## Red letter day at Caulfield as Tagaloa downs favourite Hanseatic

Shock win in Blue Diamond Stakes provides Busuttin and Young with a first Australian Group 1

n on-pace track bias at Caulfield may have corrupted some outcomes, and certainly thwarted the aspirations of many, but history will nonetheless record the winners as they stand and note yesterday's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) meeting as something of a red-letter day for many others.

Arrowfield Stud was certainly among the beneficiaries as Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) became the second Blue Diamond winner bred by the Arrowfield-Northern Farm partnership, following Reaan (Hussonet) in 2008. It was the fourth Group 1 winner, and first in Australia, for Japanese sprinting sensation Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha).

Likewise it was momentous for winning trainers Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young as the precocious on-speed running juvenile provided

them with their first Australian Group 1 winner since relocating from New Zealand to Cranbourne in 2016. Tagaloa, indeed, was their first Australian two-year-old winner at Moonee Valley back last November.

The 25/1 chance was another longshot toplevel Caulfield winner for Michael Walker who'd endured a difficult spring carnival, under media and social media scrutiny, and then been sidelined through injury. *Continued on page 2>>*

Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1000m) and the gritty Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) winning the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

Pippie's win was jockey Linda Meech's second Group 1 victory - as she became the first female to win the race - and the first Group 1 win for fatherand-son training team John and Chris Meagher, while

Streets Of Avalon, a homebred for Warren Racing, critically secured his place in the \$5 million All-Star Mile (1600m) at Caulfield on March 14, for trainer Shane Nichols and jockey Ben Melham.

Those less inclined to rejoice in how the day unfolded certainly included trainer Anthony Freedman who had two Group 1 seconds - with Super Seth (Dundeel) and Hanseatic (Street Boss) - who were each beaten just a head.

In many ways, the day revolved around Tagaloa's Blue Diamond win. He may not be Japanese-bred like last year's Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winners Mer De Glace (Rulership) and Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry) but he is by a Japanese stallion from a Japanese mare and his win - along with the success of Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) - understandably prompted some Twitter joy from the Arrowfield team...and why not with the

offspring of their three Japanese stallions to come....and a couple of fillies, by Lord Kanaloa, at Easter.

Arrowfield, who sold two Lord Kanaloa colts for \$625,000 and \$650,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in January, offers two fillies by the stallion at the the 2020 Australian Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. Lots 1 and 468 - the former out of German 1,000 Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Kali (Areion) and the latter - maintaining the Japanese connection - from the Zenno Rob Roy (Sunday Silence) mare, Glare Channel. Bhima also offers an interesting Lord Kanaloa filly - Lot 74 from an unraced half-sister to dual Group 2 winner and Royal Ascot Group 1 runner-up Gold Fun (Le Vie Dei Colori).

Busuttin Racing bought Tagaloa for \$300,000 out of the Arrowfield Stud draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, while Farnan was a \$550,000 Magic Millions purchase from the Vinery Stud draft for Phoenix Thoroughbreds Ltd and Aquis Farms Pty Ltd.

"He's a Lord Kanaloa we bought off Arrowfield and to win a Group 1 in Australia, which has been eluding us for a while, is unbelievable," an emotional Busuttin said.  $Continued\ on\ page\ 4>>$

<< Continued from page 2 "I can't believe it, I'm a bit of an emotional wreck to be honest," he added, "to train a Group 1 winner in Australia, it's been eluding us for a little while but it's unbelievable and thank you to everybody who has supported us."

Busuttin detailed that Tagaloa will have his next start in the \$300,000 Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on March 7 ahead of the \$3.5m Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Rosehill on March 21 before musing that "he won't be around next season" if he happened to win the Slipper.

Nothing went to plan for the runner-up Hanseatic. His regular rider Luke Currie fell at Moonee Valley on Friday night and was ruled out because of injury. The Street Boss (Street Cry) colt was then delayed enroute to the course and had the racing pattern less than in his favour.

Meech made the most of that pattern aboard the free-running Pippie (4 f Written Tycoon - Coupe Express, by Ne Coupez Pas) who recorded the fastest-ever time in the time honoured Caulfield 1100 metres sprint - holding off the Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra- trained duo Zoutori (Zoustar) and Crystal Dreamer (Stratum).

Streets Of Avalon (5 g Magnus - Kamuniak, by Black Minnaloushe) - the fourth elite level winner for Sun Stud's Magnus (Flying Spur) - similarly made all in the Futurity, staving off a determined three-year-old Super Seth who just failed to add to the imposing record of his age group against the older horses this season.





"I thought Super Seth, with less weight than us, stalking him was going to be a problem, but god he's tough," Nichols said, "I just assumed Super Seth was going to get us but I knew he wouldn't wilt.

"Bring on The All-Star Mile. We might change the gear, pull the blinkers off or tamper with the gear a bit. Might as well have a crack for the big cash as he's smashed through the million-dollar barrier."

Super Seth is also scheduled to be All-Star Mile bound, although the allure of further Group 1 success may see him switch course to Sydney.

### Four for Lord Kanaloa

Japanese sprinting sensation Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha) sired his fourth individual elite level winner and first in Australia when Tagaloa (2 c Lord Kanaloa - Vasilissa by Heart's Cry) ran out a surprise winner of the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield yesterday. The first foal out of the winning Heart's Cry (Sunday Silence) mare Vasilissa, Busuttin Racing bought Tagaloa for \$300,000 out of the Arrowfield Stud draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Yesterday's win meant that Tagaloa was Arrowfield's 19th Group 1 winning sales graduate since 2013. Arrowfield, who sold two Lord Kanaloa colts for \$625,000 and \$650,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in January, offers two fillies by the stallion at the the 2020 Australian Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. Lots 1 and 468 Lord Kanaloa, who has now sired 15 individual stakes winners stands for a fee of ¥20,000,000 (\$270,000) at Shadai Stallion Station.

### **Eight for Written Tycoon**

Woodside Park resident Written Tycoon (Ingleisa) sired his eighth individual elite level winner when Pippie (4 f ex Coupe Express, by Ne Coupez Pas) made all the running from a wide draw and came close to setting a new track record when landing the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) at Caulfield yesterday. Eureka Stud's Scott McAlpine paid \$26,000 for the broodmare Coupe Express (Ne Coupez Pas) in foal to Written Tycoon at the Inglis August Mixed Sale in 2015, where she was carrying the unborn foal who yesterday blitzed her way to Group 1 glory. McAlpine raised Pippie before offering her in his Eureka draft at the

2017 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, where trainer John Meagher purchased her for \$60,000. She became the third consecutive Inglis graduate to win the Oakleigh Plate following the success of Booker (Written Tycoon) last year and Russian Revolution (Snitzel) in 2018. Written Tycoon, who has sired 32 individual stakes winners. Stands for a fee of \$110,000 inc GST.

### **Four for Magnus**

Sun Stud resident Magnus (Flying Spur) also sired his fourth individual winner at the highest level yesterday when Streets Of Avalon (5 g ex Kamuniak, by Black Minnaloushe) claimed a host of notable scalps when victorious in the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield. Now the winner of eight races from 43 starts, Streets Of Avalon took his career earnings to \$1,159,210 with this breakthrough top flight success. Streets Of Avalon, who has now won four times in stakes company, is one of 21 individual stakes winners for Magnus who last year stood for a fee of \$16,500 inc GST.

### 98 for Savebeel

Waikato Stud's star stallion Savabeel (Zabeel) closed in on a century of individual stakes winners yesterday when Adelaide Ace (3 g ex Ampin by Pins) took his tally to 98 with a comfortable victory in the Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) at Caulfield. Sent out the \$2.50 favourite, the gelding controlled the race from the front under jockey John Allen to beat Nonconformist (Rebel Raider) by a length and a quarter, with another three lengths back to the third-placed Legion Of Merit (Alamosa). The South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville on May 9 is now under consideration according to trainer Lindsey Smith. "The second horse was quite determined

to pick him up," Smith said. "He drifted out up the straight but the margin was too great. "It was a good win. The gap back to the third horse always looks a good sign. The race was run to suit him. He had them boxed up and it was only really a sprint home the last 600 metres." Adelaide Ace's year older brother Savy Yong Blonk has won three of his 13 starts in New Zealand and was most recently seen finishing second behind Platinum Invador in the City Of Auckland Cup (Gr 3, 2400m). Savabeel, the five-time champion sire of New Zealand, stands for a fee of \$125,000 plus GST.

### **Four for Burgundy**

Brandenburg 3 c (Burgundy - Wansesingyee, by Galileo) beat five Group 1 winners when he defied a wide run to triumph in yesterday's Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400) at Rosehill and in the process provided the late Burgundy (Redoute's Choice) with his fourth individual stakes winner. Sent off a \$41 chance, Brandenburg held off Reloaded (Snitzel) by a half-length with leader and \$2.25 favourite Microphone (Exceed And Excel) holding third in an on-pace dominated race. While the winner snuck under the guard of punters, trainer John Sargent was anything but shocked. "No, I have always rated him a very good colt," Sargent said. "We looked after him in the spring and just took him down for the Carbine Club (Stakes). He had to front up today against these serious horses and he did. It was very impressive. He's got a very good attitude and that's what makes the horse." Brandenburg has now won two of his eight starts and finishing placed on the other six occasions. Former Cambridge Stud stallion Burgundy had to be put down in December at the age of 11 after contracting acute laminitis in his front feet.

### 44 for Stratum

Greysful Glamour (4 m Stratum - Rippled by Dalakhani) made the perfect start to her campaign when making all in the MRC Mannerism Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Caulfield yesterday for Mark Newnham to become the 44th individual stakes winner for late Widden Stud sire Statum (Redoute's Choice). Ridden by Tim Clarke, the four-year-old got the better of Bam's On Fire (Universal Ruler) by a length, while Spanish Reef (Lope De Vega) returned third. "Mark had purposely probably got her a bit more forward this preparation and targeted this race," Clark said. "He was saying four out of the last five leaders have won this race, so he had a plan and it was executed well." Greysful Glamour's next targets include the Matron Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) and the Sunline Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m).

### Two for Time For War

Time For War (Snitzel) sired his second stakes winner from just 32 runners when He'll Haunt Us (3 g ex Shadow Grande by Dane Shadow) took out the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield yesterday. The Mick Kent jnr and Mick Price-trained three-year-old got up late on the inside of the leader Sansom (Charm Spirit) to score by a half-neck, with Spend (Snitzel) another head away third. He'll Haunt Us won the rich maiden race on Magic Millions race day at the Gold Coast on January 11 and jumped straight into stakes company yesterday to claim a second win from four career starts. Time For War, who sired last season's Silver Slipper Stakes winner Time To Reign, died at the age of five in 2016 from colic having served two seasons at stud.

### 130 for High Chaparral

The late High Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) sired his 130th individual stakes winner when Arctic Stream (5 g ex Royal Devotion by Verglas) landed the Detonator Stakes (Listed 1800m) at Perth yesterday. The five-year-old took his tally to six wins in 29 starts when beating The Big Show (Frost Giant) by half a length, with Harry Thomas (Scandal Keeper) the same distance away in third. High Chaparral, whose sons include So You Think and Dundeel, died in 2014 at the age of 15. having suffered a perforated intestine.

### Waterhouse eyeing more Slipper glory after Farnan's Silver success

Gai Waterhouse has her sights on a seventh Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) win following Farnan's (Not A Single Doubt) victory in yesterday's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill. The winner of the Wyong Magic Millions (RL, 1100m) in December, Farnan had fallen out of favour since being well beaten in the Gold Coast version last month but reaffirmed his credentials with a thumping three and a quarter length win over Global Quest (More Than Ready). Debutant North Pacific (Brazen Beau) grabbed third, another length and a quarter back. "It felt as good as it looked," said Hugh Bowman, who was riding the Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt for the first time. "He's going to improve on that. I think mentally, he's a very sensible horse but I don't think he's screwed right down and he's certainly in the right hands to progress to the Golden Slipper."

### Berry baffled by Cellsabeel flop

Jockey Tommy Berry was at a loss to explain the disappointing performance of favourite Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) after the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly finished just fifth of eight in the Silver Slipper. "She never took me into the race at all today, I was gone at the 600 and never felt like I was ever going to be a threat in the race," Berry said. "It was completely different to what I rode five weeks ago." Berry told the stewards Cellsabeel could have felt the five weeks between runs, or been affected by the addition of glue-on shoes. A subsequent veterinary examination showed she had pulled up lame.

### Miss Siska heading for the top

Miss Siska (So You Think) continued her path towards the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) with another fighting win at Caulfield as she added yesterday's Peter Young Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) to her record to remain unbeaten for the campaign. Miss Siska took over at the 150-metre mark under Damian Lane and held off a late challenge from Kings Will Dream

(Casamanento) to win by a head, with Mirage Dancer (Frankel) running on for third, another three quarters of a length away. Trainer Grahame Begg said the mare would now head to the Australian Cup at Flemington on March 7. "I think last preparation has set her up for this campaign," Begg said. "She had some tough racing three weeks in a row and she has carried that form through in this campaign. She's a dream to train and she goes out and gets the job done."

### Savatiano outfoxes Randwick rivals

Group 1 contests again await Savatiano (Street Cry) after she thwarted the attempt of White Moss (Mossman) to defend her title in the Millie Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Rosehill yesterday. Since finishing third in the corresponding race. Savatiano finished third in the Tatt's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) in her final start as a fouryear-old as well as winning the Tristarc Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and the inaugural \$1 million The Hunter (1300m) in the spring. Trained by James Cummings for Godolphin, Savatiano was the \$2 favourite with the Jason Coyle-trained White Moss the \$4.80 second-elect. That was how they finished with Savatiano beating her marker rival by two and three-quarter lengths with Invincible Gem (I Am Invincible) another two lengths away in third." She's come back in tremendous order," said winning rider James McDonald. "I gave her a click at about the 500 metres and it was the wrong thing to do because she just towed me up behind them. I thought she'd blow out after looking at her parade. She looked fat and I thought she'd need the run but she was just way too good. She is a genuine Group 1 horse for sure."

### Tough La Tene battles to Caulfield win

Cummings was among the winners at Caulfield not long after when he praised the toughness of La Tene (Helmet) after her first-up victory in the Armanasco Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). How far that toughness will carry La Tene through an autumn campaign remains to be seen, but the filly is now a dual stakes winner following her win over the fast closing Lady Lupino (Sebring) by a half head with Lunar Light (Akeed Mofeed) another length and a quarter away in third. "She didn't quite come up last preparation so we did the right thing and put her away and that patience has been rewarded," Cummings said. "She's versatile and one thing she has on her side is toughness."

### Mustajeer back with stylish win

Import Mustajeer
(Medicean) [pictured
left] showed his
hand early
with a superb
return to win
the Parramatta
Cup (Listed,
1900m) at
Rosehill yesterday
and in the process put

himself on a Group 1 autumn path. The former European was brought to Australia as a Cups horse last spring and while those dreams did not materialise, the gelding appears poised to make amends this preparation. Appreciating a solid tempo, Mustajeer shot to the front under Hugh Bowman and while Eastender (Tickets) whittled down the margin to a long neck, the Kris Lees-trained seven-year-old showed his class to hold on. Mustajeer's stablemate and last year's race winner Red Cardinal (Montjeu) was doing his best work late for third, albeit five lengths behind the first two. "We probably didn't expect him to do that but it's obviously no surprise, he has been bought for weightfor-age racing," Bowman said. "He certainly raced well in the spring in the Caulfield Cup. He didn't seem at his best in the Melbourne Cup, but he's certainly a more furnished horse now mentally."

### Aktau sets out on Cup path

Another imported stayer among the winners yesterday was Aktau (Teofilo) who landed a second win on Australian soil with a late finishing burst to take out the Keno Classic Handicap (2000m) at Caulfield. Ridden by Jye McNeil, Aktau scored by a long neck from pacesetter Inverloch (Fastnet Rock), with Future Score (Cape Cross) another length away in third. Winning trainer Mike Moroney said Aktau will now be aimed at the Mornington Cup (Listed, 2400m) on March 21 with the winner of that race gaining a ballot exemption into the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) in October. "He's still a work in progress and doing it upside down at times," Moroney said. "Once he learns what it's all about, the talent is certainly there. We'd like to run in the Mornington Cup all going well now, which will get him that ticket back here if we can. He's still got a lot of improvement in him and it will be good to see him up over his right trip once he learns to relax and go the Australian pace."

### Master Of Wine makes a winning return

Stayer Master Of Wine (Maxios) confirmed his star is on the rise with a winning return over 1400 metres at Rosehill yesterday. The Hawkes Racing-trained five-year-old posted a three and a half length victory over Aliferous (Hinchinbrook) and while he is on a long-range path towards the big Cup races in the spring, co-trainer Michael Hawkes has not ruled out targeting better races this campaign. "This horse's best attribute is he's got the biggest turn of foot and you just saw that," Hawkes said. "As the races get longer it's going to be pretty exciting. Last time we thought he was a Cups horse and he just fell short because of immaturity. He will definitely head towards that in the spring. We wanted to give him a light autumn but who knows where he might take us. The sky is the limit for this horse."

### Flying Boom Chicka Boom goes in again

Boom Chicka Boom (All Too Hard) again proved good barriers are the key to his chances as he made it five wins when starting from barrier one when he led all of the way to win the Mullins Lawyers Open (1000m) at Eagle Farm. Boom Chicka Boom is bred and raced by former top equestrian Peter McMahon and his wife Michelle. The gelding is a half-brother to Real Surreal (Real Saga) who won the 2013 Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) for the McMahons.

### Melbourne to host 2022 conference

Melbourne will stage the Asian Racing Conference for the first time in 2022 when the city plays host to the 39th edition of the event which brings together racing's world leaders for a week-long conference. Asian Racing Federation secretary general Andrew Harding made the announcement yesterday morning at the closing ceremony of this year's conference in Cape Town, South Africa. The 2022 conference will take place from February 15 through to 20.

### Currie suffers fracture and breaks ribs in Valley fall

Luke Currie faces a stint on the sidelines after suffering multiple injuries in a fall at Moonee Valley on Friday night. Currie, who had been due to ride favourite Hanseatic in yesterday's Blue Diamond Stakes, was taken to hospital with suspected concussion after falling shortly after the finishing line in the final race on the card when his mount Yulong June (More Than Ready) clipped heels. It was later revealed he had suffered a C7 fracture and broken ribs in the incident. Victorian Jockeys Association executive officer Matt Hyland said yesterday morning that Currie was "comfortable, but obviously disappointed".

### Oliver handed ten-meeting ban

Damien Oliver will miss the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) and Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) meeting after being suspended for careless riding at Caulfield. Oliver was suspended for his ride on the unplaced Harlem (Champs Elysees) in yesterday's Peter Young Stakes (1800m) after shifting in onto Regal Power (Pierro), also unplaced, near the 1600-metre mark. His suspension starts after riding at the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) meeting at Flemington next Saturday and he will be available for rides on March 10.

### Te Akau dominance continues with Haunui Farm quinella

Te Akau Racing dominated the feature at Otaki yesterday landing a one-two in the Haunui Farm WFA Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) with the mare Avantage (Fastnet Rock) leading home Prise De Fer (Savabeel) by three quarters of a length for Jamie Richards. The Chosen One (Savabeel) was best of the rest, two lengths back in third. The four-year-old was recording her third top level success after victories in last month's Telegraph (Gr 1, 1200m) and her victory at two in the Manawatu Sires Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). Stable representative Libby Richards praised the ride by Johnson and the effort by runner-up in his first attempt at this level. "She (Avantage) was just so brave and seeing her go the inside and Prise De Fer to the outside, I knew they were going to fight it out which was so exciting," she said. "Danielle rode her beautifully and they're an awesome group of owners who are here to celebrate the win with. Prise De Fer also showed he was up to Group One company which is very cool."

Jamie Richards also landed the Waikato Stud Slipper (Gr 3, 1200m) yesterday for Te Akau at Matamata with the promising juvenile Need I Say More, who became the 21st stakes winner for his sire No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) and his first Australasian stakes winner. Having just his

second start, the gelding remained unbeaten when getting the better of his stablemate and favourite Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel) by a decisive two and a half lengths, while the pacesetting Snapper (Power) had to settle for third. "He's definitely a nice horse and really starting to come to it now," Richards said. "He's needed a bit of time but he's by a very good stallion in No Nay Never out of a Fastnet Rock mare who had a lot of success. I don't think the favourite (Cool Aza Beel) will lose any admirers but full credit to the big chestnut horse." Richards reported that both runners could make their next starts in the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ellerslie on March 7. No Nay Never will stand at Coolmore in Ireland for a fee of €175,000 this season and stood for \$44,000 at Coolmore Australia last year.

### 202 for More Than Ready

Sent off as favourite, Vernazza (2 f More Than Ready - Zonza by Zabeel) landed the feature Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) yesterday at Matamata for Cambridge Stud's Brendan and Jo Lindsay and Lance Noble. She became the 202nd stakes and 91st Group winner for her sire More Than Ready (Southern Halo) and the first Cambridge Stud-bred Group winner under the new ownership. Asserting close home, she won by three quarters of a length from Kelly Renee (Sam Spratt), with Bonita Aurelia (Sweynesse) further back in third. The win was also special for trainer and former Matamata Racing Club committee man Noble, who now trains out of the Lindsay's purpose-built Karaka base. "That was something special as to be able to come back to Matamata and win this race just means so much," he said. "I was 30 years here, began training here and was on the committee for 14 years. "Michael (Coleman) and I started our apprenticeships together so it's very special." Regarding future plans he added, "We'll see how she comes through today but the plan was if she went well then we would target Ellerslie next (Gr 1 Sistema Stakes, 1200m)." More Than Ready stands at WinStar Farm in Kentucky where his fee for 2020 is US\$80,000.

### **Eight for Guillotine**

Five-year-old Joe's Legacy (5 g Guillotine - Mia

Bambino by Danasinga) gained a first stakes victory in the Kaimai Stakes (Listed, 2000m) at Matamata yesterday for Jason Price and became the eighth stakes winner for his sire Guillotine (Montjeu). He ran out a two length winner over Roger That (Shinko King) and there was a further two and a half lengths back to All In Vogue (Pins) in third. "Not a lot has gone right for this horse who is one we have always rated quite highly." Price said. "He's still getting there but to step up to the open handicap grade like he did today shows what we have got." Price also said that the win has now confirmed a tilt at the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Ellerslie on March 7.

### First for Dream Journey

Outsider Miraieno Tsubasa (Dream Journey) sprung a surprise in the Diamond Stakes (Gr 3, 3600m) at Tokyo yesterday as the seven-yearold took the honours for Daishi Ito at odds of 327/1. Having been placed twice in Group company, the grey was recording his fourth win and first stakes success to become the first Group winner for his sire Dream Journey (Stay Gold), who is also the sire of Listed scorer Weltreisende. Ridden by Takuya Kowata, he got up by a nose from Meisho Tengen (Deep Impact) and the pair were five lengths clear of Ocea Great (Orfevre) and the rest of the field. The favourite, Tagano Diamante (Orfevre) finished 12 and three quarter lengths adrift in seventh. Dream Journey, a three-time Group 1 winner and full-brother to Japanese Triple Crown winner Orfevre, stands for a private fee at Shadai Stallion Station.

### Kyoto Himba for Sound Chiara

Sound Chiara (Deep Impact) was sent off as favourite and followed up her success in the Sho Kyoto Kimpai (Gr 3, 1600m) last month with victory in the Kyoto Himba Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) yesterday for Akio Adachi. Ridden by Kohei Matsuyama, the five-year-old flashed home late to win by a length and a quarter from Pourville (Le Havre) with the same distance back to Meisho Glocke (Meisho Samson) in third.

### INTERNATIONAL

### A.P. Indy dies at 31

Legendary stallion A.P. Indy (Seattle Slew) has died aged 31 at his home at Lane's End Farm in Kentucky. Often referred to as a breed shaper, A.P. Indy was the United States Horse of the Year in 1992 and went on to sire some of the best horses in North America. The son of triple crown winner Seattle Slew (Bold Reasoning) was retired from stud duties in 2011, and lived a comfortable life at the farm where he was born in Versailles, Kentucky. "A.P. Indy passed away peacefully in his stall at the Lane's End stallion complex, the barn he called home for 27 years," a statement from Lane's End said. "A.P. Indy's list of accomplishments range far and wide as his legacy continues to be carried through the outstanding performances of his sons and daughters across the globe. He was the most important and popular member of the Lane's End team and we are deeply sorry to all who loved him as much as we did." A.P. Indy was the highest-priced yearling of his year at US\$2.9 million and won the 1992 Belmont Stakes (Gr 1, 12f) and Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f) after missing the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) through injury. He went on to be North America's leading sire in 2003 and 2006 with champions Mineshaft and Bernardini among his progeny. His son Pulpit has in turn produced champion California Chrome and leading sire Tapit.

### Casamento dies aged 12

Kings Will Dream's sire Casamento (Shamardal) has been put down aged 12 at Sunnyhill Stud in Ireland due to a degenerating foot condition. The Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) scorer has proved the best of ten stakes horses produced so far by the 2010 winner of the former Racing Post Trophy (Gr 1,1600m), and he very nearly provided a fitting tribute with his second-placed finish in the Peter Young Stakes at Caulfield yesterday. Casamento stood his first five seasons between Darley's Dalham Hall and Kildangan Studs, spending 2018 at Ljungstorps Stud in Sweden before joining Sunnyhill Stud in 2019 as a dual purpose sire. He was out of the Group 3-placed Wedding Gift (Always Fair) and was a half-brother to the dam of dual Group 1 winner and Haras de Bouquetot sire Toronado (High Chaparral).

### 58 for Dark Angel

Progressive four-year-old Hareem Queen (4 f Dark Angel - Dulcain by Shamardal) was sent off as favourite on her stakes debut and duly obliged landing the Hever Sprint Stakes (Listed, 5f) at Lingfield for Karl Burke and John Dance. Running on strongly in the closing stages she got the better of Royal Birth (Exceed And Excel) by a neck and there was a length back to Watchable (Pivotal) in third. Her victory made her the 58th stakes winner for her sire Dark Angel (Acclamation) who is standing for a fee of €85,000 at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland this year. She was a 75,000gns yearling from Corduff Stud to Creighton / Schwartz Bloodstock at Tattersalls Book 1 and is a three-part sister to Group 3-placed sprinter Chessman (Acclamation).

### Dubai Warrior lands Winter Derby for Gosden

John Gosden and Frankie Dettori teamed up to land the Winter Derby (Gr 3, 1m2f) at Lingfield yesterday with Dubai Warrior (Dansili). Last seen taking the Quebec Stakes (Listed,1m2f) over course and distance in December, the four-year-old made all and drew clear in the straight to win by two and three quarter lengths from stablemate Court House (Dawn Approach) and hot favourite Bangkok (Australia) who were split by half a length respectively for second and third.
