Border trainers incensed by impact of Racing NSW coronavirus directive

*Horses stranded in Victoria and staff prevented from working
due to V'landys' pandemic measures*

Southern NSW trainers directly affected by the decision of sport's governing body to ban the movement of racehorses between states and stop Victorian-based staff from working are frustrated by the hypocritical nature of the directive.

Albury's Mitchell Beer has been outspoken

over the ramifications of the Racing NSW move implemented on July 8 as the dramatic spike in coronavirus cases in Victoria took hold, but his Riverina training peer Donna Scott has also had her stable thrown into disarray in recent weeks.

Scott's Hazel Park Racing, which is based at Albury, has a spelling property at Shepparton in Victoria and has horses either stranded there or in pre-training and unable to cross the border. *Continued on page 2>>*

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Vain under consideration for Hydro Star

Hydro Star (Headwater) justified John McArdle's belief that he is the best juvenile in his care with an eye-catching debut win which prompted the trainer to immediately turn his thoughts to Group race targets. "He's still a big baby, he still didn't do everything right but when Jamie (Mott, jockey) asked him, that's exactly what he's done at home," McArdle told Racing.com following the impressive success. "A lot of the credit has to go to Jamie. The first time he actually ever galloped him he hopped off and said, 'wow, what's this?' Hydro Star's performance earned him quotes for the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in the spring, but before then McArdle has an eye on the Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield on August 15 "He's going to be better over more ground and he's going to be better on top of the ground," McArdle continued. "He's from a good female family, he's by a good up-and-coming stallion, he's still six months away but we'll take him home and see what we do from here."

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But an even greater obstacle for Scott is the fact that stable staff who reside in Victoria are unable to fulfil their duties because of the ruling by Racing NSW's Peter V'landys.

"We had one horse trial the other day and we're going to have to undertake a six-hour trip to the south coast by the looks of it to find a race because there's nothing else around," Scott told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"The dilemma of going away like that is that my two main staff members I've lost because they live on the other side of the border. I've

got 20-odd horses here and I'm down to one girl working on the ground and one girl riding.

"For me to do these big trips, I'm left with no staff at home and no staff to go away with it. It's quite a pickle at the moment."

Scott added: "If they worked at McDonald's or somewhere like that they could cross the border, that's no worries, but because it's racing they can't.

"I've had plenty of arguments with owners who have said, 'you can get a permit'

but I've had to tell them that 'no, it's not the government, it's Racing NSW putting these rules in place."

The border ban has been complicated by the fact that it has made it difficult for trainers to access farriers and veterinarians who are based on the other side of the Murray River, while Scott believes that if racing and training can continue in Sydney at coronavirus hotspots like Warwick Farm, then local service providers should be able to cross the border.

The lack of consultation from Racing NSW decision makers is also of growing frustration for Scott.

"My staff have been isolated since day dot really, but now because of the border being shut they just refuse to allow them to work and Racing NSW won't have a conversation about it," she said.

"There were Warwick Farm trainers who came to Narrandera the other day, but we can't have our staff cross the border to come to work.

"I said to someone, 'if Chris Waller trained out of Albury would they be looking at it differently?'"

Before the horse travel ban came into effect earlier this month, Scott was able to avoid having her last-start All Victorian Sprint Series Final (Listed, 1200m) winner Lord Von Costa (Von Costa De Hero) stuck in a Victorian spelling paddock but the same cannot be said for many of her young stock.

"In the short-term, I've got two in pre-training who are due back now," she said.

"There's only so much they can do in pre-training and then I've got four horses who need to go to breakers in NSW. I've also got about six two-year-olds who are desperate to come back into work as well, so it

just makes it quite difficult and it is putting a lot of pressure on owners."

Beer also revealed yesterday that he has 22 horses in Victoria and was unsure when he would be able to get them back to Albury, and fears that some could be lost to rival trainers during the lockdown.

Scott understands that the horse movement issue will feature prominently at a

scheduled Racing NSW meeting on Monday while new NSW Trainers Association chief executive Richard Callander was hopeful of a resolution being reached in the next fortnight.

"They've (Racing NSW) got a lot of hoops to jump through and we're hopeful of a positive outcome whether it be next week or the week after," Callander told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"Things are progressing but it's a matter of Racing NSW trying to be ahead of the curve and working out where things are going (with coronavirus)."

The well-known racing media figure-turned-Trainers Association chief said he had put forward solutions to help enable horse movement between Victoria and NSW.

"We've proposed to Racing NSW that the horses would be picked up by a commercial transport operator in Victoria, they'd then cross the border, the horses would be left in a paddock and (NSW participants) take over from there," he said.

"They are looking at every option that we put to them and hopefully we will have some positive news on that next week."

12 for Headwater

Vinery resident Headwater (Exceed And Excel) landed his 12th first-crop winner when Hydro Star (2 c ex Final Star by Delago Brom) took out the Ladbrokes Back Yourself 2YO Handicap (1000m) at Sandown yesterday. Coming from back in the field, the John McArdle-trained colt showcased an electric turn of foot, scooting past his rivals to win by two lengths. Diamondesque (Snitzel) was second with Miss Bosetti (Snitzel) a further neck away in third. Hydro Star was purchased by Lauriston Thoroughbreds for \$15,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale and is one of four winners from five to race out of the placed mare Final Star (Delago Brom). Further back this is the family of Group scorers Red Colossus (Testa Rossa), Nediym's Glow (General Nediym) and Kinglike (Exceed And Excel). Headwater, who is also responsible for Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Wisdom Of Water, stands at Vinery for a fee of \$13,750 (inc. GST) in 2020.

Two for Criterion

Former Newgate resident Criterion (Sebring) sired his second first-crop winner yesterday as the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Yardstick (2 c ex Exceleine by Exceed and Excel) took out the Sky Racing Active Maiden 2YO Plate (1100m) on debut at Canterbury. The colt made all the running and kicked clear of his rivals to score by a length and a quarter ahead of Magic Ruler (Snitzel) in second, with Rule Of Law (Snitzel) a further three-quarters of a length away in third. Bred by SF Bloodstock and partners, Yardstick was purchased by Dynamic Syndications and Dean Watt Bloodstock for \$160,000 at the Magic Millions

Gold Coast Yearling Sale and is the first winner for metropolitan scorer Exceleine (Exceed And Excel). Further down the page is pensioned stallion Domesday (Red Ransom). Criterion spent three seasons at stud but was retired at the end of 2018 due to fertility issues.

New season features possible for Yardstick

The manner of Yardstick's (Criterion) debut win impressed not only onlookers but also the man on board with winning jockey Nash Rawiller describing him as "a ripping colt" in a post-race interview. "Every time he has stepped out he's improved a little bit and today was a good stepping stone for him," Rawiller told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "There was a bit of form in the race and probably some race-fit horses but his ability carried him through. He's had a good blow and he should improve a lot from the run. He can hopefully build into the early part of the spring, have a crack at something at Listed or Group level, and come back a nice horse next preparation." Yardstick's performance was enough to earn him quotes of \$26 for September's Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

Two for Panzer Division

Peppertree Farm stallion Panzer Division (Redoute's Choice) sired his second first-crop winner when Panzdown (2 g ex Moonrush by Encosta De Lago) took out a 1000-metre maiden at Belmont yesterday. The Simon Miller-trained gelding won by a comfortable margin of two and three-quarter lengths ahead of Janaura (Safeguard) with Reguardless (Safeguard) a further two lengths back in third. Purchased by his trainer for \$60,000 at the Inglis Classic Sale, Panzdown is one of three winners out of Moonrush (Encosta De Lago),

who herself is a sister to Listed scorer Purely Atomic. Panzdown's third dam is French Group 1 winner Imperial Beauty (Imperial Ballet). Panzer Division, who started his stud career at Arrowfield, stood at Peppertree Farm in NSW for a fee of \$5,500 (inc GST) in 2019.

Jungle Edge seeks another stakes win

Rising ten-year-old Jungle Edge (Dubawi) is nearer the end of his career than the beginning, but trainer Mick Bell believes the seven-time stakes winner still has more ahead of him as he prepares to step out in Saturday's Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). Jungle Edge won the Sir John Monash Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) last start and he is aiming to win the Bletchingly having placed in the race the last two years. "He's been going to the track, but he hasn't been doing a lot and that's been the secret to his longevity," Bell said. "I don't go out to make him run time as he could any time he wants to, but the main thing is to keep him feeling as well as he can. He likes the pool at Cranbourne. He splashes in the water for about five minutes before he'll actually go for a swim. He's a real character and that's why if he gets the chance to go to Living Legends they'll enjoy him as he loves attention and would like that kind of lifestyle."

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Special Missile to benefit from Qld trip

With the end of the season looming, trainers Richard and Michael Freedman are hoping that Special Missile (Smart Missile) can score a first win for the term when he lines up in the Winter Challenge (Listed, 1500m) at Rosehill on Saturday. Special Missile finished second in the Glasshouse Handicap (Listed, 1400m) at the Sunshine Coast last time out and Richard Freedman believes that he has taken benefit from the run. "I think the trip away did him good," he said. "I think he's going about as well as he can for a horse that's had a lot of racing, and he takes a bit of racing to get fit. I think we've finally got him fit now so I think he'll run a good race on Saturday. He had a little wind operation about five months ago so it's just taken him a little while to get back to peak form from that."

Saturday test for Travest

Travest (Tavistock) will step up in trip when he has his third start of this preparation in Saturday's TAB Handicap (1400m) at Rosehill. Trainer Greg Hickman is pleased with the three-year-old, who made up good ground when finishing third at Randwick last start after getting too far back over 1300 metres on a testing track. "It won't be an easy race on Saturday, there is plenty in there that have won a race and done a bit so we will still want to be on our merit," Hickman said. "He did get a little bit far back (last start) but since that run he has done very well and I will be happy to present him on Saturday. I have kept him on the fresh side and haven't over worked him."

Patis gets Kisukano opportunity

Apprentice Alex Patis will be legged aboard top juvenile Kisukano (Bel Esprit) on Saturday in what shapes as the most important mount in her short career. The Michael Nolan-trained Kisukano, widely considered Queensland's second-best juvenile behind Group 1 winner Rothfire (Rothsay), has been allotted 63.5 kilograms for Saturday's QTIS 2YO Fillies Handicap (1200m) at Doomben, with Patis' three-kilogram claim proving beneficial in this spot. "It is a good chance to further my career

and I am looking forward to the challenge," Patis said. Kisukano is likely to head to Sydney after this weekend's race.

Pagan lands first winner

Former Australian Rules player and coach Denis Pagan landed his first winner as a trainer when Frankie Two Angels (Medaglia d'Oro) took out the Ladbrokes Same Game Multi Handicap (1300m) at Sandown yesterday. "It's exciting, I was really pleased with the way Lachie (King, jockey) rode it and couldn't have been more pleased with the result," Pagan told Racing.com. On how he's finding training, the 72-year-old said: "It's good, exciting stuff. It keeps you young."

Spring on agenda for Blandford Lad

Peter Gelagotis is eyeing some spring targets for Blandford Lad (Savabeel) after the four-year-old made it back-to-back wins with a success at Sandown yesterday. "He's starting to live up to the big ticket I put on him early doors," Gelagotis said. "He had shown me some serious upside as a youngster, albeit when he was a colt. He came back as a gelding and he really settled down. Today he really showed his true colours and is starting to live up to the horse that I believe he is. We will let the dust settle and we will lap up the win. We are back on track and even if we give him a little freshen-up he might be a spring contender."

Timely win for Redoute's filly

Redoute's Choice (Danahill) filly Redoute's Image got off the mark at Canterbury yesterday to provide a timely pedigree update for her Magic Millions-bound half-brother. A \$320,000 Magic Millions purchase from the Element Hill draft, Redoute's Image now has a win and three placings from her five starts. She is the second winner from the Encosta de Lago (Fairy King) mare Tracy's Image, a half-sister to Australian Horse of the Year Typhoon Tracy (Red Ransom), as well as dual stakes winner Red Element and the dual Group 1-placed Kylikwong. Element Hill have the yearling from Tracy's Image, a colt by Sebring (More Than Ready), catalogued as **Lot 1362** at next month's Magic Millions National Yearling Sale.

Centrefire lives up to Munce's expectations

Trainer Chris Munce has long held a high opinion of Centrefire (Shooting To Win) and he was relieved after the filly added to her tally at Eagle Farm yesterday. Leading from the outset, Centrefire defeated Stylish Saga (Real Saga) by three-quarters of a length with Miraclesfromheaven (Easy Rocking) a further half-length away in third. "She is a brilliant track worker and maybe she has got me in (trouble) because of it," Munce said. "I really think she is a Saturday class horse. I have been telling everyone how good she is but it has been getting embarrassing. At least today's win saves me another red face. She might be ready to live up to her track work now."

Nicconi's Celestine impresses

James Harron Bloodstock's fillies partnership produced their fourth two-year-old debut winner from five purchases when Celestine (Nicconi) won at Murray Bridge yesterday. The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Celestine was sent out as the even-money favourite in the 900-metre maiden before winning by a length over Chosen Blonde (Choisir). Purchased for \$145,000 at last year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale out of Newhaven Park's draft, Celestine is out of the unraced mare Gleams (Northern Meteor); Gleams has a Dream Ahead (Diktat) yearling filly and a Nicconi (Bianconi) weanling colt, while she is currently in foal to Fiorente. Nicconi will stand for \$27,500 (inc GST) at Widden Stud this year.

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Rielly set for spring assault

Young Caulfield trainer Gemma Rielly is hopeful she can make her mark in the spring carnival with talented filly Tarcoola Diva (Cluster). The two-year-old has only had three career starts but after a winter break and some time to mature, Rielly thinks she is a stakes class filly. "Everything you saw in her first preparation was just raw ability and her toughness, she hadn't even had a proper hit-out at home before she made her debut," Rielly told Racing.com. "She had a nice spell and now she looks like a six-year-old mare, she's got attitude this preparation and she's starting to show us signs at home that she could be in for a big preparation. We have a maiden picked out for her at Wangaratta on August 22, which is actually her birthday. From there we'll map a path to the Thousand Guineas Prelude, and we'll see from that whether she can see out the 1600 metres for the Thousand Guineas."

Nothdurft fractures jaw in trackwork fall

Baylee Nothdurft, who tops the Queensland state title on 108-1/2 winners and metropolitan premiership on 77-1/2 victories, fractured his jaw after he was thrown from a horse while riding trackwork yesterday. Nothdurft, who is assured of becoming the first apprentice to complete the premiership double since Zac Purton in 2003, sustained the injury when the horse stood on his face. After being treated at the track Nothdurft was taken to hospital for further examination. Queensland Jockeys Association president Glen Prentice said he had spoken with Nothdurft who was in good spirits. "He is in the Royal Brisbane hospital and it has been confirmed he has a broken jaw," he said. Nothdurft's master, Brisbane trainer Tony

Gollan, thought the 21-year-old who "played a major role in our success this season" would need an operation to mend the break. "He will miss some weeks and the start to the new season," Gollan said.

Jack Cavanough injured in Scone fall

Trackwork rider Jack Cavanough was airlifted to John Hunter Hospital in Newcastle after a fall at Scone yesterday morning. Cavanough, the son of trainer Brett, was set to undergo scans last night with Racing NSW's Dr David Duckworth reporting that he had possible head and neck injuries. Cavanough's sister Georgie posted on social media that Jack had full movement in his arms and legs. In a later update, Duckworth said that a CT scan of his head showed a small bleed on the brain but that it is unlikely to need surgery.

Media barred from Alligator Blood inquiry

Today's inquiry into a positive Altrenogest swab returned by Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) when he won the Magic Millions 3YO Guineas (RL, 1400m) in January will be held behind closed doors. Trainer David Vandyke will face Racing Queensland stewards, but media requests to attend the hearing were declined, with managing owner Allan Endresz and his legal team also having no right to attend. Vandyke, who has been charged with presenting a horse to race with a prohibited substance in its system faces a fine, while Alligator Blood could face disqualification and Endresz be forced to forfeit the winners' cheque of \$1.2 million.

Victoria participants to wear face masks

Racing Victoria yesterday announced an update to biosecurity protocols which will make it compulsory for jockeys to wear a face mask at all times on raceday from today, excluding during a race. Similar protocols have been announced for trackwork and jump-outs, with all riders taking part at licensed premises in Stage 3 restricted areas required to wear a face mask while on the ground. Additionally, all attendees at race meetings staged in Victoria

are also now required to wear masks from today. RV will continue to provide single-use face masks to participants and officials upon arrival at each race meeting, other than to those who choose to use their own face coverings.

NEW ZEALAND

Prosperous impresses at first start

Trainer Stephen Autridge saddled two runners at Avondale yesterday, with three-year-old Prosperous (Savabeel) making a good impression when winning by five lengths on debut, while well-bred colt Kurt (Kingman) was narrowly beaten into second. The Kevin Hickman-owned duo both pleased Autridge, with Prosperous - a sister to 11-time victor Gustavo - one of the few runners to make up significant ground on the day. "She worked really well on Saturday morning on a wet track so we thought given she handles it she was a chance," Autridge said. "She is certainly going to improve with it but it was a very pleasant surprise how easily she won. She is from a pretty handy family. There are no world-beaters there but they win races. My job is to try and get some black-type with her."

American-owned Bourbon wins on debut

Eye-catching gelding All Black Bourbon (Highly Recommended) lived up to his looks when he won on debut at Avondale yesterday. Ridden by Danielle Johnson, the Stephen Marsh-trained All Black Bourbon rallied to defeat Kurt (Kingman) by a head. The two-year-old, purchased for \$110,000 at the 2019 Karaka Select Sale by Bourbon Lane Stable LLC, is one of six New Zealand-based horses for the collective, headed by American investor Dennis Foster and including bloodstock agents Mike McMahon and Jamie Hill. "He's a horse with a bright future," Marsh said. "He is a lovely horse. I know he is nearly three, but taking on those older horses first-up, I thought it was a gutsy effort. He got knocked over coming out of the gates and Danielle said he got really tightened, but he picked himself up. He did a lot wrong, but I thought he was really good through the line."

Yeomanstown Stud resident Gutaifan (Dark Angel) sired his second stakes when Fev Rover (2 f ex Laurelita by High Chaparral) took out the Star Stakes (Listed, 7f) at Sandown on Tuesday evening. The Richard Fahey-trained filly, who finished second in the Duchess of Cambridge Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) at Newmarket on her previous start, defeated Dubai Fountain (Teofilo) by a length with Setarhe

(Footsteps in the sand) finishing another head away in third. Purchased for £20,000 at the Goffs UK Premier Yearling Sale, Fev Rover is the best performed of three foals out of Laurelita (High Chaparral). Further down the page are Grade 1 winners Light Jig (Danehill) and Seek Again (Speightstown), while this is also the family of Dunedin Guineas (Listed, 1400m) scorer Another Coup (Darci Brahma). Gutaifan, who finished second to Arrowfield shuttler Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) in the Prix Morny (Gr 1, 1200m), stood at Yeomanstown Stud for a fee of €6,000 in 2020.

Irish 2,000 Guineas winner Magician to stand in Italy

Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and Breeders' Cup Turf (Gr 1, 12f) hero Magician (Galileo) is on the move again, with French publication Jour de Galop reporting the son of Galileo (Sadler's Wells) is to stand the 2021 breeding season in Italy. The ten-year-old began his stallion career at Coolmore's US base at Ashford

Stud in Kentucky in 2015. He spent almost four full seasons at Ashford, but transferred to Coolmore's Castlehyde Stud in Ireland for the latter part of the 2018 season. The following year he switched to Haras de Corlay in France, where he spent two seasons. He stood for €3,800 (approx \$AUD6,150) in 2020.

Stradivarius heads Goodwood Cup entries

Europe's star stayer Stradivarius (Sea The Stars) looks set to face a tough task in his bid to become the first ever four-time winner of next week's Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m). The John Gosden-trained six-year-old is among seven entries made for the feature race on Tuesday, the opening day of the Glorious Goodwood meeting, where his rivals could include Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) hero Santiago (Authorized), John Smith's Silver Cup (Gr 3, 1m 6f) winner Eagles By Day (Sea The Stars) and the hardy stayers Nayef Road (Galileo) and Spanish Mission (Noble Mission).
