Newgate Farm secures share in Slipper hopeful Stay Inside

Extreme Choice colt snapped up by Henry Field after stud enjoys super Saturday

ewgate Farm continued its rapid ascent as a thoroughbred breeding powerhouse with two of its young stallions producing their first Group 1 winners at Caulfield on Saturday and in the wake of the milestone day on the racetrack managing director Henry Field yesterday confirmed that he's secured a share in star Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) contender Stay Inside (Extreme Choice).

Artorius (Flying Artie) stuck in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) before another of Newgate's rising stars, Deep Field (Northern Meteor), sired his first elite level winner in the following Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) when his three-year-old son Portland Sky dead-heated with Celebrity Queen (Redoute's Continued on page 2>>

<< Continued from page 1 Field is taking full advantage of the momentum his farm is generating by shoring up as many talented sons of his young gun sires as possible and Stay Inside, an impressive last start winner of the Pierro Plate (1100m) at Randwick, is the latest acquisition destined for a future on the Newgate roster.

Field confirmed with ANZ Bloodstock News that the deal was successfully struck in recent days and that Newgate's share in the ownership would be registered with Racing Australia by next week.

"He looks one right out of the box," Field said. "He reminds me a lot of Extreme Choice after his second start with the acceleration he has. It takes a really good two-year-old to have a turn of foot like he does. He will be a force to be reckoned with in autumn."

Newgate Farm is now likely to have two of its future stallions lining up in the world's richest two-year old race at Rosehill on March 20, the other being the recent dominant Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) winner Profiteer, a son of their hot young sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon).

To win with either would be the ultimate return on investment and based on what happened for them on the track at Caulfield on Saturday, is not outside the realms of possibility.

Reflecting on what was a red-letter day, Field said: "It was like a defining day for me. I remember when we had the old farm and were leasing 250 acres of land with fences falling down and plywood boxes with Foxwedge. To think where we are in less than ten years is amazing."

Newgate's reputation is riding strongly off the back of its three incredibly high performing first season sires - Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt), Capitalist and Flying Artie (Artie Schiller).

"I have never seen a crop of first season sires like it. For the top three first season sires dollar wise to be out performing the top three second season sires is phenomenal. That never happens or probably won't happen again in history.

"I think it comes down to them having been an extraordinary crop of racehorses. It was a vintage crop and many good form judges say it was the

best crop in a decade and it has shone through to the racetrack and stud barn where these young sires are standing." $\,$

The emergence of Flying Artie has been a pleasant surprise for Field who said it was a challenge to get support for the horse when he first joined the roster.

How things have changed since his son's victory in the Blue Diamond. Within less than 24 hours of Artorius crossing the line at Caulfield, the Newgate team had received 50 mare bookings for him.

"The beautiful thing about this industry is the only thing that really matters is the winning post," Field continued.

"He's sired five winners and a Blue Diamond winner in his first crop and all the signs are he will be a very important stallion. Horses can't start any better at stud. I'm sure he will be in great demand this season."

So whilst Flying Artie delivered Blue Diamond success at the weekend, one of his barn mates could yet provide the Golden Slipper winner next month. Extreme Choice will be represented by Stay Inside, while Profiteer will be aiming to emulate his sire Capitalist who won the race in 2016.

With this trio of first season sires at Newgate hogging much of the limelight we shouldn't overlook the achievement of another horse on the roster there. Deep Field, who was the leading second season sire by winners in 2020.

"To have two young stallions sire two Group 1 winners in two time honoured races is something we will look back at in 20 years' time and say is amazing," said Field.

Chequerboard (3 f ex Chi by Zabeel) comfortably took out the Tasmanian Oaks (Listed, 2100m) at Launceston vesterday to provide Coolmore's Fastnet Rock (Danehill) with his 169th individual stakes winner. The Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes-trained Chequerboard was sent off the \$1.55 favourite and justified those odds with a one and a half-length defeat of Queen Adele (Adelaide). My Squeeze Louise (Mongolian Khan) finished five lengths behind the winner in third. Chequerboard always looked in control of the race under Brendon McCoull, who eased her to the front rounding the home turn. She maintained a comfortable distance over Queen Adele down the straight, with the Cindy Aldersontrained filly battling on to finish well clear of the chasing pack. Shuttle stallion Fastnet Rock, who had his 168th stakes winner on Saturday courtesy of Parure in Caulfield's Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m), stood in Australia for a 2020 service fee of \$165,000.

Two for My Admiration

Cryptic Love (5 m ex Abitcryptic by Bletchley Park) caused an upset in the Pinjarra Classic (Listed, 1300m) yesterday to provide Westbury Park stallion My Admiration (Encosta de Lago) with his second individual stakes winner. The David Harrison-trained mare grabbed the inside rail down the home straight and just got up in a photo finish under Jason Whiting, with the first five horses finishing within half a length of the winner. Western Temple (Dream Ahead), like the winner sent off a \$31 chance, finished a nose behind in second, with Son Of A God (Playing God) a short head further behind in third. My Admiration, winner of the 2012 Chairman's Trophy (Listed, 1600m) in Hong Kong, is also the sire of last year's Magic Millions WA 3YO Trophy (RL, 1200m) winner Cryptic Wonder. Both his stakes winners are out of Bletchley Park (Caerleon) mare Abitcryptic, who foaled an unnamed colt out of My Admiration in 2019.

Turkish delight as Warrior remains unbeaten in Millions

Exciting juvenile Turk Warrior (Outreach) stretched his unbeaten record to four with an impressive victory in yesterday's Magic Millions Tasmanian 2YO Classic (1200m) at Launceston. Winner of the Elwick Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and Gold Sovereign Stakes (Listed, 1200m) on his previous two starts, Turk Warrior justified his \$1.07 starting price with a comfortable three and a half length defeat of Power Magnum (Magnus). Gee Gee Enuf Speed (Rich Enuff) was another one and three-quarter lengths back in third. Turk Warrior, a graduate of the McCulloch family's Grenville Stud, was originally passed in at last year's Tasmanian Yearling Sale, before being purchased by Sayit Basol and joining the Glenn Stevenson stable. The win was a timely one for Grenville Stud, who will present his half brother by resident sire Zululand (Fastnet Rock) as Lot 106 at today's Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale.

Behemoth still on track for All-Star Mile





David Jolly is confident he will have Behemoth (All Too Hard) in peak condition for next month's All-Star Mile (1600m) after the gelding finished fourth in the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on Saturday. "We thought the inside barrier (gate 2) was going to be an advantage but once we established the way the track was racing, it was always going to be hard to find the best part of the track," Jolly told Racing.com. "They went a bit bold in front and he had to kick up. He didn't get much of a rest and he's still got a little bit of improvement in him. He's got that three-week window now, so we've got plenty of time to get him to the post in peak order." Behemoth will be reunited with Craig Williams in the All-Star Mile and Jolly added: "Nothing against Oly (Damien Oliver), but a familiar jockey will be back on next start. He has got a few little tricks and if you have sat on him before, you know that and if you haven't it might take a ride to get used to him. The bottom line is that it was no disgrace to be beaten by those top mares given not much went right for our bloke, so I think we can take something out of that and turn it around in a few weeks."



Gallop to decide what's next with Four Moves Ahead

The John Sargent-trained Four Moves Ahead (Snitzel) will have a track gallop tomorrow morning and, if she performs well, connections are likely to line her up in Saturday's Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick. Four Moves Ahead won impressively on debut at Randwick last month but Sargent was forced to scratch her from last weekend's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) after she injured herself by kicking out at home. Sargent said the filly, who is a \$17 chance with TAB to win next month's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), worked on Saturday morning and appears to be in rude health.

Tralee Rose aimed at Sydney Cup

Saturday's Lord Reim Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) winner Tralee Rose (Tavistock) will be put on a path to the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on April 10 her trainer Symon Wilde confirmed. The Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) on March 8 will be the mare's next assignment, while her longer term aim is November's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "I was having a think about it last night and if she did happen to win the Adelaide Cup, you'd have to think about the Sydney Cup," he said. "It's a Group 1 and worth a lot of money and if she could win it, she would be in the (Melbourne) Cup next spring. We wouldn't have to wait for the Andrew Ramsden in May or having to have her earn a spot in the spring." Wilde said Jason Holder may well retain the mount in the \$300,000 Adelaide Cup. "I have to talk to the owners, but I thought he rode it very well," the trainer continued. "It was probably an easy ride, but he did it well and I would be tempted to keep him on."

Aegon back in All-Star mix

A tilt at the All-Star Mile could still be on the cards for impressive Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Aegon (Sacred Falls) according to Racing Victoria's executive general manager of racing Greg Carpenter. The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained gelding was pulled out of the \$5 million race three weeks ago, with connections opting to pursue other targets in Sydney, but Carpenter said the door has been

left ajar for a wildcard, should they change their mind. "I rang Andrew (Forsman) this morning and congratulated him on the victory and told him that we'd love him to consider a wildcard into the All-Star Mile," Carpenter told Racing. com. "He did say that Sydney is their plan, but he has a week to discuss it."

Cup out, Mile on for Power

The Bob Peters-owned Regal Power (Pierro) will likely bid to defend his All-Star Mile crown if he is granted a wildcard. The five-year-old gelding disappointed at the weekend with a ninth-placed finish in Caulfield's Peter Young Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) and Peters is keen to head to Moonee Valley on March 13 rather than run Regal Power in the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) a week earlier, providing he is granted a wildcard. "Whether he gets one (wildcard) now or not, we'll have to find out," the owner told Racing.com. "I would think that, if we did get one, it would be better to go to the All-Star Mile rather than the Australian Cup. At 1600 metres, it would probably suit him better. He seemed to have pulled up alright. There seems to be nothing wrong with him. There was nothing on the scope. He is not a first-up horse. He always takes one run to get him going and that might be the case again, but he has got me baffled a bit this time."

Forbes impresses in Goulburn trial

Golden Slipper hope Forbes (Capitalist) came through his Goulburn trial unscathed yesterday as he bids to get passed fit for the March 20 showpiece. Trained by Anthony and Sam Freedman, Forbes comfortably beat his three rivals by nine and three-quarter lengths,

with Aramis En Avant (Makfi) finishing closest to him in second. Forbes had been scratched from his past two Sydney trials but suffered no complications under Jean Van Overmeire yesterday. The colt finished runner-up to Anamoe (Street Boss) in November's Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m), his only raceday start to date. Forbes is a general \$34 chance for the Golden Slipper.

Sky to air Inglis Premier Yearling Sale preview

Sky Thoroughbred Central will showcase a one-hour preview of the 2021 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale at 7.30pm AEDST tonight on Foxtel Channel 528. The preview will feature yearlings from Blue Gum Farm, Esker Lodge, Merricks Station and Collingrove Stud. The preview will also be streamed live on racing. nsw.com.au. Replays can also be seen on Sky Thoroughbred Central at 7am on Wednesday and Thursday, plus at 8am on Sunday morning.

NEW ZEALAND

Waikato celebrates Australian double

Within one special hour on Saturday, Waikato Stud graduates Probabeel (Savabeel) and Aegon (Sacred Falls) flew the New Zealand flag high across the Tasman with a superb stakes-winning double, Probabeel added a third Australian Group 1 victory to her collection by winning Caulfield's Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), before Aegon landed the Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). The results delighted Waikato Stud principal Mark Chittick. "It was a very special hour for us as a stud, but also for us as the New Zealand thoroughbred industry," he said. "We've always been able to produce quality horses that can go over to Australia and perform against their very best, and yesterday gave us two great examples of that. Both Probabeel and Aegon proved vesterday that they're super horses. They didn't get it easy, but their sheer quality got them home. Probabeel is outstanding. The way she was wide up to the turn like that and totally dominated them down the straight, it was great to watch. She's won three Group 1s in Australia now and has the All-Star Mile coming up next month, and I don't think she'll stop there either."





Dark Alley bounces back at Hastings

Promising four-year-old Dark Alley (Per Incanto) scored an impressive victory in a 1200-metre Benchmark 65 at Hastings yesterday. The Guy Lowry and Grant Cullen-trained gelding kicked off his racing career with an eye-catching win over 1200 metres at Hastings in December before running on late for fifth behind Montre Moi (Showcasing) over 1400 metres at Otaki in early January. Dark Alley was sent out a warm \$2.80 favourite for his racetrack return yesterday and comfortably defeated Mandalorian (Darci Brahma) by a length, with Miss Sweet Pee (Mossman) another one and three-quarter lengths back in third. Lowry, who bred and owns the four-year-old in partnership with Little Avondale Stud, was quietly confident of a good performance. "He's always been a nice horse that we have a fair bit of time for," the co-trainer said. "He won nicely on debut and then he struck a pretty good field last time at just his second start. I think the main factor was the track was very hard that day and he probably didn't appreciate that type of footing. I think he is better when there is plenty of cushion in the track and he got that today. I'm pretty confident he has the ability to go right through the grades."

Collett confident in Robusto's Auckland Cup bid

A victory on Robusto (Zed) in Saturday's Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) provided Sam Collett with her third win in the feature after success aboard El Soldado (Colombia) in 2017 and Glory Days (Red Giant) in 2019 and the jockey is confident Robusto can perform well in next month's Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "I spoke to Murray Baker this morning to confirm the ride on Robusto for the Auckland Cup," Collett said. "I know her two-mile form isn't that

good, but it is very hard to get off her after what she produced on Saturday. She is rock hard fit, will only carry 53.5 kilograms and with her pattern of racing she will put herself in a good spot which makes life a lot easier in those staying contests."

Justacanta gets deserved Ellerslie success

The Shaun and Emma Clotworthy-trained Justacanta (Per Incanto) got his just rewards for some outstanding efforts of late when he closed out a stylish victory over 1200 metres at Ellerslie on Saturday. The seven-year-old had not tasted success since a victory at the same venue back in October, finishing second on two occasions including in the Concorde Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m) on Karaka Million night, and Shaun Clotworthy was delighted the gelding managed to get back in the winner's circle. "He's a game little horse who has been honest right the way through," he said. "He deserved to pick up a race like that as his last few runs have been very good. His sectionals in the Railway were super and he closed off really well off a wide run in the Concorde. He's always been slow away from the gates and he was again on Saturday, but there was some really good speed up front that suited him. He always puts in and I guess the only surprising thing yesterday was the price (\$9.40) he paid."

ASIA

Three for American Pharoah

Coolmore's American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) notched his third elite-level winner, and first on dirt, when his son Cafe Pharoah (4 c ex Mary's Follies by More Than Ready) landed the February Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Tokyo yesterday. Bred by Paul P Pompa, Cafe Pharoah is the fifth foal produced by Grade 2 winner Mary's Follies

(More Than Ready). Cafe Pharoah was purchased for current connections, owner Koichi Nishikawa and trainer Noriyuki Hori, by Emmanuel de Seroux's Narvick International at \$475,000 when offered by Eddie Woods at the 2019 Ocala Breeders' Sales March Two-Year-Olds in Training event. Shuttler American Pharoah will stand at Ashford Stud for a fee of US\$100,000 (approx. AUD\$127,000) in 2021.

JPN: Territorial adds to tally

Territorial (Teofilo) added a Grade 3 win to his two Listed successes when the Godolphin-raced seven-year-old took out yesterday's Kokura Daishoten (Gr 3, 1800m). He edged out favourite Boccherini (King Kamehameha) by a nose with Dirndl (Ruleship) filling third spot, a length and a half behind the winner. Territorial now has eight wins in 32 starts.

INTERNATIONAL

87 for Into Mischief

Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday) sired his 87th individual stakes winner when Hibiscus Punch (6 m ex Bellini Sunrise by Machiavellian) landed the Barbara Fritchie Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Laurel Park on Saturday night. The Justin Nixon-trained six-yearold was winning for the third time in eight starts as she beat Estilo Talentoso (Maclean's Music) by two and a half lengths. Club Car (Malibu Moon) was another three and a halflengths away in third. Bred in Kentucky by her owners Edward Seltzer and Beverly Anderson, Hibiscus Punch is the first stakes winner from her dam, the Machiavellian (Mr. Prospector) mare Bellini Sunrise. All eight of the dam's foals to race are winners. Into Mischief stands at Spendthrift's Kentucky farm for a fee of \$225,000 (approx. AUD\$286,000) in 2021.

US: Consistent Share The Ride strikes again

The consistent Share The Ride (Candy Ride) made it nine wins in 23 starts when landing Laurel's General George Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) on Saturday. The Miguel Penaloza-trained six-year-old downed Tattooed (Etched) by two lengths, with the same margin back to Laki (Cuba) in third. Share The Ride has now won three times in Graded company and has only failed to make the first four twice in his career.

US: More joy for Charmaine's Mia

Charmaine's Mia (The Factor) registered her second successive Graded victory when scoring as favourite in Saturday's Buena Vista Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) on the Santa Anita turf. Trained by Phil D'Amato, the five-year-old mare stepped up in grade and trip following her success in a Grade 3 contest over six furlongs at the same track last start as she beat Mucho Unusual (Mucho Macho Man) by a length. Warren's Showtime (Clubhouse Ride) was another three-quarters of a length away in third. Charmaine's Mia now has six wins from 27 starts.

US: Royal Delta goes the way of Queen Nekia

Queen Nekia (Harlington) put her more fancied rivals firmly in their place when running out a comfortable winner of the Royal Delta Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Gulfstream on Saturday night. The six-year-old mare, who is trained by Saffie Joseph jnr, beat Eres Tu (Malibu Moon) by a length and three-quarters. There was a gap of four and three-

quarter lengths back to Bajan Girl (Speightstown) in third. Queen Nekia now has two stakes wins among her tally of ten victories.

KSA: Mishriff hits jackpot in Saudi Cup

Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m) winner Mishriff (Make Believe) came from a wide draw to overturn the well-fancied Charlatan (Speightstown) and take out the world's richest race, the Saudi Cup (1800m), in Riyadh on Saturday. The John Gosden-trained four-year-old, who was partnered by David Egan, pocketed connections US\$10 million (approx. AUD\$12.71m) courtesy of his length win. Great Scot (Requinto) was a further six and a half lengths adrift in third. Mishriff has now won five of his nine starts, three of those victories coming in stakes company.

UK: Prince of Arran career in doubt

Serial Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) placegetter Prince Of Arran (Shirocco) may have run his last race after finishing a disappointing ninth in Saudi Arabia on Saturday. Following the race, in which the eight-year-old was beaten seven lengths, his trainer Charlie Fellowes tweeted: "All plans on hold for Prince of Arran for the time being after a 2nd very slow start in a row. He owes us absolutely nothing and we will take our time before making any further decisions on his future. He is safe and well after his race and flies back to England on Monday."

UK: Mactaggert calls time on Goffs stint

Goffs UK director Stuart Mactaggart has decided to take early retirement and will finish his role at the company at the end of the month. Mactaggart, who started working for Goffs in 1990, was initially employed as an assistant pedigree researcher before working in the production of catalogues. He was promoted to the role of director in 2006 and has since worked as the head of bloodstock alongside his position as company secretary. He has also been a member of the inspection team since 2000 and sourced many future big-race winners who have sold through the Goffs sales ring.

Relief as interstate buyers make trip to Tasmania for Magic Millions Yearling Sale

last-minute influx of interstate buyers will provide much-needed depth to the marketplace ahead of today's Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale, the Apple Isle's first thoroughbred auction since the state's racing industry was shut down for three months last year.

"(Magic Millions') Cassandra Simmonds has booked about 70 trips for 20 people because they keep dropping flights off and this, that and the other," Brown told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday of the interstate buyers in Tasmania.

"It hasn't been easy for anybody, but the sales complex is working very well indeed and hopefully we have a good sale."

Grenville Stud, along with Armidale Stud (31 lots), will offer 21 yearlings, including a Zululand half-brother to Tasmania's star unbeaten two-year-old Turk Warrior (Outreach), the centre of a big Hong Kong offer recently. The Glenn Stevenson-trained gelding made it four from four yesterday in Launceston's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (1200m).

Bart McCulloch, who runs Grenville Stud with his trainer-father Graeme, was yesterday displaying a perhaps unexpected confidence about today's sale after significant local and interstate buyer interest during a hectic day of inspections.

"We were very relieved a couple of days ago when the (Tasmanian) premier announced the borders would be open," McCulloch told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"It was two or three days there of watching the Covid cases in Victoria very closely, so it was a big relief when that happened and we've been absolutely run off our feet today.

"There's been a lot more local interest than previous years which I think has been largely driven by the TasBred incentive scheme and there's plenty of mainlanders coming through. "The response to our first season sire Zululand has been overwhelming. A lot of the Magic Millions team have come over and said that everyone on the complex is talking about the Zululands, so we just can't wait for the sale."

Magic Millions' Brown was reticent to make any bold predictions about the Tasmania sale breaking any records and following the trend of the Australian auctions conducted so far this year, most recently last week's Perth Yearling Sale.



Golden Sixty extends unbeaten sequence to 13 with Gold Cup triumph

olden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) extended his unbeaten run to 13 straight wins with victory in yesterday's Citi Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin.

However, Hong Kong's highest rated horse was forced to spare no effort as he scrambled to add a third consecutive Group 1 to his glittering record which now stands at 16 wins from 17 starts, four shy of Silent Witness' (El Moxie) record 17 consecutive wins.

Dropped out to his customary position at the rear of the field, the gelding began his surge in the straight but the challenge from Furore (Pierro) on the inside required jockey Vincent Ho to call on everything that Golden Sixty could give and, it proved just enough in a time of 2m 0.25s by a short head, the smallest margin of any of his wins.

"I was quite confident that I would stay ahead of them but we fought hard - it wasn't easy, it was a bit unexpected to be that close," Ho said.

"I was just worried about the horse to the inside of him because Golden Sixty laid in a bit, he would have won easier if he didn't do that.

"Once he went past Exultant he wanted to lay in - it made it difficult for me but it's still a victory."

Yesterday's win was both a first in the Gold Cup for Ho and trainer Francis Lui.

"I think you can't really change the horse's character - when he passed the third horse (Exultant), Golden Sixty thinks he has finished the job, but there's another horse on the inside," Lui said.

The 131-rater is now only two wins shy of Beauty Generation's (Road To Rock) single-season record of eight and he has the first two legs of Hong Kong's Triple Crown in the bag after claiming last month's Stewards' Cup (Gr 1, 1600m).

"I will think about the third leg of the Triple

Crown, we also have a race in April in mind," Lui said referencing FWD Champions Day.

The third and final leg of the Triple Crown is the Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) on May 23 and, if successful stepping up to 12 furlongs in three months' time, he could become the second horse after River Verdon (Be My Native) in the 1993/94 racing season to win the Triple Crown.

Waikuku steams to Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup victory as Size reaches milestone

John Size soared higher into Hong Kong racing's stratosphere after the 11-time champion trainer posted his 1300th winner with Waikuku's (Harbour Watch) triumph in the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (Gr 1, 1400m).

Joining John Moore, who retired at the end of the 2019/2020 season with a record 1,735 victories, and Tony Cruz, who has amassed 1,329 wins, as the only trainers to have prepared 1,300 Hong Kong winners, Size continued an excellence which has become his trademark with Waikuku.

The six-year-old notched his second elite triumph after stalking main rival Southern Legend (Not A Single Doubt) into the straight before easing to a one and a quarter length margin over Caspar Fownes' charge. Mighty Giant (Power) was third.

In typically self-effacing style, Size attempted to deflect attention post-race as winning jockey Joao Moreira spoke glowingly about the trainer's attention to detail and work ethic.

"It probably means I've been here a long time and I'm doing my job well," Size said, reflecting on his move from Sydney to Hong Kong in 2001.

"Every achievement along the way in your career is meaningful.

"I couldn't have imagined that in my wildest dreams. Obviously, it's been a good move – very good for my career – and I hope it is that I can do a good job for customers."

At 66, the quietly-spoken horseman remains at the apex of his powers and his ability to nurse horses back into health and form remains a hallmark of his operation.

Waikuku, who had not saluted since the Stewards' Cup in January 2020, overcame a string of minor ailments to return to winning form.

"He had some interruptions earlier in the season, he had a temperature and he was out of work for quite a while," Size said.

"Back to 1400 metres was probably pretty suitable for him with our competition just at present and he likes a fast track, so he was able to run some time.

"So, he had a couple of advantages today that he doesn't normally get so he was able to win the race convincingly."

Moreira praised both Size and Waikuku.

"He's such a genuine horse, we know his finish is quite strong.

"We had a good start, we tracked the right horse. I was confident about my bloke and when I pulled him out in the straight, I knew he was going to be the strongest and he didn't let us down."

Regarding Size, one of his staunchest allies, Moreira said: "All the success he's had so far, he works so hard, he deserves it.

"Being associated with such a successful trainer, it's a privilege – I'm so proud of it.

"I hope this association can last as long as possible."

After notching his 1,300th Hong Kong win with Waikuku, Size moved to 1,301 wins as Tempest Express (Proisir) claimed the nightcap, the Class 3 Werther Handicap (1400m), a victory that edged to him outright top spot on the trainers' championship standings.

Healthy Happy lands Classic Cup to remain strongly in Derby contention

An inspired Alexis Badel capitalised fully on Frankie Lor's generosity to snare the Hong Kong Classic Cup (1800m) as Healthy Happy (Zoustar) underlined his Hong Kong Derby (Gr 1. 2000m) claims with a dramatic victory.

Uniting with the former Australian galloper for the first time after Vincent Ho picked up the ride on Tourbillon Diamond (Olympic Glory), Badel dictated tactics from the front to deliver Healthy Happy by a neck from Russian Emperor (Galileo) with Shadow Hero (Pierro) a further nose away in third.

The Frenchman's daring tactics, crowned by a pedestrian section between the 1200 metres and 800 metres in just 24.46s, delighted Lor.

"I think the horse had a chance but I wasn't sure he could win because it was the first time at 1800 metres," Lor said. "But I think the jockey is really smart, he didn't go that fast, so I can say I 'steal' the race."

Happy Healthy raced in Australia as Leviathan for Peter and Paul Snowden and, until yesterday, had not been tried beyond 1600 metres.

Badel detected from the pre-race preliminary he was on the perfect horse to be daring – assuming nobody else wanted to lead.

"It's not very easy but I had the horse for this tactic to lead and going into the gate, the horse was so relaxed. I was very happy if no-one wanted to lead, I was very happy to do so and this just happened like a dream," he said.

"The horse is very talented from the front. He's a very good horse, he's got great abilities. I am very grateful to get the ride on him.

"He's such a big horse, he's got a very big action and a very good attitude. I wanted to give him a comfortable race with a lot of space and hopefully keep the momentum.

"I was just happy to let my horse go because he's a very big horse and I knew he was going to stay on well. He was also very relaxed in front.

"It allowed him to take a very big breath before the effort and then he kept on well."

Both Lor and Badel expect the 2000 metres of the Hong Kong Derby on March 201 won't be an issue for the gelding.

Douglas Whyte was elated with the performance of Russian Emperor, a son of Galileo (Sadler's Wells) and champion Australian mare Atlantic Jewel (Fastnet Rock).

"I always said the Derby would be his day. The blinkers have certainly got his mind switched on," Whyte said.

"The winner had it all his way, the second

David Hayes was similarly encouraged by the effort of Shadow Hero, who produced his best Hong Kong performance since leaving Australia, where he won two Group 1s.

"Very happy with that," Hayes said.

Tony Millard could have a two-pronged attack in next month's Classic after Panfield's (Lookin' At Lucky) fitting victory in the Class 2 Ambitious Dragon Handicap (2000m) – a race named in honour of one of Millard's two Derby champions.

"He's a proper Derby horse and if they went a little harder here, he would have won by more. He's the real deal," Millard, who celebrated a Sha Tin treble, said.

"That was dominant and he had a clean run and it was the first time we've been able to see that. He's pretty good."

Tony Piccone's daring front-running tactics paid off aboard the Chris So-trained Pakistan Friend (Not A Single Doubt), clinging on for a narrow success in the Class 4 Super Kid Handicap (1800m) after opening up a lead of close to 15 lengths down the back straight.

Derek Leung continued his solid form of late with victory for Paul O'Sullivan aboard Vukan (Sacred Falls) in the Class 4 California Memory Handicap (1400m).

Karis Teetan notched a double thanks to victories atop Resolute (Per Incanto) in the Class 4 Gold-Fun Handicap (1200m, dirt) before Man Star (Shooting To Win) broke through in the Class 3 Good Ba Ba Handicap (1200m, dirt).

Cafe Pharoah claims dirt **Grade 1 win in February Stakes**



favourite Cafe Pharoah (American Pharoah) captured his first Grade 1 victory in this year's February Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Tokyo yesterday.

Absent of the fans and cheers, the first Grade 1 event of the season was sent on its way on the backstretch with Air Almas (Majestic Warrior), Helios (Orfevre) and Wide Pharaoh (Henny Hughes) fighting for the lead.

As Helios slipped back in the early stages, Cafe Pharoah (4 c ex Mary's Follies by More Than Ready), breaking from stall three under Christophe Lemaire, stalked the two front runners while saving ground before smoothly angling out right beside them to enter the lane in third.

From there on, the American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) colt unleashed a powerful drive, stealing the lead by the furlong marker and held off the fast-closing Air Spinel (King Kamehameha) by a three-quarter length margin.
