Savabeels to come under notice at Inglis Ready2Race Sale

*Capitalist, Headwater, Vancouver and Deep Field also on
buyers' radar at Riverside Stables*

For vendors trying to read the buying bench, 2020 is more challenging than ever before but there remains growing confidence that agents and owners' willingness to embrace an increasingly online marketplace will determine the success of today's Inglis Ready2Race Sale.

Inspections continued for a fourth day at Riverside Stables yesterday with agents and a

number of NSW trainers finalising their short lists at the complex where the credentials of a number of juveniles were lauded ahead of the opening Australasian two-year-old sale of the year.

Colts by New Zealand's perennial champion sire Savabeel (Zabeel), one a grandson of Group 1-winning sprinter Glamour Puss (Tale Of The Cat) out of winning O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Simply You and the other also carrying the same cross, are expected to capture the attention of a number of domestic and international buyers. *Continued on page 2 >>*

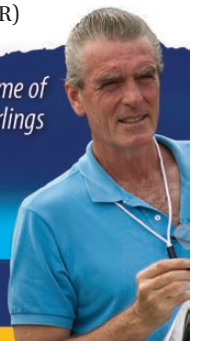

<< *Continued from page 1* **Lot 117** is consigned by Ohukia Lodge while **Lot 220**, who is out of Dubonnet (O'Reilly), is being offered by Lime Country Thoroughbreds on behalf of New Zealand breeder Trelawney Stud.

The former breezed up in 10.47 seconds at Taupo, while the latter ran 10.82 on the same course.

Lime Country's Greg Griffin has been entrusted with selling Trelawney's breeze up draft, stepping in to help out his countrymen who were unable to travel to Australia for the sale, and believes the son of Savabeel has all the traits of a high-class racehorse.

"He is a lovely horse and Savabeel needs no introduction. He's been a great horse for many years now and, again, he's reared on a really good nursery and he's exactly what you'd expect coming from quality breeders like Trelawney," Griffin said.

"He's an athletic colt, he uses himself really well and he's got a great temperament, too. He's very, very much like his father. He stamps them and you can always pick them out in the parade ring, he's got a beautiful walk and he's out of the right cross being out of an O'Reilly mare."

Lime Country will also offer a son of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) on behalf of New Zealand operation Regal Farm as **Lot 162**. The \$230,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale graduate breezed up in 10.3 seconds at Taupo.

Griffin said: "He's been very popular, the Deep Field colt, he breezed very well and is a real speed machine. Again, he's been well prepared, well educated and looks great and he handles himself very well in the parade ring."

As for predicting how the market will play out at Riverside Stables, Griffin was hopeful the international market would embrace the online bidding platform.

"If there's ever a sale to go well with online support, it's this sale. You couldn't have more information put in front of them with the breeze-up and most agents have already seen the horses as yearlings, so if they can't get here most of them would have notes," he said.

"They have their height and their weight, which I think is a good innovation for this sale. It's a great idea to give people as much information as they can get. It's all been done on the same scales, the same grounds and the same measuring stick which makes it fair for everyone."

Colts by Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) (**Lot 164**), the sire of the recent

ATC Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) winner Shaquero, and Deep Field (**Lot 135**) from the draft of Blake Ryan Racing are tipped to be on a number of agents' short lists, while Captivant's win in the Victory Vein Plate (1000m) at Randwick on Saturday boosted the appeal of the Capitalists (Written Tycoon) in the Ready2Race Sale.

They include Glenn Haven Thoroughbreds' Capitalist gelding, catalogued as **Lot 35**, who breezed up at Warwick Farm in a slick 10.17 seconds, only bettered by Ryan's Deep Field colt who set the benchmark at 9.95 seconds.

Glenn Haven Thoroughbreds' Matt Vella, who broke in Saturday's dominant Everest (1200m) winner Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt), rates the son of the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner extremely highly.

"Captivant winning on Saturday just backs up everything I have been saying about the horse. With these first season sires, you want to see them win and he's had a winner already," Vella said yesterday.

"(Lot 35) is a proper racehorse. You can do what you want as he's had a month off now and is ready to go straight into work and get him up for the Slipper lead-ups around January and February.

"The good judges here have all backed him up as a type, so I am pretty confident that he will sell well."

Vella also circled **Lot 38**, a colt by Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock), who stopped the clock at 10.3 seconds in his Warwick *Continued on page 4>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* Farm breeze-up. He is a sister to the Mark Newnham-trained, two-year-old-winning Mrs Maisel.

"I think the quality horses will sell well...and I am confident that those two specifically (by Capitalist and Hinchinbrook) of my draft will sell well and if they don't I would not be afraid to race them," he said.

Victorian vendor JCS Thoroughbreds' Vancouver (Medaglia d'Oro) colt, who ran the fastest time at the Seymour breeze-up session with a 10.16 second 200-metre gallop, has also been widely viewed as a potential top seller. From a Grade 1-winning US family, being out of Quiet American (Fappiano) mare Anatole, the Vancouver colt is catalogued as **Lot 176**.

Buy now, race on Saturday

Early in the session, a colt by young Vinery Stud stallion Headwater (Exceed And Excel) could garner interest from buyers seeking an immediate return on their investment with the Baystone Farm-consigned colt nominated for Saturday's \$500,000 Inglis Banner (1000m) at Moonee Valley.

Currently in training with Leon and Troy Corstens, the two-year-old has already been named Predetermined and won his second jump-out at Flemington on Friday with the view of the precocious colt in the lucrative sales-restricted race. He will be offered in absentia after also breezing up at Seymour in 10.65 seconds.

"He's got good ability. He won a jump-out on Friday and he'll head to the Inglis Banner on Saturday for either us or the buyer if they choose to go that way and he'll be very competitive," Baystone Farm's Dean Harvey said yesterday.

"Usually, I wouldn't go to the jump-outs or anything with breeze-up horses because it is a risk, but I think this year with limited buyers here (at the complex), the more information you can provide them gives them confidence to bid and that's why we continued on with him.

"Acceptances are on Wednesday, so you buy him on Tuesday and race him on Saturday."

Fellow Victorian vendor Frankie Stockdale also has a Ready2Race entrant, the Sebring (More Than Ready) colt Riverside Special, nominated for the Inglis Banner. Having breezed up in 10.79 seconds and he also won a Pakenham jump-out last week. He is catalogued as **Lot 148**.

Harvey agreed with Griffin that it was harder to assess the market based on inspection numbers year-on-year but was confident his draft would stack up well.

"It's really hard to get a guide because our inspections are way down on usual without the international buyers being here and that's always been a big part of the market," he said.

"It does make it tricky in setting reserves and that sort of thing but hopefully they get involved online."

Today's Inglis auction, which starts at 10am, will set the platform for the two-year-old sale market this year, with rivals Magic Millions and New Zealand Bloodstock to conduct juvenile sales next month,

Sebastian Hutch, Inglis' general manager *Continued on page 4 >>* of bloodstock sales and marketing, is confident a number of regular international two-year-old buyers will be active at today's sale.

"I don't want to speak about specific owners, but there are people who have participated extensively in this format and they have again shown a willingness to participate," Hutch said.

"Most encouragingly for us, we've worked hard to try and grow the interest and the acceptance of the format of the sale and, at this stage, they've been very receptive of that.

"We're hoping to see new buyers, both domestically and internationally, participate in the sale and I think that's a great sign in how well the vendors have prepared their horses and presented them in optimum condition."

Tempo to help Camelot

Danny O'Brien has reiterated his belief that Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) favourite Russian Camelot (Camelot) will relish a stronger tempo than he did in the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) when defeated by the reopposing Arcadia Queen (Pierro). "The Cox Plate will be run at a much faster clip than the Caulfield Stakes, which will suit Russian Camelot," O'Brien said. "In the finish Arcadia Queen, who is a top-class horse, reeled off the fastest last 200 metres for the day so his effort was very good. It's hard to hold out a sprint like that." As expected, Damien Oliver will maintain his association with the northern hemisphere-bred four-year-old at Moonee Valley on Saturday.

Grandslam paid up for Cox Plate

Grandslam (My Boy Charlie) is set to line up in Saturday's 100th running of the Cox Plate after connections decided to pay the \$200,000 entry fee to gain him entry into the race. However, it does not confirm his place in the \$5 million contest as Moonee Valley Racing Club will decide on the final field, with connections having to pay another \$200,000 acceptance fee this morning. Grandslam, who has won just one of his six starts, was last seen finishing third behind Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) and Aysar (Deepfield) in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 10. His only win to date came back in April when taking out a Benchmark 66 (1250m) at Morphettville.

Boss confident in Sir Dragonet

Glen Boss is confident his Cox Plate mount Sir Dragonet (Camelot) can upset market

leaders Russian Camelot and Arcadia Queen in Saturday's feature. Sir Dragonet, who arrived from Aidan O'Brien's yard in Ireland over a fortnight ago, has been in quarantine at Werribee's International Horse Centre. "From all reports he is doing very well in the quarantine," Boss told Racing.com. "They're the ones that run well, the ones that are thriving. He seems to be doing all the right things at the moment. I won't see him until the day, but I would have had a lot of phone calls and talked about him a lot by then." Arcadia Queen defeated Russian Camelot by a length and a quarter in the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on October 10 and Boss believes his mount could be the better of them both. "He obviously has to bring his form, but if he can bring anywhere near his rating then he is going to be right in the race. You'd have to put him right up there."

Half-kilogram penalty for Verry Elleegant

Connections of Verry Elleegant (Zed) have confirmed their star mare will contest the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) after being handed a 0.5 kilogram penalty following her win in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) on Saturday. She will now carry 55.5 kilograms in the Flemington feature and part-owner Brae Sokolski is content with the penalty. "Chris (Waller, trainer) is very happy with the way she came through it and he was happy for her to take that extra weight, so it's on to the Melbourne Cup," Sokolski told Racing.com. "She already had a decent weight but you can understand her getting a penalty because of the class of the field and the horse (Anthony Van Dyck) she beat." Verry Elleegant will bid to become the first horse to complete the Cups double since Ethereal (Rhythm) in 2001.

Prime Star given chance in Bondi

Michael Freedman is convinced Prime Star (Starspangledbanner) will appreciate a distance rise when he faces a rematch with his last-start conqueror Peltzer (So You Think) in the \$1 million Bondi Stakes (1600m). Peltzer led and held on to beat the fast-finishing Prime Star over 1500 metres in the Stan Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) but Freedman is hoping his charge can turn the tables over a mile at Randwick on Saturday. "His run here the other day was terrific and he has trained on from that," Freedman said. "The way he ran out that 1500 metres in a race that was probably set up for the leaders, I thought it was a really good test for him, and I don't think the mile should worry him." Kerrin McEvoy rode Prime Star last start but he will be in Melbourne on Saturday to partner Probabeel (Savabeel) in the Cox Plate and Freedman confirmed Tommy Berry had been booked as his replacement.

Mackinnon mission for Melody Belle

Melody Belle (Commands) will line up in next month's Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington in a bid to secure her 13th elite-

Te Akau Racing announced on Twitter: "Melody Belle heads back to Australia, Jamie Richards has confirmed, for a hit & run mission to again contest the Group 1 Mackinnon in which she was a brave runner up to Magic Wand last season - unfinished business."

Vanna Girl to continue spring prep

Vanna Girl (Husson) will target the \$500,000 Rosehill Gold Cup (2000m) later this month after connections revealed she pulled up well following her third-placed finish in the Craven Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) on Saturday. The Toby and Trent Edmonds-trained four-year-old finished behind Think It Over (So You Think) and Nettoyer (Sebring) in the Craven, a performance the training operation were delighted with. "Our stable star mare pulled

up well from her excellent performance in the Group 3 Craven Plate," Edmonds Racing said on Twitter. "It is the best she has bounced out of a race this preparation and fourth-up staying at 2000m for the \$500,000 Rosehill Gold Cup on October 31 looks ideal all being well."

Bitter blow for It's Me's connections

Unbeaten mare It's Me (Shamus Award), who won her fourth race when overcoming trouble to take out the \$1.3 million Kosciuszko (1200m) at Randwick on Saturday, faces an uncertain future after suffering a tendon injury. The Brett Cavanaugh-trained four-year-old, whose racetrack career only began in August, was yesterday found to have suffered a tendon injury, the second time she has suffered the same issue. "She'll be immediately spelled and will begin rehabilitation with no timeframes set or known on a return at this stage," owner Grand Syndicates posted on Twitter yesterday. It's Me had progressed from a Scone maiden victory

before taking out two Highway Handicaps in Sydney on her way to Saturday's lucrative win.

Supergiant sidelined

The persistent hoof problems plaguing Supergiant (Red Giant) have forced his trainer Michael Costa to abandon an interstate trip. Costa decided to spell Supergiant after the four-year-old's failure at Toowoomba on Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m) day. "Unfortunately, Supergiant did let down and he pulled up sore," Costa said. "He was probably three out of five lame with a bit of a hoof issue." Supergiant developed a corn in a hoof after he was beaten first up from a spell at Eagle Farm in August. Costa was confident the four-year-old had recovered from that problem but his Toowoomba defeat prompted a rethink. "Supergiant just didn't come to hand this time in," Costa continued. "It's not due to his ability. It's just he had a few things holding him back with his feet and I'm sure we'll get that resolved into his next preparation."

Golden Eagle order of entry released

Racing NSW yesterday announced the order of entry for the \$7.5million Golden Eagle (1500m) at Rosehill on October 31. A total of 90 horses are included on the ballot, with the number one spot behind shared between six horses: Alligator Blood (All Too Hard), Dawn Passage (Dawn Approach), Riodini (Proisir), Flit (Medaglia D'Oro), Funstar (Adelaide) and Probabeel (Savabeel). The Chris Waller-trained Kolding (Ocean Park) landed the 2019 Golden Eagle following victory in the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and the Jamie Richards-trained Probabeel will be aiming to follow suit, having defeated Funstar and Riodini in the Epsom on October 3.

Guys to continue hot form

Bryan Guy and his son Daniel have been in fine form of late and they are hoping to carry their recent success into Ipswich's meeting tomorrow. Guy, who won the Queensland

trainers' premiership in 2006-07, is having a successful year with Daniel, with 11 wins at a strike-rate of 18 per cent. They hope that will be extended by either Eagles Forever (Tornado) or Niab (Pride Of Dubai), who both line-up in the QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap (1710m). "We're going good at the moment and I've been told from our last 50 runners we have a 75 per cent strike-rate to finish in the first five," Bryan Guy told Racing Queensland. "It goes to show it's a lot different when you have some nice horses to train. Eagles Forever will lead and Niab will be running second. It's too hard to separate them as there's nothing between them in their work."

Alligator Blood named Queensland Horse of the Year

Group 1 winner Alligator Blood has taken out the state's top prize at the 2020 TAB Queensland Thoroughbred Awards. The David Vandyke-trained gelding enjoyed a stellar 2019/20


season, notching up seven wins from ten starts, headlined by his dominant Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) triumph at Flemington in February. He was also named the Three-Year-Old Horse of the Year. "It's a great honour, it is certainly the icing on the cake of what has been an incredible season for Alligator Blood," Vandyke said. "I'm so proud of him, he was given a lot of tests throughout the season and we kept lifting the bar for him and he kept jumping over it - he showed everyone how tough he is. With any hope we thought he could be a Group 1 winner, but I probably didn't think there was anything exceptional that set him apart from some of the others in my stable of the same age. To see how he has progressed, culminating with a Group 1 win at Flemington, it has been a fantastic season for Alligator Blood."



Kermond and Jarrod McLean, have been accused of conspiring to cheat and defraud Racing Victoria stewards. The trio will stand trial after pleading not guilty to the charges in a remote hearing in the Ballarat Magistrates Court. The allegation regards the use of an electronic "jigger" device on Yogi (Raise The Flag), Red Cardinal (Montjeu) and Tosen Basil (Harbinger) during the 2018 Spring Racing Carnival. They will return to court for a directions hearing on November 19.

O'Dea and Hoysted join forces

Steven O'Dea and Matt Hoysted have entered into a training partnership. Hoysted has been assistant trainer to O'Dea having joined the stable from Tony Gollan in July 2016. "I have full faith in Matt's ability as a trainer, he is a hard-working and dedicated horseman, with excellent attention to detail," said O'Dea. "In the modern era of horse training, partnerships are becoming more and more common and for good reason. It is a relentless seven day a week job that can only be improved with a second set of eyes and hands on board." Hoysted added: "I'm really looking forward to this next chapter of my career. Steve and I have always worked well together and it's very exciting to see what the future holds for the stable."

Training treble for Michelle Payne

Michelle Payne brought up her first treble as a trainer at Mornington yesterday, while also becoming the first Victorian dual-license holder to train and ride multiple winners at a single meeting. Payne rode both Think Champayne (So You Think) and Argus (Press Statement) to victory, with apprentice Campbell Rawiller winning on Cape Victory (Dawn Approach). "It's really nice," Payne told Racing.com. "We've got a great team at home and they work really hard. It (training) has its challenges but I love training on the farm at home in Ballarat, Stevie (Payne, brother) is there every day and it's a really good environment. Sometimes it gets a bit tricky but you just have to remind yourself why we do what we do and how lucky we are to have the job we have."

Newitt incurs whip ban

Craig Newitt has received an eight-meeting suspension for overusing the whip at Kilmore on Sunday. Newitt, who is already missing the Cox Plate Carnival on a careless riding charge, will now also miss Flemington's Derby Day meeting, with the ban beginning at midnight on October 26 and ending at midnight on November 2. Newitt pleaded guilty to using his whip three times more than permitted prior to the final 100 metres while riding the unplaced Dandre (Wanted) in race four at Kilmore. He was also fined \$200. Meanwhile, Brian Park was suspended for eight meetings for careless riding in race five and Jason Maskiell got the same ban for the same charge for his ride in race six.

Record prize-money paid out by RV

Racing Victoria yesterday released its results for the 2019-20 financial year ending June 30, 2020 and reported a record-breaking year for prize-money, despite the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic. \$229.2 million in prize-money was paid by RV during the financial year, a rise of 4.6 per cent from the previous year. The report also noted a nation-high average for prize-money and bonuses on offer per race of \$59,709. "FY20 was a financial year like no other with a once-in-a-century event dramatically changing the landscape for thoroughbred racing in Victoria and indeed globally," said Racing Victoria chief executive, Giles Thompson. "Despite the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic and the necessary mitigation initiatives, Racing Victoria still paid out record prize-money in FY20 and Victorian racing still generated record turnover, in excess of \$7 billion for the second financial year."

NEW ZEALAND

Tylers to target Coupland's Bakeries Mile

Father and daughter training team Kelvin and Aimee Tyler could have three runners in the Coupland's Bakeries Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) with Lightning Jack (Per Incanto) securing his spot courtesy of a victory in the Paul Brand Pendene Farm Open 1600 at Ashburton on Sunday. Connections of the four-year-old were pleased with the win and said he needed that result in

order to press on to his Group 2 goal next month. "His target all along has been the Coupland's Mile. That was a must win for him yesterday, so I am a bit relieved it turned out like it did," Kelvin Tyler said. Lightning Jack will now head straight to the Coupland's Mile at Riccarton on November 11 where he could be joined by stablemates Tobilicious (Natural Destiny) and Flying Sardine (Flying Spur). Tobilicious finished fourth over 1200 metres at Riccarton on his most recent start and will return to the Christchurch track next week for a final hit-out before the Coupland's Mile. "Tobilicious' run last start was massive, I was really rapt with him," Tyler said. "He has come through his race really well too. He is going to Riccarton next week. There is a 1400-metre race there. He is looking really good." Stablemate Flying Sardine has been in impeccable form since returning from her Australian campaign, putting together three wins from as many starts. "It's good to have her home and she just loves her work," Tyler continued. "I thought about getting her in-foal this year, but I think I might just wait another year because I am so happy with her. She races next Monday at the Wyndham Cup meeting. She is in the Coupland's Mile as well, but we will just play that by ear and see what the weather does."

Waller to train Nostradamus' Tinker McPhee

Leading New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) prospect Tinker McPhee (Nostradamus) will remain in New Zealand for her current campaign before transferring to the Chris Waller stable after the November 14 Classic. Prepared in Matamata by Simon and Katrina Alexander for Australian owner Richard Boyd, the filly made a huge impression when powering away from the highly regarded Brando (Savabeel) when breaking maiden ranks at Matamata over 1200 metres earlier this month. "She does stay here for a campaign to get her to the 1000 Guineas before she will join Chris Waller," Katrina Alexander said yesterday. Saturday's James And Annie Sarten Memorial Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Te Rapa is the likely stepping stone to the Guineas for the two-start filly. "I think we favour the Sarten over the fillies race but we will double nominate and accept for one. We will just give ourselves

a few options to see how those fields stack up," Alexander added.

Positive signs for injured Myers

Injured jockey Rosie Myers is out of her induced coma and has now left the intensive care unit at Wellington Hospital where she spent 11 days after an accident at the Foxton trials two weeks ago. The 33-year-old was moved out of the ICU over the weekend to the neurological unit at Wellington Hospital. She is due to be moved again today, this time to Hutt Hospital, to undergo surgery on the fractures to her face suffered in the incident.

INTERNATIONAL

38 for Zoffany

Coolmore's Zoffany (Dansili) sired his 38th individual stakes winner when Pythagoras (2 c ex Alegra by Galileo) came out on top in a tight finish to the Silver Tankard Stakes (Listed, 1m) at Pontefract yesterday. The Richard Fahey-trained colt was winning for the third time in five starts when beating Mystery Angel (Kodi Bear) and The Rosstafarian (Starspangledbanner) by a neck and a short head. Former shuttler Zoffany stood for a fee of €22,500 (approx. AUD\$37,350) in 2020.

Ten for Frosted

Darley shuttler Frosted (Tapie) sired his tenth individual winner when Inspector Frost (2 c ex Folk by Quiet American) got off the mark at the second time of asking with a two length victory at Keeneland on Sunday. The Brad Cox-trained juvenile, who had finished third at Churchill Downs on his debut last month, beat Tiwanaku (Tapit) with Mazzini (Tiznow) another two and a half lengths away in third. The homebred is the eighth foal out of the UAE 1,000 Guineas (Listed, 1600m) and UAE Oaks (Listed, 1800m) winner Folk (Quiet American). Frosted stands for \$22,000 (inc GST) at Darley's Northwood Park in 2020.

UK: Ghaiyyath to retire to stud

Four-time Group 1 winner Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) has been retired to stand at Darley's Kildangan Stud in Ireland. The world's highest-rated turf racehorse had a remarkable season in Britain, winning the Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m4f), the Coral-Eclipse (Gr 1, 1m2f) and the Juddmonte International Stakes

(Gr 1, 1m2.5f). Ghaiyyath finished second in the Irish Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m2f) last time out and was being aimed towards the Breeders' Cup, but Charlie Appleby said in preparation for the race that he was showing signs of soreness behind. After veterinary investigation, the five-year-old was found to be muscle sore. "Ghaiyyath has had a fantastic career winning nine of his 13 races," Appleby said. "His high-class cruising speed and relentless style of galloping was a joy to watch. It is obviously disappointing not to be taking him to the Breeders' Cup but the exertions of a long season, which started in Dubai in January, were starting to show and the decision has been made to retire him."

UK: Golden Horde retired

Commonwealth Cup (Gr 1, 6f) winner Golden Horde (Lethal Force) has been retired to stud after suffering a tendon injury, his trainer Clive Cox announced yesterday. Bought for just £65,000 at the 2018 Goffs Yearling Sales, Golden Horde landed the Richmond Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) as a two-year-old, before finishing a neck behind Earthlight (Shamardal) in the Middle Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f). Golden Horde began his three-year-old campaign with victory in the Commonwealth Cup and later placed in the July Cup Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) and Sprint Cup Stakes (Gr 1, 6f), which was his final appearance.

FRA: Abbaye hero Wooded to stand at Haras de Bouquetot

Prix de l'Abbaye (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Wooded (Wootton Bassett) has been retired to stand at Haras de Bouquetot. An Al Shaqab Racing purchase from Arqana, Wooded had a successful time at two and three with trainer Francis Graffard, breaking his maiden at Deauville and placing in two Group races during 2019. He impressed on his seasonal reappearance when winning the Prix Texanita (Gr 3, 1200m) before bowing out on Arc day as a very rare French-trained three-year-old winner of the showcase sprint.

UK: English King offered as wildcard entry for Tattersalls Horses in Training Sale

English King (Camelot), winner of the Lingfield Derby Trial and one time favourite for the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) has been entered as

a wildcard for next week's Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale. Owned by Bjorn Nielsen and trained by Ed Walker, English King could only finish fifth at Epsom and has since run behind Mogul (Galileo) in the Gordon Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 4f) at Goodwood and Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m) at Longchamp.

UK: O'Brien holds typically strong Doncaster hand

Wembley (Galileo) and Bolshoi Ballet (Galileo), the duo sat behind stablemate High Definition (Galileo) at the head of the betting for next year's Epsom Derby, are among seven possibles Aidan O'Brien still has in contention for Saturday's Vertem Futurity Trophy (Gr 1, 1m) at Doncaster. A total of 17 colts and one filly have stood their ground at the latest declaration stage for the final Group 1 race of the year in Britain.

USA: Justify Santa Anita Derby hearing set for this month

A hearing into Justify's (Scat Daddy) positive post-race test in the 2018 Santa Anita Derby (Gr 1, 9f) is set to go ahead on October 29 after a judge denied a legal effort to halt the process. After Justify's victory at Santa Anita his sample was found to contain scopolamine, a prohibited substance. However, officials opted not to call a positive finding and disqualify the horse, believing it was caused by environmental contamination. Justify went on to win the US Triple Crown and retire unbeaten.

UK: Racing's finances hit again as more shops forced to close

The UK racing and betting industries suffered a further body blow yesterday when a circuit-breaker lockdown was announced in Wales meaning further extensive betting shop closures. Announcing a "time-limited firebreak" from 6pm on Friday, First Minister of Wales Mark Drakeford directed everyone in Wales to remain at home, while pubs, restaurants and non-essential shops, including the country's 366 betting shops, close until November 9. Yesterday's announcement follows the Tier Three anti-Covid-19 measures announced in England last week, with nearly 200 betting shops forced to shut in Lancashire and 350 in the Liverpool City region.



ROAD TO THE MELBOURNE CUP

Following the Caulfield Cup on Saturday, True Self has come out of it really well and she'll now go straight to the Melbourne Cup.

We've had a chance to have a good look at the race and the horses around her, and it seemed that towards the end of the meeting the rail was certainly not the place to be, especially between the 500 metres and the 200 metres. Most of the horses who were there compounded.

We saw the likes of Dashing Willoughby weaken out of the race, and even some of the horses going for the Cox Plate, Master Of Wine and Buckhurst, went backwards and all were down on the rail.

So I would say there was a distinct bias towards the horses who were at least four out off the fence. That was a result of a fair bit of rain we had the previous night and the track simply breaking up from the traffic that had been on it throughout the day.

I think a number of good horses ran well in the Caulfield Cup. Verry Elleegant and Anthony Van Dyck both showed they were the deserving favoured horses and justified being Group 1 horses in a handicap, which is always hard to do.

The popular horse in Australia, and we've almost adopted him, Prince Of Arran ran a super race. You couldn't ask for a better pipe opener for the Melbourne Cup.

Finche, who has always been near to do it

in Australian racing since arriving from France, ran another super race.

Those four horses were clearly the ones to take from the race. The Chosen One ran a good race into third but it's hard to see him in a Melbourne Cup in the same light as the other four.

Verry Elleegant has only been penalised half a kilogram and I think she's done well. History tells you that you only get a penalty because you deserve it and Doriemus got a three kilogram penalty after the Caulfield Cup in 1995 before going on to win the Melbourne Cup.

When we won the Melbourne Cup with Doriemus, it was a huge milestone, as every blue-blooded Australian has a love affair with the Melbourne Cup once they have the remotest interest in horses.

We purchased the horse from New Zealand as a three-year-old, he'd had two starts and he was a relatively backward wishy-washy looking chestnut.

When he first got to Australia we immediately took him to Brisbane. He looked very light, but he was able to win his first race in Brisbane very convincingly and take a couple of

seconds off the class record.

To his great credit, Lee Freedman said 'I think we've got something very special and if we're patient I think we can get this horse to the highest level in a couple of years' time.'

He had two very quiet years leading into the Melbourne Cup as a five-year-old, and he won the Caulfield Cup before winning in Flemington. It was a great piece of planning by Lee and on the day we had a wet track in Caulfield and an even wetter track in Flemington, which Doriemus loved.

Two years later, Doriemus lost the Melbourne Cup in a photo to Might And Power, but it didn't feel nearly as bad as Bauer losing in 2008, because Bauer went down by a nostril and we thought we had won that.

I didn't think Doriemus had won on the day, despite Greg Hall going up in the saddle. I walked down while the photo was being processed with no expectations.

I still feel to this day that Might And Power was such a fantastic racehorse and had he lost that Melbourne Cup it almost would have been a bit of a travesty to racing because he fought off three or four opponents in the straight. As far as earning a Melbourne Cup goes, Might And Power certainly earned it.

Onto this week and we have got a very busy time ahead of us. San Huberto will run in the Geelong Cup tomorrow with Damien Oliver onboard.

It's a bit short of the ideal distance for a two mile horse, but he's very well and Matt Cumani is very happy with him, so he'll run a good race. His major plan is the Melbourne Cup and he should get a run.

In the second-level races at Moonee Valley on Saturday we've got Mr Satchmo running in the Group 2 Crystal Mile and we may have Romancer in that as well.

We also have three horses in the upcoming

Lexus Stakes (Hotham Handicap) who will try and win their way into the Melbourne Cup. Future Score, who won the Cranbourne Cup last week, Attorney, who is coming down from Sydney, and Azzuro, who ran third in the Lexus last year.

We could be well represented, but as we know between now and Melbourne Cup day is always a long time!

WEEKEND RUNNERS

Selino - Moonee Valley Cup - He was trained by James Fanshawe and ran second in the Doncaster Cup. He has done everything we've wanted since he's been in quarantine, Chris Waller has been taking care of him and he's now in their Flemington stable. He's a lovely horse and, while we haven't really set high targets for him this preparation, he'll make his presence felt in a race like this. He won't be running in the Melbourne Cup this year, but it's a great introductory race for him in Australia.

Gallic Chieftain - Moonee Valley Cup - He's been racing very well without luck and he's not far off getting a run in the Melbourne Cup, so if he was to run a good race and get a kilogram penalty, he could well go on to the Melbourne Cup.

Perseverance Pays Off For Eric Cheung

Five pound claiming rider Eric Cheung has got off to a great start in his first season as a fully fledged rider with a double on Saturday's mixed turf and sand card taking him to second spot in the early jockeys' standings for the new season.

Cheung's afternoon got off with a flying start when You And You Alone (Love Conquers All) ran his rivals into the ground with a four length win in the Class 3 & 4 over 1200 metres.

Prepared by Sio Cheung, You And You Alone flew the gates and set up a big lead in the middle stages, and then maintained a strong gallop right down to the wire to defeat Heartgoodallwell (Sebring), with Colonel Mordaunt (Zoffany) in third.

You And You Alone has been a cheap buy for owner Mr. Mok Shing Fung who picked up the five-year-old mare for the modest sum of \$22,500 at the Inglis 2019 September Online Sale. The daughter of Love Conquers All (Mossman) was originally sold for \$90,000 at the 2017 Inglis Classic Yearling Sales and was raced by Nick Moraitis of the great Might And Power (Zabeel) fame.

You And You Alone only managed two placings at Wyong and Nowra when prepared by Joseph Pride before being shipped to Macau. However, Saturday's win in the slick time of 1.08.7, was which .05 quicker than the other division taken out by Chi Chai Sin Sang (Per Incanto), bodes well for the mare who will have no trouble winning a few more on the turf over the sprint distances for trainer Sio Cheung.

Wayne Smith's Chi Chai Sin Sang was the second of Cheung's winners when he prevailed in a thrilling four-way finish in the other division of the Class 3 & 4 over 1200 metres.

Chi Chai Sin Sang enjoyed the run of the race before securing an inside run late to score by a neck over Luen On Prosperity (Written Tycoon),

with Partners Fortune (Better Than Ready) in third and Electroplate Alloy (Golden Archer) a nose way in fourth.

It was win number four for Chi Chai Chin Sang, who after being a \$60,000 purchase at the 2017 New Zealand Bloodstock 2YO Ready To Run Sales, commenced his career under the Aquis Farm banner with Toby Edmonds at the Gold Coast.

After placing second in two barrier trials, one at the Gold Coast and one at Newcastle, the gelding was purchased by Wayne Smith for Macau owner Mr. Won In Chong. The chestnut has already picked up close to HKD\$700,000 in prize-money.

Whilst Cheung is in his first year as a jockey in his own right, he is still eligible to claim a 5lb allowance as he has still not ridden the required 105 winners to lose his claim.

Cheung was a late starter as a jockey and it's been a long journey for the 29-year-old Hong Kong born lad to arrive in Macau.

"None of my family has ever been involved

in racing, but I used to watch the Hong Kong races at home on the TV and fell in love with horseracing," he said.

Originally starting as a trainee apprentice with the Hong Kong Jockey Club, Cheung was not offered an apprenticeship after he completed his training. After spending five years as a track rider in Hong Kong, Cheung still had a desire to become a jockey and took it upon himself to travel to Australia.

"I first went to Toby Edmonds at the Gold Coast for a while but I could not get a start there so I went to Warwick Farm where I worked as a freelance track rider. Then a friend suggested I contact Gordon Yorke at Gosford and I ended up going there and after 12 months and 12 barrier trials I got my license."

Cheung got off to a fairytale start winning at his very first race ride on Radiologist (Nuclear Freeze) at Coffs Harbour for Gordon Yorke on June 24th 2016. Five months down the track with 17 winners from just over 100 race rides it was all over for him in Australia, when he

encountered visa problems and had to return home to Hong Kong.

After one year away from racing, Cheung was enticed by former Champion Hong Kong apprentice and now a Champion Macau trainer Stanley Chin to give it another shot in the enclave. The apprentice got off to a perfect start in Macau for his new master winning at his first ride on Chin's My Fortune Star (Savabeel) in March 2018.

Cheung is now starting his third full year in Macau and after being sidelined for many months at the start of last season with injury has ridden a total of 53 winners.

Royal Garden (Remind) returned to the winners' circle after an absence of over 12 months to take out Saturday's Class 2 & 3 Handicap over 1500 metres under Japanese horseman Massa Tanaka.

The seven-year-old was given the run of the race by Tanaka in a one out one back trial before peeling off the back of the leaders at the top of the straight. Under strong riding,

the gelding went home too well for Tuhao Choice (Jakkalberry); with race favorite Victory Moment (Dragon Pulse) in third.

Prepared by Stanley Chin, Royal Garden was runner up to Pearl Green (Fastnet Rock) in the 2018 SJM Derby (Listed, 1800m) only going

down by a neck after running almost to the outside fence and throwing the race away. At his peak the son of Remind (Deputy Minister) was rated at 98 points, however the loss of form had seen him tumble down to a mark of 73 for Saturday's race.

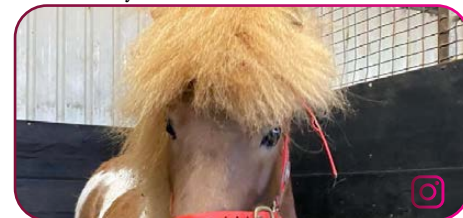
