Big players step in to snap up elite Chairman's Sale mares

In Her Time leads home virtual auction at \$2 million in session of four seven-figure lots

ome vendors were prepared to hold onto their elite breeding stock with a view to riding out the current worldwide economic turmoil while others were well-rewarded for meeting the market with their elite mares at the Inglis Chairman's Sale yesterday.

The top of the market, as it was at the recent Australian Easter Yearling Sale, remained remarkably strong at Inglis' flagship

breeding stock virtual auction which saw four seven-figure mares traded as leading industry figures took the opportunity to source some of the best-credentialled broodmares on the market.

Group 1 winners In Her Time (Time Thief), Samaready (More Than Ready), Booker (Written Tycoon) and Youngstar (High Chaparral) all broke the million-dollar barrier at the virtual auction, being knocked down for \$2 million, \$1.8 million, \$1.6 million and \$1.4 million respectively. *Continued on page 2>>*

Coolmore Australia peer Tom Magnier secured Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Booker and Samaready, who is carrying a Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) sibling to Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL,

1200m) winner Exhilarates.

Japan's Katsumi Yoshida was also active, buying the Chris Waller-trained Youngstar and her former stablemate, Group 2 winner Noire (Foxwedge) for \$800,000, to take back to the northern hemisphere.

The quartet of seven-figure lots pushed the average close to last year's impressive figures, again underlining the willingness of industry stakeholders to take a longer-term view, but the clearance rate was down as the

depth of the buying bench was tested due to the uncertainty created by the global coronavirus pandemic.

There were 51 lots sold last night at an average of \$429,804 in comparison to last year's \$432,019 average while the median of \$275,000 was also down slightly year on year. The clearance rate was hovering at 65 per cent last night. It was at 88 per cent at the same time last year.

Given the circumstances and the government-imposed restrictions placed on travel and businesses because of Covid-19, Inglis managing director Mark Webster was more than pleased with the results of the virtual Chairman's Sale.

"I have mixed feelings about what could have been if we were able to assemble all the mares here and have the buyers to develop a full marketplace," Webster said last night.

"To have achieved the results that we have with no horses on the ground and no buyers, it's very satisfying to have a sale where we've sold four mares for over a million and we've had competition from around the world."

The clearance rate is expected to pick up over the weekend and the no pass-in commission also provided vendors with great flexibility to elect to hold onto their mares if they did not reach their desired value.

"It is different to a yearling sale in the sense that breeders can hold on to them. When they have a yearling generally they want to move them on and let somebody else take over the training costs and the racing costs,"

Webster said.

<< Continued from page 2 "In this case the breeders don't have the compulsion to have to do that. They are here to trade, but they don't have to as they have other options. They can foal them down, they can sell them next year if they want to.

"Having said that, I think there is some great support for this sale from breeders in general and, equally, a high-class buying bench. I'm really delighted for the sale to average \$430,000 during a global health crisis and what is becoming an economic crisis is quite startling."

Field, trading under the Newgate Bloodstock banner with fellow local and international partners, was the leading purchaser, buying seven lots to go with his bluechip broodmare acquisition in the former Kris Lees and Ben Smith-trained The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) and Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner In Her Time.

The top-class mare, who is closely related to Coolmore's prized first season sire Yes Yes (Rubick), was sold by Yarraman Park on behalf of Orbis Bloodstock and Peter Brown.

"We thought she would make around \$1.5 million to \$1.6 million, so \$2 million exceeded expectations," Yarraman Park director Arthur Mitchell said.

"She really is lovely. She is medium-sized and she didn't look to have any wear and tear, even though she is a seven-year-old rising eight - she is very sound.

"She has a beautiful nature, with a lovely head and is a beautifully balanced mare who moves well."

Catalogued as Lot 42, In Her Time is one of five winners for Hell It's Hot (Zeditave), a half-sister to The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) winner Hot As Hell (County), Listed winners Flaming Hot (County), Craig's Dragon (Catbird) and Sin Sin (Fantastic Light), who, of course, is the mother of Coolmore's prized Everest (1200m) winning first season recruit Yes Yes.

Newgate Bloodstock also purchased Group 1-winning New Zealand sprinter Volpe Veloce (Foxwedge) for \$675,000. She will be covered this year by Newgate Farm's first season sire, the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Brutal (O'Reilly). Group 2 winner Decorah (Pins), who is in foal to Russian Revolution (Snitzel) and made \$210,000, will also visit Brutal.

Tassort has been earmarked to cover Diddles (Snitzel), the half-sister to this year's Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Barbaric (I Am Invincible), after she was bought by the group for \$300,000 yesterday.</p>

Centafaith (Keep The Faith), the dam of three-time Group 1-placed filly Fundamentalist (Not A Single Doubt), will visit Cosmic Force after she made \$250,000 as will \$200,000 acquisition Windradyne (Sepoy).

Magnier feels Justified in high-stakes play

Tom Magnier was the second leading buyer last night by aggregate, spending \$3.4 million on proven producer Samaready and off-the-track mare Booker, with the duo to be covered by unbeaten US Triple Crown winner Justify (Scat Daddy) in his second southern hemisphere season later this year.

The purchase of the two mares, which comes 12 months after Coolmore spent millions acquiring the likes of Maastricht (Mastercraftsman), Srikandi (Dubawi) and Global Glamour (Star Witness) to support Justify's first Australian book, highlights Magnier and his partners' determination to ensure the son of Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) is given every chance at stud.

"We bought a lot of nice mares last year and we want to do the same again this year. Obviously we want to be a big supporter of Justify, as a lot of people are and he's getting the best chance at stud by getting the best mares for him," Magnier said.

"Samaready ticks every box - she was a great race mare, she's a great physical, she's got the pedigree and she's proven. She's ideal.

"When you put her to a champion like Justify, hopefully the end result will be exciting. Booker looks very fast and she's got a lot of quality.

"All the top people were on her so we're delighted to get a mare like this for the syndicate."

Booker, who was raced by Victorian owners Barrie and Midge Griffiths who also sold Heatherly (Lonhro) off the track at the 2018 Magic Millions

Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale for \$1.6 million, is a brother to VRC Springtime Stakes (Listed, 1400m) winner Banquo.

Their dam Noondie (Flying Spur), herself a half-sister to Listed winner Tranquility (Redoute's Choice), made \$600,000 at last year's Chairman's Sale.

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Samaready, who was a wildcard entry for consignor Vinery Stud, was sold with an early cover to reigning champion sire Snitzel. Her first foal to race, the Godolphinowned Exhilarates has won four races including the Quezette Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and the 2019 Magic Millions juvenile race.

Vinery Stud general manager Peter Orton said it was a bittersweet decision to part with Samaready, describing her as a "wonderful mare".

"She's a beautiful mare and it's sad to see her leave the farm but she realised what was a great price for her. In this market you're never too sure but she got the value she deserved," Orton said.

"It's a new world and I just love in this industry how enthusiastic and resilient it is and how people are embracing this new concept of virtual and online selling.

"It's such an exciting industry to be involved in and for the stability to still show through under a pretty dire global situation has been fantastic."

Two mares in foal to Justify were sold yesterday, with Gall Bloodstock going to \$250,000 for Lyskintyre Lass (Snitzel). *Continued on page 8>>*

Christian and Mills land Samara Dancer and Lubiton under budget

Victorian investor Michael Christian's push to establish his Longwood Thoroughbreds operation as a leading seller of elite horses received a significant boost when the former Australian rules footballer secured two stakes-winning commercial mares for a combined \$1.37 million.

Christian, in conjunction with agent Sheamus Mills, paid \$750,000 for Group 2-winning juvenile Samara Dancer (Hinchinbrook) who is in foal to champion four-time Group 1-winning sprinter Trapeze Artist (Snitzel).

Later in the select Chairman's session the pair added Lubiton (Snitzel), who is in foal to I Am Invincible, for \$620,000.

"We've spent the week in the Hunter and looked at all the mares. We were really taken by Samara Dancer and Lubiton and were very excited to pick them up for what we thought were great prices," Christian said.

"We sat down at the start of the day and our best combination was to buy Lubiton and Samara Dancer. To buy them at the prices we could, we were absolutely rapt because we valued them at a much higher price than what we were able to get them for."

Widden Stud's Antony Thompson and Queensland-based David Lucas combined at the 2017 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale to buy the Phillip Stokes-trained Samara Dancer, the 2016 Blue Diamond Prelude (F) (Gr 2, 1100m) winner, for \$825,000.

Trapeze Artist Syndicate

Samara Dancer was sent to I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) for her

first two years, producing a colt and last September a filly by the Yarraman Park stallion before she was one of the best-credentialled mares to visit Trapeze Artist in his first year at Widden Stud. Samara Dancer was catalogued as Lot 8.

Christian plans to send Samara Dancer back to I Am Invincible this year.

"Physically, Samara Dancer had the real wow factor. She's a magnificent looking mare. She's a Group 2 two-year-old winner, which I think is critical. $Continued\ on\ page\ 10>>$



<< Continued from page 8 "She is from a great family and Trapeze Artist is certainly the best of the first season crop, so I think his progeny will sell really well."</p>

While four of the five mares offered in foal to Trapeze Artist sold at the Chairman's Sale, Arrowfield Stud's The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) was also well received, achieving a 100 per cent clearance rate and selling to a top of \$280,000.

Meanwhile, the Yarraman Park-consigned Lubiton, who was catalogued as Lot 48, also suited Christian's plan to increase the quality of his broodmare band. She was a juvenile winner of five races, including two at stakes level.

"She's a two-time stakes winner and in foal to the best stallion in the land," he said.

"We hope to send her back to I Am Invincible this spring. We are really excited to be able to get quality broodmares onto the farm."

Yarraman Park was the leading vendor by aggregate and average (three or more lots sold), with all four mares selling for \$3.06 million at

an average of \$765,000, while Glenesk Thoroughbreds was next in line, selling ten of its 11 lots for a combined \$2.86 million.

The countdown of selling for the 399-lot digital Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale starts at 10am tomorrow.

Warning out to emulate Mummify, Subzero

Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Warning (Declaration Of War) will attempt to join popular gallopers Mummify (Jeune) and Subzero (Kala Dancer) as a winner of the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) in the famous Freedman colours today. "If he brings his Victoria Derby form he's going to be right in the race," Brad Taylor, racing manager for trainer Anthony Freedman, said. "His run last start was very good. He's drawn a great barrier (3) so he'll be further forward in the field I'd imagine from that barrier. If he can get rolling before the corner and make it a real staying test he'll be the one to run down." If there is one horse that Taylor sees as the danger, it is locallytrained favourite Dalasan (Dalakhani). "People are saying Dalasan is a query at the distance. I don't believe so," Taylor said. "He was strong the other day and he's going to probably get a nice run as well but hopefully we can be in front of him and he's got to run us down this time."

Stablemates to clash in Gosford Gold Cup

Trainer Matthew Smith will send out German imports Sweet Thomas (Dylan Thomas) and Ilwendo (Lando) in today's Gosford Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Randwick. Smith admits that he wasn't planning on sending Sweet Thomas to the Gosford Gold Cup after his fourth in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), instead planning to wait until the Lord Mayor's Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Rosehill at the end of the month. "I wasn't really intending to run him to be honest, but he was feeling so well I thought we'd throw him in," Smith said. "His runs weren't bad during

that last prep. We know he stays. This might be a bit sharp for him but it might not. We will see what happens. [Ilwendo] is a really nice horse. He is probably a little bit better on soft tracks but he's fit and well, he's going good and he's got a light weight so he's definitely a chance. He will win a decent race at some stage, I'm sure of that."

Toronado's son in Sydney Crusade

Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes will send out two runners at Randwick today that have returned from Melbourne, including promising three-year-old Masked Crusader (Toronado) and Gosford Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) hopeful Scarlet Dream (Sebring). "When the Hawkes team switch states with their horses, they've got a great record winning first-up back in the new state," said Tommy Berry, who will ride both horses but is particularly excited for Masked Crusader. "He's an exciting horse and we've always had a lot of time for him. He had his first start at Wyong and missed the kick by a few lengths but rattled home to finish fifth. I was pretty gutted they sent him to Melbourne after that because I was looking forward to riding him again. He has done all of his work in Melbourne, he was a really good winner there first up and he's drawn well (seven) to get a nice run on Saturday."

Equation to continue juvenile success for Maher, Eustace

The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace team have had a strong season with their two-yearolds, including Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Away Game (Snitzel) and stakes winners Prague (Redoute's Choice), Holyfield (I Am Invincible), A Beautiful Night (Night Of Thunder), Rathlin (Fastnet Rock) and Tanker (Pride Of Dubai). They will send out another juvenile today when Equation (Press Statement) makes his debut after two barrier trial victories with Tommy Berry to ride. "It shows what we think of the horse for him to be starting in a Saturday race," Berry said. "He is very push-button. He's got nice tactical speed if you want to use it, but the other day we chose to sit off them to see what turn of foot he had. I really liked when I asked him to quicken, he dashed through and put a couple of lengths on his rivals really quickly. He's had a good platform for the weekend but he will take a lot of improvement out of it as well."

Anderson chasing Guineas quinella

Trainer Chris Anderson is looking forward to getting Profit (Dundeel) and Ballistic Boy (Smart Missile) to today's Doomben Guineas (formerly the Daybreak Lover Plate) (Listed, 1615m) after they both won over 1600 metres at the Sunshine Coast on Anzac Day. However, he believes that the pair - the highest-rated horses in today's feature - will need a bigger track than they will strike today. "You saw at the Sunshine Coast that they are both big track horses," Anderson said. "They like to have those long stretches to reel in the opposition. Profit's four wins have been at the Sunshine Coast and Eagle Farm and he was able to get into his rhythm. Ballistic Boy, his best runs have been at Eagle Farm and I think the Guineas would have been perfect for him. I am not sure of him past 1600 metres but he might get out to 2000 (metres). Profit will get a strong middle distance." Anderson is aiming both horses at the Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2200m) next month.

Don't Waiver to step up in Doomben Guineas

Trainer Stuart Kendrick may have lost his best three-year-old to Hong Kong after Eric The Eel's (Olympic Glory) sale earlier this week, but the handler believes that Don't Waiver (Not A Single Doubt) can step up when he tackles today's Doomben Guineas (Listed, 1615m). "It was a sound effort first up and he is looking for at least the 1600 metres now." Kendrick said. "I had hopes for him as a Queensland Derby horse but with that race off the board he is heading at the Rough Habit Plate as his grand final. Don't Waiver has won two of his 11 starts and has been minor placed a further six times. His most recent placings have been around three-yearolds like Profit and Guntantes so I am confident the class won't worry him."

Tambo's Mate facing Stradbroke test

Stuart Kendrick has also decided to run Tambo's Mate (Mossman) in today's BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) with sights on the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) should he step up today. Tambo's Mate steps up to Group company for the first time, but was a winner of the Recognition Stakes (Listed, 1350m) at Doomben in November. He was contemplating whether to hold off until Friday's Chief De Beers Handicap (Listed, 1000m) at the Sunshine Coast but decided to run today instead. "In the end he has the minimum weight on Saturday and the BRC Sprint will show us if we are on the right track looking at the Stradbroke," Kendrick said. "If he can't run well on Saturday we can look at something easier."

Mishani Hustler to tackle stakes race

Mishani Hustler (Exceedingly Good), a six-time winner at Doomben, gets his chance to add a Group race to his record when he runs in today's BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben. Trainer Les Ross accepted with Mishani Hustler in an open handicap at the Gold Coast yesterday, but has decided to take him to Doomben today instead. "It is often a case of horses for courses in Queensland and Mishani Hustler is certainly one of those cases," Ross said. "He has had nine starts at Doomben for six wins and two minor placings. But his form at the Doomben 1200

metres is near perfect. Six goes for five wins and a second. On Saturday, Mishani Hustler has the minimum weight which is good for a horse with his record. He has won a Listed race and been placed in two other black-type races so I think he is up to the class."

Warrior on Doomben mission

Former jockey Gary Doughty will get a special buzz if Bold Warrior (Spirit Of Boom) can help him celebrate two years as a trainer with a win at Doomben. Doughty, a multiple Group 1-winning rider, retired from the saddle two decades ago after suffering an eye injury in a fall. He has won 34 races in his two years as a trainer, with Bold Warrior his first metropolitan winner in July, 2018. The four-year-old has since won another six races, five at the Gold Coast, and while Doughty was initially thinking of going to the Gold Coast yesterday, he decided to head to Doomben today. "He is a big leggy bloke and we gave him time to mature. All of his wins have been in the 1350 to 1400 metre range," Doughty said.

Headgear for Hang Man

Trainer Michael Moroney is relying on blinkers to help Hang Man (Windsor Knot) find his best when he steps out in the Bert Bryant Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield today. Hang Man finished off nicely for a midfield finish first-up in the Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) before performing strongly for second over 1700 metres at Flemington second-up. "We've been very happy with him and I said to the owners when he came back in this time that it's the best he's ever looked and I thought he was going to be in for his best campaign," Moroney said. "Hopefully I'm going to be right. His first run was good enough but his second run was really good. The only risk we take is that he's not the best beginner without them and sometimes they do miss the start with blinkers on for the first time. That's going to be the only problem. He might not be able to use that barrier draw that well but he is going very well and I think the blinkers will make a difference to him."

Freedman stable to Show Some Decorum

The Anthony Freedman yard will run two-year-old Show Some Decorum (Starspangledbanner) and English import Aussie Nugget (Dansili) at Caulfield today. Show Some Decorum won on debut at Sale before sticking on stoutly for third at Sandown second-up. "He's a nice colt and he's really going to enjoy the step up to 1200 metres," racing manager Brad Taylor said. "It just looked like he raced like he needed the 1200 last time. He looked gone for all money and looked like he was going to drop out but even in another 100 metres he might have kicked back and won the race."

Strasbourg to step out for new stable

The Anthony Freedman yard will also debut Strasbourg (I Am Invincible), formerly with Peter and Paul Snowden, at Caulfield today. A winner of the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) last year, Strasbourg has failed to fire as a three-year-old. "He's had a couple of issues, hence the move. He's been down at our Pinecliff stable and trialled really well on the course proper at Mornington last Wednesday," Freedman's racing manager Brad Taylor said. "We've tried some different things that have worked with horses like Santa Ana Lane and the like with feet issues and hopefully we can see the best of him because on his day he looks to be a pretty talented colt."

The Drinks Cart impresses fresh

Trent Edmonds feels that The Drinks Cart (Unencumbered) may have too much brilliance to contest the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1400m), even though the race has been shortened by 200 metres this year, after the two-year-old returned with an easy win at the Gold Coast yesterday. The Drinks Cart was having his first start since January, winning by two and a quarter lengths over 900 metres. "He did give them a belting today. He will need another run before the Atkins and the logical race is the Champagne Classic in two weeks," said the younger Edmonds, who trains in partnership with his father Toby. "If he shows us in that race he will struggle at 1400 metres we can come back in distance to the Dalrello Stakes a week later than the Atkins."

Santa Ana Lane heads for Goodwood

Evergreen sprinter Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) will attempt to win The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) for a second time when he heads to Morphettville next Saturday. Santa Ana Lane is looking for a sixth Group 1 win overall and tuned up for the test in a jump-out at Flemington yesterday, finishing fifth of six behind another Goodwood aspirant, last year's Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Trekking (Street Cry). "He just had a very soft trial," Anthony Freedman's racing manager Brad Taylor said. "We didn't let him off the bridle. We did try him in the blinkers and we're just going to toss up whether we put them on race day next week or not. He relaxed nicely in them and hit the line under his own steam and had plenty there. Mark Zahra knows him very well and was very happy with him. He heads over to the race next week in really good order and hopefully he can bounce back to his best."

Bolt d'Oro to remain at home in 2020

Champion American two-year-old Bolt d'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro) will not shuttle to Spendthrift Australia this year. A two-time Grade 1 winner in 2017, Bolt d'Oro served both his first northern hemisphere and southern hemisphere books last year, with 104 mares among his Australian book at a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST) last year. However, Spendthrift Australia's General Manager Garry Cuddy announced last night on social media that Bolt d'Oro will not return to the farm this year: "We are disappointed to announce that Bolt d'Oro will not shuttle to Australia in 2020 due to him not handling the shuttle process last season. Our decision has been made with the welfare of the horse in mind."

Better Than Ready fee remains unchanged

Queensland stallion Better Than Ready (More Than Ready), who trails only Deep Field (Northern Meteor) on the leading second season sires table by winners, will stand at Lyndhurst Stud for an unchanged fee of \$33,000 (inc GST) this year. Better Than Ready, who sired 23 first crop juvenile winners last season to take the first season sire title (by winners), has been immensely popular with breeders in the past two years. In 2018, he covered 236 mares at a fee of \$9,900 before serving 216 last year at his increased \$33,000 fee. Barnmate Rothesay (Fastnet Rock), the sire of this season's exciting Rob Heathcote-trained two-year-old Rothfire, will also stand at Lyndhurst Stud for an unchanged fee of \$4,950.

Breeders flock to Written Tycoon

Arrowfield Stud's Jon Freyer has reported that breeders have embraced Written Tycoon (Iglesia) since news broke last week that the top-class stallion would relocate from Victoria to the Hunter Valley this year. Written Tycoon, whose sire sons are Rich Enuff, Capitalist, Written By and Winning Rupert, has stood at Woodside Park Stud in Victoria since 2013 but a deal was brokered to send the rising 18-year-old north for the 2020 season. Coupe Express (Ne Coupez Pas), the dam of this year's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Pippie (Written Tycoon), is among the mares booked to the son of Iglesia (Last Tycoon) in the past week. Written Tycoon will stand for \$77,000 (inc GST) this year.

Arrowfield offers yearlings via Bloodstockauction

Arrowfield Stud will offer 25 yearlings by stallions including Redoute's Choice (Danehill), Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) and Maurice (Screen Hero) on the Bloodstockauction platform. The unreserved Arrowfield draft is the highlight among the 91 lots in the current Bloodstockauction online sale. The offering includes a Snitzel colt out of Phyllis Maud (Halling) (Lot 42) and a Redoute's Choice colt who is the second foal out of Grisi (Street Cry) who is from the same family as Lonhro (Octagonal). Bidding closes on May 12. Click here to view the catalogue.

Racing NSW makes metroprovincial race changes

The 2020-21 season will see changes to metropolitan and provincial race programming in New South Wales, with the introduction of three-year-old graduation races at metropolitan midweek meetings. A graduation race will be a handicap where 61 kilograms equals a rating of 68. However, no horse can carry more than 63 kilograms no matter their benchmark rating, while maidens will carry 55 kilograms (colts and geldings) or 53 kilograms (fillies), irrespective of form. Horses will be ineligible for graduation races once they have won two graduation events. The standard minimum metropolitan midweek race will be increased to Benchmark 72 level, Class 2 provincial races will be removed and there will be changes to conditional Benchmark races as well.

Vale Admiral's Joker

Seymour Cup (Listed, 1600m) winner Admiral's Joker (Bel Esprit) has died. Trainer Kylie Vella tweeted out news of the seven-year-old's death after he suffered complications while recovering from minor surgery to remove a small bone chip. Admiral's Joker won six of his 19 starts, amassing earnings of \$486,125.

Might And Power to be farewelled

Might And Power (Zabeel), one of racing's greats, will be sent off with a tribute on Tuesday involving the racetracks where he became a Hall of Famer before he is laid to rest at his spiritual home, Living Legends. Might And Power passed away in the early hours of April 12 after a bout of colic at the age of 26. A horse that received great public affection, he lived for nearly 13 years at Living Legends with numerous appearances at race days, city parades and even schools and hospitals. A winner of the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m), Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) and Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), his ashes will be escorted to Caulfield, Flemington and The Valley before being placed in the Living Legends memorial garden. The public has been invited to participate virtually by leaving a tribute online or making a donation to help create 'Bob's Rainbow' at charidy.com/bobsrainbow.

Court win for Goodrich

Kilmore trainer Kate Goodrich was exonerated by the Victorian Court of Appeal yesterday of charges relating to the obstruction of Racing Victoria stewards from carrying out their duties in December, 2016. Goodrich argued that stewards Rhys Melville and Simon Quintner had not been properly appointed by Racing Victoria's board before they attempted to inspect her stables and a horse, but the Court of Appeal's three judges determined that it was not necessary in order to clear Goodrich of all charges. The validity of Melville and Quintner's appointments, as well as the appointment of former chairman of stewards Terry Bailey, is the subject of a claim before the Supreme Court in which Goodrich is seeking damages against the Kilmore Racing Club and Racing Victoria, claiming she was unlawfully suspended from training.

NEW ZEALAND

Darci Brahma's fee announced

The Oaks Stud has elected to keep their stallion Darci Brahma (Zabeel) at an unchanged fee of NZ\$15,000 + GST for 2020, despite his hugely successful season which included Group 3 winner Kali, Group 1 performer Harlech and Group 1 winner Catalyst among his three-year-old crop. The latter was undefeated as a three-year-old in New Zealand, winning each of his five starts, including the New Zealand 2000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) before going down narrowly in a memorable duel with Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) in the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington. A sire of ten

Group 1 winners, Darci Brahma has been the Champion Sire in Singapore on six occasions. The Oaks Stud roster is completed by Niagara (Encosta De Lago) and Roc de Cambes (Red Ransom), who will both stand at unchanged fee of NZ\$5,000 + GST.

ASIA

Hayes to train Beauty Generation

As first touted in ANZ Bloodstock News earlier this week, David Hayes will take over as the trainer of two-time Hong Kong Horse of the Year Beauty Generation (Road To Rock) next season. Beauty Generation has been prepared by John Moore since his arrival in Hong Kong in 2016, but with Moore's training tenure in Hong Kong coming to an end in July, the returning Hayes will be the beneficiary. Simon Kwok, father of owner Patrick Kwok, told Hong Kong's Apple Daily: "After careful consideration and discussion, we have decided that Beauty Generation will continue his career next season. The Hong Kong International Races will be our target and we will see how Beauty Generation performs in the Hong Kong Mile before we decide whether he will race for the remainder of the season. We are grateful to John Moore for all his work with Beauty Generation, but with John leaving Hong Kong, we will send him to David Hayes."

Jeju sale first step back for Korean racing

Korean racing remains on hold due to the ${\it Covid-19\,pandemic,but\,the\,first\,step\,towards\,an}$

industry return has been scheduled with a two-year-old sale on the island of Jeju on Tuesday. The island, south of the Korean peninsula, houses most of the main thoroughbred farms, including the Korea Racing Authority's main stud. The sale will feature the first Korean-bred two-year-olds sired by Florida Derby (Gr 1, 9f) winner Take Charge Indy (A P Indy) and Travers Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) conqueror Colonel John (Tiznow). An announcement on the state of Korean racing was due yesterday, but a new coronavirus cluster in Seoul has likely seen the return of racing at Seoul and Busan pushed back until June.

INTERNATIONAL

Gavelhouse moves into South African market

Online auction platform gavelhouse.com will branch into the international market next month with the launch of gavelhouse.com South Africa. In partnership with Klawervlei Stud, gavelhouse.com will launch an online sale of around 160 thoroughbreds from 15 to 21 June. Klawervlei Stud sales and marketing manager Grant Knowles reached out to gavelhouse.com, after concerns that their annual on-farm auction was not able to be held. The gavelhouse.com South Africa site will use the enhanced Gavelhouse Plus platform that is due to launch in New Zealand in May. Features include a more stringent buyer approval system, the ability for lots to have up to 20 photos per lot, video footage, Arion pedigrees and veterinary reports where applicable.



North America stallion books to be capped

The Jockey Club of North America's board of stewards has adopted a final rule limiting book sizes for individual stallions born from 2020 onwards to 140 mares in a calendar year. Stallions born in 2019 or before will be exempt from the cap. The new rule will impact studs who stand popular stallions in the future. The Jockey Club first announced last September that it was considering a book size cap due to concerns over the limiting of the thoroughbred gene pool. They said in a statement that "the stewards carefully considered those comments in formulating a rule that will promote diversity of the thoroughbred gene pool and protect the long-term health of the breed."

Program in place for British racing return

A provisional outline for the resumption of racing has been published by the British Horseracing Authority ahead of what is set to be a make or break weekend for the return of the sport. The BHA unveiled some of the details for its phased return to racing, with 13 fixtures over the first seven days comprising one card on the opening day followed by two meetings for the subsequent six days categorised by the regions of North, Midlands and South. In a note to trainers, the cross-industry Resumption of Racing Group emphasised Prime Minister Boris Johnson's statement on Sunday regarding the proposed route out of the current lockdown in Britain will be crucial to the return of racing, which will be outlined on Sunday, May 10. The BHA also announced plans for Classic trials to be run on the last two weekends in May, with the Guineas meeting pencilled in for the first weekend in June under a "best case scenario".

French racing back with a bang on Monday

French racing is set to return to action at Longchamp on Monday with no small degree

of fanfare as a host of well-known names appeared among the final declarations on Friday morning. Sottsass (Siyouni), Europe's highest-rated three-year-old in 2019, will make his first start since finishing third in the Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) last October in the Prix d'Harcourt (Gr 2, 2000m) a race that has attracted a field of nine. Earlier in the afternoon, Andre Fabre's unbeaten Group 1 winner Victor Ludorum (Shamardal) sets out on his three-year-old campaign in the Prix de Fontainebleau (Gr 3, 1600m) a major trial for the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2,000 Guineas, Gr 1, 1600m) on June 1. Victor Ludorum will be renewing rivalry with Ecrivain (Lope De Vega) and

Helter Skelter (Wootton Bassett), both of whom finished behind him in the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1600m) on Arc day.
