speed on the racing over there (in South America) very quickly and which racetracks (hold higher class racing) and that some of the stakes races at the lesser tracks just aren't worth as much."

South Africa's Justin Vermaak, who was also active at the inaugural sale, returned this year to buy two fillies by champion South American stallion Equal Stripes (Candy Stripes) for US\$90,000 each.

Smith made a mad dash back from Buenos Aires to arrive on the Gold Coast in time for the Magic Millions March Yearling Sale, leaving Villamil to bid on he and Clements' behalf, while Mee was expected to arrive back in Sydney late yesterday, compelling him to 14 days in isolation due to the coronavirus outbreak.

"Credit goes to Haras Vacacion and Haras Abolengo, the farms who were the backbone of that sale," Smith said.

"They put it at this time of year trying to attract people like us to the sale. The timing worked well as we went straight from Melbourne Premier to Argentina and it was good thinking by them.

"We will see how we go with these first four horses that we have bought but we have every intention to go back next year.

"It will all depend on results, as everything in this game does, but we are very happy with what we've bought and we thought it was great value.

"Going around the farms, the people hosted us fantastically well. They are very accommodating people and they were excited that someone from overseas was coming to buy their horses and to have international buyers at their sale."

### Williams keeps faith in Gaby

Craig Williams has labelled Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) one of Australia's best sprinters ahead of her return to Moonee Valley for tomorrow night's William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Racing around a turn has Williams excited for Loving Gaby's next bout with Bivouac (Exceed And Excel), who had the filly's measure down the Flemington straight in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m). In the spring, Loving Gaby lowered Bivouac's colours in the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) over the William Reid course and distance. "She was airborne before the Newmarket but Bivouac, he was dominant down the straight," Williams said. "I'm really looking forward to her getting back around a bend. She's still a three-year-old filly but she feels furnished. If we can have some luck getting back to a track that she's won a Group 1 race at, then we should be in the finish."

### Noske grounded

Travel restrictions now in effect have dashed the hopes of Perth-based rider Jarrad Noske, who was set to chase his first Group 1 win in tomorrow night's William Reid Stakes. Noske has partnered Rock Magic (Redoute's Choice) in most of his

starts since the sprinter shipped west and was due to ride him again in tomorrow's feature. "It's obviously unfortunate, he's my favourite horse and I'd love to be riding him," Noske told Racing.com. "It's even more disappointing as he's working superbly at home and we know he can match it with the best over east as we've seen previously. When the update was provided, we learnt that I'd either have to drive to Melbourne or have my own private/charter flight, which was unrealistic. We made the decision I'd stay home and book Michael Dee who rode him in the Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in 2018."

### Farnan ticks over well for Slipper

He may no longer be the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite, but co-trainer Adrian Bott believes that Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) is the right horse to make history for his training partner Gai Waterhouse. The first lady of racing seeks a record seventh Slipper, surpassing the record of six she holds with her father Tommy Smith. Bott, meanwhile, is looking for his first Slipper. Farnan won the Silver Slipper (Gr 2, 1100m) and the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) to stamp his credentials for the world's richest juvenile race, but he was dealt a blow at the draw with a double-digit gate. "The best horses have still been able to win from those draws," Bott said. "So if you've got the right horse I don't think it's that big an obstacle but obviously the market reacts quite strongly to it. He's got tactical speed which is in his favour as well."

### Global Quest scratched from Slipper

The Golden Slipper dream is over for Global Quest (More Than Ready) after the Breeders' Plate (Listed, 1000m) winner was withdrawn

yesterday. Trainer Chris Waller told stewards he was unable to work Global Quest yesterday morning, with the colt having spiked a slight temperature on Monday. His blood picture had not improved, said Waller, leading to his withdrawal from the Slipper on veterinary advice and leaving Sydney's leading trainer with just one runner in Hungry Heart (Frankel). First emergency Rathlin (Fastnet Rock), the Phelan Ready Stakes (Listed, 1110m) winner, gains a start, giving trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace five runners in the \$3.5 million feature; Prague (Redoute's Choice), Away Game (Snitzel), Muntaseera (I Am Invincible) and Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) are their other four.

### Shark favourite for George Ryder

Jockey Opie Bosson is having the autumn of a lifetime and he hopes it can continue when he rides favourite Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) in Saturday's George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m). Bosson had to make a quick decision to head for Sydney only hours after returning to his farm in Pukekawa, south of Auckland, on Sunday in order to avoid the Australian Government's 14-day self-isolation policy. "I had just got home and went out on the farm to do my jobs and was out the back of the farm when Jamie Richards rang me," Bosson said. "I went back home and my wife Emily packed my bag and booked my ticket and I went straight to the airport. There is some good prize-money coming up, so I didn't really want to be missing out on Te Akau Shark. He galloped nicely on Tuesday and looks a picture. I can't fault him one bit. I think he is a bit stronger this preparation and he has stepped up to another level."



## Bosson to reunite with Danzdanzdance

Opie Bosson hopes to be able to fly the New Zealand flag beyond Te Akau Shark on Saturday. He reunites with the Chris Waller-trained Danzdanzdance (Mastercraftsman) in the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), having partnered her into third behind Avilius (Pivotal) in this race last year. This season, she's raced six times with six different jockeys aboard; Bosson makes the seventh. "I have won two Group 1s on her and I think Kylie Bax (part-owner) was keen to have me on," Bosson said. "James McDonald told me that she went OK last start." He will also ride Stephen Marsh's Scorpz (Charm Spirit), third last start in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m), for the first time in the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m). "I think he will run well. He hit the line well in the New Zealand Derby and I think when he gets up to 2400m it will be better for him over here."

## Addeybb, Young Rascal to make Australian debuts

English trainer William Haggas will fulfill a long-stated ambition when he steps out his first runners in Sydney on Saturday. Haggas has campaigned Fastnet Tempest (Fastnet Rock) and Raheen House (Sea The Stars) in Melbourne previously, but Addeybb (Pivotal) and Young Rascal (Intello) represent his first runners north of the border. Addeybb is the early favourite for the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), coming off a classy five-year-old season that culminated in his second to Magical (Galileo) in the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Ascot in October. As for Young Rascal, he runs as top-weight in the N E Manion Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) on his way

to the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). The pair have been stabled at Canterbury's quarantine centre for nearly three weeks.

## Get The Idea given Rosehill Guineas chance

John Sargent hopes that Get The Idea (So You Think) can step up when the outsider tackles the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) on Saturday. Get The Idea faces a strong field of three-year-olds, including Group 1 winners Castelvechio (Dundeel), Shadow Hero (Pierro), Warning (Declaration Of War), Sherwood Forest (Fastnet Rock) and Prince Fawaz (Fastnet Rock), with an Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) berth on the line. "He will probably be better in six months time but they are only three once so he's having a go," Sargent said. "He's got all the ability in the world, he's probably just got to strengthen a bit. Saturday will tell us where we are in the mix against those good stayers. If he can be right there we'll press on to the Derby. He's bred to get up over ground so I don't think a mile and a half would worry him."

## Brandenburg to run in George Ryder

John Sargent's expected Rosehill Guineas runner may have been Brandenburg (Burgundy), but the New Zealand expatriate trainer has instead decided to test his three-year-old against the older horses in the George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) with one eye on a lightweight Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) tilt. Brandenburg, an upset winner of the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) two starts ago, was third last start in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) behind Shadow Hero (Pierro). "If he runs well, he'll go into the Doncaster with 49 kilos," Sargent said yesterday. "I was going to trial him but he galloped well this morning. It's a good form race for the Doncaster, so he'll be running. Also, we're low down the order of entry for the Doncaster, we've realised now, so we probably want to get some more points to get in there."

## Madam Rouge a lightweight chance in Galaxy

Trainer Chris Waller says that he "thought long and hard" about which jockey to put on Madam Rouge (Zoustar), his lightweight hope for The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m), but in

the end he is happy with his decision to opt for Kathy O'Hara. Madam Rouge will carry just 51 kilograms and Waller says it wasn't an easy decision. "It came down to the following reasons, and that's simply because Kathy continues to ride in Sydney each Saturday, she is respected by her peers, she's a strong jockey and also a natural at the weight," Waller said. "The option is, do you put a higher profile rider on and then bank on them losing a couple of kilos and still being as sharp, not just physically but also mentally? Kathy has actually won on the horse prior to her impressive Magic Millions win so she's got experience on the horse and I'm rapt to have her aboard."

## Manion Cup tilt for The Chosen One

New Zealand co-trainers Andrew Forsman and Murray Baker are hopeful their Group 1-placed colt can add another black-type victory to his resume in the N E Manion Cup at Rosehill on Saturday. The four-year-old produced a bold first-up placing in the Haunui Farm WFA Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) before tailing the field home in the Randwick City Stakes (Listed, 2000m) on March 7. "We're taking heart from the fact that he ran a bit flat second-up in his last preparation in the Underwood, then stepped up to 2400 metres with blinkers on and won the Herbert Power," Forsman said. "It's the same scenario again this weekend, although we'd ideally like to see the track improve a bit from Heavy 8."

## Zoustyle to stay at home

Brisbane sprinter Zoustyle (Zoustar) is unlikely to race interstate again after suffering a bleeding attack at Rosehill last Saturday and Tony Gollan was bitterly disappointed that Sydney had not got to see the best of the four-year-old. "He is so much better than that. But we have taken him interstate twice and both times it has been a disaster," Gollan said. "I knew there had to be something wrong when he stopped so quickly. He is automatically out for three months and I suppose we could have looked at the late spring. But I want to give him a good long spell and bring him back for the Brisbane summer. There are plenty of races for him here and he can stay here from now on."

## Stars Of Carrum returns for Mornington Cup

Pat Carey is hopeful his recent acquisition Stars Of Carrum (Fiorente) can bring home his second Mornington Cup (Listed, 2400m). But the trainer said it was not ideal to be running third-up in the feature race, especially on the quick back-up after finishing fourth in the Mornington Cup Prelude (Listed, 2000m) at Caulfield last Saturday. "We're happy with the horse and he came through his run well the other day," Carey said. "It's probably not the most ideal scenario backing-up and being third-up after having such a long break. But he gives the impression he's a clean-winded horse."

## Cultural Amnesia impresses

The Gerald Ryan-trained Cultural Amnesia (Snitzel) produced an impressive win on his third start yesterday, taking out the 2YO Maiden Plate (1400m) by two and a quarter lengths at Randwick-Kensington. "I've always had time for this colt, he's just very laid back," Ryan said. "He's a really nice horse and we'll now look to the Fernhill in a few weeks time at Randwick over the mile." Cultural Amnesia was a \$450,000 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale purchase by Ryan from the draft of Sledmere Stud. Arrowfield Stud's leading sire by winners Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) has produced 14 two-year-old scorers this season and has 63 yearlings on offer at next month's Inglis Easter sale. ## Kumasi to head to paddock

Meanwhile, Cultural Amnesia's Aquis Farm-owned stablemate Kumasi is set for a spell after finishing second in the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on Saturday. Aquis' managing director Shane McGrath announced on Twitter that the colt will return for a Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) campaign in the spring. "We have decided to send Kumasi to @AquisFarm for a break and get ready for an @atc\_races Golden Rose campaign," McGrath said. "Super effort in last weekend's Pago Pago behind Prague in his first prep. An exciting @GRyanRacing Spring prospect."

## Nimalee on Oaks path

After beating older horses in an 1800-metre BM74 at Randwick-Kensington yesterday, the Matthew Smith-trained Nimalee (So You Think) is on track for an Australian Oaks (Gr 1,

2400m) bid. "Since her last win two weeks ago she's just been thriving and looking forward to her work," Smith said. "She'll go to the Adrian Knox next and then hopefully on to the Oaks." Nimalee was a \$270,000 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale purchase by Randwick Bloodstock from the Millford Thoroughbreds draft and has built a tidy record of four wins and a second from six starts with prize-money topping \$117,000. Her Coolmore-based sire So You Think (High Chaparral) is enjoying one of his best ever seasons with eight stakes-winners to date and he has 12 yearlings on offer at the upcoming Inglis Easter sale. ## NSW follows New Zealand's lead

Racing NSW has followed New Zealand's lead and temporarily raised minimum riding weights by one kilogram to help jockeys during the coronavirus pandemic. Racetrack spa facilities have been closed for health reasons meaning jockeys cannot use them to assist in weight loss. Racing NSW chief executive Peter V'Landys said yesterday the minimum weight would go up from Monday. "Racing NSW is to raise minimum weights by one kilogram for the health benefit of jockeys and improve their resistance to getting sick," V'Landys said. "The well-being of our participants is paramount. This change will stay in place indefinitely until the virus situation changes".

## Victoria also raises weights

Racing Victoria has also followed suit in raising the minimum riding weights for jockeys. After consultation with the Victorian Jockeys' Association, RV announced on Wednesday that the minimum weight for all metropolitan and country races will be 56 kilograms. The new minimum weight, a rise of 2 kilograms for day meetings, will come into effect from next Tuesday's meeting at Geelong and remain until otherwise advised. To maintain the spread of weights across handicap races, the minimum top weight will rise to 62 kilograms while in two-year-old races it will be 61 kilograms.

## Rising stars get set to chase VOBIS riches

One month away from the 2020 Victorian Owners and Breeders Raceday at Caulfield, Racing Victoria yesterday released the

ballot order for its two feature contests, The Showdown (1200m) for two-year-olds and VOBIS Sires Guineas (1600m) for three-year-olds. Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Hanseatic (Street Boss) heads the entries for the \$1 million Showdown while Mitchell Freedman's Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) runner-up Southern Moon (Puissance de Lune) is at the top of the list for the Guineas. Both The Showdown and the VOBIS Sires Guineas form part of the VOBIS Gold Premier Race Series, an 18-race series open exclusively to VOBIS Gold-nominated horses offering a total of \$4.68 million in prize-money and bonuses. ## Gooree Stud to operate in commercial manner

Famed Mudgee thoroughbred nursery, Gooree Park Stud, has embarked on a major strategic change in direction with their business model, moving from being primarily a private racing and breeding operation to opening their gates commercially for the first time in 30 years. As a result of this change a unique opportunity for breeders and trainers has become available to the industry. Gooree Park Stud is guided by its Principal Eduardo Cojuangco Jr; inducted into the Australian Racing Hall of Fame in 2015, he is widely renowned as being one of the great breeders in the Southern Hemisphere for the past 40 years.

## Moody takes over Lindsay Park's stables

Peter Moody, whose training licence was renewed by Racing Victoria last week, will base himself at Pakenham, taking over 40 boxes that belonged to Lindsay Park. With co-trainer David Hayes bound for Hong Kong next season, the Lindsay Park operation has instead decided to move to a dual-site model, continuing with both their base at Euroa and a satellite stable at Flemington under Hayes' son Ben and nephew Tom Dabernig. That allowed Moody, who previously trained at Caulfield, to assume those boxes. "With me leaving, we just thought two training centres was enough in Melbourne," Hayes said. "We've moved on Monday, so it's all clear for Moods."

## NEW ZEALAND

## Group 2 to end The Mitigator's campaign

The Mitigator (Master Of Design) will look to end his Group 1-winning preparation on a high in Saturday's Japan Trophy (Gr 2, 1600m) at Tauranga. This season's Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner was passed in for NZ\$100,000 as a Ready To Run two-year-old but has now earned more than NZ\$380,000. "Trevor Luke tried to Ready to Run him," said trainer Peter McKay. "He didn't get the reserve so he said to a mate of his, Tim Davis, to try and get a syndicate together to purchase the horse. I kept saying this horse is going to be alright, just give him a bit of time. I think he had about nine starts as a three-year-old and it wasn't until he was four that he developed. I said whatever he is doing now he is going to be a better horse next year, and so it has proved."

## Proisir heads NZ second season sires

After a strong Saturday at Trentham, Proisir (Choisir) has stamped himself as a stallion to watch, leaping to the top of New Zealand's leading second sires by earnings. In 2019-20, Proisir's progeny have earned NZ\$515,585, taking him ahead of Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit). Proisir's Saturday results included both second and third in the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) with Vancooga and Feel The Rush, as well as Levante, an unlucky second in the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m). "Proisir has quickly proven himself a stallion that can upgrade

his mares which bodes very well for his stud future," commented Rich Hill's managing director John Thompson. "It is important to remember that Proisir's first crop progeny were conceived off a \$7,000 service fee."

## ASIA

## Moore relies on Savvy

No trainer has dominated the Hong Kong Derby (RL, 2000m) quite like John Moore. However, the six-time Derby winner admits that French import Savvy Nine (Anodin) was not quite his idea of what his final runner in the four-year-old Classic would look like. "He's in there and he's done everything right but I just feel this might be a bit strong for him. I'm just hoping he can pull a bit of prize money for the owner," Moore, who turned 70 on Tuesday - forcing his mandatory retirement at the end of the Hong Kong season in July - said yesterday, also ruing the withdrawal of Australian Group 2 winner Enjoying (Dundeel) due to a heart irregularity. "I thought I had a good chance with Enjoying because he really needs 2000 metres and more. It's disappointing and it has some effect on me and the stable staff."

## Poon's ticket to ride

Matthew Poon is excited for his first mount in the Hong Kong Derby, preparing to partner the Tony Cruz-trained Private Secretary (Kingman) in the HK\$20 million feature. Poon is one of a number of local Hong Kong riders who are capitalising on the opportunity to ride in the Derby with big-name jockeys around the world grounded due to the Covid-19 crisis;

Poon replaces Brett Prebble aboard the English import. "The Derby is the most prestigious race in Hong Kong - it's the biggest race here because it's only for four-year-olds, so it's once in a lifetime for the horse and it's really difficult to get a Derby ride," Poon said. "It's difficult to describe but I feel like the Hong Kong Derby is like the Melbourne Cup in Australia; this is our race - it's special." Poon will be aiming to be the first graduate of the Hong Kong Jockey Club's Apprentice Jockeys' School to taste Derby victory since Cruz himself in 1995.

## American Pharoah filly tops OBS March sale

A daughter of Coolmore shuttle sire American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) topped the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company March Two-Year-Olds In Training Sale on Tuesday, selling to Katsumi Yoshida for US\$650,000. Catalogued as **Lot 236**, the filly was consigned by Wavertree Stables and clocked a breeze-up time over a quarter of a mile in :20 2/5. "It's going to be all the usual cliches, but at the end of the day she was fast and she vetted good. And if they can do that, you're golden," said Wavertree's Ciaran Dunne. "She had a bit of pedigree. She was well-bought and well-sold, I would think." Out of the winning mare Megalicious (Songandaprayer), the session-topping filly is a half-sister to the stakes-placed My Sweet Stella (Eskendereya) and was bought for US\$165,000 at last year's Keeneland September Yearling Sale by Windfield Bloodstock.
