Black Soil's fillies experiment paying off with promising Isotope

Gollan-trained Deep Field two-year-old favourite to bring up hat-trick in Champagne Stakes

Isotope (Deep Field), the favourite for Saturday's BRC Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm, will further entrench her spot as the Black Soil Bloodstock flagbearer if she extends her unbeaten record to three at her first attempt at stakes level and strengthens her position towards the head of the J J Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1400m) betting in the process.

The boom juvenile, who is trained by Tony

Gollan, has emerged as the most promising of the Black Soil enterprise's small batch of two-year-olds secured at last year's sales after Sydney businessman Brian Siemsen and his advisers mapped out a plan to target well-bred fillies at last year's yearling sales.

Siemsen, who raced Group 1 winners Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo) and Temple Of Boom (Sequalo) with Gollan, had his trainer, renowned agent John Foote and Black Soil's principal agent Harry McAlpine assist in the selection process.

One of those was Isotope, the current \$5 equal favourite with Wisdom Of Water (Headwater) for the J J Atkins Plate, who burst onto the scene with a ten-length victory at Doomben on April 11 before backing it up with a professional performance at the Sunshine Coast on April 25 over 1000 metres.

The Deep Field (Northern Meteor) filly was given an exhibition gallop in company at Doomben last Wednesday and reports suggest she has come through her last start in fine order.

"I can only go by what the trainer tells me and he says that she's going exceptionally well," McAlpine said yesterday.

"Obviously, it's a step up now to Group level, but all the ratings and indicators suggest that she is up to the mark, we're looking forward to Saturday."

After such a dominant all-the-way win at her first start, McAlpine was taken with the way Isotope was able to settle behind the leaders and had the ability to go through a narrow gap before extending nicely to win by two and a quarter lengths second-up.

"It's pretty important to show that sort of racing pattern with her inexperience. She can sit off them, relax and travel and keep up with them, which is pretty impressive for only a two-start juvenile and that is what you need going into these big races," he said.

"Tony's mapped her campaign out from a long way out and so far it's gone to plan. She's travelled away from Brisbane (and won), but it's a bit of an unknown how the Eagle Farm surface will be.

"It seems like some horses handle the new Eagle Farm better than others, so I guess that is one unknown, but hopefully it's a good surface and she handles the track."

Black Soil Bloodstock, whose colours are also worn by stakes-placed three-year-old Niedorp (Not A Single Doubt), races the promising The Actuary (Sebring) and the unraced juveniles Bleu Zebra (I Am Invincible) and Rubin (Zoustar).

"Last year, we mapped out a plan ... to target fillies who looked like they were going to be two-year-olds and had a pedigree and family behind them," McAlpine said.

"The whole idea is to get good horses firstly, but to make sure that there's some residual there if they can't live up to that ability. So far, they all seem to be going well, which is good.

"The only other one to run so far out of that group is The Actuary who didn't run very well on Friday night at the Sunshine Coast (when fourth), but her second start at Doomben was pretty impressive when she ran on strongly for third.

"Those two are showing a heap of ability and we have an I Am Invincible filly which Tony has a very high opinion of and Rubin, a Zoustar filly, who is just coming to hand now."

While more than happy with the current line-up, it could have been even better for Black Soil Bloodstock had it been able to land this season's Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained star juvenile filly Away Game (Snitzel), who was victorious in four of her eight starts and the earner of more than \$2.7 million in prize-money.

"It is going well with what we've put in place with Tony and John Foote, to go and target these sorts of horses and it's nice that it's coming to hand," he said.

"But we were also under bidders on Away Game, so it's nice to know that we are shooting in the right direction."

As for Isotope, she was well under the \$425,000 that Away Game eventually sold for.

"We paid \$170,000 for her when at the time Deep Field's runners were only two, so it was a purchase we did on type," he said.

Supreme Thoroughbreds conducting reduction sale

Covers taken off Django Freeman

European import Django Freeman (Campanologist) is on track to make his Australian debut at Flemington, more than seven months later than trainer Robert Hickmott had hoped. Last year's German Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) runner-up arrived in Australia in August and was being set for a spring carnival campaign but that plan was aborted when he suffered a knee injury at trackwork in September. Django Freeman required surgery to remove a knee chip and after being given the time to recuperate, the four-year-old is scheduled to kick off his Australian career in a 1600-metre handicap at Flemington on Saturday. "It's been relatively straightforward with ongoing treatments and I've been very happy with his work over the last two weeks," Hickmott said. "He continues to improve with the fitness under his belt and he'll have his last hit-out at Sandown on Tuesday before going into the race at Flemington."

Trekking shortens in Stradbroke betting

The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Trekking (Street Cry) has been the big market mover after being heavily backed to land another big race in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m). Trekking will be aiming to be the first horse since Black Piranha (Clang) in 2009-10

and the eighth overall to win back-to-back Stradbrokes. He will also be aiming to give Godolphin its third Stradbroke in four tries after it also took the race with Impending (Lonhro) in 2017. Trekking was quoted at \$15 before taking South Australia's premier Group 1 sprint on Saturday. He is now as short as \$6 and a clear favourite in most bookmakers' markets for the biggest race of the Queensland winter carnival. Trekking is expected to head to Queensland next week to prepare for the Stradbroke at Eagle Farm on June 6.

Sunlight off to the paddock

Triple Group 1 winner Sunlight's (Zoustar) future remains unclear after two poor performances. Having finished last in TAB Classic (Gr 1, 1200m), trainers Tony and Calvin McEvoy made changes in the hope of an improved effort in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) last Saturday, but the mare again disappointed, six lengths adrift of Trekking (Street Cry). "She was disappointing again on the weekend and she'll go to the paddock now," Calvin McEvoy told Racing.com. "The owners will make a decision on her future while she spells."

Santa Ana Lane top weight for Straddie

Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) has been allotted top weight in his bid to gain a second win in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m). The Anthony Freedman-trained sprinter has been handicapped on 58.5kg, up 3kg on his 2018 win. Santa Ana Lane has since added two more elite-level victories to his record but the seven-year-old has been absent from the winners' enclosure since the 2019 TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). In his most recent appearance, Santa Ana Lane finished sixth

behind Trekking (Street Cry) in the Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville on Saturday. Trekking, who won the Stradbroke last year with 54kg, has been asked to carry an extra 4kg. No horse has carried more than 56kg to win the Stradbroke in the past 20 years with the metric weight record of 58kg shared by Rough Habit in 1991 and Campaign King in 1988.

Brisbane plans for Wild Ruler

Saturday's Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm is on the cards for Wild Ruler (Snitzel) who could strengthen his credentials for the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 6. "It's there for him if he runs well enough," Snowden said of a potential J J Atkins run. "We'll just get through Saturday first but if he's going well, timing-wise it's two weeks into that. So we'll just have to see what he does Saturday." The colt has also been nominated for a 1300-metre race at his home track Randwick, which could also prove to be a pointer for the Eagle Farm showpiece, as 18 of the 21 nominations for the Sydney race are also entered for the J J Atkins. Wild Ruler won the \$500,000 Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) at Randwick on debut in December before running a close second to subsequent Woodlands stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Macroua (Snitzel) over 1000 metres after a spell on May 2.

Australia in spring for Harlech

Trainer Mike Moroney has added promising four-year-old Harlech to his already impressive spring team. Harlech (Darci Brahma) is a Group 2 winner over 1400 metres in New Zealand and was twice a runner-up at Group 1 level this season in the NZ 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m). He had been considered for a possible Sydney autumn campaign this year before those ambitions were shelved. Moroney has won two Australasian Group 1's this season, with Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) winning the CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) in February and Tofane (Ocean Park) in the All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. Alabama Express has been retired to stud while Tofane is on a spell. "We're probably going to bring Harlech across from New Zealand," Moroney said. "He'll come across for a crack at some of those bigger miles."

Hawkes weigh up Crusader options

Co-trainer Wayne Hawkes has provided a positive update for Masked Crusader (Toronado) who was scratched on the morning of Saturday's Inglis Guineas (RL 1400m) with a stone bruise when previously favourite for the race. "We sprinted him up on Saturday morning and the girl who always rides him said he felt enormous ... but he just walked a touch ginger, that's all," Hawkes said yesterday to RSN 927. "We just erred on the side of caution and thought it's not worth taking the risk." Hawkes added that his work on Monday was excellent but said the three-year-old may end up heading for a spell. "He worked this morning and Michael's (Hawkes) quote was 'he is bucking his brands off'". What we do with him now? I'm not sure. I think there's a race Saturday week for him in Sydney, so we'll just see how he is the next couple of days before making a decision. There's probably every chance he might go to the paddock. He's done his job this time around if that's all we see of him."

Vega Magic off to the paddock

Multiple Group 1 winner Vega Magic (Lope De Vega) will head for a spell following his successful return to Western Australia on the weekend. Having not raced in WA since 2017, the seven-year-old showed tenacity to win the Roma Cup (Gr 3, 1200m). Having been his original trainer and watched his son Jake Casey have success on him when an apprentice, trainer Sean Casey said in an emotional race interview: "Looking at him (Vega Magic) makes me think of George (Daly), it makes me think of Jake, I could never, ever be so emotional after a race," Casey told Racing.com. Daly sadly passed away in March and Vega Magic is now racing for his brother Wally, with George's wife Gill still staying in the ownership. Vega Magic will not progress on this campaign after jarring up in his win. He will now have a break.

Black Heart Bart could bow out

Six-time Group 1 winner Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) is nearing retirement according to trainer Lindsey Smith and will be given one more opportunity to see whether he still maintains enthusiasm. Having his first start in Western Australia since late 2017, Black Heart

Bart finished last in the Roma Cup (Gr 3, 1200m), beaten eight lengths. "I didn't like what I saw," Smith told Racing.com. "I'm going to give him a really easy week and then we'll trial him next Monday, a decision will be made on his future after that." Smith, who trains his runners in heavy sand, believed that maybe Black Heart Bart was flat from the amount of work he had done in the lead up to the race. "Maybe he was a bit cooked from all of the work in the heavy sand leading up to the race," he said. "If he trials well then he can head to the Belmont Sprint, if not that will be enough for him."

Allen suffers broken hand

Jockey Ben Allen is set for a spell on the sidelines after falling at Pakenham last Thursday night. Allen fractured his hand when dislodged from his mount Mystical Melody (Starspangledbanner) in a 1400-metre maiden on the synthetic track. The 21-year-old was conscious and moving all limbs after the fall and was taken to Alfred Hospital, which cleared him of any major damage. The subsequent medical attention did however reveal a hand fracture, with doctors advising the injury would take at least four weeks to heal. Stewards adjourned the inquiry into Allen's fall after taking evidence from several riders.

Apprentice Neindorf to join Freedman stable

Up and coming South Australian apprentice Lachlan Neindorf will have a three-month riding stint with the Anthony Freedman stable in Victoria. Assistant trainer Sam Freedman confirmed on Monday that Neindorf will soon be moving to Melbourne. "Lachie will ride our runners at Murray Bridge on Saturday and we're hopeful to get him to Victoria sooner rather than later," Freedman told Racing.com of Neindorf.

"He will be based down at Mornington where we can feel he can gain a good work-life balance. Working with the likes of our number one track rider Robbie Scarlett and the team down there at Pinecliff, we hope will be beneficial for his development."

Enquiry into Tasmanian Derby winner

A stewards' enquiry will soon take place as to how Vamos Raffa (Stratum) returned a swab irregularity before winning the Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m) on February 1. It comes after a pre-race blood test taken before he managed his only win in eight starts. Tasmania's chief steward Scott Quill told Racing.com on Monday that the B-sample test result had confirmed the findings of the original swab irregularity. Although no date has been set, the intention is to finalise a hearing with trainer Scott Brunton before the end of this week. "We'll hold an inquiry and gather evidence before any charges are laid," Quill told Racing.com. The swab result continues an unsettled time for Brunton, who appeared in a Hobart court facing multiple charges related to drugs and firearms in December, a matter which remains ongoing. Brunton has been Tasmania's leading trainer since 2014/15 and leads this season's premiership with 41 wins, seven clear of his nearest rival, with racing suspended in the state until June 13.

NEW ZEALAND

Melbourne spring target for Jennifer Eccles

New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) is likely to campaign in Melbourne during the spring carnival. New Zealand-based bloodstock agent Adrian Clark who manages syndication business Challenge Racehorse Syndicates announced the filly would resume at Flemington in mid-September. "All things going well she will trial in New Zealand before resuming September 12 in the Let's Elope Stakes at Flemington," Clark said in a statement. Connections had hoped to campaign Jennifer Eccles during the Sydney autumn carnival following her Oaks win but Covid-19 restrictions scuppered those plans with the suspension of international equine flights.

Farm life too appealing for Bosson

Leading New Zealand jockey Opie Bosson is back on his Pukekawa farm after a successful campaign in Sydney. "It's great to be back out in the fresh air," Bosson told NZ Racing Desk. "I am busy on the farm most of the day, whereas in Sydney I had to make sure I went for a run or walk every single day and it was a little bit boring living in an apartment." Bosson's living arrangements were further confined when he returned to Auckland and had to undergo a fortnight of quarantine in a hotel room due to Covid-19 travel restrictions. "It was very boring. I was there for two weeks and I only went for a walk twice," he said. While Bosson contemplated a more permanent shift across the Tasman to see out his riding career, Te Akau's retained rider admitted the rural lifestyle was hard to leave and he will continue to ride for Te Akau for another year. "It was tempting (to move to Australia) but I really missed the farm. If I didn't have the farm or Te Akau I would definitely have gone."

Vale Jock Harris

New Zealand racing is mourning the patriarch of a racing dynasty following the death of Jock (John William) Harris. He passed away last Saturday and the family have been flooded by phone calls and messages since his death, just a few months short of his 90th birthday. His three oldest sons, John, Des and Noel, were all leading apprentice jockeys, topping the New Zealand apprentice table six years in succession. His three other children, Peter, Karen and Jenny also rode on raceday with Peter becoming leading jumps jockey for the 1976-1977 season. Like his father, John became

a successful trainer, as did Des, both celebrating Group 1 wins. Harris was born in New Plymouth and left school at 15 to be a jockey, having been encouraged by his father to sign up with trainer George New at Awapuni. After retiring from riding at Awapuni on Boxing Day 1959, Harris left racing for a period, working at an auction market as a builder's labourer before deciding to take up harness racing. He returned to Palmerston North and began his training career with just a few horses. His first winner was Goa at Awapuni in 1961. He trained horses such as Caulfield Stakes (2000m) winner Glengowan (Arragon), who was also second in the 1973 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) when ridden by Harris's son Noel.

Lane to continue Japan stint

Australian jockey Damian Lane is preparing to extend his latest stint in Japan, beginning with the Japanese Oaks meeting. Lane has been riding out of Tokyo on a four-week contract but is confident his overseas licence will be renewed for a further two months. Since arriving in Japan in April, Lane has been in great form and is fresh from winning a Group 2 in Tokyo at the weekend. "It should all go through this week," Lane said. "On my original licence, last weekend would have been my last weekend riding. But I'm expecting (a new licence) to go through on Wednesday and hopefully line up in the Oaks on Saturday on a nice filly that I won a Listed race on last start." Lane rode with success in Japan last year in a move that proved fruitful for the 2019 Melbourne spring carnival. It meant he gained rides on the Japanese contingent in Melbourne, landing the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1,

2400m) and Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) on Mer De Glace (Rulership) and Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry).

Rich Hill releases fees for roster of five stallions

Three of Rich Hill Stud's stallions will have their service fees unchanged while young sire Proisir (Choisir) has earned an increase for 2020 after the New Zealand farm yesterday confirmed its line-up for this year.

Vadamos (Monsun), whose first crop yearlings sold up to NZ\$330,000 at the New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Sale this year, will again stand for a fee of NZ\$15,000 (all fees plus GST) while Satono Aladdin (Deep Impact) (NZ\$12,500) and Ace High (High Chaparral) (NZ\$10,000) will also stand for the same fee as last year.

Proisir, whose first crop three-year-olds include Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Riodini and the stakes-placed Levante and Pilico as well as New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) placed pair Feel The Rush and Vancooga, has had his fee increased from NZ\$6,500 to NZ\$9,000 this year.

Shocking (Street Cry) has had his fee reduced slightly from NZ\$8,500 to NZ\$8,000.

"The word coming in now from breakers is extremely positive," Thompson said.

"No surprises, we knew they were lovely movers with great attitudes. We look forward to seeing his progeny out trialling and racing next autumn at two in preparation for the all-important spring three-year-old racing."

The coronavirus pandemic and the shutdown of the New Zealand industry prevented some of Proisir's best prospects being showcased in Australia during the autumn and winter but Thompson believes his progeny are showing enough talent for the stallion to see his fee go up.

There, however, remained some uncertainty about the availability of Shadai Stallion Station shuttler Satono Aladdin this year but Thompson was hopeful of the son of Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) being able to make it to New Zealand in August.

"We have had a lot of interest from breeders based on his outstanding first crop foals. We are however working through possible quarantine and travel options due to the current Covid-19 situation," he said.

"Satono Aladdin is a beautifully-bred son of Deep Impact who won Japan's most prestigious Group 1 mile race, the Yasuda Kinen, so we are very keen for him to return to New Zealand if a viable travel option can be worked out."

Managing director John Thompson said the Rich Hill stallion roster offered breeders "the opportunity to not only breed a good racehorse but also achieve a profitable return in the sale ring".

He is upbeat about the prospects of European Group 1 winner Vadamos, who had a two-start Australian campaign in 2016 before being retired to stud, after his progeny were well received in the sale ring earlier this year.

Golden Grove Stud getting back on track

Hunter Valley farm Golden Grove Stud is in the process of embarking on a plan to become a full-scale commercial entity after being hard-hit by drought in recent years.

The 259-acre property, near Denman, is owned by Melbourne businessman Sean Buckley and large-scale Northern Territory pastoralist Viv Oldfield with the latter taking charge of Golden Grove Stud in recent times.

Golden Grove Stud manager Grant Mackay said the change in direction had started last year with the relocation of the Buckley and Oldfield-owned Shamus Award (Snitzel) relocating from Widden Stud to Rosemont Stud in Victoria.

"The drought really hurt us, particularly on this farm, but we've put things in place to hopefully future-proof the farm more than anything," Mackay said yesterday.

"There's always been a good water supply under the (Wybong) Creek that fronts the farm. Basically, all we did was cleaned up and repaired the irrigation equipment that was already there, which we're allowed to do.

"We haven't gone and added anything but we've undertaken a heap of maintenance on what was there. There's more water under the creek than what there is in it."

Buckley's horses are now located at Barree Stud in Victoria while Oldfield currently has about 13 mares on Golden Grove, which has bounced back with good rainfall this year.

"They took Shamus Award down to Victoria and it was more of a convenience thing with Sean having Barree, his own personal farm that he's got down there," said Mackay who has been with Golden Grove since August 2017.

"Viv's got a few mares that he sends to Shamus Award as well and then he's got a few others that he sends elsewhere.

"We've got 12 or 13 of Viv's and he's still got a couple of more who we left in Victoria to go to stallions like Written Tycoon, so they were down there for last season while we got this place back up and running and ready to go. They will come home for this season."

Golden Grove took two yearlings owned by Oldfield to the Magic Millions Adelaide

Yearling Sale in March and averaged \$87,500 while Mackay said the intention was to take on more outside clients for the foaling down of mares, servicing the Hunter Valley stallion farms as well as the spelling of racehorses.

"We will be doing the whole lot. We are within 40 minutes of Widden and 45 minutes of Scone and a tick over an hour to Aquis, but the rest of them are centrally located," said Mackay, the son of "battling Queensland trainer" Reg and brother to Grafton trainer Brenden.

"There's 259 acres at Golden Grove and we have another farm that we are just starting to get up and going - the old Riverslea Farm on Rosemount Road, but it's not operational yet."

Derby Trial caps off a big weekend for Corrales

Former four-time Champion Macau Jockey Luis Corrales enjoyed one of his best weekends at the Taipa racetrack with five winners over the two days' racing, capped off by his last-stride win in the Listed SJM Macau Derby Trial over 1500 metres (turf) on Winnie Star (Medaglia d'Oro).

In one of the most open Derby Trial fields for some years, Corrales settled the son of Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) near the tail of the field before making steady ground from the 800 metres via the rail. Once in the home straight he peeled Winnie Star off the fence into clear running; and once balanced the four-year-old produced a brilliant turn of foot and powered down the outside to snatch victory by a short-head over Star Of Yiu Cheung (Casino Prince) in a thrilling three-way finish, with Hostwin Epanoui (More Than Ready) a short-head away in third.

Morphettville on Saturday. Winnie Star was only starting to let down over the last 200 metres of Saturday's 1500-metre contest, so the Derby trip of 1800 metres would seem to be perfect for the gelding. Race favorite Hostwin Saturn (Stratum) had no joy from his wide gate (11) and was caught three deep in the run and spoilt his chances by overracing. He was one-paced in the straight to finish sixth, four and a quarter lengths away. The Nick Moore-trained gelding was coming off a dominant win over 1800 metres in his start prior and still looms as the horse to beat in the SJM Derby on July 19.

Second placed Star Of Yiu Cheung was another that raced fiercely in the run when travelling in the box seat third, and showed plenty of fight to go down narrowly. The son of Casino Prince (Flying Spur) would need to relax a lot more in the run to get a strong 1800 metres. The runs by both Hostwin Epanoui and fifth-placed King Of Glamour (Eurozone) were full of merit. Hostwin Epanoui came home hard along the rail from near the tail of the field to just miss in a head-bobbing finish. King of Glamour was taken back from barrier eight by apprentice Eric Cheung and didn't get into the race as he would have liked. He was only really getting into his work late and

was only beaten four lengths. Beautiful Eighteen (Epaulette), who was coming off a big win last start at 1500 metres, was disappointing.

Modena Best (Medaglia d'Oro) was the first of Corrales winners for the weekend when he hit the line well on Friday night in the Class 3 over 1500 metres. Prepared by Wayne Smith, Modena Best is a former Australian galloper who raced there as Underground, winning three races in country New South Wales when trained by Brad Widdup.

Other wins for Corrales on Friday night were Lucky Gold (Catain Rio) prepared by Joe Lau in the Class 3 & 4 over 1050 metres, and Blackjack Mok (All Too Hard) trained by W H "Rambo" Tse in the Class 4 over 1510 metres. Saturday also saw Corrales quick off the mark when he ran away with the first of the day, the Maiden over 1200 metres, on the Danny Wong-trained Special Charger (Helmet).

Corrales has been on fire of late winning ten races so far for the month of May and after Saturday is on 35 winners for the season, leading Roger Yu (28) by seven victories, with J B Hamel in third spot on 23 winners. A fifth Senior Jockeys' Championship is looming as a great possibility. Corrales also has won two Champion Apprentice Titles in Macau.

Patrick Lee has a few nice newcomers in his yard and, as well as his Derby Trial victory over the weekend, Lee led in another two winners in Diamond Moonlight (The Wow Signal) and Crispy Biscuit (Written Tycoon) both ridden by Peter Ho. Diamond Moonlight is a strong-looking son of The Wow Signal (Starspangledbanner) who picked up his maiden win in the 2 & 3 Year Old Handicap over 1050 metres on the sand on Friday night.

Crispy Biscuit is a former Queenslander who raced there as Shaken Not Stirred, winning three races when prepared by Matthew Park. The four-year-old son of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) put up a good performance to win Saturday's Class 2 & 3 over 1200 metres. Fired out of barrier 11 by Ho to zip across and sit off the leader Gem Glory (I Am Invincible),

Crispy Biscuit really dug in well in the straight to go home stronger than Hostwin Shadow (Longhorn), with Gem Glory in third. Saturday's win came off a good win on the all weather over 1050 metres on April 17.

Frenchman Stephane Ladjadj was back in the winners' circle with a double over the weekend with Broadus (Danbird) and We Love Macau (Fast 'N' Famous). Broadus, prepared by Peter Leyshan, was the first of Ladjadj's winners when he finished powerfully to take out the Class 5 & 6 over 1600 metres. We Love Macau was the second victory for Ladjadj when he won the Class 5 & 6 over 1500 metres on the turf on Saturday. Prepared by Joe Lau, We Love Macau was sporting blinkers for the first time after coming off three moderate runs prior to this victory. On Saturday the three-year-old son of Fast'N'Famous
