Hanseatic could be the top colt to continue **Street Cry sire line**

Godolphin homebred leads way but Darley sires also have strong Blue Diamond hand

odolphin power brokers will have their eyes firmly cast on unbeaten colt Hanseatic (Street Boss) during the running of the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) but should the favourite strike trouble, their attention will quickly switch to his four Darley-sired rivals.

The Anthony Freedman-trained Hanseatic,

one of a handful of yearlings Godolphin sends the Victorian stable's way each year, leads the charge ahead of Ideas Man (Brazen Beau), Aryaaf (Epaulette) and Night Of Thunder's (Dubawi) pair A Beautiful Night and Riverina Storm.

The feature Caulfield meeting, and that of Sydney's premier meeting at Rosehill, promises to give a glimpse of not only Darley's current enviable stallion roster but of what promises to come including stud prospect Hanseatic in the \$1.5 million Blue Diamond. Continued on page 2>>

<< *Continued from page 1* "It is the first Group 1 of the season for two-year-olds and it is an important race for a number of reasons, but we're obviously looking at it from a future stallion's and our current stallions' point of view," Darley's head of sales Alastair Pulford said yesterday.

"A good representation by our stallions is obviously very pleasing and Hanseatic would be our best result because we still own him and would become a future stallion, but equally, we'd be delighted to see an Ideas Man or an Aryaaf succeeding as well."

The on-track deeds of Hanseatic this season clearly illustrates the justification for Darley's decision four years ago to provide greater mare support to its diverse stallion roster including Victorian-based shuttler Street Boss (Street Cry).

Street Boss flew under the radar despite Group 1-winning sprinter The Quarterback emerging from his first southern hemisphere crop and Group 3 winner Petits Filous from his second, but in 2016 breeders took notice, as did Darley, who lifted his fee from \$11,000 (all inc GST) to \$27,500 that year, after starting his Australian stud career in 2009 at \$16,500.

Pulford revealed that a pre-existing leg injury stopped him from returning to Northwood Park in 2010, a move that halted the upward trajectory of the Street Cry (Machiavellian) stallion.

"He had put his leg through the fence in America, so we were restricted in the number of mares we could cover with him and probably by that stage he was a first crop Street Cry and he hadn't really hit his straps as a stallion," he said.

"He didn't get the support that he probably deserved and then he had to miss a year to recover from that injury because it took a long time to clean up his hock.

"He came back but we'd lost the momentum by that stage and, while he still got reasonable numbers, he didn't ever get the quality. From his first crop he got the Newmarket Handicap winner The Quarterback and then along came Petits Filous, so he looked like being a pretty handy stallion who also had a couple of decent horses in America."

That was when Darley, and fellow breeders, upped the ante with the quality of mares covered by Street Boss.

"We sent a number of high-class mares to him including Hanseatic's dam Itameri but others as well.

"This is the first crop where he has stood at a decent fee - he stood at \$25,000 (plus GST) - and he was very popular.

It is the first Group 1 of the season for twoyear-olds and it is an important race for a number of reasons, but we're obviously looking at it from a future stallion's and our current stallions' point of view "A lot of good breeders supported him, including us, and we told everyone that in the past couple of years and we have continued that support. We have ten two-year-olds, ten yearlings and a number of foals by him and mares in foal still.

"We have really backed the horse in for the past four years because we know that he is certainly capable and has done it from a very slow start off limited opportunity."

<< Continued from page 2 Hanseatic may well prove to be Street Boss' best - and certainly most valuable - judging by the manner of his three victories to date, in the Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m), the Blue Diamond Preview (C&G) (Listed, 1000m) and Blue Diamond Prelude (C&G) (Gr 3, 1100m) respectively.

His pedigree, being out of a three-quarter sister to Schillaci Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) winner Wilander (Exceed And Excel) and from the same family as Magnus (Flying Spur), Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) and All Too Hard (Casino Prince), also excites Pulford.

"He is by a son of Street Cry and out of an Exceed And Excel mare, so he is 'very Darley', but he has already proven himself to be a high-class horse," he said.

"He has got to step up to Group 1 level tomorrow but if it is not tomorrow, then I am sure it will be some time in the future because he does show an enormous amount of ability."

Meanwhile, the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Inglis Banner (RL, 1000m) winner **Ideas Man**, a \$575,000 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale purchase, also has the chance to increase his stallion currency and boost the credentials of his Darley-based sire Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible).

Another juvenile colt by Brazen Beau, \$800,000 Melbourne Premier graduate North Pacific, also debuts in today's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill.

"These Brazen Beau two-year-olds, they look even better than his first crop at this stage," Pulford said.

"Ideas Man is already a stakes winner and there are a couple of others about the place. He has got a first starter in the Silver Slipper for the Hawkes team, so they just look like a pretty good crop. They sold very well and, while it is early days yet, certainly the results seem to be turning up on the racecourse as well."

Brazen Beau did not return to the UK this year as Darley takes a conservative approach with an important stallion on its roster who faces fertility hurdles.

"Brazen Beau is not the most fertile horse in our barn, so we have to manage him very carefully, and because of that he doesn't get big numbers but he is a sire who can get a very talented horse," Pulford said.

"He hasn't shuttled this year for the first time having been in England

for the past three years. Whether that makes a difference or not, we don't know. Previous history says that it doesn't really affect fertility but we will see going forward."

Another Darley stallion whose Australian stud career was curtailed due to a setback is Night Of Thunder who shuttled to Victoria for just one season in 2016 where he covered 96 mares, producing 58 live foals.

A back injury flared during that southern hemisphere season and prevented him from returning the following year.

From that one small southern hemisphere-bred crop, he has two winners - Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m) winner **A Beautiful Night** and **Riverina Storm** - as well as the stakes-placed River Night.

Pulford said: "To have two runners in the Blue Diamond obviously says a huge amount for what Night Of Thunder is doing down here, but whether he gets the opportunity again I'm not sure as shuttling isn't just a case of putting them on a plane.

"The horse has got to be right and his welfare comes first. We will determine whether he can return down the track and probably a fair way down the road in the northern hemisphere season before we even discuss it, let alone making any decisions.

"It has not been ruled out, but it is certainly not been ruled in either." Night Of Thunder is the sire of 31 first crop northern hemisphere winners including eight at stakes level, and if he did shuttle again it would provide Australian breeders with a second *Continued on page 6>>*

<< Continued from page 4 commercial option to access Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) blood alongside Swettenham Stud's Akeed Mofeed.

The other Blue Diamond hope for Darley is Shadwell's homebred Epaulette (Commands) filly Aryaaf, the Ottawa Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) winner who resumed with a second to Mildred (Hinchinbrook) in the MRC Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) on February 1.

Pulford believes Epaulette, who went to stud at the same time as Zoustar (Northern Meteor), Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo), Dundeel (High Chaparral) and Shamus Award (Snitzel), is performing well as a stallion.

That fact was also recognised by breeders, with Epaulette covering 138 mares in 2019, the most since his debut 2014 season when he served 170.

"Epaulette is competing against a really good group of stallions, but he is more than holding his own," Pulford said.

"Aryaaf was bred by Shadwell who are obviously very close to our organisation with Sheikh Hamdan being Sheikh Mohammed's brother.

"They send us a number of their mares every year and they have also bred the best Epaulette so far in Soqrat who is a champion in South Africa and Aryaaf, being out of a Shamardal mare, looks to be high class, too."

Autumn to determine Group 1 winners' future

While Hanseatic could confirm his place on Darley's stallion roster with a victory today, Group 1-winning three-year-olds Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) and Microphone (Exceed And Excel) already have the CV to go to stud.

But Pulford stopped short of confirming whether the pair would both be retired at the end of their respective autumn campaigns, with Bivouac a leading contender in today's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) and laststart MRC Autumn Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Microphone tackling the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Rosehill this afternoon.

"Our three most important colts are running on the same day with Hanseatic, Bivouac in the Oakleigh Plate and Microphone in the Hobartville, so it is a big day for Darley stallions and Godolphin," Pulford said.

"The Blue Diamond is everyone's focus for the day and it is proof that the Darley stallions can punch above their weight no matter what price level they stand at.

"It's not Exceed And Excel and Lonhro this year, it's Street Boss, Night Of Thunder, Brazen Beau and Epaulette, horses that everyone can afford."

On Bivouac and Microphone potentially retiring to stud this year, Pulford said: "Their racing over the next few weeks will have a big determination on that.

"Obviously these decisions are made by Sheikh Mohammed and his advisors, so we have got six weeks of excitement to look forward to before we make any of those decisions I would say."

It was confirmed on Thursday that Godolphin would once again retain an Everest slot in 2020 having secured the option last year after it was surrendered to Racing NSW by Damion Flower.

Presumably one, or both, of the three-year-old sprinters could race on next season to provide Godolphin with ammunition to target the \$15 million Randwick race.

Godolphin's UK trainer Charlie Appleby's unbeaten dual Group 1-winning three-year-old Pinatubo (Shamardal), victorious at all six starts, was also yesterday hailed as a potential Everest candidate.

First for Shooting To Win

Darley stallion Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor) sired his first stakes winner yesterday when Ms Catherine (3 f ex Lucky Diva by Perugino) took out the Typhoon Tracy Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Moonee Valley. The Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner, who went to stud in 2015, is also the sire of Kubrick, runnerup in last year's JJ Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) and inaugural winner of the \$1 million Bondi Stakes (1600m), as well as the stakes-placed juvenile Shotmaker. Ms Catherine is the first stakes winner and one of five winners for her dam, the Group 3 winner Lucky Diva, who in turn is a sister to Listed winner Gina Lollawitcha and a half-sister to stakes winners Spirit Of Westbury (Sir Tristram) and Duke of Westbury (Sir Tristram). Shooting To Win stands for a fee of \$22,000.

Currie a doubt for Hanseatic ride after late Valley fall

Jockey Luke Currie, who is booked to ride Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Hanseatic (Street Boss) at Caulfield, looks like missing the ride after being involved in a fall shortly after the finishing line in the last race at Moonee Valley last night. Currie rode the Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Yulong June (More Than Ready) into third in the Drummond Golf Handicap (1200m) in a tight finish before appearing to clip heels and being dislodged. He was conscious but paramedics on course placed the ninetime Group 1 jockey in a neck brace. Later reports suggested he was in Royal Melbourne Hospital where he was being treated for suspected concussion.

Blaze A Trail on Slipper campaign



Kerrin McEvoy is not running scared of shortpriced favourite Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) as he prepares to ride rival Blaze A Trail (Criterion) for the first time in today's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill. McEvoy's mount sits on the second line of betting behind Cellsabeel and although McEvoy was impressed with what he saw from the favourite last time out. he recognises plenty can change in a short space of time with two-year-olds. "She was visually very impressive winning at Rosehill a month or so ago," McEvoy said of Cellsabeel. "No doubt it's going to take a good effort to beat the filly but there's a lot of water to go under the bridge yet." Blaze A Trail is among a host of possible Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) contenders in the care of Peter and Paul Snowden, and McEvoy hopes the colt will settle better than he did when finishing third on his debut in the Golden Gift (1100m) back in November. "He was a little bit aggressive that day and raced a bit keen at the front end," he said. "He has come a long way mentally and Peter and Paul have echoed those words to me, this campaign he seems to have grown up a bit. I'm sure there is more to come from this horse."

Fawaz a Hobartville blowout hope

Anthony Cummings has already orchestrated one Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) upset and he will not be surprised if Prince Fawaz (Fastnet Rock) can deliver him another when the colt resumes at Rosehill today. The Randwick trainer won the 2005 edition with \$21 chance Outback Prince (Desert Prince), and Cummings, who won the race again three years ago with Man From Uncle (Uncle Mo) at the more sedate odds of \$5, regards Prince Fawaz as a superior horse to that pair. "They were both nice horses and they were good for the stable but this guy is a better horse," Cummings said. "I'm much happier with him. He was flat in the spring. You couldn't see it in his work, his work was good, but his trials were average and we were left making excuses for him. This time around we haven't had to make excuses for anything."

Fortress Command back on track

Having missed the spring with a minor injury, Fortress Command (Sebring) is somewhat of a forgotten horse ahead of his return in the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Rosehill. But with handy juvenile form lines behind star three-year-olds Castelyecchio (Dundeel) and Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), the colt could be one of the surprise packets this autumn. The winner of his first two starts at provincial tracks, Fortress Command was Group 3-placed on a heavy track at Rosehill before finishing fourth in the ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) won by Castelvecchio. "He had a little chip at the front of his joint so we took it out and gave him three months off," trainer Gerald Ryan said. "He's come back bigger and stronger and a lot better in the brain. He used to be a bit fiery but he's not any more. He has come back really well."

Bottega to resume

Fellow Gerald Ryan-trained three-year-old Bottega will also resume from a spell at Rosehill today, with the lightly raced colt set to tackle the Sharp Extensive IT Handicap (1400m) after drawing barrier 15. Bottega was stakes placed in the spring when third in the Stan Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Randwick at his third start then over-reacted to the addition of blinkers when he tailed out in the \$1 million Bondi Stakes. (1600m). "Last prep we whacked a pair of blinkers on him which he didn't like at all. He over-raced and pulled in them so you can take no notice of his last run," Ryan said. "He's fit and he appears to go through wet ground. Barrier 15 at that time of day might be the best gate."

Clean slate for Mustajeer

Mustajeer (Medicean) will have his first start since beating just one rival home in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) when he lines up in the Parramatta Cup (Listed, 1900m) at Rosehill today and Kris Lees is hoping to see a better performance from a fresh horse.

The gelding arrived in Australia last year for a spring Cups campaign which included a closing sixth behind Mer De Glace (Rulership) in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Lees said: "He'd had a long prep when we got him. He ran well in the Caulfield Cup and things didn't go right in the Melbourne Cup. I think we learned more this prep starting from scratch with him. He has settled in well. He's far from 100 per cent fit so he will improve off the run but he's got some quality so I expect him to run well."

Griffiths chasing Diamond dream

Robbie Griffiths is counting on Glen Boss weaving some of his big race magic when the jockey rides Glenfiddich (Fastnet Rock) in today's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield. Boss has a knack of bobbing up in feature races, sometimes when least expected, and he rides Glenfiddich for the first time in the two-year-old contest. "That's the beauty of having Bossy on," Griffiths said. "He has an unbelievable knack of being first past the post in these big races. Glenfiddich is going to run a great race, but whether he's good enough is the big question. He's going to love the 1200 metres versus the 1000 and the 1100 of his previous runs and he's a strong colt."

Ellerton-Zahra after another Oakleigh Plate

Co-trainers Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra are no strangers to Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) success and have two runners as they bid for a second-straight victory in the feature sprint at Caulfield. Ellerton and Zahra won the Oakleigh Plate with Booker (Written Tycoon) a year ago and the training partnership has Zoutori (Zoustar) and Crystal Dreamer (Stratum) in today's edition of the handicap. Ellerton also trained Miss Kournikova (Mr Greeley) (2001) and River Dove (Hurricane Sky) (2003) to Oakleigh Plate wins, with Zahra part of the business for the second of those while he worked for John Hawkes when Sports (Zeditave) won in 2000. "Crystal Dreamer is an on-speed sort of horse, goes 100 miles an hour and that's the way you've got to ride him," Zahra said. "He loves Caulfield. His form there has been enormous. He's had a nice freshen-up so he's going in there quite fit and well. Zoutori gets back a bit and whether they are a bit nippy for him with that little bit of extra weight, time will tell. His main target is the Newmarket and we'll see if he can hit the line strongly."

Barrier against Bon

Bons Away (Bon Hoffa) has another tricky draw to overcome when the six-year-old contests the Oakleigh Plate for the third successive year today. In 2018 he finished fifth, beaten less than a length after jumping from barrier 14 of 18, and then last year he was beaten under two lengths when finishing fourth from barrier 16 of 18. "I think drawing 12 is going to make it a bit difficult for him but it is what it is, we'll turn up on the day and hope for a bit of luck," Jye McNeil, who rode Bons Away for the first time on his latest start, told Racing.com. Bons Away's most recent win came in last year's WJ Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) when he settled behind the leader and took the inside route, a tactic McNeil feels suits the gelding. "It seems to make it easier if you can go to sleep in

behind them, but we might have to use him up a little bit to get a good position. He would have improved out of his first-up run. Hopefully he can produce that good finish."

Bosson happy to clock up frequent flyer points

Opie Bosson made frequent trips across the Tasman in the spring to partner New Zealand stars Melody Belle (Commands) and Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) and he is hoping for further success in the coming weeks with the pair. Bosson again flies into Melbourne this weekend to partner Melody Belle in today's Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield and begin her autumn campaign which will include a tilt at the \$5 million All Star Mile (1600m). Melody Belle finished third in her 1050m trial at Tauranga earlier this month and Bosson said he was happy enough with her run. "She needed the hit-out, she had a good puff after it. She didn't have the blinkers on, so she would have taken a lot of benefit out of it. They went quite fast in the trial and I had to give her a bit of a push along, but she was going the right way and felt good. I had no complaints."

Bucking Westport to bounce back

After an eventful return to the races in Adelaide, Westport (Not A Single Doubt) is ready to bounce back in the Angus Armanasco Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield. Westport was sent back to the barrier trials after racing erratically and attempting to buck during a 1050-metre race at Morphettville first-up which resulted in her taking no competitive part, finishing 25 lengths from the winner. Having won her enforced trial and pleasing trainers Tony and Calvin McEvoy, the filly is ready to contest today's Group 2 race for three-year-old fillies. "She's a really good filly," Calvin McEvoy said. "We went into her first-up run the other day very confident she would be extremely hard to beat and unfortunately it all went a bit wrong. She was quite unruly and was throwing her head half having a buck which is very out of character for her. The saddle did not slip. I just think she was very fresh and once she jumped a little slow and the jockey gave her a little bit of a dig she overreacted."

Emerald Kingdom turns form around

Robert Heathcote has praised his staff for the improved attitude of Emerald Kingdom (Bryannbo's Gift) who will be attempting to post his fifth straight win when he lines up in today's Class Six Plate (1200m) at Eagle Farm. "My staff work on him daily and they even took him to Doomben for a day out the previous week to his last win," the trainer said. "It meant he got to enjoy a day at the races and saw it could be fun. Any horse which can win four races in a row and any horse which can go from Class Three to Class Six in one hop is obviously pretty smart," he said. "And his time (1.9.4) at Doomben was very good on a soft track." Heathcote believes Emerald Kingdom will get further later this year. "He reminds me of another of my horses Deep Image who has matured into a stakes horse. They are both big, hard going horses who needed racing," he added.

Sears partnership to fore at Eagle Farm

The father and daughter training partnership of Tony and Maddy Sears have a top prospect by Tycoon Ruler (Last Tycoon) in the shape of Exondabeach, one of the leading fancies for the \$300,000 3YO The Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast on March 14, and they hope another of his offspring in their care can add to his tally when Tycoon Ace contests the Open Handicap (1000m) at Eagle Farm today. Tycoon Ace has won 11 races and been placed 12 times in 38 starts and Tony Sears believes Tycoon Ruler is an under-rated sire who has produced tough horses over a long period. "They are never expensive horses," Sears said. "I bought Exondabeach out of a paddock for Maddy and my wife Leigh. Tycoon Ace was bred by his owners and has won \$439,000 to date."

Staying test for Badoosh

Matt Dunn recognises Badoosh (Sebring) has a task when he lines up carrying 59 kilograms from a wide barrier in the QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap (1800m) at Eagle Farm today but the trainer is looking for an indication the gelding can stay. "If he shows us he will get 2000 metres or further we might decide to press on into the winter with him," Dunn said. "He hasn't had much luck in shorter races and he indicates he is looking for at least 1800 metres.

But he is well into this campaign and he would need to really show something to justify the winter."

Russian Camelot nears return

Russian Camelot (Camelot) took a step towards a competitive return with an eye-catching performance in a jump-out at Flemington yesterday. The Danny O'Brien-trained threeyear-old tracked wide and powered through the line under jockey Damien Oliver, being narrowly beaten by Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) in the 800-metre gallop. "Russian Camelot is a horse that has only had two starts so he's learning all the time but there's no doubt he's very talented," O'Brien told Racing. com. "Damien was happy with him but he still wanted to do a bit wrong. He accelerated nicely at the back end of it and he's a horse that will get better every time he does something." A debut winner at Ballarat over 1400 metres in October before finishing second in a Listed race at Flemington in November, Russian Camelot is scheduled to resume over 1400m at that track on March 7. While a tilt at the English Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) won by his sire Camelot has been touted, O'Brien said he was focused on preparing the colt for the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville on May 9.

Vow And Declare also trials well

Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War) is on track to make his return in the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington after pleasing his trainer in a jump-out. Vow And Declare continued his preparations towards a race return in an 800-metre jump-out on the course proper at Flemington yesterday under jockey Craig Williams, and showed sharpness to feature prominently after running on the outside of the field. "He was super," O'Brien said. "We were really happy with him. He was nice and sharp and his recovery was excellent. His fitness levels are good. I think the way he trialled this morning he would be about 99 per cent that he'll be going to the Australian Cup."

Soft trial for Black Caviar's daughter

Ready For Caviar (More Than Ready), the fourth foal out of superstar mare Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), edged one step closer to making her debut when given an easy jump-out at Flemington yesterday. David Hayes, who intends to give the filly another jump-out over 800 metres in the next two weeks told Racing. com: "We gave her a nice, easy trial more for an education and a look at Flemington and we'll give her a bit of a squeeze next week. I'm hoping she can get to the track this campaign. The gallop I gave her at Lindsay Park before she came down here showed me that she's definitely got ability and we might get a chance to see that next week."

Winner for Caboche

Apprentice Dylan Caboche has landed a winner at Sale at his first ride back from injury after 12 months out of the saddle. The recent long break only added to Caboche's woes in a career not only interrupted by injury but personal leave after a suspension for punching a horse at Port Lincoln in 2017, an incident that made national headlines. With that episode well behind him and now over his most recent ailment, Caboche partnered Whipcracker Way (Shamus Award) for Phillip Stokes who he was apprenticed to in Adelaide before his injury. Caboche tore the ACL, PCL, MCL and meniscus in his knee and suffered a fractured right foot in an accident at trackwork. "My boss put me on a good one firstup and it's good to get the monkey off the back," Caboche told Racing.com. "I thought six months in I would never ride again as there were a few complications along the way after surgery. But I moved to Victoria and Gary Zimmerman fixed me up and I'm good to go now."

The Chosen One starts Sydney Cup campaign

The Chosen One (Savabeel) will kick off his Sydney Cup campaign when he lines up in the Haunui Farm Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) with connections pleased to have seen rain hit the track at Otaki. "We're very happy with The Chosen One," said Murray Baker, who trains the four-year-old in partnership with Andrew Forsman. "This race is a bit short of his best but the track will have a bit of juice in it so it will slow them down a bit. This is probably a bit short for him but he's trialled up well and we've got to get him under way. He's an autumn fouryear-old now and I think he's just coming to it."

Big Mike returns to form

Big Mike (Don Eduardo) will attempt to back up Thursday's win in the Wairoa Cup Trial (1900m) at Te Kupenga when he makes a quick return in tomorrow's Wairoa Cup (2100m). The Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m) winner put in a bold frontrunning display under apprentice Elen Nicholas and Shaun Phelan, who trains the seven-year-old in partnership with his father Craig, is hoping for a repeat tomorrow. "We will do the same thing again,"

Phelan said. "It's better to let him roll and that's how he best races. When he gets his own way in front he is a hard horse to peg back. The track looks great and it is probably his best distance as well."

INTERNATIONAL

75 for Shamardal

Darley's Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) sired his 75th individual Group winner when Zakouski (4 g ex O'Giselle by Octagonal) got up late to land the Zabeel Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Meydan on Thursday night. Racing in third for the majority of the race, Zakouski responded gamely in the straight to swoop close home and score a neck, denying Mythical Magic (Iffraaj) a repeat victory in the race. Dream Castle (Frankel) was the same distance away in third. Out of the unraced O'Giselle (Octagonal), a sister to champion Lonhro, Zakouski is a half-brother to three winners including the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) runner-up Albrecht (Redoute's Choice) and King's Command (Dubawi), a winner of a Group 3 in France last year. O'Giselle is now back in Australia and had a colt by Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor) in 2019. Shamardal has now sired 146 individual stakes winners, including 25 that have struck at the highest level.

26 for Super Saver

Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) winner Super Saver (Maria's Mon) sired his 26th individual stakes winner when Down On Da Bayou (3 f ex Bayou Tortuga by Empire Maker) proved to be in a different class to her rivals as she scooted clear to bag the UAE Oaks (Gr 3, 1900m) by an astonishing eighteen and a half lengths. The Salem bin Ghadayer-trained filly, who was winning her second race in five starts, turned the tables on favourite and runner-up Dubai Love (Night Of Thunder), who herself finished four and a half lengths clear of the third home Serein (Uncle Mo) in a well stretched out field. Super Saver left WinStar Farm late last year to take up stallion duties in Turkey.

Ghaiyyath impresses in **Dubai Millennium romp**

Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) blew away his rivals as he set a new track record when taking out the Dubai Millennium Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) on the Meydan turf in impressive fashion. The Charlie Appleby-trained five-year-old, who was having his first start since disappointing in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) at Longchamp in October, ran on strongly to come home eight and a half lengths clear of the runner-up, stablemate Spotify (Redoute's Choice), with a further four lengths back to the third home, Privilegiado (Sea The Moon). Ghaiyyath now boasts a record of six wins and two thirds from nine starts, including five wins at Group level.

In-form Waady backs up in Meydan Sprint

Waady (Approve) kept his good run of form in Dubai going when he posted his most notable success to date when landing the Meydan Sprint (Gr 2, 1000m). A winner over the track and trip last time, the Doug Watson-trained eight-year-old ran on well to beat red-hot favourite Equilateral (Equiano) by three quarters of a length, with Blitzkrieg (War Front) a further length and a quarter away in third. Waady has now won nine of his 32 starts, three of those victories coming in stakes company.

Ms Catherine provides Shooting To Win with milestone in Typhoon Tracy

hooting To Win (Northern Meteor), to date upstaged at stud by his brother Deep Field, last night registered an important stakes winner after the progressive Henry Dwyer-trained filly Ms Catherine scored an allthe-way victory in the Typhoon Tracy Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Moonee Valley.

Now unbeaten in three starts, Ms Catherine scored a dominant win at Bendigo in November before resuming at Moonee Valley two weeks ago where she put four and a half lengths on her rivals in Benchmark 74 Handicap (1000m) grade.

Last night, with Dwyer's apprentice Georgie Cartwright maintaining her association with the homebred filly, Ms Catherine was sent straight to the lead before holding on by a neck.

Godolphin's filly Tenley (Medaglia d'Oro) was second, with Don'ttelltheboss (Street Boss) another three quarters of a length back in third.

The favourite Sassy Salitage (Toronado), who was first-up in last night's \$160,000 Group 3 race, ran fourth.

Dwyer admitted it was hard to line up Ms Catherine's restricted form against her rivals in the three-year-old fillies race.

"When they win two from two at this time of year, you've got to throw them in the deep end,

particularly with fillies," Dwyer told Racing.com post-race.

"Tony and Joe (Bongiorno) own several fillies in the family, so it's good for all the fillies, not just Ms Catherine and the dam Lucky Diva and everything.

"There was some question mark at 1200 but Georgie gave her a couple of cheap sectionals mid-race and she kicked on late."

Ms Catherine could be given a short break before possibly being sent to Adelaide for the Euclase Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Morphettville during the autumn.

"We always liked her but it is always very hard to get a gauge off a maiden and a Friday night win," said Dwyer, who will soon move his main training base from Caulfield to Ballarat. "She puts herself in front, she did everything right tonight and Georgie gave her a great ride, so I am really pleased."

Mature-age jockey Cartwright is apprenticed to Dwyer and the trainer reserved praise for his rider.

"I am very proud of her, to be honest, as she's done it the tough way," he said.

"She has been an apprentice for a long time

and she comes to the end of it at the end of the year.

"I'd have loved to have given her more opportunities than I have, but sometimes it's not the easiest sell, a female apprentice. Tony and Joe Bongiorno, who own (Ms Catherine), gave Georgie the green light and were happy for her to stay with the horse."

The majority of Dwyer's staff were at Moonee Valley last night to support Cartwright in her bid to win her first stakes race.

"It is the most amazing feeling - it's my biggest career win so far. It makes all the hard work worth it," Cartwright said.

"She flies the gate and does everything right. She probably doesn't want any more than 1200 but she was too good tonight."

Ms Catherine's sire, the Caulfield Guineas

(Gr 1, 1600m) winn Shooting To Win, went to stud at Darley in 2015, the same year as his Group 2-winning sibling Deep Field at Newgate Farm,



but covered significantly fewer mares than his brother.

In 2019, however, breeders responded to the the promising signs shown by Shooting To Win's first crop two-year-olds, with the

former Peter and Paul Snowden-trained horse covering 177 mares, the most he has served in his five years at stud.

Shooting To Win is also the sire of the Chris Waller-trained Kubrick, runner-up in last year's

J J Atkins Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) and inaugural winner of the \$1 million Bondi Stakes (1600m), as well as the stakes-placed juvenile Shotmaker.

Meanwhile, the Tony and Joe Bongiornobred Ms Catherine (3 f Shooting To Win - Lucky Diva by Perugino), who was withdrawn from the 2018 Magic MIllions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, has earned \$136,150 in her short career so far.

Ms Catherine is the first stakes winner and one of five who have been successful on the track for her dam, the Group 3 winner Lucky Diva, who in turn is a sister to Listed winner Gina Lollawitcha and a half-sister to stakes winners Spirit Of Westbury (Sir Tristram) and Duke Of Westbury (Sir Tristram).

Lucky Diva has a yearling sister to Ms Catherine and was covered by Deep Field last November while the Typhoon Tracy winner's older half-sister Ms Rodarte (I Am Invincible) retired to stud last year and was covered by Arrowfield Stud first season shuttler Real Steel (Deep Impact).

Rock On Rhianna (Fastnet Rock), another half-sister, also visited Deep Field this season.

Fitzsimmons saddles first winner

im Fitzsimmons was a hugely relieved man as he walked down from his seat to lead in his first winner as a trainer in his own right last night - Mega Gold (Giant's Steps).

The Australian horseman has experienced the highs of more than 500 winners during his time as assistant trainer to Cliff Brown in Singapore, including big race wins with the likes of Debt Collector (Thorn Park), Gilt Complex (Gold Centre) and Zac Spirit (Flying Spirit), to name a few.

But the feeling was just as unreal for the 38-year-old the moment Mega Gold crossed the line first in the \$75,000 Restricted Maiden Division 2 race over 1200m.

Fitzsimmons received his trainer's licence last April, and after he moved into his stables four months later with only a clutch of horses, he sent out nine runners without collecting a single placing.

Not surprised by the slow start given his yard had been cobbled together with mostly 'hand-me-down' horses in the first months, Fitzsimmons soon got a whiff of that first taste of success with two agonisingly close seconds courtesy of Thunder (Battle Of Marengo) and Mister Dynamo (All Too Hard).

The wait for his first winner came to an end though when his 22nd runner, \$9 favourite Mega Gold, scored under the guidance of a jockey he knows well, Brown's first choice rider Michael Rodd.

After a creditable debut fourth, the threeyear-old was considered a top chance to be Fitzsimmons' account opener, and although he was some distance off the leader in the first half of the race, Mega Gold quickened well to hit the front at the 300m mark, before holding on to score by a length and a half from Superior Coat (Coats Choice), with Lago De Como (Orpen) another three-quarters of a length away in third. The winning time was 1min 12.75secs for the 1200m on the Polytrack.

"It's fantastic, it's a huge relief. I'd first like to thank my parents, my former employer Cliff Brown and my wife and three kids," said an emotional Fitzsimmons.

"It's fitting and fantastic that it's Michael who rode my first winner, but how can I not mention Marc Lerner who helps me a lot with the horses and would have ridden my two horses tonight, if he was not suspended.

"I also have to say a big thank you to my staff, my track rider Anwar, and other jockeys, especially Harry Kasim and Daniel Moor for their help.

"I was not overly frustrated I hadn't had my first winner. It helps that I've been here for so long, I was not panicking, if anything, it felt like other people wanted that first winner more than me!

"It's great I've been able to repay their faith in me, especially the Gold Stable (owner of Mega Gold) tonight.

"The horse was further back than I thought, but they were going fast in front. I didn't know how it would be for him amongst horses, but it's worked out well in the end."

Rodd, who rode Fitzsimmons' inaugural runner Petite Voix (Poet's Voice) last September, was delighted for his friend first and foremost.

"As soon as Timmy got his licence, I've been waiting for that moment, and I'm glad I rode his first winner," said the hoop.

"A few horses nearly got up for him a few times. Unfortunately for them, other jockeys couldn't get that first winner for him, but fortunately for me, I got it.

"Everybody knows how Timmy and I go back a long way. He works so hard, and I still remember when he just got his stables, he had only two horses.

"He did it the tough way, but he knows the system and the background. Tim can train, it was just a matter of getting the right stock.

"This horse was a nice buy from the Gold Stable. He's still raw, and Marc Lerner is the one who has worked on him, so it's a shame he couldn't ride him tonight."

The favourite **Sassy Salitage** settled in third place on the rails from her good barrier (2) but was under riding approaching the home turn. She got through to second at the 100m and then battled on quite well for (1.3 lengths) fourth, albeit

after appearing to have had every chance at her first run back. **Oh Please Dianna**, who was stepping up in class after winning a 3yo fillies' maiden (1100m) at Werribee on February 3, raced in fourth place (one out and one back), moved up rounding the home turn and then battled on quite nicely for (1.6 lengths) fifth.
