NZB delighted as internationals pounce on day one of Ready to Run Sale



Lot 54: Sacred Falls half-brother to stakes winner Stella Di Paco

There was an air of confidence in the lead-up to day one of the New Zealand Bloodstock Ready to Run Sale but company figureheads were reluctant to make it public in case the optimism failed to eventuate but the international market's appetite for stock was certainly evident in yesterday's opening session of the two-year-old auction.

The platform for the day's trade was set with the first two lots through the ring - a NZ\$320,000

Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) colt and a son of Savabeel (Zabeel) who made NZ\$400,000 - in a market where the key international buying benches of Australia and Hong Kong lived up to their pre-sale interest in the auction.

Later in the 160-lot session a son of the late Waikato Stud-based stallion Sacred Falls (O'Reilly), the sire of this month's New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Aegon and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) runner-up Salto Angel, made NZ\$525,000. *Continued on page 2>>*

South Australian racing sidelined for six days

The NZ\$80,000 Karaka yearling led the session in which ten two-year-olds made more than NZ\$200,000 and another 15 made NZ\$100,000 or more.

Last night, with a number of talented horses set to go through the ring today, the average was at NZ\$92,872, the median was NZ\$51,250 and the aggregate was NZ\$7,615,500.

The clearance rate was also 60 per cent.

The figures were still down on the same session at the 2019 sale, but NZB sales manager Danny Rolston was delighted with how the day panned out.

"If you handed us these results on a plate a week ago I think we would have been doing handstands," Rolston said.

"We had a great run of horses in that first ten lots and it was really important, because sometimes you can have a really nice horse in amongst them, and it is hard to get the buyer confidence to bid early, but we certainly

saw the opposite today and that really got us kicked off and in good shape."

With a number of leading buyers unable to attend the sale in person, it was left to trusted New Zealand

agents and trainers to inspect and bid on their clients' behalf, with Group 1-winning trainer Graham Richardson buying the Sacred Falls colt and a son of Headwater (Exceed And Excel) for NZ\$300,000 for a "loyal but private client from Hong Kong".

"He (Sacred Falls) is flying. It is sad that he has passed. Most of them just need a bit of time, but they are nice, athletic horses," Richardson said.

"I am absolutely chuffed for New Zealand Bloodstock and the vendors here because it is a nervous time, and money goes around and we all need each other.

"I love buying horses at this sale. I have for years and have had a lot of luck."

Out of Savabeel Star (Savabeel), who is a half-sister to New Zealand Group 3 winner Stardane (Soviet Star), the Sacred Falls colt is a half-brother to Listed winner Stella Di Paco (Paco Boy) and two other winners including Shining On (O'Reilly) and the former Leahy-trained Viva Chef. He was catalogued as Lot 54 and he breezed up in 10.77 seconds.

It was a big pinhooking result for former jumps jockey-turned-trainer Finbarr Leahy who bought the colt from the Cambridge Stud draft for NZ\$80,000 at the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale earlier this year.

The colt was offered through Sam Beatson's Riversley Park draft, who Leahy usually partners with along with Ben Foote in pinhooking horses.

"It is going to take a while to sink in, but it's fantastic," Leahy said.

"The year 2020 has been lucky for me at the moment, but for my wife and kids it is going to be life changing for them, it's fantastic.

"You always hope, you always have dreams, and today they have been fulfilled.

"He has been popular. He has been in and out of his box more times than any other horse on the complex, so that is always a good sign."

It was his experience with Viva Chef which led Leahy to backing his judgment in buying the colt.

"I was lucky enough to have the full-brother (Viva Chef) and it was kind of Gary Carvell to send him to me to train," he said.

"I won a trial with him and I thought this horse has gears. Luckily he won in Hong Kong the other night.

"You take a chance and if you like a horse you sometimes have to go with your gut feeling. Luckily enough this time it has paid off. A couple of times it hasn't but this time it has, so we are delighted."

Cambridge Stud will offer the colt's half-brother by shuttler Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) at next year's NZB Karaka Yearling Sale.

Richardson also bought the NZ\$300,000 Headwater colt for the same Hong Kong client from Shane Crawford and Kara Waters' Regal Farm in another successful pinhook result having sold a son of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) for \$610,000 at the Inglis Ready 2 Race Sale last month.

"I am surprised and not surprised and he is definitely a lovely colt," Crawford said.

"He's full of quality and we had him on the market at \$160,000, so it was great for us having such a small draft."

Catalogued as Lot 32, the colt was an \$80,000 purchase by Thoroughbred Union from the Vinery Stud draft at this year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. He breezed up in 11.07 seconds.

Agent Dean Hawthorne was under bidder.

Yiu active at Karaka

Soon after missing out on the Headwater juvenile, Hawthorne struck for a colt by No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) who made NZ\$220,000 on behalf of champion Hong Kong trainer Ricky Yiu.

Active at both the Inglis and Magic Millions two-year-old sales, Yiu added to his Australian haul by securing the colt via New Zealand agent Hawthorne.

Offered by Riversley Park as Lot 38, the colt breezed up in 10.51 seconds. He was a successful pinhook for Riversley Park and Woburn Farm who paid \$55,000 for him at the 2019 Magic Millions National Weanling Sale. Out of winning Danzero (Danehill) mare Renounceable, he is a half-sister to two Australian winners and from the same family as Group 1 winner Vouvray (Zabeel) and Group 2 winner Real Success (Success Express).

Riversley Park's Sam Beatson said: "It's a terrific result. The No Nay Nevers can run and we bought him at the weanling sale on the Gold Coast.

"We bypassed the yearling sale and kept him specifically for the Ready to Run sale, having done the same thing with several Tavistocks a few years back and with some success."

Busuttin and Young busy on day one

The second highest-priced lot sold yesterday at NZ\$400,000, a Savabeel colt offered by Sam Beatson's cousin Jamie under his Ohukia Lodge banner, will head to Australia to be trained by expatriate New Zealanders Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young who ended up with two-year-olds on day one.

"We would rather be there than not, but it is what it is. I don't think we are too far away from hopefully Jacinda (Ardern, New Zealand Prime Minister) opening up the borders," Busuttin said.

"We have been using it (online bidding platform) for the last few sales now, it's pretty straight forward and very good."

"I thought his breeze-up was very good and the feedback I had from the people who looked at him in New Zealand for me was that they thought he was the best horse on the sales ground on type. He ticked all the boxes," Busuttin said.

"There are plenty of good people over there looking at them, so maybe that is the way of the future.

"There is nothing like being there yourself but we were confident in the people who were looking at him for us."

Catalogued as Lot 3 and the second horse through the ring, the colt is out of the unraced On Broadway (Pins) who is a sister to the stakes-placed Pins On Parade and Dower, herself the dam of Listed-winning, Group 1-placed mare Dowager Queen (Savabeel).

"I thought I might have to go that high, I was hoping not," he said. "We thought we would have to pay between \$300,000 and \$400,000. That was our last bid, we wouldn't have gone much more than that.

"We have got a good relationship with Ohukia Lodge. They break in a lot of our horses in New Zealand. Jamie gave this horse a big rap in particular, and you have full confidence that they know what a good horse is."

"We have got a good client, Ben Kwok, he races a nice two-year-old with us in Australia and he has gone in again for a significant share. It's good to have him onboard.

"The colt will make a nice 1600 to 2000-metre middle distance horse. We will get him over to Australia and give him a month off. A three-year-old campaign will be his go."

<< *Continued from page 4* The colt was sold for NZ\$220,000 by Waikato Stud to Ohukia Lodge at the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale last January before being educated by Jamie Beatson for the ready to run sale. He breezed up in 10.52 seconds at Te Rapa.

"It was a bit of a surprise but we had an inkling he would sell well," Jamie Beatson said.

"We are really happy that he has gone to such a good judge and a great stable. Trent and Natalie know what they are doing.

"It is a great start to the sale for us. I hope it stays that way."

Busuttin and Young, who also spent \$740,000 at last month's Inglis Ready 2 Race Sale, including the purchase of two colts by Savabeel for \$330,000 and \$310,000 respectively, also bought another Savabeel colt for NZ\$120,000 and a Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit) gelding for NZ\$52,500 from Riverrock Farm.

The couple also paid NZ\$220,000 for a Dundee colt, catalogued as Lot 95, from Ohukia Lodge which was another successful pinhook result for Beatson.

"Sam (Beatson) and I, before we went our separate ways, broke in Dundee, so I have always had a soft spot for the Dundees," Jamie said.

"He was a bit small and quite weak as a yearling but he has done incredibly well.

"We bought him from Hallmark Stud (for NZ\$15,000) and Mark Baker told us he was there for sale, he was owned by some Australian owners who were keen to sell."

No doubt about first lot through the ring

The horse to get the sale off to a bang was the Jamieson Park homebred colt by Not A Single Doubt who was bought by well-known New Zealand owner Gary Harding, who also raced Group 1 winner Bounding (Lonhro).

The only lot in the sale for Jamieson Park's Sam Munro, who passed the colt in at the virtual Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale when the New Zealand-consigned horses could not make it to Australia due to coronavirus restrictions.

Breezing up in 10.49 seconds, the colt is the first foal out of O'Naturelle (O'Reilly), a Listed-placed winner who is a half-sister to the Group 2-placed Orutan (Pins). He was catalogued as Lot 2.

"I loved the colt, but I didn't like the price," Harding said.

"Originally, I wasn't going to attend the sale but I started to get itchy feet and as my stocks were getting a bit depleted I decided to get here.

"We've bought a lot of yearlings here but this is my first ever Ready to Run purchase. We only came here to get this one colt.

"I love the sire and the mare had some talent, according to Sam Munro (of Jamieson Park).

"He is very well balanced and the page is good. We will try him here (New Zealand) first and if he shows us anything we will look at Australia."



Lot 120: Reliable Man colt

Te Akau's David Ellis, sitting in his customary seat at Karaka alongside trainer Jamie Richards, was the under bidder.

"We bred him from a mare we raced. She showed us some real ability so was worth the outlay of Not A Single Doubt's service fee," Munro said.

"He was to go to Sydney, but we know what happened about that. His breeze up was excellent and he is a natural athlete."

Harding later also purchased the Reliable Man (Dalakhani) filly out of Zuzela (Redoute's Choice) from the Westbury Stud draft for NZ\$270,000. Catalogued as Lot 125, she is closely related to recent Geelong Classic (Listed, 2200m) winner Confrontational (Redoute's Choice).

Windfall for Harveys

Another two-year-old by Reliable Man also provided Ascot Farm's Bruce and Maureen Harvey and their son Glen with a significant return on their meagre investment when the NZ\$5,100 purchase returned NZ\$230,000 yesterday.

Originally bought through the Gavelhouse online portal, he was consigned under Glen Harvey's Roysyn Stables banner as Lot 120 and it was Hong Kong trainer Francis Lui who was prepared to outlay the sum to secure the horse.

"He was sold by Cambridge Stud and he had a pedigree that we knew quite well," Glen Harvey said.

"We had a horse out of Shalt Not (second dam) before for the Hong Kong sale. Amelia's Dream (dam's half-sister) was a pretty freakish race horse that we never really got to see the best of.

"We had bought another Reliable Man earlier that night for \$3,500, so we thought that this guy definitely had the better pedigree.

"It was no risk buying two horses for \$9,000 when the service fee was \$15,000. It was the law of averages and he kept thriving the whole time."

The gelding is the first foal out of Ziffel (Zabeel), an unplaced half-sister to Richard Pegum's former star filly Amelia's Dream (Redoute's Choice) who won the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) before injury ended her race career.

Harvey had been pleased with the gelding's development and felt he could handle a Ready To Run preparation. *Continued on page 8>>*

"We always thought we could do quite well, especially from the reports when he was broken in," Harvey said.

"He had that confidence and toughness about him that he could handle the preparation for a Ready To Run.

"It's a good family occasion and nice for Mum and Dad to get a result like that. They have put a lot of money into the industry over the years and it is nice to see them getting rewarded."

The focus of NZB's Rolston, meanwhile, was last night on ensuring the momentum of the sale flowed through to today and he is confident that it will.

"There are some big lots, but quite honestly, they will take care of themselves with the level inquiry we've had," he said.

"While we are paying a lot of attention to them, it is really important from our team's point of view to make sure the bulk of the catalogue gets taken care of.

"We're working tirelessly to market

those horses who might fall outside that obvious bracket and I think what we saw today was a culmination of everyone's efforts, the technology working and great New Zealand results firing all around the world.

"It's come to fruition today."

Day two starts at 1pm New Zealand time.

South Australian racing sidelined for six days

Racing in South Australia has been called off for six days due to stricter Covid-19 restrictions imposed on the region. Trainers are seeking clarity on their ability to exercise their horses, as the new stay at home orders came into place at midnight yesterday. As a result, Saturday's meeting at Morphettville will no longer take place, along with Friday's meeting at Naracoorte, Sunday's Clare Cup and Wednesday's Strathalbyn trials. In an email to his owners, trainer Will Clarken said: "We have received information that all racing in South Australia will be halted for 6 days as part of the statewide shutdown in response to the most recent Covid-19 outbreak. This is a disappointing situation, however we understand and support the decision made by the State Government. It is as yet unclear as to if this will affect trackwork proceedings, however all horses currently in the stable will continue to receive their daily care and attention as normal."

Group 1 winner El Dorado Dreaming retired

2018 Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner El Dorado Dreaming (Illovethecity) has been retired following her 14th-placed finish in The Hunter (1300m) on Saturday. The five-year-old mare, whose only career victory came in the Group 1 at Randwick, returned from an eight-month absence following surgery in March, and trainer Kris Lees decided to retire the mare after The Hunter due to ongoing injury problems. El Dorado Dreaming will now head to Torryburn Stud after an 18-race

career. "El Dorado Dreaming has been retired to Torryburn Stud," Lees announced on Twitter. "Unfortunately injuries plagued her career but she was a consistent performer for her owner Yvette Pearce. Looking forward to seeing her progeny race in the future."

Pike poised for big Perth return

Leading Australian jockey Willie Pike will return to action at Ascot on Saturday following the completion of his 14-day quarantine period. Pike will be hoping to make an immediate return to the winners' circle aboard Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) favourite Inspirational Girl (Reliable Man), before partnering Trekking (Street Cry) in the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) a week later. "I haven't quite got home yet, but it is nice to be back over here and it's (quarantine) almost done so there's plenty to look forward to," Pike, who is excited to ride Inspirational Girl on Saturday, told Racing.com. "She won the lead-up (Asian Beau Quality) and she's favourite for a reason so it's easy to look forward to her." Pike also reflected on his period in Victoria and has fond memories of the trip. "Things went as good as they could have gone really," he said. "I made a lot of new contacts and achieved some success. I had one real standout day (four winners on Caulfield Guineas Day, including two Group 1s) and had some other good days as well."

Alexander eyes history with Kiwia

Archie Alexander is not concerned with Kiwia's (Reset) form ahead of his attempt to become the first horse to win three consecutive Ballarat Cup's (Listed, 2000m). The seven-year-old has not won since last year's Ballarat Cup, however

his last win before that was in the 2018 edition of the race and Alexander has followed the same race pattern as the previous year. "It's amazingly similar. He ran third in the Coongy Stakes at Caulfield last year and that's all he's done in the lead-up too," Alexander said. "He's in the same form as last year. We're not panicking. We only have to look at last year and know he comes good in the Ballarat Cup. If I didn't know the horse and know that it had worked it would be different, but he fires up in the Ballarat Cup. He's shown glimpses of form, as he did last year with another third in the Coongy. Like a lot of horses he's been in the wrong races as he's needed to step up in distance." Kiwia is one of six horses who have won the Ballarat Cup two years in a row, but none have gone on to record a third success.

Autumn Passage depends on Gong and Villiers

Future plans for talented four-year-old Dawn Passage (Dawn Approach) will hinge on his performances in Saturday's The Gong (1600m) at Kembla Grange and next month's Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Randwick. The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained four-year-old will gain a golden ticket into the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick if winning the Villiers, but his immediate attention is on the \$1 million The Gong where he will be hoping to notch his first success this preparation. "That's (The Gong) been the plan all along. We've also got a race like the Villiers on the radar for him," Bott said. "These next two runs will help finalise what his autumn campaign might look like." Dawn Passage was a courageous third to Colette (Hallowed Crown) in the Golden Eagle (1500m) last start after racing wide on a heavy track. The Gong will be his first test over

1600 metres but, given how well he coped with 1500 metres on testing ground last start, Bott expects Dawn Passage to be untroubled by the extra distance. "Getting out to the mile the first time, you'd think he'd be able to see it out, particularly given the prospect of a good, quick track," Bott said. "Also his pattern of racing, he can often settle well in his races and he's got a good turn of foot when he conserves his energy. I expect him to be able to do that from the nice soft draw (gate 16)."

Gong to Hong Kong for Olmedo

Olmedo (Declaration Of War) will contest next month's Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin if he performs to expectations in the The Gong on Saturday. Olmedo, who is part-owned by Hong Kong-based Tony Fung's Aquis Farm, finished an encouraging sixth in the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) last month, her only run in the spring so far. "As long as he performs to expectations on Saturday, he'll be going for probably the Hong Kong Cup," Aquis managing director Shane McGrath told Racing.com. "He's a French Guineas winner and a horse with plenty of class. He had his first start for Chris (Waller) in the Cantala (when sixth) over the carnival and he ran super I thought. Being first-up might have caught him out, but he'll be spot-on for Saturday."

Bivouac to head abroad in 2021

VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) will be campaigned internationally in 2021, with Godolphin keen for the four-year-old to follow in the footsteps of his sire Exceed And Excel and establish himself as a future dual-hemisphere stallion. Bivouac's devastating three-and-a-quarter-length defeat of Nature Strip (Nicconi) in the Spring Classic resulted in him receiving an international rating of 125, joint fourth in the LONGINES World's Best Racehorse Rankings. "His father was by far and away the best reverse-shuttle stallion of all time and we'd love to keep that legacy going," Godolphin Australia's manager director Vin Cox told Racing.com. "This would not only be fantastic for the business but also, to race the horse in front of Sheikh Mohammed, our principal, would be

wonderful. If he was to win in Dubai or Europe it would be fantastic for the Australian organisation and Godolphin generally. We've loosely talked about it, although it's a long way off, but it would include something like a Lightning Stakes here then up to Dubai for the Al Quoz Sprint and then to Europe. We could go to Royal Ascot and then worry about it after that. Of course, that's all in an ideal world and as we know things with horses can change, but we'd love to take that on."

Ain'tnodeeldun for Kobritz's colt

David Kobritz rejected a big-money offer from Hong Kong for his three-year-old Ain'tnodeeldun (Dundeel) following his TAB Trophy Stakes (Listed, 1800m) win at Flemington earlier this month. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained colt has won on his last three outings and attracted a substantial amount of money, but Kobritz is keen to race him on in Australia. "There was interest in him after he won the Hill Stakes in Adelaide. And then after he won at Flemington the interest ramped up very considerably," Kobritz told Racing.com. "We had a long chat with Anthony and Sam. The money is obviously attractive, but most of the owners love racing horses and Ain'tnodeeldun has done everything to date as a two-year-old, he's only turned three about 10 days ago. We felt that there was a lot of upside potentially in him as a three-year-old and even a four-year-old. As I've said to many friends, we could all look very stupid in six months' time. We want to support Australian racing as far as we can. It's an expensive game to be in, but at the same time we are in it for the love of the horse and the love of racing. Sometimes you make a decision from the heart rather than the head or the pocket."

News Girl returns to Corowa

News Girl (Magnus) could return to the racetrack by late autumn, after undergoing a successful operation on a tendon injury suffered in September. Trainer Geoff Duryea is delighted with the news and expects to be able to race the five-year-old mare by March. "We picked her up from Wangaratta where she has been recuperating. I took her out to the paddock (Wednesday) morning," Duryea told

Racing.com. "She went and had a scan and got another really, really good result. It's healing terrific, so all we need to do is give her a bit of time. They reckon there's no reason why she can't come back as good as gold. She will have another three or four months (in the paddock) and if everything goes according to plan then she will be ready to go."

Launceston abandoned

Launceston's nine-race card was abandoned yesterday due to issues with the track. After delaying the start of the meeting indefinitely earlier in the day, officials decided to pull the plug, stating on Twitter: "Launceston Thoroughbred meeting postponed at 6.17pm due to maintenance issues with the track."

Parnham injured in fall

Steven Parnham has suffered a broken collarbone and three broken ribs following a nasty fall in the second race at Ascot yesterday. Parnham was conscious and transferred to hospital via an ambulance after his fall aboard Powerful (Nicconi) in the 1400-metre handicap for three-year-olds. He will now miss the ride on leading Railway Stakes fancy Kay Cee (Playing God).

Melham to contest betting charges

Ben Melham will attend County Court between December 21-23 to contest charges relating to alleged betting offences. Judge John Bowman decided the date in a directions hearing yesterday. Melham will face a two-year ban if he is found guilty of the alleged offences, which accuse him of placing bets on Australian races between March and September 2019. Melham has pleaded not guilty to the charges.

Hefel begins Perth stint

Carleen Hefel competed at her first Western Australian meeting yesterday and left with two placings from three rides at Ascot. The 30-year-old apprentice, who moved from Victoria in order to pick up more rides, finished third aboard Aberdeen Queen (Universal Ruler) and Man Of The Hour (Sizzling) in a positive start to her three-month loan with Lindsey Smith. "The opportunities at home (in Victoria) this

time of year are quite slim for a lot of jockeys, not just apprentices, so I just thought when the opportunity came up why not take the experience," Hefel told The Races WA prior to yesterday's meeting. Hefel has three rides for Smith at Northam today.

NEW ZEALAND

Tiley trio chase stakes success

Nigel Tiley will take aim at three separate feature-race targets on his home track on Saturday. The Pukekohe trainer will produce Le Castile (Dalghar) in the Auckland Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m), Melt (Iffraaj) in the Counties Bowl (Listed, 1100m) and Cool Change (Showcasing) on debut in the Fasttrack Insurance 2YO Stakes (Listed, 1100m). They are all races Tiley has won before but it's the prospect of a good track that has him confident Le Castile can emulate his 2018 Breeders' Stakes winner Bisou Bisou (Shaft). "She's flying. I'm really happy with her," Tiley said of the six-year-old who has placed in the Taranaki Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Hawera and the Karaka Classic (Listed, 1600m) at Pukekohe in her last two starts. "We gave her a little freshen up after her last run. We were really happy with her run but Sam Collett was of the opinion that the ground was against her. She didn't have a turn of foot she would have had on a good track. We're still getting to know her but her previous best form had all been on good tracks and the track here should be nigh on perfect for her on Saturday."

HK: McEvoy or Ho for Classique Legend

Kerrin McEvoy is yet to commit to riding Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) in the Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m), as he waits to see if there is any change to current quarantine requirements. As it stands, McEvoy would have to spend Christmas in isolation if he travelled to Hong Kong for the ride on December 13. While keen to continue his partnership with The Everest (1200m) winner, McEvoy is also hesitant to miss Christmas celebrations with his young family. "It would be great to go. At the moment, as it stands, you'd be Christmas in quarantine which wouldn't be ideal so we're just going to wait and see how things unfold in the next ten days," McEvoy said on Sydney's Sky Sports Radio. "It would be great to stay on him but connections are understanding given the time the quarantine will fall in. It would be a shame to miss out but hopefully there will be a day I'll be able to get back on him in a race overseas, or even back in Australia if he comes back." Fownes and Classique Legend's owner Bon Ho have given McEvoy until the eleventh hour to decide if he will make the trip, with local jockey Vincent Ho on standby if he does not travel.

HK: Riders announced for International Jockeys' Championship

A stellar line-up featuring established greats and young rising stars will contest the International Jockeys' Championship at Happy Valley on December 9. The exciting line-up includes four previous winners of the world's most sought-after jockey challenge, including Zac Purton and Joao Moreira, both multiple champions on the world's most intensely competitive circuit. Purton and Moreira will both be chasing a second victory, as will last year's victor and fellow Hong Kong-based rider Karis Teetan, while Ryan Moore returns to the spectacular city circuit seeking a record-equalling third IJC title. The HK\$800,000 (approx. AUD\$141,000) championship is a four-

race competition for 12 elite jockeys, and this year's edition features six overseas riders and six based in Hong Kong, all battling for the HK\$500,000 (approx. AUD\$88,150) top prize, the most lucrative jockeys' challenge winner's cheque in the world. The home team will feature Purton, Moreira, Teetan, Vincent Ho and the two highest-ranked Hong Kong-based riders (excluding apprentices) after next Wednesday's Happy Valley card - likely to be Alexis Badel and either Vagner Borges or Chad Schofield. The visitors will include high-flying couple Tom Marquand and Hollie Doyle, along with Moore, William Buick, Pierre-Charles Boudot and Mickael Barzalona.

HK: Lor's trio aim for Jockey Club springboard

Frankie Lor already has two victories at the Hong Kong International Races among close to 200 Hong Kong winners across only four seasons as a trainer, and on Sunday at Sha Tin, the handler will saddle a trio of chances looking to lay out their credentials for December's showcase event. Simply Brilliant (Frankel) contests the Jockey Club Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) first-up with a second Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) challenge in mind, while Big Party (Exceed And Excel) and Fat Turtle (Smart Missile) take on the Jockey Club Sprint (Gr 2, 1200m) with the Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) on the radar. Simply Brilliant, who faded to the tail in last year's Hong Kong Mile, is returning from an eight-month layoff, which includes a stint at Conghua, due to joint

problems that required prolonged rest as the best remedy. "After his last run we found that he had a few joint problems, so we gave him some time off. He's had a trial in Conghua over 800 metres, which is a bit short for him, I don't want him to work too hard so that's why I gave him a trial over 800 metres," Lor said.

SIN: Mr Clint aims to join rare company

Mr Clint (Power) will be attempting to become just the second horse in half a century to win the SG\$1 million (approx. AUD\$1.02 million) Singapore Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m), a Singapore Group 1, in consecutive years. The Lee Freedman trainee will be attempting to join the great El Dorado (Stay Gold), who won the race three times in four years, including back-to-back in 2008 and 2009. Mr Clint enters off a strong third in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Listed, 1800m). "Mr Clint enjoys soft tracks as he showed last start, it was a very good run. He might get the same conditions this Saturday," said Freedman. "He's sound and healthy, he's a genuine 2000-metre horse whereas some of the other horses in the race are not proven at the distance."

192 for Dubawi

Exciting Godolphin colt Midtown (2 c ex First City by Diktat) justified odds-on favoritism to land the Prix Herod (Listed, 1400m) at Chantilly under Mickael Barzalona yesterday, earning Dubawi (Dubai Millenium) his 192nd individual stakes winner. The Andre Fabre-trained colt

emphatically broke his maiden with a nine-length victory on debut at Saint-Cloud earlier this month and was subsequently sent off the 2-5 favourite for this Listed contest on heavy ground. Bought for 210,000gns at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale last year, Midtown continued his progression with a two-length win over Best Lightning, who is by Telemon Stud shuttler Sidestep (Exceed And Excel), with Saqr (Dutch Art) a further length and a quarter back in third. Darley recently announced Dubawi will continue to stand at Dalham Hall Stud for £250,000 (approx. AUD\$454,800) in 2021.

27 for Mount Nelson

Dato (4 c ex Dear Lavinia by Grand Slam) took out the Grosser Dresdner Herbstpreis (Listed, 2200m) at Dresden yesterday to earn Mount Nelson (Rock Of Gibraltar) his 27th individual stakes winner. The Sascha Smrczek-trained colt finished runner-up in the Grosser Preis der Besitzervereinigung (Gr 3, 2000m) at Hanover last month but went one better when dropped back in class, defeating Enjoy The Moon (Sea The Moon) into second, with Perfect Pitch (Campanologist) in third.

UK: Godolphin to cut staff at two Newmarket training yards

Godolphin have announced a number of staff within their two Newmarket hubs at Godolphin Stables and Moulton Paddocks are to be made redundant in the next few weeks. In common with other big-owning enterprises, Sheikh Mohammed's operation have been reviewing their bloodstock and racing activities due to the world economic downturn caused by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. Although Godolphin often lay off a small number of staff at this time of year when many of their horses switch to Dubai for the carnival, they are expected to have fewer employees in 2021, with the number expected to leave forecast to be in the low double figures. Hugh Anderson, managing director of Godolphin in the UK and Dubai, said: "We have reached that point in the year when the horses in training numbers for 2021 are now settled and we are able to look at the ratio of horses to staff. This is something we do periodically with the aim of maintaining the right balance in the yards. Unfortunately, it is now necessary to make a number of staff redundant from our Newmarket racing yards. This is a difficult and sensitive process for all involved but, very regrettably, it is unavoidable."

It's time to act to help breeding heavyweights in fight against mine

The Australian racing and breeding industry, so often in competition with each other and berated for its constant internal division, must once again unite for the greater good to immediately lobby against a Hunter Valley mining application which threatens prime agricultural land.

Coolmore and Godolphin, the biggest players in the world of thoroughbreds, have the most to lose and are leading the charge but despite their collective clout they cannot do it alone.

The entire industry, Australia wide, must point out the likelihood of irreversible damage that will be done to properties in the thoroughbred breeding heartland if the Maxwell Underground Coal Mine Project is approved by the Independent Planning Commission NSW.

Written submissions regarding the Malabar Coal underground mine adjacent to the Coolmore and Darley properties close at 5pm AEDT on Friday and the Commission must hear from as many parties as possible voicing their concerns about the proposal.

Coolmore Australia principal Tom Magnier and Godolphin's Ross Cole already fronted hearings last week.

The farms have already faced five mining applications in the past ten years and if the latest is approved the ramifications could be catastrophic.

Coolmore says its independent studies show that the mine will lower the water table for 11 kilometres and poses significant risk to the water supply of the Hunter River.

The positive economic impact of mining is irrefutable and it already coexists in the Hunter Valley alongside the major horse studs, a fact acknowledged by Magnier, but the Maxwell project is one step too far.

"For over ten years, Coolmore has had a coal mine across the road we have been trying to stop happening. That mine has been stopped four times, it has then been sold to a company called Malabar and they are now trying to do another mine," Magnier told RSN927 yesterday.

"We are defending it with all that we have. It's an underground mine this time, but there's no difference to the threat to our farm.

"We have just short of 10,000 acres up here of what I believe is the best place to raise horses in the world. We have amazing river frontage to the Hunter River, we've got undulating paddocks.

"We've raised Winx on this farm. The Hunter Valley is exceptional."

The Maxwell project cannot be allowed to happen, as previous Commissions have found with similar projects, and the current panel must be told as such by as many in the industry as possible.

It is not just Coolmore and Godolphin who will be impacted. Yarraman Park and Segenhoe would also be directly affected by the project while industry wide it will undoubtedly cost jobs, particularly if studs leave the area as has been floated.

That flows through to not just horse staff, but auction houses, trainers, owners and the hospitality workers who gain work as a result of the industry's expenditure. Even racing journalists indirectly receive an income from the industry - and we are an endangered species as it is.

Borges edges closer to LONGINES IJC berth, Callan keeps on rolling

Vagner Borges edged closer to a berth in next month's LONGINES International Jockeys' Championship with his 11th win this term thanks to a sweeping success aboard Sunshine Warrior (Pierro) in the Class 2 Cheung Hong Handicap (1650m) to seal a Tony Cruz treble at Happy Valley on Wednesday, 18 November.

With the LONGINES IJC featuring six international riders and six Hong Kong-based jockeys this year – a change from the usual format of eight overseas riders to Hong Kong's four – the door is ajar for the next two eligible riders on the jockeys' premiership table to participate, with Borges and Alexis Badel (15 wins) currently filling the coveted spots, while Jerry Chau (16 wins), who sealed a double tonight, is ineligible as an apprentice.

The LONGINES IJC is the world's most prestigious jockeys' challenge, and, aided by five wins from the last six race meetings, Borges' recent run of form could see him rewarded with selection and the chance to compete against some of the biggest names in world racing.

"I'm very happy with the results I've been getting – I'm getting more confident and adapting to both of the racecourses also – I'm quite satisfied about that," Borges said.

The cut off is the conclusion of next Wednesday's race meeting, and hot on Borges' heels is Chad Schofield (10 wins), while Irishman Neil Callan shifts up thanks to double tonight to join Matthew Chadwick on nine wins with two race meetings still to play out.

But tonight, Borges' sole victory came in the feature against a hot field of ten others. It was also his first win for trainer Tony Cruz.

"Vagner (Borges) is doing a good job, that's his first win for me and I hope he can ride a few more," Cruz said.

The Pierro gelding stepped slowly out of the gates, but a cool, collected Borges kept his

head, settled his mount, and then peeled for the stand-side as he turned for home. The Brazilian hit the front with 25 metres to go, for a head victory over Green Luck (Street Cry), denying fellow countryman Joao Moreira a hat-trick.

"He didn't have a good jump but he travelled nice and handy so he was able to get there in the end," Borges said.

Cruz added: "I expected this horse to run a big race, he has a big heart and I know he had the inside draw, which was a big help, I knew he was going to come home strong."

The Australian-bred grabbed his fifth Hong Kong win at his 21st start, his third over course and distance.

Moreira, denied a treble, bagged two wins in mirror image fashion from the front. He sealed his pair aboard Wild West Wing (Exceed And Excel) in the Class 4 Hing Man Handicap (1000m) for trainer John Size.

"He's been improving each time he goes out there to race and that wasn't difficult for me as a jockey, to be honest. I just had to use his gate speed that he has got and make use of it," Moreira said.

"All prize goes to John Size though: he is a champion trainer and riding his horses makes my life as a jockey much easier."

The three-time Hong Kong champion extended his lead atop the jockeys' premiership to 36, stretching 13 clear of Zac Purton who remained joint-second with Karis Teetan on 23 wins.

Moreira's first all-the-way success came in the opener, section one of the Class 5 Wah Fu Handicap (1200m) aboard the Me Tsui-trained Master Galaxy (Align).

Callan keeps on rolling

Neil Callan secured his second double in as many meetings at the city circuit, sealing his brace with a gritty success aboard Fast Pace (Savabeel), who stubbornly fought back after being headed in the home straight to land the first section of the Class 4 Shun Lee Handicap (1650m).

"He's a nice horse, he's got a lot of raw ability. Caspar's (Fownes) done a lot of work with him, when he first came in with his first few runs he was flipping in the gates, going mad," Callan said.

The Savabeel gelding grabbed his first Hong Kong win at his sixth start, putting two previous misdemeanours in the gates behind him. The Hong Kong International Sale graduate's

exploits in the stalls have twice resulted in his withdrawal due to self-inflicted lameness after playing up.

"He's been withdrawn a few times, he wears a pacifier to just try and calm him down, because the ability is there and he just needs to just take a chill pill and hopefully more racing will do that for him," Callan said.

Callan indicated that the 48-rater has further improvement to come: "He has more ratings points in hand and he'll probably get a little bit further in time but he definitely has a bit more to give."

The win of Fast Pace was the first of two for championship leading trainer Caspar Fownes, who edged to 25 seasonal wins thanks to fellow Hong Kong International Sale graduate Guy Dragon's (Dark Angel) thrilling success in the nightcap, the second section of the Class 3 Fu Cheong Handicap (1200m) with Alexis Badel aboard.

Callan earlier kicked off his pair with victory aboard the Cruz-trained Sunny Lad (Sepoy) in section two of the Class 4 Shun Lee Handicap (1650m). The Sepoy gelding was a two-time winner in Britain prior to export when under the care of John Gosden.

Jerry Chau also bagged a double, capping it with a win aboard the Cruz-trained Mig Energy (Redoute's Choice) in the first section of the Class 3 Fu Cheong Handicap (1200m).

"The horse (Mig Energy) relaxed and on the turn he travelled well, I found room and when the gap opened he dashed home really well," Chau said.

Earlier on the card, Chau snapped two runner-up efforts aboard Sprint Forward (Lope

De Vega), driving the gelding to his first city circuit win in the Class 4 Oi Man Handicap (1200m) to nail Chau's 11th win from his last 49 rides across seven race meetings.

Blake Shinn nabbed his fourth win this season and his first for trainer Tony Millard with an accomplished ride aboard Strathclyde (Toorak Toff) in section two of the Class 5 Wah Fu Handicap (1200m).

"Full credit to Tony (Millard) he had the horse just in a wonderful frame of mind going

to the barriers and I was really happy with how he felt even before the race - I was quietly confident," Shinn said. "It was just a matter of utilising the good draw, gate two, and we were able to do that."

Hong Kong racing continues on Sunday, 22 November at Sha Tin with a trio of Group 2 contests for Jockey Club Races in the lead-up to next month's LONGINES Hong Kong International Races on 13 December.

IT'S IN THE BLOOD

TREVOR MARSHALLSEA'S IN-DEPTH PEDIGREE ANALYSIS

In racing and breeding, sometimes champagne and caviar can come disguised as flat beer and sardines, with one person's poison morphing into another person's meat.

In 2013, Gai Waterhouse and James Harron Bloodstock shelled out half a million dollars for a well-bred yearling – by Fastnet Rock out of Legally Bay.

She was a bay, and she raced as Bayrock, and at her second start she gave promise of bigger things to come when second, beaten a neck, as the only filly in a two-year-old race at Randwick.

But she didn't place again in five more tries, and was quickly packed off to the 2015 Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale, where she was bought by New Zealand's Windsor Park Stud for \$140,000. Factoring in her career earnings of \$19,175, connections were down \$340,825, plus training costs and all other begrudgingly-paid fees.

In November, 2017, a colt with the same parents won a race at Flemington. Not just a race, but the coveted Coolmore Stud Stakes.

Three months later, with the buzz around England-bound Merchant Navy growing by the day, his big sister Bayrock's first foal – a filly by Invincible Spirit stallion Charm Spirit – reaped Windsor Park \$300,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

A year after that, with Merchant Navy having won Royal Ascot's 2018 Diamond Jubilee Stakes in the interim, her second foal – a Savabeel filly also offered at the Gold Coast – fetched \$825,000. Another year on, that filly's full brother sold for \$875,000 at Karaka.

The Savabeel filly would be called Hindaam, and last Saturday the Dabernig-Hayes trained three-year-old became a black type winner, overcoming the highly-rated La Mexicana by half a length in the Twilight Glow Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Sandown. It was her third win from five career starts.

The colt, staying in New Zealand to be trained by Jamie Richards, is still an unraced two-year-old, expected to blossom at three. Subscribing to a well-known motto – “If you're on a good thing, stick to it” – Windsor Park's Rodney and Gina Schick now have another Savabeel-Bayrock filly on the ground, with a fourth full-sibling due next spring.

Though next to useless on the track, Bayrock is proving priceless in the breeding barn for the Cambridge stud, which stands Charm Spirit, Mongolian Khan, Vanbrugh and others, and owns a share of the redoubtable Savabeel.

Bayrock was selected from the catalogue at that 2015 broodmare sale by Rodney's father Nelson, Windsor Park's founder and co-owner,

and a pillar of the New Zealand breeding industry, lending expertise for which his son is extremely grateful.

“My parents started this stud and dad's still involved in helping us select mares. You can't beat that sort of intellectual property, mate,” Rodney Schick tells ANZ Bloodstock News.

“Bayrock obviously wasn't much chop on the track, but dad had always loved that family and he picked her out of the catalogue. We had a lot of horses selected and that was the one he really wanted.

“She's from one of the very best families in the Australian Stud Book. Legally Bay's from a great family and Bayrock is by a champion sire. Fastnet Rock as a broodmare sire – I can't get enough of them really.

“So Bayrock was a good type, from a good family and by a champion sire. Had she won a stakes race she'd have cost about \$800,000. But at her level, she was a very viable purchase, and as things are going, these are very exciting times with her.

"It's not always the champion racehorse who makes a good broodmare."

After the ultimately ill-fated union with Charm Spirit – the Ciaran Maher-trained filly broke a leg in training – mating Bayrock with Savabeel seemed a good fit, primarily to provide "a good outcross" from the Danzig line (Danehill-Fastnet Rock-Bayrock).

"She's a good type and so is Savabeel," Schick says. "She's a very good looking mare – good and strong and a decent size at 16.1 hands or so. Savabeel leaves cracking types, so we thought it'd be a good mating and it turns out it was. Hindaam is a beautiful looking filly, and very correct, and we've been happy to go back to Savabeel four times now."

The taproot for this female line goes back to a byword of the Australian breeding game, Lloyd Foyster. In the late 1960s he imported the Mossborough mare Gypsy Moss, and put her to the superb Planet Kingdom (Ming Dynasty, Mighty Kingdom, Our Planet, etc etc), to produce black type-winning mare Pirouette. She produced two stakes-winners as well as Class, a 1987 drop by Twig Moss who threw Classy Fella – a shock winner of the 1995 Gloaming Stakes at Rosehill. Class also threw the Last Tycoon mare Decidity.

Another who was no earth-shaker on the track, with two wins from 21 attempts in the 1990s, Decidity proved her worth in retirement. She had 10 named foals, highlighted by her eighth foal, the 2014 Myer Classic winner Bonaria (by Redoute's Choice). As a first effort, she had left the stakes-winning Time Out (Rory's Jester). And her second foal, born

in 2000, was a chestnut Snippets mare called Legally Bay.

Trained by John Hawkes, Legally Bay won the Sweet Embrace Stakes in 2003 before a sound fifth in Polar Success' Golden Slipper. She was third at Group 1 level in the Australia Stakes and Oakleigh Plate, and a nose second in the 2004 TJ Smith (when still a Group 2), before motherhood called.

Fastnet Rock proved an ideal match, with five foals. The first was Jolie Bay, a 2009 filly who won the Roman Consul Stakes at Randwick before a three-quarter-length second in Nechita's Coolmore Stud Stakes of 2012. Next came Bayrock, then another filly in the stakes-placed Zara Bay. Then along came a colt who

breath-takingly went one better than his eldest sister in the Coolmore – Merchant Navy.

Merchant Navy's full brother then became the second-highest lot at last year's Inglis Easter sale, fetching \$2.3 million. However, racing as Setanta, his form so far suggests he may provide yet more proof of racing's vicissitudes, having last been seen running fifth in a June maiden at Hawkesbury at his third start.

Born when Legally Bay was 17, Setanta was her last foal, with his exceptional dam having died a month after that Inglis sale.

But while Legally Bay may no longer be with us, through Bayrock and the exciting Hindaam – and with Merchant Navy beginning his stud career – her legacy looks set to continue.
