Alabama ready for Guineas

Having already upstaged the older horses to take out the C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1 1400m), Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) is ready to return to his own age group and take on the star three-year-olds in Saturday's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington. Trainer Mike Moroney and his fellow owners, who include Rupert Legh and Arrowfield Stud, had a whole host of options for the Group 1-winningcolt, but have elected to take on a stellar crop of three-year-olds including Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) and Catalyst (Darci Brahma). "We've already beaten the older horses at weight-for-age. We'd like to take the three-year-olds on now," Moroney said. "If he can beat the gun three-year-olds, it puts that on the mantle, too. They are obviously very good and it's a good year. But I have seen enough of our horse to think that he's improved a lot from the spring to the Morning Briefing page 9 >>

<< Continued from page 1 The influx of interstate trainers, mainly from Victoria, could lead to a heated top-end as those buyers with bigger budgets battle it out for the best-credentialed horses and potentially push the aggregate beyond \$3 million for the first time.</p>

Last year's sale resulted in 107 horses being traded for a total of \$2,993,000, a new record, at an average of \$27,972. The highest-priced lot was a \$115,000 colt by Fiorente (Monsun).

Magic Millions' Victoria and Tasmania manager Tim Brown said a host of interstate trainers were inspecting yearlings on the sale grounds yesterday.

Among them were Cranbourne's Ken Keys, who secured Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) winner Soul Patch (Shamus Award) for \$45,000 from the 2018 sale, Caulfield-based Lloyd Kennewell, Phillip Stokes, Dan Bowman, Mitch Freedman and Robbie Griffiths. *Continued on page* 5>>

<< Continued from page 3 Noted breeze-up exponent, Benalla-based Tal Nolen, was also on the grounds in a bid to source horses for his 2020 draft after preparing the Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs In Training Sale-topper at \$525,000 last year.</p>

But it was the local trainers - Scott Brunton (7) and Adam Trinder (5) were the leading buyers last year - who will prove vital to ensuring there is a healthy clearance rate, which closed at 78 per cent in 2019.

"The TasBreeders' scheme is very good and there's plenty of interest amongst owners and trainers," Brown told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"If people win a race here with the Tas Breeders bonus, they are

basically winning as much as a Melbourne midweeker and that is for any Tassie-sired or Tassie-bred horse."

Magic Millions
managing director

backed by the auction house, TasBreeders and Tas Racing.

"It is a huge opportunity (for the locals as) all the big races down here in Tasmania at the moment have been won by horses out of this sale," Bowditch said.

"It is one of those places, like Western Australia, where we all work together to get the job done, so to speak. We have all invested to make it work"

To further illustrate Bowditch's point, the exciting Bill Ryan-trained three-year-old Still A Star (Toronado), who cost just \$13,000 at the 2018 sale from the Alva Stud draft, made it four Listed wins in succession when taking out yesterday's Tasmanian Oaks (Listed, 2100m).

Alva Stud will offer eight yearlings today, including the half-sister to Still A Star by the Blue Gum Farm-based sire Manhattan Rain (Encosta De Lago), who is catalogued as Lot 23.

Catherine Hills, the proprietor of Alva Stud, said the Manhattan Rain filly had more size and scope than Still A Star, whose diminutive stature counted against her in the sales ring.

"She is a different type. She is a lot bigger, taller and stronger. Still A Star was a very small filly as a yearling, which is why she was so cheap, and she's still not a big filly but she doesn't look quite as far out of place now," Hills told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"The Manhattan Rain has got a lot more muscle and there's been quite a bit of interest in her." $Continued \ on \ page \ 7>>$

<< Continued from page 5 Hills, whose draft includes colts by Magnus (Flying Spur) and Palentino (Teofilo) and fillies by Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) and Alpine Eagle (High Chaparral), said there were big numbers of inspections yesterday, far more than in previous years.</p>

"I think it will be a really good sale as today has been very busy and a lot busier than any other Sundays we've had that I can remember," she said.

"There's a lot of mainland trainers and people coming over. It was flatchat from about 8.30am until about 2.30pm and then it dropped off a bit after that because we had the races on.

"One trainer I talked to from South Australia said last year he just came on the Sunday but needed more time to look, so he was around looking (on Saturday) as well. It is a positive vibe and the same for everybody."

Grenville Stud's late sire Lionhearted (Fastnet Rock), who died after just one season at stud, and Armidale Stud's Alpine Eagle will be represented by their first crop yearlings, and Brown expects the progeny of both stallions to be well received.

Victorian operation Sun Stud's first season sire Palentino will also have three yearlings on offer at the Tasmanian sale, the same auction ring

the dual Group 1 winner came out of in 2014 when purchased by Darren Weir for \$85,000.

Star mare Mystic Journey, an \$11,000 bargain buy, has flown the flag for her Armidale Stud-based sire Needs Further (Encosta De Lago), but she is not a lone hand for the stallion with the smart sprinter, \$18,000 graduate Bold Star, winning at stakes level at Flemington last month.

Bold Star's Adelaide-based trainer Gordon Richards, who trained his first Group 1 winner with Gytrash (Lope De Vega) in the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) on February 15, was another to make the trip to Tasmania yesterday.

Needs Further, who covered 48 mares in 2017 before his popularity skyrocketed last year when he covered triple figures (103) for the first time, has 13 lots catalogued in today's sale.

Brown said the sale was "shaping up well" and predicted the upward trend of 2020 to continue but issued caution to vendors to not set unrealistic reserves.

"With a sale like this, with a smaller book...we need to get a decent clearance rate which is important," he said.

"Yes, we get paid on gross, but we don't want to see vendors going home with horses. You want to see them cleared if we can achieve it"



Four straight for Still A Star

Still A Star (Toronado) made it seven wins from her past eight starts and a fourth consecutive stakes success when she bagged yesterday's \$150,000 Tasmanian Oaks (Listed, 2100m) at Launceston. The Bill Ryan-trained three-year-old did just enough to beat Look Sharpish (Pins) by a short-neck, with Bellx (Rock Hero) another half-neck back in third. A \$13,000 purchase by Monica Ryan out of the Alva Stud draft at the 2018 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale, Still A Star has now won \$411,190 in prize-money.

Spell beckons for Star

Following her Tasmanian Oaks success, Ryan confirmed Still A Star had done enough this preparation and would be given a well-deserved spell. "I thought she had a bit more to offer after the Strutt because we scoped her and there was still a bit of mucus in her throat. We cleaned that up and had her rescoped and blooded during the week and she was spot on. She's going straight to the paddock now."

Star's half-sister to sell today

Still A Star is out of the winning mare Lita (Casino Prince), who is a daughter of Group 3-winning mare Royal Asscher (Stravinsky). Purchased by Alva Stud for \$20,000 at the 2015 Inglis Australian Broodmare Sale, Lita missed to Alpine Eagle (High Chaparral) in 2018 and was covered by Bolt D'Oro (Medaglia D'Oro) last year. Alva Stud will offer a Manhattan Rain (Encosta De Lago) half-sister to Still A Star, listed as Lot 23 https://catalogue.magicmillions.com. au/lot/20TSY/23, at today's Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale.

14 for Trade Fair

The late Trade Fair (Zafonic) sired his 14th individual stakes winner yesterday when Free Trade (5 g ex Lady Xena by Dr Johnson) picked up the Pinjarra Classic (Listed, 1300m). The Michael Lane-trained five-year-old beat Cup Night (Maschino) by three and a half lengths, with Dance Music (War Chant) a further half a length away in third. Free Trade has now won seven races and has never finished out of the first three in his 14 starts, accruing prize-money totalling \$343,885. Trade Fair, a dual Group 3 winner in Europe and the sire of Grade 1 winner Trade Storm, was put down in 2018 at the age of 18 after it was discovered he had multiple cancerous tumours.

Fifty Stars and So Si Bon set for Blamey clash

Stablemates Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) and So Si Bon (So You Think) are set to clash again in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Flemington after running the quinella a year ago. Lindsay Park co-trainer Tom Dabernig said the stable was planning for both to back up into the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington on March 7, but connections of So Si Bon could revisit that call and shift their attention to the \$5 million All-Star Mile (1600m) at Caulfield on March 14. Both horses resumed in the C F Orr Stakes at Caulfield on February 8, with Fifty Stars finishing fourth and So Si Bon eighth. "I thought Fifty Stars ran really well first-up," Dabernig said. "The plan with him is to back up the week after into the Australian Cup and it's probably the same with So Si Bon, all going well. But if So Si Bon happened to win we could have a rethink and go to the All-Star Mile. The owners have sort of let go of that happening, but if it did happen, you'd be mad if you didn't have a go."

Nichols considers Avalon gear change

Trainer Shane Nichols is likely to tinker with the headgear on Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) ahead of the All-Star Mile. Streets Of Avalon was not nominated for the All-Star Mile but his upset win in Saturday's Group 1 at Caulfield guaranteed him a start in the race. Nichols did not nominate him for the All-Star Mile because the five-year-old has not won over 1600 metres. Streets Of Avalon has worn blinkers in all but two of his 43 starts but Nichols indicated he would look to change that in the hope he can go the distance. "I'll tinker with it a bit because with the blinkers on he doesn't really get 1600 metres," Nichols said. "But we might as well have a crack for the big cash because his rating is buggered now. We'll maybe take the blinkers off. Or maybe go with visors or maybe winkers. I'll just have a think about it."

Mirage Dancer on song for Australian Cup

European import Mirage Dancer (Frankel) has a date with one of Australia's oldest feature races in his diary after finishing a length third behind Miss Siska (So You Think) in Saturday's Peter Young Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) at Caulfield. The sixyear-old clocked impressive closing sectional times and will now step back up in distance for a tilt at next month's Australian Cup. "I thought his last 600 was absolutely super," Natalie Young, who trains the colt in partnership with Trent Busuttin, told RSN927's Correct Weight. "Ben Melham (jockey) was absolutely stoked with the performance and we were absolutely rapt. The grand final is obviously the Australian Cup in two weeks' time and I think he's going to map awesome for that."

Kewney next for La Tene

Having made a winning return to action in Saturday's Angus Armanasco Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield, Godolphin's La Tene (Helmet) is expected to remain at that level when she goes in pursuit of further glory with trainer James Cummings yesterday nominating the Kewney Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Flemington on March 7 as her likely next target. "I could run her in the Kewney in a couple of weeks, I've got a few options," Cummings told Racing. com. "Maybe she's a three-year-old filly that would be suited to Adelaide if we prolong her preparation. She might not prove to get the distance (of the Australasian Oaks) but one thing she's got is toughness." La Tene's victory on Saturday was the fifth quickest of any threevear-old over Caulfield's 1400 metres since January 2007.

Another Brisbane run for Anderson pair

Chris Anderson has decided to give Profit (Dundeel) and Ballistic Boy (Smart Missile) another race in Brisbane before heading to the Sydney autumn carnival. The pair were firstup at Eagle Farm on Saturday in a 1400-metre three-year-old handicap won by \$41 chance Naval Strike (Smart Missile). Profit ran second beaten half a length while Ballistic Boy was a length back in fourth. While the trainer has decided against sending the pair to Sydney for the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in a fortnight, both the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) on March 21 and the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on April 4 are on the radar. "I made it clear before Saturday there would be plenty of improvement in my pair," Anderson said. "I stand by that but there is no need to rush to Sydney when there is a 1400-metre race at Eagle Farm in a fortnight for them. After the Eagle Farm race there is plenty of time to head south and the Brisbane winter carnival is around the corner."

Il Paradiso to step out in trial

Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) placegetter Il Paradiso (Galileo) is scheduled to make his first appearance for Sydney trainer Chris Waller in a barrier trial at Rosehill tomorrow. Formerly trained by Aidan O'Brien, Il Paradiso remained in Australia after the Cup and has been in work for several weeks. Il Paradiso was promoted from fourth to third in the Melbourne Cup reshuffle of the placings behind Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War) after a stewards protest against Frankie Dettori on original runner-up Master Of Reality (Frankel). Il Paradiso, who holds entries in several major autumn features, is among those listed in the second of three open 1030-metre heats tomorrow. "He's come back really well," Waller said. "We are carefully finding our way with him but he seems to be adapting and doing everything right. We will see where we are after he trials, but it would be nice to think he can have a couple of runs during the autumn."

Shared Ambition to also have hit-out

Il Paradiso's stablemate Shared Ambition (Born To Sea), another European import, is also down to trial over 1030 metres. The gelding has won three of his four starts in Australia and finished third on a heavy Warwick Farm track on February 12. "He was good first-up," Chris Waller said. "He just had a big weight and it was a slow-run race on a heavy track. He will go to the Randwick City Stakes next." The Randwick City Stakes (Listed, 2000m) is on March 7. Waller has a host of other top-line horses set down for the trials, including Oaks winners Youngstar (High Chaparral) and Unforgotten (Fastnet Rock). Among the Godolphin horses expected to trial is Kementari (Lonhro), the 2018 Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner. After failing at stud, Kementari has been gelded and is in work with James Cummings but no decision has yet been made on a racing comeback.

Foxwedge colt aimed at VRC Sires

Stawell trainers Terry and Karina O'Sullivan will give Lunar Fox (Foxwedge) his chance in the VRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday week. The lightly-raced colt broke through at maiden level against his own age at Ballarat yesterday, scoring by a long-neck under a confident ride from Brett Prebble. "He's been a few weeks between runs, but I wanted to run in this race

and then in a fortnight's time is the Sires," O'Sullivan told Racing.com. "He showed a bit right from day one. I ran him in that early two-year-old race at Flemington and he was far from disgraced in that. He just keeps on improving a little bit." Prebble and Terry O'Sullivan won the same Sires' Produce race 17 years ago with Woodstock (El Moxie) when it was run at Group 1 level

MRC to investigate Caulfield bias

The Melbourne Racing Club officials will assess the factors that led to a perceived track bias at its Blue Diamond meeting on Saturday. Eight of the nine winners at Caulfield were in the first three at the 800-mark and four of them led throughout. "We have data around soil moisture and things like that and, as far as preparation for the track is concerned, we couldn't have asked for a better week," MRC executive director of racing and membership Jake Norton said. "The amount of rain we had over the last week was around 40 mils, 60 mils in the last eight days, so from a track management perspective, it was perfect. We moved the rail out three metres from the last meeting on CF Orr Stakes day, so all the ground was perfect across the track. As far as our preparation was concerned we couldn't have been happier. In terms of the race patterns and race results, I'd like to see the times, the splits, the wind direction, things like that which often play a significant role in results and the way races are run here at Caulfield."

Premier sale preview on Sky

A preview for the upcoming Inglis Premier Yearling Sale will air at 8pm tonight on Sky Thoroughbred Central (Foxtel channel 528). Replays will be shown throughout the week, while the preview can be live-streamed on racingnsw.com.au. The Premier sale is best-known as the auction through which undefeated champion Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) passed through for \$210,000 in 2008, while Group 1-winning graduates in the last 12 months include Gytrash (Lope De Vega), Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega), Nature Strip (Nicconi), Beat The Clock (Hinchinbrook), Scales Of Justice (Not A Single Doubt), Hey Doc (Duporth) and Kenedna (Not A Single Doubt).

Maher fined over safety gear

Leading trainer Ciaron Maher has been fined \$300 for not wearing a safety vest when riding a horse at the beach. Racing Victoria stewards censured Maher when the matter came to their attention via a Twitter video posted on February 14. Maher was mounted on a horse at Mordialloc Beach without the correct safety gear. He was also reminded his helmet should be properly fastened and he must wear appropriate footwear.

Whiteley banned

Queensland jockey Chris Whiteley has been suspended for a month for his behaviour in a stewards hearing. A resumed inquiry heard Whiteley was before a stewards hearing into a minor whip infringement at the Rockhampton meeting on February 9. After considering evidence from Whiteley and written statements from the stewards, Whiteley subsequently pleaded guilty to engaging in improper or insulting behaviour towards stewards. He was found to have used several profanities towards the stewards who were officiating at the meeting. Stewards considered relevant precedents and the need for a penalty to serve as a specific and a general deterrent. Whiteley was banned from riding in races for four weeks, with two weeks of the penalty suspended for a period of two years provided there was no breach of a similar rule in that time. The suspension began vesterday and will expire at midnight on March 7.

Vale Geoff Daffy

Long-time Victorian trainer Geoff Daffy, who mixed farming, business and racing throughout his career, has died suddenly, aged 77. The Camperdown-based Daffy, who had an extended association with the now-retired jockey Neville

Wilson, never had more than eight horses in work at a time but among them was 1994 Zeditave Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner Superact (Super Imposing). Daffy died on Friday afternoon and is survived by his wife of 55 years, Denise, and his five children, Anne, Peter, John, Kevin and Maree.

NEW ZEALAND

Bright future for Kelso pair

Matamata trainer Ken Kelso is planning to step both the unbeaten filly Levante (Proisir) and dual Group 2-winning mare Supera (Savebeel) up in grade after they won their respective races on home turf on Saturday. Levante is now being aimed at the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Trentham on March 14, while Supera's next target is the Bonecrusher New Zealand Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Ellerslie on March 7. Kelso believes the Trentham track will suit Levante and is keen to test her against the better members of her age group. "It is the logical step to take with her, to try and get some black-type," he said. "We've always thought the big, roomy track at Trentham would suit her so we gave her the soft option at home and a three-week gap to Wellington rather than taking on a race like the Mufhasa Stakes at Ellerslie next weekend." Supera meanwhile is set to try 2000 metres for just the second time on her next outing. "She's only had the one run over 2000 metres, which she won, but for one reason or another she hasn't got back up to that distance again this season," Kelso continued. "She's a stayer in the making and will enjoy the 2000 metres on a good track at Ellerslie."

Maher excited about Auckland Cup challenge

Ciaron Maher and David Eustace are set to break new ground next month when Azuro (Myboycharlie) will become the duo's first runner in New Zealand by lining up in the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Ellerslie on March 7. "I've never sent a runner over there before, so we're looking forward to it," Maher said. "He's a good stayer and has a great record at the trip. The Auckland Cup is a Group 1 race worth half a million dollars, and there aren't many two-mile races at that sort of level in this part of the world, so we thought it would be a nice race to target with him. It would be great for the owners if he could pull it off. They've had

a lot of fun with him already and he's been a good horse for them."

Important double for Coleman

Matamata jockey Michael Coleman is hoping the feature race double he achieved on his home track on Saturday will provide the catalyst to lift the number of raceday engagements he has been receiving of late. Coleman bagged two of the three black-type events on the Matamata card, guiding home Vernazza (More Than Ready) in the Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and one race later snaring the Kaimai Stakes (Listed, 2000m) on Joe's Legacy (Guillotine). That Coleman is even riding at the moment belies the fact that less than 12 months ago he thought he may have to give up his career in the saddle after a stint in hospital with life-threatening blood clots. "This year has been pretty tough by my own standards and the last few months I've been having a lean trot," he said. "Still it's a better spot than this time last year when I was in hospital and then I didn't ride for two months. Hopefully after a good day vesterday I might have turned the corner and the phone might start ringing a bit more."

Ellis savours stakes quinellas

Te Akau Racing principal David Ellis was on a high yesterday following Saturday's unique achievement of Te Akau preparing the quinella in both the Haunui Farm WFA Group One Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Otaki with Avantage (Fastnet Rock) and Prise De Fer (Savabeel) and also the Waikato Stud Slipper (Gr 3, 1200m) with Need I Say More (No Nay Never) and Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel). "That was some thrill we got on Saturday and I'm incredibly proud of all of our team who work together to get these results," Ellis said. "Jamie (Richards, trainer) is doing a superb job for us and has wonderful support from a very talented team behind him. This year has been very successful in getting our syndicates together and we have just a handful of places left in the last five horses that aren't fully sold yet. Funnily enough over the years it is those horses that have turned out to be some of our very best. I think Cool Aza Beel was third last to fully syndicate last year, Avantage was second last in her year and Sword Of Osman was similar."

Mozu on top in February

Mozu Ascot (6 h Frankel - India by Hennessy), the 2018 Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m) winner, secured a second victory in elite company when he took out the February Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Tokyo yesterday. Trained by Yoshito Yahagi, the six-year-old landed the Negishi Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at the same track on February 2, and he built on that form when quickening two and a half lengths clear of K T Brave (Admire Max) in the dirt feature. Sunrise Nova (Gold Allure) was a further length and a quarter back in third. Mozu Ascot has now won seven of his 21 starts and he became the fifth horse to win both a turf and dirt Grade 1 in Japan. He is also one of 10 top-tier winners for Juddmonte Farms stallion Frankel (Galileo), who is also the sire of Darley resident Cracksman, dual Japanese Grade 1 winner Soul Stirring and leading 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) contender Quadrilateral.

Doncaster Mile next for Ascot

A trip to Australia and a return to turf beckon for Mozu Ascot following yesterday's heroics, with Yahagi nominating the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on April 4 as his intended target. "He is a great horse who has won both a turf Grade 1 and a dirt Grade 1. His condition was better than the previous race, so I expected the result but got nervous," the winning trainer said. "I will bring him to Australia to contend the Doncaster Mile, and the target of this year would be the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile."

Golden Sixty keeps Derby dream alive with Hong Kong Classic Cup victory

olden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) shrugged off a burden of worry following a health setback to win the HK\$10 million Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) at Sha Tin yesterday.

And he did it despite his rider Vincent Ho's view that he was not at his peak for this second of three legs in the Four-Year-Old Classic Series, having suffered a fever two weeks ago.

"He's not 100 per cent, that's for sure – he's about 75 or 80 per cent – he won this race because he has a really good fighting heart," Ho said of Hong Kong's great new hope.

Ho enjoyed a rocket ride to victory on Golden Sixty in last month's Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) but this time had to rely on his mount's admirable guts and innate talent to keep alive the dream of a 'Golden' clean-sweep in this season's Classic Series.

The Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) gelding eased back and settled eighth in the 10-runner field as World Famous (Reliable Man) set the tempo up front. Stablemate More Than This (Dutch Art), a late-closing second in the Classic Mile, rowed past Golden Sixty's outside flank with around 500 metres to race but the real danger was ahead.

"Zac (Purton) took off quite early at the 500 (metres) on More Than This and came up outside me; but Ryan Moore's horse (Champion's Way) had plenty more in the tank so I just tracked him through the race," Ho said.

Moore, aware of the opportunity to steal a march, had fired Champion's Way (Hinchinbrook) to the lead before Ho could angle out and point Golden Sixty into clear running. When Ho found the gap, his mount's acceleration was less emphatic than the brilliant dash displayed in the Classic Mile but it proved decisive enough as he battled past his rival for a half-length score in 1m 45.88s. His closing 400-metre split was clocked at 22.38s.

"It didn't feel like a true run race but he's really tough and he wants to fight - when horses come close to him, he wants to win," Ho said.

"He's a tough and talented horse. He had his issue two weeks ago and I just wanted to get him as relaxed as possible. It was his first time at 1800 metres and I followed the right horse. I didn't want to push the button too early because I might use him too much, so I waited a little bit, found the gap and he's sprinted home."

Trainer Francis Lui was as relieved as he was delighted as he stood by the sundrenched winner's arch awaiting Golden Sixty's return.

"Everybody knew he had a temperature two

weeks ago. I was very worried he would miss this race, I tried everything to work it out and finally we got it and he still performed today; he was a bit keen before the race so I was worried, but he relaxed for Vincent and he is very tough," Lui said.

That well-documented temperature spike caused missed work and much angst in the Golden Sixty camp. The gelding's participation had been under discussion as late as Friday.

"I still wasn't sure on Thursday if he'd run and after Friday's gallop we still talked about it – if I wasn't happy with the gallop we would have pulled him out," Ho said.

"He was really fresh – the last gallop I couldn't really hold him – so I was concerned he'd be too keen today but once I got him behind the gate he was more relaxed than last time. He didn't pull, so I just had to get the right run – it was hard for him so I just hope he pulls up well."

Golden Sixty now has the chance to emulate Rapper Dragon (Street Boss), the only horse to have won all three legs of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series. To do that, the Australian-bred must win the Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) at Sha Tin on March 22.

"There's still a month to the Derby so let's hope he's healthy - that's all I'm concerned about," Ho said. "We won't push him too hard for the Derby because our main priority is his health. He's only four and he's got a great future, even in Group 1 at a mile – that suits him well."

Lui believes Golden Sixty is the horse everyone else has to beat in the Derby but he is not discounting his other contender, the seemingly more stamina-laden but also quirkier third-placed More Than This.

"At the moment, of course, I think Golden Sixty, but More Than This is also a good horse and I think he also ran well," the trainer said.

"I spoke to Zac (Purton) and he said More Than This just might need blinkers to help him because he's quite relaxed, he can jump fast and of course today the draw (10) didn't help him so he had to drop him out, but he just said he needs some headgear to wake him up, so we'll think about that."

Moore was pleased with the effort of the Size-trained Champion's Way who improved on his third place in the Classic Mile.

"He's a very honest horse, he ran super but

the winner is obviously a very good horse," the three-time British champion jockey said.

The Size stable's Beauty Legacy (Fiorente) was a disappointment. The Australian Group 2 winner pulled for his head in the Classic Mile but kept on for fourth on that occasion – this time he lost his head down the back and trailed in sixth.

"That was quite disappointing because he didn't really relax for me. We've been trying hard to teach him and as you could see in the back straight he was fighting with me and throwing his head up. We're still in the learning process," jockey Joao Moreira

There were more Derby clues in the Class 2 Lek Yuen Handicap (2000m) in which Amazing Beats (Epaulette) edged out fellow four-year-old Columbus County (Redwood) by a nose, with another Classic Series hope Super Oasis (Exceed And Excel) taking fourth in a blanket finish that also featured the fast-closing grey Glorious Dragon (Teofilo).

"He got the best run in the race and he had the

lightest weight but he showed plenty of ticker and he showed the 2000 metres certainly doesn't worry him," trainer Paul O'Sullivan said of the winner.

"He won the Tasmanian Derby – the Hong Kong Derby is a little bit of a step up but he was a Group 3 type of horse going around the city tracks in Australia and whether that's good enough to win a Hong Kong Derby I don't know, but he'll certainly get his chance now."

The day kicked off with trainer Manfred Man registering his 500th career win thanks to All Best Friends (Street Cry) in the opening Class 5 Wo Che Handicap (1200m) under Purton. The handler had notched win number 499 when his stable star Big Time Baby (Dandy Man) won the last race on Wednesday night's card but he wasn't counting.

"The press just told me it was the 500th winner – I didn't know that until then – it's nothing special!" Man said.

Hong Kong racing continues at Happy Valley on Wednesday, February 26.
