Rosemont's Exclusive Online auction next test for bloodstock market

*Industry figures optimistic relative stability can continue
through breeding stock sales*

Next week's unreserved Rosemont Exclusive Online Sale, comprising a 93-lot draft of weanlings and commercial broodmare prospects being offered on the Magic Millions platform, could provide further proof of the rapid evolution of the Australian market and its willingness to embrace technology.

On-property inspections continued at Victoria's picturesque Rosemont Stud yesterday ahead of the opening of bidding on Monday, the second online auction to be held by Magic Millions after a successful introduction to the digital format with Cornerstone Stud earlier this month.

Melbourne-based Damon Gabbedy of Belmont Bloodstock is one agent who has taken the chance to inspect the Rosemont draft of horses in their home environment.

"They are very organised down there.

The weanlings come out and, bang, there's 40 of them and they are pretty efficient (in parading them)," Gabbedy said yesterday.

"It's actually quite pleasant going down to a stud like Rosemont. It's convenient for me rather than having to fly to Sydney or the Gold Coast."

Gabbedy believes the industry has been displaying remarkable confidence and appetite to reinvest in stock despite the wider economic impact of the coronavirus pandemic, and he expected that sentiment to remain in the coming months at the various live and online breeding stock auctions.

"Obviously it's a cautious time and people are a bit guarded, but the recent broodmare sales ... have gone really well and held up well, so I think that's given everyone a bit of confidence," he said.

"We were all a little nervous about what the values were and how they were going to be affected but I don't think they've been affected too dramatically. Initially, when all this was happening, people were thinking that the mare prices were going to drop by 50 per cent, but you can still sell quality.

"Maybe it's got a bit tougher in the bottom end, but I think we know

what the market is now and we're going all right."

Gabbedy is also impressed by the quality of the stock he has seen at Rosemont, with a Written Tycoon (Iglesia) weanling filly (Lot 37) capturing his attention.

"They've got a pretty good line-up. There's a beautiful Written Tycoon filly out of a stakes-winning mare. She really caught my eye, but they've put a good even draft in across the board," he said.

"There's a good one like her as well as a Zoustar, an Exceed And Excel and then there's different levels down, so I would say there's

something for everybody."

Among those inspecting the Rosemont draft recently include Ciaran Maher, agent Andrew Williams and a number of other interstate industry participants.

"It's been brilliant really and we've had more numbers than we forecast that we would, particularly given the times we are in," said Rosemont Stud general manager of bloodstock Ryan McEvoy who joined the Victorian operation earlier this year after a long stint at Widden Stud.

"We've been responsible as possible and had plenty of people come out to the farm. We've stagnated the parades so we don't have a huge group at any given time. It's been all hands on deck in the past week and a half with parades.

"The enquiries we've had via the phone and on email, they have been double and triple the amount of foot traffic we've had on the farm. It's been overwhelming."

McEvoy's appointment at Rosemont also coincided with the federal and state governments' decision to clamp down on people movement and order the closure of a number of business sectors.

But the pandemic and resulting chaos helped Rosemont commit to embarking on an on-farm online sale through the recently launched Magic Millions platform.

"Covid has given us a chance to pause and reflect on the numbers that we do have here at Rosemont and, I suppose like any business, it has been a chance to review where we might be a bit top-heavy in," McEvoy continued.

"There were a number of factors in addition to that, like the risk involved in transporting up to 40 to 50 weanlings to a sale; the risk of transporting pregnant mares is certainly there as well.

"The wheels were in motion for this exclusive sale pre-Covid back in January, but the actual format of the sale had only really been agreed upon and solidified in the last three to four weeks."

McEvoy predicted that the number of mares traded online would only continue to grow.

"Fundamentally, I can see the online platform serving a far greater purpose, particularly with broodmares. I certainly appreciate that there's a real touch a feel approach to the yearling and weanling market," he said.

"Given the advancement in technology and the filming and videography and the level of information that studs can provide, I think the buyers can get a pretty good handle on a mare via an online platform.

"It's going to be a big part of our future in selling bloodstock here in Australia."

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch was optimistic about a strong online buying bench being active on Monday and Tuesday.

"Feedback on the number of inspections so far has been really pleasing and, more importantly, with what they are seeing," Bowditch said.

"People are going down there and finding horses that they like. From there, we're hoping that the engagement in the sale is fulfilled because the quality of stock has appeal all over Australia, New Zealand and Asia for those wanting to buy trade colts, to buy mares in foal to consistent-performing and leading sires and take them home (and foal them down).

"There's opportunities to be made to make a lot of money out of this catalogue."

The adoption of the online market was also reinforced yesterday after the release of the 613-lot Inglis Digital Online Sale, the largest catalogue of horses offered by the company.

Magic Millions is also expanding its online reach and is currently taking entries for its first open online auction, to be held from June 2 to 4.

"We're excited to be able to, in early June, hold our first public auction. The platform's working really well thus far with the Cornerstone sale and the timing's there now to open it up and engage with our clients and give them the opportunity to sell on our platform," Bowditch said.

"So far, entries have been really solid for the sale."

Ten for Spill The Beans

Spill The Beans (Snitzel) now sits three clear on top of the leading first season sires table by winners, after Atkinson (2 g ex Hayite by Written Tycoon) provided the late Aquis Farm stallion with his tenth winner at Coffs Harbour yesterday. The Nathaniel Scott-trained gelding took out an 803-metre open age maiden by a length with Zanshin (Dawn Approach) finishing second and Qukes (Swiss Ace) coming home a further length and a quarter away in third. Atkinson was purchased by owner Matt Momin at the 2019 Inglis Online May sale for a bargain price of \$2,500. Out of the three-time winning Written Tycoon (Iglesia) mare Hayite, Atkinson's third dam is five-time stakes scorer Reno Belle (Balmerino). Spill The Beans spent four seasons standing at Aquis Farm's Queensland base, covering 605 mares at a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST) before dying suddenly in October last year.

Armidale announce 2020 fees

After the relocation of flagship stallion Needs Further (Encosta De Lago) to the mainland, Tasmania's Armidale Stud have released the 2020 fees for their other two residents. Alpine Eagle (High Chaparral) whose first yearlings went through the ring earlier this year, will stand for \$5,500 (plus GST) while Tough Speed (Miswaki) will stand for \$2,500 (plus GST). Both stallions have had a fee reduction of 20 per cent. "In light of the current global situation resulting from the Covid-19 pandemic and ensuing financial downturn, we have taken the decision to reduce our Tasmanian fees by an average of 20 per cent in a bid to assist breeders through these unprecedented events," Armidale's managing director David Whishaw said.

Niccanova on Stradbroke path

The Steve Tregear-trained Niccanova (Nicconi) will take the next step towards the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 6 when he contests the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm today. "He was very consistent in the summer but he is going to pay for it at the weights on the lower-class races. Niccanova is in the Stradbroke with 53 kilograms in a year when not all of the big names are coming from the south. He will be first-up on Saturday in the Victory Stakes and while it might be too short he will beat more than beat him. Niccanova has an even better second-up record and the 1400 metres of the Stradbroke is ideal. His wet-track form is very good but of course Eagle Farm is such a good wet track these days it is perhaps wishful thinking."

Ex-journo making most of breeding caper

Former sports editor Brian Burke's love of bloodlines could pay dividends at Eagle Farm today, as his homebred Soxagon (Rocker) takes

on the Victory Stakes in a bid to earn a spot in the Stradbroke Handicap. "Everything would have to fall into place to even get a Stradbroke start let alone win. So we are dreaming," Burke said. "But he finished second to Vega One in The Gateway and he is Stradbroke second favourite. So you never know." After retiring in 2019, Burke bought a mare named Strike On Goal (Van Nistelrooy) for \$600. Her first two foals went through the sales ring but Burke decided to keep the mare's third foal by Rocker (Fastnet Rock) who won several races for former Racing Queensland chairman Kevin Dixon. "I like Rocker's pedigree, being by Fastnet Rock from an Encosta De Lago mare and I thought it would go well with Strike On Goal's bloodlines," Burke said.

Talented Supergiant on the improve

Trainer Michael Costa is genuinely excited about his promising three-year-old Supergiant (Red Giant) stepping up to middle-distance racing. Supergiant will be having only his fifth race start in today's Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1800m) at Eagle Farm. Supergiant's ability was the worst-kept secret at the Gold Coast before it became public knowledge when he beat stakes horse The Candy Man (Casino Prince) in an exhibition gallop in March. Since then Supergiant has won at Ipswich in impressive fashion before running second in the Doomben Guineas (Listed, 1600m) two weeks ago. "He had a good blow after the race. It did him the world of good and he should be getting to his peak now," Costa said. "Supergiant was going to be our Queensland Derby horse but with that race scrapped we have switched to the Gunsynd and then the Rough Habit Plate after that."

Kinane on the up: Waller

The Chris Waller-trained Kinane (Reliable Man) will carry the weight of expectation when he contests the Gunsynd Classic at Eagle Farm today, but the talented three-year-old will have to overcome the outside barrier in the field of 16. The gelding has been one of the talk horses of the autumn, exacerbated by a multi-million dollar offer from Hong Kong following his impressive victory in the Frank Packer Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick in April. "It is easy to put a hype on a horse but he certainly showed in his last start he looks like he is good," Waller told RSN. "He's still immature. He is still improving, and we sent him to Queensland to get a bit more experience. He will get that experience from a wide draw tomorrow."

Flemington to guide Khoekhoe's Atkins plans

Matt Cumani will decide whether his The Showdown (1200m) winner Khoekhoe (Turffontein) will travel to Queensland for the J J Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), off the back of his performance in the Tom Melbourne Trophy (1400m) at Flemington today. Cumani figures the rise to 1400 metres is ideal, however getting a guide on Khoekhoe through his trackwork does not fill the trainer with confidence. "He's terrific-looking, is a fluent mover and the most wonderful athlete, but he's not a particularly flashy worker," Cumani said. "So you can't take every gallop with him personally. He hasn't run enough for me to have that true confidence to do it against better horses, so if it's the case he is a good horse and saves it for race day then that's great as it gives him a bit of longevity as well."

Milwaukee to bounce back at headquarters

After finishing third behind Prezado (Denman) and King Of Hastings (Ilovethiscity) last weekend, the Mike Moroney-trained Milwaukee (Fastnet Rock) is set to run on a seven-day back-up when he contests the Straight Six (Listed, 1200m) at Flemington today. Moroney said it was always the plan to back the sprinter up in today's race and is convinced only waywardness late in last week's race cost him the win. "In the last 150 metres he moved from about seven off the fence to one off the fence, and that's what cost him," Moroney said. "He can do that now

and again, wanting to lay in and find the rail. It wasn't until he cleared the other horses that he started doing it. It looked like he had them beaten. He probably lost a length doing it and was only beaten two noses. You'd expect the run to improve him even further."

Distance test for Blaze Forth

On the recommendation of Dwayne Dunn, Tasmanian gelding Blaze Forth (Court Command) will attempt to add a 1600-metre win to his record in the Apache Cat Handicap at Flemington today. Finishing eighth behind Iconoclasm (Toorak Toff) over 1400 metres last Saturday, Dunn suggested a distance rise and after a good week it was decided to take up the Flemington challenge. "I had never really thought about it again until Dwayne said he might appreciate the 1600 (metres) at this stage of his campaign," trainer John Blacker said. "He's had two solid runs, at Sandown and then last week at Flemington, and wasn't beaten far behind some good horses. Barrier one's a big advantage if they're not going out wide, as it's a heavy track there at the moment."

Alfa Oro chasing back-to-back wins

Connections of Alfa Oro (Bachelor Duke) will be hoping to reap full rewards for their patience when the Matt Laurie-trained galloper contests the Almandin Handicap (1100m) at Flemington today. A last-start domination of his rivals in track record time on the Pakenham synthetic where Alfa Oro crossed the line under a stranglehold showed the class of the gelding, who shaped as a potential Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) candidate before a life-threatening trackwork injury intervened. "I think he is very professional and happy to gallop along in front," Laurie said. "He seems to be a horse that just gets into the zone and we feel he will handle the Flemington straight. You never can be too confident, but he comes into it in the right frame of mind and he is racing particularly well. We've missed out on his three-year-old racing and now we've just got an opportunity to take him through his grades."

Moore has faith in Petronius

Gary Moore, who is set to join forces with his brother and champion Hong Kong trainer John at the start of next season, believes Petronius

(Redoute's Choice) can provide the pair with their first Group 1 winner as training partners. Petronius will run in the Calyx@Coolmore Australia Handicap (1500m) at Randwick today, and Gary Moore believes he is on an upward trajectory. "He's got that terrific gate speed where he can take up a nice position and sustain it under heavy pressure and that's one of his attributes," Moore said. "If we're lucky enough to win Saturday, I've got to speak to the partners, but we could consider running him in the Civic Stakes."

Not An Option a likely Randwick starter

Former New Zealander Not An Option (Not A Single Doubt) will make his debut for new trainers Richard and Michael Freedman at Randwick but he is far from an unknown quantity to the stable. Previously with Tony Pike, Not An Option was housed with the Freedmans during his Sydney autumn carnival campaign, which he rounded out with a luckless sixth behind King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). "He was probably a bit stiff not to finish a lot closer in the Champagne. He hasn't had a lot of luck in some of his runs but he is an above-average colt," Michael Freedman said. Not An Option has not raced for over a month but he has tuned up for today's Darley 2YO Handicap (1300m) with a testing barrier trial. "He needs to have a run to book his ticket to potentially go onto the J J Atkins," Freedman continued.

Dolan up for no claim challenge

Robbie Dolan will round out his final day as a claiming apprentice with six rides at Randwick and fittingly the final one will be for his boss Mark Newnham. The 24-year-old outrode his claim with a double at the Kensington track midweek but because he was already declared for mounts today, he is permitted to utilise his allowance. The Newnham-trained Spirit Ridge (Nathaniel) gave Dolan his milestone 80th victory and stablemate Blazing Miss (Sizzling) rates highly to deliver another in the final race at Randwick. "The way she won the other day, if she puts in an effort like that she will be right in the finish again," Dolan said.

Toby Edmonds, who trains in partnership with his son Trent, believes there is little between his Gold Coast winner The Drinks Cart (Unencumbered) and J J Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) favourite Wisdom Of Water (Headwater) as the colts head to the Brisbane feature. Sent out a warm favourite, The Drinks Cart (\$1.65) had no problems cruising to a win after sitting back in the field in the QTIS 2YO (1100m) yesterday. "We scratched him from the Champagne Classic at Eagle Farm to run here with the idea of getting him to settle," Trent Edmonds said. "He did that and there was plenty left after he made his winning run. Robbie (Fradd) doesn't think there is much between The Drinks Cart and Wisdom Of Water. There hasn't really been much between them when they have clashed so they both deserve a go at Group 1 racing."

Fee set for Ilovethiscity

Noor Elaine Farm yesterday announced that Ilovethiscity (Magic Albert) will stand at the Eurora farm for a fee of \$4,400 (inc GST) in 2020. The sire of ATC Sires' Produce (Gr 1, 1400m) winner El Dorado Dreaming has taken a slight decrease to his fee after standing for \$5,500 (inc GST) in 2019.

Review into Australian pattern announced

Racing Australia has announced it will form a working party to review the racing calendar with an over-riding national focus. The group will be charged with analysing the structure and relevance of the Australian Pattern guidelines which help determine which races are allocated black-type status. Among the working party's main goals will be an assessment of the current racing calendar from a national perspective, including the timing of Group 1 races, to determine if the industry is maximising opportunities. The working party will be convened by RA chairman Greg Nicholls and include two representatives nominated by each of Racing NSW and Racing Victoria and another three representing the remaining states and territories. RA has set a deadline of July 31 for the working party to present its report to the Australian Pattern and Development Committee, which will assess the findings and issue a recommendation to the RA board.

Cutaway rail in place at Sandown

The cutaway rail, rarely used in Victoria but common in parts of New South Wales and Western Australia, will feature for the five flat races at Sandown Lakeside on the eight-race card tomorrow, with no more than 57 horses running on the Lakeside circuit. "The Lakeside circuit has had a busy racing schedule of late on rain-affected ground so there's a lot of wear and tear on the track and more than we've had in the past few seasons leading into this date," Sandown Racecourse Manager Tim Bailey told Racing.com. "There are two meetings to go on Lakeside over the next two weeks and we identified there were two options for the rail

position - true or nine metres. We've decided to keep the rail in the true position for the Wednesday, June 3 meeting and so this Sunday the rail will be at nine metres with a cutaway in place at the 400 metres."

Ings' race fall inquiry adjourned

Stewards adjourned an inquiry into a bad fall at Hawkesbury that saw jockey Chelsea Ings spend Thursday night in hospital with a concussion and facial injuries. Ings was taken to Westmead Hospital after she fell onto the turf when riding Miss Merlin (Camelot) in the Australian Farrier Conference Maiden Plate (1300m). The Wanda Ings-trained filly was given a bump by Rizzuto (Manhattan Rain), ridden by Travis Wolfgram at the 300-metre mark. Ings was knocked unconscious in the fall but had regained consciousness when she left the track and was transported to hospital. Scans cleared Ings of serious spinal or shoulder injuries but a bad concussion and fractured nose meant the rider had to stay in hospital overnight. Stewards opened an inquiry into the fall but will wait for Ings to be fit to give evidence before continuing the inquiry.

NEW ZEALAND

Refreshed Asano keen for racing to restart

Leading jockey Kozzi Asano has had a breakthrough season and is looking forward to it resuming in July. The Canterbury-based rider is just six wins behind premiership leader Lisa Allpress and he is looking forward to battling it out for the premiership. "We will see how the first race meeting goes after Covid-19," Asano told NZ Racing Desk. "I am definitely looking forward to trying to close the gap." Asano has been leading the premiership for most of the season and he did admit he was a bit jaded prior to the lockdown. "I was quite tired before the lockdown," he said. Asano now believes he is rested after the lockdown but admitted he lost some fitness over the six-week period. "I stayed home all the time, watching racing and working on my car, and doing housework during the lockdown. It was quite relaxing."

ASIA

Rain a concern for Exultant

Tony Cruz's two fears are a storm and Furore (Pierro) in the lead-up to Exultant's (Teofilo) run in the Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) at Sha Tin tomorrow. "I don't want a downpour, that's my concern," Cruz said. "As long as the track is good to firm, as normal, Exultant should win this race again. But I want that normal track!" Moore said. "Furore had a little bit of mucus in his throat last time so I think he can run a better race this time. I think he's the one that could give Exultant a race. Time Warp might not stay this distance but Furore should handle the trip."

Moore finds key to Thanks Forever

John Moore hopes to have found the key to Thanks Forever (Duporth) as the consistent galloper seeks a first Group race victory in the Sha Tin Vase (Gr 3, 1200m) tomorrow. The gelding has raced ten times this season for one win and seven placings, including two top-three finishes at Group 1 level. Moore believes the latest of those, when behind Mr Stunning (Exceed And Excel) in the Chairman's Sprint Prize (Gr 1, 1200m), could have given him the knowledge to allow for further improvement. "What we learnt from the run is that he has a short run," Moore said. "Blake (Shinn) made

his run and I thought he was going to sustain it right to the line and be strong through the line which he wasn't at the 150 (metres). He looked like he was going to win the race but he bottomed on his run, so from that point of view Zac (Purton) has to be very mindful of that - he doesn't have a long run."

INTERNATIONAL

New races unveiled as Royal Ascot broadens programme

Major revisions to this year's Royal Ascot were unveiled yesterday which included six extra races, two-year-old races being weighted towards the end of the festival and consolation races for the Royal Hunt Cup (1m) and Wokingham (6f). The Buckingham Palace Handicap (7f), scrapped when the Commonwealth Cup (Gr 1, 6f) was introduced in 2015, returns this year and will open the meeting in place of the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m). Three new races will be staged for this year only - the Copper Horse Handicap (1m6f) for four-year-olds and up, the Golden Gates Handicap (1m2f) for three-year-olds and the Palace of Holyroodhouse Handicap (5f) for three-year-olds - while the most prestigious juvenile races will take place on Friday and Saturday this year. UK and Ireland slash Classics prize-money

Prize-money figures published for the British and Irish Classics highlight the scale of funding cuts as the sport continues to adapt to the financial impact of the global pandemic. On the BHA racing administration website, the 1,000 and 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) are listed at £250,000 each, half their original values. These figures at this stage are provisional, however. In Ireland, the Irish 2,000 and 1,000 Guineas

(Gr 1, 1m) are worth 37.5 per cent less, cut from €400,000 to €250,000. Prize-money for the Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) has been halved to €750,000 and the Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) cut from €400,000 to €250,000. The minimum prize-money for British Group 1's has been temporarily dropped by 50 per cent to £100,000 and the Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m4f) on June 5 has provisionally been listed at that figure, having been worth £425,000 last year.

Training partnerships approved in UK

The British Horseracing Authority is allowing trainers the opportunity to work in partnerships. Two separate individuals can now apply for a training partnership licence in Britain following the BHA announcement on Thursday. "If approved, this will result in a new training entity being created and a joint licence in Britain being granted," read the BHA statement. "Both individuals comprising a training partnership are required to meet all the existing pre-requisite criteria covering competency and capability. In addition, both applicants must complete all the related modular training courses in advance of being eligible to apply."

Canadian International Stakes cancelled

The Pattison Canadian International (Gr 1, 12f) is the latest top-level contest to fall foul of Covid-19's sporting shutdown, with officials at Woodbine racecourse opting to cancel the race that had been set for an increased prize fund of C\$1 million this year. A statement from Woodbine Entertainment said: "Due to complications with international travel, at this time the Pattison Canadian International has been cancelled for the 2020 season." The race that typically takes place alongside the quality contest, the Grade 1 EP Taylor Stakes (Gr 1, 10f), will still be held on its original date of October 18, as well as the top-level Northern Dancer Stakes (Gr 1, 12f).
