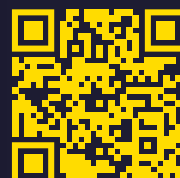

## Melody Belle displayed special qualities right from day one: Autridge

*Experienced trainer recounts champion mare's early days at Te Akau as she prepares for sales ring*

Champion mare Melody Belle (Commands), one of the rare gems to be offered at this week's star-studded Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale, has been credited with helping shape the stunning career trajectory of New Zealand trainer Jamie Richards.

But Stephen Autridge, Richards' senior

training partner during the early part of Melody Belle's racing career, yesterday revealed that he could sense the 14-time Group 1 winner was a bit different from an early age.

Te Akau's David Ellis paid a relatively low NZ\$57,500 for Melody Belle at the 2016 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale. He bought 17 yearlings from the Premier session and just one was cheaper than Melody Belle.

However, Autridge was immediately taken by the Marie Leicester-bred filly when canvassing the latest batch of yearlings who would come under his and Richards' tutelage when scouring the paddocks at Te Akau Stud.

"Well, I tell you what, it goes back to the first day I saw her in the paddock at Te Akau Stud as an unbroken yearling," Autridge told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"She just had a standout beautiful head. That day I had a drive around Te Akau Stud looking at all the yearlings I was going to train and she was the standout type.

"She was just a perfect horse to do anything with."

Autridge trained Melody Belle with Richards in her first 12 starts before the partnership ended and the latter was appointed in sole charge of Te Akau Racing.

During that time, Melody Belle would progress from an October two-year-old debut winner at Ruakaka before showing her class three starts later with victory in the NZ\$1 million Karaka Million (RL, 1200m).

She would go on to win the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) prior to embarking on a successful two-start Queensland Winter Carnival campaign in which she took out the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m), defeating Taking Aim (Choirs) and subsequent Group 1-winning sprinter Pierata (Pierro).

The experienced Autridge, who has more than 1,000 winners to his credit of which nearly 100 are at stakes level, recalled: "The only time she disappointed us was her lead-up run to her Karaka Million win.

"We had to give her a run at Ellerslie (two weeks earlier), she drew badly and got a bump and she ran nearly last (eighth of ten). We were a bit concerned, but we brushed it off and said, 'she'll be right', and we were.

"That night in the Karaka Million we got the gun run from the gun jockey (Opie Bosson) and now it's history what she's gone on to achieve."

Autridge, now training in partnership with Kris Shailer at Matamata, has marvelled at Melody Belle's racetrack feats season after season.

The rising seven-year-old mare's win the Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Ellerslie was her 14th at the highest level and the victory also saw her surpass fellow champion New Zealand mare Sunline (Desert Sun) for her number of Group 1 successes.

"Nine times out of ten, a horse who shows you something would go sore, train off or whatever but she never did," he said.

"She was a very rare mare to have. It was just so good to see so many of her owners enjoy the ride. There's quite a few of them and they loved every day of it."

The Fortuna Thoroughbreds syndicate, who own the mare, has entrusted Julian Blaxland's Blue Sky Premium Consignment with selling Melody Belle who ended her 41-start racing career when running on from last to finish fifth in Saturday's Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m).

"She's the best performed mare to go to auction probably anywhere in the world from a Group 1 point of view and I am just really excited for Tuesday," Blaxland said yesterday.

"There's 34 owners in this mare and it's the end of a long and very exciting journey for all of those owners and, of course, Jamie Richards.

"Jamie's obviously a very accomplished trainer now, but this mare really put him on the map and she's just a wonderful mare.

"It's the last chapter for them and the beginning of a new chapter with the start of her breeding career."

Melody Belle is out of Meleka Belle (Iffraaj) who is a half-sister to four stakes-placed horses including the Group 1-placed filly Tsarina Belle (Stravinsky).

"I've been lucky, especially in the past few years, to spend time around some top horses and they certainly have something about them," Blaxland said.

"They have a presence and Melody Belle knows she's good. She is very athletic. You can see that she's got an enormous overstep, a beautiful head on her.

"Athleticism is the first thing that comes to mind when you look at her and I think she should appeal to all big breeders and operations.

"From a pedigree and performance point of view, she wouldn't be out of place in any broodmare band anywhere in the world and if she can throw a type like herself, you're going to get an athletic racehorse out of her."

With Melody Belle sure to capture international attention from buyers, Blaxland was keeping an open mind on what price the Commands (Danehill) mare could make tomorrow.

"I think if you compare her to the Sunlights and those types of mares and the Unforgottens of last year, she's certainly in the \$2.5-\$4.5 million bracket," he said.

"The market is very strong and these big breeding operations want mares like her. She's a collector's item. She represents an enormous opportunity for any stud that wants one of the best mares in the world in their broodmare band."

Melody Belle, catalogued as **Lot 510**, will be the seventh horse to go through the ring at the Gold Coast tomorrow. The sale starts at 10am.

## Adelaide connections lose star mare Li'l Kontra

Talented Adelaide sprinter Li'l Kontra (Krupt), who was trained by Ryan Balfour, sadly died en route to the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale where she was to be sold.

The rising five-year-old mare was found dead in her box after the transport company taking her from Adelaide to Sydney had stopped in country NSW on Friday night to break-up the long trip.

The discovery was made early on Saturday morning by the driver.

Li'l Kontra was a dual stakes-winning juvenile who ran fourth in the 2019 Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) behind colts Exceedance (Exceed And Excel), Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) and filly Libertini (I Am Invincible).

She was to be offered through the Blue Sky Premium Consignment draft.

"It's devastating for Ryan Balfour and his owners with Li'l Kontra. She

was halfway to Queensland and unfortunately passed away while in a transit stop overnight," Blue Sky's Julian Blaxland said.

"It's very sad for them. We were really looking forward to selling her on their behalf, but sometimes these things happen with horses.

"We send our thoughts to her owners and also to Ryan."

Noted for her consistency, Li'l Kontra won five of her 29 starts including in April when scoring at Caulfield. Li'l Kontra was a sister to the former Balfour-trained Group 2-placed sprinter Cashed.

Balfour, with the assistance of agent Dave Mee of Pinhook Bloodstock, paid \$110,000 for Li'l Kontra at the 2018 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale. She won \$574,935 in prize-money.

Her dam Li'l Cashy (Keltrice), who was trained by Balfour's late father David, has a yearling filly by Toronado (High Chaparral).

## No Group 1 tilt for Splintex

Hallmark Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Splintex (Snitzel), who was beaten one and a half lengths in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) last start when sixth, will bypass Saturday's Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) in favour of the Moreton Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm a week later. The Mark Newnham-trained four-year-old entire will also not be aimed towards the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) and will instead be restricted to 1200-metre races. Splintex's stablemate Greysful Glamour (Stratum) ran sixth in the Pam O'Neill Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Doomben on Saturday and will be offered as **Lot 679** in the race fillies and mares session tomorrow at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale.

## Snowdens to line up two in Kingsford-Smith

Peter and Paul Snowden, however, hope to have two runners in the Kingsford-Smith Cup, Signore Fox (Exceed And Excel) and Dame Giselle (I Am Invincible). Signore Fox, a winner of the Star Kingdom Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) first-up in early April, finished fourth last start in the Takeover Target (Listed, 1200m) at Gosford on May 8, a performance deemed good enough by the Snowdens to send the five-year-old entire to Queensland for a shot at the Group 1 sprint. Group 1-placed stablemate Dame Giselle, a three-year-old filly who is a four-time Group 2 winner, tuned up for her Queensland campaign with a third behind Aim (Star Witness) in a trial at Rosehill on May 21.

## Godolphin to also have multiple runners

Godolphin also intends to have multiple runners in the weight for age Kingsford-Smith Cup. At this stage, Kerrin McEvoy has been booked to ride dual Group 1-winning sprinter Trekking (Street Cry), who finished fifth in the Doomben 10,000, Queensland-based jockey Michael Rodd has been booked to ride Kementari (Lonhro), who will be having his third start at Group 1 level in a third state this campaign, and Hugh Bowman will partner Savatiano (Street Cry) in the \$700,000 race. Savatiano, who was runner-up in the All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) last start, won a Randwick barrier trial over 1040 metres on May 13.

## Al Maher filly Design Artist impresses at Sandown

Phillip Stokes has been surprised at the steps Design Artist (Al Maher) has been able to make before a winning debut at Sandown. Two-year-old filly Design Artist displayed a lot of potential in taking out the Ladbrokes Bet Ticker Handicap (1200m) yesterday. Stokes said he was surprised to see the filly at the racetrack so early in her career, although that did not stop punters stepping in and backing the filly who rode the speed under Ben Allen before recording a narrow, but decisive victory. Sent off the \$2.60 favourite, Design Artist held off Cardigan Queen (Sebring) (\$3) by a neck with Gracie Turf (Turffontein) (\$101) a further two and three-quarter lengths away in third. "I was surprised that she's got here this early," Stokes said. "She looks like she's going to make a lovely three-year-old and she'll take a lot out of this. We'll tip her out now and look forward to the spring. She was left out in front a long way out but toughed it to the line and I'm really happy

for the owner in Adelaide. She's had those 800-metre trials at Pakenham and it is the sign of a good horse that can hang on and do that on debut. I'm hoping we can stretch her out over a bit longer next time and I'm looking forward to the next prep. I think she's got a future."

## Neasham weighing up options

Meanwhile, Annabel Neasham is considering her options with Zaaki, a horse who arrived in Australia last December and started his new career Down Under in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) on April 10 when an unlucky sixth. The Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) is the main spring goal. "I don't want to be too greedy and thinking I've gone to the well too many times when we get to the spring, so I'll work out if we press on to the Q22 in the next 24 to 48 hours," Neasham told RSN. "But being a European horse, they don't appreciate long holidays and he's a big burly horse who wants a three-week break anyway. The way in which he won (on Saturday), we'd be mad not to set our sights on the Cox Plate."

## Brandenburg pressing on to \$1.2 million Q22

While Annabel Neasham may bypass the \$1.2 million Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) at Eagle Farm on June 12 with Zaaki, rival Sydney trainer John Sargent is full steam ahead towards the lucrative race with Brandenburg (Burgundy) who ran third in the Doomben Cup. The four-year-old gelding, who won the inaugural \$500,000 The Coast (1600m) at Gosford earlier this month, led the Doomben Cup field up on Saturday under jockey Regan Bayliss. Zaaki tracked him in the run and sprinted clear to win by seven lengths while Toffee Tongue (Tavistock) finished runner-up.

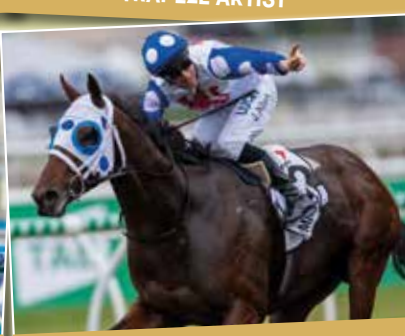

## Julius to appeal ban

Apprentice jockey Melissa Julius will appeal a six-week suspension handed down for her ride on Azzureous (Deadline) at Murray Bridge on Saturday. Racing SA stewards found Julius guilty of failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures on Azzureous (\$51), who was first-up, in the Ridley Plumbing And Earthmoving Handicap (1600m). The Peter Blanch-trained four-year-old was making ground when Julius said she eased the horse down to avoid the heels of the tiring leader Neodium (Terango). Azzureous finished 11th, beaten five and a half lengths. "(We're) definitely appealing, one of the worst decisions I've seen," Julius' manager Phillip Roost told Racing.com. "(We're) very disappointed in the finding, their reasoning is not acceptable and it appears to just have been the wrong decision. The suspension is particularly disappointing for Melissa because she's out of apprenticeship at the end of the season, so we're really hoping the powers at be make the right decision on appeal."

## Riding High exacts revenge at Sandown

A year after dumping his rider on the way to the start when favourite for the Australian Hurdle (3900), Riding High (Raise The Flag) has returned to Sandown to claim the Australian Steeplechase (3900). This time Riding High, under the guidance of Clayton Douglas, upset favourite backers on a horse that trainer Henry Dwyer described as "buzzy". Settling behind the speed, Riding High (\$5) took over soon after straightening, racing to a seven-length win from the \$2.05 favourite Michelin (Pentire) with Rexmont (Shinzig) (\$11) five lengths away third. Dwyer, a Group 1-winning trainer, described winning a feature jumps race as exciting. "You win Group 1s and that sort of stuff but there's

no greater feeling than winning a feature jumps race with a nice horse," Dwyer said. "It's a good sport, the jumps enthusiasts love it. Whether it's risk and reward, I don't know, but winning a jumps race is a huge thrill."

## Saunter Boy bounces back

Saunter Boy (Myboycharlie) has lived up to the lofty expectations of the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace stable with a demolition job in the Australian Hurdle at Sandown. Expectations were Saunter Boy would take out the Galleywood Hurdle (3200m) at Warrnambool during the carnival earlier this month and then head to Sandown for the Australian Hurdle yesterday. However, Saunter Boy jumped indifferently at Warrnambool, eventually finishing fourth. In a bid to get Saunter Boy to jump with more confidence, Maher and Eustace sent the gelding to Cranbourne on May 14 for a hurdle school, an exercise that paid off handsomely yesterday. Ridden by Steven Pateman, Saunter Boy (\$4.20) raced to a ten-length win from The Statesman (Zoffany) (\$17) with the \$3.10 favourite Home By Midnight (Domesday) four lengths away third. "It was bloody awesome," Eustace said. "He jumped better today. We thought he could go and do that at Warrnambool but he just didn't jump well enough. He got his confidence in a trial at Cranbourne and Steve got him in a lovely rhythm. He missed a couple but all-in-all it was a pretty good round of jumping and we thought he'd like the bigger track at Sandown because he's a class horse on the flat."

## Noblet no jumps novice with Out And Dreaming

Out And Dreaming (Street Boss) has followed up his maiden hurdle victory with a dogged win at Sandown. The four-year-old was lining up for his third jumps start yesterday when contesting the Ladbroke It Hurdle (3400m) having taken out a maiden hurdle (3200m) at Warrnambool earlier this month. "He's the only jumper I've ever trained," Ballarat trainer Andrew Noblet said. "I pre-trained a horse called Transferal for Robbie Laing a number of years back, but other than that I haven't had a jumper. It's very rewarding when you get a win with a jumper with the amount of work that goes into them." Under the guidance of Tom Ryan, Out And Dreaming (\$17) recorded a length win from Eckhart (Pentire) (\$3.40) with the \$3 favourite Mawaany Machine (Teofilo) two lengths away third. Noblet said he purchased Out And Dreaming as a middle-distance flat performer and did not expect him to turn into a jumper. "He wasn't being that genuine on the flat, then he started jumping and he thrived on it," Noblet said. "In between Warrnambool and today he's really come on. He's still inexperienced in his first preparation, but he's a young horse with a good future ahead of him."

## Stars given green light to fly into Queensland

Health officials will allow horses to fly into Queensland after days of negotiations. A flight from Melbourne will be able to arrive on Tuesday night, with Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) favourite Gytrash (Lope De Vega) expected to be on the plane. Plans have already been put in place for many horses to travel via road, including Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Savatoxl (Kuroshio) and Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) favourite Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry).

## Per Incanto fully booked

Little Avondale has announced that its stallion Per Incanto (Street Cry) is fully booked for season 2021. Coming just days after a weanling colt by the New Zealand stallion sold for \$500,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale, studmaster Sam Williams confirmed Little Avondale had been overrun by breeders wanting to book mares into the Group 1-producing sire. "Per Incanto has had an exceptional season, particularly in Australia and Hong Kong. He's now getting those runners from his better credentialled mares," Williams said. "Group 1 winner Bonham's from a Redoute's Choice mare and

New Zealand Oaks runner-up Charms Star's the first foal of a dual stakes-winning mare. His runner to winner ratio in Australia is 70 per cent this season." Per Incanto, who is also the sire of exciting Sydney sprinter Lost And Running, stands for a fee of NZ\$25,000 (plus GST) this year.

## Patience paying off with Francesca

A dominant display by promising three-year-old Francesca (Ifraaj) at Te Rapa on Saturday impressed Murray Baker and his training partner Andrew Forsman. The filly had pleased Baker in the early stages of her career but was set aside after two eye-catching runs in August last year to allow her to develop into her imposing frame. She has now won three of her four starts since resuming in April, with her five and a half length demolition of a Benchmark 74 field over 1400 metres on Saturday indicating she is a stakes winner in waiting. "We always thought she was a promising filly, but she was too weak to really finish things off in her first couple of runs last year," Baker said. "We put her away for a decent break and let her strengthen up as she just needed that time to grow into herself. She has come back a much stronger individual and that shows in the way she has won three of her four starts in this prep. I think she is going to be even better in the spring so she will probably have one more start and then we will put her aside again."

## McNab times Run To Perfection

Michael McNab brought up a winning treble at Te Rapa on Saturday when he guided the Stephen Marsh-trained Run To Perfection (Sepoy) to a comfortable five-length victory in the open 1400-metre event. McNab, who had earlier posted wins aboard Tevere (Contributer) and Uareastar (Jakkalberry), never missed a beat as he worked Run To Perfection into a challenging position on the

inner entering the home straight before exploding away from his rivals at the 200 metres. It was the third career victory for the four-year-old gelding, who was having his third run back in New Zealand after an uninspiring Australian campaign, where he was unplaced in four starts for trainer Danny O'Brien. "It's just great to have him back after he didn't perform up to expectations in Australia," Marsh said. "I think he is a very good horse, but it has just taken a little bit of time to get him right again. His last start at Te Rapa was a far better effort than it looked on paper, so we did have confidence he could go a bold race this time. Michael handled him superbly and he ended up winning on his ear really."

## Another Ballymore result for Cunningham

Curraghmore Stud principal Gordon Cunningham continued his good form with Mike Moroney and Pam Gerard's Ballymore Stables when Tevere (Contributer) broke her maiden status at her second start when storming clear to win over 1200 metres at Te Rapa on Saturday. "Tevere is the third horse I've had in training with Ballymore," Cunningham said. "The first was Chicharita, who won the Royal Stakes and she finished fourth in the New Zealand Derby. The second was Tofane, who we sold after she trialled and last year she won the All Aged Stakes." Tevere, who had featured prominently at four trial outings before finishing fourth on debut at Avondale last month, put that raceday experience to good use on Saturday, as she overcame a wide draw to score handsomely in the hands of Michael McNab. Settling third last in a strung-out field, Tevere stood the leader 12 lengths passing the 600 metres, but quickly improved her position as McNab set her alight approaching the home straight. Tevere stormed down the centre of track to win easing up by one and three-quarter lengths from pacemaker Corretto (Zacinto). "They were going quickly and she showed a sharp turn-of-foot to win easily," McNab said.

## ASIA

### First for Gold Ship

Überleben (3 f ex Meine Theresia by Roses in May) landed the Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) (Gr 1, 2400m), the second leg of the Triple Crown for fillies, at Tokyo yesterday, providing her sire Gold Ship (Stay Gold) with his first elite-level winner. Having been placed four times in Graded company, the Takahisa Tezuka-trained filly notched her first stakes success with a one-length win over Akaitorino Musume (Deep Impact), while rank outsider Hagino Pilina (Kizuna) was a nose further back in third. "She suffered from colic in February and has shown a slow but steady recovery," winning jockey Mirco Demuro said. "She broke smoothly today and it did worry me a bit that we were dead last in the backstretch but she responded well when the pace accelerated from the third corner and showed her tenacity in steadily advancing in the straight. She was strong pulling away and holding off the others. The added distance wasn't a problem for her at all. I'm thrilled - it's always wonderful to win a Grade 1 race." Gold Ship, the winner of six elite-level contests during his race career, is the sire of three stakes winners and stands at Big Red Farm in Japan.

## INTERNATIONAL

### 90 for Galileo

Empress Josephine (3 f ex Lillie Langtry by Danehill Dancer) defeated her stablemate Joan Of Arc (Galileo) in the final stride of the Irish 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) at the Curragh yesterday, providing Galileo (Sadler's Wells) with his 90th individual elite-level winner. Sent off at 14-1, the Aidan O'Brien-trained filly produced a late turn of foot to run down Joan Of Arc and score in a photo-finish, with No Speak Alexander (Shalaa) a length back in third. Unraced last season, Empress Josephine made a winning debut at Naas in

March but had failed to score in two subsequent runs at Group 3 and Listed level. Out of dual Group 1 winner Lillie Langtry (Danehill Dancer), Empress Josephine is a sister to seven-time top-level winner Minding, who was second in this race in 2016. Galileo, the sire of 336 individual stakes winners, stands at Coolmore in Ireland for a private fee.

### First for Power

Helvic Dream (4 g ex Rachevie by Danehill Dancer) narrowly got the better of odds-on favourite Broome (Australia) to land a thrilling edition of the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Gr 1, 1m2f) at the Curragh yesterday, providing Power (Oasis Dream) with his first winner at the highest level. The Noel Meade-trained gelding was neck and neck with the Aidan O'Brien-trained Broome during the final furlong and battled best to score in a photo, reversing the placings from the Mooresbridge Stakes (Gr 2, 1m2f) run at the track earlier in the month. True Self (Oscar), who landed the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington for the second time in November, was a length back in third. Helvic Dream is the first foal out of unraced mare Rachevie, who is also the dam of Group 3-placed filly Flirting Bridge (Camelot). Power, the sire of New Zealand-bred Group 2 winners Mighty Giant and Gift Of Power, will stand at Oaklands Stud for NZ\$13,200 in 2021. The win provided Meade with his first Group 1 winner on the flat as a trainer and he said: "I just can't believe it to be honest with you. I'm thrilled. I've been second in the Guineas twice and placed in Classics and Group 1s, fourth in the Epsom Derby, but that's the first Group 1 winner. It means a lot."

### 79 for Sea The Stars

It proved to be third time lucky in Group company for Sea Of Sands (3 c ex Salve Haya by Peintre Celebre) when he landed the Derby

Trial (Gr 3, 2000m) at Berlin-Hoppegarten yesterday, having placed at Group 3 level on his previous two starts. The Jean-Pierre Carvalho-trained colt got the better of favourite Lord Charming (Charm Spirit) by a head, with Vallando (Lord Of England) two lengths behind the winner in third. Sea Of Sands is the fourth winner from as many to race out of three-time winner Salve Haya (Peintre Celebre), while her second dam is the German Champion Salve Regina (Monsun). The win provided Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) with his 79th individual stakes winner and the six-time Group 1 winner stands at Giltown Stud in Ireland for a fee of €150,000 (approx. AU\$236,315).

### Two for Protectionist

Amazing Grace (3 f ex Amabelle by Danehill Dancer) broke her maiden in style on her fifth start when taking out the Diana Trial (Gr 2, 2000m) at Berlin-Hoppegarten to become the second individual stakes winner for Protectionist (Monsun). The Waldemar Hickst-trained three-year-old was held up by Rene Piechulek and she came wide and picked up well in the straight to run down Noble Heidi (Intello) and win by three-quarters of a length, while Theodora (Ito) was a further length and a half back in third. Amazing Grace was second on debut at Chantilly last July and returned to run second in a Listed race at Cologne in September and third in the Preis der Winterkönigin (Gr 3, 1600m) in October, before running fifth on her seasonal reappearance and only other start earlier this month. She is out of the Listed winner Amabelle (Danehill Dancer) and joins Lambo, who landed the Bavarian Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) on May 1, as the first two stakes winners for Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Protectionist, who stands at Gestut Rottgen for €6,500 (approx. AU\$10,240).

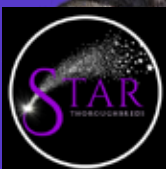
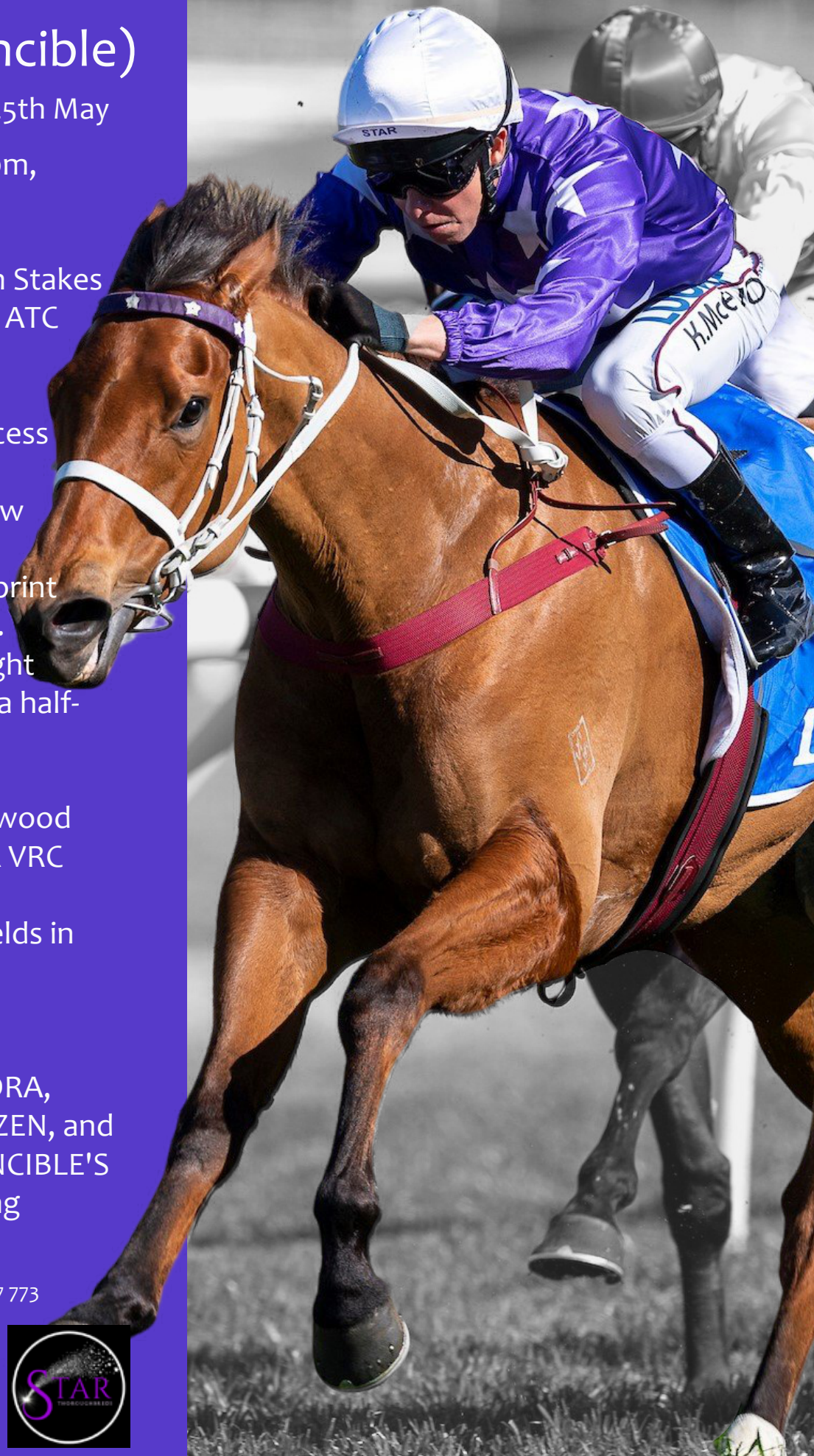

The Johnny Murtagh-trained colt, who gained a free entry to the Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) with the win and is also entered in the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) on June 5, pulled clear of Arturo Toscanini (Galileo) in the closing stages to score by one and three-quarter lengths. Snapraeterea (Buratino) was another three lengths back in third. Earlswood, who placed at Listed level at Chester on his previous start, is the third winner from as many runners out of Group 2-placed mare Field Of Miracles (Galileo). Pivotal, the sire of 32 individual top-level winners, was retired from stud duties at Cheveley Park Stud earlier this year aged 28.

## 23 for Nathaniel

Nationalista (4 f ex Rime A Rien by Amadeus Wolf) got off the mark in stakes company when landing the Prix Haras du Lion (Listed, 2000m) at Le Lion d'Angers yesterday, earning Nathaniel (Galileo) his 23rd individual stakes winner. The Mathieu Brasmé-trained four-year-old finished fourth at Listed level last start but improved on that run to defeat Control Tower (Youmzain) by a length, with Tree Valentine (Fastnet Rock) the same distance further behind in third. Former Tweenhills resident Hot Streak relocated to Haras d'Annebault this year where he stood for €3,500 (approx. AU\$5,514).

## 16 for Arcano

Four times stakes placed from five previous attempts, Cirano (3 c ex Concerto Finale by Footstepsinthesand) had his day yesterday in the Premio Mauro Sbarigia (Listed, 1600m) at Rome and became the 16th individual stakes winner for his sire Arcano (Oasis Dream). Cirano, who was recording his fourth win from 11 starts, forged through in the final furlong before grabbing the rail and grounding it out win by half a length from Convivio (Casamento) and Cantocorale (Helmet), who were split by a short head for second and third. Cirano's dam Concerto Finale (Footstepsinthesand) was a winner and is a daughter of the stakes-placed Connessa (Invincible Spirit). Arcano started out at Derrinstown Stud in Ireland in 2011 but relocated to Allevamento di Besnate in 2016 where he has stood since and his fee this year was €5,000 (approx. \$AU7,877).

## 12 for Goldencents

Nocentsinkentucky (4 g ex Greeley's Geisha by Mr Greeley) landed the Jagersro Sprint (Listed, 1200m) yesterday to provide Goldencents (Into Mischief) with his 12th individual stakes winner. The Fredrik Reuterskiöld-trained four-year-old, who was making his second start in stakes company after an unplaced effort in the UAE 2,000 Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) last year, justified being sent off the short-priced favourite with a comfortable win over Gulfstream Tiger (Elusive Quality), taking his record to eight wins from 12 starts. Goldencents, a three-time Grade 1 winner in the United States, stands at Spendthrift Farm for a US\$15,000 (approx. AU\$19,400) service fee.

## ITY: Tokyo strikes gold in Italian Derby for Yoshida

French raider Tokyo Gold (Kendargent) blitzed the field in the Derby Italiano (Gr 2, 2200m) at Rome yesterday in the colours of Teruya Yoshida. The Satoshi Kobayashi-trained colt came up the centre of the track under Cristian Demuro and routed the field by four lengths. Juan De Montalban (Lope De Vega) finished second, a length and a half ahead of Alastor (Helmet), who came out best of three horses in a blanket for third. Yoshida homebred Tokyo Gold won on his second start last July and scored Listed honours in the Prix Haras de Bouquetot (Listed, 1650m) on his next outing. Placed again in Listed company earlier this year, he came into this race off the back of a fourth-placed effort in the Prix Noailles (Gr 3, 2100m) last month. He is a brother to Group 1-placed Notte Bianca, out of Yoshida's Listed scorer Biancarosa (Dalakhani).

## ITY: Baptism justifies favouritism for first Group win

Baptism (Sea The Stars) collected his first Group success yesterday in the Premio Carlo D'Alessio (Gr 3, 2400m) at Rome for Alduino Botti. The four-year-old was previously trained by John Gosden for whom he won his maiden at Chelmsford, and he broke through in stakes company on his second start in Italy in the Premio Botticelli (Listed, 2100m) before running fourth in the Derby Italiano (Gr 2, 2200m) and this is his first win in seven starts since. Sent off as favourite, he made the running and was a clear two-length winner from Nubius (Dylan Thomas) and Keep And Love (Lope De Vega), who were split by a head for second and third.

## ITY: Attimo Fuggente steps up for Group success

Attimo Fuggente (Exceed And Excel) followed up his Listed win last month with victory in the Premio Presidente Della Repubblica (Gr 2, 1800m) at Rome yesterday. The four-year-old colt was sent off as favourite under Fabio Branca and he duly prevailed by three lengths from Thunderman (Blu Air Force), while Only Time (Requinto) was a further half-length back in third of the six runners.

Irish import Going Global (Mehmas) is living up to her name as the filly, from the first crop of Tally-Ho Stud's Mehmas (Acclamation), remained unbeaten in the US when taking out the Honeymoon Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) at Santa Anita. A winner in Ireland for Mick Halford, she pitched into Graded company on her debut for Philip D'Amato in February when landing the Sweet Life Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) before landing the China Doll Stakes (Listed, 8f) in March. She also captured the Providencia Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) last month. Her victory yesterday was the most impressive to date as she cruised to a four and three-quarter length success over Golden (Tapit) and Midnight Diva (Midnight Lute), who were split by half a length for second and third. The plan now is to aim for the Del Mar Oaks (Gr 1, 9f) in August. "I've trained a lot of

good fillies and mares, but this early on in their career, I'd say she's definitely the best," D'Amato said.

Four-year-old Sconsin (Include) got back to winning ways in the Winning Colours Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) at Churchill Downs after her last-start runner-up effort behind champion Gamine (Into Mischief) in the Derby City Distaff Stakes (Gr 1, 7f). The Gregory Foley-trained filly's last victory came in the Eight Belles Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) last September before she ran fourth in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (Gr 1, 7f) and last of seven in the Madison Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) in April. Stalking the pace, she ran down the pacesetter Rising Seas (First Defence) to win by three and a quarter lengths. Rising Seas held on

for second by half a length from the favourite Frank's Rockette (Into Mischief).

## USA: As Time Goes by holds This Tea in Santa Maria

Coolmore filly As Time Goes By (American Pharoah) held on in a photo in the Santa Maria Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at Santa Anita to land her second Graded contest on the bounce, having taken the Santa Margarita Stakes (Gr 2, 9f) at the same track last month. The Bob Baffert-trained four-year-old tracked the pace and swept past Miss Stormy D (Tapizar) after the second turn but had a battle in the stretch to see off This Tea (Curlin) but she prevailed by a nose, while there was eight lengths back to Miss Stormy D in third. As Time Goes By has now won four of her seven starts, while she also ran second in the Beholder Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) last month to Swiss Skydiver (Daredevil).

# Panfield soars to the top of Hong Kong's staying ranks with Champions & Chater Cup victory

A perfect ride aboard Tony Millard-trained Panfield (Lookin At Lucky) delivered Karis Teetan success in the Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) at Sha Tin yesterday and also immeasurable personal solace.

Grieving the death of close friend Nooresh Juglall in a race fall in Mauritius on May 15, Teetan dedicated the victory to his wife Xaviere after Millard's brilliant training effort lifted some of the 'Mauritian Magician's' gloom.

"I'm really glad I got this one home. It's been a tough week. I needed this (race) to get me back to work, to the track and I want to dedicate this to my wife (Xaviere). She's been by my side this past few weeks and she's given me confidence every day," he said.

"If I did not have my wife by my side, I might not have been here at the moment and she was there and kept on pushing me and gave me confidence.

"I had this horrible news last week where we lose one of my best friends and my brother in racing and I take this pretty hard. This win makes it a little bit better, but we still miss Nooresh.

"It's been a long time since I got one of these big ones, but this feels good. You need to just keep working hard and it will come."

Teetan tracked Exultant (Teofilo) and Zac Purton relentlessly behind pace-setter Time Warp (Archipenko) before mounting his challenge in the straight, clawing his way past the five-time Group 1 winner before withstanding a late challenge from Joao Moreira and Columbus County (Redwood).

Half a length separated Panfield and Columbus County, with Exultant a length and a quarter further back.

"At the 700 (metre mark), I knew this horse would go right through the line because he literally dropped down a gear and started to

motor home," Teetan said. "(But) you know when Joao comes next to you in a race, you know you've got a hard battle. In those big ones, he's come next to me a few times and he's got the better of me and I was like 'C'mon Joao, not today' and it pays off."

Dual Derby-winning handler Millard posted his first Group 1 triumph in Hong Kong since Ambitious Dragon's (Pins) 2013 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (Gr 1, 1400m) said Panfield – winner of three Group 1s in Chile before arriving in Hong Kong – had received a "proper Millard preparation" leading into the race.

"We did a good 1800 metre workout and if any of you saw it, it was unbelievable. He broke 60 seconds for 1000 (metres) and he came home (the last 400m) in 21.8 and Karis was hanging onto him.

I said to Karis after that, 'I don't care how good they are, he's ready,'" Millard said.

"Quite clearly, a lot of the older horses are finished now so that puts him at the top spot as the best staying horse in Hong Kong.

"Karis rode a beautiful race today, that's exactly how we planned it and it worked out to an absolute tee. I'm very happy for him because it gives him the confidence to know that if he is on the right horse that he can do it. Quite clearly

this horse was the right horse today and he did everything 100 per cent."

In addition to the HK\$6.8 million in prize-money, Panfield collected a Top-Up Bonus of HK\$500,000 – a payment available to horses who have already won a High Achievement Bonus of HK\$1 million after winning a Class 2 race or higher before turning five.

Blake Shinn notched his first Hong Kong double since arriving in the city in 2019.

"It's fair to say it's been a little while in the making. It's taken a bit longer than I would have liked. It's just nice to get two winners in a day – it's satisfying," the Melbourne Cup-winning jockey said after piloting Caspar Fownes-trained Hall Of Champ (Dark Angel) to victory in the first section of the Class 3 Indigenous Handicap (1400m).

"It's also great to get winners for David Hayes and Caspar Fownes. They've given me plenty of support in Hong Kong, so it's nice to win for both of those guys."

Shinn marked his return from suspension with victory aboard David Hayes-trained Donc Je Suis (Star Witness) in the Class 4 Viva Pataca Handicap (2000m) before Frankie Lor's Free Foal (Press Statement) broke through for his first Hong Kong win in the Class 4 Blazing Speed Handicap (1600m) under Matthew Chadwick.



After waiting 23 starts to break through, The Hulk (Spirit Of Boom) made it two on the bounce for Fownes and Teetan in the second section of the Class 3 Vengeance Of Rain Handicap (1400m).

Joao Moreira extended his lead in the jockey's championship with a treble, climbing to 131 wins – 20 ahead of Zac Purton (111).

Chad Schofield joined Shinn and Teetan as jockeys to savour doubles, while John Size and Fownes shared training honours with a treble apiece, leaving the trainers' title delicately poised with Size leading Fownes 65 to 62.

## Courier Wonder impresses in Sha Tin Vase and extends record to a perfect five

Sprinting sensation Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls), 118lb, extended his unbeaten record to five at Sha Tin with an age and experience defying win in the HK\$3.5 million Sha Tin Vase Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m), writes Declan Schuster.

Stepping up in grade as the least experienced runner in the race, the three-year-old juvenile capped his perfect debut season with a classy victory against a collection of the circuit's best sprinters, including Computer Patch (Exceed And Excel), 132lb, and Sky Field (Deep Field), 130lb, second and third in last month's Chairman's Sprint Prize (Gr 1, 1200m) to Wellington (A Too Hard) on FWD Champions Day (April 25).

Under championship-leading jockey Joao Moreira, Courier Wonder broke away cleanly from gate six to settle in the box seat, before taking over at the 200m mark for a three quarters of a length victory in advance of the fast-closing Stronger (Not A Single Doubt), 130lb, and Sky Field, respectively.

"In the straight, I pulled him out and he dashed home as he always does - good horses like him give jockeys an amazing feeling," Moreira said.

The win was Moreira's second in the race after his triumph aboard Not Listenin'tome (Dylan Thomas) in 2015 for John Moore, while trainer John Size snared his first.

"I'm very excited (for next season), he's the type of horse that everyone dreams to have," Moreira said.



Courier Wonder

Courier Wonder is the full-brother to Icebath, runner-up in the 2021 Doncaster Mile Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick Racecourse last month.

"We had a great opportunity to learn a bit more about him today, the pace was really genuine so he had a chance to settle behind others.

"When we first started turning he got a bit lost and wanted to run out today, shying away from the other horses, but as we progressed he started to relax, which is fantastic," Moreira said.

With a pre-race rating of 100 and flickers of top-class ability, the New Zealand-bred now stands on the cusp of competing at Group 1 level after only five starts across his short career.

Plotting a path towards the Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) at the 2021 LONGINES Hong Kong International Races, Size confirmed the showcase dash as the gelding's long-term target: "That's where we're heading (Hong Kong Sprint)."

"There are no races I would want to run him now and I think that he probably showed that he was looking for a break anyway - that was the feeling I got watching the race live," Size said, indicating that Courier Wonder is to have a break.

"He's got talent and we just have to manage it and try and keep him out of harm's way and then turn him loose on a race track," he added.

The youngster capped an early treble for Size who succeeded with debutant winners Toronado Phantom (Toronado) and Drops Of God (Mossman), the former taking the Pakistan Star Plate (1200m) for Griffins under Chad Schofield, while the latter prevailed in the Class

4 Makarpura Star Handicap (1200m) under Moreira who would later seal a treble.

"I think there's a lot of development in him, I'm pretty hopeful about his future - he's going to win some races," Size said of Toronado Phantom.

Size maintained his three-win lead at the top of the Hong Kong trainers' championship with a treble as he bids for a 12th title, while nearest rival Caspar Fownes grabbed three of his own and moved to 62 wins in outright second place.

"He looks like the sprinter that he's supposed to be, he's well-behaved and even on his first day at the races he seems to do everything right," Size said of Drops Of God.

Fownes' three-timer kicked off with The Hulk claiming the Class 3 Vengeance Of Rain Handicap (1400m) under Karis Teetan, before Hall Of Champ claimed the first section of the Class 3 Indigenous Handicap (1400m) later in the day under Blake Shinn.

Both Fownes and Moreira capped their trebles in the finale, the Class 3 River Verdon Handicap (1200m) when Killer Bee (Savabeel) stung his rivals by a length and a half as the race's 1.6 favourite.

"He had everything against him today, the gate, circumstances that didn't help him - he was exposed four wide with no cover, at least he was nice and relaxed underneath.

"When I dug him up he showed that he has quality, he has class and only good horses can win under those circumstances," Moreira said.

Hong Kong racing continues next Wednesday (May 26) at Happy Valley.

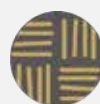
